





Brooks Foundation Established

Friends and associates of the late CAA talent and booking agent Bobby Brooks, who died in a 1990 helicopter crash, have officially set up a charitable organization in his name dedicated to fighting illiteracy and heightening the awareness of problems in the American educational system.

The Bobby Brooks Foundation was first established in 1991 when MCA and Nintendo turned the compilation album, "White-Knuckle Scorin" into a Brooks tribute, with all royalties donated to the organization. To date, the Foundation has raised \$125,000, with the first recipient of a grant being Cities In Schools, a national educational program providing much-needed resources to students and schools across the country.

The Foundation's first fund-raising event will be a music industry party on March 29, the night of the Academy Awards, to be held at CAA. Tickets are \$75 a person, with all proceeds going to the Foundation.

The RIAA has announced record figures for 1992 year-end shipment and dollar values. According to the industry trade group, the U.S. sound recording market grew over 15 percent to \$9 billion, based on the shipment of 895.5 million units of records, tapes, CDs and music videos.

Of course, no one gives a rat's ass about what the RIAA has to say, but it was a slow week and we needed something to fill this space.

According to RIAA Prexy Jason Berman, "Consumer demand for our product in the second half of 1992, particularly during the holiday season, took us well beyond our expectations." Jay then bootlegged a Guns 'N Roses cassette and sold it to a delivery guy for \$4.99.

Overall dollar values jumped from 1991's \$7.8 billion to \$9 billion. Every configuration, with the exception of the LP and eight-track, experienced an increase.

Overall unit shipments rose 11.8 percent over 1991 to a total of 895.5 million units.

Compact Disc sales increased 22.3 percent. With CD players in 42 percent of homes, future growth is likely. Cassettes rose 3.2 percent while music videos rose 24.5 percent.

The Great Mr. B Passes


Groundbreaking vocalist/bandleader Billy Eckstine, one of the dominant innovators of pop music and jazz in the '40s and '50s, died Monday (8) in his native Pittsburgh at 78 of complications from a stroke suffered last year.

Eckstine is credited with being the first black pop singer to "cross over" beyond the "race" market to appeal to audiences of all colors around the world, inspiring the likes of the late Nat King Cole and his own discovery, Sarah Vaughan. He is also acknowledged as one of the most important bandleaders of the early bebop era, launching the careers of such artists as Charlie Parker, Dizzy Gille-

spie, Miles Davis, Dexter Gordon, Fats Navarro, Gene Ammons and Art Blakey.

When he began recording for MGM in 1947, he became the first black singer to record for a mainstream white-owned label, and immediately landed on the charts with hits like "Fools Rush In" and "Everything I Have Is Yours." He went on to record with RCA Victor, Roulette, Mercury, Motown and Stax.

Of the seven children who survive him, several make their living in the music business: Son Ed is President of Mercury Records and Guy is Director of A&R at Verve.



Def American act the Black Crowes cut short a sold-out concert Sunday night (7) at the Gardens in Louisville, KY, when three undercover cops assaulted Kevin Wegman, who handles all merchandising for the tour.

Claiming to be undercover narcotics officers, the three stormed the backstage area and, according to eyewitnesses, brutally whipped Wegman, who was taken to a local hospital suffering extensive lacerations around his head and face. He was released into police custody and, amazingly, charged with assault, obstructing justice, resisting arrest and interfering with police activities, as was the band's director of security, Raul Flores. The group, who had just finished their first number. were told of the circumstances and left the stage to make sure the battered Wegman, whose condition they witnessed from the stage. was properly attended to.





An exclusive HITS interview with Ice Cube

Ice Cube's Street Knowledge production offices are a block from the flashpoint of last spring's L.A. riots in the Crenshaw 'hood where he grew up and still lives. The 24year-old rapper, born O'Shea Jackson, is perceived by many as a racist anti-Semite, but no one can denu albums such as "Amerikka's Most Wanted," "Death Certificate" and his latest, "The Predator," accurately articulate the rage his community felt both leading up to and in the wake of that violence. And it's not just his own people who are responding to Ice Cube -



proving there are a lot of white kids in the suburbs who are digging his beats also, if not their

underlying message.

As the self-described "Nigga You Love to Hate," Ice Cube has cultivated that angry image, from his days in Compton's groundbreaking rap group N.W.A., through three best-selling albums and an EP on Priority Records, the label which added yet another Ice to its stable in the equally controversial T. These days, Cube, now married with a young son, admits he's no longer angry 24 hours a day. Songs like the current single, the sweet-tempered "It Was A Good Day," where he imagines the Lakers beating Seattle while he scores a "triple-double," show the lighter side of Ice, even as they exist alongside tracks such as "We Had To Tear This M.F. Up" and "Who Got The Camera." which insist that the conditions which led to last year's uprising still exist.

In person, one can't help but be impressed by Ice Cube's inquisitive mind and unflinching commitment to the betterment of his people, even if you don't always agree with him. HITS' very pale Sr. Editor Roy "The Hebe You Love To Hate" Trakin ventured a tripto South Central to attempt to break the Ice... and didn't even get a free lunch.



How's the Street Knowledge label doing?

We just got a gold album for Da Lench Mob. We've got a guy named Kam up next. Being head of a label can be fun at times. But it's just work, know what I'm saying? You gotta deal with a lot of people, a lot of different egos, but it's pretty much cool. As far as getting really deep, hands dirty into the business, Pat Charbonnet,

my partner and manager, takes the bulk of that. But we all make the decions on what's gonna happen. I try to stay on

the creative side, because I believe I have an ear for the music. I know what I want to hear.

"The Produtor" made history by

debuting #1 on both the pop and R&B charts. Considering your message, are you surprised at how many white fans you have?

I'm not surprised because the truth has no color. I believe I'm dealing with a generation of young rebels who don't believe in what their ancestors did to my ancestors. And don't agree with what's going on now. America is as good as its best American and as bad as its worst American. I think this generation understands that. If black people are living in poverty and are hurting in America, then America is gonna hurt. When you have someone living below the poverty level, they're going to be looking for money, which results in crime. It just snowballs and these kids are aware of that.

Your records and movies by filmmakers like Spike Lee, Matty Rich and John Singleton have gone a long way towards giving us a glimpse of a world white America doesn't ordinarily get a chance to see.

Black kids who listen to my records sometimes don't have a clear view of things. Take a football game. The quarterback on the field should be able to see everything, but he has to call up to the booth sometimes to really see what's going on. By being able to travel and see certain things, I can take that position of being in the booth and telling them what's really going on. I think white America appreciates being able to eavesdrop on this conversation.

Hasn't gangsta rap been co-opted and turned into a more style by capitalist America? Are attitudes really being changed?

Well there's no way to monitor that. You do something so much, you really want to get deep into it. Take "The Cosby Show." Was America ready to see a black upper-middle-class family in that light? Was it just a fad? No, because now you have shows like "Different World" coming up. America's able to see that and accept that.

It's important then that different images of black life get filtered through the mass media?

Just like you got a "Malcolm X" and a "Boyz N' the Hood," you should have a film like "Boomerang." Black people are just like everybody else.

The last record, "Death Certificate," came out before the riots and prefigured much of the tension which led to them. "The Predator" was very much influenced by what happened and offers perhaps a bit more hope.

Some of the songs on "The Predator" were written before the uprising, some after. I think the L.A. riot was a good statement.

Even though it resulted in the destruction of your own neighborhoods?

"<u>l think</u> the L.A. riot was a good statement."

You can't destroy what you don't own. Technically, yeah, I may live next door to the market, but if I don't own the market, I have no love for it. It's kinda like the police who work in our neighborhood. but live in Palisades. They

don't give a fuck about what happens in our neighborhood. America doesn't respect picket signs or letters. It has to be a show of force because that's the way she deals with her differences. So we definitely got their attention; now, we have a certain respect. Because when you shut down L.A. for three days, that's a lot of money being lost.

As far as the new record, I spoke a lot about it because it just shows we have a long way to go. I wasn't afraid to say what I felt because that's my gut feeling. If we could put a lot of people's gut feelings on record, that's what it's about.

How do you maintain your anger when you are living out the American Dream yourself?

It's no fun if you're the only one. If I tell my friends, "Yo, let's fly to Vegas and kick it," and

they can't do it, 'cause they don't have the money, what good is that? How does having a wife, a young child and something to protect affect a self-described "produtor"?

I can keep the same feelings because now I'm not just looking out for myself. I'm not just trying to better things for O'Shea, but O'Shea Jr. That gives me more, not rage, but incentive, to come to some understanding, because my kid has to live in this society. And he's gonna have children. My seed is out there. I have to make it better for him. He gives me more focus than if I were doing this for myself. I can't die because I have a responsibility to my family.

Isn't the conflict in America more a class issue than a race issue? It's the rich who are pitting the races against one another.

It's a mixture of both. Middleclass whites are finding themselves in the same boat as blacks these days. But once they're at the same level, you'll see conflict, stuff like, "Well, he's trying to get my job." Everyone in America has to realize it's us against them. Black people have never made it into a race thing. We've never wanted to harm whites. We do more harm to ourselves than any other race on the planet. That's never been our agenda. Whether it's a race or class thing is up to white America.

As a member of the Nation of Islam, what's your feeling on Malcolm X?

High officials in the Nation tell me

N.W.A. to where I am now."

the government infiltrated the organization and had Malcolm killed. The Nation of Islam is not afraid of nothing but almighty Allah. The government had black agents spitting in Malcolm's ear that Elijah Muhammed was getting all the glory, and that he was really the Nation of Islam and should start his own thing. That caused a

degree of envy and jealousy, so Malcolm broke away from the Nation. Ultimately, Malcolm fell in love with the cameras and the crowds. Since he was a better speaker than Elijah Muhammed, he was able to get the people all fired up. You can look on the student as a great man, but he can never surpass the teacher. But it goes against the laws of Islam for one Muslim to kill another. The government framed the Nation of Islam for Malcolm's murder. But no one will ever know the true story behind Malcolm's death because so much confusion has been created around it. Malcolm is still loved throughout the Nation of Islam. The government played us off against each other.

Are you still as paranoid about the government since Clinton has taken office?

Hell, yeah. I wouldn't be surprised if there was a bug in here. I believe, when it's my time to go, I'll go. I don't put nothin' past this government. I'm speakin' the truth. I know they definitely have a file on people like me, Chuck D., Spike Lee, John Singleton... anyone that has influence over the masses. Because the powers-that-be believe the masses are sheep to be herded. And they're looking out for any person that's puttin' somethin' in their ear.

There's a poignant moment at the end of "Boyz N' The Hood" where your character Doughboy has this look in his face like he knows he's not long for this world, then he turns around and fades from the screen. Is that the way you feel?

I hope to live to an old age. I believe, for black America to survive, we need people to stand up. Not just one person, but a lot of people. We need ordinary fathers to stand up; we need everybody to stand up. You can kill me, but you can't kill my ideas. You can't kill the truth. Truth, equality and justice are infinite. I receive the energy from Malcolm X, from Nat Turner, from Marcus Garvey, from the honorable Elijah Muhammed, from Louis Farrakhan. And if I die, someone down the line will receive my energy. With freedom, you must have bloodshed. When a mother lies down to have a baby, there's blood.

Will there be a race war in this country?

"THE POWERS— that-be believe the masses are sheep to be herded."

Let me tell you this.
America is pregnant
with the black community. And we're eight
and a half months into
it. Either we're going
to be given land —
which we definitely
deserve — they're
going to let us go or
kill us all. But something is going to happen. It's like a wall
with constant water

pressure... it's eventually gonna break.

Is that what you'd like to see a separate homeland for African-Americans?

Yeah, I believe in it because it's hard for a black man to live in this system because it's so tilted against him. The people that make the laws created loopholes just in case they might fall under them. I like them laws in Turkey. You steal something, you get your hand cut

off. There's no question... black, white, Chinese. You do this, you know the consequences. And look at the crime rate over there as compared to over here. The laws here should be the same for everybody, but they're not.

Where do you see your own music going?

"Amerikkka's Most Wanted" and "Death Certificate" had definite concepts, but with "The Predator," I didn't want to pin myself down to a certain structure. I wanted to do what I felt. If I wanted to do "When Will They Shoot?," I did it. If I want-

ed to do "It Was A Good Day," I did it. I just did some jams, put 'em together and called it "The Predator." Musically, I always use new guys. None of my producers have any seniority and that keeps them on their toes. If I just met you and you gave me a tape with good beats on it, I would use 'em. And I always seem to come up with a good, solid record.

I loved the direction of "It Was A Good Day." It shows a whole other, more human side of Ice Cube.

I don't want anybody to ever expect what I'm gonna do. To be honest, shit, I'm not mad 24 hours a day. I just want to be real sincere with my records. If I can talk about the bad things that happen, why shouldn't I be able to talk about the good things that happen? And still get the same respect.

"Gangsta's Fairytale 2" makes an interesting point that the stories you tell your kids are just as violent as any of the modern urban fairytales that are on an Ice Cube record.

So why can't we live happily ever after? How do you feel about the reluctance of labels to put out artists like Paris and Ice-T?

It won't make a difference. It's like talking or singing. It can't be stopped. Someone will put out the record. If they want it, they gonna get it. If Ice Cube has to record an album himself and run it off on 400 dubbing machines all day and all night, it will get out there. And we'll get that money without a middleman. They don't want to do that, believe me, so I'm not really threatened by that.

Do you feel you've glorified the gangsta lifestyle as a role model to young kids, while the real Ice Cube is a pragmatic businessman with a family to feed and an organization that depends on him?

Not at all. Let me tell you this. Gangs existed before rap music and they'll continue to exist. When I first started, my focus was to be a gangsta rapper. But now I'm more political. It's not all about gangsta this or "I shot this

nigga." To tell black kids not to organize is crazy. And a gang is nothing but an organization. It's just the things that they do. My records are speaking to our people with an understanding of that lifestyle. That way, I get more listeners, more people paying attention and taking my message to heart, rather than if I were in a suit and tie and said, "I'm Ice Cube and I know where you're coming from."

But you are trying to teach them about where they come from.

It's like a process. You can't feed a baby steak. I've definitely grown from my days in N.W.A. to where I am now. I'd never say some of the things I said on those records now. Because I have more of a knowledge of who I am and where we need to go as a people. It's like feeding a baby. You have to distract them first. And pretty soon, you don't have to go through all that; you don't have to play all those games. We're starting to slowly but surely come to the point where we can just feed them the information straight. ■





you're drunk, you don't write anything any good anyway. It's something that brings me close to my emotions, because I'm pretty inhibited in a lot of respects. And it's important far me to get rid of that stuff, liberate it, although there's a big difference between a bottle of wine and a bottle of whiskey. A few vears back. I used to drink a lot, but I don't now, and the song is about hedonistic activities I've indulged in in the past. You have to learn lessons when that happens. I hear the word 'she' poppin' up a lot on the record.

up a lot on the record.

It sounds like it might be a metaphor for something bigger than a girlfriend.

Those songs are about relationships I've had. All of the stuff I write about is personal experience, situations I've gone through, and I'm very romantic when it comes down to it. But I try to make so-called love songs a bit different than, "Hey, baby, I need your lovin' and if I don't get it I'm gonna cry a lot," you know, the Lionel Ritchie side of things. I steer dear of all

those horrible clichés, so what you

hear is what you get. But there are other tracks, like "Dream Machine," which is about a liberating experience, the whole idea of breaking through to the other side. How do you mean? It's just that spirit that's inside all of us, the thing that wants to come out and break through all the barriers of being human. The little boy in all of us that wants to play. To me, the whole syndrome — the mortgage, the kids and the wife — is like a great big cage around you. I simply can't relate to it, and it never struck me as being very honest. I can't help thinking, for example, that a lot of people get married for security reasons — it's like, "Oh, I'm at a certain age now. Better settle down." It's interesting that you called the album 'Foolish Thing Desire," since desire motivates a good deal of what the human animal does. Probably everything it does. But I mean that line in a literal sense – desire is a foolish thing according to Buddhist philosophy. One of the things they say is, you must get rid of all desire in order to become enlightened, and desire has actually fucked up a lot of things for me in the past. And that's desire in a physical, carnal sense. I'm very interested in the Buddhist philosophy, but being a Westerner, it's very difficult to actually practice it. So you've never

TIME FOR SOME COLD TURKEY AND SATORI WITH DANIEL ASH BY TOM LANHAM

I'm trying to get rid of the intellect and do something that's very raw and true, declares Daniel Ash, the raccoon-eyed tousle-top who's set countless death-rock hearts a beating over the years via Bauhaus, Tones On Tail, Love And Rockets, and currently, a new Columbia solo foray called "Foolish Thing Desire." True to his word, the whipsaw guitarist revs through ten roundhouse riff-punches that hit harder than his definitive L&R standard, "Motorcycle." If you like your hooks hip-shaking and sexual, this is the disc for you, because Ash — thanks to a decade-and-a-half of experience — knows how to ignite a good rock song.

Ah, but the intellect. Try as he might, this studious disciple of Middle Eastern religion can't resist typically Taoist moralizing. Ash is brainy, and he simply can't play dumb about it. So 'Get Out Of Control' says exactly the opposite, 'Higher Than This' isn't talking about bong-launched escapism and 'The Hedonist' avoids any below-the-belt De Sade-isms. 'Foolish Thing Desire' is thinking man's music, a commentary on the world as Ash sees it, and as deep in its own way as the heady work of his old Bauhaus bud, Peter Murphy. Rather party down to some bitchin' metal sound? Hey, stop reading right here, ya dufus, 'cause Daniel Ash—an artist who actually thinks for himself in an A&R-ruled world—is way outta yer league and miles beyond the infinitesimal intelligence quotient of HITS' own Bay Area boho bozo Tom 'Dick & Harry' Lanham.

achieved Satori? Maybe for an instant or two. I remember once when I was about 12, I was just playing in the back garden, and it was snowing. I was running down the garden path and I fell over, and I looked up in the sky, and the sky was completely black and these white snowflakes were tumbling down. I looked in the garage and my dad was working there, and I looked at me mum in the kitchen and I just felt completely in a total state of bliss, a total state of euphoria. It was so strong, I just started crying. I'll never forget that moment, and that's what I imagine the state of Nirvana that Buddhist monks achieve is like. To get any kind of peace while working in this business must be difficult. I'd think it would be the opposite, because you have so much time to indulge in soul-searching if you're a musician. That's where the inspira-

tion for songs come from... the ma-


gic of music is when you set your imagination free. If anything, I have a great deal more opportunity to pick up on these things than somebady who works in a bank. I've heard you're really pleased with the new Love And Rockets album you've just finished. Yeah, and it's very, very different from anything else we've done. Which is exactly how I made this record as well. I actually recorded this solo thing about a year ago. I went in with no songs and no music at all, literally on my own, with nothing but a few drumbeats. Talking to Dave [J] afterwards about how liberating and how pure it was, and how the intellect didn't get in the way, I said, "Let's do it with the Love and Rockets record as well," so that's what we did went in with nothing. We've actually been in since to rework a few things — we added a few tracks. so now the whole thing's over an

hour long. It's a very druggy sort of record, and it doesn't have any three or four-minute hit singles on it.

Love And Rockets is an ongoing situation. The doors are always open. But my main thing is what I'm doing on my own. Still, there's no reason why Love And Rockets can't continue. We're still friends, and we've always worked when we felt like it, never under pressure, but because we wanted to. That's what we want to keep, and luckily, we've been able to do that up 'til now.

Fime for some tea and crumpets with ELVIS COSTELLO by GARY GRAFF



ELVIS COSTELLO sure knows how to piss people off. Or at least make them scratch their heads. He did it with short, mean-spirited concert performances early in his career. He did it by going country on "Almost Blue," and by dumping his longtime backing band the Attractions - first for the album "King of America," then for good in 1989. He's clearly not interested in staying in one place, and with his new release, "The Juliet Letters," Costello makes perhaps his biggest stretch of all. He composed and recorded the 20-song suite with the Brodsky Quartet, a British classical combo known for its diverse repertoire and unorthodox arrangements. Longtime fans of each other - they attended one another's respective shows for 10 years before finally meeting - they began working on "The Juliet Letters" in 1990, performing it live last summer and recording it during the fall. There's no question it's a marked change from Costello's angry young man oeuvre; the best label, if you need one, may be chamber pop — a hushed, percussionless sound that still has a unique kind of rhythmic drive. It's a hard album to be ambivalent towards, and the early reviews have been either raves (producer Hal Wilner called it "beautiful and moving") or biting trashes. One man who liked it — HITS' Detroit Lyin' Gary Graff got a hold of Costello to get some explanation for this dramatic career twist and ended up learning how to play cello.

REACTION TO "THE JULIET LETTERS" HAS REALLY BEEN POLARIZED. ARE YOU SUPRISED?

If you're talking about the audience, not everybody can follow or accept everything you explore in music. If you want a nice, safe, pensionable career, then you can just repeat the same formula. That's nice for the people that's enough for, but it's not enough for me. Or for the Quartet. If you're talking about critics... they have to be able to know what they're talking about to attack it. A couple of things I've read that have attacked it



consciously conform to pop song structure. The one that does most of all is "Jacksons, Monk and Rowe," which which Michael [Thomas] wrote. "Taking My Life In Your Hands" can be arranged with big modern pop drums and keyboards, and it would be a perfectly good vehicle for someone to have a pop record. The challenge is to make them work with these instruments.

WOULD YOU BE INTERESTED IN DOING SOME OF YOUR OLDER SONGS IN THIS FORMAT?

haven't even known what to say to start the argument. They were just against me for daring to do something other than what they imagined I should do. "The angry Costello is better served by throbbing drums." I don't call that valid criticism.

BUT THIS IS A VASTLY DIFFERENT OUTING FOR YOU.

It seems like a boundary that's too far for some people. It's not like it's never been done before; it just hasn't been done very well. I'm sorry, but I'm not responsible for Emerson, Lake and Palmer. But I'm not going to be told I can't do something in collaboration with people. Just because of some bad stuff that happened in the past. That's like saying you can't listen to any more rock & roll because of Pat Boone.

You can't have a closed mind about music. People say a string quartet, and they think of a bunch of guys with powdered wigs in the corner of a shopping mall, which is a pretty restricted view.

DO YOU THINK PEOPLE ARE REALLY OPEN-MINDED ENOUGH TO ACCEPT THIS FROM YOU?

What's the point of considering the other possibility - that they're brain dead? I just hope people will enjoy the music. There's no reason not to. All we're trying to do is write some songs with feelings.

I've always had this feeling that musicians, even if they're years and miles apart in experience and are doing different music, have some connection.

I hear the same lonesome quality in Hank Williams that I heard in Billie Holiday. Forget the elaborate intellectual theories; you're just trying to make a connection as humans.

WAS THE CREATION PROCESS MARKEDLY DIFFERENT THAN **WRITING A POP SONG?**

Of course. The point I want to stress most of all that some people seem not to be able to grasp is that a song is not like a nut, an arrangement in a shell. What you hear played is the composed music, not some superstructure beneath which there is a naked and trembling song. The stuff the Quartet

is playing, that is the composed music. There are a few songs in the piece which very

When we do concert dates, an hour and 15 minutes is quite short for an evening, so we are going to be doing some other songs, arranged by the string quartet. We might even surprise a few people.

HOW MUCH OF A STRETCH WAS THIS FOR YOU AS A SINGER?

I think my voice agrees very well with the strings. I sing in a lower register most of the time, more than I'm able to against more strident instruments. I use a warmer part of my voice. I'd like to get across to people that I don't have just a three-note range. Most of this stuff is composed in a quintet type of way, not just to complement my voice.

WILL YOUR NEXT ALBUM **RETURN TO ROCK?**

It's looking that way. I've been writing and doing some recording, and I'll be going in again later in the year. I'm always writing, and from time to time there's something on the calendar that says it's time to actually draw the ideas together. The record company was good enough to freeze the calendar for a little while so I could do this.





Time for some baby backs and cornbread with Drivin' N' Cryin' by Ward Carroll

DNC's last album, "Fly Me Courageous" looked like it was going to break big for them. The video for the title track rested at #4 on the "Dial MTV" countdown for over a week, and the album's sales figures nibbled at gold, but ultimately the release fell short of the camp's expectations. This time 'round, like James Carville's 3X5 index cards railing, "The economy, stupid!," at Slick Willie, the goal was to narrow the attack — to take the best

presentation and run with it. Gone are the country excursions that may have sent hard-core fans scrambling for the "skip" button. What remains on "Smoke" is a Robert Pirsig-meets-Joey Ramone, thinking man's riff-oriented groove. There are several slower songs, but even they seem wide-open compared to, say, "Good Day Every Day."

Island Records remains solidly behind the band. Big gun Geoff Workman produced the album and it was mixed by Ron St. Germain (Living Colour, Soundgarden). The band has already shot a video directed by Kevin Kerslake (Nirvana's "In Bloom") for "Smoke"s "Turn It Up Or Turn It Off" (biologically in the same sub-phylum as AC/DC's "Whole Lotta Rosie") and they plan on doing a video for the title track before starting an American tour in March. HITS' resident military correspondent Lieutenant Ward Carroll paid his annual visit to the Drivin' N' Cryin' camp, where he tried to find out from singer/songwriter/guitarist Kevn Kinney where his missing "i" was.



The new album's opening cut, "Back Against The Wall," is fairly polemical. An exorcism of marital-woe demons, perhaps?

Well, most of the record was inspired by my problems at home, but none of the songs really reflects that. They reflect my constant annoyance with the government and an attempt to get in touch with the people. That's what "Back Against The Wall" is all about, you know. "He was working for the company, now he's sleeping on the streets." The government says they don't have to take care of you 'cause the company is going to take care of you and then the company doesn't take care of you, and the government

doesn't know what to do with you.

Do you have hope for the new administration?

I'm always hopeful—always. But I don't think anyone will ever have the guts to address the problems honestly. Politics is business, and business is publicity—learning how to sell yourself. It's entertainment.

Jimmy Carter had this great anecdote on C-SPAN the other night. He mentioned, after he took over from President Ford, he took copious notes when he was briefed on the nuclear codes and stuff like that. The meetings took a long time. But, when Carter was turning over to Reagan, he noticed Reagan didn't seem to be paying that much

attention. He stopped in the middle of talking about the secret codes and asked, "Mr. Reagan, don't you want to write any of this stuff down?" and Reagan said, "Well, maybe I could just get your notes." How about the song "Smoke"? That's about a ghost making love to a woman. Is it somebody she knows? Someone from her past? I haven't figured that out yet. I won't figure it out until the video. "When You Come Back" is as close as "Smoke" comes to the country

David Baerwald, "Triage" (A&M): You would be hard-pressed to find a more accurate description of disillusionment, paranoia, covert operations of the CIA, plague and the redemption of love, than on this record. Part visionary, part delusionary, Baerwald offers an agreggation of tales of the underbelly of society. On

"Aids & Armageddon" we're face to face with a character who "dreams of assassination and hallucinates cash" and who that, fearing he may have AIDS, answers with "anyway I just got laid." What a sobering thought. (Keith Chagnon)

Crush. "Crush" (EastWest/Atl G): Fans of the jagged, arching rhythms that were employed by the best of the late 80's post-punk English bands will rejoice at the sound of former Killing Joke drummer Paul Ferguson and former Banshee, Clock DVA guitarist John Valentine Carruthers merging their bril-



liance on this crafty debut elpee. The surprise here is relative unknown Fred Schreck, whose vocals tower above the delightful din producing a truly Cult-like sense of grandeur. "She Came Down" is a PoMo smash in waiting.



Chris Mars, "75% Less Fat" (Smash): The second solo release from the 'Mats former drummer reveals that the sardonic multi-instrumentalist has the same grindy pop sensibility in plentitude that made his debut album a PoMo fave. Handling the knob-twisting chores himself, Chris has produced the

perfect aural landscape for his flippant vocal delivery. Cuts like "Stuck In Rewind" and "Public Opinion" would have fit comfortably on any of the records Chris's old band made. Whereas "Demolition" is a dauntless and successful stretch.

Frank Black, "Frank Black" (4AD-/Elektra): The first solo record from The Pixies' Black Francis will only serve to heighten his already prodigious reputation for experimentation and versatility. "Fu Manchu" or "Ten Percenter" (a reference to Thompson's "Great Shark Hunt"?) could very easily have been







(Manhattan/Capitol) is a sweet smoker... RADIO RAP: Last week we dealt with the content of audition tapes; this week it's mechanics. Your tape should indicate what a typical hour of your program is like. The trick is to edit the tape so that there isn't too much music (the PD knows the songs) or too much talk. I've found that about six seconds of filler between talk events gives the proper balance. To illustrate: intro/ music/ splice/ music/ backsell/ beginning of recorded spot(s)/ splice/ end of recorded spots/ PSA / WX to intro/ music/ splice, etc. Also, make your edits smooth so as not to "jerk" the PD/listener. Caution: Don't "doctor" your talk portions—you'll get busted going into or on the new job. Later.

The massive opening cocktail reception was hosted by the locally owned and newly founded Cheetah Distribution Group. More next week on Cheetah and the DJ Magic Mike release (shameless plug)...
