With the Greatest Gainer nod on Christian Albums (10,000 sold; up 4,000), Mother's Day gift-buying lifts Casting Crowns' Come to the Well to its best sum since Christmas week when it sold 31,000. Current single 'Jesus, Friend of Sinners' also earns Greatest Gainer on Christian Songs (16-13).



Mary Mary posts its fifth straight nonseasonal top start on Gospel Albums with Go Get It, the soundtrack to the duo's reality show on We TV. With 19,000 sold, the set also enters Top R&W/Hip-Hop Albums at No. 3, the pair's second-best rank on that list. The title track logs a fourth week atop Gospel Digital Songs (6,000).

With his biggest Nielsen SoundScan week (22,000 copies), Washington, D.C.-based rapper Trip Lee scores his second No. 1 debut on Gospel Albums and Christian Albums with his fourth full-length set, The Good Life. Lee topped both charts two years ago with Between Two Worlds.

The rapper has the biggest-moving song within the top 20 with this singalong hit. Up 34% in audience, the infectious tune has a total listenership of 13 million impressions.

The crooner grabs the Greatest Gainer/Airplay award as the first official track from his forthcoming set Chapter 5 bounces 51-25. The song posts an 80% increase, placing its audience impression count at 8.8 million.

The rapper debuts two singles simultaneously. The higher-ranked track is from the upcoming G.O.O.D. Music compilation album while the other appears on DJ Khaled's set Kiss the Ring, slated to debut later in the year.

Last issue's Bubbling Under pick surfaces as a charted artist as the rapper's breakthrough single debuts with a 32% increase in audience impressions, aided by a robust 24-play bump for the week at KXHT Memphis.

BETWEEN THE BULLETS FAT JOE RETURNS TO TOP 10



Fat Joe nabs his fourth career top 10 on Hot R&B/Hip-Hop Songs as "Another Round" (featuring Chris Brown) rises 11-8. The track becomes the Bronx Bomber's first top 10 since "Make It Rain" hit No. 6 on Jan. 27, 2007. Five years later (and no longer part of Atlantic Records, Koch/eOne or Capitol) the Terror Squad leader's "Round" previews his still-untitled album, due later this year. Meanwhile, "Round" gives Brown: his 22nd top 10 and ties him with Luther Vandross for the third-most top 10s among male singers in the Nielsen era (which began in December 1992). They trail only Usher (24) and R. Kelly (35). —Karinah Santiago

The track claims the Greatest Gainer/Airplay tag supported by a 20% increase in audience impressions. It's the crooner's first song to reach the top three since "OMG" peaked at No. 3 in June 2010.



The sultry songstress earns her first No. 1 on Top R&B/Hip-Hop Albums with her 2-week-old The Mr. Life. It's the first album to reach No. 1 without debuting in the top slot since Nicki Minaj's Pink Friday ascended in its seventh chart week in January 2011.

The "Cha Cha Slide" man opens as the Hot Shot Debut. That party dance staple was his only prior title to reach this list, peaking at No. 24 in 2001.

Former 112 member debuts his first title as a solo act. The singer was part of 20 charting titles from his days with the legendary Bad Boy group, with the last coming in 2005. New title is from his forthcoming debut, Q Parker: The Manual.

The not-so-little sweetheart debuts his new, mature voice on this track from his upcoming album Believe. The Mike Posner-produced song is Bieber's second to reach this list, having previously spent a solo frame at No. 96 with "Baby," featuring Ludacris, in 2010.

BETWEEN THE BULLETS FUTURE CONJURES 'MAGIC' TOP 10 HIT



Rapper Future makes it over the top 10 hump as "Magic," featuring T.I., lands safely at No. 10 on the Hot R&B/Hip-Hop Songs chart, rising from No. 12. The title becomes his first top 10 as a lead artist and his second overall—he guested on YC's hit "Racks," which peaked at No. 6 in May 2011. The 29 weeks that "Magic" took to enter that region of the chart comes after two other recent rap songs, Kirko Bangz' "Drank in My Cup" and LoveRance's "UP,," broke through to the top tier after at least 29 weeks.

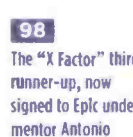

Houston-born rapper Kirko Bangz earns his first top 10 on Hot R&B/Hip-Hop Songs as his second charting single, "Drank in My Cup," moves 13-10. "Drank" enters the top tier in its 31st week, a rare circumstance on the chart. The last rapper to take longer was Yung L.A. in 2009 with "Ain't I" breaking the top 10 in 33 weeks. Bangz' title also celebrates its second week in the top 10 on Rap Songs, where it has a chart life of only 14 weeks. The track comes from his fifth mixtape, Progression 2: A Young Texas Playa.

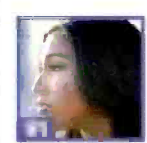

Rihanna and Usher both enter the top 10 with their equally aged (four weeks) titles on Hot R&B/Hip-Hop Songs. Rihanna's "Birthday Cake," featuring Chris Brown, earns the Greatest Gainer/Airplay badge as it moves 17-7 while Usher's "Climax" surges 18-10. Rihanna's ninth top 10 on the tally becomes her fastest-climbing as a lead artist while equaling her four-week top 10 jaunt as a featured act on T.I.'s "Live Your Life" in 2008. For Usher, "Climax" is his quickest top 10 climb since "Papers" reached the upper tier in four weeks in 2009. 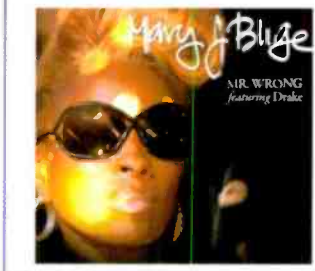

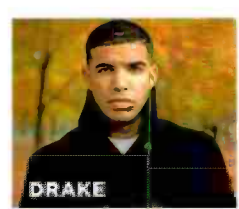

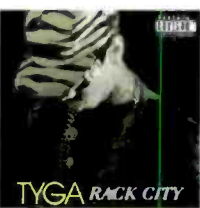

The ladies man returns to the chart after a four-year absence, debuting this Ne-Yo-assisted track. Perfect timing: It coincides with LL Cool J's hosting duties at the 54th Grammy Awards (Feb. 12).

BETWEEN THE BULLETS TYGA'S 'CITY' RISES



Tyga, Young Money's latest new star, nabs his first top 10 as a lead artist as "Rack City" moves 12-7 on the Hot R&B/Hip-Hop Songs chart. (He was a featured artist on Chris Brown's No. 1 "Deuces" in 2010.) "City" received a 10% increase in audience impressions, giving it a total listenership of 21 million, according to Nielsen BDS. This is the second charting single from his second studio album (and first with Young Money), Careless World: Rise of the Last King, due to arrive Feb. 21. "City" is the 21st top 10 hit for the Young Money label.

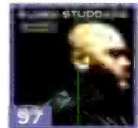

After a 19-week run on the chart that culminated in October, a remix of the song featuring 50 Cent brings a renewed interest in the track and a re-entry on the list at its highest peak to date. (It previously topped out at No. 69.) The track is also the Hot Shot Debut on Rap Songs, starting at No. 23.



Title moves 21-17 on Adult R&B (rising 53% in plays) and in just its third week on the list, is the youngest track in the top 20. Song is the fourth charting single from the 2010 release Intimacy: Album III, which sits at No. 28 on Top R&B/Hip-Hop Albums.

The Velvet Teddy Bear returns to the chart after a two-year hiatus, having last charted with "Don't Make 'Em Like U No More" (No. 32 peak in 2010). His declaration in the song's title is accompanied by his wedding date, an amusing and odd juxtaposition for the recently separated singer.

It's been three years since the rapper had a single on the chart on which he was the lead act—"I Want You" from 2007. Most recently he was featured on John Legend and the Roots' "Wake Up Everybody," with Melanie Fiona, in 2010. This single is from his newest set, The Dreamer/The Believer, which debuted at No. 5 on Top R&B/Hip-Hop Albums last month and sits at No. 12 this week.

DRAKE DRAWS EIGHTH NO. 1



Drake's "Make Me Proud" becomes his eighth No. 1 on Hot R&B/Hip-Hop Songs, and his second as a lead artist. He also continues to control the peak of the Top R&B/Hip-Hop Albums tally with Take Care (29,000; down 8%, according to Nielsen SoundScan), the parent album of "Make." His first No. 1 song as a lead came with his chart debut, "Best I Ever Had," which spent seven weeks at the top beginning June 27, 2009. Meanwhile Nicki Minaj, the featured artist on "Make," celebrates her second leader, coming almost a full year after her "Moment 4 Life" hit the top (Feb. 26, 2011).
