Major Tour Notes

After years of false starts, Prince has finally confirmed a tour of North America. He officially starts March 8th at the Sunrise Music Theatre in southern Florida. That show and the one the following night both sold out the 4,084 seat venue in short order and now a local radio station is leading a crusade to convert what had been scheduled as a tour rehearsal on March 7th into an added show. The tour is sticking to mostly theatres and small halls and is likely to result in Prince being one of the hottest tickets out there this spring. It is his first U.S. tour since 1987 and the first where he hasn't carried his own stage and enormous production. Someone must be giving the Purple One good career advice.....

Ozzy Osbourne has rejoined **Black Sabbath** and the original headbangers are expected to go into the studio to record in the coming months. Sabbath's most recent frontman, **Ronnie James Dio**, is out which comes as no surprise after he refused to take part in the November 14th joint appearance with the Oz at the Pacific Amphitheatre. Osbourne left Sabbath in 1979 to go it solo but he announced his '92 No Tears tour was his last as a solo performer. Who will manage the new Sabbath is unclear although **William Morris** is expected to be booking a tour for the band before the end of the year.....

As **Guns N' Roses** geared up for the next leg of its tour, which kicked off February 23rd at the Frank Erwin Center in Austin, the band, minus **Axl Rose**, rehearsed at the Miss. Coast Coliseum in Biloxi February 20th. The rehearsal was attended by 75 invited guests, contrary to an erroneous Associated Press report that only that many showed up for a publicly announced concert when Rose didn't show. And the hard luck GNR fans in Detroit will finally get to make use of the ducats they've been holding since the band cancelled four shows there last year; in January due to **Axl illin'** and again in April when police from St. Louis were trying to nail him for the Riverport riot.

MCA Asks Court To Curb Dispute

MCA Records filed a complaint for declaratory relief in Los Angeles County Superior Court February 19th against Curb Music in order to settle disputes that have arisen from a 1983 pact. The agreement entered that year concerned independent production and licensing and was amended in 1988. The major point of dispute seems to be the rights to the master recordings of **The Judds** which were originally released by RCA Records. The disagreement also concerns payment of artist royalties and promotion costs for

MCA/Curb artists. An MCA spokesperson said the suit is only an attempt to "clarify the relationship...and is designed to strengthen, not weaken, the joint efforts of MCA and Curb. By a judicial determination of the rights and duties of both parties, MCA will be better able to fulfill the needs of all MCA/Curb artists, and the relationship between MCA and Curb can only become stronger than ever." No damages are being sought by MCA. A Curb spokeswoman declined comment on the suit.

Mo, Irving & The Gentle Giant

Shonen Knife

Shonen Knife do not live on Earth. Well, yes they do, but Naoko Yamano, vocals/guitar, has clearly expressed her desire to live on Pluto, despite the fact that the planet has no oxygen. It's a surrealist point of view, and indeed one which perfectly expresses the aims and desires of this band from Japan: to take listeners somewhere else, weird, unknown and kinda kooky. Rounded out by Naoko's sister, Atsuko, on drums and Michie Nakatani on bass and occasional vocals, the band have been making Japan and other portions of the universe groove and chuckle for over a decade. Long the darlings of the underground rock world, Shonen just wrapped up a string of promo dates in the States, where longtime fans Thurston Moore and Kim Gordon from Sonic Youth, members of Redd Kross, and even Kurt Cobain showed up at gigs to "worship" their self-proclaimed gods. Naoko is happy to have their patronage, in fact, Nirvana and Sonic Youth insisted Shonen support them on past tours of the U.K. and Europe, and all three bands contributed to an indie release which featured over 30 American bands doing Shonen covers. With friends like that, Shonen Knife have nowhere to go but up, probably into the stratosphere if they had their choice.

"It was after we finish school. Me and Michie were bored so we decide to start a band, but we need drummer. I made a pretty flyer and put it on refrigerator. Soon Atsuko see. She made another pretty flyer and put it back. She said she would be drummer." As Naoko explained, so began Shonen Knife. It happened sweetly, yet another of the band's hallmarks. The music though, is something else entirely. As Naoko described, "It is like a candy. On the outside it is sweet, and on the inside is a peanut. Something hard to bite down on." Rather like an offspring of the Ramones meeting The B-52's and put in a blender, Shonen Knife are perfect for power pop pogoing. Shonen means "little boy" in English, so the band's name therefore means, boy knife, or a small children's pocket knife. Whoa. Shonen Knife is a state of mind and a damned unique one.

Let's Knife, the band's first full-length disc in English, is just out on Virgin Records. With song titles like "Cycling Is Fun," "Twist Barbie," "Riding The Rocket" and "Flying Jelly Attack," Naoko says the band uses deceptively simple ideas to get across important messages, but more on that later. From the cover photo (Atsuko designs and makes all of the band's distinctive stage wear), one might think Shonen Knife to be some kind of weird Japanese version of The Partridge Family, a mere novelty item, but let's set the record straight and Knife along. At a recent show at The Roxy in Los Angeles, one of Naoko's idols showed up, guess who. "We were playing and I see Lemmy from Motorhead in audience!! I was so excited. After show he came backstage. I ask him to sign my guitar and he did! ...I listened to British and American musics of 1960s and 1970s, like Beatles and Jam, but we like the heavier musics too. I write new song called 'Mongoose And The Cobra' which is really hard. Like Motorhead."

As Naoko said, beneath the sugar coated surfaces lay peanuts. The sweetness lures the listener, the peanut does the rest. "We are inspired by very many things, not just rocket ships, animals and

candy. We also like the controversial things." Take for example "Black Bass," which Naoko said is about environmental hazards; putting large predatory fish into small ponds. Behind the simple, humorous lyrics of "Flying Jelly Attack," she explained, lies a message. "I used to work at imported grocery store as cashier and I hate it. It was Christmas time and the man who ran store tell me to work harder because there are so many people. So there are many people shopping and it gets busy, so always they are running around store and it looks like jelly beans are flying. It is about people spending too much money." But overall, she said the band's aim is, "...to see the people and communicate with them, but we also like to tell people to have fun and to make them happy."

After another support slot with Nirvana at this year's Reading festival in the U.K., at which they played in front of 50,000 punters, Shonen returned to Blighty in late November, where they toured for a month and a half. Naoko asserted they won over many skeptics along the way. After an appearance on television, "People recognize us on street, hotels and airport. They come up to us and say, 'We see your show!' Or, 'We see you on TV!' People said we make them happy and that makes us happy!" One of the more amusing things to happen to Shonen involved a surprising emulation of their support act. Seemingly without effort, Naoko, Atsuko and Michie elevated the mundane to the weird, and must have left more than a few Scots scratching their heads. "On tour we had the support of BMX Bandits. They are from Scotland, so when we go on tour, they say things to us and we cannot understand the way they speak Scottish. Time went by and by the end of tour, we understand and learn to speak with Scottish accent."

The group often plays in 3,000-5,000 seaters at home, but the exact nature of their dates when they return to the States for a prolonged visit in June is yet to be worked out. There have been rumors that a Lollapalooza stint is possible, but until then, the band are busy writing songs for another album back in their hometown, Osaka, and just... well, being Shonen Knife. Naoko believes the band's brand of wackiness will catch on big time in the States, but for now: "I love to make music, but also I love to collect guitars. I have 40. They are mostly cheap and from the second hand stores. I love to cycle, but I am so weak and lazy that I do not go to cycling track. I just put up my bike and cycle inside my house and play with my cats, one, his name is 'Eyebrow' in English." Paraphrasing Rod Serling: Submitted for your approval, Shonen Knife.

He plans to permanently relocate to NYC sometime between April and June..... Rod Essig has become the third agent hired for the growing CAA operation in Nashville. The longtime Variety Artists agent's appointment went into effect February 22nd. He didn't take any Variety acts with him to CAA and said his booking territory has yet to be determined..... Richard Evans has been named to the new post of executive veep and chief operating officer of Gaylord Entertainment, the company that owns the Grand Ole Opry, TNN, and Opryland, among other things. Evans has previously served as CEO/president of both Madison Square Garden Corp., and Radio City Music Hall Prod..... Fred Suss has been appointed assistant GM for the South Shore Music Circus and Cape Cod Melody Tent in Massachusetts. Suss was an agent with the New York office of William Morris from 1981-1991.

The Maine Stop On The Concert Trail

Residents of Maine may snag a few dates on this summer's major tours if the town councils of Scarborough and Old Orchard Beach have anything to do with it. Don Law Company was awarded rights to hold concerts at Scarborough Downs racetrack after it was ruled the facility complies with a town ordinance requiring concerts to be held in a fully enclosed space. Some of the town fathers had argued the ordinance meant an indoor venue. The chain-link fence surrounding the racetrack's infield was deemed satisfactory to meet the zoning requirement. The Boston promotion company will stage between one and four concerts between April 15th and October 31st. The racetrack has the capability to seat 45,000 outdoors. Holding concerts in Old Orchard Beach may be a little trickier though. Promoter Frank Russo had sued the town last year, contending its noise ordinance made it impossible to operate out of his SeaPac venue on the site of an unused baseball stadium, which is situated in the middle of town. Russo later retired from the concert business and the matter died. Now the council is negotiating with Montreal-based Donald K. Donald and another company with an office in Portland, Maine, Entertainment Fund Inc., to promote concerts there once again. The council is looking into making it easier for the next promoter to hold concerts and still meet the noise ordinance by limiting attendance and prohibiting "heavy metal" bands.

A Naked Soul In Fresno

Scotti Bros. Records' group Naked Soul was forced to cancel its tour after a van carrying the band's equipment was carjacked following a February 17th show at the Cadillac Club in Fresno, Calif. Singer/guitarist Mike Conley was filling the van with gas when two men jumped in and drove off. Unbeknownst to them, drummer Larry Pearson was sleeping in the back. When Pearson awoke, the carjackers held him at gunpoint, robbed him of cash and his wedding ring (he had been married only two weeks), and then fled with several instruments, including two vintage Les Paul guitars. Local police are still searching for the missing equipment, as well as suspects, and the band is off the road attempting to get compensation from their insurance company.

Farm Aid VI Lineup Announced

Willie Nelson has unveiled the lineup for Farm Aid VI, which will take place April 24th at Cyclone Stadium in Ames, Iowa. In addition to Willie and Farm Aid regulars Neil Young and John Mellencamp, those scheduled to appear include Ringo Starr, Paul Simon, Alice In Chains, Johnny Cash, Dwight Yoakam, Bryan Adams, Ricky Van Shelton, Fabulous Thunderbirds, Soundgarden, Travis Tritt, and Levon Helm. Roseanne and Tom Arnold, Lou Diamond Phillips, Williams & Ree, and Yakoff Smirnoff will host the show, portions of which will be broadcast on TNN.

A SoundScam Detected

SoundScan CEO Mike Fine has revealed that the company discovered a small indie retailer in Raleigh, N.C. tried to manipulate the point of purchase system by falsifying sales information on four R&B singles. Fine said he discovered on February 2nd upon review of the retailer's report that the four singles had sold 10 to 20 times more than any other outlet in the nation. The singles were SWV's "I'm So Into You" on RCA, S.O.U.L. S.Y.S.T.E.M's "It's Gonna Be A Lovely Day" on Arista, Tisha's "Push" on Capitol, and AZI's "Trust In Me" on Scotti Bros. Apparently, the Raleigh merchant repeatedly put unsold copies of the singles through his bar code scanner. Officials at BMG and EMI Music said their companies had nothing

to do with the incident and they condemn any attempts to falsify SoundScan data. Instead, fingers were pointed at Rich Weinman, owner of indie promotion firm Best Performances Inc. in New York. Weinman acknowledged to the Los Angeles Times that he had sent a letter to record companies saying his company could manipulate the SoundScan system through retailers who could fix their sales figures. However, he said the letter contained a typographical error, that he wasn't offering to falsify information, and that the retailer must have misunderstood his intentions. Fine said he contacted the retailer and warned him that SoundScan wouldn't tolerate anyone manipulating the system.

Supreme Court Gives Chuck Berry The News

The U.S. Supreme Court ruled without comment that Chuck Berry is not a victim of racism and therefore must face charges in his native Missouri state court, stemming from the alleged videotaping of hundreds of women using bathrooms at his Southern Aire Restaurant in Wentzville. Two women involved in the suit, and who also coincidentally were videotaped, have stated that Berry's charges of racism have no credence. In a related incident, the 8th Circuit Court of Appeals also rejected an attempt by Berry's lawyers to invoke a civil rights law which would have transferred pending prosecution and invasion of privacy suits stemming from Berry's alleged marijuana use and videotaping of nude minors to federal court. Berry claims he was a victim of racism and that evidence against him was obtained on an illegal raid on his home

in 1990. That raid resulted in a misdemeanor conviction for possession of marijuana.

Elton Plays Cricket Down Under

Elton John was forced to cut short his encore at a February 19th gig in Melbourne, Australia, after a swarm of grasshoppers invaded the stage. The insects reportedly landed in Captain Fantastic's hair and mouth, and also wreaked havoc with audience members as the stage became a slippery mess of crushed crickets. Despite the insectal stage diving, John performed for nearly two hours. The outdoor venue at the National Tennis Centre was fumigated before the next night's show.

It Must Be The Year Of The Jackyl

Jackyl frontman Jesse James Dupree was arrested February 20th following a show at the Orange Pavilion in San Bernardino, Calif., where they supported Damn Yankees. Dupree took off his clothes at a February 17th Long Beach Arena gig and reportedly appeared to simulate masturbation. After receiving complaints, the Long Beach police followed the band into the next county and arrested Dupree after the band finished its set. Dupree was charged with indecent exposure and obscene live conduct. He was released the next day after posting \$10,000 bail. His case is scheduled to be heard March 4th in Long Beach Municipal Court.

Short Items Of Note

Harry Nilsson, 51, suffered a heart attack at his Los Angeles home February 14th. Nilsson is in Cedars-Sinai Hospital where he is listed in "fair and stable" condition..... Sting was forced to postpone three of five Miami warmup gigs at Gusman Center after contracting the flu. In order to make up the dates, ticket holders from several of the shows scheduled for the smaller Gusman venue will be accommodated at a February 26th show at the larger James L. Knight Center..... It looks as though Eddie Murphy will tour behind his latest effort, *Love's Alright* on Motown Records. Motown has plans for Murphy to tour Europe in late summer, possibly, in a strange pairing, as support for Bon Jovi. Murphy's band reportedly includes Larry Graham, Ernie Isley, and possibly Herbie Hancock on keyboards. After doing Europe, Murphy is talking about touring the States in a show which would mix his music and stand-up comedy..... While in Baltimore to promote his soft drink, Jocola, Joe Jackson defended himself against the

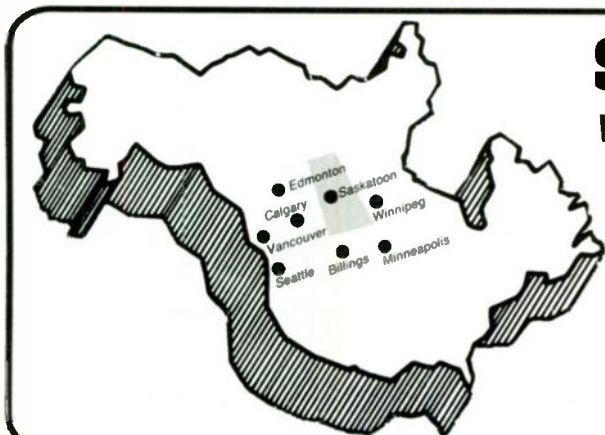

GRP Records has branched off from its contemporary jazz and NAC roster to create **MCA/GRP Records**, a subsidiary label dedicated to pop, adult contemporary and urban artists. MCA / GRP product will be marketed and promoted by GRP domestically and by MCA and Geffen internationally. MCA acquired GRP in 1990 but the label continues to operate fairly autonomously out of NYC, where MCA/GRP will also be located..... Lagos, Nigeria papers have reported that famed world beat musician **Fela Anikulapo-Kuti's** bail hearing on a murder charge was postponed until March 2nd, in order to give the prosecution time to study the case file. Fela and four associates were charged with conspiracy and murder following the suspicious death of a man believed to have been an electrician at Fela's Afrika Shrine club. If convicted, all four men could face the death penalty..... Los Angeles Judge Robert O'Brien has refused to temporarily lift curfew restrictions against the **Hollywood Palladium** while the venue attempts to work out a compromise with the City Council over its curtailed hours of operation. Palladium owners say if the curfew isn't changed the building will be shut down permanently. And a correction: **Tim Stinson** is a rep of WG Prod., and is not Marky Mark's manager, as was incorrectly reported in last week's story about the Palladium. The Calvin Klein kid is still managed by Dick Scott.

DCC Configuration Means More Meat On Table

MCA will release *Bat Out Of Hell II* in April.

Mercury Puts New Acts On The Road

Mercury Records is trying innovative touring and marketing schemes for four new hip-hop acts and three new country artists. To expose college and high school students to Mercury's Diamond, Nefertiti, Dougie Dee and Yaggu Front and to get the acts' touring feet wet, the Hip-Hop College Tour will kick off in mid-March hitting campuses in 15 cities across the country. In an agreement with host campuses, the hip-hop acts will play concerts free of charge, take part in career day seminars, campus promotions, interviews and local retail visits. Mercury staffers will also be on hand to speak on careers in the music industry.

Any money raised from admission or merchandise will be donated to a community charity of the schools' choice. Mercury Nashville will be taking new country artists Shania Twain, Toby Keith and John Brannen on a Triple Play tour of country dance clubs in 15 Southern cities. CAA Nashville's Ron Baird is booking the tour, which kicked off February 26th. To keep costs down, the artists will be backed by the same Triple Play band made up of seasoned session musicians. CAA's Rob Light used the same Triple Play concept with a trio of new rock acts several years ago.

Damned Shreveport Society

Society Of The Damned filed suit against the city of Shreveport, La., over a canceled August 1st concert by the parks department. The thrash metal band was to headline the show at Dickson Park but, according to the suit, it was scrapped after a parent complained when the show was advertised as an underground music festival and free speech rally. However, the city said it canceled the concert because the band didn't follow city guidelines in organizing the event. According to an ACLU attorney, the suit claiming violation of free speech rights was filed as a last-resort after months of talks with city officials, who failed to reschedule the concert. Parks director Johnny Ford said the band could play Dickson Park on its own, but the department doesn't want to sponsor a concert headlined by the Damned. A sponsorship by the department waives fees for the use of the park, stage, sound and lighting systems, and security.

Obituaries

Toy Caldwell, 45, died during the morning hours of February 25th at his home in Spartanburg, N.C. The actual cause of death was unknown at press time, however he had a chronic bronchial condition which reportedly had severely worsened in recent weeks. Caldwell was a founding member and guitarist / vocalist of the Marshall Tucker Band. Last year, he released his first solo effort for Cabin Fever Music. Plans are already underway to stage a tribute and benefit concert, which would assist his wife and two teenage daughters..... **Al Rivers**, 65, original member of the Ink Spots, died from cancer February 17th in Portland, Ore. Rivers founded another Ink Spots group in 1985 and toured the Northwest until his illness forced him to stop.

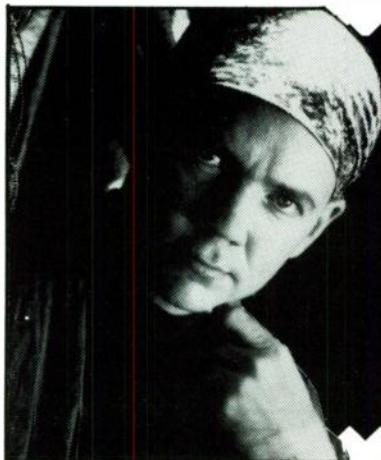

35th Annual Grammy Awards ★

The 35th Annual Grammy Awards were held February 24th at the Shrine Auditorium in Los Angeles and Eric Clapton proved to be the artist of the evening. Slow Hand took away six of the nine Grammys he was nominated for. The soundtrack to "Beauty And The Beast" was also a big winner with four awards, and other multiple winners included Stevie Ray Vaughan, Linda Ronstadt, The Chieftains, Vince Gill, and Arrested Development, who was honored as best new artist. The ceremony featured performances by those nominated for record and song of the year, in addition there were particularly memorable performances by Peter Gabriel, in a fashionable prosthetic chest, Red Hot Chili Peppers and En Vogue. Michael Jackson was also scheduled to perform, however he decided to use the time to continue in his chatty mode of late, giving a long and surprisingly revealing and witty acceptance speech as he accepted the Grammy Legend award from sister Janet. He also took advantage of the situation to say, "I hope this puts to rest -- finally puts to rest -- another rumor that has been in the press for years," Jackson said as he pulled Janet close.
