• ROCK ROUNDUP •

THE HEAT IS ON for WDRE Long Island, N.Y.'s Underground Network format. PD Russ Mottla is out after a rough spring book, in which WDRE plummeted to a .7 share, the lowest the station has ever had. WDRE's 12-plus share has steadily deteriorated from 2.3 a year ago. Similarly, WIBF Philadelphia, WDRE's first simulcast outlet, dropped 3.0-1.5 in three books. These results come as WDRE—which has full- and part-time affiliates in markets as diverse as Little Rock, Ark., and Cape Cod, Mass.—adds affiliate No. 10, WYKT Wilmington, Ill., for overnights.

Speaking of networks, Z-Rock is undergoing an overhaul in its focus. In memos circulated to all Z-Rock affiliates that included summaries of different demos and observations about music fans, managing director Lee Abrams explains that Z-Rock is abandoning bands whose sound/look/attitude resemble the '80s rock of Bon Jovi, Motley Crue, Poison, etc. Abrams says we are in a musically "intense" period in which a new sound is emerging. He compares today with 1956's "early rock" (the Coasters, Elvis), 1964's British invasion (Stones, Beatles), 1969's progressive rock (Led Zeppelin), and the early '80s "New Wave and New Metal" (Police, Def Leppard).

Spring books were good for KLOS Los Angeles and WHFS Washington D.C. The revitalized KLOS returned to the top 10 for the first time since summer '93, moving 2.3-3.3. WHFS moved up to third place in its market (3.7-4.4) and had a great book in Baltimore as well (3.4-4.9).

Arbitron reports a 10.1% improvement in its 18-24 male response rate, with the biggest increase in college towns, such as Boston, Ann Arbor, Mich., and South Bend, Ind. Surprisingly, this increase didn't help Beantown modern rockers WBCN (5.1-4.5) or WFNX (2.0-1.8). Instead, triple-A WBOS went 2.4-3.3, giving it the biggest gain in the market for a rock station.

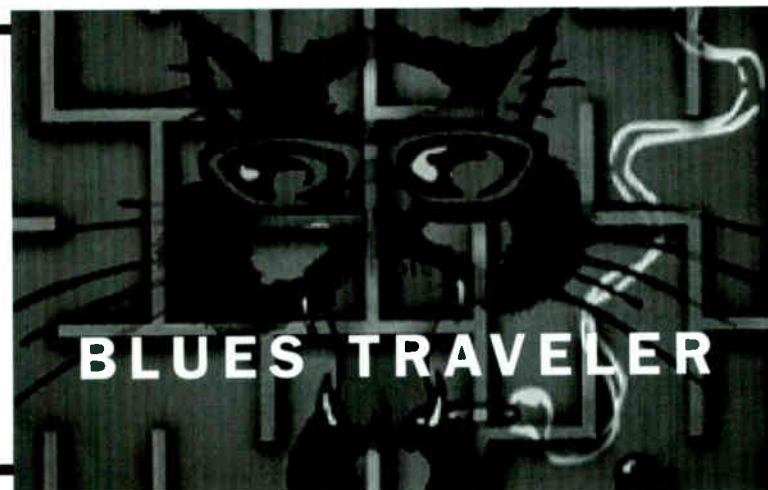
