
#### APLA Committed

AIDS Project L.A.'s "Commitment To Life" benefit at the sold-out Universal Amphitheatre last Wednesday (18), which honored Barbra Streisand, David Geffen and L.A. Mayor Tom Bradley for their efforts in fighting the disease and providing care for people living with AIDS, raised \$3.9 million for the organization.

In addressing the audience, Streisand called for a boycott of Colorado in the wake of the state's passage of Amendment 2, a measure that prevents the adoption of legislation which protects gays and lesbians from discrimination. Since the election, several entertainment groups have announced an industry freezeout of the state.

The benefit was produced by Bernie Taupin and included performances by Streisand, Liza Minnelli, Elton John, Patti Austin, Lyle Lovett, Johnny Mathis, Aaron Neville, Wynonna Judd, Kenny Loggins, Billy Joel, Clint Black, Patti LaBelle, Natalie Cole and Eddie Van Halen, among others.

#### **Country King Mourned**

The Grand Ole Opry's King of Country Music, Hall of Famer **Roy Acuff**, died early Monday morning (23) of congestive heart failure at Baptist Hospital in Nashville, Tennessee at the age of 89.

A successful businessman, philosopher, singer, fiddler and flea market expert, Acuff was perhaps most famous for writing such country standards as "Wabash Cannonball" and "The Great Speckled Bird." He is survived by a daughter and a son, five grandchildren and five great grandchildren. "It's the strongest debut in months," screamed The Wherehouse's Violet Brown.

"It's our #1 seller," yelled Abbey Road One-Stop's Ron Simms. "I hope Priority can keep it in stock."

So what's all the screaming and yelling about? Simple... Ice Cube has returned.

In its first week on the street, the Priority album "The Predator" blew the competition away, debuting at #1 on the HITS Top 50 Albums chart.

"The tremendous amount of CDs we've sold indicates this goes well beyond the rap audience," noted John Rose of Western Merchandisers.

WELL beyond is an understatement. It would take far less space to list the national accounts *not* reporting massive sales for the project. Ice Cube is a bonafide pop artist.

Meanwhile, Arista's "Bodyguard" makes an impressive #2 debut behind a Whitney Houston personal record-breaking single which rockets to the top of the HITS Top 50 singles chart.

And if that's not enough to make the folks at 6 W. 57th St. smile, Arista's **Kenny G**. has a tremendous first week debuting at #7 on the HITS Top 50 Albums chart. In appreciation, Kenny sent us the spit from his sax.

#### Vast Wasteland

Gary Kurfirst, co-founder of MCA-distributed Radioactive Records, has launched Wasteland Records, a new independent label devoted to "embryonic" bands. Kurfirst, whose Radioactive roster includes the Ramones, Londonbeat and Live, formed the new imprint, to be distributed by Virgin subsidiary Caroline Records, as a grassroots company for bands "whose development needs to be nurtured at a slower pace." First act signed to the label is Dig. with a debut album scheduled for 2001. Kurfirst has named dead poet T.S. Eliot as its first executive officer.

The new label will seek to develop new video directors and record producers as well as artists. Kurfirst has previously managed the careers of Talking Heads, Eurythmics, Blondie, Deee-Lite, Big Audio Dynamite and the 1992 presidential campaign of George Bush.





#### **Butterfly's New Wings**

Steve Lewis, former Managing Director of Virgin Music's UK publishing company, has been appointed Managing Director and CEO of a new music division created by Chris Wright's Chrysalis Group, which signals the latter's re-emergence in the record business since he sold his interest in the Chrysalis label to EMI last year.

The new division will encompass an as-yet-unnamed label to start operating in the new year, together with all of Chrysalis Music Publishing's activities in the U.K., Europe

and North America; and the Chrysalis Group's interest in the Hit Label, the Speaking Book Company, Air Edel Associates and Wessex Studios. Lewis will retain his current interest in the Tuchwood Label, which he recently established with **Rob Melbourne**.

Commented Wright: "It was always my intention to rebuild Chrysalis Group's recording interests on the solid foundation of our music publishing and related activities. The only downside is now I have to start talking to you losers again."

Over 20% more young voters aged 18-24 voted in this year's election, an increase of more than 2 million over 1988, according to Rock The Vote, the non-partisan grass-roots voter registration organization. The 1992 election marks the first increase in voter participation among this age group since 18-year-olds first cast ballots in 1972. As of June 1992, Rock The Vote had influenced over 750,000 young

people from all 50 states to register, then over the summer, the voter registration drive netted an additional 300,000 eligible voters.

Of the new voters, 35% wrote in Bono for President, 30% opted for Eddie Vedder, 23% tapped Cindy Crawford, 7% went for Howard Stern, while just 5% pulled the lever for Clinton, Bush or Perot. Who said kids are dumb? Here's a rundown of this year's stats:

## WAYNE'S MORLD

An exclusive HITS interview with

WAYNE FORTE, Co-Founder, International Talent Group,

#### by JOAN TARSHIS

ayne Forte became a talent agent out of necessity. When his high school

band couldn't draw the proverbial flies, he instituted weekly "Battle of the Bands" shows which rocked the gymnasium. "I'd find the best three bands around town, then the next three and had playoffs to determine the winners," he recalled. "We made money, but my own groups never won!" When he mentioned the concerts being put on at his college weren't very good, he was challenged to do better. He did. And while he never planned on becoming an agent as a career, he did accept a job out of curiosity just to see if he liked it. He did. In 1981, after years of major and minor agency experiences, Forte founded International Talent Group with partner Michael Farrell, a fellow William Morris agent who Wayne describes as "the other odd man out over there." Today, as one of the most dynamic theatrical agencies around, ITG offers its clients a lot more than "just booking tours." In a unique department run by Marty Diamond, Forte uses complementary marketing strategies, along with old-fashioned PR, to target a band's earning potential around the country. With a client list that focuses on newer music such as Jesus Jones, PJ Harvey, the Cure, Joe Satriani and Shakespear's Sister, as well as more mainstream heavies like David Bowie, Genesis, Pink Floyd and Peter Gabriel, Forte insists the real secret to his agency's success is that he only works with artists whose music he likes to listen to himself. "After all," he laughs. "If I was a really good player myself, I wouldn't be here right now." ■ Which means he would have avoided this excruciating confrontation with HITS' resident Geisha of Erotic Shiatsu, Joan "Your Pain Is Her Pleasure" Tarshis. . . . . . . .

### When you walked away from William Morris, most of the roster followed you.

Many of the music acts which went with us were meaningful, but certainly they weren't as meaningful then as they are today. We took a great deal of the new, alternative stuff which they weren't particularly interested in anyway over there. Of course, then they all followed us. But everyone looks back and says, "Gee, you took all those big acts with you." But the ones that are big today weren't that big then.

### You were able to carve a niche out for yourself by staying involved with the music you loved.

At first people called them punk acts, then they were new wave, then they evolved into new music and now they've evolved into alternative and Post-Modern. We carved a niche just by being there, enjoying that style of music and knowing who was who and what was what with various different acts. We were committed to eventually developing them into major acts — even when 99.9% of our peers thought there was no shot. Even during the years when I chased after the Clash - peoplé thought I was out of my mind... until the third tour, that is.

### What was it like working with the Clash?

It was chaos. They went through three different tours with one manager and one tour with no manager. That's how they lived. It was part of their whole scene. At one time, I thought they could be the biggest act in the whole world. It was just a matter of timing and someone believing enough to develop them, especially at a time when they were going absolutely nowhere. I remember working one Clash tour where I had three radio stations in America playing them and then, six. But it developed. You just had to give it time.

How difficult is it to work a tour when the acts aren't getting radio airplay?

From 1981-'88, most of our roster consisted of acts that weren't getting airplay. Some exposure did start to develop on the alternative stations, but it was all a matter of getting a foot in on a consistent basis. To build momentum and develop a career when you weren't getting airplay was difficult... not that it's much easier when you are getting airplay. Once you're getting played on the radio and your records go gold and platinum, other problems crop up. That's when you get people who see a platinum record and say, "Let's put them in my venue and we'll sell

from most, if not all, of the other agencies is that we are marketing driven, musically driven, passionately driven and career driven. But everyone says that. In reality, when you go out to buy a car, every dealer says their car does the same thing. But people know, if they want an American highmarket car, to buy a Cadillac.

I wouldn't say I'm a sophisticated marketing consultant type because my approach is really from the gut, from the heart. People ask me what I'm going to do and I can't explain it to them... I just know I'm going to get a good result.

that's on the threshold of being signed to an indie label. They don't have a manager, but we've seen them and we like them. How did we see them? One of my guys saw them in a club. There's another group that we're involved with that's a little bit further ahead than that - so we've got two or three acts now that are way ahead of their time. We've got two acts from England signed right now that have no record deal. We're working with the manager to develop the act. Have you ever dropped an act from representation? Believe it or not, it's very

out." Of course, what happens when it doesn't sell out? Just because you sold a million records doesn't mean everyone likes your band.

What makes ITG different from other agencies?
Part of what differentiates us

Usually agents don't put themselves in the role of A&R types by actively searching out new talent. You're right, we are A&R guys. You have to be. Right now, we're in the middle of negotiating a deal with an act difficult to drop an act. I remember when I started in the agency business, I was sitting in a meeting with this old agent — he was probably as old as I am today! - and he said, "We've got to fire that act." And somebody else chimed in, "We did fire them, but they won't leave," adding, "Remember, the act can fire you, but you can never fire the act." It's true. They won't leave unless they want to. We've dropped a couple because of a management change and another act wanted to go to a smaller agency where they thought they could work more. But they weren't interested in development as much as they were their income.

We're usually in for the long haul. My partner has been involved with a few of his clients for 20 years. I've been involved with a number of my clients for over 10 and sometimes it takes seven or eight years before you crack them. That's a long commitment. We're in for a penny, we're in for a pound.

What's the average time it takes for a band to break? It took nine years with one to really crack - not just make progress. Making progress would have been after four or five, but really cracking took nine. You have to consider bands don't write an album every year like they used to in the old days. It's every other year, every two and half years. They don't tour every year. So nine years is really four or five tours, which is not that many. Have you written any

weird riders to

performance contracts? It depends on who's looking at them. If I took some of the riders home and showed them to my parents, they'd think they were off the wall. Over the years there have been some really weird ones. In the mid to late '70s, many of the UK bands were requesting vegetarian food. Some of the stuff was very weird for Americans, but not for the Brits. You always get one or two acts or a road manager that come up with something ridiculous. When they feel the promoters, the buyers or even the venues aren't paying attention, they might put something really strange on it.

There was an old story from the William Morris days about an agent who decided he was going to put something strange on the rider, so he listed 12 bottles of beer, a piano and a henway. Most of the promoters just signed the rider, sent it back and didn't ask. One guy calls back and says, "I've got a really strange question. What's a henway?" And the agent said, "Shit, I don't know... three or four pounds." How has the recession affected the touring market? The way the economy is, with every group I do business with, there is no 100% rule that applies. It's totally unpredictable. You have to pay that much more attention to what you're doing. You can't just scale down, because if you're overly cautious you can get killed just as easily.

What mistakes have you made in your career?

I didn't sign Nine Inch Nails—that was a big mistake. We were all into the band; I just felt, at that time, we couldn't give them the time or the attention. It was a mistake, but you know, if I was back there to do it over again, I would have done the same thing. I couldn't take them on, tap dance with one hand behind my back and hobble around pretending I was doing a good job—I just can't do that.

What has been your proudest achievement?

The Cure. We've been with them from the beginning, when they appeared before 200 people at Hurrah's in New York. Just having them on tour doing the business we did, selling the amount of records we've sold and hearing people fight over which station will play the single first... all for a band no one wanted to hear about. No one played them, because everyone thought they were terrible. Nobody was interested in them in those

days. They went through three, four, maybe five record labels in this country, so you want to talk about rejection. But their manager stayed straight ahead on it and I stayed straight ahead on it. Depeche Mode was another band nobody cared about and look what happened with them.

Is packaging several different headliners into one show an answer to the current touring doldrums? Whenever there's a recession, everyone gets real nervous and feels we have to package. I keep reading in the trades packaging's the answer. But it's not the answer. People don't want to see a whole load of crap any more than they want to see one piece of crap. They want to see what they want to see. They want to see what's interesing. They want to see what somebody's told them about. They want to see what they've heard about. Packaging is one answer but not the answer. You can't just throw things together haphazardly. Putting a line-up together that's interesting still takes some creativity.

What did you think about Lollapalooza?

Lollapalooza had some interesting aspects, but what it was selling was the volume. And in a recession, yes, volume does work. But two or three acts isn't volume. They're selling seven acts for a little more than

the regular price of a concert and it's a full day's event. The kids go because they can hang out for the day and do whatever they want to do. That's a good concept. And the acts are put together creatively.

Now everyone wants to do a Lollapalooza. Well, it just doesn't happen that way. You don't just put three, four or five acts together. You've got to be creative. People aren't gonna buy it any faster than they buy anything else. l was at a Lollapalooza recently and half the kids were passed out. They were sound asleep with blankets over their heads. They certainly weren't there to see the music. They paid just to hang out for the day. And years from now, there will be hundreds of thousands of kids who'll say they were there. Like Woostock. I've met more people who said they were there, than were there. I admit on tape to the world and the music industry that I wasn't there. I'm the only one who wasn't there. I was on the highway, there was a small hold-up and I turned around and went home. We heard on the radio that traffic was backed up for miles and we said, we're going home. We stayed up all night pretending we were there by playing records. Real records, the vinyl kind, with the holes in 'em.

# Feelthe Power

An exclusive HITS radio dialogue with

### Frank Walsh, PD PWR96, Miami, FL

This New Jersey-born broadcast vet's been in the business 17 years and is currently celebrating the equivalent of a decade at 96 on the dial in Miami... in one form or another. Walsh started out in the city back in '75 at 96X, programmed at the time by current PWR96 consultant lerry Clifton. He worked there through the '70s when it was known as Disco96, then segued to San Antonio to program KITY and KTFM with Kid Curry. He returned to the City of Vice and Oranges, where he's been for the last five years at PWR96, working with such radioslingers as Clifton, Bill Tanner, Steve Rivers, Lee Logan, Robert W. Walker, Mark Driscoll and Joel Denver (who?). Your guess is as good as ours as to where HITS' resident Republican and Texas shorthorn, Todd "Cold Rod" Hensley, fits in.

### What did you do when you first heard about Hurricane Andrew?

We first took care of the station by getting a few people to commit to seeing it through, working the phones and such. Hurricanes have been through here before, but never anything really serious so you almost take them for granted. We knew it was coming, but there was no way we, or anyone else, could have been prepared for what happened. When the eye came through, we were knocked off the air for 36 hours. Only a handful of stations stayed on the air. Some stations were off for over a week because there towers were knocked down. A third of the city is totally devastated, another third received heavy damage and the rest at least partial damage. It affected everyone in South Florida.

### What have you done since?

When we realized the extent of the damage, we got involved in having people drop off food, clothing, etc., using the station as a drop-off point, then caravaned with the station limos, vans and employee trucks to south Dade county to deliver everything. We did that for about two weeks. We are still involved. We announce jobs that are available on the air and try to place people. We were involved with the Gloria Estefan concert and our own Hurricane Relief concert a couple of weeks ago drew over 10,000 people and all the money went to the relief fund.

### How has it affected you from a programming standpoint?

Many of the areas hit were hot zip codes for our station. A lot of people moved out of the area, some as far away as Boca Raton. There are a great many people displaced into all parts of the city and surrounding counties. You cannot find an available apartment in Dade County and even hotels are hard to come by. Some of the communities where we — and other stations I'm sure — were strongest simply don't exist anymore.

We have been on the streets more than ever. We have to find our audience and let them know we're still here. For entertainment as well as relief efforts.

### How do you feel about the Arbitron ratings in the wake of the disaster?

I don't think they should have come out. If you look, there are stations that just simulcasted TV signals and went up a total of three full shares. Many stations were off the air for almost a week and were really hurt by the hurricane. The ratings were not an accurate reflection of radio in southern Florida. Arbitron told the press the

hurricane only slightly affected the book. We have counted the share points, and that's just not true. At least it was the Summer book rather than the Spring or Fall.

PWR96 has a 50% hispanic audience and, as I mentioned, many of these people have been displaced or have moved out of the area altogether. So far, we have not received a statement from Arbitron as to how they're going to handle this for the Fall book.

### What have you learned from all this?

Over the past year, I dealt with a great deal in terms of programming the station. There was a lot going on besides just radio. When I first got the programming job, there were several problems involving members of the staff. Bottom line is, if you have a team of dedicated, loyal employees, then you can get over any crisis. I knew we had good people that were hard workers, but it took dedication on their part because we had to band together. We really have a family here. You hear that a lot, but it has proven true at PWR96. We have dedicated people who not only love radio, but support me and the ownership. We could not have maintained the entertainment and energy level of this station if it had not been for them. We have kept the highest cume in the history of South Florida over this past year even through the various personal crises we've faced. I am very proud of that.

### Anything else you'd like to say?

There are many stations that have changed format or direction, but PWR96 has maintained the course we've been on for the past five years and continued to be successful. In an industry where change is so dominant, I am proud of the stability of the PWR96 staff and format. I hope these stations that change are doing it because the market is asking for that change and not just because other stations are making the same change. I have no problem with change... as long as it is for the right reasons.



Ween, "Pure Guava" (Elektra): I used to think only artists like the Grateful Dead, Frank Zappa, and Syd Barrett could truly capture bohemic lifestyle and somehow make it enjoyable and addictive music to listen to. Ween have put another notch in that belt of obscurity that they simply think of as

life. Their third psychedelic tapestry is a large hodge-podge of experiences and situations bravely put together by a label who want the masses to embrace life with a grain of salt and a beer and bong close by. Long Live Commune Rock! (MC)

Rage Against The Machine, "Rage Against The Machine" (Epic): The self-titled debut by this Los Angeles based band shows a range of influences from the "Bad Brains to Malcolm X, from Minor Threat to Martin Luther King, Jr...." whipped into a merciless



and unyielding consolidation of punk rage against the machine rock and metal. Co-produced (with the band) by Garth Richardson (Chili Peppers and Ozzy), the songs "rage" against a socio-political machine, as well as technology, creating a rawsome sonic boom not intended for the weak of spirit. Black 47, "EP" (SBK/ERG): On a blustery night in NYC you can wander into a pub called Paddy Reilly's and watch the walls sweat and the floors creak from a band of Irish ex-patriots called Black 47, named after the most treacherous year of the potato famine. Produced by Ric Ocasek, songs such as

"Funky Ceili" and "Black 47" evoke the finest moments of the Boomtown Rats and Dexy's, with a decidedly borough-cratic (as in the Bronx) bent. Although decidedly political, the experiences are remarkably universal. Fiddleeee indeed.



Recently I talked to my main man Mike Payne of WJMO-AM/Cleveland (Ed. note: He brought J.J. into radio before he was old enough to know better). Naturally, the conversation turned to radio and jocks. The rhetorical question, "What makes a good radio announcer?," came up and he offered these three virtues: Dependability, good attitude and performance. While the three are inextricably connected, let's talk about them one at a time. This week: Dependability. This has to do with not only showing up on time where you're supposed to be, but what you do when you get there. Can the PD/GM/station depend on you to keep the logs properly? Did you look for that copy or cart before you crossed it off? Was your descrep clear and thorough or cryptic and

opinionated? When you're called upon to show up at a client's location for a remote, can you be depended upon to arrive appropriately attired and to put forth that wonderful personality you're known for on the radio? What about following station rules? If unauthorized studio visits, and/or extended personal phone talks are prohibited while on the air can they depend on you to keep the rule? As a PD, my favorite jocks to work with were those to whom I could hand an instruction and walk away. Inasmuch as even dependable people screw up sometimes, I naturally kept my eye on things, but some people I watched over more than others. Those people were a drag, talent notwithstanding. Next week: Attitude. Later.




