**ITG Partners Split**

Wayne Forte and Michael Farrell have decided to end their 12-year-old partnership arrangement in International Talent Group. Forte, the agency's former president and CEO, will depart the company in the coming weeks to take on a new, as yet unspecified, venture. Farrell will continue to operate ITG from his Los Angeles office while New York-based agents Joel Peresman and Marty Diamond will continue to operate that office following Forte's departure. It is unclear which acts might follow Forte to his new address. Among the agency's major headliners, Forte is responsible agent for David Bowie and The Cure while Farrell handles Genesis and Pink Floyd. The Solo-ITG venture in the U.K. and the Hollywood-based Camden/ITG alliance will continue, according to Farrell. ITG is 50 percent owned by the Labatt Entertainment Group and it is not yet clear exactly what is happening to Forte's interest in the agency. Forte cited a differing vision with his partner over the agency's future as the reason for the split. He promises to announce details of his new venture in the near future. Farrell said he was sorry to see Forte leave and wished him the best in his new venture. Farrell was very upbeat about the future of ITG and promised some significant announcements of his own within the next few weeks.

**New Shed Goes Dark 3 Weeks Into Season**

The new \$3 million city-owned Pompano Beach Amphitheatre in southern Florida closed its doors just three weeks after city officials congratulated themselves and a Florida promoter at the shed's opening night gala. But its been discovered that this is more than a case of a small promoter going belly up. Bruce Keiter of Florida Suncoast Attractions blames his financial backer, Pompano Beach Recreation Advisory Board chairman Richard Porraro, for pulling the plug on his promise to back FSA with \$250,000. Apparently Porraro, who is also an area dentist, agreed to fund Keiter's company, but got cold feet when Keiter's obligations reached \$94,000. That was the day before the first show, on September 4th. Industry veteran Wallace Barr, who had been contracted by Keiter to solicit offers on his behalf for the Pompano Beach Amphitheatre project, told POLLSTAR that he and Keiter had met with the city early on and everyone was aware that Keiter had a prominent businessman backing him. But at the time nobody knew it was Porraro. When Porraro pulled out, Keiter attempted to keep the venue open, according to

Barr. But eventually the checkbook ran dry and Keiter was forced to cancel the September 23rd Confederate Railroad show. But Barr said the city illegally cancelled the remaining shows when the head of security notified them he hadn't been paid. Keiter, who virtually disappeared after the doors of the venue were shut, was officially notified at a city commission meeting September 28th that the city had voted 5-0 in favor of cancelling his contract to operate the amphitheatre. But Keiter has 15 days to "cure" the problem, and if he does, his contract will still be valid. Barr said Keiter is currently looking for another backer for the project. Repeated attempts to reach Keiter were futile, as were attempts to reach city officials. It seems the political scene is not smelling pretty in Florida. Even though it wasn't illegal for Porraro to back Keiter, Commissioner Emma Lou Olson called for a probe of the 4-1 "emergency" vote that waived competitive bids during the selection of an operator, and the mayor is unhappy about the secretive nature of the whole process. Keiter, who admits that Porraro agreed to persuade the city commissioners to hire him, appeared at the city meeting, but did not speak. Now the city is without an operator for the facility, Porraro is out \$94,000 and everybody from teenage ushers to lighting and production companies got burned from bouncing checks and unkept promises. But The Turtles and The Grass Roots, who were two of the last groups to play the venue, did get paid. Howard Silverman of Paradise Artists said there was some trouble getting the money, but Keiter came through with \$1's and \$5's from the concessions to pay the artists. Silverman also said that he had Maynard Ferguson going in on September 25th and when that show was cancelled, Ferguson offered to play for the deposit only, but the mayor's office refused. Silverman said he can only assume the city was too embarrassed by the whole situation. Ticket holders for the 15 concerts cancelled, including Hal Ketchum, Diamond Rio and Frankie Valli, also got left holding the bag if they didn't buy their tickets from Ticketmaster. The box office at the shed is closed and a spokesperson from Ticketmaster recommends that anyone who bought tickets directly from the box office contact the city.

## the JULIANA HATFIELD three

Juliana Hatfield has no problem communicating through her songs. It's when the music stops that she gets herself into trouble. "Sometimes I just try to piss people off so that they'll stop asking me questions," Hatfield says. Though she's known for writing brutally open songs, Hatfield finds one-on-one encounters difficult. So she's discovered it's better to let the music talk than to be trapped into saying something she regrets. "It's hard for me to communicate with people, so I think [performing is] a way to give people something — 'cause I can't talk to them." Her new band, The Juliana Hatfield Three, is proving to be an effective carrier of her message. On the strength of "My Sister," the first single from the album *Become What You Are*, and a new association between Mammoth Records and The Atlantic Group, Hatfield is reaching more people than ever before.

Hatfield gained indie notoriety in the mid-'80s as singer/bassist with Boston's Blake Babies. When the band grew constricting, she ditched the group and struck out on her own. Though she's got a new band now, some of the people behind the scenes remain constant. She's managed by Gary Smith of Geronimo, a friend from the Boston scene who produced much of the Blake Babies' work. A friend of Smith's, Bob Lawton of TwinTowers Touring, books Hatfield's band. "This guy, Bob, he took on the Blake Babies early," Hatfield says. "We weren't a big money-maker for him, but he just was a nice guy and we're still with him."

Last year Hatfield released her first solo album, *Hey Babe*, a critically acclaimed collection of songs she doesn't always look back on fondly. Not so much for the music, but for the way the album opened her life for interpretation, particularly by music writers. "They just take something that's so pure and innocent and then they just, like, try to fuck it up," she says. "I hate that." Hatfield recorded *Hey Babe* in ten days for North Carolina-based indie Mammoth with a who's who of the alternative rock scene serving as her backup band. But Hatfield says she missed being in a steady group. Two friends, Dean Fisher on bass and Todd Philips on drums, were recruited last October, and, with Juliana switching to guitar, the Juliana Hatfield Three was born.

Atlantic and Mammoth forged their partnership after *Hey Babe* had been released. *Become What You Are* is the first release distributed under the indie label's new connection to a major. Hatfield says she doesn't feel pressure now that she's working for a major. "The only pressure I get is from myself to be better," she says. She has found that things have changed a bit, though. "Well, there's more of everything," she says. "There's more money, so I was able to spend the time in the studio that I needed to spend. All of my other records were extremely rushed.... There's just more people working with the record, more bodies." It's also meant a lot more exposure on radio and MTV, something Hatfield doesn't mind. "I like all the attention," she says. What she still doesn't like is having to explain herself to the press. "They try to take all

the mystery out of it," she says. "You can't do music justice with words on a page. It's so personal to everybody. Each song is completely different to each person."

Though she describes herself as shy and introverted, Hatfield doesn't have a problem performing before a crowd. "I think a lot of performers are kind of shy," she says. "It's not as hard to get up on a stage as it is to deal one-on-one with somebody because it's not intimate. There's this huge barrier between you and the crowd, which is the stage — it's like they are just one big thing. It's not like you're dealing with the people. You don't talk to them, you know." Hatfield says she's still not the songwriter or the performer she wants to be. "I've never done what I really wanted to do on a record or in a live performance," she says. "Sometimes I feel like I'm moving in that direction, but usually I feel like it's giving me this endless struggle. But I get a little bit closer every time." Hatfield finds both recording and performing to be necessary. "I need to do both, because they're completely different," she says. "They're both part of the whole thing, and neither one is totally satisfactory." Hatfield just wrapped up a month-long U.S. tour that took her to clubs in 19 cities. She's set to play a series of dates in Great Britain during the first half of October. From there, she returns to headline a few more U.S. shows before joining Paul Westerberg's tour.

While Hatfield's been performing songs from her new album on stage, she doesn't listen to the new album anymore. "When I make a record, I listen to it real intensively for, like, a few weeks, and then I stop because I get burnt out on it. I get sick of it. Now I'm thinking of the next batch of songs I'm writing." If the past serves as a guide, that new batch of songs won't be anything like the last one. "I don't want to write about the same things — that would be boring," she says. "I don't want to bore people." And, like Charles Barkley, she doesn't want to be anyone's role model. "I don't really pay attention to how people perceive me," she says. "I don't care if some people want me to be their spokesperson. I'm not interested in that."

So why's this admittedly shy woman put herself in the limelight, subjecting herself to the wrath of the press and expectations of her fans? "The thrill of creating a song, I think that's why I do it," Hatfield says. "I want to share my songs with people because I'm really proud of them. They're like my little children, and I want to show little snapshots of my children to the world."

## Buddy Lee Granted Restraining Order

A judge in Nashville ruled September 27th that any act that was represented by Joe Harris while he was at Buddy Lee Attractions is prohibited from leaving the agency to follow Harris to the William Morris Agency. Harris apparently signed an employment contract with Buddy Lee which prohibited him from representing any of the agency's clients for two years after his departure. The injunction puts the two acts that did immediately follow Harris, Great Plains and Trisha Yearwood, in a booking limbo of sorts. The managers of both acts have not been available for comment on the effect the injunction will have on their clients. Harris was also responsible agent for Garth Brooks, Mark Chesnutt, Tracy Lawrence and Clay Walker, but those acts have not yet made any moves. Buddy Lee is seeking unspecified damages from both Harris and William Morris. No date for the trial in Davidson County Chancery Court has been set.

## Trouble On The Mountain

Ray Charles and Dan Fogelberg both canceled recent bookings at The Mountain Winery in Saratoga, Calif., charging the venue didn't make scheduled deposit payments on time. That marks three such charges since July, when Johnny Mathis also cancelled a series of dates. But a Mountain Winery official insists all obligations were met. Fogelberg blew off his three sold-out shows that were scheduled to launch his new tour October 1-3. "Deposit payments weren't forthcoming, and we rebooked the dates in other locations," Fogelberg's agent, Steve Smith of the Howard Rose Agency, told POLLSTAR. Mountain Winery general manager Mike Collishaw claims Fogelberg pulled out because the venue wouldn't meet his demand for full payment more than 30 days in advance. Ray Charles was scheduled to perform September 24-26, but that show was blown out because of "a breach of contract," according to Charles' spokesman Bob Abrams, who would not elaborate any further. A source at the William Morris Agency, which represents a major portion of the acts the venue booked this season, said the Mountain Winery has been late making nearly every scheduled deposit payment. While many shows have ultimately played this season without the acts

getting stiffed, the WMA source said the erratic financial behavior dates back to the final show of the 1992 season, when the Pointer Sisters accepted a bad check from the venue which it took months to make good on. The WMA source also said the deposit for Charles wasn't received until after the show was cancelled, and even then it wasn't for the full amount due. In a statement to POLLSTAR, Collishaw, the son of Mountain Winery owner Ray Collishaw, said tickets for Charles' shows weren't selling well, forcing cancellation of one date. "We renegotiated the new price for three days and wired the full payment of \$97,500 to his agency. It was accepted and they agreed to play." But Collishaw said Charles' attorney sent a letter the next day cancelling the shows, claiming \$3,500 in hotel accommodation expenses weren't included. Collishaw said the \$3,500 was then wired, but Charles still refused to perform. William Morris is now holding \$101,000 of the venue's money, and it may well take litigation to determine how much, if any, of it gets returned. In July, Johnny Mathis cancelled his performances at the venue on the day of his first scheduled show, claiming a promised cashier's check wasn't delivered. Collishaw said Mathis and his manager arrived a day earlier than scheduled and left town after refusing a company check, even though they offered to accompany them to the bank to cash the check. The WMA source said Mathis had a signed agreement promising a cashier's check upon arrival at the airport on a specific date, but no one was even there to meet him, let alone with a check. Mathis reps then elected to give the venue additional time to have a cashier's check delivered to their hotel, but it never came. So the next morning Mathis and crew boarded an airplane and left town. In the wake of all this difficulty, the venue's talent buyer, Gary Hansen, resigned two weeks ago. The *San Jose Mercury News* reported that Mountain Winery owner Ray Collishaw, a prominent local developer who bought the property from Paul Masson in 1989, has been having some financial difficulties. The lender on the Mountain Winery property initiated foreclosure proceedings last December, but Mike Collishaw told POLLSTAR the \$3.8 million debt was paid off in April. Ray Collishaw also fell behind \$57,000 in rent on another property, but Mike Collishaw said that situation was settled earlier this month. "We're coming out of the woods," Mike Collishaw said. "It was

## No Girlie Show For Germany

Madonna's "Girlie Show" world tour had its lone stop in Germany cancelled a few days before the scheduled October 2nd show at Frankfurt's 12,000-capacity Festhalle. Some senior German politicians had objected to the show's content as obscene and wanted it banned or access by minors restricted after hearing reports from the tour opener in London September 26th. The "Girlie Show" is reportedly less brash than the "Blond Ambition" show on her last tour, but yet full of gender-bending sexuality and a bit of nudity. Promoter Marek Lieberberg said the cancellation was due strictly to logistics problems, not the threat of a ban. Apparently, the tour production team underestimated the time it would take to prepare for the sold-out show, which requires 21 hours of set up. City officials said the cancellation seemed somewhat mysterious, but Lieberberg contends that David Copperfield was performing at the venue the night before Madonna and by the time his load-out would be completed, it would leave less than the 21 hours needed for her set up. Even if Copperfield wasn't playing, the crew would be cutting it close,

because Madonna's final Paris show was scheduled the night before the Frankfurt date. The Paris and Frankfurt shows are the only two dates in different cities that are scheduled back to back. And officials in Germany aren't the only people trying to censor Madonna's tour. Rabbis in Tel Aviv have demanded that she be forced to tone down her act when she visits Israel. But, prior to the Frankfurt cancellation, a spokesperson for the Material Girl said Madonna has no plans to censor her performance, whether it be in Germany or Israel. Meanwhile, back in the U.S., a Catholic group is fuming over a VH1 advertisement on New York City buses which pictures the Madonna who is "Like a Virgin," next to The Madonna, The Virgin. The ad is part of the VH1 campaign "The Difference Between You and Your Parents." A spokesperson for the transit authority said the Madonna ad, which includes Raphael's familiar "Madonna and Child," is neither illegal nor obscene.

## Boulder Theatre Sold At Auction

Two businessmen who foreclosed on an historic Boulder, Colo., concert venue have purchased the building at auction, and the theatre's former owner-manager has been arrested. David Edwards and Raymond Livingstone put in the only bid for the 87-year-old Boulder Theater September 22nd, and purchased the building for \$1.5 million. The pair plan to sell or lease the building, which can remain as a concert venue and nightclub or could be converted into office and retail space. Meanwhile, the theatre's former owner-manager, Richard MacLeod, was arrested the same day for contempt of court for failing to appear at an August 31st hearing. MacLeod is facing civil lawsuits filed by Livingstone and Edwards.

## Former Gunner Becomes Millionaire

A settlement between former Guns N' Roses drummer Steven Adler and his ex-bandmates and managers has made him \$2.5 million richer. The agreement was reached just as a lawsuit filed by Adler was about to go to a Superior Court jury. Settling was probably wise for Axl and company, since several jurors stopped on their way from the courtroom to shake Adler's hand. "The jurors felt that Steve had been unfairly treated," said Adler's lawyer, David Chodos. Adler was awarded \$2.3 million from the band, \$150,000 from ex-manager Alan Niven and \$50,000 from current manager Doug Goldstein. Adler was fired from the band and signed away his partnership rights in 1990 because of a heroin addiction. Chodos said the agreement was read to Adler while the drummer was strung out on heroin and without an attorney present.

The dedication of the **James Brown Soul Center Of The Universe Bridge** in Steamboat Springs, Colo., drew more than 2,000 people September 15th, including the Godfather of Soul himself. It's proven to be a boon to the local economy ever since. Following the dedication, merchants have cashed in with James Brown Roast coffee, James Brown Ale, and (no kidding) James Brownies..... PolyGram Diversified Entertainment will broadcast a live U2 concert from Australia on pay-per-view cable November 27th..... 

## A Paramount Deal For Someone

The planned merger between Viacom and Paramount is beginning to look less like a done deal and more like a free-for-all. But Viacom and its chairman, Sumner Redstone, apparently will come out ahead in the short-term regardless of how the dust settles. Redstone has stated that under the agreement he forged, Paramount would owe Viacom \$820 million if the merger falls through. To solidify Viacom's bid to take over Paramount, Blockbuster Entertainment Corp. has agreed to invest \$600 million in Viacom, whether the merger goes through or not. Blockbuster reels in more money from the video business than all its major competitors combined. Meanwhile, media giant Cox Enterprises is said to be negotiating with regional phone companies to form a partnership which would also buy into Viacom for at least another \$600 million. In recent weeks, QVC, backed by Liberty Media and Comcast, has offered \$9.5 billion for Paramount in an attempt to outbid Viacom. That move has resulted in Home Shopping Network's decision last week to put its plans to merge with QVC on hold until the Paramount deal unfolds. Plus, there are rumors that Ted Turner and Capital Cities/ABC will float bids for Paramount. The continuing chain of events was touched off September 12th, when Viacom and Paramount announced they planned to merge into a single entity.
