



f you see a pink Elephant on this week's charts, you're not just feeling the effects of last night's hangover.

V2's ex-husband-and-wife duo The White Stripes, the subject of unprecedented critical kudos. including a rare five-star Rolling Stone review, stampeded onto the chart this week atop their fourth album, Elephant, scoring a #6 bow while selling just south of 120k. This developing, multifaceted story represents a true triumph

for compelling indie rock and a perfectly executed label game plan—and they're just getting started.

Hastings' Mike Fuller says a "Seven Nation Army" couldn't hold back Stripes fans from storming retail: "I'm really thrilled with the opening week for The White Stripes. They really surpassed even my expectations. Hey, ya think they need a bass player? I'm available."

WB's Linkin Park, Shady/Aftermath/Interscope's 50 Cent, Capitol's Now 12, Epic's Celine Dion and Blue Note's Norah Jones are at #1-5, respectively, with only the superstar rapper and the Canadian diva switching places from last week's Top Five.

A greatest-hits collection from WB icon Cher was the other newcomer to the Top 10, entering at #7, with 111k sold, making it the last of seven albums selling more than 100k this week. Wind-up's Evanescence, Epic's Chicago soundtrack and Jive's R. Kelly complete the Top 10.

Other chart newcomers were Capitol's Chris Cagle (#17), Virgin's Robbie Williams (#30), Geffen artist Rob Zombie's House of 1,000 Corpses soundtrack (#41) and the re-entry of Virgin's Ben Harper (#50).

Albums showing sales gains include VP/Atlantic's Sean Paul (+8%, #12), Epic's Good Charlotte (+1%, #22), Jive's Justin Timberlake (+3%, #23), DreamWorks' A.F.I. (+4%, #26), Dream-Works' The All-American Rejects (+3%, #28), Fo'Reel/Universal's Nelly (+9%, #39) and Atlantic's Matchbox Twenty (+2%, #42).

Next week, retailers prepare for a religious epiphany, as Republic/Universal's Godsmack sends sales heavenward.

Added Fuller: "Hey, I'm a believer. We were real strong on their last record, and looking forward to doing the same with this one. Is it OK if I take the Lord's name in vain just this once?"

In related news, MTV will debut a new feature called *The Leak*, which will make a free stream of an entire album available on MTV.com a week before the album's scheduled release date. Madonna's *American Life* will be the first to get *Leaked* on April 16.



Avery Believes in Godsmack

hen they called their third and new Republic/Universal album Faceless, New England metal giants Godsmack were only partially kidding. Indeed, after two previous albums that have sold more than 6 million between them, along with three Grammy nominations, the hard rockers remain one of the industry's best-kept secrets.

That's something Republic President/Universal Records Sr. VP Avery "Breath You Take" Lipman set out to correct with a massive, six-month-long push that will deliver a chart-topping record next week.

"I hate to put it this way, but it's been like a military campaign," says Lipman. "The TV and radio appearances are the air attack, and the grassroots retail and street teams are the ground troops."

With 1.1 million albums on the streets, some retailers are predicting that first-week sales could reach as high as 400k, thanks to an aggressive pricing policy that will see the new album sell for under \$10 in some places.

"We wouldn't have been able to do that without the participation of the band," says Lipman. "That's the cherry on top of the plan."

Carl Mello "Yellow," a Newbury Comics buyer in the band's hometown of Boston, says: "Our stores are excited about what will surely be our #1 release of the week and, more than likely, the biggest-selling local artist release of the year for us."

Pointing to the continuing strength of the Godsmack catalog—which includes the band's self-titled, four-times-platinum '98 debut and 2000's double-platinum Awake, Lipman insists he didn't have to push retailers to take product. "The demand was already there."

That demand has been stoked by the first single, "Straight Out of Line," formerly Most Added at PoMo and Active and now Top 10 at both, with the video Top 20 at MTV

and MTV2 and Top 10 at MuchMusic. Also included on the album is "I Stand Alone," which was on Universal's gold Scorpion King soundtrack, earning singer/writer Sully Erna Grammy nominations for Best Hard Rock Performance and Best Rock Song.

The label has lined up a series of press opportunities for the band to ensure they won't remain *Faceless* much longer.

"We had a comprehensive plan that included any and all media," says Lipman. "We haven't forgotten about the band's initial fan base, handing out stickers, postcards and snipes at shows. We made a conscious decision to go back to the folks who made the group what they are. We took nothing for granted."

50 Cent Drives a "Hybrid"

5 O Cent is one busy mofo. On the heels of the expected announcement that the hip-hop phenomenon has been given his own Interscope imprint, G-Unit Records, comes some more surprising news.

Shady/Aftermath/Intescope is shipping more than 1 million units of a "hybrid" release, hot on the heels of the nowquadruple-platinum Get Rich or Die Tryin'. Described by the label as a "true multimedia experience," the package, titled The New Breed and streeting April 15, includes a DVD containing two hours of material, accompanied by a CD featuring three unreleased tracks. The release comes in a standard CD iewel box and will be stocked in the music sections, not the DVD sections, of retailers. The New Breed will be tracked on the HITS Top 50 Albums sales chart.

Says Interscope sales and marketing ruler Steve Berman: "In today's incredibly tough environment of selling music, we feel it's extremely important to support the art and the creative vision of Dre, Eminem. Paul Rosenberg and 50 in what we believe will be the frontier of a new art form. We don't want to pigeonhole this new release. That's why we're putting it in the brilliant box and marketing it in the music section. Is it a CD with a DVD attached? Is it a DVD with a CD added on? We don't care. It's a new piece of entertainment art from 50 Cent."


More than 70 minutes of previously unreleased material are on the DVD, including an exclusive video for the song "Heat," an interview with Tony Yayo of the group G-Unit from Riker's Island and live footage featuring 50 Cent and Eminem. Also included are the clips for "Wanksta" and "In Da Club."

Meanwhile, the first release on G-Unit will be from the group G-Unit—Yayo, Lloyd Banks and Sha Money XL. The album is expected to come out by the end of the year.

Said 50: "Me and G-Unit are bringing it in 2003. First, I drop my album and people pay attention. Now that I got their attention, I'm gonna drop the next shit on them...the G-Unit shit, both the label and the group. The New Breed brings it all together. It's like an extension of the mix tape for me—hitting people with something you won't find anywhere else. I'm not leveling the competition, I'm destroying it."

Said IGA Chairman Jimmy Iovine: "When you have an artist like 50 Cent, you want to be in business with him on every level: movies, video games, wherever he wants to go. He has the kind of vision and work ethic that lets you know from the outset, he's going to win. We're looking forward to the same type of artistic quality and commercial success from G-Unit that we've had with both Shady Records and Aftermath Entertainment."

The Jayhawks, Rainy Day Music (American/Lost Highway/IDJ): While the Gary Louris-led band has shown considerable stylistic range (especially with the souped-up rock & roll of 2000's underrated Smile), they remain masters of harmony-rich country-rock, as their seventh album demonstrates. The Jayhawks are above all a song band, and Rainy Day Music is one of their richest collections. Among the memorable tunes are the

metaphysical lament "Stumbling Through the Dark" (co-written by Matthew Sweet), a zeitgeist-capturing song that opens and doses the album, the unabashedly sentimental "All the Right Reasons" (a potential country hit), the textured, tasty rocker "Tailspin" and the poignant, harmony-powered "Save It for a Rainy Day." Considering his sizable and dazzling body of work, it's time to acknowledge Louris as not simply a worthy inheritor of the Byrds/Burritos legacy but as a significant artist in his own right, and on his own terms. (BS)

Flashlight Brown, My Degeneration (Hollywood): With breakneck tempos, power chords and attitude aplenty, this Guelph, Canada-based quartet's big-label bow will effortlessly charm melodic-punk aficionados. But their flair for big chorus payoffs separates them from the pack, as does their dear fondness for dassic pop, old-school rock and even ska. Frontman/guitarist Matt Hughes' vocals mix snarls and yearning, while lead guitarist Mikey



Conroy's ultra-tasty playing and drummer Tim Thomson's power and precision keep things tight. Producer Rob Cavallo, meanwhile, lends punch and darity. Highlights: reference-heavy love anthem "Patricia," opener "Ready to Roll," the soaring "Looking Away" and "Whoa Man." (SG)



The Fleshtones, Do You Swing? (Yep Rock): These Queens, N.Y., natives formed against the punk-rock backdrop of the 70s, but they've emerged as the missing link between the Nuggets-style rock of American groups like the Outsiders, the R&B-influenced Andrew Loog Oldham Stones and current PoMo progenitors The Hives. The honking harmonica and hoarse howl of original Tones vocalist Peter Zaremba, the group call-

and-response and co-founder Keith Streng's fuzztoned, tremolo guitars remain unchanged after 27 years and 16 albums. Those elements can all be heard in the rousing "Hard Lovin' Man," the N.Y. Dollsy "Destination Greenpoint," the Coasters-like "I'm Back Again" and the tongue-in-cheek, pro-feminist "Right on Woman," along with an irreverently speedy "Communication Breakdown" that out-psychedelicizes Led Zep. It would only be fitting if the latest garage-rock revival finally brought the longest-lived cult band this side of the Flaming Groovies some well-deserved recognition. (RT)

Gob, Foot in Mouth Disease (Arista): While this Vancouver foursome has a similar sound to that of pals Sum 41 or the Blink-182 kids, the Gobsters light out for new territory all their own, applying the high energy and power-chord crunch of "pop-punk" to some deeper musical and lyrical ideas. Single "Give Up the Grudge" is an ideal power-pop specimen, while "Oh! Ellin" and "Bully" up the melodic ante with undeniable chorus hooks. More moody and introspective are "I Hear You Calling" and doser



introspective are "I Hear You Calling" and closer "Everybody's Getting Hooked Up," which explore the downside of recklessness—or the upside of having a conscience, depending on your perspective. "Fed Up," meanwhile, expands the band's harmonic horizons. In Gob we trust. (JO)





MUSICALLY SPEAKING: OK, enough already. For the past several weeks, you've had to endure tales of the ups and downs of my personal life. And let's face it—you are not being paid to be my therapist. I do, however, want to thank you for reading about it and caring enough to check in again this week for the latest. The only thing is, not much has changed. So rather than dwell on the issue, it strikes me that this would be a good time to talk music—a topic you are, in some way, shape or form, being paid for. What follows, then, are some observations about hits and hits-in-the-making. You see, I've spent a lot of time on the phone with my friends in radio this past week (it has something to do with the need to keep busy), and there are several records making noise that you need to be aware of if you're not already... Let's begin with one by an artist that I've been writing

about for weeks now, Da Brat "In Love Wit Chu" has Rick Sackheim and team Arista smiling big, as it lands Most Added status this week by a mile, yanking in majors from coast to coast, including KMEL, WWKX, KGGI, WJMN, KUBE and countless others. Finally, the song is "earpicked" from people with great taste, like Beata, Chris Tyler and Jammer, and has consistently been ringing the phones at KSFM since Tony Tecate took his copy out of the envelope and put it on the air immediately. Play this hit and get ratings... Next, I'm forced to get on my soapbox about Columbia's Frankie J. record. Quite simply, this is a monster for nearly everyone playing it. For proof, just check the

airplay: KPRR and KXME 71x, KDDB 68x, KDON 65x, and WKTU 51x. I could go on, but you get the point. Oh, and did I mention that the requests are pouring in, too? If you don't believe me, call someone who's playing it and ask. Just be sure to start with JD Gonzalez and Pablo Sato because it's #2 in San Antonio and Top 5 in San Diego. Song too Pop-sounding for your station? Don't fret—an Urban remix is on the way. But that shouldn't really matter, given it's the lyrics that are driving the reaction... Next, and from almost completely out of left field, comes the latest effort from Bone Thugs-N-Harmony. A few weeks back, when the record was first released, I popped it into my CD player and was pleasantly surprised. What a great idea to use Phil Collins' "Take Me Home" throughout, I thought. It seemed perfect for Rhythm stations courting a coalition audience of both Anglo and ethnic partisans—hip-hop that would appeal to all segments of the audience. Imagine my surprise, then, when I started to ask my friends in radio about it and some literally burst out laughing on the other end of the phone! Most were convinced there was NO WAY their audiences would respond to this record. There were, however, a few brave souls who heard it in somewhat the same manner as I did, and decided to take a chance. Now, these same stations are reaping the rewards that come with a hit. It's Top 5 in callout at both WLLD and KDGS, picks up great new action this week from WPOW and WNVZ, and is spinning significantly at B96, KPWR, KYLD, KYWL and many others. A little odd-sounding when compared to the rest of your playlist? Yes. A mass-appeal hit nevertheless? Yes again... Of course, in a column devoted to songs showing every indication of making it through the pipeline, I must also mention the new Monica jam on J Records. Michael Williams and his crew scored Most Added status last week and new adds this week from HOT 97, KQKS, WCHH and several others. Then, add into the mix "earpicks" from J.R., Tap Money, Robb Royale and Big Bear and it starts to become clear that "So Gone" is definitely going at radio... Last, but certainly not least, I have to bring up Tom Maffei's Talib Kweli track. Now here's a record I didn't get on first listen—or on second or third listen, for that matter. But I must admit that not only is "Get By" spinning in solid, 30x/week or more rotation at majors everywhere. including KMEL, KBMB, KXJM and WPHI, the full length is now also starting to sell behind this airplay. Retail moves of note include 71-32 at Virgin National and 73-58 at Wherehouse this week. And you know how I feel about the importance of retail sales in a down economy. Quite simply, if they're spending their hard-earned dollars on a CD, the track driving said sales is almost always a hit. So why are you not playing this yet—at least at night?... And that's the musical view from here this week. Until next time (when there may be yet another shift in the status of the whole Jay issue)—C-ya!...





had a pretty boring weekend, as usual. I had company coming from out of town, so I did a whole lot of cleaning. I also continued my search for a place to live, but with no luck yet. Snoop Dogg is currently #3, with an increase of 140 spins this week. Geo is definitely within spitting distance at this point. Priority/Capitol has some great records coming, and a #1 on Snoop would be a great way to start the summer. Two of their new artists performed at the aforementioned convention, and I heard that they were great: Chingy is Ludacris' new artist from St. Louis, and his debut single, "Right Thurr," is generating quite a buzz at several stations. The other new artist is a young man named Javier from the east coast. I mentioned him a few weeks ago, because I've been listening to his advance album in my car and it is really one of my favorites. I know everyone who got a chance to see him knows what I'm talking about. Make sure you look out for his new single, "Crazy," which should be on your desk soon... Another strong possibility for the #1 spot in the next few weeks is the Busta Rhymes and Mariah Carey record, "I Know What You Want." The song is currently #7 with an increase of 325 spins. Ken Wilson and company should definitely make a big move for next week. They are also doing an amazing job with the Monica single, which jumps from #45 to #31 only one week after impact. They have some really great stations, including WBLS (19x), WAMO (37x), WBLK (26x), WAJZ (27x), WCDX (18x), WPEG (45x), WOWI (34x), WWWZ (40x), WHXT (17x), WKKV (19x), WPWX (38x), WQUE (32x) and KPRS (15x). I will say it one more time: This record is going to be huge! J Records is making some big moves lately, and Heather Headley is just another example. 





"We'll take one of absolutely everything," he says. And the reality is that it's been paying off. In a down market since the monster year of '99, by comparison, they have been thriving. In 2000, they were down 1/2%. And actually, LT's numbers were up in '01 by 3% and in '02 by 2%. While most retailers have been experiencing major decreases, that's a major feat. When Karl Sr. founded the store, it was a



mere 900 sq ft. Thirty-two years later, it boasts some 4,500 sq. ft., having annexed neighboring retail space. The Groeger family has finally purchased the building where they've been leasing all these years and plan to ultimately fill the entire 10k sq. ft. They joined CIMS some three years ago and Karl Jr. believes that it's been a great thing for his business. "Being on Long Island, we've always had a very close relationship with the N.Y.based labels, but CIMS has put me in touch with the West Coast. And we're really honored to be affiliated with some just absolutely amazing stores like Waterloo or Twist and Shout. The CIMS members are the kinds of stores that I look to and try to emulate." Karl Jr. has also become very close with CIMS associate Rob Roth of Vintage Vinyl. Together, they have started a new program called the Metro Breakout. "With him in in New Jersev and me in New York, we can really get behind a band and try to break it out of this area"... While we were away at NARM, Alliance Entertainment Group promoted an old friend of ours, Nancy Goldwin, to VP Merchandising. Goldwin has been with AEC for the last six years. We adore her. Apparently, they do, too... The shuttering of Immergent Records has left their incredibly talented VP of Marketing Melissa Boag looking for opportunities. Someone should do themselves a favor and hire her. She can be reached at (818) 566 4338.
