

Working my club gigs, I get so many requests for this record. The remake of the 4 Non Blondes takes it to a new level. It's a hit, hit, hit, hit...

RIVER OCEAN f/India Love & Happiness (STRICTLY RHYTHM) - This is it, pump this record in the club, in your mix. Strictly has got it going on...

MOHAMED MORETTA, POWER 96, Miami

RIVER OCEAN f/India Love & Happiness (STRICTLY RHYTHM) - Props to Louie and India for writing something very, very different. They search deep to combine the afro-latin rhythms of our ancestors with the melodies of today! It didn't hurt to have Tito Puentes laying down some beats along with Remy Dope either! Nice change from the norm.

VIRGINIA PLAIN <u>Slamm</u> (IMPORT) - Strong Euro-track full of energy for any dancefloor and mixshow. Thanks to Gary Cannavo for sending it to me! These type of tracks are also starting to work well on Power 96 rotation.

2 IN A ROOM El Trago (The Drink) (CUTTING) - They're back with a brand new track. Instant smash in Miami. All the right elements to go all the way to #1 in this market. Catchy, hard and monotonous. What more could you ask for? Oh yeah, if you can't deal with hip house...play the dub. Remember, don't drink and drive! Thanks to Barry, Bob, Ricky, Frank, Barbara and Jay and everyone at Hitmakers for letting me share my views in the magazine. I never dreamed I would be on the cover!

KID FRESH, THE BOX, Houston

DAS EFX Baknaffek (EASTWEST) - Once again, tryin to figure out what tha fukk deez muhfukkaz are talkin about but, whatever the shit iz they're saying, tha shit iz dope!



WHERE DID YOU GET YOUR START IN THIS LOVELY BUSINESS?

I wanted to be a sports commentary guy and there was a technical school that offered radio broadcasting as an elective, so being that I completed my lunch and P.E. electives and I really didn't want to take any more math, I decided to take this radio broadcasting class and give it a shot. The rest is academic. I started in Albuquerque at public radio back in 1982. No one would give me a break in Albuquerque. Overnights and weekends, that was the extent of it and then along the way I met a guy named Bob Perry and he reestablished my passion for radio. I was about ready to call it quits and hang up my headphones.

NOW WHAT YEAR ARE WE TALKING ABOUT?

It was in July of 1988 I started with Bob Perry at KPRR. I was production director and did middays for Bob Perry.

WHEN DID YOU GET INTO THE PROGRAMMING ELEMENT?

When Bob Perry departed for KTFM in San Antonio, Mike Martinez aka Eli Milano who does mornings now at HOT97.7-San Jose, became the program director and saw that I was really aggressive and had a passion for radio. He took me underneath his wing and showed me the ropes. I was knocked around and didn't really get a shot until U.S. Radio gave me the opportunity to program at KPRR.

IT WAS A LITTLE UNSETTLED FOR AWHILE.

Exactly. Roberta Varella was here for two books and Mike Daniels lasted half a book. It's been real up and down lately, but things hopefully will get settled. In fact, it was kind of a joke around the marketplace. When we go into clubs, we'd run into the guys at the competitive Rock station. They would ask, "Who are you?" and I'd say, "I'm the intern." They'd say, "Give it six months, you'll be the PD." That was kind of cold, but it was true.

THIS IS QUITE A CHALLENGE FOR YOU.

Yes, my biggest so far. I've learned

from Bob Perry and Eli Molano, I consider them the guys. I've studied people like Jay Stevens at WPGC, Steve Smith at HOT97, and Keith Naftaly at THE BEAT and their radio stations...finding out why they do things, not only street wise, but strategic wise and try a little bit of image in shaping what POWER102 sounds like today. I've worked in El Paso for six years, and I know the city well.

WHO IS CURRENTLY YOUR CONSULTANT?

Bob Mitchell, Mr. Radio. Bob Perry was consulting us when Transcontinental owned KPRR. Transcontinental Radio is in an LMA with U.S. Radio Incorporated which is based in Philadelphia. It's a Reagan-Henry deal. He owns KISF, a Top40 in Philly and here in town he owns the leading Country format, which is Y96. Our sales department wasn't up to speed, we were losing some money, there were talks of format change for quite a while and when the LMA went into effect, Bob Perry got lost in the shuffle. A lot of people inquired about the position and thus Bob Mitchell got the job. I will say Bob Perry made KPRR what it is today. I'm just trying to maintain and build what Bob's

listeners wanted, and put them on the air. It made us a unique station. These were our secret weapon records. After that, we played a lot of Urban ballads for a while. They seemed to test passively, but nothing that really reacted quite like the early days at KPRR. We're finding a big success with the freestyle records once again. Johnny O has come back along with Collage. These are probably two of our hottest. Also, the old school records, songs that were never really burnt out in the first place, songs like Genius Of Love by Tom Tom Club, Cutie Pie, even Zapp & Roger. We put those records back on with a combination of a little bit of freestyle flavor and playing the big hits - Ace Of Base, Jodeci and SWV, and that combination is exactly where POWER102 is right now. But the uniqueness is those freestyle dance records that the people shy away from. Those are definitely POWER102 records right now. That's not to say what the trend will be in the future, but for right now that seems to be what the street vibe is going for.

BEING PRETTY MUCH A BORDER-TYPE TOWN, YOU HAVE A LOT OF INFLUENCE FROM MEXICO?

HOW HAS KPRR CHANGED OVER THE YEARS?

Things are kind of cyclical. When I first came in Bob Perry was at the forefront of what we call freestyle music. The Bay Area calls it hienergy. The Johnny O's and Cynthia's really went to the forefront of POWER102 in El Paso. There were competing stations that stayed away from these types of records. They said that those records are only for young kids. Freestyle is not only for the nightclubbers, and we all know that. POWER102 took the market by storm. They just blew past the competition, that sound became hot for POWER102. Bob Perry found these records from the streets that

Yes and no. Nightclub life is very hot on the strip. Each nightclub has its own direct market — Hip-Hop, Techno, freestyle, hi-energy clubs, etc....the way the nightlife is around here, it influences El Paso. POWER102 is very, very hot in the clubs. In fact, we have more club advertising that promotes Juarez nightlife, than we do El Paso nightlife. If you're between 18-21, you really don't have a place to go, so they tend to go to Juarez. The nightclubs are putting a lot of money there.

IN THE LATINO COMMUNITY MUSIC IS NOT JUST A PARTY THING, BUT A FAMILY THING AND THAT'S WHY YOU AND THE AUDIENCE GROW WITH IT. THUS THE SUCCESS OF OLD SCHOOL.

That's a good point. In El Paso, listeners are very slow to grasp on to records, but when they click, that's the name of the game. They just want to drive in their cars, listen at home, or whatever they're doing and sing along to a record. That's exactly the Hispanic vibe. El Paso is very loyal. It's a very Catholic community, very traditional and people tend to keep the radio on one position when they wake up until the time they go to bed at night.

LET'S TALK A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THE PROGRAMMING ELEMENT OF POWER102.

We're a dance rhythm-oriented station. At night we're mixing from 8-8:30 and on the weekends we have two big shows. We mix it up Friday and Saturday nights until 3 a.m. and Charles Chavez, who is my music coordinator has been around for years. Charles Chavez knows music and more importantly knows El Paso. Some other special programs we run are: Street Pulse, a street intensive program. I thought it was time to speak up and say something. There's been a lot of talk on some of the organizations, but no one had actually done a thing. I thought why not, let's try it here in El Paso. We stopped the music from 10-midnight and opened up the phones and said how can we stop the violence: that kicked off our stop the violence campaign, which is hosted by Victor Star. He is very community-oriented. With Victor's passion for the street, ratings went through the roof. We went #1 that book and we didn't have any billboards, no TV, zero promotion dollars, and yet we were the #1 rated listening station in El Paso. The reason is because we were community driven

HOW DOES BOB MITCHELL COME INTO PLAY?

Bob Mitchell, our new consultant – you may remember him from WPGC and KSOL – this guy is passionate. I call him Mr. Radio. He eats, thinks and sleeps radio. He's a brilliant teacher, which is what us young guys in the business need. We talk hours and hours about radio in general, and he's taught me to be more sensitive to the 25+ category, and that was one of the things he felt that we needed to do. In our last Arbitron book, we saw that we needed to grow with females 25-34. We're playing more of the core

WHO DO YOU SHARE WITH MOST?

It's odd because this will surprise a lot of people, but we are shared the most with the Album-oriented Rock station, which is KLAQ. Hispanics, cume us and the Rock station the most, I was quite surprised.

WHAT DO YOUR DO GUYS DO PROMOTIONALLY?

We're extremely community Think community, community, community. Some of the things that we've been successful with are the things that have worked well for the big markets. Again, it depends on what the market wants. I found out by listening to stations like WPGC in D.C. The Original Guns Amnesty bill had people turning in their illegal guns and no questions would be asked. I sat down with the promotion people, and we said what can we do. Victor Star, the guy that heads the street pool said why not give them an incentive. It's like what New York had done with the toys for guns or money for jams. Since we don't have this big, fat budget we got together with the record companies that offered our listeners jams for weapons. The point was that we're not looking for an equal value, we were trying to get guns off the street, and it's one less item, one less weapon that our law enforcement officials have to worry

IT'S A SYMBOLIC GESTURE. IT HAS NO EQUIVALENCY.

Exactly. The whole community kind of scoffed at us saying who in the world is going to do that. There were articles in the newspaper saying this is crazy and on the other side we said hey, it's worth the effort. Friday and Saturday night we set up two listening places where people could come in and turn in any type of weapon. We had switchblades turned in, rifles with nails in them, guns - we had 225 weapons turned in from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. on a Friday night for a CD or tape of your choice. That was very inexpensive, yet the community felt that we were doing it for them. This guy came up and you could tell that he was hardcore all the way, he had long hair, beard, and jeans. He just fit the lifestyle. He had a sawed-off shotgun, a baby girl in his arms and he walked up to the counter and put down the rifle on the desk and said, "I've had enough." People were

just amazed at this. It's things like that, these risk-taking things that you do that actually help you win. What we did for President's Day was great. Cat Simon, our midday jock, thought of a great idea. He dressed up like George Washington and handed out pictures of George, which of course were \$1 bills. We had \$600-\$700 and went in our POWER102 cruiser, jumped out at different locations and said Happy President's Day and started handing out \$1 bills to everyone on the street. We got great TV coverage out of it. Again, do the unexpected. I think one thing that Bob Mitchell has taught me is there are no

No doubt, you're into it. Everyone sez that we need to get back to the old days of entertaining and having fun. Sometimes we're so locked into so many rules that I think sometimes we get stale. Be creative, go ahead and break the rules. Ask yourself, "what if," then, ask yourself "why not." Hey! This is entertainment and you are doing just that, entertaining. What separates you from the competition is what goes between the records.

locker room-ish. I think building a big radio station starts with a solid morning show. Your promotions have to target the lifestyle, the image of your core audience. In middays, we've got Cat Simon. He's been around El Paso for 17 years, and has programmed twice in the market, so he brings along great ideas. Before we got Cat, we noticed a big dip from mornings to afternoons and it seemed like everybody listened to the morning show, then turned it off once they got to work. Then they would turn it on in for the afternoon show.

THERE'S NOTHING LIKE HAVING A SEASONED PROGRAMMER ON AIR.

Yes. He makes me work that much harder because I know that he sees things that could be worked differently, so he helps me work harder and pushes me. Plus I let him go. He's got some crazy, whacked-out ideas that are always fun and entertaining. We just hired the music director from Las Cruces, which is a small suburb of El Paso. His name is Flash Gordon. He's from Detroit, a young guy, who's in afternoons, and has got a great pair of pipes. This guy is a hard worker. He's our production director as well and this guy will stay until midnight. He'll do whatever you ask of him. He's a very hard worker. Nighttime we have Victor Star. He is

music. This guy is what I call the street ears of El Paso. He's got a knack of figuring out which records work...he's been here for about 23 vears. He was born and raised here. His mom and dad kicked him out and made him go to work. He's been active with records since he was nine years old. He started working in clubs when he was 13. This guy is so much into music that he works on Friday and Saturday night at Metropolis Nightclub, which is the biggest Top40 club in town. He's a consultant for a record store as far as the purchase of 12" records, and two days a week at another store. He's our mixshow coordinator, and he's also helping me out in the morning show. He does it all. He's going to make a great music director.

WELL, JUST LIKE ANY GOOD PROGRAMMING SITUATION IT'S BALANCE.

No doubt, you have to know which records are definitely club records. There are a lot of variables involved: tempo, balance, structure and timing plays a big part of the game and where each piece of the puzzle fits. You don't want to be so hip-intensive. The name of the game is familiarity and to play, just the hits. You don't want to dispose of the hits too quickly. I guess the thing that I've learned the most is you need to be a great listener. You can't program to what you think the audience is going to like. You have to know what they like, and the only way is to get out there and ask them. That's exactly it. It sounds easy. It sounds so simple.

ANYONE ELSE YOU WOULD LIKE TO MENTION OR ARE CLOSE WITH?

I'd also like to mention the people I work for - U.S. Radio. These are radio people. Don Kidwell is the CEO. Rob Burton is the GM for POWER102. He is another key part and really gets involved with the radio station. He's not just a salesoriented GM. He's genuinely concerned with the sound of POWER102 and is constantly critiquing, measuring and managing. So I think we have a great team. Starting at the top, they are all believers in Top40 and they're going to do whatever it takes to keep POWER102 on top. We're not the stepchild. They see a money-making team here and thank goodness they're going to get a sales team that can actually sell a Top40, and that's great

Anyone and everyone can play exactly the same records. Make every day a celebration of common day events. Your station should be so hot no one wants to turn it off.

LET'S TALK ABOUT YOUR STAFF.

I do mornings, along with Charles Chavez. As we speak, we're looking for a sidekick, preferably a female, with a news background. I just stepped into the morning show about seven or eight weeks ago, so we're still in a transition period. I think it would be great to have a female's point of view otherwise it sounds too


the man. This guy is a programmers dream, a real high profile personality.

WHAT ABOUT LATENIGHTS AND OVERNIGHTS?

Latenight is Kelly Allen. She's got a wonderful voice. She's only been in commercial radio for a couple of years. She will be strong in time.

WHAT ABOUT THE PROGRAMMING DEPARTMENT?

I do the programming along with the music and I'm up here day and night doing both at POWER102. Charles Chavez helps me out with the


