

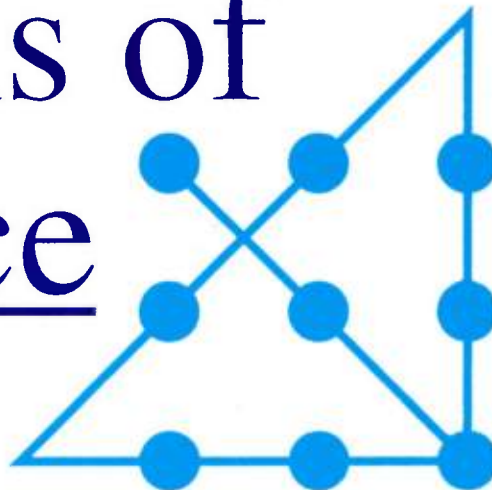

**Sony / Pace Make A Blockbuster Deal**

A joint venture to develop and operate amphitheatres internationally has been forged between Sony Music, Blockbuster Entertainment Corp. and Pace Entertainment. The venture combines Sony's huge stable of artists, Blockbuster's deep pockets and marketing know-how, and Pace's talent buying and venue management expertise. Under the deal, the companies will merge their existing amphitheatres. Sony and Pace amphitheatres in Pittsburgh (Star Lake) and Raleigh, N.C., (Walnut Creek) will fall under the new umbrella, as well as venues now under development in Camden N.J., and Tampa. Blockbuster's Desert Sky Pavilion in Phoenix, and Blockbuster Pavilions in Charlotte, N.C., and San Bernardino, Calif., will join the partnership. Pace will also contribute its partnership deals in Houston and Nashville. The venues will be managed, booked, staffed and operated by Pace. "Basically, the day-to-day operations will be Pace's responsibility with full-time local staffs in each market," Pace exec Brian Becker told POLLSTAR. Each company will hold a third of the joint venture, but further financial details haven't been made available. Becker wouldn't predict how many projects the partnership could embark upon in the near future. "We hope to be very aggressive, very ambitious," Becker said. "But it's really going to be a matter of making the right decisions." It is not clear at this point if Delsener/Slater, which handled the talent buying for Blockbuster this year, will have any role under the new arrangement. Also, the National Bowl at Milton Keynes, a 60,000-capacity U.K. amphitheatre outside London currently operated by Pace and Sony, so far isn't a part of the deal, Becker said. "It is our hope that ultimately everything will become part of one big partnership. However, technically that's not [now] a part of it."

**Madonna Does Puerto Rico**

The promoter of Madonna's October 26th concert in Puerto Rico had more to worry about after the concert than the Material Girl's up-close and personal interaction with the Puerto Rican flag. Local media reported that ticket holders were locked out of the arena, while others were displaced from their reserved seats within the arena. Promoter Larry Stein told POLLSTAR that the reason the gates were closed was because the local firefighters, who were inexperienced in judging the size of a large crowd, perceived that the building was at capacity. They independently made the decision to lock the gates because of what they thought

was an oversold situation. Stein said when he heard the firefighters had shut the gates, he pulled the rest of the tickets out of the box office, met with the firefighters and explained to them that there was actually enough room for the people holding tickets outside of the gates. The firefighters eventually re-opened the gates, but some of the people had given up in frustration and left. In a press conference the following day, Stein presented the ticket manifest and other documentation to support the fact that he did not oversell the show. He also refunded money to anyone still holding an entire ticket. Stein said the seating problems were caused because the security provided by local police was "too little and too late." Although they had come to an agreement with the police to provide sufficient security, Stein said that wasn't the case the day of the show. And Madonna herself suffered a bit of fallout after Puerto Rico's House of Representatives unanimously passed a resolution officially condemning her for showing disrespect to the flag by rubbing it between her legs. There are no plans to try and extradite Madonna for what would be a misdemeanor charge. And in Argentina October 29th, a judge turned down an 11th-hour request to ban Maddy from performing in Buenos Aires, but ruled that children under age 13 must be accompanied by a parent. Contrary to the pattern of protests, the Roman Catholic Church in Brazil does not plan to protest her upcoming run in that country, but a judge has warned she will be arrested if she makes any offensive or erotic acts with the Brazilian flag.

**Another Less Than Great Week For MJ**

Michael Jackson postponed his November 2nd and 4th concerts in Mexico City, apparently to recover from some sort of dental surgery. The first concert, the third of a five show run, was rescheduled for November 9th but the other has not been reset. Meanwhile, the promoter of MJ's upcoming concerts in Puerto Rico, Larry Stein, won a battle to go ahead with his scheduled November 14th date. The possibility of cancellation arose

# IAN MOORE

With the first exposure to the new self-titled blues-rock Capricorn release, *Ian Moore*, one might seriously doubt that the driving force behind the record is a product of his parents generation — Moore was born in the summer of 1968 in Berkeley, Calif., at the height of the hippie countercultural movement — but the rocker's strategy for his career reveals he is as much a product of that generation as he is of the Texas-based, blues-rock, guitar-god era he is now emerging from. Even though Moore's family left the West Coast, relocating to Austin, Texas while he was still in diapers, they did not abandon their alternative lifestyle. Moore's father, an India scholar described as a "weirdo" and a "head" by his eldest son, owned Anablep Anablep's Far East import emporium in Austin, which was next to Oat Willie's head shop. With incense wafting through the air, young Moore was exposed to alternative lifestyles and music of the era. Neither of Moore's parents were musicians, nevertheless, they always had music and musical instruments around the house. When the Moore family moved to India in '71, three-year-old Ian was exposed to the first instrument he played, the sitar. But Moore said he really played *with* it rather than actually playing it.

When they moved back to Austin, Moore's father started taking his young son with him to the live music clubs nearly every night. Moore characterizes that era as a time when the worst thing that could happen was that everybody would be stoned out of their minds. Moore, who saw more live music by the time he was 12 than most people see in a lifetime, said it was "cool" being a kid in those days because everybody was "into" having kids around.

When Moore was six-years-old, after hearing Austin legends The Cobras, with Stevie Ray Vaughan, he told his parents he wanted to play the guitar. But Moore's mother was the "earth-mother, folkie" type and she didn't want loud music in their home. She suggested he take up the violin instead. When Moore realized that noise was noise, he went for it.

Mastering the violin, Moore joined the prestigious University of Texas String Project. But when he was 14, he tore the tendons in his hand and his career as a classical violinist was over. He then turned to the instrument he had always wanted to play, the guitar. But two years would pass before Moore's true inspiration to play the guitar came — at the 10th anniversary of the legendary blues club Antone's. There was an "extravaganza" of blues guitarists there, including Otis Rush, Luther Tucker, Hubert Sumlin, Albert Collins, Jimmy Rodgers and Stevie Ray Vaughan. But Moore said it was Buddy Guy's performance that really floored him, causing him to realize that blues could transcend genres and drive the audience as much as any hardcore rock band could.

By the time Moore played South By Southwest in 1992, he had become established as a hot club player in Austin. And with that, came the inevitable comparisons to Stevie Ray Vaughan; the Texas press wasted no time pegging Moore as the next guitar-god in waiting.

After SXSW, Moore said record companies started showing interest. He eventually signed to EMI, but was dropped during the streamlining after Charles Koppelman came aboard. Moore didn't let that get him down. With the help of his manager, Jan Mirkin



of Mirkin Management, and his agent, Betsy Nissen of Mophead Agency, Moore persevered and ended up on a label he feels his perfect for him, Capricorn. "They have a fundamental understanding of blues and soul that most record labels *wish* they could....It's perfect for me," he said.

Ian Moore and his band — drummer Mike Villegas, bassist Chris White, and Bukka Allen on piano and organ — have been on the road constantly since the July release of the album. As the first single started to climb the AOR charts, Moore returned to California with his own music — he had previously played the Left Coast while touring as a guitarist with Joe Ely's band. The response at The Roxy in Los Angeles was surprisingly warm, but when they played Slim's in San Francisco, Moore came up against something he can't stand, a cold crowd. "That's one thing I wish I didn't care as much [about]...but I cannot go through a show without winning a crowd....And I couldn't deal with it....Finally I just...[said]...'look...were not out here trying to be rock stars, were out here...trying to share our music with y'all. And if you like it, I'd appreciate it if y'all would come up closer and give me some input. [And] if you don't like it, get the fuck out'...And the really wonderful thing was...it worked. I was so scared, I thought that everybody was going to freak out and leave [and say]...'that little shit.' But they stayed and they came up front...and that made me feel a lot better."

Moore was able to win a crowd in the Bay Area, but he isn't ready to expose the multifaceted side of his music — yet. That may cause one to question whether Moore is really as "out there" as he likes to think. Moore said he deliberately used caution with his first release, but his admiration for artists of the '60s paves the way for future recordings. "The thing about Hendrix that...I would like to be similar to, is that he really was unusual and he took his sound in any direction he felt like going, and was very at peace with that....I want to...get people to groove on where I'm coming from and expound from there. As you do that you create your own niche. Once you get support from the industry and radio, and...as long as you are consistent with what you do, you can get as weird as you want....If the Beatles had put the white album [out first]...nobody would have listened to them because people didn't understand it. But what the Beatles did is put out [two albums] which were not that different from what was out at the time, [and] everybody loved them. And then as they went on, they got more into their individual sound, until their sound was so powerful that it couldn't be denied at radio....That's what I want to do."

Ian Moore is on the road throughout the end of the year, and Barry Weisblatt at Artists and Audiences Entertainment takes over booking the band starting in January.

because the concert coincides with the day Puerto Ricans will go to the polls to choose between statehood, independence or commonwealth status. Back in Los Angeles, MJ's attorney filed a motion October 29th to postpone the civil suit which alleges he sexually molesting a 13-year-old boy over a period of several months. Attorney Bertram Fields said his client has a right to postpone the hearing until the statute of limitations on possible criminal charges has passed. If granted, the case would be postponed until the year 2000. Another of MJ's high-powered attorneys, Howard Weitzman said that it is standard practice to put civil cases on the back burner when there may be a parallel criminal case in the works. The LAPD is continuing its criminal investigation, but no charges have been filed to date. However, the attorney for the teenager said his client needs to put this episode behind him and get on with his life. Attorney Larry Feldman filed a motion November 1st requesting that Jackson be ordered to attend a November 19th hearing and that the suit go to trial before March 16, 1994.

## Comment Gets Cypress Hill Canned At KMEL

San Francisco radio station KMEL-FM pulled all of Cypress Hill's records off their playlist after someone on stage made derogatory remarks about San Francisco's gay and lesbian community during the band's October 24th performance at the Bill Graham Civic Auditorium. However, in retrospect, it isn't clear if it was actually a member of Cypress Hill that made the remarks. An eyewitness to the event told POLLSTAR that members of House of Pain, Funkdoobiest, and The Whooliganz were all on stage at the time the comments was made. KMEL's program chief Joey Arbagey said the station is investigating the possibility that someone other than a member of Cypress Hill actually made the offensive remarks.

## Blind Melon Head Meets Cite-ful Vancouver Police

Blind Melon lead singer Shannon Hoon was arrested on October 31st for public nudity and committing an indecent act during a Halloween concert at the Pacific Coliseum in Vancouver, the final night of their tour opening for Lenny Kravitz. According to press and eyewitness reports, when Blind Melon took the stage three members of the band were in dresses, the bass player was naked, except for his "instrument" and Hoon's face was painted

white and he was wearing a white dressing gown with what turned out to be very skimpy underwear. During their set, Hoon took off the dressing gown, played a few numbers in his underwear and then took them off. He performed several numbers completely naked before walking up to the edge of the stage and urinating in the security pit, sending security scattering, and then on the audience. Hoon was arrested after Blind Melon's set, but only after he reportedly climbed on top of the band's bus and screamed obscenities at the police. Hoon was released pending a court appearance in December. He later issued a statement apologizing to the city and tongue-in-cheek suggested that bandmate Rogers Stevens (who was celebrating his birthday) may have spiked his drink. Blind Melon will also return to Vancouver December 20th and will donate part of their fee to a fund to provide underprivileged kids with toys for Christmas.

## Another Rap On Guns

Rappers Tupac Shakur and Flavor Flav were arrested in two separate shooting incidents last week. Shakur (aka 2Pac) was arrested October 31st in Atlanta for allegedly shooting two off-duty police officers. Apparently the car Shakur was in nearly hit the officers and their wives while they were walking across the street. Another car pulled up and everybody piled out of their vehicles, pistols in hand. Police Capt. Herb Carson said an argument ensued and when one of the plain clothes officers pointed a gun at the group, Shakur fired. An eyewitness, however, said he saw Shakur fire, but he was not the first one to shoot. It isn't clear if the officers identified themselves as members of the police force. Shakur shot one of the officers in the abdomen and the other in the buttocks. Their wounds were not serious and they were released from the hospital the following day. Shakur was charged with two counts of aggravated assault and one outstanding count of battery and was released on \$55,000 bond. A hearing is scheduled for December 1st. In an unrelated incident in New York November 1st, Flavor Flav of Public Enemy was arrested for allegedly firing a gun at a 54-year-old neighbor at their Bronx apartment building. Police patrolling the area heard the shot and the apartment's doorman waved them over and told them Flav, whose real name is William Drayton, had shot at another resident. Drayton surrendered to police in the lobby and then took the officers to his apartment where they

found an unlicensed semiautomatic pistol with one bullet missing from its clip. He was charged with attempted murder and possession of a weapon. Drayton, who was being held at Rikers Island prison, is expected to check himself into a California drug rehabilitation program, according to the District Attorney's office. His bail was set at \$15,000.

## Rod Closes The Greek's Season

## Keeping Pace With Tommy

Pace Entertainment's first try as lead producer and general partner in a new Broadway musical is shaping up to be a major success story. So far, "The Who's Tommy" has recouped about 25 percent of its \$9 million starting investment and is working off the rest at a rate of \$150,000 a week. Pace chairman Allen Becker expects investors will be paid back by March. The road show opened six months after the Broadway show, an unheard of event for a new musical, Pace Theatrical Group president Scott Zeiger told POLLSTAR. He termed the road show's inaugural dates in Dallas last month "successful," and said the second stop in Ft. Lauderdale "is sold out to the walls." Zeiger predicts the "Tommy" roadshow could run for at least 150 weeks. "We're already booked for 100, and we will probably do 150 weeks by the time we repeat certain cities." The show's promotion differs from city to city, he said. "What we've done is book the show aggressively on our Broadway subscription unit," Zeiger said. Pace Theatrical has subscription series in 23 markets. "In a number of markets, Pace independently or through local affiliates is presenting the dates ourselves. There are a few of the larger markets where we've booked it for longer runs where we're not the promoter of record. So it's a combination." Local concert promoters are presenting certain dates, he said. Eventually, four "Tommy" companies will be playing. Productions will also open in London next fall and in Toronto in January 1995.

## Paying The Price For "Elton's Diet Of Death"

Elton John won more than \$500,000 in his libel action against a British newspaper November 4th in London's High Court. John said the *Sunday Mirror's* December 1992 article defamed his character by falsely reporting he was on a "diet of death." The article claimed John was seen at a Hollywood party chewing his

food then spitting it out. John said the article portrays him as a "sham and a hypocrite," since he had publicly announced he is in recovery from the eating disorder bulimia and has held out his recovery from that and drugs as a positive example and a life-line of hope to others. John said the *Sunday Mirror* benefited economically from the story and he refused a deal which included an offer to print an apology, pay his legal costs and donate a lump sum to a charity of his choice. John refused the deal because, although the paper admitted the story was untrue and apologized, it denied the article was libelous and claimed it was just a case of mistaken identity. The British jury indicated that most of the fine was to punish the paper for what it perceived as reckless disregard for the truth. The paper may also have to cough up an additional 300k to cover John's legal expenses.

## Aerosmith Packs Lakewood

## Pros On The Move

Bruce Moran has announced he will be leaving his VP position with Ogden Entertainment, where he functioned as head of Ogden Presents, to become the main talent buyer for O.C.E.S.A., the leading concert promoter in Mexico. Moran will relocate to New York City and will open a U.S. office there on January 1st to represent O.C.E.S.A., a company in which Ogden has a significant minority interest. In conjunction with Ogden Presents, O.C.E.S.A has been promoting virtually all the major concerts going into Mexico City's new Sports Palace arena and its renovated National Auditorium. In addition, both companies are involved in the construction of a new 15,000-seat amphitheatre in Monterey, Mexico which is expected to open next year. 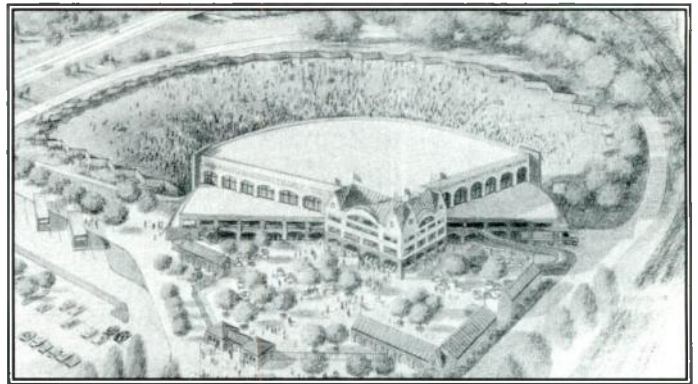

Arista/Nashville VP **Allen Butler** is rumored to be headed to Sony as executive VP/GM, but that depends on if he can extricate himself from his current gig..... **Larry Wanagas** has been named president of Mute Records of North America. He replaces Bruce Kirkland, who is now an exec at Capitol Records. Wanagas is the longtime manager of k.d. lang and will retain that role in addition to his Mute duties, which will also include U.S. management for Erasure and Nitzer Ebb. Ogden previously functioned as Paul McCartney's manager from his position as managing director of MPL Communications.

## It's Been One Blockbuster Deal After Another

H. Wayne Huizenga could certainly say 'the video rental business has been very very good to me.' His Blockbuster Entertainment Corp., has been making acquisitions at a dizzying pace this year. Before the ink was dry on the Sony/Pace deal, rumors were circulating that Blockbuster was negotiating to buy Dick Clark Productions. The talk boosted Dick Clark Productions stock by \$1 to \$6.25 a share on the Nasdaq board as of November 3rd, giving the company a value of about \$50 million. Wall Street insiders think Blockbuster wants to absorb the company into its

Spelling Entertainment Group. Blockbuster already has announced plans to merge Republic Pictures into Spelling. Last month, Blockbuster agreed to invest \$600 million in Viacom to shore up that company's bid for a friendly takeover of Paramount. Also in October, Blockbuster added 270 record stores and 160 video stores in a \$150 million dollar deal with Philips Electronics. Earlier this year, it cost Blockbuster \$165 million to buy nearly half of Spelling and \$25 million for a 35 percent stake in Republic. The acquisition of Music Plus and Sound Warehouse set Blockbuster back another \$125 million. Blockbuster also entered a \$150 million partnership with the Virgin Group in Great Britain for a chain of American and European "megastores." Plus, the company entered a joint venture with IBM to distribute music, videos and games directly to stores electronically.

## New Shed Still On Track For Next Summer



The first convertible indoor/outdoor amphitheatre remains on track for a July 1994 opening. Late last month, the Hartford Redevelopment Agency formally approved the **Nederlander Organization** and **Metropolitan Entertainment's** plans to build the \$21 million **Connecticut Center For The Performing Arts**. The theatre will seat up to 30,000 people when it's a shed and 7,500 when it is closed in like a theatre. Final approval of \$11 million in state financing is still pending, as well as several other minor government hurdles. **Nederlander's Lou Raizin** hopes construction can begin within the next few weeks.

## Legal Grievs

**Boy George** appeared in a London court room November 1st to deny the claim that he is the father of a 7-year-old boy. Boy George, whose real name is George O'Dowd, said conception would be a miracle since he has never penetrated a women in his life. The case was adjourned until March, allowing time for O'Dowd to have his blood analyzed for proof of paternity..... The attorney for St. Louis biker William "Stump" Stephenson, who sued **Axl Rose** for allegedly attacking him at a Guns N' Roses concert in 1991, says his client received somewhere between \$160,000 and the \$2 million he had sought in the case. Stump and Axl settled for what Rose had called a "very minimal" amount after the case had gone to the jury October 21st..... Comedy Central filed for an injunction in a New York federal court asking **Jackie Mason** to stop using the title "Politically Incorrect" for his one-man Broadway show. The cable network has a show with the same title. Mason claims he was described as politically incorrect by the media for many years and intends to fight the move and possibly file his own infringement action..... A video by Papua New Guinea group **Banditz** has been banned from local television broadcasts because it shows people

He had claimed the apparition appeared at Bobby Mackey's Music World in Wilder, Ky., after he dared the ghost, a legendary figure at the club, to show itself. He said the ghost, which appeared as a dark-haired man with a noose around his neck, fled after it attacked him. The club's lawyer has asked that the case be dismissed because it would be hard to get the only other witness, the ghost, into court.

## Controversy Right Here In Music City

Some Nashville record execs claim they were misled into believing all profits from an Eagles tribute album would go to the Walden Woods Project when, in fact, less than 10 percent of the total royalties will go to the charity. But at Giant Records, which put out *Common Thread: The Songs of the Eagles*, officials insist an early miscommunication was corrected, and all labels were given a chance to pull their acts but refused. The excellent album features a host of major country singers covering songs the Eagles made popular in the '70s. "We're approached on a daily basis from benevolent organizations," said RCA Records Nashville veep Thom Schuyler. "So when a controversy like this arises, it kind of stops us cold in our tracks and makes us wonder about the role we play." But Giant's Doug Mark said, "No matter how you cut it, Walden Woods will make at least a couple of million [dollars]." Artists get a 20 percent royalty rate, and 8 percent of that goes to Walden, according to Giant. Of the remaining 12 percent, 3 percent goes to the song's producer and the other 9 percent is split between the label and artist. Walden is expected to receive about \$1.3 million from album sales if the record sells 2 million copies as expected. Several artist managers stressed that it's the record execs, not the artists, who don't like the way the proceeds are being split.

## Short Items Of Note

**Pearl Jam** kicked off their North American tour with a surprise gig at The Catalyst in Santa Cruz, Calif., October 27th. When word leaked out the day before the show that Eddie Vedder and friends were going to be performing at the 800-capacity club, a line of more than 1,200 people formed around the venue. The Catalyst's talent buyer, Gary Tighe, told POLLSTAR that all went well and the members of the band, as well as their crew, were very easy to work with. The date was actually a make-up for a show the group had been forced to cancel some time back..... **Gaylord Entertainment** and **American Airlines** have teamed up to attract tourist and convention business from London to Gaylord properties in Nashville. American Airlines will divert advertising money to the program, but many of the deal's specifics are unclear. American is expected to add a London route to its Nashville hub soon, and it is hoped the five-year deal with Gaylord will enhance both companies' investments.

## Strange But True

Geffen is set to unleash *The Beavis & Butt-Head Experience*, an album featuring bands the influential but ignorant duo says "don't suck," on November 23rd. B&B will duet for the first time on their self-penned track, "Come To Butt-Head," produced by Nile Rodgers. Nirvana, Red Hot Chili Peppers and White Zombie are among the bands contributing previously unreleased tracks to the album..... A play based on the **Barry Manilow** hit "Copacabana" will open in London's West End next year. The play will be set in a 1940s Cuban nightclub. Singer Gary Wilmont will play the lead role of Tony the bartender. Manilow, who won't be in the production himself, said he's looking for the British equivalent of a young Judy Garland to play Lola. No word on if Ray Davies is available..... Ticketmaster is offering concert tickets in exchange for **guns** in an Albuquerque, N.M., promotion that has drawn more than 70 firearms so far. Sawed-off shotguns, small-caliber pistols and semi-automatic weapons were among the arms turned in. The *Albuquerque Tribune* and KKSS-FM co-sponsored the offer. So far, tickets to upcoming shows by Pearl Jam and Dr. Dre seem to be the concerts of choice for those who've turned in their piece.

As we reported several weeks ago, after a 27 year absence from the concert stage, **BARBRA STREISAND** will be performing two shows at the new 15,000-seat MGM Grand Garden in Las Vegas. Show dates are New Year's Eve and January 1st. Other than charity fundraisers, Streisand has not made a paid concert appearance since 1966. The appearance will come two weeks after the opening of the \$1 billion MGM Grand complex. Although neither MGM or Bab's management have announced how much she is being paid, some estimates put the fee at a cool \$1 million. Many of the ducats will likely be comped to the casino's high rollers, but those tickets that are put on sale will reportedly range from \$100 to \$1000. Streisand's management, Martin Erlichman Associates, told POLLSTAR that there are no plans for any other dates..... The Runt is taking his *No World Order* concept on the road. The upcoming tour by TR-i aka **TODD RUNDGREN INTERACTIVE** promises to be a totally interactive experience for both Rundgren and the audience. Appearing with three dancers, but without a band, the presentation will be "in the round," with no seating in the venues, making for a dancehall atmosphere. The stage will be in three levels, with a main stage, a center stage where Rundgren performs, then above him will be a large stage that will have 24 television monitors in a 360 degree array. There will also be three digital message boards which will feature announcements on what is coming up, what Rundgren is doing, and instructions to the audience on what to do next. Suspended above the stage will be hollow metal tubes containing cables that will be attached to little devices and toys like video cameras, blow-up dolls, and drumsticks. Rundgren will relay to the audience, via the message boards, what to do with the devices. This is all supposed to effect the performance itself, with the audience itself being a major part of the concert. There is a song set, however the only part of the show that is "carved in stone" is the opening and closing number. What happens in the middle is up to Rundgren and the audience..... **PHIL COLLINS** tours Europe in April, followed by a U.S. tour in June..... If you can't make it to New York, one of the Big Apple's most famous attractions just may be coming to your town. **"THE GREAT RADIO CITY SPECTACULAR"** starring **THE ROCKETTES**, with special guest star **SUSAN ANTON** embarks on a worldwide two year tour this month. The show brings production numbers never before seen outside of Radio City Music Hall, including scenes from the "Radio City Christmas Spectacular," and "March of The Wooden Soldiers"..... Yes **PEARL JAM** is hot. Evening Star sold out all 14,000 tickets for the group's two Aladdin Theatre shows in Las Vegas in just three hours. Meanwhile on the opposite coast, **NIRVANA** has set a fastest sellout record for IMP in D.C..... Last week we mentioned that of the performers scheduled to entertain during the festivities surrounding the World Cup Soccer drawing at Caesars Palace in Las Vegas, only Julio Iglesias would be performing live, with the other artists appearing on video tape. The concert, to benefit Britain's National AIDS Trust and Crusade, will be held at Wembley Arena..... Arghhh! Last week we listed an itinerary for Laura Love & Grant Street.
