M Street Figures Show Top 40 In 10th Place And Still Losing Stations

Over the past six years, the top 40 format has lost almost two-thirds of its commercial outlets, according to new figures from weekly industry newsletter "The M Street Journal." Top 40—which includes mainstream and rhythmic outlets—is down to 318 stations this year, off from 358 commercial stations last year and 951 in 1989. M Street Journal publisher Robert Unmacht blames the decline on the failure of owners to market the format to listeners and advertisers, as well as "low self-esteem."

Top 40 is the 10th-largest format in the country, falling behind R&B radio, which jumped to ninth place this year with a 328-347 gain in station count, powered largely by the rise of R&B adult stations. Top 40 was the third-largest format in 1989, when The M Street Journal began releasing its annual station counts—although it was well past its peak station-

building years of 1982-84. Top 40's station count has fallen every year since 1989. Country remains the nation's leading format, although its station count was off slightly for the first time since 1989.

The M Street Journal numbers are from its forthcoming 1996 radio directory, which will be published later this year. The top 40 numbers do not include hot AC stations (which are part of a shrinking AC universe) or modern rock outlets (which are part of the journal's rock classification).

Other interesting facts from this year's station tally:

- Commercial top 40 suffered a net loss of 40 stations last year. Unmacht says those stations segued primarily to the modern, album, and classic rock formats, which gained 107 stations in 1994-95, and to country. Those defections were offset slightly by the 14 stations that entered the format this year. Of that num-

R&B Vs. C.O.: Who Has More Tools?

Do top 40 promotion departments have more tools than their R&B counterparts? PDs who have reported to both charts say they do. And that's one reason why the format-definition issue remains so highly emotional.

The 10-year format war between top 40/rhythm and R&B mainstream outlets was the focal point of two panels at the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar, held Oct. 12-15 in New York, including a highly charged session on format definitions and reporting status that made clear how little consensus there is on the issue (Top 40 Airplay Monitor, Oct. 20).

R&B reporters at that panel were vocal about what they perceived as slights from the label side: fewer promotions, fewer ad dollars, and less attention when stars come to town. And many PDs who have reported both ways agree.

Says Dave Allan, OM of R&B/top 40 combo WUSL (Power 99)/WIOQ (Q102) Philadelphia, "From seeing both sides of it, I have to say that [pop] departments have more money to spend in promotions, and it seems like they have more promo people. . . . Also, they seemed to have access to the records sooner, just because they had more records on the street. Now, with R&B departments going away or being consolidated, I don't think the situation is getting any better."

WGCI Chicago OM Elroy Smith launched then crossover outlet KJMJZ (100.3 Jamz) Dallas in 1988. "It's so exclusive in that group [of reporters]," he says. "There is definitely an advantage—we were part of an elite. Then there was [the advantage of] not just being pigeonholed as black. . . . To be part of that panel means that you are also influencing top 40s and urban stations with your playlist—that makes an incredible statement. But when I was at Jamz, I had to appease the tastes of blacks, whites, and Hispanics. I don't have that pressure now."

Although Smith says that WGCI-FM is not encountering any problems in terms of service from the labels, he also says, "When I worked at Jamz, we just had more strength. If I wanted a big promotion with Janet Jackson, I would get it. For an urban station, it would be different."

KKBT (the Beat) Los Angeles MD Maurice DeVoe was at Q102 when it and WUSL were musically similar but reported differently. He says that while Q102 did seem to get preferential label treatment, KKBT's influence affords it similar advantages. "Once you get into the top five markets, I don't know whether you have a lot of the same problems as someone in market No. 20 and market No. 50," he says. "Some of the cries coming out of the other stations. . . . were real valid. But labels look at how much the station can sell and produce and the numbers they can deliver."

The flip side of the different-treatment issue is the R&B promotion people who see their func-

tions being taken over by a pop counterpart. KKBT OM Harold Austin says, "I think [that] overall the problem of being a reporter, whether R&B or pop, is not so much at the stations as at the labels." Austin, who does believe that "pop departments seem to. . . have more tools to work with than the R&B department," also notes that many pop executives have more resources and latitude than R&B executives, which fuels in-house resentments. "It varies from label to label, but some [R&B reps] can be very territorial. Others will call and say, 'Hey, my pop counterpart is in your market, why don't you meet with him?'"

WUSL/WIOQ's Allan says in-house label competition is based on economics, not race. "I don't think any of it is malicious," he says. "Everybody is doing their job and doing it well and trying really hard to get their records played. The situation itself creates problems. I used to think the departments were trying to one-up each other. . . . I talk to record reps all the time who say they're just hard-working people trying to get their product sold. They are not trying to beat anyone down."

"It is true that the record companies and the artists seem to be much more fulfilled when the record goes [to the] general market, instead of just being an R&B record," adds Allan. "So many record companies want their records to cross over, and the CHR station gets the benefit, and the R&B stations and the R&B departments cry, 'We're the ones who started it, we built it.' They have a legitimate beef when they say, 'We appreciate your thanks, but we need to be remembered when we need [artist] drops or promotions.' Sometimes they're forgotten."

As for possible dual reportership for borderline stations, Austin says, "It's a good idea, but something we have to discuss even further. We need criteria and guidelines. From what I see in the trades, I think WPGC-FM [Washington, D.C.] is a blacker station than KKBT, but then again, D.C. is 70% African-American. I think WPGC is top 40 for Washington—they've played records that we wouldn't touch, because we don't feel it fits the sound of the station. [With WQHT] Hot 97 [New York], it's a tough call. Ultimately, I would love to see a universal chart that both urbans and churbans could report to."

Duff Lindsey, PD of WJHM (102 Jamz) Orlando, Fla., has programmed both formats. Lindsey is happy as an R&B reporter and wouldn't consider switching status. "We've always been an urban, and I think we get treated very well," he says. But Lindsey also says there is probably "no difference between my playlist cut for cut" and a top 40/rhythm-crossover outlet. "There is not an inequity like that in my market. If there were, I would be hopping mad," he says.

Rock Rules, Modern Dies (Well, Maybe Not)

It used to be said that if you break out a ratings book creatively, any station can be No. 1 in some demographic. Now, with radio in a state of transition, you can make a case for any musical or programming trend.

Want to say that mainstream/classic rock stations are kicking modern rock's butt? There's a story in Chicago, Dallas, Detroit, Baltimore, and Cleveland, and any market where the new modern rock station has made the heritage rocker only a little uneasy. Add all the moderns that were down this summer, and it becomes a trend, if you overlook WNNX (99X) Atlanta, KROQ Los Angeles, WBCN Boston, KNDD Seattle, WMRQ Hartford, Conn., or KOME San Jose, Calif., which remained their markets' dominant rockers.

How about that mass revolt against grunge in which thousands of Gen X'ers shaved their goatees, grew their hair back to one length, and took up Del Amitri albums to protest the sameness of modern rock? That story has been written elsewhere, and you can always cite the number of modern hits that are pure pop (Edwyn Collins, Alanis Morissette), new-wave (Rentals), rhythmic (Folk Implosion, Garbage), or triple-A in nature. Again, you have a case if you overlook "Bullet With Butterfly Wings," "Lump," "Geek Stink Breath," "Comedown," and "Possum Kingdom."

Many modern rock stations did have crummy summer books. And there was a period when

hard rock dominated the modern rock format and some folks bemoaned the lack of variety. When that happened last fall, it was easy to connect the two. This time, you have to factor in mainstream rockers that may have beaten modern rock by pre-empting the format and going modern themselves. Or modern rock stations for which the down book could easily be the result of hard rockers protesting all the triple-A music.

Modern PDs now find themselves trying to adjust without giving listeners whiplash. Top 40 had problems in 1990, going from too much rap to "no rap," angering fans on both sides of the debate. Country PDs alienated 40-year-olds with too much current music and then chased off young-end listeners by bringing back the oldies. After all, many folks are happy with modern being the new heavy metal, just not everybody.

Any music one hasn't heard in a while eventually sounds good again. Classic rock radio has existed since 1983, and it says a lot about its durability that some folks gave it up for only a year before it became fresh again. Besides, it was never fair to assume that every listener would want to hear "Sweet Emotion" twice a day for the next 30 years, as it is unreasonable to think that no one will ever want to hear it again. There'll always be a place for the classics. And for today's music. And just as modern rockers once liked Morrissey, the Cult, and New Order together, the acceptance of more variety at modern rock shows that even modal formats need a balanced diet.

Lane Out At KYSR; Shakes Quits Frisco

PD Randy Lane is out after only eight months at Viacom's KYSR (Star 98.7) Los Angeles. The station has been undergoing a transition to a modern rock-based adult top 40.

KIOI San Francisco OM Dave Shakes has announced his resignation, effective at the year's end. Shakes, who notes that he's leaving on an up book, will consult owner Evergreen on special projects. Look for consultant Steve Wyrostok to be more heavily involved in day-to-day operations until a replacement is named.

WDJX Louisville, Ky., PD Chris Shebel is the new PD at WPRO-FM Providence, R.I., replacing 15-year station vet David Simpson. Shebel (aka Chris Hamilton) starts Nov. 6.

KDGE Dallas PD Joel Folger is consulting KTBZ (the Buzz) Houston. Buzz PD Cruze did mornings for Folger years ago at KJYO (KJ103) Oklahoma City. Jeff Pollack will continue to consult both Cruze and Folger. In other modern rock news, assistant PD/p.m. driver Alex Luke is named PD at KPNT (the Point) St Louis, and Dr. Dave Allen Marrocci is named station manager at WZAT Savannah, Ga.

GM Gil Hammond has exited KDLE (Power 93.9) Wichita, Kan. Station veteran Bruce Adamek becomes assistant GM.

Regent Communications officially took over Apollo Radio's KMXV Kansas City last week. Apollo's CEO Bill Stakelin remains on board with Regent. Look for consultant Mike McVay to make a guest appearance in Kansas City.

Ardman's WOVV (Star 95.5) West Palm Beach, Fla., enters a joint sales agreement with crosstown AC WRMF and easy WRLX.

CKOI Montreal host Pierre Brassard generated some international press last week when he managed to get Queen Elizabeth on the air

under the guise of being Canadian prime minister Jacques Chretien. Meanwhile, KLOS Los Angeles morning men Mark and Brian are reaping free publicity following the live on-air shower they took with San Francisco mayor Frank Jordan. A bare-shoulder shot of the trio appeared in The San Francisco Chronicle.

Arbitron has canceled the phase one fall Arbitrends for Fresno, Calif., and will delete it from the fall book because of an error that resulted in 39.8% of the metro not being sampled during the first four weeks of the survey. Six other Arbitron markets have been affected by variations in sample allocation: Albuquerque, N.M.; Buffalo, N.Y.; Dallas; Milwaukee; New York; and Philadelphia. Additional sample will be added in phases two and three.

WZEE (Z104) Madison, Wis., morning guy Johnny Danger is scheduled to start Nov. 3 at KQKQ (Sweet 98) Omaha, Neb., but owner Midcontinent is now threatening to enforce Danger's contract, which expires next July.

KJET-AM Hoquiam, Wash., flips from Christian to top 40 (in AM stereo) as "Flight 149." PD Brian Spencer co-owns crosstown oldies KGHO-FM with brother John. They need service from all labels; call 360-532-1200.

At KHTQ Spokane, Wash., morning co-host Nick Tyson exits. . . . WFME Baton Rouge, La., hires new morning guy Tom Gallagher from KSYG Little Rock, Ark. . . . WYXR (Star 104.5) Philadelphia ups swing jock Rich Davis to full-time nights, replacing Walt Seal. Davis (aka Joe Friday) also leaves the MD/night post at WAEB-FM Allentown, Pa.

ber; most were involved in duopolies or were hot ACs that turned up the heat.

• AC, recently considered the safe harbor of the all-important 25-54 numbers, took the biggest format hit of the year, losing 129 outlets (1,784-1,655), although it maintained its status as the nation's No. 2 format. Meanwhile, the easy listening format lost 45 stations. In its six years of measurement by The M Street Journal, easy listening has gone from 328 to 61 outlets.

• Top 40's reach may be better than the sheer number of stations would indicate, since it thrives primarily in larger markets, as 69% of top 40 stations are located in Arbitron-rated markets and, as expected, are found almost entirely on the FM band (96%).

• Other hot-button formats of the year: news/talk (undoubtedly fueled by the O.J. Simpson trial), including all-sports outlets—the biggest gainer of the year, increasing by 156 outlets (1,028-1,184) and cementing its hold on third place; religious stations (926-981); rock (721-828); oldies (714-710); Spanish and other ethnic programming (470-494); and adult standards (435-470).

• The number of stations that were reported off-air this year declined by 61, perhaps indicating a rebound in the financial health of the industry. By contrast, the number of stations reported dark increased by 50-100 outlets a year in the early '90s.

• Only 13 top 40 stations are still doing the format on AM, giving it a .03% coverage of the band it once dominated.

LOW SELF-ESTEEM

Unmacht blames top 40's continuing decline on an ongoing identity crisis, brought on by a combination of poor marketing, low self-esteem (given its recent history with agency buys), and an insistence on sending conflicting signals to the agencies.

The first step in rebuilding top 40, Unmacht says, is to admit what the format is (something with which he says many formats have a problem), and then begin to educate the agencies. That means viewing top 40 as a niche format. "If the print world was run by radio people, you wouldn't see Field & Stream, Sewing Weekly, or any other of those super-niche magazines," Unmacht says. "Radio wants to be Time or Newsweek; [it] wants those big, broad demos.

"Agencies can't see any difference between [AC] KOST Los Angeles and [country rival] KZLA, [because] their demographic breakdowns are almost identical on paper. They just see raw numbers generated by computer . . . We need to educate media buyers to realize that country, modern rock, and top 40 each have a different, specific lifestyle appeal. The buyers need to dig deeper and narrow the field, instead of buying the hot AC because their profiles might look similar on paper."

Unmacht adds that formats need to present a unified front. Stations, he says, always insist that they're not like their format rivals. "[They say] 'We have more music, cooler vans, better personalities, etc.' You must first convince them that top 40 is the format they want, then convince them that you're the

best top 40 station.

"Most other businesses market themselves much better than radio. Check the Yellow Pages: heating and air-conditioning companies don't mind being lumped together. It's easy to find them. You don't see them misrepresenting themselves. We're not air conditioning. We're cooling and lifestyle ventilation."

THE CLASSIFICATION QUESTION

The failure to admit what a station's format is extends to the controversy over format classification. The M Street Journal has long classified such outlets as WPGC-FM Washington, D.C., and WQIT (Hot 97) New York—stations at the heart of the controversy—as R&B. (The M Street Journal runs a disclaimer noting that its opinion of a station's format may differ from that of the station.) "How would a media buyer know to find WPGC in the Top 40 [Airplay] Monitor?" Unmacht asks. "You wouldn't look for air conditioning in the real estate pages. It's very misleading."

To that end, Unmacht rejects the notion that certain stations that may be one format on paper and another on the air can still be "top 40 for the market." "If WPGC can claim they're top 40 for their market, then [country] KKBQ (93Q) should be considered top 40 for Houston," he says. "Houston is a very country market, and KKBQ uses top 40 formats and is programmed by a veteran top 40 PD, Dene Hallum."

Contemporary formats aren't the only ones that have problems in that regard, Unmacht says. "News/talk and easy listening stations are shying away from saying who they really serve—over-55, rich, happy people who may own two homes, two cars, and take two cruises a year. Instead of admitting they lean 35-64, they'll say, 'Yeah, but check out these 25-34 numbers we have.'"

DANGER: HARD-HAT AREA

The outspoken Unmacht takes issue with radio as it exists in several areas. Among them:

• Stations that sign on jockless: Can you recall any other business that would open while still under construction? Top 40 radio loves to hit the air with just a name in place, then add those extra elements one by one. Unmacht compares that strategy with a supermarket that opens with just one aisle stocked: "Help us fill the other aisles in the weeks and months to come." Stations often start with a horrible, half-finished item and expect their audience to base their likes and dislikes on that.

• Stations that just segue during the overnight show because they feel it's not worth taking the time to sell that daypart. Back to the unfinished supermarket: "That's like leaving the back third of the store empty, because you think it's too far to walk back there," says Unmacht. "Compare radio with retail, where you generate money per square foot. Don't let air time go by without dollars in it. Many stations running Howard Stern think they're getting fat and happy off those morning numbers, and thus aren't motivated to maximize revenue in other dayparts."

TOP 40 PROFILE

Bill Hennes: Doing Top 40 From The Original Recipe In Wilmington, N.C.

Broadcast veteran Bill Hennes certainly knows top 40 radio. He programmed CKLW Detroit and WKLO Louisville, Ky., during their top 40 heyday, before moving to heritage stations WMAQ/WKQX Chicago in the late '70s/early '80s. He later moved into management, spending several years as GM of WBCK/WBXX Battle Creek, Mich. He also operated Bill Hennes & Associates, a programming, management, and sales consultancy.

Until August, Hennes was GM of Tri-State Broadcasting's country/'70s combo WNWN/WEAT Kalamazoo, Mich. That's when he got the call to travel south to head the "Q-Network," becoming GM of HVS Partners' country WWQQ Wilmington, N.C., as well as '70s-based classic rocker WXQR (Star105.5) and AC WQSL (Whistle 92.3)—both dual-licensed to Wilmington and Jacksonville, N.C.

The results of Hennes' first research project were clear: "There was a huge hole in the Wilmington and Jacksonville markets for a pure top 40 station," Hennes says. There had been no top 40 radio in Wilmington for at least three years, although nearby New Bern/Jacksonville does have top 40 WRIT.

Hennes decided to break every rule of today's overly niched top 40 and program the format as it was originally designed: play the most popular hits, regardless of musical genre, in heavy rotation.

"Everybody wants to put a label on everything," says Hennes. "No one lives by one genre alone. That becomes evident when you look at anyone's record collection or check the CDs they buy. People's tastes are eclectic by nature. It was up to us to put the blend together just right. Top 40 wasn't intended to be a niche format."

The new WQSL (All Hit 92.3) plays Bone Thugs-N-Harmony, Tim McGraw, and Green Day. Initially, it played its powers 133 times a week to establish an identity; it has since backed off to a tasteful 95 spins. Like Mike Joseph's "Hot Hits" stations, it plays no gold. "The listeners always hear a popular song when they tune in. Our station is a snapshot of the most popular music today," he says.

And the response after less than two months on the air? "The reaction has been phenomenal, both on the phones and on the street. People have identified with this station immediately, saying it's a breath of fresh air . . . This was a radio station that nobody knew or cared about, and suddenly listeners care about us. Top 40 radio, done correctly, becomes a part of the listeners' lives. What's not to like?"

"The key word that keeps coming back to us in our research is 'variety,'" adds Hennes, using a buzzword often associated with AC stations.

That word is not used on the air, but the public perception is that WQSL delivers a variety of musical styles. "All the songs we play transcend their labels," Hennes says. "We play popular songs for regular folks who don't apply labels to records they like."

Here's a recent 6 p.m. hour: Janet Jackson, "Runaway"; Luniz, "I Got 5 On It"; Goo Goo Dolls, "Name"; Groove Theory, "Tell Me"; Take That, "Back For Good"; Shaggy, "Boombastic"; Green Day, "Geek Stink Breath"; Coolio, "Gangsta's Paradise"; Gin Blossoms, "Till I Hear It From You"; Natalie Merchant, "Carnival"; Mariah Carey, "Fantasy"; TLC, "Waterfalls"; Red Hot Chili Peppers, "My Friends"; AC/DC, "Hard As A Rock"; and Lisa Loeb, "Do You Sleep."

So what about train-wreck segues? "The audience only cares if they like the songs or not, and they wind up listening longer," says Hennes. "With our quick rotations, if they do away, they'll come back quicker. [For example,] Sophie B. Hawkins has a big AC song, but they'll hear it more often here than from WGNI, the AC station. The same holds true with the biggest hits on crosstown modern rocker WFSM and urban WMNX. We're rotating their biggest hits and rotating them faster than they do. When a song is hot, the listeners want to hear it more often. We like to draw against the entire market. We want equal-opportunity enemies."

As for WQSL's music meeting, Hennes says, "We check retail sales in both markets, our call-out research, requests, Airplay Monitor, and weigh everything to give us a well-balanced playlist. During an average week, we may lean more urban, rock, or pop, depending on what's hot at any given time." Label reaction, Hennes says, has been "fabulous, very supportive. They recognize what we're doing is reality, not only here but across America."

Hennes recently hired new PD/p.m. driver Jake "the Jammer" Edwards from WKPK Traverse City, Mich. MD/morning host Gary Alexander is a WQSL veteran who came through the transition. The night jock is Tyler Richman from KYKY St. Louis. Middays and overnights were still open at press time and are being handled by a rotating wheel of part-time talent.

WQSL is in the process of putting together its sales staff. "It's important for us to train our sales staff in the value of this format," says Hennes. "Top 40 has always been about putting bodies in seats, not about whether the advertiser likes the format or not. The bottom line is, 'Can we deliver the consumer, the lifeblood of their business?' Not every advertiser listens to every station, but if they're smart, they'll spread the message around. People always gravitate to where their favorites songs are, and we just happen to be playing more of them more often."

For now, Hennes and company continue to use an old-fashioned, word-of-mouth, grass-roots campaign to create awareness of All Hit 92.3. "We treat it like a big secret and let the listeners find out about it," Hennes says. "This format is so unique that it creates its own buzz." **KEVIN CARTER**

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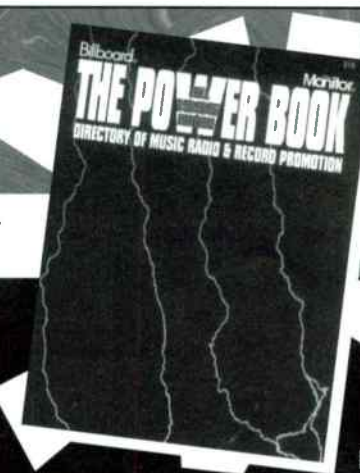
