Modern Starts More Top 40 Hits Than Any Other Format

Two years ago, for a record to have started at modern rock was as much a hindrance as a boon to its prospects at mainstream top 40. But this fall, modern rock radio has again become the format where the greatest number of mainstream top 40 hits chart first, ending, by a slim margin, a two-year period in which mainstream top 40 was starting more of its own hits than any other format. In a sign that mainstream top 40 is becoming more balanced than it has been in years, R&B radio, rhythmic top 40, triple-A, and country have also increased the number of hits they send mainstream top 40 over the past six months.

Airplay Monitor analyzed where each of the mainstream top 40 hits from our Nov. 20 issue had first charted. When you include ties, modern rock was first on 12 titles and first outright on nine. That's up from nine songs in total and seven outright from when we last looked at the subject in April. It's also the first time the format has spawned crossovers in the double digits since April 1996, when it was first on 12 songs in total and 10 outright.

Mainstream top 40, by contrast, was first on 11 songs including ties and six outright. That's down from 15 total and 11 outright in the spring but comparable to its 11 total/eight

outright showing a year ago. In fact, mainstream top 40 seems to start more of its own hits at the beginning of the year than it does at the end, probably reflecting a greater presence of multi-format superstar product in the fourth quarter.

Rhythmic top 40 was the third-most-influential format; it was first on nine songs altogether and five outright, up from six altogether and four outright in the spring. It was followed by modern adult (first on six altogether but only one outright), mainstream R&B (five altogether, four outright), adult top 40 (four songs, but all of them shared with other formats), triple-A (three altogether, one outright), country (two songs, both of them exclusives), and AC and mainstream rock (each with one exclusive song).

MUCH MORE MODERN

Modern rock was first to chart top 40's current hits by Third Eye Blind, Shawn Mullins, Eve 6, Semisonic, Fastball, and New Radicals. It was first on both Goo Goo Dolls hits, as well as Matchbox 20's "Real World." It was tied for first on chart hits from Alanis Morissette, Barenaked Ladies, and Eagle-Eye Cherry. Its lead on titles that eventually charted at mainstream top 40 ranged from three weeks (in the case of "Iris") to five

Scott Muni Takes A Shot At Sports Talk, While Tortora Takes Middays At WNEW

Radio vet Scott Muni is back working at the CBS New York cluster. He'll host a one-shot two-hour sports-talk program on WFAN with another WNEW alum, Richard Neer. WFAN PD Mark Chernoff says that although this is a one-off show, he's not ruling out anything for the future. Chernoff, incidentally, helmed WNEW twice during Muni's lengthy tenure with the rocker.

Meanwhile, Long Island, N.Y., radio vet Ralph Tortora, most recently PD of album WEFX Stamford, Conn., joins WNEW for middays as part of PD Garry Wall's plan to line up a staff with multiple talents.

COMPUTER NUT CRACKS 'HFS CODE

The Washington Post reports that fans of modern WHFS Washington, D.C., received E-mail saying the station's 'HFS-Mas Holiday Nutcracker show had been canceled. The E-mails were generated by a hacker who broke into the WHFS system and distributed false information for three days.

BUSINESS: JOURNAL UPS TWO

Journal Communications' board of directors has elected president/CEO Steven J. Smith chairman/CEO and elevated executive VP Douglas G. Kiel to the post of president. Smith replaces the retiring Robert A. Kahlor. Rock outlets in the Journal Broadcast group include album KEZO/classic rock KKCD Omaha, Neb., and album KJOT/modern KQXR/modern adult KCID Boise, Idaho.

CBS Radio's eight Chicago properties—including talk/classic rock WCKG—have teamed to form the CBS Promotions Group Chicago, which will serve as a sales, marketing, and promotional unit. Robin Cecola is named director of this division. She previously was with Columbia Records and, more recently, Music Choice in Chicago. Gary Ellis joins the promotions group as senior AE from the Kellogg Co.

PROGRAMMING: HE HAS THE BEAT

Modern WMRQ/top 40 WKSS Hartford, Conn., VP of programming Jay Beau Jones exits for the PD seat at R&B oldies WRCX (the Beat) Chicago.

Album WYMG Springfield, Ill., PD/middayer Mike Thomas heads to Dayton, Ohio, to program Jacor's album WTUE.

Modern WPBZ West Palm Beach, Fla., PD John O'Connell becomes OM/PD of WPBZ and sister AC WMBX (Mix 102.3), as WMBX PD Kevin Callahan exits. WPBZ MD Dan O'Brien gets APD stripes. Jeff Clark remains APD at WMBX.

Album WRQR Wilmington, N.C., MD/middayer Christine Martinez picks up PD duties as well.

Modern adult KLLY Bakersfield, Calif., needs a PD and morning co-host to replace Mark McKay and Bill Fox, respectively. According to KLLY sources, the duo is headed for top 40 WBHT Wilkes-Barre, Pa.

Westwood One has pacted with the National Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences to become the official Grammy radio network for the 41st annual Grammy Awards show and through 2001. Coverage begins with the Jan. 5 nominee announcements and will include nine two-hour specials, including ones focusing on mainstream rock and modern rock, that will continue through the Feb. 24 event itself, which it will cover with CBS-TV.

FORMATS: AUSTIN'S PLANET GOES FROM ORBIT TO OBIT

Modern KFMK (the Planet) Austin, Texas, ends its short-lived run at the format for R&B oldies.

Adult standards outlet KMJC Mount Shasta,

Calif., trades the format for triple-A under PD Don Holland.

PEOPLE: N'AWLINS MAWNIN' MOVES

Album WCKW New Orleans picks up the syndicated Bob and Tom show. That sends morning team Walton and Johnson to cross-town WRNO for mornings as that station shifts from classic hits to classic rock. Meanwhile, former WALC (Alice 104) St. Louis PD Bob Davis, who has been consulting WRNO, forges an alliance with the Randy Lane Co. that will also make him available to RLC clients. Davis will continue to work with his own stations.

After last week's exit of J.C. Corcoran from mornings at album KSD St. Louis, morning co-host Mark Close—a 25-year market vet in his own right—inherits the shift for the foreseeable future.

The Pittsburgh Post-Gazette reports that album WDVE morning co-host Jim Krenn has picked up a side gig. He's consulting the Western Pennsylvania Historical Society museum to help revamp existing exhibits, create new ones, and voice a humorous audiotape tour of the museum.

Modern KCXX Riverside, Calif., P/T Scott Lowe gets the same at modern KLYY (Y107) Los Angeles.

Classic rock WEGQ (Eagle 93.7) Boston makes some staff changes, sending middayer Stella Mars and afternoon host Jay Michaels to P/T. Night jock Steve York gets middays, and market vet Karen Blake joins for afternoons from the same at country WKLB. Crosstown album WAAF P/T Dave Breen replaces York in nights.

Modern WJBX Fort Myers, Fla., promotion director/middayer Stephanie Davis is exiting. Also at the station, Anrae, who had co-hosted mornings with the recently exited Joe Scott, inherits the solo shift.

Modern WPLY (Y100) Philadelphia moves morning producer Ben Maxwell to overnights, replacing the recently exited Monkeyboy. New to mornings is intern Casey Boy, who takes the role of morning assistant.

Modern adult KZPT (the Point) Tucson, Ariz., goes the open-audition route to find a morning co-host for Cathy Rivers, in its Ultimate Point Payroll promotion. In a sign of the times, the on-air auditions are being co-sponsored by Pepsi One. The station will give each of its four finalists a week's audition in March.

ALL YOU ZOMBIES HIDE YOUR FACES

Album KUPD Phoenix PD J.J. Jeffries reports that Rob Zombie played the nearby Mesa Amphitheater the day after Thanksgiving. During one song, Zombie invited some women from the audience onstage. One woman removed her top, and the others followed suit, with Zombie and band ending the song surrounded by a group of topless women.

Mesa, though, is a conservative Mormon town, and one of Zombie's roadies was met after the show by someone from the Maricopa County sheriff's department looking for Zombie. The roadie told the cop he was going to get Zombie. And he did. He got him into a catering truck and spirited the guitarist out of the venue and the county to rendezvous with his tour bus.

NOW HOW MUCH WOULD YOU PAY?

For album WQXA Harrisburg, Pa., advertising on NBC's "Today" show cost \$10,000. That's how much money was up for grabs in WQXA's version of a format perennial contest offering a bounty for the listener who could most creatively expose the station's logo to the greatest number of people. The grand-prize winner earned the prize by skydiving while holding a "105.7 the X" banner, video of which the "Today" show aired six times.

'Shimmer' Basks In 1,000-Spin Spotlight

THE THOUSAND-SPIN CLUB: Nineteen stations have played Fuel's "Shimmer" (550 Music) more than 1,000 times since its debut on the modern rock chart in March. The title remains lodged in the modern rock top 30 . . . Green Day's "Time Of Your Life (Good Riddance)" (Reprise), which debuted in November '97 and went to recurrent status in May, is still one of modern rock's most-played songs. Thirty stations have played it more than 1,000 times, giving the title a total of more than 70,000 spins to date.

The Fly's "Got You (Where I Want You)" (Delicious Vinyl/Irauma) remains bulleted at modern rock for 17 straight weeks, making it modern's longest consecutively bulleted record of 1998.

Metallica's "Turn The Page" (Elektra/EEG) sets the active rock record for most spins in a single week. "Turn" has 1,516 detections and is being played on all of the active rock panel's 50 stations. The title has the fourth-highest single-week spin count ever at mainstream rock, with 2,501 detections. The top three are Pink Floyd's "Keep Talking" (2,600), Live's "Lightning Crashes" (2,514), and Collective Soul's "December" (2,512).

Only two songs starting with the word "psycho" have ever charted at mainstream rock. Both Kiss' "Psycho Circus" (Mercury) and Black Sabbath's "Psycho Man" (Epic) are on the chart this issue, coinciding with the opening of the remake of the Alfred Hitchcock thriller.

PERSONNEL FILE: Billboard Bulletin reports that Reprise GM Rich Fitzgerald will take "a very senior marketing role" at the label and sister Warner Bros. The new role would have him report to Warner Bros. Records chairman/CEO Russ Thyret and president Phil Quartararo. While the move comes after Jon Leshay's exit from the senior VP of marketing position in the wake of recent layoffs, Fitzgerald's proposed role will be "much broader" than Leshay's. Bulletin also confirms that EMI Recorded Music North America deputy president Roy Lott becomes permanent president/CEO at Capitol Records.

Market Vet Luczak Takes Flight With Classic Hits On WING-FM Dayton

Michael Luczak's radio career reads like an Ohio guidebook, from the University of Dayton's student-run WVUD in the mid-'70s to a decade with album WEBN Cincinnati, to a brief out-of-state stop at classic rock WCKG Chicago before a return to WEBN, followed by stints at album WAZU Dayton, WMMS Cleveland, and WBZ Toledo. In 1996, Luczak returned to Dayton to program WAZU's old frequency, now classic hits WING-FM. He's now OM of WING-FM, top 40 WGIZ (Z93), and N/T WING-AM.

What he got in WING-FM was a signal that didn't cover all of Dayton and, in fact, competed with WEBN on the south side of the market. The station had Bob and Tom, but under then LMA partner Great Trails, Luczak says, WING was "an afterthought. Z93 was a big top 40 with all the attention and all the marketing and all the effort."

Modern had just hit the market in the form of WXEG, and album WTUE was mixing a few classic tracks with a hearty serving of grunge. "Meanwhile, WING is playing Joni Mitchell next to Foghat next to El.O next to James Tay-

we're an out-of-market signal." He attributes part of WING's success to growing pains at Jacor's Dayton cluster. "Jacor came into town at the end of '97. They had an interim GM, and they fired Tom Carroll, and they had their morning guy doing the PD job, and he'd never been a PD before. That whole building was in a state of flux, and I don't think there was enough focus on what their competitors were doing. I think they got their eye off the ball. Not so much the guys on the front line and the guys who live in town here, but that whole structure of owning a million stations. When you have an interim GM, how are you going to get things done? I think that played to our advantage."

And part of that reflects back to the music. Luczak says WING and WTUE had jostled for musical turf in recent years. "In '97, they went back and claimed that classic rock turf," says Luczak. "Jacor took them back to sounding harder and younger, and we just stayed in our classic rock mode."

"Any time you do an oldies station, you're going to play the same 300 or 400 songs as your power library. To me, the whole trick is just making it interesting, and I think we did that. It's all packaging. And we're always trying to reinvent the cleverness around the records."

That means daily features like "The Favorite 45" at 1:20 p.m. "We'll play James Brown's 'Cold Sweat,'" says Luczak, who calls the station "adventurous and flavorful. For a while we were playing TV theme songs. They found boxes of old jingles from WING-AM's top 40 days and reworked them for drops."


And there's room for new music, too. "Everybody says old guys don't like new music," Luczak says. "Some of them do, and they care; you just have to be cautious, and it's got to fit the genre." That means new music from veterans like Bruce Hornsby and John Mellencamp, classic-sounding new acts like Jonny Lang and Kenny Wayne Shepherd, and even the new Metallica track. Luczak explains, "This is a great song by Bob Seger. You've heard it forever. This is Metallica. This is the '98 version. This is the band that sold out River Bend in five minutes. It's stupid not to play it."

Here's a sample hour on WING-FM: Eagles, "Desperado (Medley)"; Edgar Winter Group, "Frankenstein"; Black Crowes, "Thorn In My Pride"; Boston, "More Than A Feeling"; Doobie Brothers, "Rockin' Down the Highway"; Kenny Wayne Shepherd, "Somewhere, Somewhere, Someway"; Dire Straits, "Money For Nothing"; Animals, "The House Of The Rising Sun"; and Steve Miller Band, "Rock'n Me."

The latest chapter in the WING story is still being written as the converging Jacor and WING parent Clear Channel are spinning off Luczak's three properties. Luczak, who first came to the stations under Great Trails when that company was getting ready to spin off the stations, remembers that feeling of being in no man's land. He says, "We're orphans again... I'm kind of jaded about it, [but for] some of the folks in the building, it's a tough experience."

And there's another concern. "This is the advantage the company now has," Luczak says, listing all the WING-FM information Clear Channel/Jacor now has. "They have budgets for the year 1999. They have financial information on all the clients. Who we've done business with. Who our good clients are. They have information on our marketing plans, our promo plans. They have detailed info on every single employee in terms of performance evaluation... To me that seems like an unfair advantage. And I don't think that situation has existed that much. That's a new one to me where, 'We've got to get rid of these stations, but we'll know everything about them.' In this day and age, it's all about information and getting a step ahead."



lor: They were all good songs, but there was no cohesion," says Luczak. "So, little by little we lost the moniker 'the classic hits of the '70s' and just called it 'classic hits,' and we started playing Beatles, Who, Stones, Zeppelin... and started getting some numbers," specifically a 4.7-5.7 12-plus rise in the summer.

Music aside, a major weapon was lying dormant in the WING arsenal. In early '96, "we started a full-bore effort to make people realize that Bob and Tom were in the market," he says. "Their camp will tell you that Bob and Tom are an acquired taste, and it just takes some time. So, we spent a lot of time... We brought the Bob and Tom band in, sold tickets to a night-club appearance, caused some hoopla with that. Sold their CDs, ran TV commercials." Luczak says that from the show's sign-on in '95 through '97, the station spent hundreds of thousands of dollars solely on promoting the morning men in Dayton. Eventually, he adds, the pair would draw listeners from country, AC, and full-service AM competition.

Once the morning show was set, 1998 was the year to take the growing Bob and Tom audience and introduce it to the rest of the station, using forced-listening contests to recycle audience throughout the dayparts. This year "was the first time we invested in any kind of on-air prizes to entice the audience," says Luczak. "Our whole approach was, we're talking to 35- to 44-year-old guys. These are older guys who, 15-20 years ago, might have cared about front-row seats and winning a new CD. You know what these guys care about [now]: Titanium-shaft drivers, bass boats, a 1970 Chevelle that would look cool in their driveway, going to Mardi Gras on a trip, having somebody come and do all their lawn care for a year, and computers."

Luczak says that beating WTUE "should have never happened. There's no way in hell this station should ever beat them given their heritage and signal strength and the fact that

Modern Starts More Top 40 Hits Than Any Other Format

months on Eve 6 and more than three months on Semisonic and Fastball.

Not only was modern rock earliest on a larger number of hits, it was earliest on the largest number of major top 40 hits. On the chart we examined, the top six hits at mainstream top 40 all began at modern rock, five of them outright.

When modern rock last dominated these stats, the broadcast dial was much different. Modern AC was only a few months old as an identifiable format. Modern rock stations were still popping up in any market that didn't already have one and in some that did. Mainstream top 40 was, after five to seven years of decline, only beginning to rebuild its station base, and the top 40 dance boom, prompted by the success of WKTU New York, was brand new.

Since then, the fortunes of mainstream top 40 and modern rock have reversed, with top 40 rebounding and modern rock losing stations and, to some extent, audience share. That, combined with the initial decision by some moderns to go harder and set themselves apart from modern AC and top 40, managed to stem the flow of modern-to-top 40 crossovers. So did the rise of the teen-oriented pop groups and the record industry's realization that it wasn't always necessary to start a top 40 hit at another format to sell albums.

But now, enough modern rock outlets are leaning to the poppier side, as a result of modern AC's presence, that the modern format is again laying claim to some acts that previously might have been ceded to modern adult, i.e., New Radicals or Cherry.

(Modern AC, by the way, was tied for first on tracks by Morissette, Barenaked Ladies, Sheryl Crow, Jewel, and Edwin McCain. It was first outright on "Back To Good." Not only does that represent a significant change from a year ago, when modern AC was first on only one title, but it's also the first time that the format has been first on any one song outright. This time, it was adult top 40 that had only four ties to its credit: tracks by Morissette, Crow, Jewel, and McCain. Triple-A, meanwhile, was tied on tracks by Morissette and Cherry and first outright on Everything's "Hooch.")

WHAT DOES MAINSTREAM OWN?

The increased presence of titles on mainstream top 40 stations that started at modern rock also reflects the public concern expressed by some PDs about the format's heavy reliance on dance/pop and teen acts. Those have become the two genres that mainstream top 40 owns outright, perhaps explaining why there were fewer top 40 exclusives this time.

Top 40 was first on hits by Jennifer Paige, Britney Spears, 98°, the Backstreet Boys, and Madonna, as well as 'N Sync's "Tearing Up My Heart." It was tied on 'N Sync's "(God Must Have Spent) A Little More Time On You," as well as hits by Jewel, All Saints, Morissette, and Will Smith ("Miami").

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After yielding an unusually low number of crossovers in the spring, rhythmic top 40 rebounded in the fall. It was first to chart songs from Brandy, Monifah, Shaggy & Janet, Divine, and Will Smith ("Just The Two Of Us"). It was tied on hits by All Saints and Janet ("Go Deep"), as well as "Miami" and "(God Must Have Spent) A Little More Time On You."

PDS GO DEEP(ER) ON R&B

Mainstream R&B, a format that only started one record on the mainstream top 40 chart at this time last year, was more influential at top 40 this fall than at any other time in the 2½ years that we've been analyzing the issue of where

records start. It was tied on "Go Deep" and first outright on hits by Aaliyah, Monica, Nicole, and Lauryn Hill. (Adult R&B, which was first on one title during the spring, was first on none this time around.)

Mainstream top 40's greater acceptance of R&B product probably reflects the lessened availability of (or greater resistance to) dance/pop product, as well as the greater emphasis on R&B product on the rhythmic top 40 chart. It probably also helped that there were more mid-to-uptempo R&B hits this year, after a period when many of the biggest R&B hits were either rap or ballads.

This doesn't mean the trip from R&B to mainstream top 40 is necessarily a speedy one. The fastest R&B hit to chart at mainstream top 40 was "Go Deep," which charted five weeks after its R&B debut. None of the other R&B-to-top 40 crossovers made the mainstream top 40 chart in less than 10 weeks. Nicole's "Make It Hot," in particular, took 21 weeks to cross over—more weeks than any other record from any format.

TOP 40 HAS FAITH IN COUNTRY

It was big news last fall when LeAnn Rimes' "How Do I Live" broke country's four-year cold streak at mainstream top 40. This year, the big news is that country has been represented at mainstream top 40 for more than a year. And that for the first time since the early '80s, country is represented by two titles at mainstream top 40.

Unlike in the spring, when country radio charted Shania Twain's "You're Still The One" as an album cut but didn't make it a hit until after pop radio was on board, country clearly had exclusive possession of both Twain's "From This Moment On" and Faith Hill's "This Kiss," both of which charted at country radio many months before crossing to pop.

AC EMBRACES CELINE SOLUTION

In the spring, AC could lay claim to being first on only one record, but it was Celine Dion's "My Heart Will Go On." This time, it is first on the R. Kelly/Dion duet, "I'm Your Angel."

Mainstream rock was also first, by a week, on one mega-hit, Aerosmith's "I Don't Want To Miss A Thing." It was first on two titles, one outright in the spring.

Kent Offers Melancholy, Majesty

With bands such as Radiohead and the Smashing Pumpkins offering a romantic blend of melancholy and majesty, Stockholm quintet Kent is now throwing its hat in that ring.

The band has been at it for three albums in its homeland, and with its first U.S. release (and first in English), the single "Isola," the act managed to grab the attention of some modern rock programmers earlier this year. Now RCA plans to go back after the album, making Kent a label priority in 1999.

Kent translates its musical thoughts "in a Neil Young sort of way," says singer Joakim Berg, also the band's prime songwriter. "When we did our first album in Sweden, our first producer was a total Neil Young fan, and he said we should try to get that slow, slack-er attitude in the playing . . . just let the notes hang."


Recording in Belgium during a particularly rainy summer helped. "We slept all day and recorded all night, just to get that feeling." Berg's songs of alienation come from his belief that "the saddest songs are always the songs you remember, on my favorite albums anyway. I guess it's pretty natural [for me] to just try and write beautiful songs that are quite sad and melancholic; maybe that's the Swedish spirit."

Berg didn't grow up with rock'n'roll aspirations. But "my mother was a huge Beatles fan when she was young, so she made all these tapes from radio with lots of '60s top 10 songs and stuff. It was that I listened to," says the singer, recalling such songs as the Hollies' "He Ain't Heavy, He's My Brother" and the Rolling Stones' "Paint It Black" playing in the house.

There was also the occasional music video that would be shown in between Swedish TV programming. One night, Berg saw the Cure video for "Close To Me" and became obsessed. "I spent like two years trying to find that song because they didn't say what band it was or the name of the song. I finally found it on 'Staring At The Sea.' The same year I had bought a guitar as well." Kent members met in school, trading albums from the Smiths, Depeche Mode, the Pixies, and the Velvet Underground. But for Berg, "the most inspirational band has been the Cure, and you can hear that in the sound."

Berg says he likes the long, dark Swedish winters and that his songs are somewhat borne out of it, but he attributes the basis for Kent's yearning, cinematic tunes to a different malaise. "I try to write about the inability to communicate in relationships or wherever. Sometimes, we're surrounded by so many gadgets: beepers, cell phones, Internet, and computers, that it's supposed to make communication easier. I think sometimes it makes people more isolated, because you don't really have to go out and meet people. You can do it all from home; you can shop from home. You don't have to meet people eye to eye, and that's a bit isolating."
