

The album, like the movie, zoomed to #1 in its first week, on sales north of 330k. As an added bonus for the original Bad Boy, album sales were heated up by Nelly/P. Diddy/Murphy Lee's

Homers' Rick Galusha reiterated his support for Kobe while asking for the girl's phone number before effusing: "It's just amazing how Bad Boys II is selling. There hasn't been a soundtrack this hot in a long time. With a huge radio story, this has the feel of a franchise."

Bowing "Right Thurr" at #2 is DTP/Capitol St. Louis-based hip-hopper Chingy.

"The Chingy record is seeing big, big sales, especially for a brandnew artist," Galusha enthused. "Right Thurr' is now part of my everyday vocabulary. Once again, a big radio record takes full advantage and breaks through."

RCA Nashville dynamic duo Brooks & Dunn was the third newcomer to the Top Four at #4, with only #3 Columbia/CRG diva Beyoncé breaking up the domination of first-timers.

Murder Inc./IDJ co-diva Ashanti (#5), Wind-up's Evanescence (#6), Shady/Aftermath/Interscope's 50 Cent (#7), Blue Note's Norah Jones at #8 and Maverick troubadouress Michelle Branch (#10) made it an even 10 records in this week's Top 10.

A fourth debut, from Republic/Universal's Pat Green—a Texas Springsteen who is breaking big out of monstrous regional sales in the Lone Star State—finished #11. Wheee-dogggggies!

Also making chart bows were So So Def/Arista's Da Brat (#22), Def Jam/IDJ old-school hip-hopper Keith Murray (#17), who announced this would be his last record for the label, and Epic neo-soul singer Macy Gray (#49).

Look for UTV's *Now 13*, Capitol's Jane's Addiction, RCA Nashville's Brad Paisley, Interscope's Mya and Volcano's 311 to break into the Top 50 when next we meet.

WMG Diskeries Sold

OL Time Warner reduced its massive debt by \$1.05 billion on July 18, as the media conglom announced a definitive agreement to sell Warner Music Group's DVD and CD manufacturing, printing, packaging, physical distribution and merchandising businesses to Canada's Cinram International.

The deal includes WEA Manufacturing, Warner Music Manufacturing Europe, Ivy Hill, Giant Merchandising and WEA's physical distribution operations. WEA's sales and marketing operations are not part of the deal.

The decision to sell the operation to Cinram means that WEA head Jim Caparro, who had put together a consortium to bid on these assets, is the odd man out, as all but the above-mentioned sales and marketing divisions have been yanked out from under him. The AOLTW announcement makes no mention of Caparro's post-deal status.

Under the terms of the agreement, Cinram will be the manufacturer, printer, packager and physical distributor for WMG, Warner Home Video and New Line Cinema in North America and Europe. Cinram has facilities in Canada, the U.S., Europe and Larin America.

Said AOLTW Chairman/ CEO Dick Parsons: "We're very pleased to have reached an agreement with Cinram that meets our strategic and financial objectives. The agreement ensures these businesses and their employees a great home while continuing to provide Warner Music Group, Warner Home Video and New Line Cinema with the highest quality manufacturing and distribution services in the industry. Just as important, it demonstrates the significant progress we've made toward fulfilling our commitment to reducing debt through free-cash-flow generation and the sale of non-strategic assets. With this agreement, as well as our legal settlement with Microsoft and the sale of our interests in Comedy Central and GM/Hughes, we have announced this year transactions generating nearly \$3.8 billion in cash proceeds earmarked for debt reduction. And just wait till we have that giant vard sale."

Added WMG Chairman/CEO Roger Ames: "We're in a period of rapid change in the music business and are working to make Warner Music Group as streamlined, efficient and agile as possible. The agreement we're announcing today is part of that evolution. Each of the companies being sold has a long and rich history as part of Warner Music, and each is a leader in its field—but history is in the past, and frankly, pressing plants aren't very sexy.

"Cinram is a well-managed international company that not only recognizes the tremendous value of these assets but has demonstrated a commitment to quality and service. We're confident that these businesses and their employees will continue to thrive under Cinram's leadership, and we're pleased that Warner Music will continue to manufacture, package and distribute its products through Cinram. Your move, Roff."

According to AOLTW, if the Cinram deal had occurred at the beginning of 2003, operating income before depreciation and amortization for the six months ended June 30, 2003, would have been reduced by about \$130 million.

The sale won't be official until the requisite regulatory reviews in the U.S. and elsewhere have been completed.





Others noting the opportunity for indie labels may get even greater once Clear Channel's indie promo deals expire Aug. 1. Might there finally be room for the little guys at radio once more?... Speaking of radio, with the problematic books coming down for Top 40, whisperers whispering that the format may have finally leaned too far toward Rap and Urban, with some stations indistinquishable from their Urban counterparts, which have a more loyal core audience. Word is a growing number of T40 programmers are looking toward artists such as Hilary Duff, who not only bring mainstream star quality, but also a strong connection to family (i.e. kids and moms) to restore ratings... From the Can't Keep a Bad Boy Down department, P. Diddy's back on the radar in a big way, as Bad Boy/Universal's Bad Boys II blows by 300k for the week... Meanwhile, Andrew Slater's Capitol team continues to score, as debut artist Chingy nabs #2 out of the box and Coldplay nears 2 million over the counter... With MTV's VMA nominations coming this week, insiders saying to look for big nods for Missy, Justin, Eminem and 50 Cent, as well as a major, media-magnet wildcard... Names in the Rumor Mill: Val Azzoli, L.A. Reid, Barry Weiss, Jason Flom and Sylvia Rhone.

THE INDIE-MAJOR QUESTION: Chatter continues in A&R circles about the potential PROFITABILITY of artists graduating to a major from an indie. In the current climate of downwardsliding sales, will the increasing trend of signing hotly pursued independent artists (such as Pedro the Singing Monkey) be fruitful, given the size of the deals in play? Another resounding concern, even among the pursuers themselves, is whether majors will have the resources and patience to develop said indie actsand thus enable them to make commercially viable records. One often hears of some indie hardcore-metal band, newly in the spotlight, being dubbed "the next Metallica" by label reps. Yet Metallica took eight-plus years and five records to reach their breakthrough album. And with the trend of most bidding-derby signings committing to just two records, the deck seems pretty stacked. Some insiders say that allowing acts to develop at the indie level is now a necessity for majors, due not only to an overall lack of artist development, but also to cutbacks that have forced

many labels to rely on skeletal staffs. And with the stream of indie acts come new, progressive artist deals structured by artist reps. Stay tuned... HERE'S THE SCOOP: Looks like the Larry Jacobson/Scott Bradfordrepped Avenged Sevenfold is close to finalizing a deal with The Bunny. The band's sophomore indie record will be released this August... Label peeps also turning out to the Jacobson-repped Rise Against last Saturday at the Troub... Hollywood's Knitting Factory welcomed a packed crowd last Thursday for soulful Bay Area songstress Goapele. Naturally, the audience was sprinkled with some label heavies. With heavy rotation at KBMB, KHHT, KJLH and KMEL, the artist's current LP is approaching the 30k mark... Expect some label peeps at the Post Stardom Depression show at the Viper Room this week... Talkers talking about the radio and sales outlook for the Nick Ferrara/ Paul Bassman-repped Jibe. The band released an independent record last week... Trauma Records co-founder Paul Palmer has been meeting with several majors for a new deal for his 5

Crowns Music company. Trauma, you may recall, ultimately sold over 33 million albums worldwide, with a roster that included No Doubt and Bush. Several artists in Palmer's new stable-Diana Aniad, CrashPalace and Antonio-have been perking weasels' ears. Hot-shot barrister lan Montone reps Palmer and will be mediating the weaseltude...Buzz band Thursday's highly anticipated major-label debut is now complete, and yours truly was given an early listen. The tracks are smokin'! Kudos to producer Sal Villanueva and Island Def Jam A&R hitter Ben Lazar for delivering the goods. The record is slated for release this September... The Ken Krongard/ Cliff Fadry-repped Samantha Moore inks with Jimmy lovine and Jordan Schur at Geffen, Former MCA A&R dude Clyde Lieberman, who initially brought in the act, comes on as a consultant on the project. He'll work with Interscope A&R exec Thom Panunzio... Lots of pub interest brewing for the Peter Torres/Peter Cohen-repped Mozella. The teen femme troubadour previously inked with Guy O. and Scott Austin at Maverick... More pub

A&M's Black Eyed Peas have inked a worldwide deal with Al Smith at Cherry Lane Music Publishing. That, to answer the band's smash musical question, is where the love is. Keep an eye out for Smith's latest acquisition, Latin Pop singer Jean Rodriguez. See below for gig info... 

The E-man rocked (as usual), and even did a Springsteen cover (though don't ask his manager what she thought of that)... Guster drew 3k to a KINK Noon Tunes lunchtime concert in Portland. Of course, the band stopped by the station and performed stellar renditions of several songs, including "Amsterdam (Gonna Write You a Letter)" which, as we speak,

closes in on #1 at APM... Props to Dylan Smith at SCI Fidelity for putting together a #1 Most Added first week on Keller Williams "Love Handles." Also making a justifiably big splash this week was "New York City," from the Peter Malick Group featuring Norah Jones. The track was tied for #1 in Mediabase-monitored stations. These independent recordings were made in '00 prior to Norah being signed to Blue Note, and have just now come out on KOCH. Also forthcoming from KOCH is a great new album from Joan Baez, Dark Chords on a Big Guitar, from which you will LOVE the track "Elvis Presley Blues." Watch your mail... It was another big week for Wilshire as eight more Modern Adult stations add the record, including those in Austin, Houston, Seattle and Louisville. As we've told you, "Special" is blowing up and deserves a real listen. Have you given it one?... Congrats to Paul and Katrinka at Rounder for picking up some key adds on Cash Brothers' "Shadow of Doubt" as WXRV and WFUV come in... Kudos to Lisa Michelson for bringing in KTCZ on Jason Mraz's "You and I Both"... Props to Or Music's Jason Fisher for landing WXRV on Los Lonely Boys' "Heaven"; also to Lava's Tommy Daley for his big KENZ add on O.A.R.'s "Hey Girl"; to Nick at Hollywood for closing KBAC on Pete Francis' "One Train"; KBAC also added another one of our faves, Turin Brakes' "Pain Killer (Summer Rain)." Look for Turin Brakes out on the road with David Gray through the first week of August. The band sold 110 CDs at its first date in Connecticut. Speaking of records under the EMI Music Collective umbrella, Blue Note has signed Van Morrison. They will impact a single in September and street the record in October. Meanwhile, Fountains of Wayne is getting some attention at APM as well, with WXPN adding "Stacy's Mom" this week... As you've probably read, Warren Zevon bravely chose to spend his time since being diagnosed with brain cancer making what will be his last album. Titled The Wind, the record includes guest appearances by Eagles Don Henley, Joe Walsh and Tim Schmit, Bruce Springsteen, Tom Petty, Jackson Browne, Emmylou Harris, Dwight Yoakam, Billy Bob Thornton, Ry Cooder, Tommy Shaw, David Lindley and John Waite. Warren chose as the lead single a majestic live-in-the-studio version of Bob Dylan's "Knockin' on Heaven's Door." With WXRT, WFUV and WXPN already on board, KINK adding this week and an amazing buzz, look for a blow-out add week when the record impacts 7/28... hitsmm@aol.com...

Jane's Addiction, Strays (Capitol): On their first studio album in 13 years, original members Perry Farrell, Dave Navarro and Stephen Perkins (along with newcomer bassist Chris Chaney) lay claim to the title of America's Led Zeppelin, as they duel live for the honor with Audioslave on this summer's Lollapalooza. Old (and new) Jane's fans won't be disappointed by this Bob Ezrin-produced effort, which has all the tribal jet propulsion of "Pigs in Zen" and

"Ocean Size" on the first single, "Just Because," and "True Nature" (with its anti-Bush polemic, "We'll go to war for you backward heroes"). Apocalyptic then, seemingly prescient now, Jane's explores its own mortality (and survival) in "Price I Pay" and the title track ("The road it's getting thinner"), while the circumspection of "Jane Says" is echoed in the rueful, bittersweet "Everybody's Friend." Worth the wait (RT)

Thrice, The Artist in the Ambulance (Sub City/Island/IDJ): This Orange County foursome's songs are packed with raw emotion, but the term "emo" hardly does justice to the reach of their major-label debut. Justin Kensrue's supple pipes, Teppei Teranishi's versatile hardrock guitars and the breakneck tempos of fraternal rhythm section Eddie and Riley Breckenridge field metal dissonance and melodic beauty with equal aplomb. Best



of all, the band grounds its varying impulses in sturdy song craft. The creamy three-part harmonies at the center of the crunchy "All That's Left" melt in your ear, and the worried, skittering verse in "Stare at the Sun" gives way to a huge, yearning refrain. Other highlights: the galloping "Under a Killing Moon," the huge and gorgeous "The Melting Point of Wax" and the breathless title track. (SG)



Patrick Park, Loneliness Knows My Name (Hollywood): The Colorado-bred, L.A.-based Park comes off as a quintessential loner on his musically and lyrically detailed debut album, which offers a cast of worldweary characters scarred by life and victimized by love. Working with producer Tom Trumfio (My Morning Jacket, Wilco), Park frames his hardscrabble narratives in jewel-encrusted settings featuring violin, cello, reeds and

harpsichord, along with his own precisely fingerpicked acoustic guitar and Dylanesque harmonica. Putting his weight behind his boyish tenor, Park appears to be willing himself to break through a membrane of reticence, which provides the album with its dramatic tension. Particularly noteworthy are "Desperation Eyes," which contains Park's most intense vocal performance, the metaphoric beauty "Silver Girl," the thematically definitive "Something Pretty" and the raunchily genteel "Honest Skrew." Park seems connected to something deep and ineffable, like the offspring of Nick Drake on a Rocky Mountain high. (BS)

Three Days Grace, Three Days Grace (Jive): Having made it out of small-town Ontario to their new home in Toronto, this Canadian power trio mixes big-city hooks with one-horse angst to produce a debut of unsettling sonic and lyrical clarity. Opener "Burn" comes on with a hyper-kinetic Badmotorfinger -like riff, morphing into a huge chorus, while the following "Just Like You" brings another massively grinding motif worthy of vintage Ritchie Blackmore. Single "I Hate Everything About



You" brings it all home with its soaring, searing complaint ("Why do I love you?). Other highlights include the singed 6/8 bitterness of "Let You Down" and latent melodic smash "Take Me Under." When you say Grace, be sure to wear earplugs. (JO)

HITS-Ma-HUSTLE

BALLING IN THE HIP-HOP NATION: I'm touching on something for the sports fans this week, because this DVD from Bryan Turner's Melee Entertainment just hit my desk. It's a little bit of hiphop history brought to you by Gregory Marius, founder and CEO of the now legendary NYC Rucker Park basketball battle. It all began back in 1980 when rival rappers The Disco Four (Enjoy Records) challenged Cash Crew (Sugar Hill) to get their game on. That day, Disco Four happened to be doing a radio interview, and they broadcast the gametime and location over the airwaves before heading out to show off their skills. Neither team expected a crowd, but when they got there, about 1,000 cats were hanging around to catch the clash. Marius played on Disco Four's team, which trounced Cash Crew by 59 points. Marius produced the hard-hitting hip-hop DVD featuring some of my old Loud crews Mobb Deep and Dead Prez, along with Fat Joe f/Remy Martin, Talib Kweli, Roscoe and more. Sure to be a burner for all the b-ball fans out there... DreamWorks principal Michael Ostin, demonstrating more game, gives Q-Tip license to "pursue musical freedom with the release of (his upcoming CD) Starfoods and launch his own label, Abstract Artworks, which the rapper will oversee as CEO. Tip's approach will be "one artist at a time, one song at a time, one lyric at a time," and he is "happy to be working with music people and not just suits." Good, another new outlet for people with passion for hip-hop and R&B in the never-ending era of cutbacks. We love seeing nurturing and growth instead of merging and downsizing!!... Speaking of growth, hats off to the full Monte for DTP/Capitol rapper Chingy's #1

two weeks running, ringing in a new era of what's sure to be a slew of #1's 'for Hubbert's crew. The label's Roscoe is over 1000 spins now and still coming strong, with KUBE adding (and already spinning 9x a day) and WRED hitting it, too... Elektra's Hecht and co. have done a fine job of growing Fabolous into Top Five, keeping the pressure on with Tamia and delivering DJ Mark Ronson with a bang, spinning at over 26 stations... Columbia hits a homerun with 32, (count 'em), new adds on Frankie J., while Bow Wow pulls Top Five phones at KBBT and KWNZ. What can I add about Epic's Ginuwine except it's a slam-dunk by Liz, Ayelet and Mike? This ballad is most requested at about half the panel—in the summertime, no less!! Meanwhile, Big Brovaz is a pick from Chino at KZZP and getting strong support at XHTZ, KUUU and WYIL...Universal's Baby Bash made hoop

shots at KYLD and KKWD and crosses to the southeast now at WXIS. Marella's mob also macks as Nelly/P. Diddy/ Murphy Lee, holds strong at #10. Gary is working hard on Aaliyah's hot bootie calling, "Come Over," coming on at WCHH and KOHT, while he pushes Lumidee toward Top Five... For those who think Christina Aguilera is a pop artist, please get your real Q-Tips out, apply as needed, and RE-LISTEN to this track. Lil Kim brings her thang to the table on this one, and she has been reigning queen of the rhythmic charts. I love this song and my dial is tuned into Power-Uno-Zero-Seis in Los Angeles, which, last time I checked, is not a Pop station. Amigos, escuchame! RCA/J is not letting the massive callout story on Lyric go ignored at radio. Even if this record has been out a minute, you will not escape Michael Williams' dedicated heat on this one... Reno's newest hip-hop programmer Jasmine Curiel picks Geffen's Mary J. to go the distance at The Bomb and Big Bear at KCAQ told me it's "power" for him. This chart-burner is almost Top 10 already! Check www.marytv.com for her radio interview schedule... Arista's OutKast is blowing people's minds everywhere, and we got particularly favorable feedback from Jack Spade at WQSL, who is already getting response on both tracks from mixshow play. Youngbloodz blows the roof off at Sirius' rap channel as my pal Ken Spellman reports heavy, while Sackheim reveals it's #2 callout at KBOS, with Top Five phones everywhere. KKFR's Joey Boy said his audience is feening for Pharrell. He's getting mad phones, and lots of anticipation calls about The Clones CD... Interscope's 50 Cent consistently requests off the ringer across America and is moving quickly toward #1. And Nino's bringing home Black Eyed Peas, which I LOVE, with very few holes left to fill on this song with substance... Jeff Z tested Stagga Lee's new reggae-influenced "Rock Your Body" on ArtistDirect at WKTU and it immediately became #1 requests, so it's going to power in NYC... New jump shot joints: Bubba Sparxxx's "Deliverance," Lil Kim f/Missy's "Can You Hear Me Now?," Kelis' "Milkshake"... Keepin it straight: Cyphers, Austin, Clay Church, Lucas, Romeo. If you look up the word "visionary" in the dictionary, you will find two definitions. One, of course, is a prophet or one who sees the future. The other deals with dreams that are "not practicable or realizable," visions that are "utopian" or "unrealistic." Some three years ago, it was this second definition that was the way most people in the industry viewed Jim Caparro's vision of consolidating manufacturing for most, if not all, of the Big Five distributors. However, before Caparro joined on as head of WEA, he came within an inch of putting together the deal, only to watch it unravel as one of the key players got cold feet. When he was tapped to head WEA, it was obvious to anyone paying close attention that creating the worldwide manufacturing unit was the main reason he took the job. And since putting the new WEA team together, Caparro has been on a granted leave of absence in order to pursue that goal. The industry, obviously, has changed its mind about how "unrealistic" or

"utopian" this idea is. When negotiations first started, Caparro was widely regarded as the frontrunner to win the contract. Then, Canadian manufacturing behemoth Cinram came into the picture to grab the inside track. But an 11th hour bid by Caparro had many of us believing again that he could still prevail. Why? Partly because we all wanted it to be true. But also because, it was his baby from the start and we all knew he was the guy that had the skills and the vision. It's hard to remember a time in the music business when everyone was pulling so hard for one man. People in the industry really wanted Caparro to pull it out in the final minutes, but it wasn't to be. So now that Cinram won the battle, what's next for Caparro? He has the widely respected John Esposito running WEA. Scott Pascucci is taking great care of Warner Strategic Marketing and ADA continues to prosper under the able leadership of Andy Allen. Is there a job left there big enough for the legendary icon? The decision is said to be his whether he stays on or not. And he tells us that he has yet to make up his mind. Is the probability of a Warner-BMG merger enough to spark his interest? He won't say. We just want to point out that the first definition of "visionary" is the appropriate one. Because, whether or not he closed this particular deal. you'd be hard-pressed to arque that Caparro hadn't seen the future. And we have every reason to believe that he'll see it again.


