

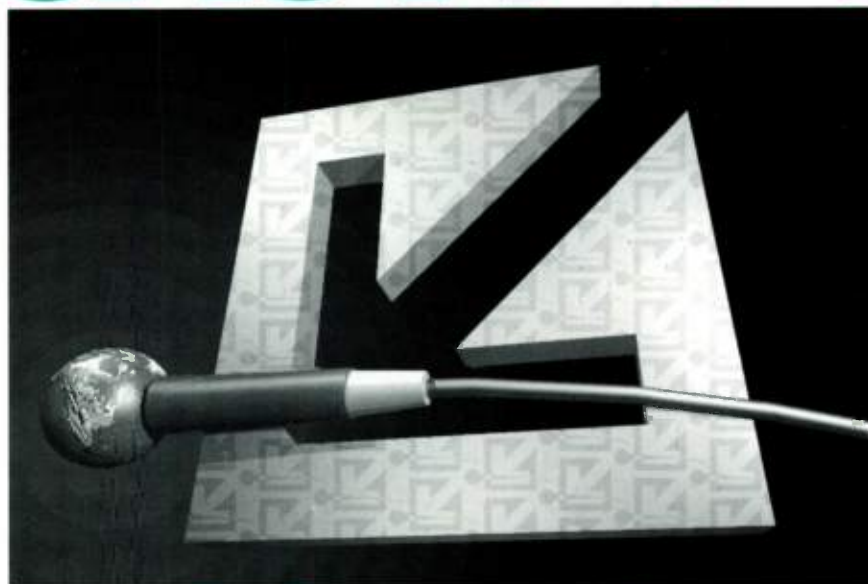

Legal Aftermath Of Country Fans Death

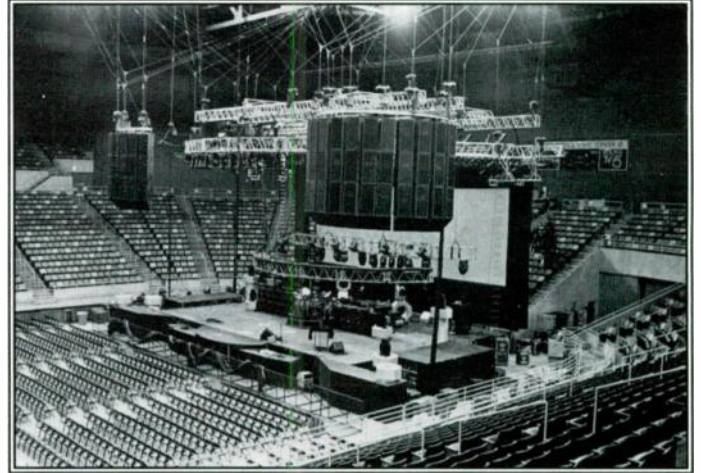
The former wife of a man who died of a heart attack he suffered during a Alan Jackson concert at Roberts Municipal Stadium has filed suit against the stadium, the city of Evansville, Ind., concert promoter The Gehl Group, an ambulance company and others on behalf of the man's children. Scott Davis suffered a heart attack at the stadium on March 19th and later died at a hospital. The suit was filed on January 28th, and seeks unspecified damages. Among the allegations are charges that it took 10 minutes for Davis to reach an ambulance stationed at the stadium, that nobody at the stadium or in the ambulance provided proper CPR, and that the ambulance wasn't properly outfitted. Executive Director Sandie Aaron said that the facility goes beyond local ordinances in providing medical services at shows. "According to the terms of our contract with the city, we are required to provide first aid services," she said. "Since Ogden has managed this facility, we have always gone above and beyond that by having an ambulance available at every show — which we did on that night. We don't feel that there was any wrongdoing at all."

\$10.9 Million Marked For Coliseum Repairs

The Los Angeles City Council allocated \$10.9 million February 9th from the first federal earthquake grants it received to start repairing the Memorial Coliseum. A detailed report of the damage was expected to be released late last week, and it is hoped that the stadium can be ready to host USC and Raiders games as scheduled. A streamlined bidding process for contractors was approved to get the project moving quickly. The council also told a city attorney to report on whether Spectacor Management Group, its architects, or anyone else failed to comply with their responsibilities by failing to give the Coliseum Commission a report warning that the stadium was susceptible to major damage in a quake, the *L.A. Times* reported. Though a 1991 report by a structural engineer warned that the structure did not meet L.A.'s seismic safety code and could suffer major damage in a large quake, the report evidently wasn't seen by the commission. In 1992, the commission approved a \$15 million renovation for the stadium that stated that no "permanent seismic retrofit or seismic strengthening work" was to be done on the facility. That renovation, which included adding thousands of new lower level seats and lowering the playing field, was completed last year. Coliseum managers issued a press release on February 2nd disputing that they saw the report warning of

potential trouble. "SMG did not at any time withhold information from the L.A. Memorial Coliseum Commission," GM Jay Hagerman said. "An engineer was commissioned by SMG's architectural firm, HNTB, in 1991 in the process of planning a major renovation that would have added additional seating and luxury suites and boxes to the existing structure. However, this renovation was not undertaken by the commission or SMG. The report was given directly to Coliseum architects for evaluation."

BAD RELIGION

Bad Religion didn't need a major label. In the past, the band was courted by some of the biggest and didn't hesitate to send them packing. Through its own independent label, Epitaph, Bad Religion managed to consistently reach six figures in album sales and pack 1,200-seat venues without a bit of help from a huge media conglomerate. That all changed last year when Atlantic signed the band to a long-term deal. Atlantic quickly re-released *Recipe For Hate*, an album which had been in circulation for a few months on Epitaph. Suddenly, the group that — along with Fugazi — personified the do-it-yourself ethic was on the same label that created mass-market monsters like Led Zeppelin.

But then Bad Religion isn't a band that fits into anyone's arbitrarily-set niche. If your idea of the face of punk rock still has a ring through its nose, Bad Religion will force you to take another look. "We've never professed to be anything other than a band who makes music with relevant lyrics and aggressive beats and overt harmonies — a band that makes you think," says singer Greg Graffin, who writes many of the band's songs. He also holds a master's degree in geology from UCLA and is pursuing a Ph.D. in zoology from Cornell. He has taught biology labs at Cornell as part of his graduate studies, and he's married and the father of one young child. In fact, three band members are fathers.

Graffin thinks Bad Religion's lyrics are a big part of what sets the band apart. A recurrent theme for him though the years has been religion. "We're lucky we called ourselves [Bad Religion], because religion is a good metaphor," Graffin says. "We don't use it literally — we're not talking about bad Christianity or bad Judaism or bad Hinduism or whatever. Religion is a metaphor for prescriptive thought and organized beliefs — blind faith in organized beliefs. And those are things that are going to affect a person throughout his entire life."

Bad Religion came to be in a Los Angeles suburb in 1980 when 15-year-old bassist Jay Bentley, high school classmate Graffin, guitarist Brett Gurewitz and original drummer Jay Ziskrout (Bobby Schayer joined the group in 1991) started playing living room jams. In early 1981, Greg Hetson, then a member of the Circle Jerks and now a member of Bad Religion, played the group's demo tape on Rodney Bingenheimer's show on L.A. radio station KROQ. The band's first high-profile gig was opening for Social Distortion in decidedly un-punk Orange County.

Bad Religion quickly built a following, though no label was interested in releasing their music at the time. So the band created Epitaph to release their first EP in 1981. "I think in the early days, it proved that the real substance was in the music," Graffin says. "Because, obviously, we weren't knowledgeable or any way expert in the music industry. But we had a product to sell, and that was our music. It's almost like kids selling lemonade at a lemonade stand on a hot day. If you've got a product that is unique and has some individual flavor, people are going to buy it."

Gurewitz, who worked for a record distribution company, soon began devoting more time to Epitaph. Under Gurewitz' ownership, Epitaph now boasts some of punk's most renown bands — among them NoFX, Pennywise and Rancid. With his academic and family commitments, Graffin generally keeps clear of Epitaph's business.

"I try to distance myself from it because it was never a path that I wanted," Graffin says. "I never wanted to be a record mogul. That's why I live in Ithaca [N.Y.] and they all live in L.A."

Ultimately, the band signed with Atlantic because the label afforded them the opportunity to reach a larger audience, Graffin says. Being on a major also gives Gurewitz time to focus on other Epitaph bands. "The fact is, we're not making more money on Atlantic," Graffin says. "I think we have the potential to sell more records, in which case we would make more money. But by no means is the money they put up front any more than we would have made on Epitaph." While Epitaph has one marketing person and one promotion person, Atlantic offers a full staff, Graffin says. "As long as the label can convince you that you're a priority — which they have convinced us — they will put that staff in motion and they will give you the full benefit of their resources." That includes a distribution network that puts Bad Religion's music into more stores than ever before.

There were howls of protest from some in the punk community when Bad Religion signed with a major, but Graffin says he actually expected it to be worse than it was. "There are always malcontents," Graffin says. "If it's not because you're on a major, it's some other reason, like, 'Well, now you're playing three slow songs on your record when you used to have only one slow song.' So we've gone through this, believe it or not, every year for at least the last four years. And you have to hope that for every [fan] you lose, you pick up numerous others. Now I don't want to imply that the old fans aren't important to us, because I think the one thing that we can do for them is to be committed to our style and be committed to the consistency of Bad Religion."

Live performance was largely responsible for Bad Religion's popularity in the group's earliest days. Though the band slept on many strangers' floors when they first began to tour, that lifestyle didn't last long. "We quickly decided that we have got to be able to tour comfortably because we want to be able to put on a great show," Graffin says. "You can't do that if you're staying up at other people's houses partying all night." At first, the band relied on the contacts Hetson made from his days with the Circle Jerks when booking places to play. Eventually, Hetson led the band to ICM agent Andy Somers. "In Andy's very early days, he was an independent, but he booked a lot of Circle Jerks shows," Graffin explains. "Andy moved to various agencies and ended up at ICM." The band linked with its first manager — Danny Heaps at Addis, Wechsler & Associates — last year.

Look for Bad Religion to have a new album in the stores and be back on the road in North America late this year.

City Settles Lawsuit Over Deadhead Death

The Inglewood City Council settled a wrongful-death lawsuit with the parents of a 19-year-old who died from neck injuries suffered when he struggled with police after a Grateful Dead concert at The Forum in December 1989. According to the *Los Angeles Times*, the City Council, without admitting any wrongdoing, agreed on February 1st to pay Patrick Shanahan's parents \$750,000. Apparently, after the 1989 concert an officer spotted Shanahan standing rigidly with a blank stare on his face. Shanahan didn't respond to questions from the officer — instead he dropped to his knees and started yelling and laughing to himself. The officer then tried to arrest him, and Shanahan resisted. After the officer called for backup, he wrestled Shanahan to the ground, but the teen broke away. One of the officers grabbed him and used a carotid artery chokehold —

which is a controversial form of forceful restraint banned by many law enforcement agencies — to restrain him. The coroner ruled that compression of the neck during restraint was the reason for Shanahan's death. In addition to the chokehold, witnesses said they saw officers beating Shanahan with nightsticks. The coroner's report also concluded that multiple injuries and acute LSD intoxication were contributing factors in Shanahan's death. Inglewood police denied they used excessive force, and the D.A.'s office cleared them of any criminal wrongdoing.

MJ Faces Grand Jury Scrutiny

A Santa Barbara County grand jury convened February 9th and began hearing testimony in the Michael Jackson sexual molestation investigation. The first witness before the panel was Miko Brando, Marlon Brando's son, who is a former employee at MJ's Neverland ranch. Several subpoenas have reportedly been issued to witnesses, including Norma Staikos, the VP of MJJ Productions, but neither MJ or his teen-aged accuser have been asked to testify. The grand jury can be used to collect evidence for the prosecution and/or to determine if a criminal indictment will be handed down. No charges have been filed in either Santa Barbara or Los Angeles county. However, reports of politics are proliferating with L.A. District Attorney Gil Garcetti reportedly hesitant about going into another high profile case and possibly losing (Garcetti recently was unable to get a conviction in the Lyle and Eric Menendez trial). Yet Garcetti reportedly doesn't want the Santa Barbara D.A.'s office to get the glory if there is sufficient evidence to bring charges. However, Garcetti acknowledged that prosecutors from both Santa Barbara and L.A. are now collaborating on the case.

Short Items Of Note

A 75-year-old amusement park, **Peony Park**, which hosted many concerts on its outdoor stage, is in its last months of operation because the owners couldn't attract a buyer who wanted to keep it open. The rides at Peony Park are being sold off one by one, and the park's managers, citing financial losses as the reason for ceasing operation, are still considering offers to sell the remainder of the property. The park will officially close March 31st unless a new buyer steps forward and decides to keep it open.... In Vermont, the Stowe Zoning Board of Adjustment ruled that no more than eight concerts could be held during the summer season at the **Stowe Mountain Performing Arts Center**. Capacity was also lowered to 12,000. A spokesperson for Metropolitan

He was arrested at Los Angeles Int'l Airport on November 9th after airport security spotted a .40 caliber semiautomatic pistol and hollow-point bullets in his carry-on luggage. Lee faces up to a year in jail, but remains free pending his February 22nd arraignment.

Legal Grievs

Barbara Mandrell took the stand in Nashville February 1st to attest to the industry stature of Kirk Cappello, Reba McEntire's late bandleader who died in the plane crash that took the lives of seven members of McEntire's band three years ago. Cappello's parents filed a \$20 million wrongful death lawsuit against Duncan Aircraft Sales of Venice, Fla. The suit claims the pilot, who worked for Duncan, failed to follow proper operating procedures, resulting in the crash. However, Duncan claims the accident was a result of negligence by air traffic controllers.... **BMG** filed a lawsuit January 31st in Los Angeles alleging that an insurance company denied coverage and refused to pay attorneys to defend consumer lawsuits stemming from the **Milli Vanilli** lip-syncing catastrophe, according to *Daily Variety*. **BMG** alleges that Centennial Insurance had initially agreed to cover the expenses for the defense of four of the 25 class action claims brought by consumers who purchased Milli Vanilli albums and later learned that Rob and Fab were just lip-syncing. The four claims were set apart from the other 21 lawsuits because they included allegations of emotional distress. **BMG** is seeking more than \$6 million in damages.... **Barney** the purple dinosaur is involved in a \$5 million breach of contract suit filed January 19th in U.S. District Court. The suit filed in Boston by Compass Entertainment of Taunton, Mass., the first distributor of Barney videos, alleges deceptive practices by Lyons Group of Texas. Compass charges Lyons broke a written agreement giving it rights to produce Barney concerts on a long-term basis in exchange for financing

test concerts in 1991. Barney has 11 sold out shows scheduled for March 5-13 at Radio City Music Hall. A spokesperson for Lyons denied all the allegations.... The copyright infringement trial in which **Michael Jackson** is accused of stealing the song "Dangerous" from an unknown Denver songwriter got underway last week. Crystal Cartier claims that MJ's hit "Dangerous" was lifted from a song she copyrighted in July 1991. However, Cartier was unable to produce an original taped copy of the song for the trial — claiming she gave them all away. And the judge refused to allow as evidence a "re-created" tape — which Cartier put together interspersing lines from her "Dangerous" with those from MJ's version to show the similarities.... After 13 weeks, testimony finally concluded in **George Michael's** restraint of trade case against Sony on January 26th. Each side is expected to conclude with about a week of closing arguments beginning February 17th. Michael is attempting to have his long-term contract with Sony terminated, and if successful, the legal precedent could have huge implications for the record business.

Between The Dates

The legendary English group PINK FLOYD hasn't toured since 1988 when they were that year's top boxoffice attraction selling \$27.6 million worth of tickets. After the first few dates went on sale, it has become obvious that the group's fans have not suffered any momentary lapse of desire to see them. Before the tour even starts, they will likely have exceeded their entire 1988 tour gross. All 53,000 tickets were sold as fast as the computers could spit them out for Floyd's June 2nd show at Veterans Stadium in Philadelphia. A second show was immediately added and it also went clean in less than a day. In anticipation of the heavy demand, Electric Factory's Larry Magid asked The Spectrum to also open it's box office across the street from the stadium and it sold 8,000 tickets. It took a little longer in Miami, but by the end of the day all 54,000 tickets for the first U.S. date on the tour, March 30th at Joe Robbie Stadium were gone. Cellar Door's Ron Cohen said he is hoping CPI will let them add a second show. Two weeks ago, the temperature dropped to 45 below in Toronto as fans lined up to snatch 54,000 tickets for the July 5th show at CNE Stadium. A second Toronto show, scheduled for July 6th went on sale Saturday. For markets that have yet to announce ticket sales, keep your ears open for a radio "teaser campaign" made up of three spots that run the weekend before the on sale announcement. On day one, the spot, which makes no mention of Pink Floyd, consists of the sound of a helicopter with the announcement, "Redefining the concert spectacular." The second spot contains the same announcement along with music and a venue. On the third day the campaign announces Pink Floyd.... An announcement is expected this week about the BARBRA STREISAND tour. Meanwhile Bab's representatives have advised eight United Kingdom publications that advertisements announcing Streisand concerts in Glasgow on November 1-2 and Manchester November 10-11 are "totally fallacious in content." Polar Promotions of Glasgow, along with Atlantic Entertainment had placed the ads. The ads requested ticket applications in writing "enclosing cheque/p.o. payable to Polar Promotions and S.A.E." When notified of the false ads, one newspaper notified the police which started to intercept mail headed for Polar Productions. Streisand's reps Marty Erichman and Lee Phillips report that no concerts have been "locked" with Polar Promotions, and there are no plans for any concerts in November. The eight publications carrying the ads have been asked to advise their readers of the misrepresentation.... It was only last fall when a Nashville insider told POLLSTAR, "Keep your eye on JOHN MICHAEL MONTGOMERY. He's the one to watch." So far this year we've watched him jump to the top of the pop album charts with "Kickin' It Up," one week after it entered at number 3. Montgomery benefited from opening for Reba McEntire in '93, and this year it may be Reba who benefits. Montgomery will be on the first three months of her current tour.... The "Little Big Band" that is COLIN JAMES' backing band is actually Roomful Of Blues.... Electric Factory Concerts has renovated the TOWER THEATRE in Upper Darby, PA making both general admission and reserved seating shows possible. The front orchestra seating area is now removable for general admission events allowing for approximately 1200 people. Reserved seating will still be the practice for the back orchestra section and the balcony. In addition to the new arrangement, Electric Factory plans on putting up a curtain from the balcony and closing off the rear of the theatre to create a "club-like" atmosphere for smaller acts.... Look for a DAVID BYRNE theatre tour April through June.... A stunned audience of about 5,000 watched reggae artist MAXI PRIEST, unhappy with the accompaniment to his first song, silence his backing band and perform the rest of his concert by himself on February 6th at Bermuda's National Stadium. Priest was performing at Bermuda's Drug Awareness Day with two local musicians, when he suddenly turned around and told them to "turn it off." Priest's presence at the festival created controversy even before he played a note because, although he urged the public to avoid using drugs, he believes in the Rastafarian idea that marijuana is a holy herb and should be legalized.

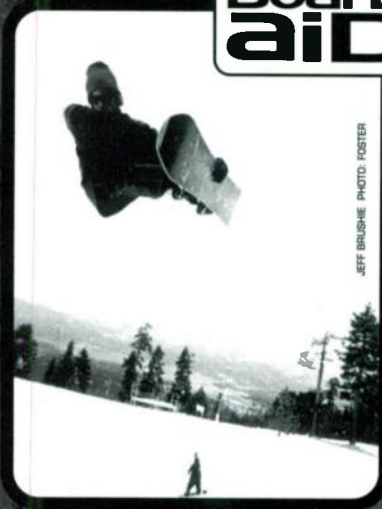

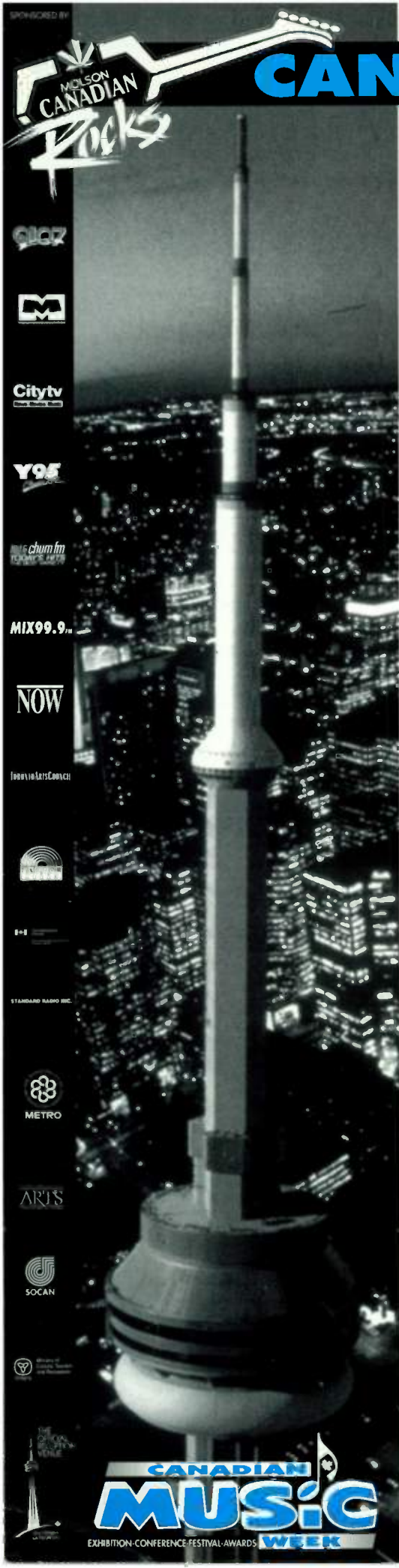
