The self-appointed censors are going to be working overtime on Geto Boy Bushwick Bill's new solo album, "Little Man" (Mix-A-Lot/Priority). whose first single, the lilting dub reggae hip-hop track "Ever So Clear," gives a blow-by-blow account of the night his girlfriend shot his eye out as he threatened to toss the woman's child out the window while high on the 110proof grain alcohol.

While the band's popularity has kept it in the Top Ten for centuries, the big move to the top slot is due to a number of factors. The new cut "Jeremy" features a moving clip that's making monster moves at MTV. And while we're on the subject of the channel, the band continues to ride the momentum caused by their "MTV Unplugged" appearance. And finally there's "Lollapalooza '92" — the tour that continues to sell out even when the guaranteed sell-out artists are that nothing's proving guaranteed. Under Milgrim's stewardship, Capitol Records has achieved two consecutive record sales years and the highest profits in 20 years, experiencing chart success with artists such as Hammer, Bonnie Raitt, Richard Marx. Megadeth, the **Beastie** Boys, Eric Johnson and others.

"Hale has consistently proven himself to be a savvy music executive and has led Capitol Records into a leadership position within the industry," commented EMI Music President/Chief Executive Officer Jim "Fe" Fifield "Fo Fum." Added Anderson: "Savage Records is truly an exciting opportunity that has not existed in the record industry for many years. Great music and great people is a formula for success. Keep your eye on us." (Translation: It was either this or play golf all day.)

Mimran and Anderson then announced the formation of the Savage Field promotional staff, with the appointment of the following regional directors: Walter Winnick (West), Bruce Brody (Northeast), Jim Davenport (Southeast), Bob Feinegle (Mid Central and Midwest), and Tony Williams (Southwest).



# MOST VAL-UABLE

An exclusive HITS interview with

Val Azzoli, Senior VP/GM, Atlantic Records

hen Val Azzoli began his music business career as the road manager of a friend's club band, he claimed to know so little about the music business, "I thought I was the band's manager." After realizing he didn't want to spend his life on the road, he helped found Toronto-based ATV Publishing, which scored a couple of successful covers, including Pat Benatar's version of "Hit Me With Your Best Shot." "We got lucky," says Azzoli humbly, "I learned this is an industry most people don't know anything about, but say they do."

After rising to President of the company, Azzoli realized he didn't want to spend his career in publishing, so he began working for Rush's management company SRO, and their in-house label, Anthem Records. When he came to New York to work for Cliff Burnstein and Peter Mensch, Azzoli had experience in almost every aspect of the music business except working for a major label. When Doug Morris offered him the opportunity to work at Atlantic Records, he jumped at the chance. Recently named Sr. VP/GM, Azzoli admits. "The record company was always the adversary, so it was a hard decision to make. But Doug Morris has always been very open and allows his people a great deal of autonomy.

For years as a manager, you're always saying, 'If [the label] were only doing this...'"

Now Assoli has his chance. Unfortunately for him, it also meant being pinned to the floor and held in a hammerlock by HITS' own pro wrestling superstar, the woman whose tongue is the second strongest muscle in her body, Joan Tarshis "And Feathered."

### You said people really don't know what music publishing is about. What is it about?

The subtleties of publishing are enormous; it's a very complex thing. As time goes on, people have become more sophisticated about it. If you were to say to the average artist who's just starting out, "Do you know anything about publishing?," they'll say, "Of course I do." Then if you ask them what it is, they'll say something like, "Well, if I write a song, I get some money somewhere along the line." But they don't understand the real asset is in owning the song's copyright. Owning a song is as important as owning a building. It's a concrete asset, one that can be parlayed into other things. They don't realize the different ways to receive revenue and cultivate that asset exploiting it without killing it. They don't appreciate the value of that asset... or how to use it for other means.

### Like placing a song in a TV commercial?

I learned certain things from the way ATV Music Publishing handled the Beatles' catalogue. For years, companies wanted to use Beatles' songs as commercials — "Michelle" perfume," Yesterday" funeral parlors, etc. — and they kept saying, "No, no, no." I realized, by letting it be used that way, it would ruin the song. The beauty of "Michelle" would forever be gone when it was put on a perfume bottle. If people offer you \$100,000 for something and you take it, you don't realize this asset can make as much

money 10-20-50 years from now. There are many great songs that are generating huge amounts of money. "Yesterday" alone has been covered over 500-600 times. I had no idea there were such things as performance royalties, mechanical royalties, synchronization royalties, one-off royalties, sheet music royalties. Of course, publishing is going through

its own evolution. It was not glamorous, so no one really cared about it. It lent itself to a lot of sleazy characters, because hardly anybody knew how it worked.

#### Let's talk about your current label. Atlantic Records has such a rich musical heritage.

It certainly does, from jazz to R&B to pop, but people always fail to realize that Atlantic really catapulted into the major leagues with the British Invasion — bands like Led Zeppelin, AC/DC, Genesis, Yes and Emerson, Lake and Palmer. That's in addition to the heritage of Bobby Darin, Ray Charles and Aretha Franklin.

Atlantic has always done well, but the music business has changed dramatically and we had to change along with it. Marketing, selling, merchandising and promoting records have all evolved. Radio and retail are not what they used to be.

Music is a reflection of the times. In order for Atlantic to thrive in the '90s, we, as a company, had to streamline ourselves and be more street-conscious. We had to be less promotion-oriented and more marketing-oriented, to be A&R driven again, and more cognizant of

developing new acts from the ground up. Just as the music was coming from the street up when Atlantic signed Led Zeppelin and Genesis — who were really left of center at the time.

How have you begun to do that? It's apparent that Doug Morris was aware of all this when he started up Atco/EastWest, and began distributing Interscope, Third Stone, makes sure all the support systems are in place when a band comes through town. We have a check list of all the stores that should carry this type of music and go through it, asking, "Is the record in all the stores? Are the posters in all the stores? What are the interviews the band is going to do while in town?" These are all fundamental questions you'd think would get answered, but they don't. I was always the one who used to do this. I used to tell

A Vision, Big Beat, Delicious Vinyl, Mammoth, Rhino, etc. These are great sources of A&R because you bring creative people together. But we had to restructure the company to accomodate this new kind of music and this new climate. Basically, we streamlined the label so that it could react more quickly to situations as they came up.

## How are your actions now influenced by having been a manager?

Every manager and every band has the same beef. I could never understand why I would go into a city — and this is from working with groups as big as Rush to as little as a touring club band — and the records weren't in the stores, the posters weren't in the stores and nobody was there to do an interview.

The record companies want to do the best job they can because they're in the business of selling records, but things do fall by the wayside. Rush made it by selling records from gig to gig. Gigging has been and will continue to be the most important tool in selling records.

So when I got here, we started a tour development department, which

the local guy, "I'm getting off the plane at noon and these are the record stores I'm going to visit. At least have the records and posters up when I'm there." Sometimes I would show up, sometimes I wouldn't, but at least I knew I would have a poster or a window display up for that day.

### What exactly does your "progressive marketing department" do?

They phone mom-and-pop stores to make sure the records are stocked, that the posters are there and so on. When new product arrives, they discuss it. These stores aren't plugged into the main distributors; they go through the one-stops. Since they're once removed, our progressive marketing department is trying to get them closer to us. We find if the records in there are selling and, if they're not, which ones aren't... that kind of stuff. We give them tickets when our major bands come in town, just to get them into the loop. Because these stores are where the new music is coming from; it isn't coming out of a mall in New Jersey. The malls may sell volume, but it's these momand-pop accounts that are breaking the acts.

### How does your approach differ from what marketing used to be like at Atlantic?

It was more promotion-driven. If it was on the radio, they'd make sure things were being done in and around the radio station. The whole idea was, "If we can get it on the radio, people will come and buy it in the stores." Certainly that is true, but I also believe people will buy it in the stores if we do other things, like interviews, street marketing, word of mouth, instore play, selective television advertising, selective print advertising, etc. There are other ways of getting people into the stores. Mind you, radio is the easiest - and the hardest. Once you get it on, it's easy. The other approach is more like guerilla warfare — you're working real hard for every sale. But the good news is, with every sale, you've made a fan.

### What other departments have been revamped?

The creative services department was getting a little flat, so we revitalized it. We brought in Melanie Nissen from Virgin to run it. We all thought we needed a fresher, younger look in our retail and trade ads and she certainly has brought that into the fold. Imaging is very important. We also re-organized the promotion department to be more street-oriented. We also tried to deghettoize our various departments like alternative and metal so that they could work together and better communicate with one another.

### Has the music industry become too fragmented for its own good?

We're so caught up on having a title for stuff so we can pigeonhole it, shelve it and compartmentalize it. But it's important to remember, we all ride the same train together at the same time. As a full-service record label, Atlantic must be able to accomodate all types of music—from an R&B act to a country act to a rap act to an alternative act, doing a ballad, a hard track, or jazz. I think it's important we do it all by working together rather than in our own separate niches.

### The indie labels you are distributing have given you an even wider range.

Rhino is a purely musical marriage. We have a great repertoire and they know how to sell that type of repertoire. But the Mammoth, Delicious Vinyl and Big Beat deals have a three-fold purpose. One is the source of A&R — you can never have enough great A&R people — two, it's a breeding ground for a type of music that the mainstream hasn't accepted yet and three, it's

a way of developing people. The other thing that excites me is that these are all mavericks. They're finding new ways to break new ground. I'm learning from them.

### What's an average day like for Val Azzoli?

It starts at 6 in the morning. I get up, crawl out of bed and run and swear at every step I take. Then I jump in the car.

It won't work if it's not the right act.

You guys have distributed Luther

Campbell's records. What do you make
of the record censorship issue?

It's something that has to be addressed. You would have to be blind, dumb or deaf not to have come in contact with it in one form or another. We at Atlantic Records have been fortunate we haven't had to make too many of those serious decisions. Luther Campbell is nursery rhymes compared

rigging has been and will continue to be the most important tool in selling records

I shower in the car. I drive a Winnebago, It's a bitch parking in Manhattan. I basically listen to music or I'm on the phone. From 9:30 until I leave at 7:30 or 8:00, it's a continuation of meetings and phone calls. It's just crazy. A lot of people report to me. I'm a very people-oriented guy and I want to make sure that I get through to everybody and they can get through to me. It's a full day. The hardest thing in this position is being able to return all the calls. I get guiltridden if I don't. Then there's a lot of traveling to the various branches, seeing bands on the road, sales offices, branch offices, band manager's meetings.

### On another subject, what do you think of infomercials?

I think they're hysterical. Most of 'em are like religious preachers. I don't mean that facetiously. I do think they work. Of course, the next step is an infomercial with the President of the United States. (Ed. note: Isn't that what the party conventions are for?) It's just another way of marketing; the same way the talk show has become another way of marketing.

to some of the other stuff that's going on.

# The label has been taking an aggressive stance in marketing its rich back catalog, what with the Rhino deal and some elaborate box sets.

We were basically one of the pioneers of boxed sets with our Led Zeppelin package. It's the most successful boxed set ever and it's continuing to sell because what we do is take it off the market and put it back every Christmas. I think people want to know more about music. But the boxed sets, like everything else, have been bastardized. I've seen some that are just garbage. The consumer has to beware of some of them. We take our boxed sets very seriously. We are very sensitive to the artists when we do these things.





# Time for a cup of Joe and a doughnut with Gregg Alexander by Sean O'Neill



regg Alexander is an eccentric young man. And that may be the understatement of the year. A lunch with him goes something like this: First, he quizzes the waiter at length about almost every item on the menu (turns out he's a health food nut). Then he asks for a glass of tepid water and a pot of hot water (so he can blend the two if the glass of water is too cold). After his meal, he requests a small plate, produces an array of vitamins, crushes quite a few of them on the plate with a spoon, then scoops them up and ingests several spoonfuls, washing them down with just-warm-enough water. Clearly this guy doesn't spend much time at McDonald's.

11 regg Alexander's debut album, "Intoxifornication" (Epic), sounds like nothing you've heard before. And that may be the second understatement of the year. Its sound is difficult to describe, like an especially mercurial buzz or an exquisite session of lovemaking defy easy explanation. Suffice to say that "Intoxifornication" is unique among aural/oral experiences. Some will love it, some will hate it, but none will escape unscathed. Gregg Alexander may be seen by some as supremely twisted, but even he was plainly ill-prepared for a face-to-face with HITS' slap-happy deviate, the permanently penitent heavy metal miscreant, Sean "I've Been A Bad Boy, A Very Bad Boy, Will You Spank Me?" O'Neill.

#### How did you get signed?

It's a weird story. I recorded a bunch of obscure B-sides and album tracks from the first Culture Club album and everyone thought I wrote them. I played them for all these people and they loved them, and then I told them that I didn't want to record those songs because they were old and I didn't appreciate them anymore.

#### How do you write?

I've gotten really paranoid about my next-door neighbor. So what I do is, when I get ready to write, I turn on the

fan in my bathroom, you know — shhhhhhhhhhh — and then I go to my radio and set it to the edge of the dial at peak volume so it's like — zzzzzzzzzz. Then I turn on my electric shaver and place it by the window so, if my neighbors are listening, all they'll hear is my whole apartment buzzing with

Why are you so worried about your neighbors? Because they're part of the Lebanese underground.

Why would they care about your songs? I don't know. It's just become... I'm a really bad creature of habit. Once I start doing something, I can't get out of it. So when I write, I have to be surrounded by white noises. Literally. I'm not kidding. It's probably not a good quality to possess. But it's actually helped me write some good songs. Any other strange habits we should know about? I never answer the phone in my normal voice. I always answer like [high-pitched whine], "Hello." Or [low voice], "Hello." Or with an English accent. In case I don't want to talk to somebody. And I have a scarf that I carry with me

everywhere so I can open door handles with it and not touch germs. And when I go into clubs, I cover my face with the scarf so I don't have to breathe cigarette smoke. It does get to be a bit much. And when I go into the bathroom, you know how you wash your hands after you take a piss? No, I don't. I'm Irish.

Well anyway, when I'm done washing my hands, I grab paper towels to turn off the water faucets.

Yoù don't use paper towels to turn on the faucets?

No, because then I wash my hands. There is a system to my madness.

#### Even when you're drunk?


I'm like an insecure drunk. Like, if I had a fight with somebody or there's somebody who doesn't like me, or if somebody isn't nice to me and I've been nice to them, I'm the kind of person that, when I get drunk, I'll call them and be like [slurred], "Hi, it's me. What did I do to you? Why don't you like me? Aren't I nice?"

Have your parents heard the record?

They've only heard a few of the songs. They haven't heard the whole record. I think they're mildly amused by the title "Intoxifornication." I think they want to think of me as some sort of angel.

You could have titled it "Drunken Fuck." Exactly.

But if, like you said, you're an insecure drunk, that doesn't exactly lend itself to good sex. When I'm alone and drunk, that's when I call people up. I thought you were going to say, "When I'm alone and drunk, that's when I have good sex." No, usually when I'm drunk and I'm not alone, I'm insane. I'm really bad with that kind of stuff. I cause damage to things. I become... not violent towards other people, but violent towards objects. I break windows. I go around and play ding-dong ditch. And that's not a very safe thing to do in L.A.
