



The Destiny's Child leader's Dangerously in Love moved an impressive 331k units, while Branch's sophomore effort, Hotel Paper, the follow-up to her multiplatinum debut The Spirit Room, soared to 158k, thanks in part to manager Jeff Rabhan, who spent last week walking up and down Sunset Blvd. in a sandwich board.

Top gainers were DreamWorks Okie pop-punks The All-American Rejects, who showed a 19% increase over the previous week.

Next up, it's all about Murder Inc./IDI's R&B chanteuse Ashanti, whose Chapter II hit stores Tuesday in anticipation of what many believe will be a chart-topping bow next week.

A Smashing New Show on Tap

S *mash*, the first primetime network TV pop-music performance show in decades, hits the WB airwaves July 16 with an opening night lineup of Evanescence, Monica, Black-Eyed Peas and The Ataris. The Pepsi-sponsored series will feature a new host every week, including WB TV and film star Amanda Bynes, American Pie's Alyson Hannigan and four other young celebs, who will be announced next week.

The program, executive-produced and directed by Tenth Planet's Joel Gallen, will tape the week prior to broadcast on a specially designed two-stage, inthe-round setup at Hollywood's Ren-Mar Studios in front of a studio audience of about 600, culled from the featured performers' fan sites and via local radio promotions and giveaways.

Each installment of Smash will feature four high-profile performers playing one or two songs apiece, plus one buzzing up-andcoming act that may very well be getting its first national TV exposure. There'll also be a music-chart countdown and artist interviews.

"We're creating an event every week that people will want to attend in person," says Gallen.


And not all the action will take place on camera. The backstage area will boast a special green room VIP "Smash Bar," the setting for an exclusive weekly backstage party for the artists, their friends and various A-listers.

Can RIAA's Full-Court Press Make the Swap Drop?

The RIAA's long-expected announcement that it will pursue litigation against individual online file-sharers—bolstered by supportive quotes from a small army of artists, songwriters and other copyright holders—made a big media splash last week. But will it achieve its desired result of deterring P2P use and urging digital-music fans toward legit services, or will it have the opposite effect?

A poll on America Online—hardly a hotbed of radicalism on most topics—suggests the biz has a way to go before swappers are spooked.

In answer to the question, "Has the music industry's plan to sue individuals stopped you from swapping songs online?" 54% said no, a mere 6% said yes, and 13% said they've cut back but not stopped. 26% said they don't download songs—a likely story.

AOL bulletin boards related to the topic were filled with vitriol against the industry, along with the usual claims that sales are down because most records suck.

The respondents may have shown such defiance in part because of the emergence of software that claims to protect user anonymity over P2P networks. The latest include Blubster 2.5 from Spanish company Optisoft S.L., Palestine-based Earthstation5 and the new version of Morpheus.

"Blubster will always pursue counter measures to preserve the freedom and empowerment of decentralized networking," promised developer Pablo Soto, who likened a file sent via the program to a very accurate message in a bottle. "The very existence of our network ensures artists and content creators an alternative to signing away their rights to copy-

right barons."

With the providers of file-sharing services freed of responsibility for users' actions by a district court in a case against Grokster, users may be the RIAA's only viable target for legal action. But a new decision, handed down Monday (6/30) against swappery Aimster, suggests the RIAA has a reasonably good shot at winning its appeal of the earlier verdict.

"We're delighted by this decision, which makes clear, as did the Napster decision, that companies cannot profit from copyright infringement," exulted RIAA Prexy Cary Sherman. "A peer-to-peer service is not off the hook simply because it claims there may be legitimate uses of its network. When these types of services exist primarily as a vehicle for copyright infringement, they have an obligation to try and reduce the illegal activity occurring on their networks."

A Federal District Court decision forcing Verizon to hand over the identities of high-volume swappers cleared the way for litigation against individuals. Meanwhile, Congress may soon address this issue, with anti-piracy politicos squaring off against defenders of online privacy.




BEAT'S ME

MIDYEAR RESPITE: The first six months of 2003 in movies, music and sports have been perhaps the most desultory in memory for this Mets/Jets/Knicks fan. 

HOT FUN IN THE SUMMERTIME: By now you've heard about some of the talent that will grace this summer's Boulder Summit. John Schoenberger has put together another stellar line-up for what many consider the most "livable" of conventions. The Fox Theater showcases kick off on Wednesday night (8/6) with a very special Dave Matthews and friends show, featuring a rare semi-acoustic set from Dave, along with the Graham Colton Band, Ben Kweller and North Mississippi All Stars. Thursday night at the Fox, it's Nickel Creek, Jonny Lang and Howie Day. Friday night, it's Ziggy Marley, Guster and the great new Elektra act Steadman at the Fox, along with Los Lonely Boys and Indigenous next door at Tulagi. And wrapping things up on Saturday night, it's Blues Traveler, Bob Schneider and Frankie Perez at the Fox, with Rodney Crowell and the reunited Mavericks at Tulagi. (I'll be right up front for that one!)... WRLT's Rev. Keith Coes, who camped out for the first time since he was in college, filed this report from Bonnaroo: "They installed plumbing, roads, tents-it felt like the biggest city in Tennessee for the weekend. Musically, the high point was the Flaming Lips show at midnight Saturday night. The theatrics were amazing. They had a giant rabbit on-stage. Other highlights were Neil Young's three hour set; Jack Johnson and Ben Harper on stage together; and the new guitar God of the jam band set, Warren

Haynes, who performed solo, as well as with Galactic, the Allman Brothers and Widespread Panic. And with five stages going at once, it was harder to cover than SXSW." Rev., we're sure you managed to catch as much as anyone there... Speaking of Ben Harper, "With My Own Two Hands" is in Heavy practically everywhere and Top Five at the format. His tour with Jack Johnson is one of the most successful of the summer with two capacity shows at Red Rocks in Denver, and three at San Francisco's Greek Theater. And if you've spent any time with Ben's Diamonds on the Inside CD, you know how deep it is. We'll no doubt be liv-

ing with it for a long time to come... RCA wunderkind Gavin DeGraw is kind of a cross between John Mayer and Billy Joel. There's already airplay on "Follow Through" in APM markets with plenty of Hot Adult action—it was one add away from #1 Most Added at the format in its impact week. But if you're thinking the track is too mainstream, note that tastemaker APMs like WFUV, WXPN and WNCW are also on the record. DeGraw has been writing songs since he was 13, growing up with his working-class family in the Catskills. His is a real record by a real artist that demands your full attention. In other RCA news, 1,000 people showed up and bought 600 CDs at Boyd Tinsley's Virgin Megastore in-store several weeks back. The current Dave Matthews Band tour will bring Tinsley to a ton of APM markets. His "Listen" is a great APM song. Play it and work with Adrian Moreira to set up a meet-and-greet at the venue. Other records Moreira's involved with include Annie Lennox's new Bare, which continues to sell close to Top Five after moving 152k in its first week. Annie is a superstar you should really be playing. If KGSR can work with "Pavement Cracks" (they added it this week), so can you. And finally congrats to Adrian on bringing in the new David Gray track, "Caroline," #1 Most Added with 18 combined adds... Props also to Columbia's Trina Tombrink, who came in a close second with 17 adds (though ahead by three in Mediabase-monitored stations) on Pete Yorn's "Crystal Village," and for grabbing WDOD on Wilshire's "Special"... Another album that I've become quite enamored with is the Cash Brothers' A Brand New Night. Get a copy from Paul or Katrinka at Rounder... As huge WBOS and WTTS adds come in on "You Dance," word from the eastmountainsouth road trip with Tracy Chapman is that response has been phenomenal, including regular standing ovations and 100+ CDs sold nightly. Strong!... With Guster's "Amsterdam" essentially Top Five, their new album Keep It Together explodes at retail with 30k+ sold—good enough for a Top 25 chart debut... Look for Astralwerks non-comm faves Turin Brakes on the road with David Gray. Labelmate Gemma Hayes, incidentally, was incredible at the closing show of her first U.S. tour last week. Gemma casts a broad stylistic net. At times I hear Shawn Colvin fronting the Breeders while Beth Orton comes through occasionally. At the end of the day, though, Hayes is just a tremendous new voice in the process of finding itself... Finally, props to Michele St. Clair for grabbing WGVX on Gus Black's "Dry Kisses," to Tom and Lorraine at Jive for bringing in WMMM on Indigenous and, finally, to Nick Bedding, closing WKOC on my beloved Pete Francis record... hitsmm@aol.com..

Guster, Keep It Together (Palm/Reprise): The first album from the trio of Tufts classmates and perennial Boston college student faves since '99's Lost and Gone Forever (Sire) suggests that the time away has been well-spent. Like a stateside Coldplay, the band nods to '80s new wavesters the Smiths and New Order on songs like "Careful," and to R.E.M. on the single "Amsterdam," a break-up song that references fellow

New England cult icons the Shaggs. With the title track as his rallying cry, singer/songwriter Ryan Miller embraces the future in "Come Downstairs and Say Hello": "I look straight at what's coming ahead/and soon it's going to change in a new direction." From the Brian Wilson homage "Ramona" to the unlikely mix of Indian raga and country harp in "Backyard," these savvy PoMo auteurs refuse to allow irony or disappointment to cloud their sunny pop dreams. (RT)

Bleu, Redhead (Aware/Columbia): Boston's Bleu McCauley may have made the most open-throttled guitar-pop album since Jellyfish revealed its love for Queen, with all due grandiosity, on 1993'a Spilt Milk. In fact, Jellvfish auteur/frontman Andy Sturmer shows up for two tracks, including the explosive opener/first single "Get Up," on which he's credited as "the king of Queen." Fellow popmeister Dan Wilson (Semisonic, Trip



Shakespeare) also drops by to co-write and sing on "Somethin's Gotta Give," one of the soaring mini-symphonies that dominate the album. When McCauley swings for the fences (notably, on "We'll Do It All Again," "Somebody Else" and "Trust Me"), he invariably connects. And when he pulls back ("You Know, I Know, You Know"), McCauley displays the languid grace of the young Todd Rundgren. If any of these reference points resonate for you, Bleu's your color. (BS)



Mogwai, Happy Music for Happy People (Matador): This influential Glaswegian instrumental art-rock combine here take their rarefied, moody aural sprawl to the next level, refining their subtext-driven themes into subtly shape-shifting waves of meaning. Packed with guitars, organs, Mellotrons, strings and plenty of sweet analog fuzz, the record, which occasionally recalls Tindersticks' more expansive moments in its

monumental sweep, is hypnosis waiting to happen. Opener "Hunted by a Freak" fades up like a long-lost outtake from Dark Side of the Moon, while "Boring Machines Disturb Sleep" and "Ratts of the Capital" are shot through with the Celtic spirit, two-minute crescendos building to such fury, one can almost hear the winds of Thor blowing through the runes, or smell the funereal smoke as another fallen warrior approaches Valhalla. (JO)

S.T.U.N. Evolution of Energy (Geffen): Bristling with anger and ideas, this L.A. foursome's debut harnesses the insurrectionary fervor of Rage and the Clash to the ambitious, sensual explorations of Jane's Addictionand kicks out the jams, hardcore-style. Veteran producer Sean Slade, meanwhile, who also mixed several tracks with longtime partner Paul Q. Kolderie, has helped the band create a recording with the urgency



of a humid club show. Singer Christiane J. has the pipes and authority to match the storming assault of guitarist Neil Spies, bassist Nick S. and drummer Bobby Alt, and the collective has a flair for efficient, propulsive hooks. Just check out the furious bounce of "Annihilation of the Generations," the tension/release of "Movement" and the infectious "Watch the Rebellion Grow." (SG)




The jury continues to be out on Sun Capital, which just acquired the wounded Musicland chain from Best Buy, for what Major League Baseball would call a "rosin bag and a bucket of balls." When the "sale" was first announced. most we talked to were happy that the once-dominant chain had not been bought by another retailer (i.e. Trans World), reducing an already-decimated retail account base. But since then, many inside the Big Five have confided that there are still quite a few unanswered questions. To be sure, Sun Capital has taken many distressed companies and made them whole again. But the music industry is an unusual animal, and the furniture business it's not. So, to begin with, it's not a given that SC will be "opened" (given a line of credit) by the Big Five. Currently, they are all operating on a cash basis with Musicland. SC's exposure is nil, having paid nothing for the company, with Best Buy assuming all of the debt. SC is only responsible for the lease agreements and the ongoing costs of operat-

ing the chain. Insiders tell us they are meeting with SC's brass next week and will be looking for "some sort of comfort level" that can come in various forms of financial backing. That could be anything from a line of credit or a bank note to placing the majors in a "first position" should anything go south. However, it's hard to believe that any bank funding the deal for SC would sit still for the majors being first in line should a bankruptcy occur. That said, it's also struck more than a few very strange that not only didn't SC reach out to anyone in the music community before the transaction, but three weeks have now passed and still SC has yet to make that call. Next week's meetings should make things clearer... Alliance Entertainment Corp. held its fourth Annual Indie Retail Convention, with CEO Eric Weisman and company hosting 50 AEC sales reps at the Bahia Mar Hotel in Ft. Lauderdale. They were treated to sets by new Columbia act Wilshire, who brought down the house with an acoustic set, Rykodisc's Josh Rouse and Godhead, a new Marilyn Manson discovery on Reality Entertainment through Caroline, though the highlight was Friday night's jam with AEC brass Robbie DeFreitas and Bob Ekizian... ADA President Andy Allen upped Michael Black to Sr. VP Sales and David Orleans to VP Mktg... Wherehouse Music will submit its plan to emerge from Chapter 11 for suppliers, which they could be ready to show the courts as early as next week.


