Joe Harris Moves But Will Garth Follow?

Joe Harris resigned from Buddy Lee Attractions August 18th and has joined the William Morris Agency in Nashville. Tony Conway issued a statement which said Buddy Lee didn't expect any changes in their client roster as a result of Harris' departure. Trisha Yearwood, however, has just jumped to WMA and the agency expects several other acts to follow suit. But the big question is, will Garth Brooks follow Harris to the Morris office? Co-manager Pam Lewis said that Brooks does have a "key-man" clause with Joe Harris in his Buddy Lee contract and he is free to leave the agency if he chooses. As of August 26th, Brooks was still a Buddy Lee client, according to his management.

A Little Dispute Over GN'R Band Business

Testimony has begun in the lawsuit brought by drummer Steven Adler against his former bandmates in Guns N' Roses. The suit alleges Adler was tricked into signing away his rights to millions of dollars as a member of the band. Adler was booted from the band because of a heroin addiction in March 1990, but not until he had signed away his share of profits earned by the group in the 1980s, his attorney, David Chodos said. No damages were specified in the case, but Adler's attorney estimated the lost pot of gold at between \$4 million and \$10 million. GN'R guitarist Slash, whose real name is Saul Hudson, testified in a Los Angeles courtroom August 19th that the band put Adler on probation to scare him into kicking his habit. Slash said Adler was strung out on heroin and nodding out during rehearsals when he signed a "probation" agreement with the band's other members. That agreement essentially made Adler an employee of the band for a 30-day period, during which the drummer was urged to give up heroin. Axl Rose told the jury he threatened to leave the band during a 1989 concert because of the group's now-legendary drug problems. "It appeared to me that the band was a wreck, meaning that everybody had some kind of substance abuse (problem)," Rose said on August 23rd. Bass guitarist Michael "Duff" McKagan, testified that he had to write the drum parts for songs on the first two GN'R albums because Adler was in such a sad state. Adler, 28, testified last week that he had no idea he was risking his partnership rights in the band by signing the agreement. Adler sued the band members in July 1991, and later added band managers Alan Niven and Doug Goldstein as defendants. Goldstein testified that he tried for a

year and a half to get Adler off drugs without success. He said Adler's addiction wasted thousands of dollars in rehearsal and studio time. The trial is expected to last several weeks.

Manilow Opens The Biggest Arena In L.A.

Scott Zieger of Pace Theatrical Group told Reuters that Pace hopes to follow up their success with "Tommy" by producing a Caribbean-flavored musical with Jimmy Buffett. Zieger said they have met with Buffett and he is considering writing a musical score and lyrics for the production.... Agency for the Performing Arts senior veep Burton Taylor has announced his departure from the agency to pursue personal management opportunities and other projects. Taylor had been with APA for 17 years.... The Scorpions will make their only U.S. appearance of the year at the head-banging Foundations Forum confab in

UB40

UB40 does not exist to be a political messenger. One of their original intentions as a band was to popularize reggae music and, according to lead singer and trumpet player Astro, they are starting to see the fruits of their labor. UB40's highly accessible reggae-fied covers of familiar pop songs are blowing open the door for reggae music on the radio. But UB40 isn't "just" a cover band, even though many perceive them to be. Astro said UB40's reputation as a cover band continues in America because of the success of their *Labour of Love I* and *Labour of Love II* albums. UB40 has released 13 albums of original work, including the new release on Virgin Records, *Promises and Lies*. But the perception of them as a cover band is hard to shake due to their current hit single, "Can't Help Falling In Love," which is the only cover tune on the new album, and their reggae versions of Neil Diamond's "Red Red Wine," and Sonny & Cher's "I Got You Babe," which featured guest vocalist Chrissie Hynde.

But UB40 did not intend to include the Elvis Presley cover on their new release. As the story goes, they, along with many other people, were asked to cover an Elvis song for the movie "Honeymoon in Vegas". Only one version of each song made it to the soundtrack and UB40's was bumped in favor of U2's. The song resurfaced when UB40 was asked to contribute it to the film "Sliver," and the funny thing is, UB40 bumped U2 down the charts on that one. Astro said, "There's always been a lot of stuff going on between us and U2, as far as chart positions, etc., go. With *Labour of Love II*, worldwide we had out-sold U2, which the rest of the world doesn't really know about. But that's how it goes. Our chart [positions] are important to us, of course. But in reality, I don't care if the records don't go to #1....As long as we know we are actually selling records, as opposed to being hyped....Somebody else can take the glory." UB40's new release of original work is selling well, but people in the U.S. are still more familiar with UB40's cover albums, because they were unintentionally released back-to-back in the States. They intended to release *Labour of Love I* as their debut album because they felt it would show people where their interest in reggae music came from. But they were advised to hold off on the American release, and they did.

Even though UB40's biggest hits are cover tunes, they have written and recorded some of the best selling original albums in the U.K., and have managed to retain total artistic control of their work. "We decide what we are going to record, and we give the record company the finished product, and [they either] take it or leave it. We won't allow them to tell us to drop numbers off the album or whatever. This is the package, you take it or you don't." Astro said they don't want a record company "messaging around" with their releases. "Years ago they tried that. Some record company in South Africa was deleting tracks off our album just because [they were] a little too close to the bone for the apartheid regime....We just withdrew the album straight away so they couldn't have nothing, it's as simple as that. You either take the album in its entirety or you don't take it at all." Astro said they are

very pleased with their current relationship with Virgin Records. "Virgin are pleased with what we've given them and so far they're doing everything to assist us in selling it." UB40 is also happy with their current management, Mick Cater and David Harper of David Harper Management in London. Astro said they have been with David Harper for about six years, which is a record for UB40. "We've gone through managers left, right and center. We've got a bit of a bad reputation for dumping managers." But they feel that David Harper must be doing something right for them to have survived as UB40's management for such a long time.

UB40 is currently in the middle of a North American tour, which is something the band is very happy about. "Going out and doing shows, that, for me, is more important than actually making the records....There is nothing better than standing on stage and watching people just erupt in front of you. It's the biggest high that you can get....There's nothing quite like communicating with people." Astro also said that this tour has made him realize that UB40 is gaining new fans with each new release. "I've been noticing 10-year-old girls at the concerts. And as far as they're concerned, this is a brand new band. They don't realize we've been going for 10-plus years." And by walking on the stage with a very racially mixed band, UB40 makes a statement that is very close to their hearts. "We've got some West Indians, Norman is half Arab and half Welsh, we've got Scottish, we've got Irish, we're just a mixed up band anyway. Just walking on the stage is a statement in itself, showing you that people can live in harmony regardless of the color of your skin or your nationality."

But because of their mixed races, their British homeland and their pop accessibility, die-hard reggae enthusiasts have been known to criticize UB40's work as less-than-authentic reggae music. Astro said their music has a strong pop influence because they were exposed to Western pop music as kids, verses Jamaican reggae which is strongly influenced by American R&B and funk. But he said, first and foremost, UB40 is a reggae band. If you strip away everything in their songs except the drum and bass rhythms, you can see that their foundation is most definitely reggae. Astro said he doesn't give much credence to the critics who don't respect what they do. "The only critic I take notice of is the public, because it is the public that go out and buy the records. They're the best judge as to whether or not you've done a good record or a bad record." Astro said it strikes him as funny that the critics tend to bash their records and two weeks later they are in the top five. "Just goes to show you who's taking notice of these people." But he doesn't have any anger or hostility towards the people who critique UB40's music. "Critics have to earn their pennies, so let them say what they like."

UB40 is booked by Don Muller at the William Morris Agency in Los Angeles.

The operation was called a success and Owens is expected to recover full use of his voice.... **James Brown** has now completed his 2 1/2 years on parole but still faces five years of probation. Based on his good behavior, South Carolina officials will reportedly seek to ease his probation restrictions. While on parole, Brown was required to attend substance-abuse treatment, clear any out-of-country concerts or trips with parole officials, and report weekly to his parole agent.... **Jamaica's** new police chief has pledged to stop rap and reggae performers from singing about violence towards police, homosexuals and even Pope John Paul II, who recently visited the Caribbean nation. Police Chief Trevor MacMillan said when he takes office September 1st he will research current law to find a section under which performers could be prosecuted for advocating such violence, claiming he would go on stage and make arrests himself, if necessary. A spokesperson for controversial Jamaican artist Shabba Ranks, expressed hope that the chief can understand the social conditions that prompt such attitudes from musicians. Ironically, one of the biggest reggae hits to ever come out of Jamaica was Bob Marley's "I Shot The Sheriff."

Comics Sue The Improv Over Videotaped Shows

Two comics, Robert Shimmel and Carol Siskind, filed a \$2.5 million lawsuit August 19th in Los Angeles alleging The Improv illegally taped them and dozens of other comics at the Melrose Avenue comedy club and sold the tapes to an Atlanta distribution company. The suit is aimed at co-owner Mark Lonow, his wife Joanne Astrow and the distribution company. High-profile club co-owner Budd Friedman, however, was not named in the suit because the comics have no evidence he knew about the taping. A spokesperson for The Improv claims that the comedians were aware of the taping and they each had consented to be taped, either verbally or in writing. But Shimmel and Siskind contend that isn't true. Both allege that others who were recorded are equally angry, but they fear being blacklisted from the string of Improv clubs. A spokesperson for the defendants said the suit was a personal vendetta by the comics. One of the tapes was pulled from distribution the day the suit was filed, and the other was reportedly discontinued more than a year ago.

Apple Corp. Goes After Beatles Clone Band

The lawsuit filed against "1964: As The Beatles In Concert" in 1992 by Apple Corps Ltd. has not stopped the group from continuing to perform their tribute to the Fab Four. The act's agent, Mark Hellman of Group H. Nashville, said the suit, which

goes to trial in January, is an attempt to stop the four musicians from earning their living imitating The Beatles. He said the suit's claim that 1964 is profiting from merchandising The Beatles name is totally false, stating that the only commerce 1964 is involved in is performing live on stage. Hellman said the group has been performing its tribute act for eight years, has been invited to the home of George Harrison's sister, after she became a fan of the faux Fab Four, but they have never gotten any kind of response from Harrison, Paul McCartney or Ringo Starr. Hellman wondered if the Apple suit stops his act, could that great American institution, the Elvis impersonator, be next?

hounded by the IRS for years and has tried some creative ways to hang on to his property. The agreement being auctioned off made Lewis responsible for paying property taxes on the home, which is officially owned by one of his former managers, Cecil Harrelson. Memphis lawyer David Monypeny said Lewis would probably try to block the sale through litigation. "We would be surprised if anyone would pay anything for it," Monypeny said. Lewis has six months to buy back the property if it is sold, Monypeny said. Lewis and his wife, Kerrie, have lived in tax-friendly Dublin, Ireland since March. The singer owes more than \$3.7 million in U.S. back taxes, penalties and interest, and the IRS seized his possessions May 6th. An auction was postponed in June after Lewis' wife said she owns many of the belongings. Monypeny said that matter is "close to resolution."

The Case Of Michael Jackson

Michael Jackson opened his world tour in Bangkok just as the media frenzy about his alleged involvement in a child-sex-scandal started to explode. He made it through that first show but had to reschedule his second Thailand date because his personal physician said he had become severely dehydrated on opening night. The second show was initially postponed one day but was then pushed back to August 27th. If Jackson isn't well enough to take the stage at that time, that show will likely be cancelled and the tour will move on to its next stop in Singapore. The promoter in Bangkok said the concert was postponed for health reasons and had nothing to do with the mushrooming international furor. The L.A.P.D. confirmed August 17th that a criminal investigation of Jackson has been initiated, but no details regarding the nature of the allegations have been disclosed. The investigation was prompted by a call to the police department's Sexually Exploited Child Unit, from a Beverly Hills dentist who claims his 13-year-old son confided in a therapist that Jackson had fondled him and engaged in oral sex with him, according to reports in the Los Angeles Daily News. The dentist is in the middle of a bitter custody fight with the teenager's mother, and he filed papers asking the court to prohibit the mother from letting her son have any contact with Jackson. Jackson met the boy last year and began showering him with elaborate gifts and taking him, his mother and his sister on trips to far off places. And London tabloids have published photographs of Jackson and

his child companion that were taken when they were on a trip to Monte Carlo. But Anthony Pellicano, a private investigator who has worked for Jackson for four years, contends that the investigation was prompted by an unsuccessful attempt to extort a \$20 million film deal from Jackson. The dentist, who reportedly co-wrote the script for Mel Brooks' latest movie, "Robin Hood: Men In Tights," had threatened to call the DA's office when Jackson would not pay the money. Pellicano encouraged him to do so, saying that Jackson gets up to 30 extortion attempts a year. However, there have been no complaints to officials regarding the extortion plot. In a phone call to CNN's "Larry King Live" a lawyer for the boy's mother said she was not part of any extortion plan and "she was not aware of any abuse." The scandal has prompted the investigation into the possibility that there might be other boys involved. An 11-year-old boy who was at Jackson's Neverland ranch over the weekend of August 20th when the L.A.P.D. raided and searched Jackson's home, came to Jackson's defense. He told KNBC in Los Angeles, "He wouldn't do anything like that. He wouldn't touch people in a different way that you shouldn't." He also said that Jackson had given him friendly hugs and kisses, and that they had slept in the same bed together, but it was totally innocent. Jackson's attorney, Howard Weitzman, said his client believes the investigation will clear his name of any wrongdoing and he believes the L.A.P.D. will conduct a fair and thorough investigation. Jackson also said he intends to continue with his would tour and a spokesperson for tour sponsor Pepsi Cola, said the company was not worried about any negative impact from the news frenzy. However, it is speculated that even if Jackson's name is cleared, his future endorsement opportunities may have been irreparably damaged. The Jackson family has stood behind MJ during the ordeal and Janet Jackson was said to be winging her way to Singapore where she will join her brother.

The Rocker & Last Year's Model

Axl Rose is involved in yet another legal tiff, but this time he's not a defendant. Rose filed suit in Los Angeles against ex-girlfriend Stephanie Seymour, claiming assault and mental and emotional abuse. Rose claims Seymour tried to hit him with furniture during a fight last Christmas Day in the Malibu home

The Woodstock Generation In The '90s

While plans for a Woodstock 25th anniversary concert are still being debated, organizers of a 24th anniversary mini-celebration, scheduled on the original site August 12th, had to quickly reorganize and move the event because the new owners of Max Yasgur's farm dumped truck loads of chicken manure on the land and threatened to have trespassers arrested. But an area resident who attended the 1969 concert offered organizers use of his nearby land. June Gelish, the original site's owner, claims she dumped the manure to make sure the grass is green and lush for a commemorative event next year. But the Woodstock spirit seems to be waning as lawsuits and arguments surface, addressing issues as diverse as who actually owns the old Yasgur farm, to the nature of the capitalist community trying to make money off the memory of the most famous free concert in history. The lawsuit pending over the land's ownership was filed by Helen Necketopoulos who said she was married to Louis Nicky, the man who had bought the land from Yasgur's widow in 1981. The current owner, Gelish, who was Nicky's companion when he died in 1989, questions whether Necketopoulos was ever married to Nicky, but nonetheless is trying to reach a settlement with her. Further complicating matters, a group of "pilgrims" filed another lawsuit against Gelish in an effort to claim the land for the Woodstock Nation. That suit was thrown out and the pilgrims, who had been camping on the property, were evicted. In the midst of the legal issues,

including a suit brought by a neighbor who claimed Gelish invited the public to travel to the site to commemorate past anniversaries of Woodstock, one of the original festival organizers, John Roberts, wants to schedule his own concert for the 25th anniversary, to be held on a site 50 miles away. Roberts wants a more contemporary concert, but he does intend to feature some Woodstock originals. But Gelish's plans, which are being co-sponsored by the Multiple Sclerosis Society, focus on the over-35 crowd. An MS spokesperson said they plan on gearing the two-day event toward people aged 35 to 50, and hope to sign several of the original acts from the '69 concert. Gelish's event, which cannot use the name "Woodstock," because it is owned jointly by Roberts and Time Warner, has rumored ticket prices of up to \$200 and plans for an on-site jail patrolled by National Guardsmen. Roberts will need to get a reluctant Time Warner's approval to go ahead with his idea and Gelish's plan doesn't seem to have gotten much beyond the manure stage yet.

Assorted Legal Grievs

Ozzy Osbourne has filed a \$1 million lawsuit against Music Confidential magazine for "printing an utterly false, misleading and defamatory cover story." The story in question, printed in the August 3rd issue of the New York-based magazine, said Osbourne suffered a stroke that "stopped the rock star in his tracks." The Oz issued a statement saying, "It's an insult to me and the intelligence of my fans and I'm tired of being a scapegoat so someone can profit off my name." The suit was filed August 23rd in Los Angeles Superior Court..... Billy Joel's attorneys plan to fight a \$10 million copyright infringement lawsuit filed by Long Island songwriter Gary Zimmerman, who claims that Joel's "We Didn't Start the Fire," and his current "River of Dreams," are substantially based on one of his songs. Zimmerman claims his song was submitted to Joel through an acquaintance in 1986. Zimmerman said he decided to file the lawsuit after "River of Dreams" was released because it had stronger similarities to his song than the earlier hit..... Phyllis Diller appeared in a Pennsylvania courtroom August 19th in a lawsuit brought against her for cancelling 10 shows at the Peddler's Village Dinner Theatre in 1988. Promoter Richard Akins was suing for \$32,000, claiming he was forced to refund more than 2,000 tickets and eat his expenses. The two sides came to an out-of-court settlement just before Diller's attorneys were to present their case. Diller claims she cancelled the shows on her doctor's advice after she had suffered a fainting spell..... Easy Street Records has sued Madonna and Time Warner for \$2.25 million in a copyright infringement case. The small Manhattan record company claims the Material Girl used parts of one of their songs in two of hers. There has been no immediate comment from either Time Warner or Madonna..... A judge dropped the extortion, money laundering and copyright infringement charges that Eazy-E and Ruthless Records had filed against former N.W.A bandmate Dr. Dre, Death Row Records, Solar Records chief Dick Griffey, and Sony execs Tommy Mottola and Dave Glew. The suit claimed the defendants conspired to intimidate acts signed to Eazy-E's label into canceling their agreements. Attorneys for Eazy-E said the dismissal only addressed the racketeering counts and they definitely plan to appeal. The other claims in the suit which alleged interference with contractual relations and unjust enrichment, among others, were not affected by the ruling.

The Concert Business Pitches-In For Flood Relief

As the devastation from the floods in the Midwest continues to be added up, so does the outpouring of financial support from the entertainment community. Bob Hope, Wayne Newton and Ross Perot appeared at an August 1st show in Branson, Mo., and raised \$557,000 for flood relief agencies. George Jones, who realized that humans are not the only ones affected by the floods, donated 60,000 pounds of his private-label pet food to benefit the area's pet population. Former Tonight Show host and Nebraska native, Johnny Carson, reached into his pockets and donated \$100,000 during a telethon hosted by Willard Scott, Spencer Christian and Jay Thomas. Jay Leno, Rosie O'Donnell, Kevin Nealon, Franklin Ajaye, and Tom and Roseanne Arnold appeared at a 30-hour "laugh-a-thon" August 14th at The Improv in Los Angeles, raising more than \$50,000 for flood victims. Meanwhile, just outside St. Louis, Contemporary Productions has hosted a slew of fund-raising efforts at the Riverport Amphitheatre. Several artists have also donated \$10,000 each including Brooks & Dunn who appeared at Riverport July 17th, Reba McEntire who was there on August 13th, and Kenny G. who came in the following night. And coming up on Labor Day weekend, the Budweiser Rock 'N Country tour with Travis Tritt, Trisha Yearwood and Little Texas, will play Riverport as a flood benefit. Proceeds from that tour's stop at Contemporary's Sandstone Amphitheatre in Kansas City on September 2nd will also be donated to the flood relief efforts. Also over the Labor Day weekend, Wynonna Judd will kick-off her plan to donate \$1 for each album she sells between September 6-12 to the Operation Heartland flood relief fund, by hosting a six-hour country music radio-thon to be nationally broadcast on the Westwood One radio network. Joining Wynonna in her efforts will be Clint Black, Alan Jackson, Brooks & Dunn, Patti Loveless, McBride & the Ride, Tracy Lawrence and Willie Nelson, among others. The American Red Cross, Operation Heartland, Farm Aid and the Salvation Army will be on hand to take pledge calls during the fund-raiser. Country musicians aren't the only ones to lend a hand. Jackyl will be the headliner at KSHE-FM's August 24th benefit concert at the American Theatre in St. Louis. Jackyl also contributed to the flood relief

efforts by auctioning off frontman Jesse James Dupree's favorite musical instrument, his turbo-charged chainsaw, which brought in over \$1,400 for the cause. And Robert Cray is offering aid in a different way, by performing at a free concert for all those who lent a hand during the disaster. The Cray concert at Sec Taylor Stadium in Des Moines September 19th is part of the "Wash Away The Blues Volunteer Recognition Weekend."

A Classic Case Of Louisiana Politics

A compromise was reached August 25th, but not before Gov. Edwin Edwards threatened to call the Louisiana state Legislature into special session if the two businesses quarreling over the right to build a land-based casino in New Orleans didn't settle their differences. Rival bidders Harrah's Jazz Co., who won the bid from the gaming commission, and the Grand Palais group, which owns the lease to the site of the casino, will be partners in the only land-based casino in Louisiana. Under the compromise agreement Harrah's will hold one-third equity in the casino, their New Orleans investors one-third and Christopher Hemmeter with the Grand Palais group one-third. Grand Palais and Hemmeter will develop the casino and Harrah's will operate the site. The agreement came on the heels of the August 11th decision to grant Harrah's Jazz Co., the right to operate the casino. But plans for development were halted when losing bidder Grand Palais filed suit in two different courts to block Harrah's from moving forward with their plans to develop the site. Grand Palais holds the city's lease for the only legal site for a state casino, the 20-year-old Rivergate Convention Center. They were demanding a 50-50 split with Harrah's, but Harrah's only wanted to negotiate a sublease for the building. If the special session would have been called, the state Legislature could have possibly changed the official site, which would have left Grand Palais out in the cold. Or they could have scraped the initial award to Harrah's and reopened the bidding process, or even repeal the entire land-based gambling law completely. The casino board had asked New Orleans' Mayor Sidney Barthelemy not to sign any lease for the site until an operator had been chosen. But the mayor, who had balanced his budget on Grand Palais' promise of \$15 million on signing and \$15 million after they were chosen as the casino's operator, signed the lease anyway.

Between The Dates

Some acts lay low for a few years and when they come back they find their fan's adoration has moved on to someone else. That, however, is not the case with **BILLY JOEL**. He has a number one album and, given the box office reaction to the first dates on his tour, he will also be one of the hottest draws this fall. The opening date in Portland, Maine went clean immediately and more than 100,000 people snapped up the tickets to his six shows at Madison Square Garden in just three hours..... Although he has mostly arenas on his schedule, **ROBERT PLANT** is playing it conservative by doing some of his dates in large theatres..... The on-again, off-again, on-again **COVERDALE / PAGE** tour looks like it is off-again. Tickets for arena shows in Miami, Orlando, and Tampa had been available since the first week of August but were pulled off sale August 24th, and plans for the fall tour have apparently been put on hold. Last June, it looked like the David Coverdale / Jimmy Page collaboration was going to be one of the summer's hottest tickets. The album was doing well, and some amphitheatres had even listed the act on their summer schedules. In July the tour was pushed back until the fall with the official explanation that backing musicians had yet to be picked..... Three-fourths of the way through the schedule, **THE KINKS** decided to abruptly end their tour. An August 22nd date in Somerset, Wisconsin turned out to be their last stop. Ray Davies and company may go back out in October..... Why bring in outsiders when you can do it yourself? As **MADONNA**'s "Girlic Show" gets set to embark on a world tour next month, yet another planned stop runs into opposition. Carlos Garcia, president of the Archdiocese Committee Against Crime in San Juan, Puerto Rico, said the island, "already has too much pornography and too many television shows that are in bad taste for someone to come in from the outside and corrupt our youth." Madonna is scheduled to perform in San Juan on October 26th. Madonna has already run into problems trying to schedule a show in Thailand..... The good news for his fans is that **GARTH BROOKS** is going to do another show at Texas Stadium on September 26th. The even better news is that the 65,000 tickets are free. So okay, there's a catch. Brooks will not be singing. Instead he will be lip-synching to tapes made during his three sold out performances at the stadium scheduled for September 23-25. The free "show" will be used for filming closeups and retakes to be used in an upcoming television special..... The most independent band in the world is on the road again, and this time **FUGAZI** is breaking with its do-it-yourself tradition by using an actual booking agent to plan the tour. "We prefer to be called scheduling confederates or scheduling conspirators," Lisa Miller of Vertigo Touring told POLLSTAR. The band is also known for charging a flat rate of \$5 per ticket for the U.S. and \$6 for Canada. That policy will continue for the current tour, unless local or state taxes apply. In that case, the amount of the tax will be added to the ticket price.
