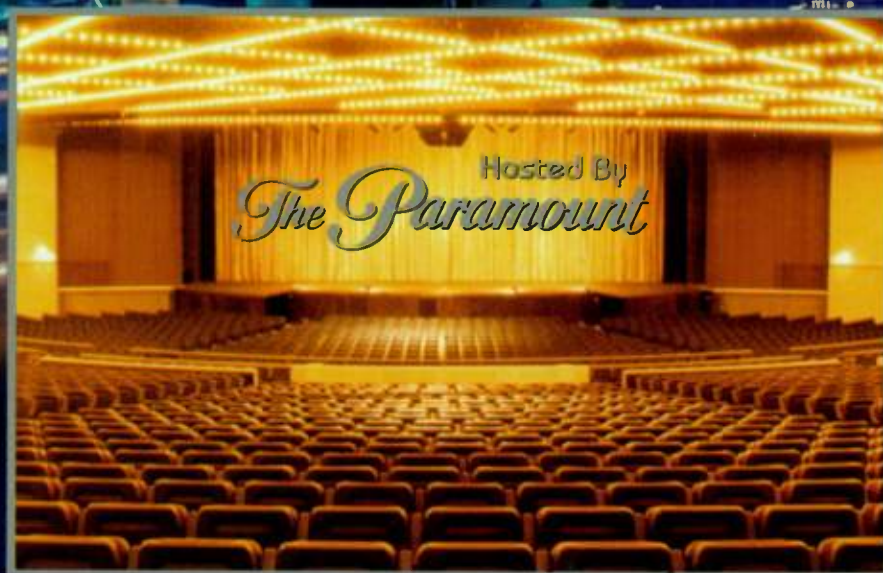

Chameleon Fades To Black

Chameleon Records has confirmed it is shutting down operations, however, President Bill Berger's office has declined to make any further comment on the situation. About 25 staffers are headed for the street. The Pritzker family is reportedly selling their half of the label to Elektra, which already owns the other half of the operation. All inquires to Chameleon regarding the future of their artists, including the Pogues, Dramarama, Sonia Dada and Lucinda Williams, have been directed to Elektra Records, which isn't saying much at this point either. Chameleon's demise, however, has had an immediate impact on the co-bill tour by My Sisters Machine and I Mother Earth. MSM manager Toby Mamis said Elektra elected not to pick up his band's Chameleon contract and that cut off the band's tour support budget leading to the cancellation with more than a month of dates to go. The last show was November 13th in Pittsburgh. I Mother Earth, which is on Capitol, wanted to continue the tour, but without MSM on the bill, most promoters reportedly elected to pass.

Madonna Makes Phallic Faux Pas In Australia

The Material Girl was presented with a traditional tube-like instrument called a didgeridoo on her November 17th arrival in Australia. However, among Aborigines a women isn't allowed to play the five-foot long instrument. An aboriginal elder, Badangthun Munmunyarun, said, "In Aboriginal culture, women do not touch or play the didgeridoo. The fact Madonna is a Westerner and the didgeridoo is a gift does not change the fact she should not be carrying it around." Apparently it carries some kind of phallic symbolism, which one could suppose made it the perfect gift for Maddie.

George Michael / Sony Battle Gets Ugly

George Michael's manager raised more than a few eyebrows when he testified before a London High Court in the singer's bid to sever ties with Sony. Rob Kahane alleged that Sony Music president and CEO Tommy Mottola might have ties to the Mafia and that the label tried to bribe him with a consulting contract while he was negotiating a deal for his client. A Sony spokesperson vehemently denied those charges. Kahane also testified that Michael's 1990 video for "Freedom" caused Columbia Records president Don Ienner to hit the roof. The video featured Michael's leather jacket exploding into flames, a

symbol of the singer's desire to break with his past image. Kahane said he sought to switch Michael from Columbia to the Epic label after Ienner released the second single from the *Listen Without Prejudice* album two weeks after the first, which Kahane said killed the album. Kahane said Mottola agreed to the label switch, then reversed the decision. Sony's attorneys said Mottola will deny he ever agreed to make such a switch when he takes the stand. Michael is charging Sony with restraint of trade, saying his contract to deliver six more albums by 2003 is unfair.

Mountain Winery's Chapter 11 Stops Foreclosure

Through some last-minute legal maneuvering, the owner of the Mountain Winery in Saratoga, Calif., has managed to avoid foreclosure proceedings. Ray Collishaw filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy on November 17th, which gives him protection from

THE HOLMES BROTHERS

After about three decades of playing their own brand of soulful blues for New York-area audiences, the last thing The Holmes Brothers expected was to be "discovered." Three men well into middle-age who make gospel-tinged music harkening back to Otis Redding aren't exactly on the top of too many A&R scouting lists. But about five years ago, it happened.

Singer/drummer Popsy Dixon was at a jam session that included New York harmonica player and producer Andy Breslau, who also happened to have connections at Rounder Records. An impressed Breslau asked Dixon what band he was with, and shortly thereafter Rounder execs began checking out the group's performances. Dixon, Sherman Holmes and Wendell Holmes have been counting their blessings ever since. "At least 50 percent of it is surely luck, because a lot of people play all their lives and they're very good and never get out of their communities," Sherman Holmes says. "I mean, I could go up to a church right now and find you some fantastic singers." Wendell Holmes is still awe-stricken by all the attention. "It has me amazed, because we're just doing the same thing that we've been doing for the last 35 years," he says. "Nothing's changed, it's just that people have taken a little notice of us."

It was pure love of music that kept the brothers going over the years. "Music was always encouraged in our family, and it has been with us since we were so small that it's almost a way of life," Sherman says. "Of those that drop by the wayside, some of them love the music, but a lot of them just love the scene, and they outgrow it or whatever." The brothers played together on and off in a variety of groups through the '60s and '70s. In the early '70s, Wendell met Popsy, which led to the formation of The Holmes Brothers. "I would be doing it if it wasn't even about making money," Wendell says. "We just stuck it out. We worked a lot, and the opportunity just happened to come along."

Though the money wasn't good enough to forgo their day jobs until recently, Sherman and Wendell always had a place to play their music. "Even though we weren't on a big scale, we always worked," Sherman says. "I remember at times during the '60s, we would turn down nights because we wanted to watch a certain television show." The extra income the music generated wasn't to be scoffed at either. "I'd look at it like this," Sherman says. "If I'd be sittin' at home watchin' television anyhow, and my little car might cost me three dollars to get to work, I'd have 45 more dollars than I had. And I still had a good time."

But there were difficulties when Wendell and Sherman tried to play outside of New York. "One of the things that's obviously changed is that, as you move around, it's easy to find places to stay," Sherman says. "Years ago when you went on the road, you used to have a thing called the Green Book. That was a book that would tell black people where they were safe to go — you know, what hotel wouldn't take you, the alternatives and stuff like that. So I've seen that change." Ironically, The Holmes Brothers' audiences are predominantly white today, the brothers say.

Besides linking the band with Rounder Records, Breslau also introduced the band to Concerted Efforts, where Paul Kahn and

Jack Randall share booking and management responsibilities. "I really love it, not because it makes me feel big or anything, but I just realize how much of a load is off our backs." Wendell says. "It's very hard to represent yourself. We're not getting beat, and they care about us and we care about them. It's a family thing." Sherman credits Concerted Efforts with getting the band better gigs and more exposure. "It's been a big change," he says. "I guess you definitely need management to get to that first step."

Since their first album was released in 1989, The Holmes Brothers have been able to take their music all over the world. They've been regulars on the blues and jazz festival circuit, and have opened for Neville Brothers and Indigo Girls, among others. In 1991, they played WOMAD festivals in England, Germany, Spain and Germany. It was at WOMAD that the band caught the ear of Peter Gabriel, who invited them to record a gospel album for his Real World label. "I've never seen anything like it," Wendell says. "They had food and everything right there. He has one of the best recording facilities in the world. It was good for us because it was a gospel album and commercially it did pretty well. And it was a big boost for us." The band is currently on a European tour that takes them through Germany and Scandinavia. They return to New York on December 18th and have East Coast dates scheduled through mid-January.

The brothers are making the most of their opportunities to travel. "It's always a blessing to be able to travel to different places where most people aren't able to go," Wendell says. "We were in Africa last year, and that was one of the greatest experiences of my life to go back to the homeland and just mingle with the black people and get back to the roots." In Africa, the band had the opportunity to jam with African musicians, an experience Wendell and Sherman say reinvigorated their music. "It makes you see things from a different perspective," Sherman says of his experiences overseas. "It makes me appreciate my country a lot more. Even though I've gone to countries I really liked, there was always some reason I wanted to be here."

The Holmes Brothers recently released their fourth album, *Soul Street*, on Rounder. Breslau co-produced the album with Scott Billington. "I think it's the best album that we've ever done, and I'm not just saying that," Wendell says. "There was more money put into it for producing it and getting it done right." Sherman says country music influenced the new album more than the band's past efforts. "I think it was done well." Sherman says. "As a matter of fact, it seems to be getting a better [initial] reception than any of our other records."

creditors until he reorganizes his company's finances, the *San Jose Mercury News* reported. Most of Collishaw's \$14.3 million debt is reportedly owed to his own family, friends and businesses. Concert series subscribers and the IRS are among the others owed money. A week earlier, Collishaw had staved off another foreclosure attempt by finding a mortgage banker to refinance an \$800,000 debt. Collishaw's bankruptcy attorney said all claims will be satisfied. The Mountain Winery reportedly has between 4,000 and 5,000 ticket refunds it has yet to issue for the shows cancelled by Ray Charles, Johnny Mathis and Dan Fogelberg. All three performers claimed the venue didn't make required payments. Collishaw went to court last month seeking \$5 million each from Charles and Mathis over the canceled shows.

Glenn Frey's TV Career Heads South

Glenn Frey's "South of Sunset" television series was canceled after just one episode aired. That series cancellation seems to be part of a new trend in TV programming called the short order; ordering less than the traditional 13 episodes prior to a series debut so the network doesn't get stuck with too many lame duck episodes of shows it suddenly decides it doesn't want. Frey's cancellation turned out to be one of the quickest in TV history. By comparison, Paula Poundstone's show lasted two weeks.

Common Thread: Who Benefits?

A Tennessee state agency investigated how the tribute album *Common Thread: The Songs of the Eagles* was represented to artists who contributed songs, but found only a technical violation by Giant Records. The project was spearheaded by Don Henley to help raise money for the Walden Woods Project, which aims to protect the Massachusetts land that Henry David Thoreau wrote about from developers. Some Nashville record execs had expressed displeasure with the amount of money that will actually go to the project — about a dollar per album sold. The state investigated and found that a \$1,000 fee to register as a professional solicitor was not paid by Giant. The label paid the fee, and the state concluded that the violation was unintentional. "I can only repeat that no record was made or released without the consent of everybody involved, with the exact terms of the

way royalties were being paid on the record," Giant Records' spokesman Doug Mark said. Giant has reportedly already advanced \$750,000 to the charity, and it's predicted that album sales could reach 2 million units by January. The back of the CD says a portion of the profits will go to the charity, not all the profits. Henley apparently has no beef with Giant Records making a few bucks on the album, and it is probably receiving more attention from the label than it would if Giant had zero profit potential on the project.

MJ Cancels Tour And Then Disappears

Michael Jackson canceled the remainder of his "Dangerous" world tour November 12th, costing himself and tour promoters millions of dollars in the process. News of the cancellation also included MJ's first public statement about the sexual molestation accusations brought against him in August. In the recorded statement released by his publicist, reportedly after he had already left Mexico, MJ said he had recently become dependant on painkillers, and his friends, specifically Elizabeth Taylor, and doctors had advised him to immediately seek treatment for the addiction. He said he is physically and emotionally exhausted and it is not possible for him to complete his tour. The announcement caught promoters by surprise, with several of them first hearing about the cancellation through the media. A promoter in Venezuela is being forced to refund nearly \$3 million worth of advance ticket sales for a show that had already been rescheduled once. Some members of the tour crew were already on their way to Puerto Rico when they got word the tour was off. The promoter in that country, Larry Stein, had at first issued public statements that the shows were still on when the cancellation rumors first started, but the following day he learned the shows weren't going to happen through the media. And at this point, it's not clear how much, if any, of the local promoter's financial disaster, will be born by Jackson. MJ's attorney, Bertram Fields, would only say those kinds of contractual matters required sorting out. MJ, in his statement, addressed the sexual molestation charges, saying he has been the target of an extortion attempt and he has been accused of "horifying and outrageous conduct." MJ goes on to say he was humiliated, embarrassed and hurt, suffering great pain in his heart. He said he became increasingly dependent on the drugs because of the pressures of the allegations coupled with the energy needed to perform. Jackson claims he first started taking

the pain medication several months ago after major reconstructive surgery on his scalp, which was burned in 1984 during the filming of a Pepsi commercial. Speaking of Pepsi, their sponsorship contract with MJ officially ends at the conclusion of this tour. But the abrupt cancellation of the tour essentially marked the end of that endorsement deal. However, a Pepsi spokesperson said that no decision has been made regarding future deals with MJ. Jackson's exact whereabouts are unknown. He reportedly flew to England with Taylor and her husband, but where he went from there is a mystery. The decision to cancel the tour just prior to the only scheduled dates on U.S. soil caused the rumor mills to churn out speculation that MJ was fearful he would be arrested. But MJ's attorney, Bertram Fields, said MJ is seeking drug treatment outside of the U.S. to avoid the media circus that would be unavoidable in the states. Speculation has placed him in either Britain or Switzerland, although the media at one point got duped into thinking he was at a hotel in the French Alps. British tabloids are offering money and a free trip to Walt Disney World to whoever spots him first. Fields also said MJ's addiction progressively made it more difficult for him to function, and he adamantly denied rumors that MJ is stalling his return to the U.S., saying treatment would last six to eight weeks. In the meantime, a source close to the case claims that a judge has signed a warrant ordering Jackson to submit to a physical examination upon his return to the states in an effort to confirm a description of unique details about his genitalia. But attorneys on both sides claim no warrants for Jackson's arrest have been issued. Also, one of MJ's attorneys has made a claim that the L.A.P.D. is using unethical and unusual scare tactics in an effort to intimidate young friends of MJ's into generating evidence for the criminal case. Michael Jackson has also been dropped as the 1994 recipient of the prestigious Scopus Award given annually by the American Friends of the Hebrew University. MJ asked that his name be withdrawn from the award, which recognizes humanitarians, after it became apparent he won't be attending the event.

Dolphin Luv Sexual Harassment

A former member of Three Tymes Luv filed a sexual harassment lawsuit against Miami Dolphins safety Louis Oliver, who is vice

president of Sunshine Productions, the Florida record company that first promoted the group. Karen Washington alleges that the female singing group was treated as "the personal harem of Louis and his Miami Dolphins friends." She said she was subjected to "a continuous torrent of inappropriate touchings, sexual remarks [and] requests for sexual favors." The suit, filed in U.S. District Court in Miami, seeks unspecified compensation and punitive damages for sexual harassment, battery, invasion of privacy, negligent supervision of company employees, and unauthorized use of her likeness to promote the group after she quit.



Eubanks, who at one time in his career was a concert promoter in Los Angeles, will trade off the host duties with Peter Marshall, Dennis James, Jamie Farr and Dick Van Patten..... **Caesars World** has announced plans to build a \$25 million gambling casino on Indian land in downtown Palm Springs, Calif. The company plans to open the entertainment complex by 1995 and expects to offer full Las Vegas style gambling..... Recent rumors in business circles that TCI head John Malone wanted to buy a one-half stake in MCA were quashed when MCA's parent company, Matsushita, denied it had any intentions of selling. That started new rumors that Malone was eyeing other Hollywood studios. Meanwhile in the media conglomerate shuffle, Liberty Media, a TCI affiliate, has backed out of its agreement to invest \$500 million in QVC's bid for a hostile takeover of Paramount Communications. Liberty also has agreed to sell half of its 22 percent interest in QVC, worth about \$600 million. The QVC shares created antitrust problems for Liberty when parent company TCI was bought out by Bell Atlantic for \$21.4 billion..... The newly-released 1993 Simmons Study of Media and Markets shows country music has expanded its lead over other radio formats. The study showed that country music reaches 41.6 percent of U.S. adults while the runner-up format, adult contemporary, reaches 31.5 percent. That translates into 77.3 million adult country music fans, an increase of 10.4 million listeners over 1992.

Towards the end of **Paul Simon**'s October 6th concert at The Paramount in New York City a fan yelled out a request for "The Boxer." Simon obliged the fan and brought out Art Garfunkel again, but they only sang one verse for the fan, since the duo had opened the concert with the tune. Maybe the
