



PAGE & PLANT: LED WAIT IS OVER


The long-awaited reunion of former Led Zeppelin mainstays Robert Plant and Jimmy Page has resulted in a brand-new album, "No Quarter," on Atlantic, slated for release November 8, and an October 12 MTV "Unplugged" special that garnered the series' highest-rated episode in its history.

The 90-minute MTV "Unplugged" attracted a viewing audience of more than 2 million, earning a 6.2 rating, with a 21% share among the 18-24-year-old male audience. Commented MTV President Judy McGrath: "We're proud to have been able to bring this powerful reunion to music lovers across the country. I haven't been this excited since Ren got back together with Stimpy."

Warner Music U.S. President/COO Doug Morris first had the idea to get Plant and Page together again when they played at the label's 40th anniversary celebration in 1988, though he credits mgr. Bill Curbishley for actually bringing about the pairing.

"I thought it came off brilliantly," he said. "The idea was to do it in a way that would make it artistic; not just to do their greatest hits, but some of the more obscure material." He is confident the duo will make a studio album and tour together in '95. "I think this is a way of using the past to get to the future," he added. "This is not the next chapter for Led Zeppelin, but the start of something new. By the way, which issue of *Billboard* did you say this was running in?"

The album and special included tracks Plant and Page recorded in Morocco, Wales and on a London soundstage in front of a live audience last August, with drummer Michael Lee and bassist Charlie Jones (from Plant's regular band) being joined by Egyptian string and percussion ensembles, local Morroccan musicians, European string and brass sections and other Western and non-Western instrumentalists. Plant and Page also played as an acoustic duo, performing a number of Zeppelin classics like "The Battle of Evermore," "Since I've Been Loving You" and a radically reworked "Kashmir" as well as three new songs in "City Don't Cry," "Yallah" and "Wonderful One." The "No Quarter" CD will include new versions of ten Zeppelin songs and the three new tracks featured in the MTV special, while an A*Vision home video is slated for release by the end of the year.







I's been a little over six years since 31-yeareld high school dropout and longtime LA. resident Quentin Tarantino left his job at a Manhattan Beach, California video store to pursue his destiny as a filmmaker, but he still talks like an overexcited film buff derk, his conversation bouncing around from Jean-Luc Gedard to Sorgie Loone, from the relationship of surf music and spaghetti westerns to the fin de siede chann of '70s bubblegum pop. Talking to him is a little like riding the rollorster of his current smash and winner of the **Cannes Film Festival's coveted Palme D'Or,** "Pulp Fiction," a gut-bustingly hilarious black semic trilogy surrounding the misadventures of two hit (John Travelta and Samuel Jackson, Jr.), a washed-up boxer on the take (Bruce Willis), a

sadistic black gangster (Ving Rhames) and his drug-addled moll (Uma Thurman).

Tarantino has already ponned four screenplays — the first two, "True Romance" and "Natural Born Killers," were directed by Tony Scott and Oliver Stone, the last two, "Reservoir Dogs" and now "Pulp Fiction," he was at the helm himself. He is currently Hollywood's boy wonder, a director respected not just in Tinseltown but in the cineaste circles of New York, for bringing the French nouvelle vague fascination with the U.S. gangster noir genre full circle, reclaiming it from its roots in "30s and '40s "pulp fiction."

Tarantino has a love of both the spoken word and pop music which runs through his work. The most memorable scenes in

> "Reservoir Dogs" revolve around a discussion in a dinor about the psychosexual implications of Madonna's "Like A Virgin" and actor Michael Madsden torturing a policeman while dancing a jig to Stealers Wheel's "Stuck In The Middle With You." In "Pulp Fiction," Tarantino intersperses cheesy '60s surf music with '70s funk-soul nuggets by Al Green and Kool & the Gang, Dusty Springfield's "Son of A Preacher Man," the Statler Bros.' "Flowers on the Wall" and Urge Overkill's cover of Neil Diamond's "Girl You'll Be A Woman Soon" to create a sense of dislocation which makes the film timeless and the viewer uncertain whether it's taking place in the '50s, '60s, '70s, '80s

or present-day. There's also an incredible twist dance scene between Travolta and Thurman to Chuck Berry's "You Never Can Tell," set in a faux '50s diner called Jack Rabbit Silm's peopled by waters that look like Martiyn Monroe, Buddy Holly and Jayne Mansfield. Originally brought to MCA by Sr. VP/GM Soundtracks Kathy Nelson, Tarantino is a music junkie and the soundtracks to both "Dogs" and "Pulp Fiction" intersperse the films' memorable dialogue with his own carefully chosen pop songs. In person, a Tshirt and jeans-clad Tarantino is still the quintessential film nerd, proving a perfect match for HITS' own resident nerd Roy "Ale With Cheece" Trakin. aficionado. What it offered me was the opportunity not to have to work for a living. I just hung out and talked about movies all day. I'd go to the Cedar in downtown L.A. or this theater in Carson to watch a film I had heard about. Or I'd find out about some weird bottom half of a double-feature playing in a drive-in in Inglewood you couldn't see anymore.

The '70s musical motif runs throughout both "Reservoir Dogs" and "Pulp Fiction," especially your love of disposable bubblegum hits from that era. I know many people who say they'll never hear "Stuck in The Middle With You" the same way again after "Reservoir Dogs."

Music has been important in both the films you've directed. The '60s surf music and use of oldies in "Pulp Fiction" make you wonder exactly when this film is taking place

Everyone knows "Pulp Fiction" is taking place in the '90s, but we don't ram that down everyone's throats. Look out the window right now. All those cars parked there aren't '90s models. All through the '80s, me and my friends drove 1978 Honda Civics or whatever *The Recycler* was selling at the time. When people watch this film 20-30 years from now, you won't have to worry about it dating that much.

The surf music actually has kind of a kitsch '50s futuristic quality about it, almost like a "Telstar" thing.

The reason I used the surf music as score, as opposed to source music, was I never quite understood what it had to do with surfing. To me, it always sounded more like Ennio Morricone, spaghetti western music. Those trumpet flourishes have that big Spanish feel about them, a real operatic quality. In a way, that's a good explanation of the movie. It's sort of like a rock & roll spaghetti western crossed with a blaxploitation movie. Working in a video store these days must be like being a French film critic in the '60s with access to all those vintage American noir movies at the Cinematheque. The only reason I got that job in the first

place was because I was such a movie

that you use so well you can't ever hear it again without imagining Michael Madsden doing that little Texas two-step.

You've said you remained a real fan of Top 40 when album-rock was coming into vogue in the early '70s. There is something special about being the last bastion of a certain form that became antiquated overnight. It's funny, when you bought an album in the '60s, they weren't albums the way we think of them today. Most of them back then included the hit and the rest was filler. But I don't get nostalgic about anything, really. Things have to move on. It's funny how you show Uma Thurman playing music on a turntable and a reel-to-reel rather than a CD player. When CDs first came out, you think they're wonderful. You went out and bought them all and enjoyed hearing this old music in a new way. But in some ways, it's almost getting too clean. To me, the biggest advantage of CD is that you can make it louder than you can a turntable. I love my album collection. And one of the good things about CDs is you can go to used record stores and trade them in for old records. Vinyl is so cheap you can take a chance on buying an album you might just

like one song on. I'll go to used record stores, drop \$50 and come out with 50 records. It's much more fodder with which to make tapes for your friends.

Why did you use the Urge Overkill cover of "Girl You'll Be A Woman Soon" rather than Neil Diamond's original? I love the Neil Diamond song. Urge Overkill are big Neil Diamond fans, too. His version is great, but Urge Overkill's version is more hypnotic. There's a piano wire difference, but it's there. The Neil Diamond version is more dramatic; he's telling a story whereas Urge Overkill's has a more flattened-out, deadpan quality. That seductive dance thing Uma Thurman does works far better with Urge Overkill.

One of the recurrent themes in your movies is the way

people are put into situations where there doesn't seem to be any way out, and yet they escape, like minor miracles.

Circumstance and coincidence are right alongside one another. Often, the ways they're able to get out of them involve the fact that they stop yelling and start talking. They either agree to disagree or come together. Who knows if fate, in the form of that Pop Tart, hadn't popped out of the toaster, what would have happened between John's character and Bruce's?

And, of course, the final scene in the diner, where they're all facing off with one another, is much like similar scenes in "Reservoir Dogs" and certainly owes much to directors like John Woo and Sergio Leone.

To me, the Mexican stand-off is the modernday equivalent of the western showdown. In a western shootout, the guys are standing there

without drawing their guns, waiting to be the first one to shoot. In a Mexican standoff, you don't want to shoot. But you don't want to put your gun down, either. Because you don't want to get shot. And it's like, how do we get out of this now?

It's like the least little movement could set off Armageddon.

Exactly. A cat's meow could be the trigger. It's funny because people will ask me why I did this same scene in "True Romance," "Dogs" and "Pulp Fiction." I never heard anyone tell Sergio Leone it was limiting. John Woo's done it before, too, but when I wrote "True Romance," which was my first script, I'd never even heard of John Woo. When I finally saw John Woo do it a few times, I thought, "A-ha. A guy after my own heart!" Cinephiles love you because of all the filmic and pop culture references, stuff like ordering a Douglas Sirk steak and having the surty Buddy Holly lookalike waiter growl. "Do you want that burnt to a crisp or bloody as hell?" I can honestly say, if I owned a '50s restaurant and had to come up with '50s icons to

name my food after, I'd have a Douglas Sirk steak. A Martin & Lewis would be a vanilla shake and an Amos & Andy a chocolate one. Have you seen "Natural Born Killers"?

Not yet. From what I heard, the most that was left of my writing was the opening scene... that was the purest dose of Quentin. I read some of the reviews which mentioned certain lines and I began to think maybe they kept more than I thought. That line about Charlie Manson was mine and I hear it gets the biggest laugh in the film.

From what I've read, Oliver Stone's impressed with how cutting edge he thinks he is filmically. My girlfriend saw the movie and said she thought the first half was genuinely engaging because there's a lot of visual stuff

Critics have said it's an homage to Anna Karina in Godard's "Vivre Sa Vie."

Uma looks a little like Anna did in that movie. There's also a dance sequence with two other guys in "Band a Parte" and in "Le Petit Soldad." The thing that's amusing is, since you're known as a film aficionado. everyone thinks there are all these links and hurdles about how you did this, that or the other. It's like people have told me I obviously took the idea of the glowing suitcase in "Pulp Fiction" from Robert Aldrich's "Kiss Me Deadly." But I came up

with that idea on my own. And it was only as I was writing Woo and all his Hong Kong cohorts with their Triad movies. They can literally take a movie and do it scene-for-fucking-scene, but it's different because they're doing it in their wild Hong Kong way. I just love when people reinvent the genres, like Cassavetes did with "The Killing of a Chinese Bookie."

My biggest single influence on "Dogs" was Melville. I didn't take anything from his movies, but I absorbed what he was doing. He changed the whole damn thing by working with his rhythm. And I liked that I was taking my cue from him, but giving it back its American vernacular.

happening. But I just don't have any desire to see it. I'll watch it in a hotel room maybe, but I won't contribute to its theatrical release. How do you respond to the allegations published in Film Threat magazine that you lifted the plot whole for "Reservoir Dogs" from a Hong Kong film called "City on Fire"?

I think that's pretty funny, considering Hong Kong movies rip off more American films wholesale than anyone else in the world. It's like the Germans complaining that the Irish drink too much beer. I was making a movie in a certain subgenre: the heist film. Anytime you do that, you're going to be influenced by the films that came before you.

The funny thing is, when "Dogs" first came out, everyone said I stole it from [Stanley Kubrick's] "The Killing." Then they said I stole it from "The Taking of Pelham One-Two-Three." Now they're saying I stole it from "City on Fire." Now those are three vastly different movies, man, so which one fucking is it? It kind of proves my point. The bottom line is, I love "City on Fire." But watch "City on Fire" and "Reservoir Dogs" and you're seeing two different movies.

Are you planning to deconstruct any other genres in the future, like a musical?

I actually think I've done the two best dance sequences of the year in "Pulp Fiction" with Travolta and Uma. Her number is one of

did I realize it was a little like "Kiss Me Deadly." But it wasn't like I said, let's rip off "Kiss Me Deadly." Whenever I do lift things directly, no one even gets 'em. But my ripoffs are so obscure, I dare people to get them. I'll meet the director of a movie I did a direct lift from and even he won't realize it. Because I do it well.

What's so satisfying about your films is, the same way the French nouvelle vague was inspired by '50s American B-movies, you borrow from their take-offs and thereby reclaim Hollywood noir by bringing it all back home, turning the gangster genre movie as art film back into a nod to our own '30s and '40s pulp fiction.

That's very nice of you to say that. It's a nice analogy. I love the French New Wave. But I always loved best those movies which worked within the genre. Like "Le Petit Soldad" is Godard's secret agent movie, "Breathless" and "Band a Parte" his crime films, and "Pierrot Le Fou" his young couple on the run movie. Those were his most enjoyable films for me. Even before him, you had Jean-Pierre Melville taking the standard Warner Bros. crime thrillers and setting them in Paris with his own way of doing them. He created something wholly other, which didn't exist before. Same with Sergio Leone and the western. And John


volta says, "They have a lot of the same shit over there that we've got here, except there it's a little different." They call their Quarter Pounders with cheese a Royale with cheese, put mayonnaise instead of ketchup on their french fries in Holland, make change on a bus or serve beer in movie theaters.

There are certain scenes in the movie, like the process shots outside the window of Jack Rabbit Slim's or Uma Thurman drawing a square in the air, where you stress that artificial quality of film.


It's meant to be playful. I don't mind being obvious about it, as long as it's not, "Hey Ma, watch me direct." When I'm watching an old film and they do some antiquated filmic device, it doesn't take me emotionally out of the movie. One of the things about those scenes you mentioned is they're not overbearing. It's just something you don't expect. Those are like little kisses to the audience. And I think that's the way they take it.

I read where Madonna responded to your "Reservoir Dogs" rap about "Like A Virgin."

I had her sign my "Erotica" album and she wrote, "To Quentin: It's about love, not dick. Madonna." But I can't even take credit for the initial theory. The basis for that came from the MacDonald brothers of Redd Kross, which I took and wrote a two-page monologue on it. 🔳



Time to remove some warts with Veruca Salt

Veruca Salt — those two little words have been on the lips of every A&R person in the business for nearly a year. From the first time we saw this Chicago-based band at SxSW in Austin, TX, there was always a roomful of record execs present, pushing up to the front of the stage, intently absorbing something that is a rarity in their life's pursuit — a band doing something original, truly creative and, of course, something that radio is bound to love. But, to gush a little quixotic for a minute, there's something more. By the look on everybody's faces that night in Texas, the word "arresting" somehow seems an appropriate description for the band.

But it's probably safe to say any creative endeavor starts humbly. Veruca Salt's prime movers Nina Gordon and Louise Post "found" each other when Nina listened to Louise give an acoustic performance at a New Year's Eve party over the telephone. When the two first got together and played each other their songs, Post described the meeting by saying, "I felt like I'd met my mirror."

These meetings continued for a year before the two thought they were ready to take a stab at forming a band. After abandoning the idea of a gender-specific rhythm section, bassist Steve Lack and Gordon's brother Jim Shapiro, a serious singer/song-writer/guitarist in his own right, accepted the drum throne to fill out the lineup. A single on Chicago's fledgling indie Minty Fresh, owned by local music czar Jim Powers, followed, as did PoMo radio Top 10s and a fierce bidding war.

At the time of this interview, the band had yet to decide on a major label home. A few weeks ago, DGC announced a longterm agreement with the band, ending months of speculation and column fodder for this reporter as they plan to reservice

the barely one-month-old Minty Fresh fulllength "American Thighs." But all good things come to an end. Veruca Salt is just beginning, while HITS' boy blunder Joe Fleischer "Margarine" heads off in the opposite direction, stopping just long enough to hold court with Salt's Nina Gordon.

NINA GORDON: Before we start, I have to congratulate you on coining the term "Wait Rock." [Laughs] What is the deal with that?

When I saw you guys at SxSW, I was kinda worn out, leaning against Karen Glauber, and the band really perked me up. I turned to Karen and said, "This band is really amazing! What do we say about this?" And she said, "It's Waif Rock." And Mark Kates leaned over and said, "No. It's Maximum Waif Rock." So I didn't really coin it as much as I absconded with it.

You've said it three times in HITS and somebody called us the same thing in a Chicago paper. [Laughs] So it's catching on, I'm sorry to say. Although I found it funny when I first read it, there's something inherently insulting about immediately jumping to body type. I mean, we re women making music, and the first thing that comes to mind is, "Oh, they're skinny... they're

waifs." I thought it was funny until Louise pointed out there's something a little scary about it. I like that Mark Kates added "Maximum," because that makes it more powerful. I mean, rock is a powerful word and it counteracts the waif part of it, which is sort of weak and mild, and "Maximum" definitely helps boosts it a little bit. We kind of hope it doesn't catch on. The other day, we were sitting around trying to coin little catch phrases for every kind of band. If we were built differently, we would be "Hefty Rock" or "Tub Rock" or something. There's something a little creepy about that.

It's not lost on me that the term could have a belittling effect, but it's like HITS' version

of Sad Core, the UK press' pigeonholing of bands like American Music Club, Red House Painters, etc. These things are just goofy media creations.

It was amazing at first and then it dawned on me, "Hey, wait a second, we're talking about our bodies... what about our music?" But I loved how you referred to Christian of Loud Lucy, who's a friend of ours, as "indier than thou." It doesn't bug me, but if we end up on the cover of Spin and it says "Maximum Waif Rock," I'm going to be pretty bummed. I don't mean to harp, but could your next article pronounce the death of waif rock?

No problem.

It's funny, we were interviewed by this guy from Cake magazine who only wanted to know what my favorite foods are and I really sound like a crazy person. In light of maximum waif-rock, suddenly you begin to wonder if you're starting to sound like this insane person with the most bizarre eating disorders. I talked about eating only blue food, which is what I did for a couple of years. Actually... maybe a couple of weeks. Well, anyway I don't want to talk too much about because it would be bad news if suddenly Veruca Salt was pegged as... The eating disorder band?

[Laughs] Actually, We're totally healthy. Health rock, that's what we are

Why did you name the band for Veruca Salt, the character in "Willy Wonka And The Chocolate Factory"?

It's mostly because I thought they were cool words, and I definitely

loved the book when I was little. I could identify with her being a total spoiled brat and all... I'm sure my brother can attest to that. But it has a lot less to do with the character and more to do with loving the words. We didn't realize Roald Dahl, being the clever and wicked fella he is, named the character Veruca Salt because she was this horrible character, and veruca means wart. Veruca Salt, I think, may be some kind of wart medicine or wart remedy. And British people always say, "Why would you call yourselves Veruca?" It's not exactly a wart wart; it's more like a planter's wart, the kind that grows into your foot.

Like a ballet dancer gets?

Do ballet dancers get planter's warts? I know they get bunions and coms, but I don't know if they get planter's warts. Anyone can get a planter's wart. In fact, I have suffered from planter's warts. Not plural, but one planter's wart at one time in my life. [Laughs] In fact, on a really pivotal night of my life, too! I was like maybe seven or eight or something and I had a planter's wart, and it was really scary, becaue the doctor said, "Well, we'll just take care of that right now." And I thought that meant just putting some kind of weird acid or something on it to take it away. But he actually had to cut my foot open and pull this thing out, and he showed it to me and it was just totally repulsive. But the huge bummer of that evening was that we were going to see "Annie" on Broadway that night, and little did I know

standpoint of women who do have a certain agenda. That's going to be inherent in the music, but the songs are definitely not about that in particular. "Seether" is definitely about anger, and, specifically, women's anger. Well, not women in general - it's just about my anger and trying to control it. Maybe that's a universal thing, but it was not meant to be. Do you and Louise write together at all?

No, we write everything separately; you know, lyrics and chords and stuff. We sort of structure the songs separately, bring them in and then things can definitely change form a lot. We've added things to

> each other's songs, as have Steve and Jim. We don't have that much time to write together, but I think if we did, we would.

How did you guys come to work with producer Brad Wood?

We actually shared a practice space with Liz Phair's band when we first started playing, but they only came in a couple times and that's when we met. We'd always imagined either recording a 7" or going into the studio ourselves and doing something with Brad. We even called him before we knew him and introduced ourselves. But then he just stumbled onto like our third show or something, and I guess he was really into it and he talked to us afterward and said he'd really be into recording us. This was before Minty Fresh, when we had only played a couple of shows. But it didn't happen, because then the Minty Fresh thing went down. I guess Jim Powers and Brad had worked together before and so it just kind of fell together.

How did it feel being together for about a year and having every label on earth chasing you?

It's definitely a double-edged sword. It's totally flattering and nice to be recognized and to have people like us, but it's also scary because we're not fully developed and we haven't been doing this very long, although Louise and I had been playing our songs together for maybe a year before the band got together. But we haven't been playing

our instruments that long and we're not seasoned musicians. It could create a situation where people say, "Oh well, they're not as good as the hype." What's disturbing is the sort of mini-backlash I'm feeling in Chicago. And it's not fair because we didn't create the hype or ask for it. I know there are plenty of bands who'd kill for this kind of attention, but it's scary because people are blaming us. We really thought we'd go out, play our songs and have time to develop. I have total faith, as I'm sure everyone in the band does, in what we're doing and the vision that we have, but I don't know that we've totally realized that vision yet. It's weird to be put in the position where people will be judging us on where we are now, when we don't feel like we've totally arrived yet.



Time for a haircut and a shampoo with the Cult's Ian Astbury and Billy Duffy BY STEFFAN CHIRAZI

Things have never come easy for The Cult. From their Goth beginnings in the UK as Southern Death Cult to their platinum-coated hard-rock success as the shortened The Cult, Ian Astbury and Billy Duffy have endured their fair share of criticisms and internal strife. Their latest album, simply self-titled "The Cult" (Sire/Reprise), marks a return to the form shown on the band's mid-'80's release "Love." Rich with songs and backed with new injections of The Cult's natural arrogance, the Bob Rock-produced album signals the beginning of a new era for the much-troubled band. Astbury and Duffy took time out recently at a Melrose Avenue coffee shop to discuss all matters Cult and otherwise with HITS' RIP-off artist Steffan "Lonn Is My Friend" Chirazi.

It's never been an easy road for this band, has it?

Buy DUFFY: Put it this way. Just before we went in to do the "Love" album, none of the "A"-grade British rock producers wanted anything to do with us. We were getting "B" list producers. We were like the little mongrel dog that got kicked around; no one wanted to know about this freaky little punk band with their pretentions to being a big rock act. Very few people believed in us.

Many people feel that "Love" is still your best album.

IAN ASTBURY: No one was making late '60s-early '70s hard-rock records back at that time. The influence was to go and make something a lot more like "...Are You Experienced" or "The Doors" and I was really happy with "Love." I thought it was a great record. We got on the bus at the time and it basically turned into the magical mystery tour. DUFFY: We toured on the "Love" album in America, took loads of ecstasy in Texas where it was legal, found out we were a big band in Canada, groupies appeared and the whole rock & roll microcosm hit us over the head. We'd turn the radio on and hear the Doors and Zeppelin, things you didn't hear in Britain unless they were on your stereo. That tour turned our heads around and we saw the bigger potential in America. Britain was very stifling, and also the "Love" album was absolutely panned over there. We went through a lot of press beatings. They didn't like us because we were a good-looking band, loads of birds liked us and we weren't horrible, spotty, narrowshouldered shoe-gazing Englishmen. We had all the things the British hate, including self-confidence. So America and Canada really saved us. When did the personal situations start to go askew?

ASTBURY: It was around the "Electric" album when things started to get out of control. We wanted to work with ["Love" producer] Steve Brown again to achieve a drier sound. We'd heard Rick Rubin's stuff and we wanted to go that way with Steve. He wanted to work with what we did naturally, which we couldn't see at the time. We'd tasted the apple, left the garden and wanted a bit more of it. So we fucked around in The Manor studios in Oxfordshire. For me, it was get up at 4 or 5, straight into the wine cellar, get plastered, go into the studio, screw around until 4 or 5 am, when Steve would have to get up five hours later to work with Billy's guitars. It was just one big party really, and it was brilliant. Incredible. We were ensconced in this beautiful country home with plenty of money, air rifles, fireworks... it was the Bash Street Kids with loads of booze...

DUFFY: Ian was being a bit of a pain in the arse! I remember Rubin saying to us, "Why do you play pussy English alternative music? You're a rock band. You look and sound like a classic English rock band, so why not try playing like one?"

There are actually some "hopeful" songs from you this time, lan.

ASTBURY: "Sacred Life" sums up how I feel today with regards to living. I was very self-destructive. certainly suicidal, at times. I've got a son now, so I'm very in touch with mortality; I feel very much alive again. I don't want to get all "heavy," but I think you have to occasionally appreciate the profoundness of just "being"; it isn't just some cheap doormat. I think the deaths of Kurt Cobain and River Phoenix have been romanticized, and I mentioned Abbie Hoffman in there because he did seem, from what I've seen of him, to give a shit. And the thing with Phoenix is that he was an icon of this generation.

Your new-found lust for life is in direct contrast with the "Sonic Temple" era, where it seemed you really didn't give a shit.

ASTBURY: I was into acoustic guitars, poetry and walking through the forest, but I was also into being fucked up and waking up in the gutter at 5.30 am by some shithole. I really enjoyed being out of it! This was a time when everything was carte blanche; I never paid for a drink, everything was laid on for me. I was in Disneyland. I knew that it was a time for complete self-destruction and nothing else. But, really, I've always set myself up for everything because I am just being myself.

steps above their previous ghetto blaster quality recordings. Backed by several members of Pavement, Berman's vocals run as deep as Beat Happening's Calvin Johnson, minus the child-like innocence, on "Advice To The Graduate" and "Tide To The Oceans." Any indie rocker that thinks Pavement turned into corporate rock sell-outs can feel hip again with this fine debut. (CC)





Time to get the kinks out with Oasis

THE GRAY AND RAINY STREETS OF MANCHESTER, normally associated with the likes of 808 State and New Order, is not the

place that one would expect a guitar-toting rock & roll band bent on having fun, playing live and writing great songs. First discovered playing a gig in Glasgow — secured by threatening the club with arson — the quintet (brothers Liam

and Noel Gallagher on vocals and guitar, bassist Paul McGuigan, drummer Tony McCarroll and guitarist Paul Arthurs [aka Bonehead]) are already a massive hit in the U.K. with both the press and the public. Having a reputation for heated disputes both on and off-stage, songwriter Noel and charismatic frontman Liam claim "that's just the way brothers are." Joining fellow HITS' Brit git Commander Dicky Winn "Lose or Draw" at the rooftop pool of their luxury Hollywood hotel for a spot of midafternoon tea to talk about their debut U.S. release, "Definitely Maybe" (Creation/Epic), Noel and Arthurs explain they are under no illusion their star status in Merry Olde guarantees them anything in the rest of the world... a lesson our own Dicky had to learn the hard way.

What's it like coming to America and having to start from the bottom up?

NOEL GALLAGHER: It's like it was a year and a half ago when we started out. We've done it in England; now we've got to do it everywhere outside of England or just stay in England and be big there. But who wants to be big just in England? You've got to be as big as you can around the world.

The majority of British press is very positive. Do you expect a backlash here?

NOEL: I thought it would work out great, but some of the reviews we've been seeing seem to be saying, "Here's another band launched off the back of good British press." It's happened before and everyone is entitled to say, "Well, so what?," but we're actually quite good. I think people are suprised we aren't a bunch of miserable twats that go on about how miserable we are. There seems to be a lot of children who were abused in bands these days and want to tell people how bad it was. Shut-up being miserable for Christ's sake and have a good time. We're not over here to do like six gigs and then go home again and start slagging America off for not buying the record. You've got to come over here and stay a few months and get it right; if we don't, at least we had a try. Would you be willing to hook up with someone as an

opening act? How about Lollapalooza '95?

NOEL. I don't want to go out and support Guns N' Roses or something. You've got to build up your own following; you can't be trying to pinch other people's fans. Who wants Guns N' Roses fans buying your records anyway... know what I mean?

That traveling festival thing seems to be up its own arse. It's trying to be too radical for its own good. It doesn't seem to be about music; it seems to be about everybody being "different." I mean, it's only rock & roll, ain't it? It's just a lot of bands playing in a field somewhere. Then they set up all these stalls, like "Sign a petition for 'Save the Badger''' and all that shit. You either go there to listen to music or you don't. If you want to sign petitions, go join Greenpeace. There has been a great deal written about the friction

There has been a great deal written about the friction between you and your brother.

NOEL: The British music press is basically middle-class fucking idiots. They don't really know what to write about, so they just write about what color socks you wore that day. They're all writing, "There are two brothers in the band and they had an argument once." They make up a load of bullshit about that and people will believe it.

PAUL ARTHURS: Its like a fucking soap opera. I mean, what are we going to do next? It's the kids who queue

up in the rain, buy your album and get it to #1 which makes a statement... not the press. Is there any music out of America you like at the moment? NOEL: Beck, Grant Lee Buffalo... I think Beck is just a bit too mad for his own good, though. Neil Young, of

too mad for his own good, though. Neil Young, of course... he's still there, ain'r he? But I don't get all this Green Day nonsense... it's like the Buzzcocks, but worse. Have you had any time to do more recording since this album? Noel: We're doing some recording while we're here actually, in Austin, Texas. We've got a single coming out in England at Christmas and we haven't recorded the B-side for it yet. We have no no big theory about recording music. What's wrong with music today is too many people seem to fall into the trap that it's this big statement to make a record. It's not. It's the easiest thing in the world. You just plug in your guitar, play it, sing it and that's it... and maybe it's in tune. Kids are not arsed about a snare drum sound. They're not arsed about how loud the backing vocals are. It's all these other fuckers who sit 'round the office all day and have nothing better to do than listen to snare drums and say, "I don't like the sound on that" or "You could do with turning the bass up a bit." It's like, what's the bass control on a fucking stereo for if you're not going to turn it up? Let the person who is listening decide.

Victoria Williams, "Loose" (Mammoth/ Atlantic/Atl G): Victoria Williams follows up the outstanding "Sweet Relief" tribute compilation with her first new album in four years. Combining country, bluegrass, folk and rock influences, but transcending all of them, Williams provides her most inspiring songs yet, such as the beautifully moving "You R Loved," and the happily twisted

tale "Crazy Mary." String and horn arrangements from the legendary Van Dyke Parks helped produce a touching version of "What A Wonderful World." Guest appearances from friends in Soul Asylum, the Jayhawks and REM only accentuate the talents of this truly unique artist. (Chris Carey)

Black 47, "Home Of The Brave" (SBK/ EMI): Black 47 have been an integral part of the NYC music scene for quite awhile now, blowing the roof off Paddy Reilly's twice weekly, when not touring their joyful and riotous mishmash of musical genres accross the country. Adeptly produced by former Talking Head Jerry Harrison, "Home



Of The Brave" runs the gamut from an outcry against inter-island prejudice within Great Britain to a story of unrequited lust. It's been a long time since a record covered so much ground without trying desperately to do so. Impressive. (Anthony Hayes)



Portishead, "Dummy" (Go! Discs/ London): Named after creator Geoff Barrow's hometown, Portishead are a rather unusual musical "collective" based in Bristol, England. Fronted by Beth Gibbons' strange and haunting vocals, Portishead could be a mix of the Sugarcubes, Moby and Big Audio, but they are much more than just a blend of contemporaries. The opening cut, "Mysterons," creates a

wonderfully intimate setting for the album's many great songs, which include super spy music "Sour Times," the single, the incredibly sexy "It Could Be Sweet," and "Roads." with its superb orchestration complementing Beth's beautifully vulnerable voice. (Cmmndr Dickie Winn, HITS UK Correspondent)

Big Chief, "Platinum Jive" (Revolution/ Capitol): Yeah sure, Big Chief's sound could easily be described by the posing press as "eclectic," but applied here, it's not to kindly underline musical shortcomings. If Big Chief slides from concussive guitar riffs to slippery R&B-inflected throwdowns to trippy psychedelia to canny hip-hop, it's because they damn



well know what they're doing. Ace knob-twister Phil Nicolo of Butcher Brothers fame (Cypress Hill, Aerosmith, Urge Overkill) presides over a delightfully sparse and crunchy major label debut that will only heighten Big Chief's rep for uncompromising trail-blazing. Kick ass, one time.



World Radio History



Retailers roaming the halls of the Phoenix Biltmore this weekend with Pam Horowitz, Jim Donio and the rest of the NARM constituency for the annual fall gathering should find themselves trying once again to find solutions to some problems that have now been hanging around so long they've qualified for Medicare. EAS anti-theft technology: What is it going to be? Who is going to foot the bill? When is it going to be instituted? This mishigas may very well bore the hell out of outsiders. but you can be sure that retailers' veins pop out in their necks when they talk about it. The MAP (Minimum Advertised Price) policies: Labels would sure like it if people would stop selling their damned CDs for less than wholesale. The "offenders" all say they would love to stop (you have to believe that they wouldn't mind actually making some money on this stuff), but no one wants to be the first. The record clubs: Retailers want to know how the manufacturers can really be all that worried about the "perceived value" of CDs when they are willing to give away eight for a penny. A slightly newer issue will be The EMI/McDonalds promotion: Most retailers are saying to anyone that will listen "let us sell Roxette for \$6 a pop and we'll go through 500,000 units, too!" And with the

re-instatement of video into the NARM mix, the topic might have something to do with the labels' contention that videos have the same release date restrictions as audio product (it seems that "Jurrasic Park" hit the racks in many places as fast as it came off the trucks). We'll see you there ... Navarre is currently in the process of relocating itself to New Hope, Minnesota, just outside Minneapolis (Is that a great metaphor for a move, or what?). CEO Eric Paulson is engineering the move in order to consolidate what is currently a three-warehouse set-up (with a separate packaging facility) in Brooklyn Park. The new space measures a tidy 100,000 plus sq. ft. and features a computerized product movement system ... Westem Merchandisers has just officially changed its name to Anderson Merchandisers, having been purchased by Anderson Publishing earlier this year ... Retailers at NARM are going to be bombarded by all the new "interactive" products that are now available. One new twist is going to be hitting the U.S. soon. Until now, if you wanted to use the same CD to play in your audio player and as an interactive multimedia CD ROM in your personal computer, there was a price to pay (besides the fact that it usually increases the cost by some three or four times). You lose Track One of your music to the computer (and worse, many times it can still be heard on your audio player as white noise). Australia's ActiveAudio has just perfected an interactive CD manufacturing process that allows the two formats to live side-by-side and should only add a dollar or so to the cost of a regular audio CD. The first release is the new single by Australia's GF4. distributed stateside by BMG after the first of the year. The CD has four remixes and the capability of showing you the video, a press conference and other "fanzine-style" bells and whistles.


