

Gene Sandbloom and Darcy Sanders, as well as Stacy Seifert, Maria D'Arcangelo and the incredible airstaff did one helluva job in putting on the show. Which brings me to the point of this whole article...The music! KROQ attracted the best roster available and even though I had a backstage pass, I spent almost the entire show glued to my seat!

Conference Call Hot Tips:

The big records this week on the call include: Crowded House Locked Out (Capitol), Psykosonik Welcome To My World (TVT), Blur Chemical World (Food/SBK/EMI) and Cure Purple Haze (Reprise). New Tips: k.d. lang Just Keep Me Moving (Warner Bros.), Tony Bennett Steppin' Out With My Baby (Columbia) and try to find a copy of David Bowie and Lenny Kravitz Buddha Of Suburbia (Import)!

Make sure you check out:

DIG Believe (MCA) - This record has exploded! New adds this week at 91X and Q101. Believers already include WBRU, WFNX, WHTG, WZRH, KNNC, WWDX, WLAV, CIMX, WIIZ, WOXY, KPNT, KTOZ, KKND, KTCL, X96 And KRZQ. What did you say Leslie Fram? "I finally 'believe', and my arms are waving in the air!" Hallelujah Sister!! Believe and you shall receive!(big phones).

NICK HEYWARD Kite (Epic) - Thanks to all in the Alternative World format, this record is poised and ready to crossover into Mainstream radio. Very good performance at the KROQ Acoustic Christmas show, and check this out...already ten stations at Top40 radio this week including: WRFY, WHTO, WZAT, WQUT, K106, KMGZ, KWTO, KLYV, KQIX and KTMT. Sean Robertson at The End in Cleveland thinks you should "Spend the time it deserves..." Epic isn't officially going for it until January 11, but good records just can't be held back. This 'Kite' is gonna fly the multi-format skies.

POSSUM DIXON Watch The Girl Destroy Me (Interscope) - I have been talking about this record for a long time now, and it's cool to see that radio feels the same. Here's another example of a record that can't be stopped. It has that early 80's- Stranglers-type of sound that radio has been lacking for awhile. Here's a rundown of the stations that couldn't wait for the official add cate. Adds this week at WHFS, WZRH, WKOC, KTCL, WHTG, WCHZ, WWDX, KLZR, KAVC and stations already playing include: Q101, X96, WEQX, WLAV, KBBT, KBAC and WRAS.

Retraction: Last week I reported some stations erroneously playing the Bjork record. Hope I didn't ruffle any feathers. Sorry for the inconvenience.

Coming soon to a desk near you:

Look for a new compilation album from Greenpeace on Hollywood Records coming out in the early part of '94. Artists will include: REM, U2, James, P.M. Dawn, EMF, Annie Lennox, Sonic Youth, The Soup Dragons and others.

Personal Stuff: Do not miss Francis Ford Coppola presents a claymation interpretation of William S. Burroughs "The Junkie's Christmas." It will be seen on VH-1 December 20th and 23rd at 11:30p.m. Also, to Greg Seese, I can finally accept the Notre Dame victory over Florida State. But who is gonna win the National Championship?





T.R.U.E <u>Show Me</u> (WIZ) - This local group from Allentown is really making a buzz in my club and in the mix. The "Bass-ic" mix hits a hard freestyle sound very similar to VOYCE. Keep a sharp eye out for this track, it has the potential to work for many of you DJ's and radio stations. I'm an early believer!

JODY WATLEY <u>Your Love Keeps Workin On Me</u> (MCA) - This is a great radio record and it adds flavour to the mix. The "MK" mixes work very well, so far this record is getting a strong response.

JOHNNY VISCIOUS <u>I Luv Musik</u> (WHITE PROMO) -This remix of the classic has a kickin over beat, loops and samples. Nice record to mix with Rozalla's <u>I Love</u> <u>Music</u>. If you find it, check it out and give it a spin! **KENNY DOPE** <u>Boomin In Ya Jeep</u> (MOON ROOF) - Nice down tempo hip hop-ish dance hall feel. Testing well in the clubs, people seem to be responding at this point. This is one of my club picks for this week!

JACKSON TAYLOR, WBCX, Gainesville

BJORK <u>Bigtime Sensuality</u> (ELEKTRA) - I heard this for the first time at a party in New York last week. One of the best releases this year by Elektra. All the mixes are kickin' but my personal pick is disc 2, side D "Nellee Hopper Extended Mix" Flawless!

THE DAOU Give Myself To You (TRIBAL AMERICA) - If you liked the previous release from The Daou then you'll relish this release. The Daou and Danny Teneglia are in Great form. And as always any tribal release is a must for house purists.

I TO I <u>The Right Time</u> (NEXT PLATEAU) - I got this white label from Marco Navarro while in New York. A perfect dance record formatted for the radio. The "Extended Mix" is great Top 40 while the "Fiction Remix" is great for clubs.

DOMINICA <u>Gotta Let You Go</u> (MIC MAC) - Another record with Top 40 crossover potential. It sounds great in the mix... House jocks go straight to the "Back Stage Underground Mix."

k.d. lang <u>Just Keep Me Moving</u> (WARNER BROS.) - Real house music from k.d. From the movie <u>Even Cowgirls Get The Blues...</u>love the "Movin' Mix" and "Wild Planet Mix."

CLIFF HORVICK, WBHT, Scranton

THE URBAN COOKIE COLLECTIVE <u>The Key. The Secret</u> (RADIKAL/CRITIQUE) - Great song! Mixes range from hard edged to soft laid back Euro-house. Jam this!

ARETHA FRANKLIN (Pride) A Deeper Love (ARISTA) - With mixes by Clivelles & Cole AND Morales, we get a 'Bad Mama Jama.'

Also check out and rock with these kuts till Santa comes knockin: **D:REAM** <u>Things Can Only Get Better</u> (GIANT/REPRISE) and **LISA** <u>Skip To My</u> Lu (PENDULUM/ERG)

'SIR' CHARLES, WBLS, New York

TITIYO \underline{\textit{Back \& Forth}} (BMG/ARISTA) - Great import, hip, R&B party record.

MARY J. BLIGE <u>You Don't Have To Worry</u> (UPTOWN/MCA) - Rockin Remix.

SNOOP DOGGY DOGG *Lodi Dodi* (DEATH ROW/INTERSCOPE/ATL. GRP.) - Slammin ghetto funk.

JERU DA DAMAJA <u>Come Clean</u> (ffrr/PAYDAY) - I've been playing this one since they dropped the promo, and it's still smokin

RONNIE 'Captain Kirk' MATTHEWS, WCKZ, Charlotte


