





# MTV AWARDS!!!

#### Vanilli Rebate

A Chicago circuit court judge has granted preliminary approval to an unprecedented settlement to resolve more than 20 class-action fraud lawsuits filed against Milli Vanilli's record company, Arista. A previous proposal by the label was rejected because it required consumers to purchase additional products to get refunds.

Under terms of the new agreement, Arista and parent company BMG have agreed to pay \$1 for singles, \$2 for albums and cassettes and \$3 for CDs purchased by disgruntled Milli Vanilli fans prior to November 27, 1990. In addition, any individual who bought group merchandise will have a \$250,000 contribution made in their name to either the T. J. Martell Foundation, AMFAR or The Rainforest Action Network. The defendants must notify the public of the settlement and submit claim forms available through an 800 number via ads in consumer publications as well as radio and TV spots. First two refunds went out to a Mr. Rob Pilatus and a Mr. Fab Morvan of Hollywood. (Ed Note: Can I get a rebate on this writer's salary? Hey, just asking.)

## **Run Walks**

Run DMC's Joseph "Run" Simmons has pleaded innocent to charges he raped a woman after a concert in Cleveland last August 9. The

25-year-old rapper entered the plea on charges of rape, kidnapping and gross sexual imposition. He was freed after posting a \$10,000 bond.

## N.W.A. Rapped

N.W.A. group member Dr. Dre (Andre Young Jr.) pleaded no contest to misdemeanor battery in Los Angeles Municipal court in connection with an assault on "Pump It Up" host Dee Barnes at a private party last January. The rapper was upset with a TV spot on the show featuring former group member Ice Cube.

Judge Fredrick Wapner fined Young \$2,513, sentenced him to 240 hours of community service and put

him on probation for two years. In addition, Young was ordered to pay \$1,000 to the California Victims Restitution Fund and to produce an anti-violence PSA for TV. Barnes still has a \$22.7 million lawsuit against Young and the rest of the group, accusing them of "libel, slander and infliction of emotional distress." Commented Dre in Rolling Stone: "It ain't no big thing. I just threw her through a door."

By the time you read this, the 1991 MTV Music Video Awards gala spectacular will more than likely be a thing of the past. •Abbey Konowitch said absolutely *nothing* funny, witty or intelligent the entire night, but people still made him think he did.


•Tom Freston counted the minutes until he was back at the country club in Connecticut, sipping martinis.

## It's Just Too... Too!

Everyone knows Top 40 radio is currently in a down trend. Stations are leaving the format — going country, going Hot AC, going oldies, just plain going. Many think it's because of too much rap, or too much rock, or too much of something. Therefore, we've decided to take a look at some of the albums topping last week's chart the ones people are buying and help supply the proper excuses why they should not be programmed on Top 40. After all, if people are making the ultimate decision and plunking down their cash, it must be for records that are TOO SOMETHING OR OTHER.

Starting at the top with **Metallica** (Elektra) is easy: it's just too damn metallic. And Natalie Cole (Elektra) at #2 is too MOR. Bonnie Rait (Capitol) is easy again: It's too bluesy. (Ed note: Now we're on a roll.) Boyz II Men (Motown) is a little more difficult, but let's just say it's too BBDish — and BBD's new record will be too Boyz II Menish. Color Me Badd (Giant) has those great harmonies, so it's obviously too Wilson-Phillipsish. Halen (WB) is too Van Halenish, R.E.M. 
(Capt/Virgin) is too dance and Amy Grant (A&M), even with her new consciousness, is obviously too religious.

C&C Music Factory (Columbia) is too sweaty, Michael Bolton (Columbia) is too good friends with Warren, Extreme (A&M) is simply too extreme, and DJ Jazzy Jeff & the Fresh Prince is too much like watching TV. The Black Crowes (Def American) sold two million copies before having a hit, so they must be too popular, Tom Petty (MCA) is too Wilburysish, N.W.A. (Priority) is too street, Heavy D. & The Boyz (MCA) is simply too heavy, the Geto Boys (Rap/Priority) is too shot in the eye, Seal (Sire/WB) is too fishy, Garth Brooks (Capitol) is too country, Luther Vandross (Epic) is too good, Candy **Dulfer** (Arista) is too pretty and Lenny Kravitz (Virgin) was too Cosbyish when he was married to Lisa Bonet, but now is simply too available.

## Kiss Off

Former Kiss drummer Peter Criss is suing the publisher of the tabloid Star over a story describing him as a "homeless, hopeless alcoholic" who had abandoned his wife and was living on the Santa Monica pier. 



# DOIN' THE RAITT THING

"What is success? Is it doing your own thing/Or to join the rest/Should you truly believe/Keep trying over and over again/Living in hopes/Someday you'll end a winner?" The words are from an Allen Toussaint song Bonnie Raitt covered in 1974 on her "Streetlights" LP and — like so much else that has happened to the veteran singer/songwriter/guitarist over the last two years — destiny somehow fated to come true. It's no mistake Bonnie's dubbed her first album since the triple-Grammy winning, chart-topping "Nick of Time" LP, "Luck of the Draw."

The 41-year-old music business veteran made her recording debut 20 years ago and over time, she has experienced her share of near-misses and bad breaks. Things weren't always so great for the daughter of Broadway star John Raitt, which is why her current winning streak is doubly sweet. Raitt has overcome drug and alcohol abuse as well as being dropped by the only label she'd ever been on three years ago when Warners cut her and several

Did you feel any pressure to follow up the success of "Nick of Time"? I don't concern myself with that. I just make the music I like at the time and I mean that honestly. I'm not just being coy. I really can't be concerned whether anyone else is going to like my choice of music. If the record label believes in my taste, and that I can pull it off, then we've got a deal. If they don't, I'm off the label. This time around, we didn't even see the people from the record company until it was time to mix. For me, it's always the same process prepare the greatest songs I can find at the time, then go in and record them. I would have been worried had I not been able to come up with any songs of my own. But that's an implicit pressure every songwriter feels. I don't gauge success by how many records I've sold. Success means I've made a good record. What has winning those Grammys meant to you and your career? It's a big relief, y'know, to not have to worry about underpaying the band or playing places that aren't as full as they should be. It's given me the freedom to bring someone like Charles Brown on the road with me, a great rhythm & blues piano player and singer who deserves wider attention. It's made a lot of political groups I work with real happy because now I can actually give them some real money and

Having money is certainly better than not having money, but in my case, because I use the money for other things than padding my own nest, it has repercussions for other groups as well. My music isn't just about me — it's about what I stand for in terms of the kind of music I do, which I believe is deserving of broader recognition.

Someone like me straddles a lot of different styles. It was important to me for "Nick of Time" to get that kind of recognition from my peers let's face it, the Grammys are not the American Music Awards. Because of the oddity of winning four Grammys, I got on the first page of newspapers, which meant that the radio stations and record stores that wouldn't have normally paid any attention to me put the record in a front-of-the-bin type position. All of a sudden, the record went to #1 from the curiosity. We'll see if that curiosity holds over to people wanting to hear more. I personally have not heard radio playing a great deal of my kind of music. I don't hear anything like me on the radio. As long as you don't have to worry about whether you're gonna have an audience or lose your record deal, you're free to do what you want. I'm not going for the brass ring or the #1 record — I'm just trying to make a living and play some good music. There'd be a lot more pressure if I was 22 and this was my second

longtime roster mainstays in a massive housecleaning.

These days, Bonnie is satisfied both professionally and personally. She recently married actor Michael O'Keefe, a relationship whose inevitable ups and downs are chronicled throughout "Luck of the Draw." The new album marks a number of creative firsts for Bonnie — this time, she gets co-production credit with "Nick of Time" producer Don Was, and has also written four originals, including one, "One Part Be Wy Lover," co-authored with her new husband.

As a card-carrying member of the "thirtysamething" demo, Raitt's experiences have hit home with precisely that target audience. But don't think Bonnie's some spoiled baby boomer. In person, she is down-to-earth and plain-spoken. The trappings of success have never meant a great deal to Raitt, so all the Grammys and #1 albums haven't changed her one iota, as HITS' intrepid Sr. Editor and yuppie wannabe Roy "Bring Home The Bacon" Trakin discovered in this exclusive (to him) chat.



album. But it's not, In retrospect, did "Nick of Time" feel like a breakthrough to you? I don't compare albums. But "Nick of Time" had a certain purity of style to it. There was a particularly great choice of songs, mixed with an unadulterated production style. The seasoning and soulfulness of the people involved shows through in the music. And it's the same thing with "Luck of the Draw"—the same

draw attention to their causes.



mix of musical styles, the same fine songwriters and the same good performances. For some reason though, "Nick of Time" happened at the right time. It was a better presentation of what I do than maybe some of my other records were.

You co-produced and wrote several of the songs yourself this time.

My role really isn't that different this time --- we just made it official. Writing "Nick of Time" gave me the confidence to see if I could go to the well again. In fact, I started most of the songs for "Luck of the Draw" the week before the Grammys. I went away to see if I could come up with something, at least for my own sense of self-esteem, so if I did win, I wouldn't sit around wondering if I could do it again. I would've been disappointed if I couldn't come up with something as good as "Nick of Time" again.

I really would like to develop my skills as a songwriter. I have more opportunity to do so because I'm not wasting as much time doing the things I used to do. My lifestyle change has made that possible. Two of the songs which seem most personal — "Something To Talk About" and the title track — weren't even written by you.

"Luck of the Draw" is about a woman who's a waitress and a screenwriter on the side, which obviously I'm not. All of the songs are either about me or other people. I

don't need to be the "Angel from Montgomery" to be able to sing that song and feel it myself. And I don't need to be the woman in "All At Once," though I am the woman in the chorus singing it. I can't sing a song that has no meaning for me. I don't find it any less personal to sing a Paul Brady or a Jackson Browne song than to sing one of my own. "I Can't Make You Love Me If You Don't" is not a situation I'm in right now, but I sure do remember what it feels like. It would be pretty boring if I only sang about what I was going through exactly at the time. What you are going through is a pretty great time, being married and

in love.

Yeah, but that has its tangled and dark sections, too. Since when is any relationship all sweetness and light? The most challenging arena is matrimony, just in terms of being able to make it work. And that is a subject a lot of people in our generation are writing about. Because they're going through it. I'm not writing about making out in cars anymore. While I still love to do that, it's not the primary deep purpose in my life. I feel I should be writing about stuff that's adult, because I am an adult. There's pop and then there's a different, more serious kind of music, but that's the way it's always been. There's a deeper kind of angst written about by Randy Newman than is written about by Neil Sedaka.

Can someone who is content in their personal life create great music?

There are plenty of people that write and create great art who are happily married with children. I think it's a romantic myth you have to be fucked-

there's an instinctive difference between writing stuff that's illuminating and cathartic and being compulsively confessional.

By the way, how was the wedding? Great. We had about 90 people

up to sing rock & roll or miserable to sing the blues. I get miserable when I read the paper. I'm not happy all the time. I remember what it was like to have my heart broken. I get into arguments with my husband and I'm artistically unfulfilled when I can't come up with a lyric fast enough, I get mad at myself for not being perfect. And as much as I try to help the situation with my political wark, I sometimes feel I'm banging my head against the wall. And when I listen to the radio and hear only one kind of drumbeat, I get depressed. Nobody's happy all the time. There are challenges to being married and there's a fine line between exposing every underside of your relationship and being sensationalistic. To me,

there, enough to fit the family and some friends who were near by. It was very romantic and spiritual, really sweet, It was not anything I ever expected to do, so it came at a good time for me. I'm not of a generation that cared one way or another whether someone's married. You live together and, if you feel like it, you get married. It's not like you get a big "A" branded on your chest for not getting married. Il seems everyone is so happy for you because you're someone who has succeeded for all the right reasons.

That's a good thing to hear, I'm going through a really good period right now, and I know it. There's nothing better than being happy and



successful. People that are truly blessed usually feel truly blessed. But I know how fate can take it all away. It gives you the hand you're dealt. That's why this album's called "Luck of the Draw" — one minute you're down and the next you're up. My happiness is tempered by the fact there's a lot of unfairness in the world, so the only way I can live with the amount of good fortune I've had lately is to try to give it back to people. By doing the right thing with my money and time and trying to be a good friend instead of ignoring people.

As a very private person, how do you put up with public recognition? I don't put myself in a position to be tabloid fodder. The level at which I'm famous is pretty miniscule compared to others. I don't like celebrity. Being recognized and appreciated is a wonderful thing; having your privacy invaded is a drag. If you can't learn how to wear a hat and sunglasses and sit in a corner of a restaurant, you're in the wrong business anyway. I don't mind people coming up to me — it's just when they sit down at the table and try to eat my food I get a little irritated.

I've always had a great life. I've been a star for 20 years. When my name stops being on the marquee, and I have to go work for somebody else, I'll still be happy. I've been able to call my own shots. I've never not had an audlence and I've never not been able to play. For me, being unsuccessful would only mean having to do something I didn't want to do. Which I'll never do anyway.

### Bonnie Raitt's career is a textbook example that sometimes critical respect can make a difference.

That full-page Newsweek piece by Ron Givens on "Nick of Time" really started the ball rolling. He reviewed my record along with albums by Paul McCartney, Bob Dylan and Elvis Costello, but I was the lead. The article was all about finding your voice at a later stage In your career. And the rest of the press picked up on that. Do you feel vindicated by your suc-

### Do you feel vindicated by your suc cess after being dropped by your previous label?

Not at all. I'll feel vindicated when Ruth Brown and John Hiatt have #1 records. Then I'll feel we really made a difference. If this album does well on radio, maybe there'll be a deeper response to signing artists like myself. But the real change would be opening up progressive FM radio again to where Richard Thompson,



John Prine, Lyle Lovett, Taj Mahal and myself can get played. But people would still rather sell 14 million Guns N' Roses records than 500,000 John Hiatt albums. That's the bottom line. But tonnage ain't where I'm at. I listen to KCRW for a reason.

Unfortunately, the only blues I get to hear on a mainstream level is on TV commercials, If it's not sponsored by a cigarette, jean or beer company, you don't hear any slide guitar or harp. Unfortunately, It's usually by a cheaper, white version of the legendary black guy they could have gotten, It's just the nature of the game. I ran into Joe Smith the other day and we were joking about how Deep Purple and Black Sabbath used to pay the bills for Little Feat, Ry Cooder, Randy Newman and myself back in the old days. At Warners, none of us cared about tonnage. We just cared about the economics of doing well enough to make a living, have fun and create some great music.

It's just not the same. It wasn't an

industry then, it was the music business. Now, it's a major, corporate, multinational, bottom-line, quarterly, dump-the-fat business like any other. How come more left-leaning, politically active rock artists didn't protest the Gulf War?

It didn't last long enough. Do I agree with Jingoistic, pro-war attitudes? Of course not, I'm a pacifist. If It had gone on longer, I think there would have been a stronger response. It really was a unique situation that had more to do with teaching us about our own ability to turn human lives into a football game.

### Can you still reach that over-30 audience with rock & roll?

People hear music all over the place — movie soundtracks, "The Arsenio Hall Show," cable specials... It's not just the radio anymore. If there wasn't as much press or VH-1 response, I wouldn't be here talking to you. There are all kinds of ways to reach people. Someone told me the other day they heard a muzak version of "Nick of Time" playing in

Ralph's supermarket.

### Has sobriety been a major factor in turning around your career?

I don't think it's a coincidence. I think making the best record of my career wouldn't have happened if I hadn't made the changes I did. I think I made fine records before and I didn't make 'em drunk. I went through a dark period and came out a more mature, sober and clearer person who had come to terms with a lot of the demons. heartaches and dissatisfaction that is part of being an adult — all of which I was trying to deny. All of us who are going through that process are writing much more brutally honest songs about it. There are people out there living these lives just like I dld. And I'm one of the lucky ones to get through It. I have a lot of friends who didn't make It. This album is dedicated to Stevie Ray Vaughan because he did make it, yet he got snuffed out anyway. All of this can be gone in an instant and I'm just going to be grateful for what I've got.



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# TELLING IT LIKE IT IS

The look is World Wrestling Federation tough — brick-wall chest, basketball biceps, bullet eyes and a birthmark above the right eyebrow that's both distinguished and threatening. But when Aaron Neville opens his voice to sing, it's a soft, smooth and sweet sound that could carry in a church choir as easily as it does in the pop music world. "The voice of an angel and the body of a linebacker — I hear it all the time," says Neville, who, at 49, is the third oldest of New Orleans' famed Neville Brothers. The voice is commanding a great deal of attention these days. A quarter-century after his sole hit — the 1966 #2 "Tell it

Like It Is" — Neville struck Grammy gold this year with "All My Life" and "Don't Know Much," two of his four duets on Linda Ronstadt's last album. A leather-vested Neville is also featured in a new Gap clothing ad, and then there's the Ronstadt-produced "Warm Your Heart," Neville's first solo album in more than two decades. Neville seems poised to leap from cult and critical acclaim into well-deserved pop stardom, though the whole plan could easily have been put into jeopardy when he agreed to talk with HITS' own very earthbound, misfiring Detroit piston, Gary "Don't Call Me Steffi" Graff.

### Why have you waited until now to record a solo album?

We've been working hard getting the Neville Brothers name established. I had the chance to do something with Linda Ronstadt, and that got me heard a little more, so I figured, "Hey, why don't I do this now?" While we were touring together last year, I asked if she'd produce my solo album, and she was very excited about it.

How long have you known her?

I first met Linda in '84, when she was playing in New Orleans with Nelson Riddle during the World's Fair. Me and the brothers were playing at Pete Fountain's club, and after her gig, she came over. Someone told me she was in the audience, so I dedicated a song to her, called her up on-stage and sang some doo-wop with her. She said it was an honor for her to get to play with one of her favorite bands. She said she felt like Cinderella at the ball, which was very flattering to us. After the show she came backstage, and I asked for her autograph. I told her, "I'll sing with you anytime, any place."

You two sound so great together.
Any idea why?

I don't know. I like singing with her, and she likes singing with me. The first time we sang together, I felt like we'd sung together before, maybe in another life.

I'm not the first person to tell you what a great voice you have. How do you do it?

God gave me the voice. It's just emotion and feelings inside — feelings about the world, about the way I've been, things I've seen. Whatever comes out when I sing, that's what comes out. I've been singing "Tell It Like It Is" probably the same way for a bunch of years, but each night I get a different feeling from it.

You started singing at a very young age.

"The first time [Ronstadt and I] sang together, I felt like we'd sung together before, maybe in another life."

I remember as a young kid, sitting in my grandmother's lap on her rocking chair, listening to spirituals and singing along with them. My dad used to have lots of Nat King Cole records, and as a little bitty boy, I used to try to sing like him. My brother Art was a big influence, too. He and a bunch of older dudes used to hang out on a park bench, singing doowops and harmonies, beating on hub-

caps and Coke bottles for rhythm.
"Tell it Like It Is" will probably always be your signature song. How
did you first discover it?

It was written for me by Lee Diamond
— who's dead now — and George
Davis. That was their first song, too. I
had no idea it would be a hit. Art did,
though. I was into uptempo songs at
the time, but he said, "No, that's the

one right there, brother." And sure enough, it was. And still is.

Despite the hit, a bad royalty situation left you with no real money to show for the song. Were you angry?

I didn't have time to think about that. I had a family to take care of, so I went back home and did all kinds of work — longshoreman work, driving a truck, painting a house, whatever. I'd play on the weekends with my brothers — just to be able to sing was the most important thing to me.

How did you go about selecting songs for the new album?

I picked a few out, and Linda picked the rest. The whole idea of the album was to bring out the feeling of Louisiana and New Orleans. "Close Your Eyes" was one we talked about doing on her album, but decided to save for mine. "Warm Your Heart" was a thing me and Dr. John knew — we're the same age and used to hang out a long time ago, and he knew how to play it. "Please Stay" was by the Drifters, and I had to do "Ave Maria." Singing "Ave Maria" is like doing "Mona Lisa" — it makes me feel something special in there, like spiritual medicine.

### Are you ready for the kind of visibility that comes with having hit records?

Sure, it's great. I think it's right on time. It took where I've come from to get me where I am; it took who I was to make me who I am. I feel like everything has its time. There were times when I've thought about giving it up, but there's something inside of me that was always saying, "Give it time, keep going." A friend of mine who's seen me go through a lot of changes is always telling me, "Man, patience is a virtue." That's actually what I wanted to say when I got that Grammy, but I forgot.
