• ROCK ROUNDUP •

The year of 1994 for the rock format unfolded to be one of its most successful ever. The ratings that stations have received and the sales of rock records were fantastic. Modern Rock strengthened its position in the arena of radio as a formidable format with new stations in major markets and quality Arbitron numbers at many of its outlets, while Album Rock radio, whose reluctance to play new artists has waned, provided unwavering support for and impacted the sales of the year's top rock acts, including Stone Temple Pilots, Pearl Jam, and Soundgarden. With Modern Rock radio embracing harder rock and Album Rock radio broadening its playlists to include new, cutting-edge artists, the lines are becoming increasingly blurred in categorizing rock artists. Who could have predicted that the perennially alternative-based Meat Puppets would have a hit that would stay in the Album Rock top ten for 16 weeks but wouldn't crack the top ten at Modern?

SHINE ON: Undoubtedly one of the year's biggest hits, Collective Soul's "Shine" took the top spot for Album Track of the year. The song, written by an almost-defeated Ed Roland, stayed at No. 1 from May 21 to July 9 for a total of 8 weeks. The summer song's broad appeal did well on both the Hot 100 chart (No. 11) and the Modern chart (No. 4) as well. The song's uplifting motif had won the early support of stations in the Southeast, but it was Atlantic's foresight that allowed the record to be able to enrapture the airwaves around the country. Even if it may hold the dubious distinction of being the only year-end No. 1 rock song to exclusively use a drum machine—that in a format inherently impassioned with inspirational individual live performances that would separate it from other formats—"Shine" had just the right groove to illuminate the charts. Congratulations to Atlantic Records for having a tremendous year at both formats, especially at Album where their artists held the No. 1 spot for 19 of the 50 weeks. "Interstate Love Song," which holds the No. 1 spot again this week for a record-breaking 15th consecutive week, follows the two-week stay at the top "Vaseline" enjoyed to account for Stone Temple Pilots holding the top rock spot from September through December.

AND WASH AWAY THE RAIN: Soundgarden's "Black Hole Sun" became the first song to close out the entire, fragmented Album Rock panel during its 7-week stay at No. 1 in July and August, but its longevity was different at Modern. While it was never actually a No. 1 song at Modern, it was fortified by an incredible 14-week stay in the top ten and managed to collect more plays than any other song during the year. A&M's tremendous year with Soundgarden started with "Superunknown" debuting at No. 1 on the Billboard 200 on March 26 and spending the next 28 weeks entrenched in the top twenty.

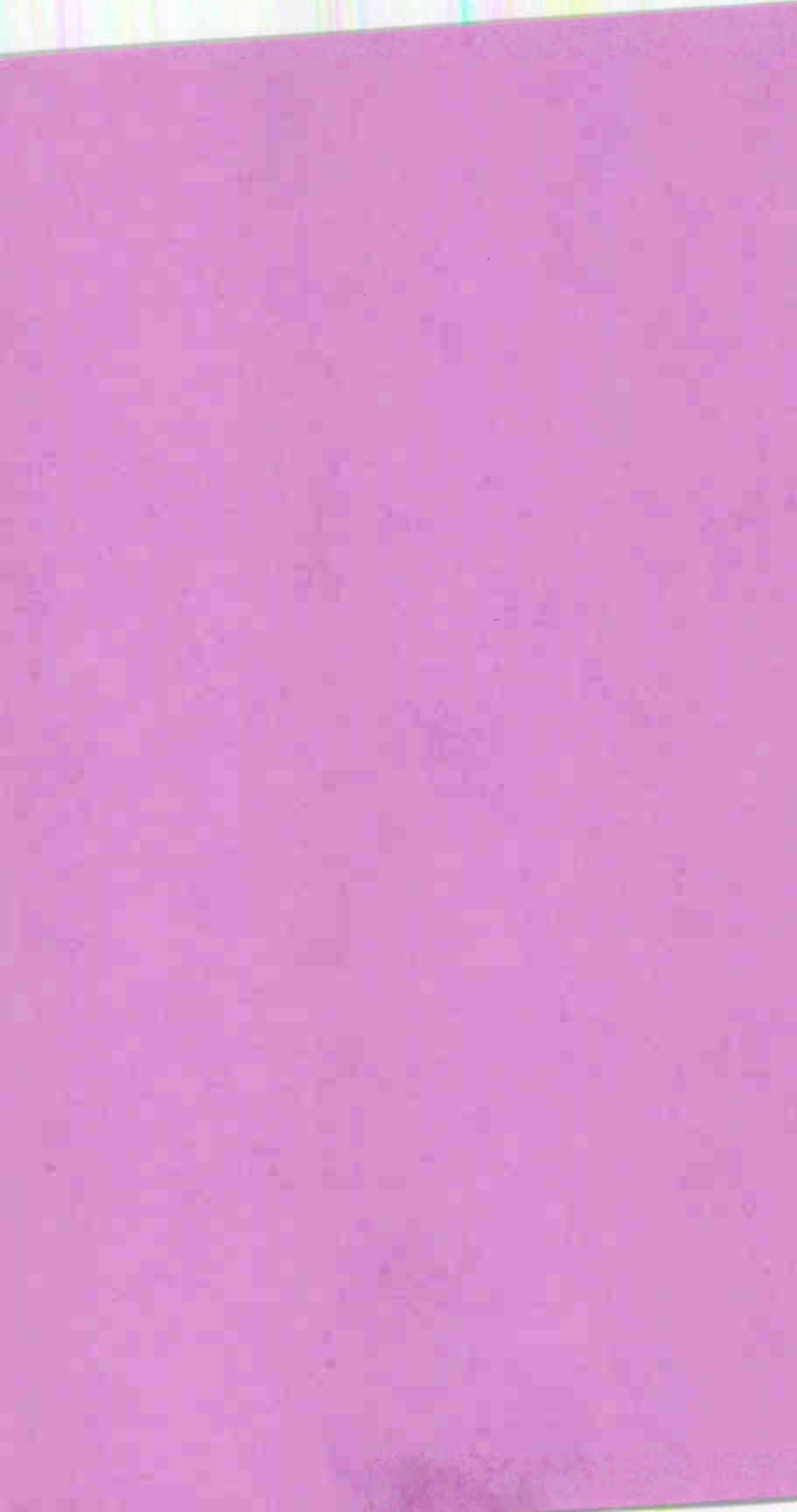

In today's world of corporate takeovers, restructured contracts, and merchandising deals, the tangle of legalities hasn't hindered some successful major-label musicians from joining together under an old-fashioned concept: musical escapades in the basement, with the only binding force a desire to create music with friends. How many of us can recall daydreaming aloud about potential supergroups in the same way that sports fans compile their dream teams? Groups such as **Mad Season**, whose members are from **Pearl Jam**, **Alice In Chains**, and **Screaming Trees**, seem to serve a dual purpose for the successful musicians involved. These groups, formed purely under the auspices of a connected musical intuition, offer members a reprieve from the commercial restraints that come with success, affording them the opportunity to stretch their musical voices.


Whether it has been as an elegy for a friend (**Temple Of The Dog**) or an informal jam by some of today's most inspiring musicians (**Mad Season**), some rock superstars have plugged into a musician kinship that had been lost in the exploitative pop culture of the past two decades. Unlike the '70s and '80s, when superstar musicians rarely ventured outside of their own bands, today's blockbuster acts do not seem adverse to forming side projects and then releasing the recorded sessions, sometimes unintentionally. With plans just to jam, it's amazing **Mad Season** went full-on to record an album in a mere 10 days, skipping the demo stage altogether. "Everything came together so fast," said drummer **Barrett Martin** in a March 23 *Rolling Stone* article. "You can imagine, we're three pretty busy bands."

Given the contractual limitations/obligations of major-label artists, it will be interesting to see what develops out of the **Neil Young/Pearl Jam** collaboration. If the **Mad Season** album is an indication of what big-name musicians can do in the spirit of jamming, let's hope more collaborations are in store.

ROCK ROUNDUP

A RUNDOWN OF THE Fall '94 Arbitrons: With a few exceptions, most of the modern stations seem to have leveled off a bit from the hugely successful numbers earned in summer '94, accounting for a generally soft fall book. WKQX Chicago, coming off third place in the market with its best book ever, goes from 4.3-3.6 share, ranking eighth in the market. Note the similar scenarios for WNNX Atlanta (5.7-4.9), KEGE Minneapolis (6.5-5.9), and KXRK Salt Lake City (6.3-4.3).

With rock stations abounding in Detroit, slices of the pie are getting smaller. In its first book as a modern, WHYT is already having an impact on the other rock stations—with a 3.5 share in the 12-plus, it is neck-and-neck with WRIF. However, WRIF came out on top of the 18-34 demo with a 7.6, ahead of WHYT's 5.4 share. CIMX, which landed second place among persons 18-34 in the summer book, lost ground (3.3-2.2 12-plus) to WHYT, WRIF, and WLLZ (2.2-2.3 12-plus).

In Seattle, KNDD held its 5 share, even as it slipped from 5.2—good enough to stay ahead of KISW, which dropped 5.3-3.9 12-plus. KNDD had an excellent showing in the 18-34 demo, where it managed to beat out all other stations in the market.

WAXQ New York, after seesawing back and forth with WNEW, regains the hold on the 18-34 demo. Still, WAXQ has yet to break out over a 2 share 12-plus.

BIG WINNERS: WXRA Greensboro, N.C., seems to have filled a niche for rock music in the market since switching from country five months ago. In its first book as an album rock station, it scored a 7.1 share 12-plus, good enough to rank second in Greensboro. KEDG Las Vegas moves 4.9-6.6 12-plus to place in the top five in the market, ahead of all rock stations.

Modern Rock as a format ranked as one of the three primary gainers in the fall book, according to Interep (the others were N/T and oldies); its share rose from 2.3-3.1.
