Have you ever been in love? Yes, I always imagine love to be much bigger. I don't know whether I've reached total love yet. I suppose you don't really know till you're there!


Are you always honest with your fans? As honest as I can be. I'm dishonest with myself, so it's very difficult to be honest with them.




