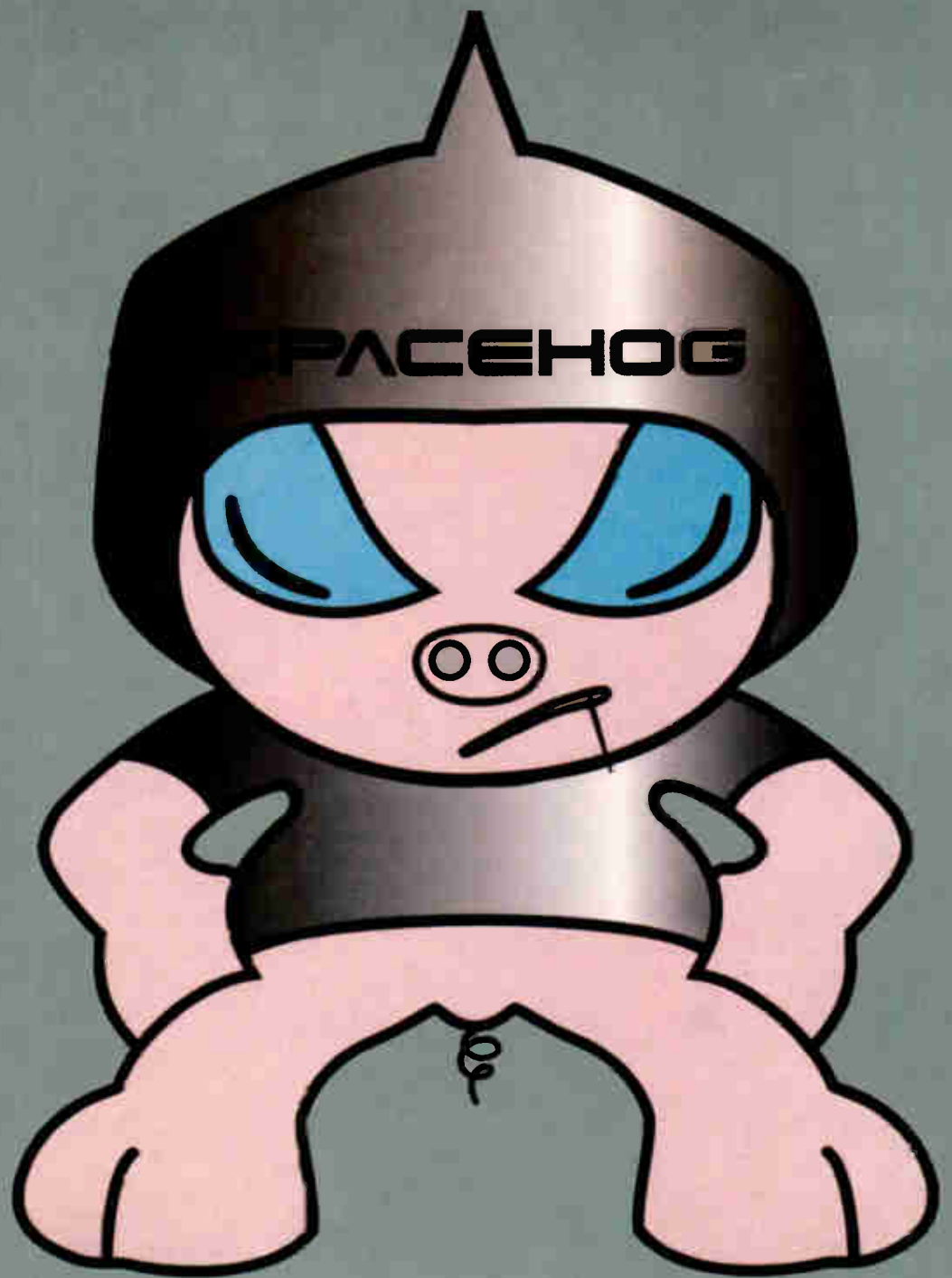

• ROCK ROUNDUP •

Here's how the dust settled for a few of the stations around the country that were pursuing the holiday concert event.

KROQ Los Angeles' Almost Acoustic Christmas show, considered the blueprint for such promotions, will take place over two nights, Dec. 17-18, at the Universal Amphitheater. The first night features Alanis Morissette, Foo Fighters, Garbage, Joan Osborne, No Doubt, Porno For Pyros, the Presidents Of The United States Of America, Radiohead, Sonic Youth, and the Toadies. The following night is Morissette, Garbage, Goo Goo Dolls, Osborne, Lenny Kravitz, Oasis, Radiohead, the Rentals, Silverchair, and Tripping Daisy. Tickets for KROQ's sixth annual show are \$25, and proceeds benefit the L.A. Countywide Coalition to End Homelessness and other local charities.

KNDD (the End) Seattle's Deck The Hall Ball show at the Seattle Center Arena Dec. 2 will feature Jawbreaker, the Rentals, Tripping Daisy, Everclear, Oasis, Sonic Youth, and Porno For Pyros for \$20. The End has been doing a Christmas show since 1991, and proceeds benefit children's charities in the Northwest.

The third annual Edge Christmas concert, Dec. 3, hosted by KDGE (the Edge) Dallas, will feature Tears For Fears, Del Amitri, the Rentals, Matthew Sweet, Lisa Loeb, Deep Blue Something, the Nixons, and the Toadies at the Fair Park Coliseum for a \$25 ticket price.

WBCN Boston has "taken over the city," as Oedipus puts it, Dec. 5 and will play host to a multivenue event. The WBCN Xmas Rave stretches out through six different venues in the city, and tickets will be sold separately for each place. Listeners can choose among 25 bands, including the Toadies, the Dave Matthews Band, Heather Nova, Jewel, Goo Goo Dolls, Garbage, and Everclear. Proceeds benefit the Stop the Handgun, Tay-Sachs, and Margaret Fuller House charities.

On a smaller scale, KTEG Albuquerque, N.M., will offer contest winners an intimate dinner and a pre-show party at a local restaurant, according to PD Sandy Horowitz. The entourage will then attend a club show by Sweet, No Doubt, and a handful of local bands.
