When I left Australia in June 67 I told Go-Set that I was going away to learn as much as I could in all aspects of entertainment so that when I eventually returned to Austrelia for good I would be an experienced all round entertainer. Of course a hit record would have been nice but it was not the most unpursant thing I was looking for.

I asked Johnny what his plans for the future were "I've always loved playing to kids and I will go on doing so until the kids stop coming to see me. I hope to branch out into television and record production and other behind the scenes work but I certainly will not stop making records.






