R.I.P. Bill


It's hard to imagine the world of rock & roll without legendary concert promoter Bill Graham, the son of Russian Jews who escaped the Nazis to carve out an empire which included venues like Winterland and the Fillmores West and East, along with successful management and merchandising companies. The entire industry mourns the 60-year-old Graham, who died in a helicopter crash last weekend.

Graham got his start when he organized a benefit featuring the then-unknown Jefferson Airplane for members of a San Francisco mime troupe he was managing who were arrested on obscenity charges. Graham went on to become the standard-setter and standard-bearer for the music industry as we know it today. His contributions were countless. His mark indelible.

The Most Added singles of the week at Top 40 radio are #1 Color Me Badd (Giant), #2 C&C Music Factory (Columbia), #3 Firehouse (Epic), #4 Motley Crue (Elektra) and #5 Richard Marx (Capitol). Last week's Wildcard, Marky Mark (Interscope), explodes and Tevin Campbell (Qwest/WB) comes flying out of the box. It's virtually unprecedented given the limited amount of radio airplay it's received. The phenomenon rockin' retail this week is DGC's Nirvana, whose "Nevermind" has rocketed to 23-9 in just its third week on the HITS Top 50 Albums chart.


Check out this action: 11-2 Vinyl Vendors, 10-2 Pro One-Stop, 11-1 Record & Tape Trader, 10-1 Streetside, 10-1 S.W. Wholesale, 50-5 Central South, 16-8 Tower National and 23-6 Wherehouse.

Chalk another one up for that classic combination of Post Modern radio and MTV exposure.

"It went Gold this morning" said DGC guru Bill Bennett, who added, "It's the kind of record that's breaking all the rules. Everyday the fences get torn down a little more."

"It's just great," said Manager Dunny Goldberg, who wondered if the band's meteoric success would help his political aspirations or get him booked on any late-night cable TV talk shows.

According to HITS Resident Retail Expert Mitch Perliss: "When a record sells, retailers make money." He's definitely worth the big bucks we pay him.

It expiodes 24-19 at Z100. pulls instant debuts at WZPL and fifteen others. Include PWR99. Adds KUBE, WHYT, WBBQ and tons more. This one's a sure thing, even with Rick Alden at the helm!

"My quote in the press release should be exactly 82 words, contain 324 syllables and end precisely five words from the right side of the page," said newly promoted Executive Arista Vice President/General Manager Roy "The Best Place To Smoke A Doob Is In The Parking" Lott, just before experiencing the horror of discovering one of the tassels on his loafers fell slightly askew to the left.

Promo Frustration!!

l've never seen lor heard) quite the level of frustration that exists these days in the highest ranks of record company promotion departments. It's getting harder and harder to close on legitimate records, harder to get a readina on developing records and harder to make it through Tuesdays with one's sanity in working order.

The following are the major reasons given:

Fragmentation 1. playlists. Dance stations won't play rock. Rock stations won't play rap. And mass-appeal stations can't figure out what the hell to do.

2. Major market records vs. small market records. (And rarely does the twain meet.) The latest bizarre trend is that programmers have decided certain records are all right for some markets, but not for others - even if they're really working where played.

Too many ballads. This one repeats itself every winter, and sometimes every summer. The problem is that ballads work, and lots of them. But it's hard to get them really rotated because they are plentiful, and the ones that do get rotated tend to stick around forever and block the next ones.

4. Less and less stations are willing to play rap and rock. It used to be that Top 40 was a catch-all format, playing the best records from all segments of the biz. But that simply is not so anymore, causing an extremely restrictive limit on the amount of stations available for even the biggest of these genres.

5. Too many records added for station promotions. These records

are added as favors and usually receive limited rotation, making it both difficult to determine their hit potential and blocking the way for spins on hotter product.

6. Country records are selling like crazy, but remain a dirty word at pop radio. This programming philosophy has lasted for quite some time, but sales are getting so big that some Top 40s are starting to cherry-pick records. One smash could change this around.

So, what's the answer? Basically, it's simple. Since stations will continue to program their playlists based on their own needs, promotion departments should work the records to the best of their ability for as long as possible, disregarding slow add weeks, and believing in their product. Will things ever get better? Probably, but not until the next big change in Top 40 radio, when someone like Mike Joseph comes along again to "re-create" a Top 40 format encompassing all types of music and heavily rotating currents. (Aside to Jeff Pollack, Don Benson, Jerry Clifton, Dan Vallie, et. al: This new "creator" will get very rich!)



AN EXCLUSIVE HITS INTERVIEW WITH HAMMER BY ROY TRAKIN

Hammer has a tough act to follow, and he knows it's gonna take more than dropping the M.C. from his name or his patented "Thief of Baghdad" pantaloons to top the 17-million-and-counting workdwide success of his #1 album, "Please Hammer, Don't Hurt 'Em," and his subsequent world tour, which played to sold-out houses in 23 countries around the globe. That's why he's agreed to meet the international press, which quickly learns Hammer Time runs approximately four hours behind everyone else's when the superstar strolls in at 3:00 p.m. for a scheduled 11:00 a.m. start. Seems Hammer's been up all night editing a video from his new album, "Too Legit To Quit," but he bounds in with his entourage ready to tackle any and all queries.

The new record represents a stunning departure from "Please Hammer." Intent on showing critics he can do more than sample other people's hits — as he did Rick James' "Superfreak" for his chart-topping single "U Can't Touch This" — and that his thematic reach extends to the problems of modern-day society, Hammer is rightly proud of the new record. The album ranges from the obvious dance-floor smashes like the title track and "The Addams Groove" to Marvin Gaye-influenced social commentary such as "Brothers Hang On" and "Street Soldiers," the jazz-funk fusion of his paean to the working class, "Good To Go," and the soaring gospel of "Do Not Pass Me By," featuring Tramaine Hawkins and a 35-voice choir. As Hammer's quick to point out, the disc contains not a single sample and all of it was played by live musicians, including his own discoveries Saja & the Homeboy Choir and an Earth, Wind & Fire-styled three-piece horn section. Other musical touchstones include Parliament-Funkadelic, Stevie Wonder and, natch, the Godfather.

Having already turned himself into a Saturday morning cartoon and popular pitchman for the likes of Taco Bell and Pepsi, Hammer's intent on having it both ways. With "Too Legit To Quit," he makes his bid to be accepted as a mass-culture figure and youth role model on the level of Michael Jackson as well as a serious artist. On the other hand, HITS' resident Falstaff figure, Senior Editor Roy "Don't Touch That, Touch This" Trakin is more than content to wallow in his own mediocrity.

Was "Too Legit To Quit" a direct response to critics of your last record?

They started calling me M.C. Sample. The problem is, the only way radio will play these rap guys is if it's a hit from the past. Most rap hits have been made out of records that were hits before. What they're saying in actuality is, rap artists are not authentic. They're guys who take music from the past, put a few words over it and go from there.

I feel I'm very legitimate in what I do. I can sit down in a studio with, say, Barry White, and help him make records. I can suggest chords to play, for the drummer to change his tempo or help with the melody and lyrics. From a musical standpoint, I can produce songs all day long. For people to think I'm only capable of sampling other people's records is wrong. And this album proves they're wrong. I took that criticism as a slap in the face artistically. It was like they were tellin' me, "Hey, man, you can't do nothin' but make a rhyme over an old record."

This was your way of showing people you could do much more than that.

In a big way. Once it was finished, I wanted to be able to sit down and listen to it from beginning to end and say, "Hey, this album has quality music." The tracks are structured songs. They don't just ramble on. They say something about the world we live in... about life, love and having a good time. It's a work of art.

Did you feel any pressure in trying to follow up as successful a record as "Please Hammer"?

I'll tell you why I didn't feel any pressure. I knew that "Please Hammer" was not my best work. Regardless of how many it sold. You can listen to that album and "Too Legit To Quit" for ten minutes and see they don't compare in terms of musicianship. "Please Hammer" was good for what it was, but it's no "Too Legit." It's not the album I'll play 25 years from now and say, "Look what I did." "Too Legit" is me. It's not Rick James or the Chi-Lites or Prince.

Aren't the hard-core rap fans going to feel you've abandoned them with this album or do you see rap evolving to the point where it's just another element in a mix which includes soul, R&B, gospel, funk, jazz and other black musical forms? Absolutely. Those who have ears will hear and appreciate the way I've fused different styles together. The bottom line is, when you put the needle to this particular record, you hear a quality production in terms of the way the rap wraps itself around and goes

Me By." It's a smooth ride.

In response to the hard-core rap audience, to be quite honest, there aren't that many of them. And they only like lyrics that are profane and degrading to women. I'm not going to lose sleep over losing those fans. I want people who like music, who hold others in high esteem and have self-esteem themselves. There's a place

through the music. They don't fight each other. They belong together. Look at the way rap and gospel work in "Do Not Pass

for gangsta rap, but it's separate from what I do.

I feel as though many people address these issues simply for monetary gain. Just because a rapper says something with an attitude or uses profanity doesn't suggest he means it. My social concern's backed up with charitable donations and charity work. I employ 165 people from the community in my organization. Most of the rappers who say they're concerned about things — it's all lip service. I'm more qualified to talk about these things than any of them. I'm a real voice from the streets. The people who are with me are the guys who've been in jail, who've seen drive-by shootings. I'm not impressed with these so-called gangsta rappers. I'm laughin'. Lock me in a room with 'em — I'll take their wallets. For the most part, these records are theatrical. If these guys did half the stuff they said they did, they'd be locked up. How many true murderers do you know that sit down and make records? (Ed. note: Slick Rick?) People have to separate what's real from what's not real. But I actually like some of those hard-core drama records.

As far as what those guys think about me — most of 'em admire me. Most are my friends. Eazy-E spent two and a half months traveling on my plane and introducing me before my show. Chuck D would be the first to tell you he's a good friend of mine. The press tries to make the separation. They're the ones saying the street guys don't like me. But it's not true. I think my view is a lot more real than these guys making records with their police sirens and gunshot sounds.

Are you still battling with Vanilla Ice?

Hey, there was never a feud between us. That was the press again. When Vanilla Ice and I see each other, we laugh. He just shouldn't let the media manipulate him like that. He let them twist what he said. I mean, some of the things he said, he said. But he didn't say all those things the press tried to say he said in regards to me, and I know that. That's why you'll never hear me criticize Vanilla Ice. I've always said this and I'll say it again. He's no Michael Jackson. He's not a valid contender. Most of his tricks he learned from me when he opened on my tour. He watched me from the first day to the last. By the time the tour ended, he was wearing my clothes. Which was OK with me. Except for the fact he wouldn't admit it. Speaking of Michael Jackson, your records are going to be out at approximately the same time. Do you relish the challenge of going head-to-head with Michael in the marketplace?

That's why I did an album like this. I had to make sure my gun was loaded, musically speaking. I couldn't go one-to-one with

Michael using samples. I built my whole game plan around going up against him. So many people are cowards who run from a challenge. I think it's great. He can't get his album out soon enough for me. He can even call me and I'll help him mix it. I respect Michael, but I'm gonna get at 'em. I'm gonna whup 'em, like young Cassius Clay did to Sonny Liston.

What kind of father are you?

I wish my daughter [four-year-old Akiba] were here to tell you. She wouldn't leave my side. Fortunately, and I can only attribute it to the grace of God, my daughter knows me very well, even though I've been home a total of two months over the last three years. If she were here right now, we could do a duet on "Have You Seen Her?"

And yet, one of the issues you address on the new album is the absence of the father from black families.

It's a large problem. I know, because I came up in a family of nine, raised by just my mother. I won't say if I'm married or not or what Stephanie's [the mother of his daughter] role is, but we all live together. Let me put it this way, I don't plan on ever leaving my daughter or her mother. Because I believe my daughter should grow up with her mother and father together. But there has to be some mystery in my life.

You take your image as a role model for kids very seriously. Don't get me wrong. I never said I was perfect. I've made mistakes and I still do. Hammer is not clean-cut. [Laughs.] There is dirt under this collar right now. I live in the real world with real people. What I try to provide for kids is the most positive image I can. I encourage kids to be themselves, to get an education, to not be followers. I've seen the guy who's making \$10,000 a week get shot on the corner with Uzis. I want to tell people to use their lives for something good. But I've done some things I'm ashamed of, too. I once stole a miniature race-car from Mervyn's and one time I was arrested for scalping tickets at a football game. But when push comes to shove, I'm not intent on painting a pretty picture of perfection. I'm just trying to help people.





Some people have criticized you for "selling out" rap by doing commercials.

Give me a break. Everything my jealous peers accuse me of they've done in a far worse way. If I sold out rap by selling Pepsi, what have they done by selling malt liquor to their own people? If I sold out rap by doing "U Can't Touch This," what are they doing touring with white rock bands? And that's not aimed at my friends Ice-T or Chuck D. I actually think it's a good move to open more people up to rap, but I'm using that as an example. When you say you're down with the people in the streets, but you don't give any money back to the community, who has really forgotten their people? We just get wrapped up in our emotions so often we sometimes don't realize what we're saying.

Marvin Gaye seems to be a particular influence on several songs from the album.

I'm a big admirer of Marvin Gaye. When I was doing songs like "Living In A World Like This" or "Street Soldiers," I knew subconsciously that was the feel I wanted, relative to today's times. What's going on now in 1991, from my standpoint. A lot of people have been making that comparison. For me, my job is done. Because that's what I wanted out of this album. Whether I sell one million or a hundred million, I'm getting my message across. And that is to create some awareness and controversy, so people can discuss and come up with solutions to the problems we face today.

On another note entirely, you're one of the few people with something nice to say about ex-Oakland A's owner Charlie Finley, who made you the team's batboy and then gave you a job in the front office.

He flew in for several of my shows last year. He wanted to market the "Hammer Time" watch. He's a great person, a real friend. I'm an Oakland A's fan for life because of Charlie Finley. I am what I am today because of him. The name "Hammer" came from my association with the A's. Being able to sit down and talk to you without having any prejudiced views comes from being part of the A's, which enabled me to work with people from different ethnic backgrounds and communicate with everybody.

Tell us about some of the high and lowlights of the KEGL-KHYI rivalry.

When you're pitted against programmers who get more press than the President, it can be somewhat intimidating at the onset, then you realize they're copying our liners word for word, our adds and even our promotions! At that point, you realize it's only their reputation that precedes them! Some highlights of our battle that come to mind are KEGL's image-enhancing Star Parties and private performances which have included artists such as Billy Joel, Marky Mark, Michael Bolton, Amy Grant, Firehouse and John Mellencamp just to name a few! I guess the "lowlight" has to be when KHYI attempted to use "Powerpig"-like tactics against KEGL. I hate stooping to that level, but when backed into a corner, it must be addressed. In the long run, that type of radio gives the whole medium a black eye. With KHYI bowing out of the Top 40 competition, you have no direct competitor. Who

do you see as your big rival now?

Whether KHYI is in the picture or not, any radio station targeting 18-34-year-olds is a rival.

How can you keep that competitive edge without a direct rival?

Keeping the competitive edge with no "direct" competition is relatively easy. We always try to outdo what we've already done. When we formulate something new, we are our own yardstick for excellence... not to mention "borrowing" ideas from great Top 40s out of the market. The switch in music emphasis you undertook was pretty risky. What enabled the move to work?

I actually think it would have been more risky for KEGL to keep a hybrid approach and achieve our overall ratings goal. When you have a limited universe of recurrents and Elmont, New York native Jimmy Steal graduated the University of Central Florida in Orlando. Don't tell us you never heard of it, because while he was still enrolled and wasting his parents' hard-earned money sleeping through Chemistry 101, Steal was also toiling at local station WDIZ as music coordinator and mid-day jock. From there, it was crosstown to Y106, where he was APD/MD. Steal headed for Dallas' KEGL, where he's been for five years — except for a brief stint at LA.'s "Pirate Radio" — most recently as Assistant PD/MD. It was here that HITS' probing radio proboscis Mike Murphy sniffed him out... and breathed him in, suffocating the poor guy in the largest nostrils this side of Mt. Rushmore.



oldies and are at the mercy of appropriate current product flow, a more mass-appeal direction becomes obvious. The beauty of a true Top 40 is you play the biggest hits of the day, a current reflection of mass tastes.

Today, KEGL plays everything from Prince to Garth Brooks! We try to keep the radio station palatable to as many 18-34s as possible. We've never in our history been beaten in that age category by KHYI. To continue to do this variety is the key. We'll gladly steal listeners from any format!




You're a Springsteen fanatic who loves the new Southside Johnny. Why should Top 40 play this record?

Bruce Springsteen and Southside Johnny are some of the last artists around who were touched by the original rock & roll flame. The current rock & roll climate, with music like the Black Crowes and the Commitments flourishing, actually makes real rock & roll fashionable again, as opposed to generic Journey/REO/Styx-type music. Top 40 should play this record first and foremost because it's a great record. The only thing that could stop it is programmers not seizing the moment. Hell, it's a great party song with a universal message about growing up! I won't even mention Bruce Springsteen sings on it.

Will Top 40 radio reign supreme again? The trends will turn back in favor of Top 40 when people who are calling the real shots figure out that radio is a medium that, to succeed, has to be programmed from the heart as much as it does from the mind.


