## WSIX, WIVK-FM, And KSCS Are Top Billboard/Monitor Award Winners

WSIX Nashville, WIVK-FM Knoxville, Tenn., and KSCS Dallas each took home two awards from the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Awards, held Oct. 18 at the Orlando Renaissance Resort in Florida, at the culmination of the three-day annual Radio Seminar (see story, page 3).

WSIX Nashville was named medium-market station of the year for the fourth consecutive year. That station joined large-market outlet KKBQ Houston and small-market powerhouse KASE Austin, Texas, in this year's winners circle. Also, WSIX morning man Gerry House was named medium-market local air personality of the year for the sixth consecutive time.

WIVK-FM OM Les Acree took home the small-market PD of the year trophy, while WIVK's Chris Huff was named music director of the year. The other dual winner, KSCS, took home trophies for morning man Terry Dorsey (major-market air personality of the year) and promotion/marketing director of the year Tami Griffin, who recently left the station.

In addition to Acree, PD of the year winners were KNIX Phoenix general program manager Larry Daniels, who repeats last year's win in the major-market category, and WQYK-FM Tampa, Fla., OM Tom Rivers in the medium-market category.

Joining Huff as MD of the year winners were WUSN (US99) Chicago's Tricia Biondo (major market) and

WSOC Charlotte, N.C.'s Rick McCracken (medium market). KVET Austin morning hosts Sam Allred and Bob Cole took home the small-market air personality of the year trophy.

Bob Kingsley received his 11th consecutive award in the country network/syndicated program of the year category for his "American Country Countdown" on ABC Radio Networks. Rusty Walker of Rusty Walker Consulting got the radio consultant of the year nod in the country category for the third consecutive year. And CBS Radio's Howard Stern again won the nationally syndicated air personality award, which is not format-specific.

The ceremony also included a new accolade, the Alison Steele Lifetime Achievement Award, named in honor of the pioneering New York air personality known as "the Nightbird," who is best remembered for her 11 years at heritage rock outlet WNEW-FM New York. Broadcast legend Casey Kasem was the recipient of the first-time trophy. Kasem, who hosts several countdown shows for Westwood One, also served as MC at this year's Radio Awards show.

The Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Awards, which honor excellence in radio broadcasting, are given annually in seven format categories. Winners were determined by the readers of Billboard and the four Airplay Monitor publications. A total of 94 awards were given to 470 nominees this year. Musicians LL Cool J and Paul Carrack were co-presenters at the show.

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## Panel: Should Labels Buy Time?

Should labels buy full-fledged, above-the-board plays for their songs at radio? A discussion of that scenario took center stage at the "Country Format Focus Group" session at the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar and Awards, held Oct. 16-18 in Orlando, Fla. Moderators Bob Moody of McVay Media and Rob Dalton of Epic Records discussed the possibility of labels teaming up with retailers to buy time on stations to play new songs in their entirety.

Positioned as a new-music program sponsored by, for example, a chain such as Wal-Mart or Blockbuster, labels might buy about 20 three-minute blocks of time on stations in a week and position the featured song as, say, the "Wal-Mart pick hit of the week." With labels paying stations their average unit rate for that time, the song could replace a three-minute stopset, thereby benefiting programmers as well.

The full-length-commercial issue has been raised several times at various formats over the past two decades. Former R&B outlet KACE Los Angeles tried it in the mid-'80s. Top 40 KHYI (Y95) Dallas announced a retail tie-in program, similar to the one suggested here, in the late '80s but scrapped its plans after negative publicity.

"What PD wouldn't rather play a song instead of three minutes of spots?" asked



Moody. In the ultimate extension of that scenario, Moody said, a station could end up playing 16 songs an hour—12 that are paid for and four selected by the PD. On the downside, he said, some GMs "will be so desperate for the bottom line that they take your money [to play the song] and still play the same amount of spots."

Label reps present, including Mercury's Larry Hughes, endorsed the idea in theory. Asked for his reaction, WMZQ Washington, D.C., PD Mac Daniels said, "My response is like it is to anyone who buys time on my station. I would have to hear the product. If it met with all the regular spot criteria, I would accept it." Moody noted that "the station would always have the right to refuse the buy" and that for the labels, "that would be the best information we could have if it came back [that] we can't even buy this song onto the air."

Daniels noted the long-term danger of "stations holding labels hostage and making them pay to play a record" or complaining if a label is spending more money at a rival station or with a rival chain. "You guys could really be opening Pandora's box," he said. "I can count on one hand the number of labels who have bought time on my station" for a regular spot. "Let's try that first before we do this."

In an unrelated discussion, the perennially hot topic of station concert "presents" was debated at the same session. Most attendees agreed that the issue has not cooled in recent years. Curb's Eva Wood described one recent situation in which "we had a station that want-

ed a major artist so bad [that] they went into cahoots with the promoter and disguised themselves in the contract." The artist went into the market thinking it was a neutral show and got a nasty surprise, and the label couldn't rectify the situation because of the contract. "It was that juvenile and that sneaky," said Wood. As a result, the artist involved will no longer play that market.

In addition to several all-format panels, two seminar sessions focused exclusively on country at the seminar, which broke its own attendance record with more than 950 programmers and label reps registered. The "Ten Weeks And Off" session, which was specifically intended to address the speed at which records move on, up, and off country radio playlists, also touched on a number of other topics. Moderator Butch Waugh, senior VP/GM of the RCA Label Group, noted that when he previously worked on the label's pop side, the term "polarization" never came up, but he now hears it frequently in country. Consultant Pam Shane of Shane Media Services said, "That's because the emotional content of our songs is so much higher. Our songs are stacked to touch people."

In a discussion of how to deal with polarized records, KKBQ (93Q) Houston VP of programming Dene Hallam said he was worried that "people keep concentrating on taking negatives off the air, rather than putting positives on the air. If you have such a shit station that one record is going to blow the cume off, you might as

well turn the thing off. It hacks me off that everyone is so concerned about covering their butt. You have to go out there and make mistakes. What we're concerned about [at KKBQ] is our batting average."

Shane later noted that people who use research as an excuse to reject records "don't deserve the money for the research."

Arista Nashville president/CEO Tim DuBois used a seminar showcase for Jim Collins to further explain to the programmers present why he was merging the 3-year-old Career label back into Arista (see On The Row, this page). DuBois called the move "a conscious and well-studied decision, I hope in the right direction, to reflect what's going on at radio. This is not a knee-jerk reaction. This is a proper business decision that will allow us to better serve [radio]." DuBois stressed that the move, which was in the planning stages for three months, "was not forced on us by New York." And with a promotion staff that now numbers 14, DuBois told the programmers, "we will be in your face on a more regular basis."

Although Collins was the only country artist showcased at the seminar, country hits could be found during other performances. Geffen pop/dance act She Moves included a cover of "It's Your Love" in its set during the opening party at Universal Studios, and Arista's Gary Barlow performed "So Help Me Girl" during the Radio Awards.

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## ON THE ROW

### Career Merged Into Arista; Brooks Sued

**C**areer Records has been merged into Arista. **Denise Nichols**, Career's director of national promotion, is named senior director of field promotion at Arista. Career artists **Lee Roy Parnell**, **Brett James**, and **Jim Collins** move to the Arista roster. **Tammy Graham**'s contract option has expired, but her future with the label has not yet been determined. Arista will now have 11 regionals. Three former Career regionals are out: **Angela Lange**, **Todd Berry**, and **Scott St. John**. **Rob Reid** remains as one of Arista's Southeast reps. Chicago-based rep **Jon Conlon** relocates to Los Angeles to cover part of the West Coast. **Dawn Richardson**, who had a sales and marketing position in the Dallas branch, will become a Southwest regional for Arista.

Rapper **Warren G** has filed a lawsuit against **Garth Brooks**, his company Blue Rose Inc., and Home Box Office alleging Brooks has infringed on the rapper's trademarked "g" in merchandising and advertising materials. The suit seeks an injunction barring Brooks from using the trademark plus compensatory and punitive damages. Warren G's suit follows one filed Oct. 3 by Brooks seeking an order saying that Brooks' logo does not infringe on the rapper's trademark. Brooks' attorney, **Russell Jones**, issued a statement saying "Brooks has always been

responsive and reasonable and regrets that Warren G's representatives have failed to reciprocate."

Former Decca regional **Tami DeVito-Millsbaugh** joins Curb/Universal as Southwest regional, replacing **Jimmy Harnen**, who is now Northwest regional for DreamWorks.

**Mindy McCready** has cancelled all remaining 1997 appearances in order to recover from a tonsillectomy, scheduled for mid-November. Her new album is due Nov. 4.

BNA Records director of East region promotion **Chuck Thagard** relocates from Nashville to Atlanta.

Epic Records and Backstage Productions will offer an hourlong, nonexclusive **Collin Raye** radio special for airplay between Nov. 15 and Jan. 1. Hosted by **WSIX** Nashville midday personality **C.C. McCartney**, the special features an interview with Raye and 10 of the 14 cuts from his recently released greatest-hits album. The special will also offer listeners numerous chances to win MCI prepaid calling cards. A total of almost 180,000 minutes of free long-distance calling time will be awarded through promotions planned by each participating station. Raye performed at an Oct. 18 march in Washington, D.C., to end the silence surrounding domestic violence. The march was organized by the Silent Witness National Initiative.

Arista artist **Michelle Wright** has signed with Monterey Artists for booking. She is planning a 14-city tour of Germany.

Opryland Music Group has signed three new writers to its BMI-affiliated company, Acuff-Rose Music. They are **Scott Whitehead**, **Mark Anderson**, and **Ken Harrell**.

KFMS night jock **Joe Farmer** exits for a morning-show job at Wichita Falls, Texas, working for former KFMS PD **Jay Phillips**, who joins Cumulus Broadcasting as head of country programming for the West Texas region. Phillips will oversee programming at the group's four stations in Wichita Falls, including **KLUR**, plus other future purchases. P/T jock **Scott O'Neil** is upped to nights at KFMS. Cumulus also taps **Dan Gorby** from the GSM post at **WZZK** Birmingham, Ala., as GM of its Augusta, Ga., stations, including country **WUUS**.



## ★ Dixie Chicks

### "I CAN LOVE YOU BETTER" (MONUMENT)

The debut act for the revived Monument label, Dixie Chicks has been voted "best country band in Dallas" four times by The Dallas Observer. The trio of Texas natives consists of lead vocalist Natalie Tarabay and sisters Martie Seidel and Emily Erwin.



Tarabay, a Berklee College of Music vocal scholarship recipient, is the daughter of renowned steel guitarist Lloyd Maines. Fiddler Seidel has been playing since the age of 5 and has been recognized in many national fiddle competitions. Erwin has been playing various instruments professionally since the age of 12. The group made its debut performing on a Dallas street corner in 1989 and has since built up a loyal following touring coast-to-coast.

## Matt King

### "A WOMAN LIKE YOU" (ATLANTIC)

Asheville, N.C., native Matt King moved to Nashville in 1994, when Gary Morris took him under his wing and arranged for an audition with Atlantic. After King played his song "A Woman's Tears" at the audition, Atlantic brass asked him, "Do you have a lawyer?" When he replied, "I can get one," they said, "Congratulations, you're Atlantic Records' new artist." Morris produced King's debut album, "Five O'Clock Hero." He also has a cut, "She Was Mine To Lose," on the new Wade Hayes album. His is currently on tour with Patty Loveless and Bryan White.

## The Kinleys

### "PLEASE" (EPIC)

Twin sisters Heather and Jennifer Kinley grew up in Philadelphia and moved to Nashville at the age of 19 to pursue a country music career.



For the next seven years, they spent nights waitressing and days working on their songwriting. They crashed parties, went to writers' showcases, and spent a year at the Courtyard Cafe doing covers, with Jennifer on piano and Heather on guitar. A demo of "Just Between You And Me" got the attention of Epic Records. The duo's debut album is named for that song.


I don't study these things closely, but I'm in a market 160 or so market sizes smaller than his, and 25 stations still show up in my "noncompetitive" market.

Urban teamed up with drummer Peter Clarke in 1988 to form a band that was successful in their home country. Bassist Jerry Flowers, a native West Virginian, auditioned for Urban and Clarke in Nashville in 1993 and was immediately hired to complete the trio.


## MONITOR PROFILE

### Bill Anderson Reflects The 'Rainbow' Of Country With His Varied Career

**A**lthough he is best known as the performer of a string of country hits on Decca and MCA from the late '50s through the late '80s, Bill Anderson has also had a unique relationship with radio throughout his long career. He started in the business as a DJ at WGAU Athens, Ga., and WJJJC Commerce, Ga., and even after making the move to the songwriting and performing side, he continued to be involved with radio, owning country station KFTN Provo, Utah, from 1975 to '81.

Anderson will speak about many of his experiences with radio during a keynote address at Country Radio Seminar West in Sacramento, Calif., moderated by Airplay Monitor director of charts Wade Jessen, but he first gives us a preview of that conversation here.

Growing up listening to the radio in Georgia, Anderson recalls that the format was distinguished by "the real cornball kind of stuff," where a DJ might be heard to say, "We're going

to ball and squall and climb the wall, y'all." Even after that sort of presentation became passé, Anderson says, country radio was still marked by poor production values and sound. Today, he adds, "I like the fact that it's out of the barnyard. It's out of the hayseed image. It's as contemporary as any other radio station in the '90s. Sometimes when I'm on the road I'll get mad because I'll turn the dial and I can't really tell if I'm listening to a country station. And yet, in a way, that's good because it used to be you could tell the country station because it was the worst-sounding one on the dial."

Despite the production problems, Anderson says his early days in radio were distinguished by talented personalities, something he says has largely been lost. "I would love to listen to the radio and hear more disc jockeys," he says, interjecting, "I'm sorry, but that's what I call them. They can call themselves radio personalities or broadcast personalities if they want to, but where is the personality? I would like to hear people on the radio who sound like they're having fun doing what they're doing, and aside from just a few that I hear around the country, they're all just cookie-cutter, and there [are] no real individuals."

Besides the loss of personality radio, his biggest pet peeve with the format today is that jocks don't back-announce songs. "They tell you the name of the station 14 times, but they won't tell you who the singer is, and I don't see why," he says. "If you don't watch the videos, there's nothing that sounds all that individual or distinctive about a whole lot of the singers, and then when they don't tell you who they are, it really kind of leaves you in the dark."

As the singer of everything from deep country narratives like his No. 1 hits "Still" and "Mama Sang A Song" to quasi-disco with his No. 4 1978 hit "I Can't Wait Any Longer," Anderson is amused by the ongoing debate about what is and isn't country, particularly when

singers like Shania Twain and Bryan White get accused of not being country enough.

"Folks, I hate to tell you, but this is not a new argument; only the names have been changed," he says. "When I was a disc jockey in 1957 and '58, I got the flak, 'Are the Everly Brothers country? Is Elvis country? Is Jerry Lee Lewis country?' I'd be sitting down there in Commerce, Ga., and I'd play Lester Flatt and Earl Scruggs and then I'd turn around and play Jerry Lee Lewis and my phone would light up, [with someone complaining] 'That ain't country.' One of my favorite things about country music is the breadth and the depth of it. I've done everything from songs with a harmonica and a banjo to country disco, and it's because I genuinely like a lot of different kinds of music. A lot of times when you look at country music it's like looking at a rainbow. Its got a lot of different colors. And that's one of its strengths."

While many of his contemporaries complain about not getting airplay anymore, Anderson is more sanguine about it, especially since a recent songwriting hot streak has at least kept his songs on the radio. "I'd be lying if I said I didn't want any more exposure for the things that I've done or the things I may yet do. Of course I do, but my lord, I had a pretty good run of 30-plus years when they played me on the radio a lot," he says. "My attitude is, I'm too busy trying to create new things to sit around with my head buried in the past. I'd love to hear Merle Haggard and George Jones and Charlie Pride and Tammy Wynette on the radio, but you've got to admit that they don't put running boards on cars anymore either. I'm not out crusading for it. If someone wants to play one of my records, I love it, and I appreciate it, but I'm not marching down the street waving a flag."

In addition to performing about 75 dates a year, regularly appearing at the Grand Ole Opry, co-hosting TNN's "Backstage At The Opry" show, and cutting a new album for Warner Bros., which was produced by Steve Wariner and will be out next year, Anderson spends several days a week writing songs with as many of the hot young writers as he can.

After a 10-year stretch from the early '80s to early '90s, when Anderson hadn't written many songs, Wariner had a hit in 1992 with a remake of Anderson's "The Tip Of My Fingers." That experience, Anderson says, "kind of lit a fire under me. I did not realize how much I missed writing and hearing my songs on the radio and seeing them on jukeboxes until all of a sudden there it was again."

When Vince Gill released "Which Bridge To Cross, Which Bridge To Burn"—a song he co-wrote with Anderson—as a single, that further "whetted my appetite," says Anderson. More recently, he's written what may be Bryan White's next single, "One Small Miracle"; the title cut on James Bonamy's current album, "Roots And Wings"; and the song "I've Enjoyed As Much Of This As I Can Stand" on the current Lorrie Morgan album. He also has cuts on upcoming projects from Mark Wills and Randy Travis.

Anderson joined the Grand Ole Opry cast in 1961 and has been a staple there ever since. He says the Opry has evolved along with the rest of the industry to the point where "right now the Opry on most Saturday nights is about as exciting and alive and vibrant as it's been since I've been there. I love going out there in the weekends, when there's two or three of the hot, young, new acts on and then the legends are right there beside them. There is an amazing energy in that Opry house when that happens."
