## Some See Paid Play As Valid Tool, But PDs Fear Loss Of Control

With broadcasters scrambling for new revenue streams, it was inevitable that the issue of paid airplay by labels would resurface. Such programs have been attempted several times over the past two decades but are getting renewed attention following the news that CBS Radio will launch a chainwide program on its country stations in the spring and sell some of the playlist slots to labels (Airplay Monitor, Dec. 12). The topic was also debated recently at the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar, where both PDs and execs seemed intrigued by the idea of full-length, above-board plays paid for by labels, possibly in partnership with retailers.

That Airplay Monitor found detractors and supporters of the CBS plan on both sides of the fence is a significant change from nearly a decade ago, when top 40 KHYI (Y95) Dallas was forced to withdraw a similar plan to sell labels price and position with a

local retailer, as well as exposure on Y95. Ironically, KHYI is now CBS' KYNG (Young Country), whose former PD Rick Torcasso is one of the CBS execs who was recently in Nashville touting the idea.

Some programmers liken paid airplay to the infomercials that exist elsewhere. "I'm not surprised that someone is exploring this concept," says top 40 KKRZ (Z100) Portland, Ore., PD Ken Benson. "With all these new conglomerates looking to maximize revenue under pressure from Wall Street, some broadcasters have started their own separate concert and events companies and other ventures as a way to produce non-spot revenue. The reality is, stations have to find more creative ways to increase that revenue. For years, AM stations have run infomercials as longform programming for cash."

Benson believes that for such a program to work, "you would have to leave the programming department out of it, at least initially, and set it up as a new-music hour, sponsored by a record company and sold

## Hosten Fellowship To Aid Cancer Research

The Heston Hosten Fellowship for colon cancer research has been established by the Billboard Music Group with the T.J. Martell Foundation for Leukemia, Cancer, and AIDS Research.

Hosten, editor in chief of Billboard's four Airplay Monitor publications, died Nov. 19 in New York after an extended battle with colon cancer. He was 29 years old.

According to Tony Martell, chairman of the T.J. Martell Foundation, the fellowship will help the organization to keep at least one highly qualified scientist devoting his or her attention to colon cancer research.

The Billboard Music Group will announce annual fund-raising activities to complement its own contributions. "The creation of this fellowship will allow us to contribute towards the continuing battle against this disease and remember our friend and colleague," says Howard Lander, the group's president/publisher.

The T.J. Martell Foundation was established in 1975 after Martell's son, T.J., died of leukemia. The organization raised more than \$8 million in 1997 for research into cancer and

AIDS and to date has raised more than \$110 million. Martell says the foundation's doctors are currently treating 57 people in the music industry or their family members.

Colon cancer is one of the most common cancers, according to Dr. James F. Holland, scientific director for the T.J. Martell Foundation and chief of the division of neoplastic diseases in the department of medicine at Mount Sinai Medical Center in New York.

Most cases occur in men and women over 50 years of age, although those with a family history of colon cancer are good candidates to be tested for the disease, he says. Holland also notes that colon cancer is preventable, citing studies that show that a low-fat diet rich in grains, fruits, and vegetables limits the chances of developing the disease.

Hosten, a five-year veteran of the Billboard-affiliated Broadcast Data Systems (BDS), joined Airplay Monitor in April (Billboard, Nov. 29). Despite his ongoing battle with cancer, Hosten's tenure at Airplay Monitor was marked by the development of numerous new charts and features, some of which will continue to debut in those publications in the months to come.

## SFX Buys More Concert Promoters

**S**FX Broadcasting is rapidly achieving its goal of diversification by acquiring several concert-promotion companies and a couple of trade magazines. SFX will acquire West Coast concert-promotion firm Bill Graham Presents for about \$65 million, St. Louis-based concert promoter Contemporary Group for about \$90 million, and Southeast-based Concert/Southern Promotions for about \$15 million. SFX intends to purchase the Network Magazine Group, publishers of Album Network, Network 40, and Urban Network, as well as SJS Entertainment, for about \$70 million. Billboard Bulletin recently reported that SFX was close to a deal for Houston-based PACE Entertainment for \$122 million.

Shortly after the recent \$18.4 million Regent deal fell apart, local press reported that other suitors—including Clear Channel and an investor group assembled by GM **David Macejko**—are lining up to kick the tires of Great Trails' **WGTV (Z93)/WING-AM-FM** Dayton, Ohio. In other station news, fresh out of the overnight spot at crosstown R&B **WROU (U92)**, Z93 snags market vet **Nicholas Busbe** for P/T. P.S.: Z93 creative services director **Gary McGill** has proudly produced "Hanson Got Run Over By A Reindeer," which he'll trade for your song parody, regardless of whether it features an act meeting an untimely demise in a similar manner.

It's an early Christmas present for **Tom Peace**, as SFX ups the eight-year station vet to PD of **WRVW (the River)** Nashville. Peace, who has been in the market for 10 years and at the River since it was **WYHY (Y107)**, will continue to pull an airshift to be determined. OM **Charlie Quinn** will continue to oversee the River and country **WSIX** and will be the SFX programming coordinator with the PDs of recently-LMA'd **WLAC AM-FM** and jazz **WJZC**.

Consultant **Guy Zapoleon** is now working with rhythmic top 40 **WIOQ (Q102)** Philadelphia.

## Local Hits You Might Have Missed

**L**ast year, Airplay Monitor introduced something unique in its year-end issue: Year-end Power Playlist rankings for more than 100 reporting stations; in effect, scores of year-end countdowns like the ones that stations assemble for themselves at year's end.

The year-end lists are found again in the special combined edition of Airplay Monitor that mails with this regular issue. And while you might expect that the more arcane results would be of interest only to those of us troubled enough to remember that **Peter Brown's** "Do You Wanna Get Funky With Me" was the No. 27 song of 1977 at **WLS** Chicago, this is still a slow time of year for new music. So identifying songs that weren't huge national hits but did perform locally isn't just for us geeks. It's also a public service for PDs in need of secret weapons.

Consider "Call Me" by **Le Click**. It came along in time to catch the Euro-backlash at some stations. That didn't keep it from being No. 2 at **WWZZ (Z104)** Washington, D.C.; No. 3 at **WKTU** New York; No. 31 at rival **WHTZ (Z100)**; No. 4 at nearby **WBLI** Long Island, N.Y. (where the group had two songs in the top 10); and No. 5 at **WDRQ** Detroit. **DJ Company's** "Rhythm Of Love" had a similar pattern at many of those stations (**WWZZ**, No. 18; **WBLI**, No. 21; **WKTU**, No. 27). And in keeping with its dance lean, **Real McCoy's** otherwise overlooked "I Wanna Come (With You)" was **WWZZ's** No. 35 record this year.

**Jocelyn Enriquez's** "Do You Miss Me" was a **WWZZ** hit last year, when it was new. This year, it's No. 2 on **WKTU**; No. 19 on **WBBM** Chicago; and No. 27 on **WFLY** Albany, N.Y.

You'd expect **WKTU** to be iconoclastic, and it doesn't disappoint: **Living Joy's** "Don't Stop Movin'" is No. 6 there, **Real McCoy's** "One More Time" is No. 7, **Love Tribe's** "Stand Up" is No. 9 (and No. 20 at **WBLI**), **Diana King's** "I Say A Little Prayer" is No. 12, "The Jock Jam" is No. 19, **Ultra Naté's** "Free" is No. 29, **Sandy B.'s** "Make The World Go Round" is No. 33, and **Bad Yard Club & Crystal Waters'** "In De Ghetto" is No. 34.

Who else can rival that for local hits? Try **KHOM (Mix 104)** New Orleans with **Aaliyah's** "One In A Million" (No. 18), **Rome's** "I Belong To You" (No. 24), **Buffy's** "First Love" (No. 26), **K5's** "Passion" (No. 31), **B-Rock & the Bizz's** "My Baby Daddy" (No. 37), and **Peggy Scott-Adams'** "Bill" (No. 39).

Try **KYLD** San Francisco: **Spanish Fly's** "I Can See" (No. 11), **Angelina's** "Without Your Love" (No. 9—also No. 5 at **WPOW** Miami), **DJ Taz's** "That's Right" (No. 12), and **Josette's** "In A Dream" at No. 16. **Rockell's** cover of "In A Dream" was No. 12 at **WIOQ (Q102)** Philadelphia, where her "I Fell In Love" was No. 1 for the year. Q102 also had **Summer Junkies'** "I'm Gonna Love You" at No. 7 and **Acid Factor's** "Fantasy" at No. 8.

**Heavy D's** "Big Daddy" was No. 2 for the year at **WKYS** Washington, D.C., and No. 3 at rival **WPGC-FM**. Elsewhere in D.C., local hero **Kenny Lattimore's** "For You" was No. 7 at **WKYS** and No. 37 at **WPGC**. **Donnell Jones'**

remake of "Knocks Me Off My Feet," was No. 14 at **WPGC** and No. 26 at **WKYS**.

**KPWR (Power 106)** Los Angeles represented West Coast rap with **Mack 10's** "Nothin' But The Cavi Hit" at No. 1 and **Makaveli's** "To Live And Die In L.A." at No. 4. **Shaquille O'Neal's** "Strait Playin'" was No. 17 at **KPWR** and No. 22 at **KYLD**.

Dance and R&B stations didn't provide the only local hits. **WHYI (Y100)** Miami had two songs from **Gloria Estefan** in its top 40 and another local fave, **Jon Secada**, at No. 17 with "Too Late, Too Soon." **Celine Dion's** "To Love You More," which, 'til recently, existed only as an import, was No. 31 at **Y100**.

**WXKS-FM (Kiss 108)** Boston offered **Tori Amos'** "Silent All These Years" at No. 13, the **Cranberries'** "When You're Gone" at No. 15, and **Indigo Girls'** "Shame On You" at No. 28. The latter was No. 8 for the year at **WSTR** Atlanta, where **John Mellencamp's** "Just Another Day" was No. 11, better than his hometown finish of No. 17 at **WZPL** Indianapolis.

**Barenaked Ladies'** "The Old Apartment" was No. 3 at **WDCG (G105)** Raleigh, N.C.; No. 5 at **WKSE** Buffalo, N.Y.; No. 12 at **WKRQ** Cincinnati; and No. 7 at **WPLT** Detroit. While **BNL's** regional story was well documented this year, it's worth noting that **Better Than Ezra's** "Desperately Wanting" performed at many of the same stations. It was No. 15 at **WKRQ**, No. 1 at **KALC** Denver, and No. 7 at **WKRZ** Wilkes-Barre, Pa.

Even factoring in its modern lean, G105 offers several surprises: **Cravin' Melon's** "Come Undone" is No. 8. **Tracy Chapman's** "Smoke And Ashes" is No. 21. **KALC** has "You Turn Me On" by the **Ugly Americans** at No. 23. **Sublime's** "What I Got," a big year-end hit at many outright modern ACs, is No. 10 at **KALC** and No. 12 at G105. **Sublime's** "Santaria" is No. 23 at **WKRZ**.

Two of the biggest reaction records of the year weren't around long enough to become many PDs' most-played records. But **Aqua's** "Barbie Girl" was still No. 21 at **WXYV** Baltimore and No. 27 at **KHOM**. As for **Bob Carlisle's** "Butterfly Kisses," it was No. 35 for the year at rhythmic top 40 **KSFM** Sacramento, Calif., which demonstrates just how many format boundaries that song broke. Another phenomenon, **Bruce Springsteen's** remixed "Secret Garden," was No. 40 at **KKRZ (Z100)** Portland, Ore., the station that garnered national attention for it.

Finally, there are those songs from previous years that, thanks to monitored airplay, can be seen getting some action in 1997. The **Cranberries'** "Dreams" is No. 2 for the year at **WKRQ** and No. 30 at **KKRZ**. **2 Unlimited's** "Get Ready For This" is No. 32 at **KHKS** Dallas, where **Real McCoy's** "Another Night" is No. 35. (The latter was a popular bring-back for new top 40s in markets where it wasn't played as a current. Dallas was a market where it did get played.) **Donna Lewis'** "I Love You Always Forever" is No. 10 at **WNCI** Columbus, Ohio, where it was No. 9 last year, while you could feel **Live's** "Lightning Crashes" coming back again at No. 39 on **WBZZ (B94)** Pittsburgh.

**Reed Haggard** (now at modern **WNNX**), and **Bill Murray** (now the voice of TNT). The gathering helped raise college funds for the children of veteran **WQXI** jock **Barry Chase**, who died last month. Chase's partner of 30 years, **Scott Woodside** (now doing traffic at Z93), also attended.

**WPLJ** New York morning maniacs **Scott Shannon** and **Todd Pettengill** have just released their sixth wacky album, "Scambushed," featur-

ing more than an hour of their most-requested comedy bits and phone scams. All proceeds will benefit the T.J. Martell Foundation and the Blythdale Children's Hospital.

**KYSR (Star 98.7)** I.A. swing jock **Brian Douglas**, already flush with his success as a bartender on "Beverly Hills, 90210," moves his show-biz career one step closer to "the envelope, please" with a recurring role as an orderly on the CBS Monday-night medical drama "Chicago Hope."

through the sales department." But, he adds, like any element of on-air content, the programming department would have the final say if a song doesn't fit its production standards.

"It could be a valid concept," Benson says. "There are a lot of active people listening who are open to hearing new music, and this is a feature that's not much different than doing a mix show or any other specialty show."

Similarly, triple-A consultant John Bradley of SBR Radio says, "I'm surprised it's been this long in coming, that stations haven't approached the labels with this concept. It's not payola to get the money for airplay. You just have to disclaim it on the air . . . It's like an infomercial."

Bradley says that, in the post-consolidation environment, "all groups are going to see labels as renewed sources of revenue. It can probably be done in some way creatively. [And] you always have the power to say no. I can't imagine they're going to take anything for the money. I think they would be more strict than commercials because it's music and entertainment content . . . more so than commercials are."

As a method of exposing new music, "it's an absolutely interesting idea to explore," says Bradley, who also expresses surprise that slots in the weekly new-music shows that stations air haven't already been offered to labels. "There's some opportunity in that, and I think it would be a great avenue to get exposure for songs."

Several label reps also see a potential marketing value. "It's like paying for a spin in test rotation," says Freeworld director of modern rock promotion Jack Fulmer. "For a new project, it could be helpful to get it exposure and have the PD hear it on the air." But, he adds, "you always have to take into account the integrity of the artist." When paid for airplay, a station has to announce, "This song brought to you by Freeworld," notes Fulmer. "Depending on the integrity of the artist, you can jeopardize that."

And in a world where independent promoters now make their "promotional consultant" deals with stations upfront, and where some stations promise a set number of spins to an act that appears at a station concert, some observers say the paid-spin concept is not that different from what's already happening—overtly or otherwise. Speaking anonymously, one record exec contends, "We're already essentially paying for airplay. So what's the difference? Rather than giving [an indie] \$400 or \$500 . . . I'd rather give [the money] to the station and cut out the middleman."

KFKF Kansas City PD Dale Carter says paid spins may make more sense than "these huge showcase deals [that] really miss the mark," referring to the label junkies that are now a common practice in his country format. "Labels spend their money for endcaps in stores and in newspapers" and not on radio, other than to "take PDs and MDs on cruises . . . My belief is, we ought to be getting our fair share of revenue, and this may be the way to do it."

Carter was already considering re-adding a light current category on KFKF and playing a few records in label-purchased spots in nights and overnights. He says, "[If you] put it in a daypart that won't kill you, it allows you to research it after the fact and see if it does work."

Asked if that opens a can of worms, Carter says, "I think we've already opened a can of worms by paying [PDs'] Visa cards off and taking [their] families on trips. There are a lot seamier things going on than buying a playlist slot."

### THE COST OF DOING BUSINESS

That overtly paid airplay might not be so different from what already exists is what scares some people. "It's another form of trying to water down the premise of payola," says Dwight Bibbs, VP of R&B promotion at Virgin Records. "The role of promotion gets watered down."

"The bottom line is the cost of doing business is at an all-time extreme high," says Geffen head of rock promotion Warren Christensen.

"Record companies are not making enough money to support it. At the current rate of doing business, there are going to be some labels going out of business in the next two years because they can't afford to stay in business without having a number of hits. We've never had to spend more to market our music than we have this year." Geffen head of promotion Bob Catania adds, "I think it's dangerous for any broadcaster to look at record companies as potential profit centers."

"Any time you get into this kind of dimension it gets to be very scary," says BNA Records VP of national promotion Tom Baldrice. "It blurs the lines of 'Is it about the song or the money?' It's a real gray area that's very dangerous." But that doesn't mean BNA would never buy spins. "You have to do what you need to do to be competitive. If 95% of the labels in town are doing it and having success, you have to look at it. But would we be the leader with it? No."

"The problem comes in when the traditional promotion person has to utilize his college training for his advertising and marketing talents, where he's not just a promo man talking about radio every day but talking about sales," says Def Jam Records GM Kevin Liles. "This is a concept that will help the new promotion person in the year 2000, but what it gets away from is the genuine relationship between promotion people and programmers."

As the first major potential manifestation of full-length spots in the monitored airplay era, "the CBS plan, and the general concept of paid plays, clearly raises questions about the rules which govern our airplay charts," says Billboard director of charts Geoff Mayfield. "We need to canvass labels and radio programmers to ensure that such developments do not corrupt the quality of our charts."

### WHO MAKES THE CALL?

"At some point it's going to be up to individual programmers to make a stand," says Geffen's Catania. Like KKRZ's Benson and SBR's Bradley, he notes that PDs would have to draw the line on songs that don't fit, paid or not. But Catania taps into many PDs' fears by imagining a GM saying, "Too bad, but they're paying us \$2,000 a minute, and we need the revenue."

"This would take away too much control from the PD," warns R&B adult WDAS-FM Philadelphia APD/MD Daisy Davis. "Where do you draw the line on what does and doesn't get play? Do you play anything they are willing to pay for? Programmers do more than just choose which songs to add. You have to consider flow. Does a song fit the format? Are you going to sacrifice the sound of your station for the revenue? And will this affect your numbers overall?"

Davis, who thinks labels would be better served by conventional ads reinforcing what a station is already playing, also fears "a situation where if you're looking at the bottom line, sales will have the final say. At most stations, there is some tension between sales and programming anyway; they have different goals. If labels are going to pay for play, why do you even need a PD? It would affect the regional promotion people. If a label can play for a certain amount of spins on a station, why do you need to pay a person in Philly to work your record at radio?"

"When a label can go through the sales department for airplay, it lessens the value of the PD," says R&B KMJM (Majic 105) St. Louis PD Chuck Atkins. "I don't like the idea of the labels making the programming decisions at radio. You hire a PD because of their experience and knowledge of music. I don't want anything on my station that I didn't personally listen to and choose," says Atkins, who also worries that labels could buy their way past KMJM's ban on "songs with certain violent, drug, or gang references."

But, he adds, "I don't like the idea, but if my company came to me with a program like this, I would have to deal with it or leave. As a programmer, I would try to position the program where it would hurt us least. As a programmer,

you don't get to do everything you want and sometimes you have to do things you don't like, especially in today's radio world . . . More and more PDs are learning to deal with management decisions that are not necessarily about programming but are about money."

"My playlist is not for sale," says Mike Marino, PD of modern adult KKPN (the Planet) Houston. "The only available revenue slots I have are 60 seconds long. That's it. If somebody wants to pay to jam a 60-second song into that spot, I'm fine with that, as long as it fits the format."

### SMALLER LABELS LOSE

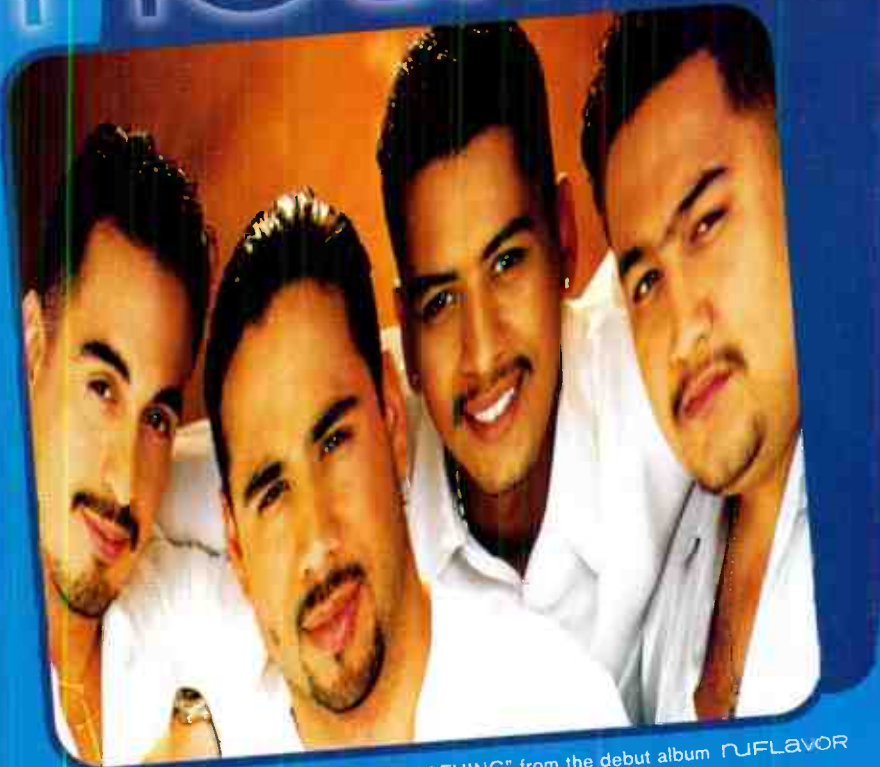
Among other concerns: Virgin's Bibbs notes that smaller labels would be at a disadvantage. And Tom Marshall, PD of classic rock KLSK Al-

buquerque, N.M., thinks that labels couldn't buy enough spins to really affect listener behavior.

Several respondents felt that labels would only feel the need to buy exposure for stiff. "One of the reasons everyone is happy with monitoring systems like Broadcast Data Systems is it keeps the crap out," says R&B KPRS Kansas City PD Sam Weaver. "Hit records get played; you don't have to force radio to play them. This will just allow for more bad music to be made and pushed down our throats."

"I'm certainly not going to pay to play a song as a last resort if nobody wanted to play it voluntarily," Catania adds. "My promotion budget will be better spent cultivating something that programmers will willingly want to play."

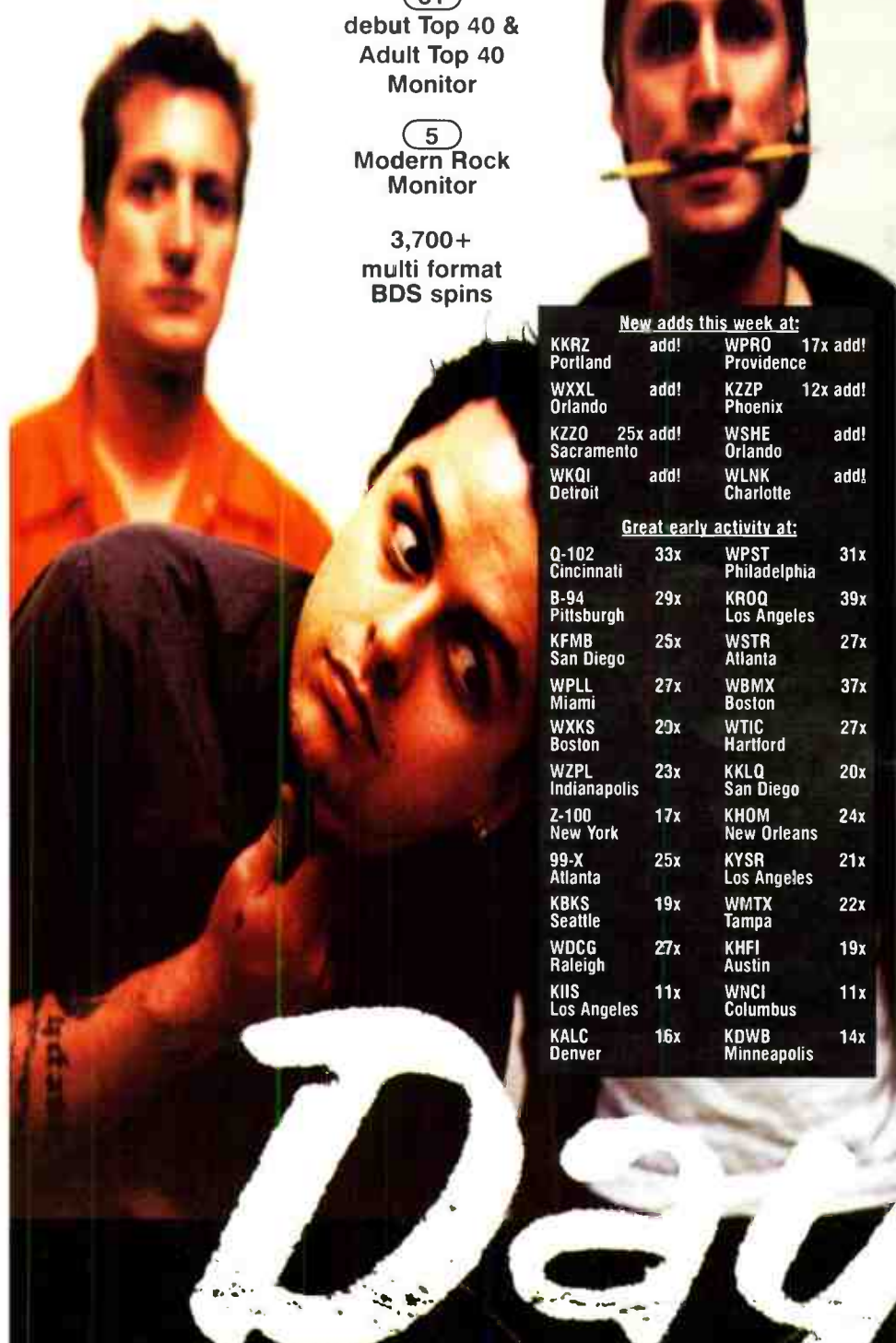

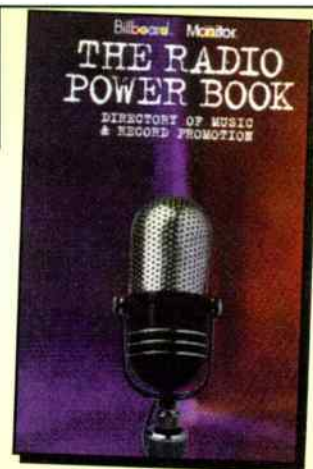
