Fogerty Is Creedence

Ex-Creedence leader **John Fogerty** was cleared by a S.F. federal court of plagiarizing himself. The six-member U.S. District Court ruled unanimously against **Saul Zantz** and Fantasy Records, the band's publishing copyright holders, which claimed Fogerty's solo single, "Old Man Down The Road" copied the melody of his former group's 1970 song, "Run Through The Jungle." "If you can't steal from yourself, who can you steal from?" said one panel member of the decision. "Besides, all of the guy's songs sound the same anyway." No word on whether Zantz will sue Fogerty on plagiarizing his son John's name.

In one of the most heated battles ever for the top spot on the *Hits* Top 50 Album chart, Island's **U2** narrowly edged out Elektra's **Anita Baker**. The margin of victory this week was less than one percent.

Don't expect the fireworks to end as Baker continues to pick up steam on the heels of her SRO tour, and U2 continues to gain massive exposure with a feature film that did close to \$4 million in its first week at the box office. Add to that the still-surging "Cocktail" soundtrack on Elektra, and you've got the set-up for some strong chart drama in the coming weeks.

Meanwhile, there are plenty of other hot spots on this week's Album Chart as Columbia's **Barbra Streisand** breaks into the Top Ten, exploding to #8, while WB's **Traveling Wilburys** jump from #28 to #12.

It's interesting to note that the Top Ten is now inhabited by four "Yuppie" or upper-demo projects: The aforementioned Baker, Streisand, Epic's **Luther Vandross** and Arista's **Kenny G.**, which hits this week at #9.

U2 BO Hums

U2's "Rattle and Hum" defied the conventional wisdom about rock movies by finishing second in total box office gross for its first week, taking in \$3.8 million. There is no truth to the rumor **Ted Turner** plans to colorize the film and re-release it.

Teach Your Children

David Crosby, **Stephen Stills** and **Neil Young** will join **Graham Nash** this Saturday at the Palace in Hollywood for a four-hour broadcast to raise money for UNICEF and other children's groups battling famine. **Jackson Browne**, **Robbie Robertson** and **Randy**

Newman will also perform for the radio concert, which will be carried nationally by 125 stations. M.C. Nash hopes to raise \$500,000 through telephone pledges. Sorry, no punchline here. Even we're not crass enough to make jokes about starving kids.

THE**BYRD****HAS****FLOWN**

Interview By Craig Modderno

Don't worry, David Crosby hasn't exactly joined Nancy Reagan's "Just Say No" campaign, but the former Byrds founder is a new man these days, drug-free and happily married to his long-time sweetheart Jan Dance. Crosby's past problems have been well-documented, but he lays open all the old wounds in his candid, often unflattering new autobiography, "Long Time Gone," co-authored with the Emmy-winning screenwriter Carl Gottlieb ("Jaws," "The Jerk"). The book masterfully describes the '60s L.A. sex, drugs and rock 'n' roll scene, which Crosby lived with a



gusto that landed him in a Texas jail, broke and near-death as a strung-out cocaine and heroin addict. With his own long-in-the-works solo album, "Oh Yes I Can," scheduled for release on A&M Records early next year and the brand-new Crosby, Stills, Nash and Young album, "American Dream," on Atlantic, the stocky singer-composer has a lot to be thankful for. The talented musician seems hungry once again to turn physical survival into songs of honest yet positive harmony. For Crosby's numerous friends and fans, it's been a long time coming.

How were you able to continue to make music while increasingly strung-out on drugs?

For a long time, I didn't write or sing any songs. So much for the drugs enhance creativity theory. Then I wrote "Compass," which is on "American Dream," and I began to think I could create again. I'm very critical of my work, so when I saw the lyrics to "Compass" were honest, I began to get excited about my music again. I wrote a song called "The Monkey And The Underdog" for my solo album that really details who I was and what I went through during this difficult time. It's my song about overcoming drugs. You know the tendency is to be very preachy while patting yourself on the head and telling everyone how great your life is now. You get up on a soapbox, sound like a fool and look stupider. This is a story song that we recorded live in the studio without overdubs. It's very difficult to write a song about recovering from being an addict.

In the book, you discuss how the anti-Vietnam war movement influenced the music of the times. What made you become a political activist back then?

It was a response to a repressive and unresponsive regime in the country when Richard Nixon was president. It's hard to understand America's involvement with drugs unless you understand the '60s. You put the music and the era in context and you'll understand why I became a visible political media guerilla. I wanted people to get a total picture of who I am, not just a self-serving portrait. That's why the book has interviews with other people and comments by others that are often not flattering.

One of those comments is made by David Geffen, your former manager, who says you were the least talented member of CSN&Y, a statement you don't refute in the book.

I think time and the public's opinion of me makes the best answer. By keeping that comment untouched in the book, I think it makes a specific statement about Geffen that stands on its own.

What are some of your best musical memories of the '60s?

I watched Buffalo Springfield blossom right in from of me from a bud into a flower. For a short period of time, including one performance at Big

Sur, I was a member of Buffalo Springfield. I actually replaced Neil Young. Stephen Stills and Young made that band. When Neil split, it was basically goodbye. But I don't think you would have seen either the Byrds or Buffalo Springfield if not for the Everly Brothers. The Everlys and the Beatles were the biggest musical influences on both those bands.

You describe Roger McGuinn as a musical genius, yet there always seemed to be a creative struggle between the two of you for control of the Byrds' sound.

It was mostly my young ego trying to peck its way out of the shell and spread its wings. I was just blossoming as a songwriter then. Make no mistake about it, though, Roger was the major talent in the Byrds. And he's still a major talent musically. It's a shame he doesn't have a recording contract now. When I think of the Byrds, I remember the good times, like when we were driving down the Sunset Strip in a black station wagon we bought from Odetta for six hundred dollars and suddenly, "Mr. Tambourine Man" comes on the radio. Bambo! Zappo! "Oh, my God, they're going to play it!" Fantastic. We're just happier than clams. And then KRLA played it again and again, back-to-back-to-back! We pulled the car over to the curb and hugged each other. It was heaven. The greatest rush anyone could ask for.

When did you realize the '60's were going to be a very special time?

First of all, we were

breaking out of the '50s, which was the dullest time on earth. There was an enormous change of cultural values going on out on the fringe. Musically, politically and sexually, I felt an excitement this country had never had before and sadly, hasn't had since then.

In the book, you come across as the rock musician who got laid more than anyone back then.

(Laughs) Ah, the legend looms larger. Those laurels fall to other hands. J.D. Souther and Don Henley actually surpassed everyone else with their sexual experiences back then. Listen, I tried to handle those situations delicately. God knows Joni Mitchell wasn't a role in the hay for me. She was a woman I was in love with. There was no attempt to sleaze anyone out with the book, and that's something I'm proud to say we accomplished. I am close friends with every girlfriend that I had during that time to this day.

Your best friend Graham Nash quickly began a romantic relationship with Joni Mitchell after yours ended. Was there ever any jealousy?

I can't see where you can get uptight about two people you love falling in love together. I was then in love with somebody else. Jealousy and possessiveness are really in another ballpark. It's a Tarzan type ego trip. (Pounds his chest) "Me a man! You're my woman!" To me, loving is giving. If Joni had gone off with a total sleazebag instead of a great guy like Graham,

you can bet I would have been hurt a lot.

When did the Byrds get psychedelized?

When we took acid! If you had to tag a date, it was between 1964-1966. "Eight Miles High" was definitely an acid-inspired song. McGuinn and I took acid together before we ever recorded "Mr. Tambourine Man." The first drug experiences I ever had were incredibly positive. Acid helped blow us

remembered to take his lighter fluid onstage to set his guitar on fire. The bottom line on Hendrix is that he played guitar better than anyone else in the world.

Is it true you wrote "Triad" about a sexual tryst with Grace Slick and Paul Kantner?

No. We were all good friends at the time, but I have never had sex with Grace Slick. Or Paul for that matter. We were like

loose from the '50s. I have no quibble with that. I think it was a great idea. It also takes your whole world view, throws it up for grabs and kind of rearranges it as it comes down. We needed a lot of changes quickly, and acid definitely helped us do that. I wouldn't recommend that people take it every day, but I certainly don't classify it with heroin or cocaine.

You wrote that Jimi Hendrix was high on acid for his legendary performance at Monterey Pop.

I saw him take two Purple Hazes. But you must remember, Jimi was a showman from the word go. Even though he was high that night, he

two brothers and a sister. People read that in it because Grace first recorded the song on "Crown Of Creation." I wrote the song about two girls in Los Angeles that I was having a relationship with at the time. Back then it was a lot of fun to be with two girls at the same time. Listen, the easiest way to get laid by a girl or get rid of her is to write a song about her. Stephen (Stills) wrote "Suite Judy Blue Eyes" for Judy Collins and "Dark Star" for Joan Baez. Stephen always had a definite thing for girl singers, but then, we all did!

At the Monterey Pop Festival, you talked about the conspiracy to kill JFK onstage during the Byrds

set. What did the rest of the band think of your theories?

They were upset because they didn't think I had any right to use the band as a political forum. I did it because it was a chance to put it out in front of a lot of people, make them uncomfortable and stir up trouble, which had always been one of my favorite things to do. Is there any question in your mind now that my conspiracy theory was correct? I knew my statements would get a lot of media attention at the time. I always felt that the media was not created for us, but instead it was created to sell things. If we care or want to try to stand up for any set of values at all, then we have to get some nuggets of truth in the stream. We have to use the media to effect change in the system.

In the book, you single out Paul McCartney as a gentleman and detail how kind he was to you when the Byrds first toured England, then you say you never really liked his attitude.

Paul was extremely kind to us then. He and John together had a wonderful effect on each other. John was too bitter, Paul was too lyrically sweet. The combination made bit-tersweet, which is a wonderful flavor. John without Paul was often acid-ton-gued. And not very fun. Paul without John was often too admiring of himself. Paul thought he was a star and there is no such thing. There are musicians and there are singers. Superstar is bullshit. It implies you're bigger than life and have the wisdom of the ages. That's Paul's attitude. He's still a major talent, though. I would have died to have written the songs Paul did. He and the rest of the Beatles were very exciting to hang out with when the band came to Los Angeles. The Beatles were a wonderful influence on the Byrds because of their music and the dry, humorous way they dealt with the press. We didn't have to introduce the Beatles to girls in Hollywood, either. They always seemed to be able to find them on their own.

What was it like to debut

CSN & Y in front of half a million at Woodstock?

We were actually more nervous about the people behind us, our peers, who were on-stage. You could only see the first forty rows anyway. I defy you to imagine half a million of anything in front of you.

Why has the CSN&Y output been so scanty up until "American Dream?"

There were definite problems. We tried putting it together a number of times. I'm not going to hang out our dirty laundry in the media. There have been problems in CSN&Y, and for a long time I was one of them. Neil has said one of the reasons he's now working with the band is because I'm clean and sober.

The four of you performed early in the day at the infamous Altamont Stones concert in 1969. Did you have any premonition that disaster would occur after you left the stage?

It was completely out of control. There was nobody in charge. It was absolutely destined for disaster. I got upset with the people who later criticized the role of the Hell's Angels as concert security. If you don't want the tiger to eat your lunch guests, then don't invite the tiger to lunch.

How would you describe "American Dream?"

There are a great many

issue-oriented songs on it, not just necessarily political stuff. That comes naturally to us. We are people with strong opinions and we're still strongly anti-war. Make no mistake about it. We don't like the covert actions the U.S. undertakes in other nations. I don't think we have any right to tell people around the world how to live their lives. That's what songs like "Night Of The Generals," "Soldiers Of Peace" and "Shadowland" are about. "This Old House" should make it very clear what we think about the farmer's plight and the title song tells about the Jim Bakkers and Jerry Falwells, who claim to be the moralists of America.

Will someone who hears your solo album begin to understand what your life in prison was like?

They'll get glimpses of it. It's very difficult to write songs like that without falling into self-pity.

With all that's happened to you, it's remarkable

you're still alive. To what do you attribute that survival instinct?

I can't tell you. I really came so close. I overdosed myself on heroin and did other self-destructive things like gunfights. I don't know anyone who took as many drugs as I did and is still alive. By sheer logic, there's no excuse for me being alive now. I guess making music is what's kept me going.



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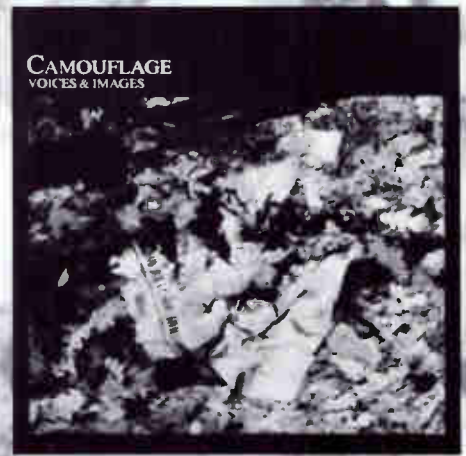

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Hot on the heels of a reputation as one of England's best live bands, the *Escape Club* are finally being given deserved exposure over here via their second album, "Wild Wild West," on *A&T*. The title track, its first single, is a Top 40 hit after much buzz as a *Hits* wildcard. The band (Trevor Steel, lead vocals, guitar; John Holliday, guitar, harmonica, backing vocals; Johnnie Christo, bass, backing vocals; and Milan Zekavica, drums) never saw its first album, "White Fields," released in this country but, now aided and abetted by stellar producer Chris Kimsey (Rolling Stones, Peter Frampton, *Psychadelic Furs*, Marianne Faithfull), they've impressed with their guitar-based style of pop-rock. Bassist Johnnie Christo recently spoke with *Hits*.

to America how great it is to listen to radio. The things you play over here are great. In England you're made to feel embarrassed about liking Deep Purple, Led Zeppelin and things like that. We've really had it with the music scene in England at the moment. It really is tough. There's no room for rock bands anymore. You have to be like Pet Shop Boys or something like that. I get disillusioned about that.

slot. And we're not like U2. Bono and Trevor Steel are two different guys who sing two different styles. I love U2. I think they're a wonderful band and I respect them. But we do not want to be put in their category. In England, they compare you with U2 if you're a "guitar band." We did this album "Wild Wild West" intentionally so that people, once they listen to it, would not think of us that way.

Your press bio calls you "an alternative to the rising tide of synthesized pop." Are you opposed to technopop dance music?

Sounds like you're trying to expand your musical boundaries on this elpee to include more dance-oriented material.

I understand this is your first trip over here. What are your impressions of America so far?

It's like a *Kojak* movie. I can't think of anything else except Telly Savalas sucking on a lollipop. And everything is so much bigger here—the buildings, the streets, the cars and even the flies. We were just having lunch at this restaurant and this huge fly landed on the table. One of the guys in the band went: "Whoa, look at the size of that thing!"

I'm not *against* it. It's great for a kid to be able to buy a keyboard nowadays, like a little sampler, and try making a record out of that. But there are people who've played guitars for years and done all the groundwork, and they're the guys, like us, who've found it really tough. There's no room to be a normal rock band. That was our biggest problem with our first album.

Yes, there are three or four dance tracks on the album along with the out-and-out rock tracks. We decided to use a drum machine on two or three cuts, had our drummer Milan play a trap kit over that end and we got Steve Scales from Tina Turner's band to play some percussion. He was wild.

What about musical impressions?

I've realized since coming over

How did producer Chris Kimsey get involved in the record?

We sent out lots of demos to producers. One was Chris Kimsey, who called us saying there was this one song he kept singing and humming, in the bathroom, everywhere, and he didn't know it was us. So he said he wanted to work with us. That song was "Standing on a Bridge," which isn't even on this album. It's on the back bumper at the moment.

Are you surprised at how well the album's doing?

We didn't think it would happen this quick, I must admit. I mean, five weeks in the charts, I'm in New York for the first time—it's a wonderful experience, the people are great. We've been so well received. It makes us feel we can go out and play, without having to apologize to anybody.

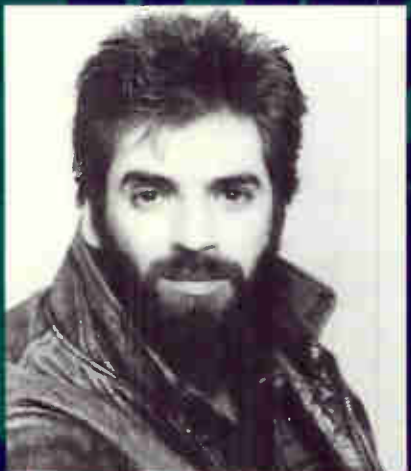

This native New Yorker literally grew up on the Top 40 sounds of WABC before moving to the left coast, where he began keeping track of the KHJ Top 30 charts and followed the station through its golden years from 1966. An avid record-keeper, Zapoleon compiled a list of his own Top 1000 songs and published it in *Circular Magazine*. With the recognition, he landed jobs at K-EARTH, then at KRLA as M.D. in '77. With a rep for picking the hits, Guy returned to K-EARTH, this time as M.D. before landing his first P.D. gig at KRQ in Tucson seven years ago. After a stint at B94 in Pittsburgh, Guy came to KZZP in Phoenix, where he brought the station to double-digit ratings for two and a half years. He is currently National P.D. for Nationwide Communications, Inc.



What are your plans at Nationwide?

I feel really good about all the people I'm working with and have worked with, including Bob Moody, who has handled several Eastern stations and of course, Bill Richards, who was Co-Group Director before him. We really did

from them— marketing, packaging— all the things which make a great station. I've also had the opportunity to work with such great people as John Coleman and Jerry Clifton. In working so closely with them, it has allowed us to really succeed in every market we've been in. Phoenix is such a competitive and heated up market right now, with two other fine Top 40's, that it was time for me to hire a great PD that could devote 100% of his time to KZZP. Bob Case was just the guy to take us to the next level. One of the things I'd like to do is recreate RKO when it was at its peak. Bill Drake was my idol for a long time and when he was national P.D., he did some fantastic things. I'd like to see Nationwide go in the same direction and improve on these ideas.

Will you miss working with just a single station?

Ya know what? Honestly, no. I am going to be here at KZZP, so I'll be able to share in some of the fun things. But it's funny, because a great many people ask me how I'm going to be able to handle not having my name on everything. I'm really not that kind of person. I remember when I was on the swim team in high school, I swam twice as hard when I swam with the team than by myself. I don't need to have my name out there to get recognition or to do a good job. Just helping people and getting in-

Nationwide stations into creating a powerful organization that will make all of us better.

Where do you see Top 40 radio headed? Can the new Post-Modern music make a dent?

When you watch music as I have for the last 25 years, you see things recycle. What is happening now is really like 1968. That year had the Supremes, it had rock product like Creedence Clearwater and even Marvin Gaye. Post-Modern music is really all the garage bands of 1968 that eventually developed into heavy metal or dance-oriented music. What you had were bands like the Electric Prunes, and the Standells, who were the forerunners of today's Post-Modern sound. All that danceable rock product is what Post-Modern is now. When I was at K-EARTH, I'd listen to KROQ and watch the Go-Go's and Blondie and all those people, praying all the while the audience would get into that sound because basically, I was tired of the wimpy stuff flooding the airwaves at the time. I was ecstatic. Thank God fun radio and fun music has come back into vogue.

So you feel there is room for all kinds of music at Top 40?

Absolutely. All it is is musical trends that went away for fifteen years because programmers thought, to get adults, you had to

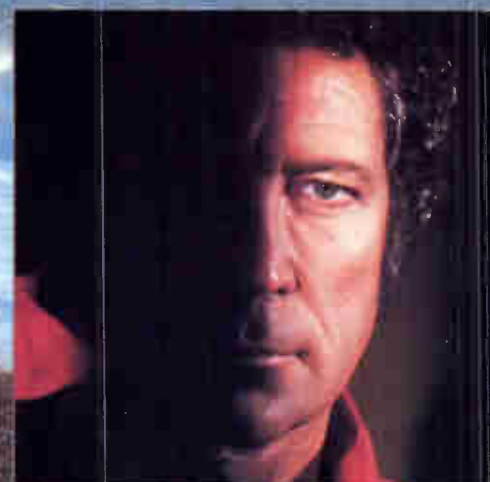
