After more than six years with Nashville-based Entertainment Artists, Tim Tye has resigned his position to start his own agency. His initial clients are Liberty recording artist Ricky Lynn Gregg and Canadian rockers The Guess Who, both of whom he represented at Entertainment Artists. Both are exclusive U.S. deals. Tye told POLLSTAR he started his own agency so he could direct his attention to artists he had the most interest in. "I'm a great agent when I have a passion for an artist, and I found that my passion was with Ricky Lynn Gregg and The Guess Who," Tye said. Money Woes Close Circle Star

The Circle Star Center in San Carlos, Calif., has closed its doors due to financial troubles, and the building is now up for sale. Rene Boisvert of Circle Star Center, Inc., which took over as operator of the venue's concert business about a year ago, said he is negotiating a new lease with facility owner Jim Burney and is looking for capital. Burney said Boisvert stopped paying the rent, and the two agreed to shut down the building on December 1st. The theatre-in-the-round has hosted some of the biggest names in entertainment over the last 29 years. It had 25 full-time employees and 135 part-time workers during performances. A statement from Boisvert said the older, traditional Las Vegas-style acts that put the Circle Star on the map no longer can play multiple-date performances in the current marketplace. The new management tried to bring in different acts, but "substantial results were not experienced soon enough to allow the Circle Star to continue without injecting new capital," the statement said.

Frank Zappa

Innovative musician and composer Frank Zappa, 52, died of prostate cancer December 4th at his home in Los Angeles. His wife, Gail, and four children, Moon Unit, Dweezil, Ahmet and Diva, were with him when he died. Zappa came to prominence in the early '60s as leader of the Mothers Of Invention. Despite his unorthodox music, Zappa managed several hits, including "Dancin' Fool," a smite at the disco craze, and "Valley Girl," in which his daughter Moon Unit sang using the lingo popular with California's mall-cruising suburban youth in the '80s. All told,

he recorded more than 50 albums as a bandleader or a solo artist. Zappa's *Jazz From Hell* album won a Grammy in 1988 for best instrumental. He also was one of the most active and articulate foes of the Parents Music Resource Center, which proposed that albums with explicit lyrics be required to carry warning labels.

Pros On The Move

Bill Kitchen has accepted a position as director of marketing at Sony Music International. Kitchen was formerly a talent buyer for Metropolitan Entertainment and The Ritz in New York, where he won the Concert Industry Award for nightclub talent buyer of the year in 1991. He also handled most of the talent arrangements for Bill Clinton's inauguration celebrations.... Chrysalis Music has promoted **David Ellman** to VP/GM. He previously was director of finance.... **John Dukakis**, who was named a VP at Paisley Park Records in January, has been upped to general manager. He'll oversee the day-to-day business at the label.... Atlantic Records has established a new jazz department, with **Michelle Taylor** at the helm. Taylor, who will work out of Atlantic's New York City headquarters, comes to the company from RCA-Novus.... **Brad Hunt** has been appointed senior marketing VP for Zoo Entertainment in L.A. The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum has named former *Rolling Stone* music editor **James Henke** chief curator.... **Joy Bailey** has been appointed to senior director A&R, R&B at Arista Records. Bailey had most recently been associate director of black music, A&R at Capitol Records.... American Recordings promoted **Rob Kasino** to an A&R position. Kasino was formerly executive assistant to GM Mark Di Dia.... **Daniel Makagon** has joined Hollywood Records as an A&R representative. Boy Howdy

When Boy Howdy's first album came out in 1991, the band's name was perceived as a sarcastic poke at country music and its artists. "I think radio thought we were making fun of country music," lead vocalist and songwriter Jeffrey Steele told POLLSTAR. "It's more the complete opposite. The name is a celebration of country music, but they thought the name was poking fun — they thought it was a joke." However, misinterpretation of the band's name wasn't the only obstacle Boy Howdy had to surmount in its early days. As a matter of fact, it was a minor hurdle in light of the trauma the band suffered when their drummer, Hugh Wright, got into a serious accident and landed in the hospital on the brink of death.

Initially, the four members of Boy Howdy — Wright, Steele, and the Park brothers Larry and Cary — came together out of the Los Angeles club scene, where they had spent a decade on the local country circuit. "One night we thought it would be real cool to put a couple of songs together and play at the Palomino," Steele said. "And we did it and it sounded really good." It was then that they decided to put a band together and see where they could take it.

After showcasing and gigging for about three years, Steele was inspired by the Persian Gulf war to rewrite the lyric to, "When Johnny Comes Marching Home Again." "I made it into a real up-tempo, rocking country song," Steele said. When Boy Howdy started playing the song live, it got a good response. They recorded it on cassette and eventually the big rock and country stations in L.A. picked it up. Steele said when Curb Records heard it, someone from the company called the band and told them Curb wanted to put the song out, even though Curb had already seen the band four times, and passed on them four times. "And then two days later the war ended," Steele said. "So it didn't work out, but we caught their attention enough to warrant going and cutting some more demos, trying to get an album together."

In May 1992, the band had just finished shooting the video for their first single and was heading back to the hotel they were staying at in Dallas. When they passed a serious accident on the LBJ Freeway, their manager, Alan Hopper of Boy Hopper Management, and Wright stopped to help. Wright and a couple of other bystanders had succeeded in freeing a man who had been trapped in his automobile when another vehicle traveling 60 m.p.h. ran into them, throwing Wright 50 feet in the air. He landed on the median and suffered a major head injury and fractured his leg and ankle. The rest of the band was called to the hospital, and the doctor informed them that their bandmate was in critical condition and "could go either way."

The band had to deal with the tragedy of a member getting in a life threatening accident, and they had to face the reality of how the accident would effect their future. Steele said, "We didn't know whether we should just go home and forget it or regroup and try to give Hugh something to come back to." Guitarist Cary Park said, "As far as making the decision, it didn't take very long. We just had to say, 'we're going to keep going until he gets well and he can come back and play.'" Wright spent five months in a coma before he was able to start his rehabilitation trek back to the band.

In the meantime, Boy Howdy hired a temporary drummer and proceeded. Steele said the first single was doing well and the band

was starting to make a name for itself. They played FanFair that year, and Steele said playing in front of 25,000 people was tough because it was their first date without Wright. But they got through that time, which Steele credits partially to having a song on the radio. But when the second single "stiffed," the record company started wondering if the band was going to survive. Steele said the band decided to keep playing to try and keep their name in the public eye. "We just said, 'if we get another shot at another single, we'll do everything we can to make it a hit.'"

So they came off the road and talked to Curb about doing a promotional radio tour. For \$20-a-day, the three original members of the band, Steele and the Park brothers, agreed to hit the road and play acoustic concerts at 114 radio stations in two months. When their third single came out, Steele said, it was obvious the radio tour had been successful. "It made a big difference. And before we knew it, we had a top ten record, and Hugh woke up and started practicing." All of a sudden the band felt a resurgence, a feeling of power, Steele said. "If we can get Hugh back in the band, anything's possible. No obstacle's going to be big enough to stop us," he said. Steele and Park agree that Boy Howdy is like a family, which grew closer after Wright's accident. "It was amazing how much closer it brought us to each other. We were a family before, and we're even a closer family now," Park said.

Boy Howdy made it through those tough times with the help of their manager, Hopper, and their agent, Gayle Holcomb at William Morris. "We owe them a lot because they kept throwing us bones when we really didn't have much to go on. They kept us working and gave us something to keep us going in a straight direction — not having to look back too much," Steele said.

Looking forward, Boy Howdy's second album is due out January 11th, and the first single, "She'd Give Anything," is already moving up the country charts. Wright is fully recuperated and back in the band, which is wrapping up a series of U.S. club dates December 19th. "It hasn't been an overnight thing," Park said. "We were in a van for two years, with six guys and our gear. Now we've graduated to a nice tour bus and a driver. We can go to sleep at night and not have to worry about driving. And we're happy about that." Boy Howdy hits the road again mid-January.

Myrtle Beach Tries To Become Branson East

Plans for two new entertainment and shopping complexes in Myrtle Beach, S.C., have been unveiled. One new complex, designed by John Q. Hammons Industries, will consist of at least 12 theatres ranging in size from 1,000 to 3,000 seats on a 350-acre tract. Negotiations are under way to bring country music stars and other entertainers into the planned buildings. A 20,000- to 25,000-seat amphitheatre also is planned, along with a 14-acre lake which will go through the center of the acreage. The Gatlin Brothers announced they will build a \$7.5 million, 2,000-seat theatre in a separate tract in the vacation haven. The Gatlins' expect to set up residence in Myrtle Beach in the summer of 1994 at the theatre. They'll locate on a 200-acre development that also will include a 1,000-seat theatre housing "Magic On Ice." A large outlet shopping center and hotels are among other plans for the site. Calvin Gilmore opened Myrtle Beach's first country music theatre, The Carolina Opry, in 1986, and he's a bit

leery of the new boom. "Without a marketing infrastructure for country music, I don't think the demand will exist," he said. But Myrtle Beach city planner Jack Walker said a consultant's study estimates the Grand Strand — 60 miles of beaches from the North Carolina line to Georgetown — could support 50,000 seats. Myrtle Beach already draws about 10 million tourists annually, and has more than 55,000 hotel rooms.

Legal Grievs

Rapper **Snow** had to be bailed out of a Toronto jail by his mom December 1st after he was charged with making death threats against two hotel employees. Police said he was sent to the pokey after an argument with two staffers in a hotel room in which verbal threats were allegedly made. The threats were reportedly repeated in front of police who came to the scene. Snow, whose real name is Darrin O'Brien, is due in court again on December 21st.... **Jerry Fleming**, a former member of the '60s rock group The Classics IV, was arrested December 4th for allegedly abducting his estranged wife. Police were contacted when alleged victim Anne Marie Fleming yelled for help at a McDonald's drive-thru window in Twin Falls, Idaho. A member of Jerry Fleming's current band, Skywalker, said Fleming felt his wife's family turned her against him, and that if he could talk to her alone he could win her back.... **Micki Free** of Shalamar filed a \$1 million libel suit against Paramount Communications claiming he was defamed by a story run on the syndicated tabloid news show "Hard Copy." Free claims he was unfairly portrayed

It's All Downhill For A Soul Asylum Ski Trip

L.A. Ski and Sun Tours and Jackson, Wyo., city officials have settled their dispute over a December 21st Soul Asylum concert. The city was predicting that nearly 4,000 students traveling to their city would become unruly because the facility at which the concert is booked only holds 2,000 people. The California travel company had claimed that the 2,000-capacity limit was arbitrarily imposed. However, in an effort to settle the problem, they agreed to buy another date and have the students attend two separate shows on December 20th and 21st. A spokesperson for the tour company told POLLSTAR that the contracts had been signed and they expected nothing but smooth sailing from here on out.

Victim's Son Gets Manson Royalties

It looks like Axl Rose inadvertently did a good deed by including an acoustic rendition of a song by Charles Manson on Guns N' Roses' latest album. Because of a 1971 judgement, Manson's royalties from the song "Look At Your Game Girl," which appears as an uncredited bonus track on *"The Spaghetti Incident?"*, will be awarded to the son of one of Manson's victims. The son of Wojciech Frykowski, one of seven victims of the 1969 Manson family murders, stands to make about \$60,000 for every million copies GN'R's new album sells. The album sold more than 300,000 copies in its first two weeks on the shelves. Bartek Frykowski was 13 years old when his father was killed, and received \$500,000 in a court judgement against Manson in 1971. With interest, Manson now owes him \$1.2 million. GN'R guitarist Slash said that in light of the fact that Manson won't benefit financially from the recording, the band will not remove the track from the album. "We naively thought there was a certain dark humor in Manson singing these love song lyrics at the time, but now I find the word 'humor' doesn't

fit into the equation at all," Slash said. "[Manson is] the epitome of what's wrong with the human existence at this point and we don't want to glorify Manson in any way. But rather than pull the track it seems like we could at least help out a kid who lost his dad." In an earlier statement, Rose, who reportedly recorded the Manson song over the objections of other band members, said he would donate his royalties from the song to an environmental group. Geffen president Ed Rosenblatt said he wishes the song wasn't recorded, "but given our belief in freedom of speech, as well as the clear restraints of our legal agreements with the band, it was not our decision to make." Meanwhile, the Doris Tate Crime Victim's Bureau is urging a boycott of Geffen, despite the fact that Manson won't benefit financially and that the label pledged to make a contribution to the victims' group. The bureau is named after Sharon Tate's mother. Sharon Tate was one of the Manson family's most notable victims. Protesters picketed the West Hollywood and New York offices of Geffen late Tuesday. Geffen had no immediate comment on the boycott effort.

Cafe Kills Dead German Tourist Concert

The Hard Rock Cafe in Miami pulled the plug on a December 10th concert by a band called The Dead German Tourist because of complaints from the city commissioners. The concert featuring the Tampa-based band was to be broadcast live on the syndicated radio program, the Ron and Ron Show. When the cafe refused to broadcast the concert unless The Dead German Tourist was taken off the bill, the Ron and Ron Show decided to reschedule the entire concert elsewhere rather than go forward without the

CBGB Alums Return For 20th Anniversary

CBGB, the legendary dump in New York City's Bowery that helped launch the careers of countless bands from The Ramones to Blondie, is celebrating its 20th Anniversary throughout December and January. To mark the occasion, more than 100 bands are set to pay tribute to the club. Among those scheduled to return are David Byrne, Helmet, The Lemonheads and Sonic Youth. An album and video of the performances will be compiled for release sometime next year.

Black Radio Takes A Stand Against Gangsta Rap

Black-owned radio stations are putting forth a message against gangsta rap by banning or censoring songs that glorify violence or have lyrics that are profane or misogynistic. KACE-FM in Los Angeles, which is owned by former Green Bay Packer Willie Davis, took the first step a couple of weeks ago when it pulled songs from its playlist. This week, New York City's WBLS-FM decided to follow suit, and banned songs that advocate violence or have derogatory lyrics. Frankie Crocker, VP of WBLS owner Inner City Broadcasting Corp., said December 7th that the station is doing "what is morally right." WBLS, one of NYC's most consistently high-rated stations, hopes to encourage other radio

stations to follow suit and pressure record companies into reconsidering the material they release. The new policy will apply to all other stations owned by Inner City Broadcasting Corp. Rev. Al Sharpton, who supports the ban, said, "You have a right to speak, but not the right to shout, 'Fire!' in a crowded theatre." He said some of the lyrics in today's music are shouting "Shoot!" in neighborhoods crowded with guns. In Los Angeles, KPWR-FM joined the bandwagon when it announced it will be bleeping out offensive words on the records it plays. The three words — "bitch," "nigga," and "ho" — will be masked or deleted in songs when they are used negatively. However, it does not intend to completely ban offensive songs from its playlist. WCKZ-FM in Charlotte, N.C., has dealt with the issue by limiting gangsta rap to the late night hours. Black Entertainment Television will follow suit by removing explicitly violent rap videos from its programming beginning next year.

Short Items Of Note

The Boston opening of "The Who's Tommy" at the Colonial Theater was cancelled December 2nd due to a computer malfunction, leaving 1,200 ticket-holders disappointed. "Touring is apparently being more funky on the computers than anyone anticipated," said the show's local spokesperson. The show went on as planned the next night.... Merrill Lynch Capital Partners Inc. will funnel \$30 million into the **Wherehouse Entertainment** chain, mostly to fund two acquisitions. The 15-store Pegasus Music and Video stores in Utah will be purchased for nearly \$10 million, and some of the other cash will be put toward securing permanent financing of Wherehouse's June acquisition of the Record Shop chain in Northern California.... Fans trying to buy **Garth Brooks** tickets by phone tied up phone service in southeastern Illinois, southwestern Indiana and western Kentucky for about two hours December 4th. Tickets for three concerts scheduled for 10,000-capacity Roberts Stadium in Evansville, Ind., quickly sold out.... The NFL is still searching for someone to entertain at halftime during the **Super Bowl**. Bruce Springsteen, Billy Joel, Elton John, Paul McCartney and Garth Brooks all reportedly have turned down offers.... Elvis Presley's face will soon appear on a long-distance calling card. Elvis Presley Enterprises Inc. has signed an agreement which allows World Telecom Group Inc. of Mountain View, Calif., to market four versions of its prepaid calling card with **The King's** mug. One card sports a photo of Elvis on the phone shortly after

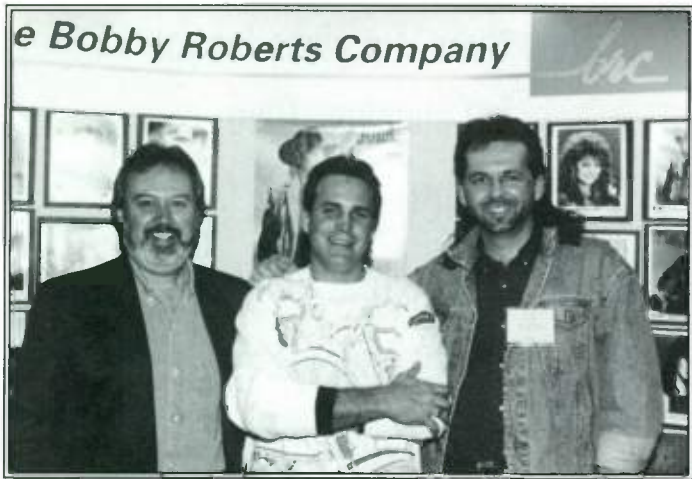

his discharge from the Army, another features his military ID photo, and two versions will be artist renderings of the singer.... A new law in France will make it easier for French pop artists to compete with English and American performers for **airtime** on FM radio stations. The National Assembly approved the law December 4th, which will require FM radio stations to play a minimum of 40 percent French songs. The bill must now face the Senate, where approval is likely.... As part of a marketing campaign for a new corn chip called Scoops, Frito-Lay Inc., is sponsoring 40 dates on **Reba McEntire's** U.S. tour. Earlier in the year, the corn chip company sponsored dates on Billy Ray Cyrus' national tour and saw a 5 percent sales increase in the cities where they had sponsorship.... PRA Records, a new independent label headed by artist manager **Patrick Rains**, placed its first release — Marcus Miller's *The Sun Don't Lie* — at #18 on the jazz charts. The label is distributed domestically through Koch International.

Michael Jackson: The Saga Continues

The past week, Michael Jackson's previously silent family came forward to defend their troubled brother and son. No sooner did they, when LaToya Jackson took an opposite stance and began a media blitz, insinuating that molestation charges against her brother are true. MJ's mother, Katherine Jackson, and brother Jermaine, proclaimed during televised interviews that MJ is innocent of the accusations brought against him. Mrs. Jackson and Jermaine criticized the way MJ's people are handling the case, and they pleaded with Michael to return home to defend himself. Mrs. Jackson also said that the suit brought against MJ by five former security guards claiming they were fired because they knew too much about MJ's "nighttime visits with young boys" is simply a case of disgruntled employees. The Jacksons recently talked to Michael, and they denied reports that he had moved to a Connecticut hospital for his treatment for pain killer dependence. In an article in the December issue of *Vanity Fair*, MJ's attorney Bertram Fields said when his client testifies he will admit to sharing a bed with his accuser, but that their relationship was the same as any 12 year old boys and was not sexual in nature. The article also reports that a friend of MJ's claimed the troubled superstar called him from Europe and said he was never

coming back to the States. But lawyers for both MJ and the teenager who brought the suit against him confirmed that the superstar will be deposed on January 18th, and they expect him to return to Los Angeles at that time. However, it is legally possible for MJ to give his deposition from a foreign country. And the most slamming comments of the week came from LaToya, who called a press conference from Tel Aviv to say she believes her brother may have abused young boys who spent the night with him. She also claimed that she saw numerous checks made out in large amounts to the parents of the children that MJ spent time with. Even though she alluded to it, she refused to call the checks "hush money." The estranged Jackson said she loves her brother, but she doesn't want the children to be hurt. She cited her own alleged molestation by her father as the reason she finally came out about MJ. LaToya also said her mother, who earlier in the week had denied that MJ was gay, used to complain that her famous son was a "faggot." LaToya's husband, Jack Gordon, said MJ had threatened to kill LaToya and had tried to kidnap her twice to keep her from revealing his secrets. But MJ's parents and some of his brothers said LaToya had been brainwashed by her husband and they both were lying. They also said that LaToya and her husband's recent comments to the press were motivated purely by greed. And in an unrelated case, the copyright infringement suit brought against MJ got underway in Los Angeles. Two childhood friends have sued him and his father Joe, Lionel Ritchie, Quincy Jones, Ron Temperton and several corporations involved in the publishing and distribution of three of MJ's songs. Reynaud Jones and Robert Smith told the court that they had submitted three songs to the Jacksons for consideration, but they were turned down. A lawyer for the songwriters said the two were surprised years later when portions of three of MJ's hits sounded remarkably like parts of his clients' songs. MJ's lawyer in the suit claimed the two songwriters resorted to the lawsuit when they failed to sell their songs to the Jacksons. The Jackson family trauma has produced a landslide of work for high-powered Los Angeles attorneys. His legal team beefed up this week with two of L.A.'s best known attorneys. Johnnie L. Cochran Jr., attorney for riot victim Reginald Denny, was brought on as co-counsel on the sexual molestation civil suit, and Elizabeth Taylor's personal attorney, Neil Papiano, will be participating in the case as a consultant. The additions to the legal team for the civil suit include added responsibilities for MJ's criminal attorney Howard Weitzman. Weitzman said Bertram Fields, MJ's civil attorney who has recently come under attack by the Jackson family, has not been removed from the case, but some of his duties will be assumed by other lawyers.

Elvis Look-Alike All Shook Up

A distraught Elvis Presley look-alike was arrested November 30th for allegedly ramming two state trooper cars after a high-speed chase along Interstate 40 outside of Memphis the day before. The Faux King temporarily evaded arrest by fleeing into the woods for the night. Andre Guay, 34, of Quebec was charged with attempted murder, reckless driving, vandalism, leaving the scene of an accident and evading arrest. Guay told police officers he became distraught over his marriage problems, and that "he became even more distraught after visiting Graceland." Following a 17-mile high-speed chase, Guay allegedly rammed

Producer Scrooges Himself Out Of Production

The traveling stage version of "A Christmas Carol" starring Mickey Rooney as Scrooge has been canceled because of problems the show's producer is having with the Actors Equity union. Los Angeles-based promoter Kevin Von Feldt allegedly failed to make payroll during rehearsals last year, and until he settles the \$8,000 debt he is barred from using union members, including Rooney. Ohio promoter Mike Scott said he is upset at losing almost \$10,000 in deposits on the show, which was scheduled for five shows at the Masonic Auditorium in Toledo. Von Feldt had announced in October that his show would open in Los Angeles and travel to Toledo, Cleveland, Indianapolis and St. Paul, with other cities to be added later.

Sony Chief Suffers Stroke

Sony Corp. co-founder and chairman Akio Morita suffered a cerebral hemorrhage November 30th, company officials said. He underwent surgery in a Tokyo hospital, and was in satisfactory condition. Kyoto News Agency reports also quoted unnamed

company officials as saying Morita, 72, will step down due to health problems. The company so far denies those reports. Speculation is that Sony CEO Norio Ohga will assume a higher profile if Morita's illness proves to be lengthy.



Obituaries

Larry Uttal, 71, who ran several successful independent labels during the '60s and '70s, died of AIDS-related complications November 25th. He was best known for his work at Bell Records, which produced hits by Mitch Ryder & The Detroit Wheels, and Barry Manilow, among others. After Bell folded in 1974, Uttal opened Private Stock, a label which released hits by Frankie Valli, Rupert Holmes and others. He established a travel agency that targeted music business clients in the early '80s..... Douglas Hopkins, 32, who was fired as lead guitarist for the Gin Blossoms last year, shot himself to death. His body was found at his Tempe, Ariz., home on December 5th. Hopkins wrote the band's biggest hit, "Hey Jealousy." He reportedly was fired because of excessive drinking, and was said to have attempted suicide six times in the last 10 years.
