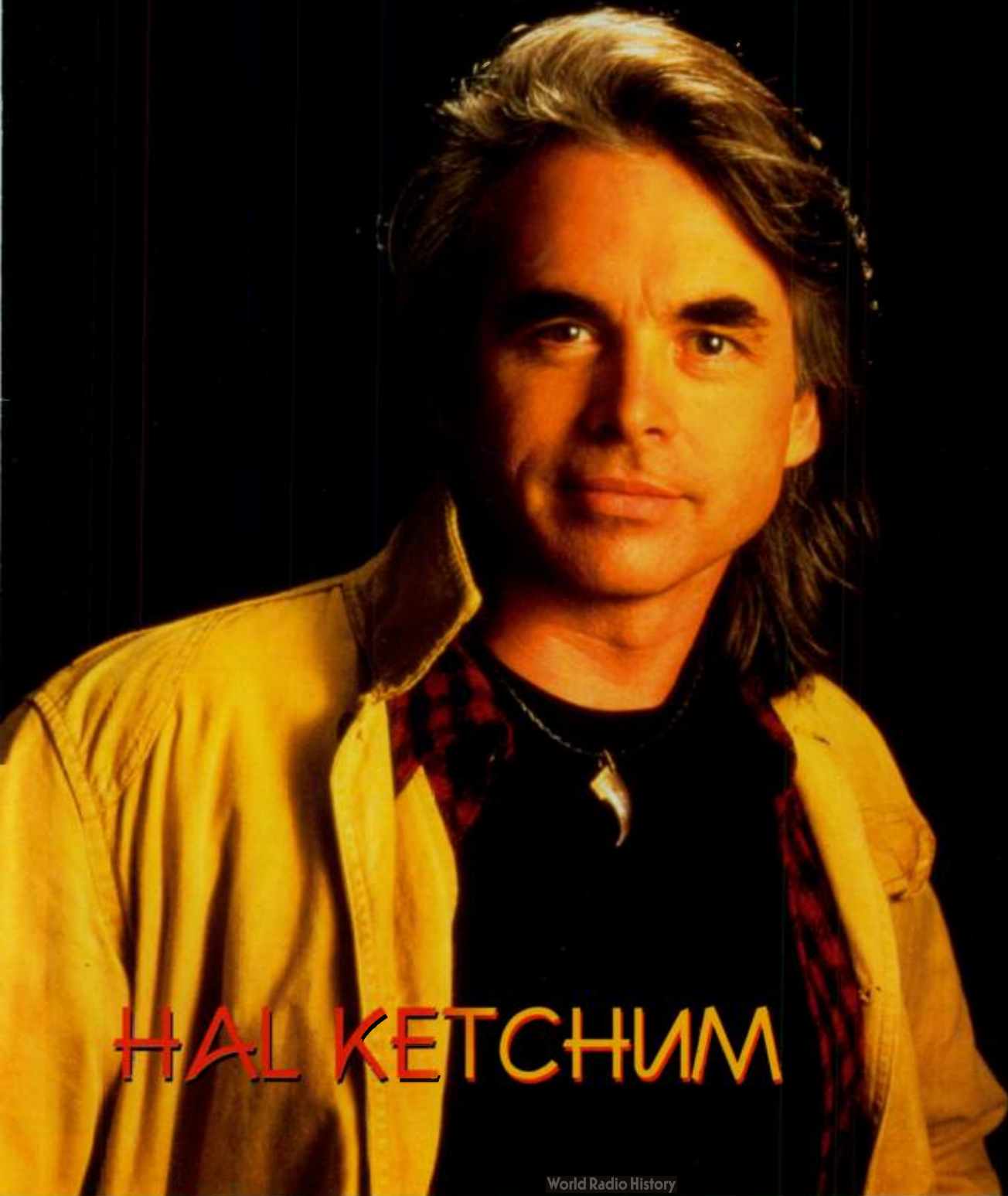


## McGhee & Associates Buy LMI

Leisure Management International, one of the top five private facility management companies, has been acquired by Mike McGee and his two partners, Houston businessmen Morton Cohn and Douglas Schnitzer, from majority owner John McMullen. In addition to his LMI duties, McGee is also well known within the industry as the manager of The Summit arena in Houston. All three of the new owners had been minority investors in LMI since its inception. McGee said, "LMI's financial resources and depth of operating expertise will allow the company to grow exponentially. The opportunities for expansion are significant and LMI is ready to catapult to the next level." John Blaisdell has been named president and chief operating officer of LMI. Cliff Wallace, the former president and CEO of LMI, will assume new responsibilities as president of Leisure Management Nashville, which was established to pursue a management contract for the new Nashville Arena which is projected to open in the Spring of 1996. Aside from The Summit, LMI also operates the Miami Arena, James L. Knight Center, Monroe Civic Center, The Pyramid Arena, Gwinnett Civic Center, Ponchartrain Center, and Palm Springs Convention Center.

## Changes At the Top Of Virgin Records

Virgin Records America named Phil Quartararo president and CEO following the August 9th resignation of Jeff Ayeroff and Jordan Harris, who had been co-chairmen of VRA since last year's consolidation of the Virgin and Charisma labels. Before the merger, Ayeroff and Harris had been co-managing directors since the founding of the company in 1986. Ayeroff and Harris said they agreed to stay on at Virgin long enough after EMI purchased the company to see it through the transition. They said now was the best time to leave, with Virgin having three albums and three singles in the Top 10. Industry insiders, however, speculate that the resignation was due more to significant power changes brought about by Virgin's acquisition by EMI in March 1992. Some even speculated that it might be Quartararo who would depart Virgin amidst the rumored infighting. Quartararo joined Virgin in 1986 and headed the launch of Virgin's second label, Charisma Records in 1990. He will now report to Ken Berry, the chairman and CEO of the Virgin Music Group Worldwide. Thus far, Virgin is the only major EMI owned label which hasn't fallen under the domain of Charles Koppelman.

# HAL KETCHUM

From dream to reality, Hal Ketchum feels he has achieved his aspirations, but it wasn't without dislocations. Less than four years ago you could hire him for as little as \$10 to \$15 dollars an hour, not to serenade you with song, but to rebuild your ailing kitchen cabinets or remodel your entry way. But today Hal Ketchum has achieved a successful career as a singer/songwriter.

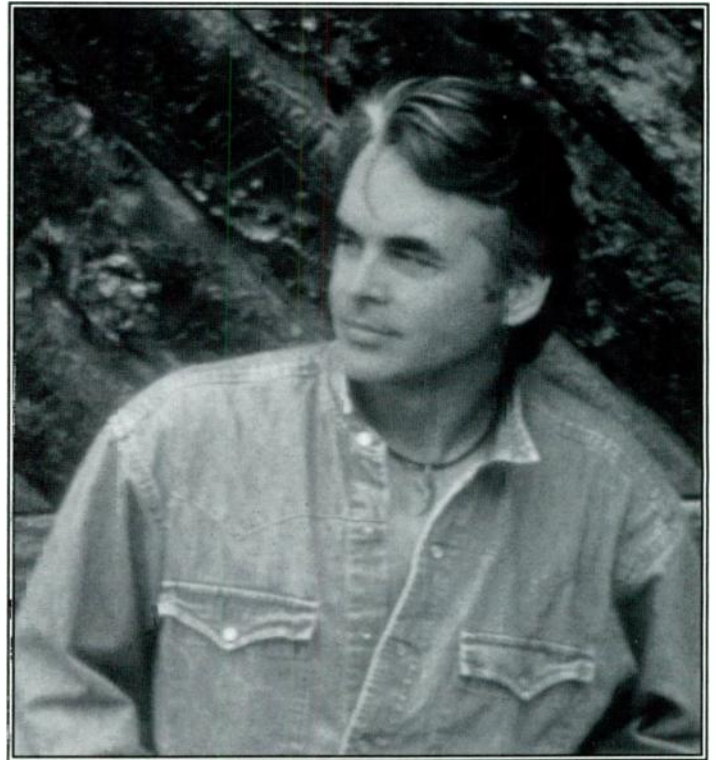
"I'm finally realizing that this [music] is what I was meant to be doing," said Ketchum, "however, I think that had I known how tough it really was I might not have gotten in as readily as I did. I thought you basically get up there and you sing, the record label gives you a bus and a bunch of money, but we all know it's a lot deeper than that....I feel like I've learned a lot and one of the most important things I've learned was to mind my own shop. Not to pay a lot of attention to what anybody else is doing, but to find the best, the most expedient, and the most cost-effective way to get my music to the people."

Once Ketchum's songs began to take shape, he astutely felt the need to physically meet the people who would be crucial in helping him get his career off the ground. This was not an easy task for an inherently shy man who was not one to blow his own horn. "I can't overemphasize the importance of going to meet the PD's and MD's at the country radio stations, it's the most critical front-end part of any one's musical career, and it was a big step for me. I've kind of chosen my own path and I didn't get to open for a lot of headliners."

Ketchum likes to play an eclectic mix of environments. "I played the Orange County Performing Arts Center in Costa Mesa, Calif., which is a remarkable architectural and acoustic structure, and from that I went to a cotton warehouse in Quitaque, Texas, which was one of the best shows I've had. It was a great musical experience. I'd love to make a live record there. I'm to the point now that I just love playing so much that....we can go anywhere in the world and have a good time, musically. People will take that energy over all the bells and whistles any day, I'm convinced of that. The audience knows when your faking it, and when your not. And so throwing myself into it musically first, has allowed me to savor the environment no matter where it is."

Ketchum feels he's in a position of privilege being a performer and that the stage really has become a place for him to go and be spiritually involved. It's his church. When the audience see's him pour himself into his work they really get behind it. "As a writer and as a singer, I can climb inside these songs and actually have some control over my life for three to four minutes at a time."

Hailing from up-state New York, Ketchum decided in 1981 that he wanted to move west and see what life would be like somewhere else. So with a job opportunity in San Antonio, he set his sights on locating an environment where he could really woodshed his act, where he could have access to endless nightclub opportunities, and where a guy could go and not wear out his welcome. He discovered his haven in New Braunfels, Texas at the historic Gruene Hall nightclub which has been a hangout for



country music traditionalists dating back to Ernest Tubbs. While attending school in San Marcos, George Strait used to play there every Saturday night. "Gruene Hall really was music school for me, I learned a lot about how to write there."

After spending a few years in Texas honing his musical skills, Ketchum's popularity began to increase and with the release of his self-produced first album, he decided it was time to pack up his gear and move to Music City. "It's been good for me in Nashville. I'm very fortunate here. I've married the most remarkable woman who is unflappable. She has been in the music business for 20 years, 15 of which has been devoted to publishing music, to her this [entertainers lifestyle] is not something she's particularly impressed with. To her it's just life. We're enjoying it, and it's good to be in an environment with someone who probably has a deeper understanding about the business than I do."

Another person who is also held in high regards in Ketchum's world is his former manager Dick Whitehouse who runs the country division of Curb Records. "When I met Dick, I had been shopping my first release, *Threadbare Alibis*, and I had talked to a lot of people, but when I met with Dick he spoke in a musical language that I appreciated and he asked me what I wanted to do, and saw that I wanted to do my songs my way and has supported that concept from the beginning.

Ketchum is now under the managerial guidance of the Fitzgerald Hartley Company which has offices in Los Angeles and Nashville. Booking is coordinated by responsible agent Bobby Cudd at Monterey Artists. Ketchum really appreciates the fact that they are both companies which share the same vision as himself when it comes to live performances. "Something about all of this, that's so important to me, is that there's no separation between live performance and recorded performance and writing songs, and singing songs. There's just no line anymore, there's absolutely no way to discern one from another, it's all become one big loop."

## Penguin Found Innocent

A captive audience of 12 jurors decided that Robin Vann's lawsuit against Gallagher and his 2-foot-tall stuffed penguin was for the birds, when they turned down her bid August 6th for more than \$33,000 to pay medical bills, lost wages and damages, which she claimed were caused by the penguin hitting her in the head during one of Gallagher's shows. The jury and the judge had a difficult time keeping straight faces when Gallagher testified August 4th in Santa Ana Superior Court. Gallagher wisecracked on the stand claiming his penguin, which concealed a fire extinguisher which he uses to spray water at his audiences, was innocent. Vann's attorney called Gallagher's testimony the most ostentatious, crazy exhibition he had ever seen by any witness.

## A Bad Loser

Hugo Zuccarelli, inventor of the three dimensional Holophonics recording system which was used on Michael Jackson's "Bad" album, was convicted and sentenced August 5th for, essentially, being a bad sport. Zuccarelli, who had filed a \$40 million trademark infringement suit against Jackson and Sony Music, was found guilty of three counts of misdemeanor battery for punching Lawrence Iser and shoving Eve Wagner, who represented Jackson in the suit, and hitting Sony Music attorney Tim Alger, after the court dismissed the trademark infringement suit in March. Zuccarelli, who claimed Jackson, his production company and record label used the Holophonics system on the album without paying royalties, was sentenced to three years probation, 60 days of highway work detail, \$3,520 in fines and no less than nine months of psychiatric counseling.

## Forever In The Studio, Forever In Court

Paula Abdul took the stand to deny allegations that her singing on her "Forever Your Girl," received major uncredited help. Abdul told a federal jury July 27th in Los Angeles, that Yvette Marine sang only selected background parts and had "no input" into the lead vocals. Ms. Marine claims that she sang lead vocals on four of the hits and was only credited with singing backup. Producer Antonio "L.A." Reid, who co-wrote and co-produced one of the songs Marine claimed to sing lead on, has stated publicly that her contribution was minimal at best. An expert witness from the Univ. of California, Santa Cruz used recordings by Barbra Streisand, Bob Dylan and Willie Nelson to demonstrate his voice print computer graphic technology which, he said, showed that Paula Abdul sang lead vocals on her own album and Yvette Marine did not.

## The Trial Of Rick James

Rick James' assault trial got underway August 11th after his girlfriend and co-defendant, Tanya Anne Hijazi, pleaded guilty to assault with a deadly weapon. James and Hijazi were charged with assault with a deadly weapon, aggravated mayhem, torture, forcible oral copulation, making terrorist threats and furnishing cocaine stemming from an incident at James' Hollywood Hills home in July 1991. Prosecutors said that James tied a woman to a chair, burned her with a crack cocaine pipe and a heated butcher knife and forced her to perform sex acts. While awaiting trial in that case, James and Hijazi were both accused of attacking another woman at the St. James Club in West Hollywood. Charges in that case include assault with a deadly weapon causing great bodily injury, false imprisonment, sale or transportation of cocaine and kidnapping. Hijazi's guilty plea was for that November 1992 incident at the St. James. She now expects to be sentenced to four years in prison with all other charges against her to be dropped. Hijazi appears to also be a victim of James' physical and mental abuse, according to Deputy District Attorney Andrew Flier. She has not agreed and does not plan to testify against James. Friends and associates of James have said all the trouble he has gotten into stems from his cocaine abuse. In both of the pending cases, James told police the women were trying to steal cocaine or money from him. If convicted, he faces a possible life prison term.

## Bon Jovi Raises 100K For Flood Victims

## Grateful Dead Sue Warner Bros. Over Royalties

The Grateful Dead filed a complaint in Los Angeles Superior Court August 3rd against Warner Bros. Records and Warner Bros.-Seven Arts Records, alleging Warners erroneously listed albums that were sold as promotional freebies. The group has been recording for Arista for several years but many of its earlier albums were released by Warners. The Grateful Dead's attorney, Martin Jacobs, told POLLSTAR that there are some serious allegations in the suit, but he would give no further comment, stating that the group did not want to try the case in the media. The suit seeks payment of all royalties due plus interest and unspecified punitive damages.

## Deals, Moves & Changes

Ruthless Records has made a marketing and distribution deal with Relativity/RED which went into effect with its August 12th announcement. The first release to pass through the RED indie pipeline will be Blood Of Abraham. Ruthless is the label headed by Eazy-E which really helped define the gangsta rap genre.... In an effort to give them a better marketing hook, the three year old Florida Suncoast Dome in St. Petersburg was officially renamed the ThunderDome August 5th.... Charley Pride is the latest country singer to announce he's putting up a theatre in Branson. The new 2,000-seat Charlie Pride Theatre is expected to open in April.... Mel Tillis, who has had a successful 2,200-seat Branson theatre for several years, is building a new 2,600-seat theatre, which will open next spring, because he's had a falling out with his current partner. Tillis does not have a current record deal but he seems to be doing fine without one. He now releases his music on his own Radio Records label and claims to have sold about 100,000 copies of his product, which is only available at his theatre.... The now shuttered El Rancho Hotel & Casino in Las Vegas is being bought by Beverly Hills-based Las Vegas Entertainment Network Inc., which plans to reopen the 22-acre property as the family oriented Country Land USA Hotel & Casino.... The world's largest gaming casino may soon be located in New Orleans. Harrah's Jazz Co. was selected August 11th over rival bidders including Caesars World, which had been considered the frontrunner, to build Louisiana's only land-based casino on the site of the Rivergate Convention Center. The construction and opening of the casino will be done in

phases, with a 40,000 square-foot temporary casino targeted to open in the first quarter of 1994.... After four seasons performing the Monday Night Football theme, Hank Williams Jr. is out of the lineup and viewers will see a different performer each week. Scheduled for the show's musical openers are Vanessa Williams, KISS, Boyz II Men, Billy Ray Cyrus and kicking the ball off in a blaze of glory September 6th will be Jon Bon Jovi. You might note that the singers are all from PolyGram Records.... Speaking of PolyGram, the company has made a deal with World Cup USA 1994 which covers rights to several areas including concerts, videos, and a theme compilation album. The first major event to be announced, other than the soccer matches themselves, is the July 16th final concert at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles featuring Placido Domingo, Luciano Pavarotti and Jose Carreras. The event is being co-produced by Tibor Rudas on the night before the World Cup final match, with tickets ranging from \$15 to \$1,500.... WEA president/CEO Henry Droz has announced he will retire at the end of this year. David Mount, the current head of Live Entertainment, will join WEA next month and will work as co-president/CEO with Droz until he departs. Prior to joining Live five years ago, Mount spent 11 years with what was then Warner Communications, as a sales VP.

## Jett-ing Off Without Paying The Bill

Three Birmingham, Ala., attorneys are trying to stake their claim on \$2.8 million for legal services rendered to Jett Williams in her quest to prove she was the illegitimate daughter of Hank Williams Sr., and share in his royalties. Court records show that Williams received \$5 million when she settled her legal tiff with Hank Jr. David Cromwell Johnson and two associates from his firm are asking a judge in Montgomery, Ala., to award them payment for 7,000 hours of work at \$400 an hour for toiling on the case from 1986 to 1992. But Williams' husband, manager and attorney, Keith Adkinson, said the claim is "ludicrous" because Johnson and his associates had agreed to work on a contingency fee, and they quit the case before it was settled. But Johnson said he withdrew from the case after receiving a letter from Adkinson saying he would not be paid for his services. However, Johnson said that he and his associates did all the

## Bono Has Satanic Surprise At Wembley

U2 had a very special guest come out of hiding to make an appearance at their August 11th concert at London's Wembley Stadium. Author Salman Rushdie, who was sentenced to death in 1989 by the late Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini for blasphemous comments to Islam in his book "The Satanic Verses," joined Bono and mates on stage in front of 72,000 fans who were surprised to see the author make a public appearance. Just prior to his appearance his voice was broadcast to the audience, and most of the crowd at that time believed Rushdie was communicating with Bono by telephone, something that has practically become a trademark for the Irish rocker. Rushdie has become increasingly bold in recent months after spending the first three years of his Iranian death edict under 24-hour police protection and changing his living quarters almost weekly. The appearance of the Indian-born author followed a satellite link-up with Sarajevo in which three Bosnians, each representing a different warring faction, complained of the world's indifference to victims of the war. Bono told the Bosnians that U2 was supposed to play a concert there but they were advised not to go because of the violent situation.

## Disputed Items


Marky Mark claims his little skirmish with Madonna at a Hollywood gala was all her fault. Mark told the N.Y. Post, Madonna "dissed" him when he said hello to her, because he had told a London magazine he thought Madonna's snap-on gold tooth was not very attractive. The situation then got as ugly as the tooth, with both celebs trading obscenities, after which, he claims, one of Madonna's bodyguards blindsided him with a punch for which he counterattacked with a soda bottle. Mark also denied making any anti-gay statements and said he still has


a lot of respect for Madonna, even if she can't handle someone who's not scared of her.... The morning team at KOMP-FM in Las Vegas went to blows July 28th after reading a trade sheet interview in the Hard Report in which sidekick Craig Williams felt the show's host, Byrd didn't give him enough credit. Byrd suffered a bruised beak and a black eye while Williams apparently broke his hand. No charges were filed over the incident.... A lot of people in Hollywood seem to be running for cover over the whole Heidi Fleiss madam-to-the-stars affair. Billy Idol is the one prominent music business personality who has, so far, been publicly connected with Fleiss in any way. Idol's publicist, Ellen Zoe Golden, said, "There may have been sex, but there wasn't commerce." Idol, who had been photographed with Fleiss, also denies ever paying for services rendered. "I have never used her professional services, and God knows I don't need to," Idol said, "Fortunately, I've never had to pay for sex."..... It seems you can act in it but if you want to write and perform the title track for the upcoming "Beverly Hillbillies" movie, you can't have appeared naked in a magazine. Geffen Records reports that plans for Jackyl to provide a new theme for the upcoming 20th Century Fox film were in the final stages when director Penelope Spheeris had Jesse Dupree dropped from the project after learning that he was in an eight page spread in the August issue of Playgirl. Dupree is now accusing Spheeris of sexual discrimination, citing that Erika Eleniak, the actress that portrays Ellie Mae in the film, has appeared many times sans clothes in Playboy. Dupree and his lawyers are currently considering if they should file a suit over sexual discrimination.

## The Secret Flood Story

Kansas City area native Pat Metheny will take his "Secret Story Tour" to his home town September 5th in an effort to raise money for local flood relief projects. The proceeds from the concert at Kansas City's Midland Theatre will go directly to the Red Cross and will be augmented by an additional \$1 per seat contribution by Geffen Records. The theatre, promoter Outloud Productions, Ticketmaster, and several media outlets are donating services to help reduce production and promotional costs.

## Between The Dates

Technical breakdowns involving the show's video effects interrupted **PETE TOWNSHEND's** presentation of *Psychoderelict* at Great Woods on August 9th. Never at a loss for words Pete told the audience, "For a hundred dollars you can all come backstage and see the definitive artist temper tantrum, because I'm going to kill a bunch of fuckin' people." Townshend did return to complete the musical part of the concept album but the rest of the show did not include the special effects or the three actors that play narrative parts.... **MICHAEL JACKSON** will be performing at Moscow's 100,000 seat Lyzhniki Olympic Stadium on September 15th.... The next leg of the **POISON** tour, originally scheduled to start August 13th in Lubbock, Texas, has been cancelled.... **BELL BIV DeVoe** have also cancelled their summer tour.... Possibly in reference to reports that appeared in British and Australian music magazines about another name change, this time from the symbol to Victor, **PRINCE** told the audience at his July 26th show in Birmingham, England, "My name will not be Victor. People ask me what they should call me, but if you're with me all the time, you don't have to call me." The fanzines had reported that Prince will change his name to Victor after his current European tour. A source close to Prince's Paisley Park management, says that as far as they are concerned, the name will remain the symbol.... Meanwhile, a presentation of Prince material will take place at the Glam Slam in Los Angeles. Billed as the Glam Slam Ulysses, a loose retelling of Homer's epic poem, it will feature 13 new songs by (symbol). Described as a "interactive music and dance production" where all club space will be utilized, the show opens August 21st and is projected to be a 13 night run. Prince (symbol) will be performing in Europe during this time.... **MADONNA'S** plan to perform in Israel in October, has drawn the wrath of Rabbi Avraham Ravitz, a member of parliament from the Torah Judaism Party. The Rabbi said he is outraged at the prospect of Madonna flaunting her body in front of young Israelis. No comments were made on the prospect of flaunting her body in front of old Israelis. In mainland China, The Beijing Evening News reported that "The Girlie Show" may be toned down a bit if it plays in that country. This is in contrast to reports that the Material Girl has no plans to clean up her act for anyone.... The all-star benefit concert for Walden Woods is set to happen on Labor Day at Foxboro Stadium outside Boston. **ELTON JOHN, STING, AEROSMITH, and MELISSA ETHERIDGE** will join **DON HENLEY** to raise funds for the Walden Woods Project. Henley founded the nonprofit environmental organization to preserve land near Walden Pond, an area made famous by Henry David Thoreau. The show will air live over the Westwood One Radio Network.... Whoops! The **JOHN LEE HOOKER** dates that we printed last week should have been listed as **ROBERT CRAY** dates. The correct dates for both artists are in this week's issue.

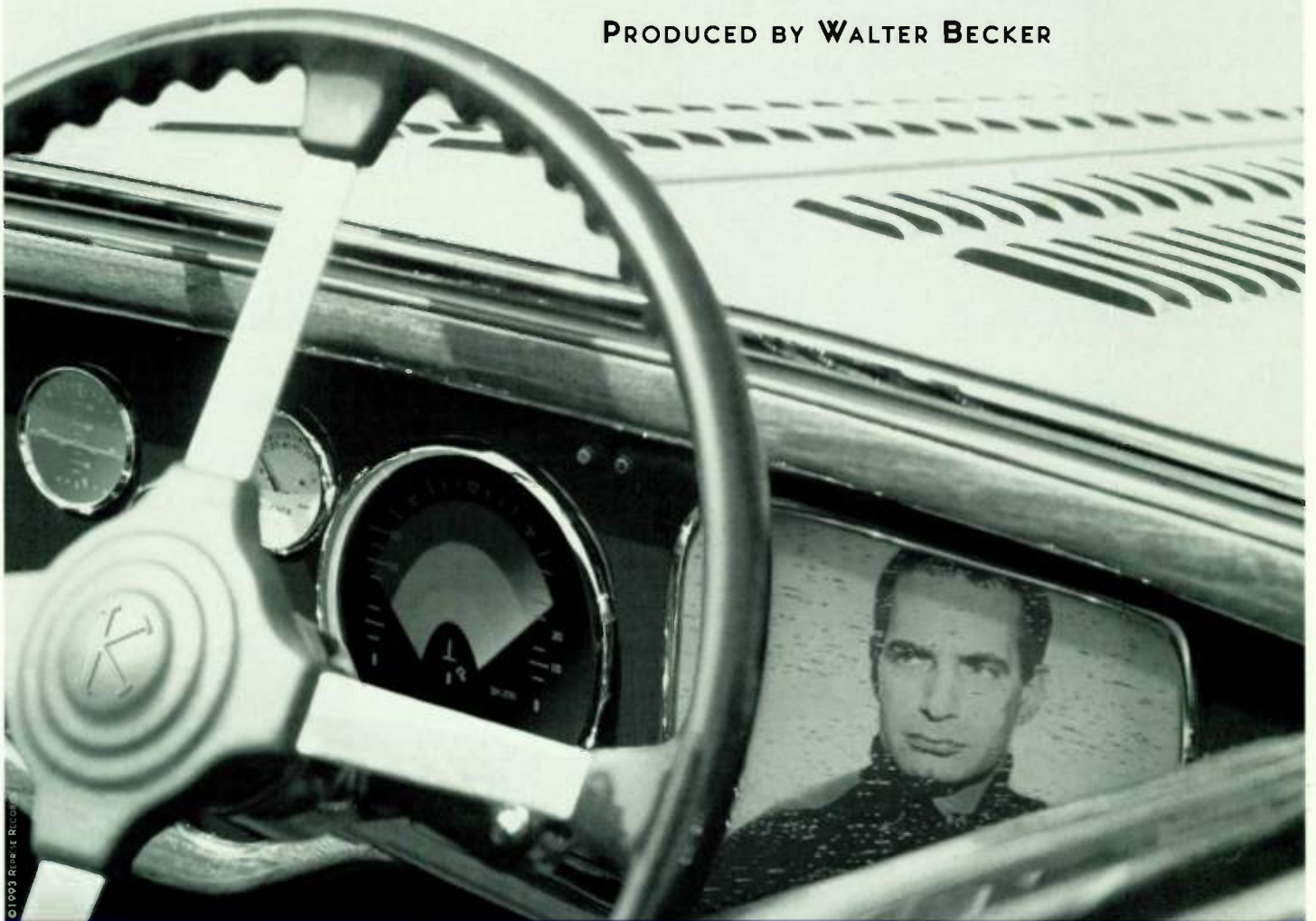
