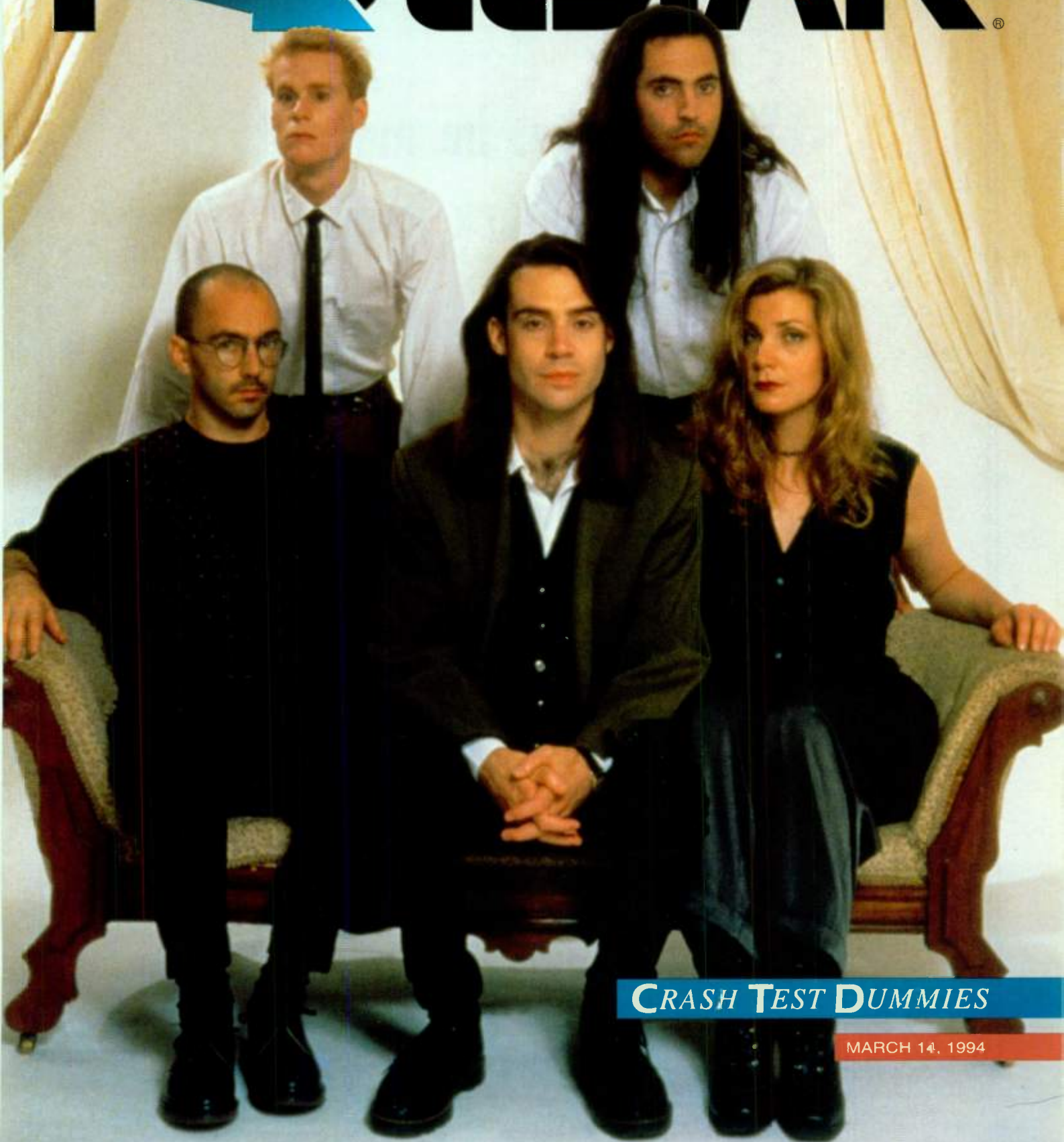

of both Ticketmaster and Pacer/CATS. It allows Ticketmaster to further expand its operations and make closer strategic alliances with movie exhibitors. It will also provide theatre owners access to Ticketmaster's extensive marketing and distribution systems, and will open up more opportunities for the growing stadium, arena and amusement park market. Pacer/CATS sees the new relationship as a major step in the continuing growth of both companies. The financially troubled Wembley had hoped to sell the entire Pacer/CATS company for \$30 million to help meet an end-of-March debt repayment deadline. Ticketmaster reportedly will pay Wembley \$16.4 million for its 50 percent.

Hartford Shed Clears State Hurdles

Plans and financing for a new Hartford amphitheatre were given final approval by the Connecticut Development Authority on March 9th despite a lawsuit filed by a nearby theatre to stop the project. However, the length of the approval process may push the venue's opening date back, said Jim Koplik of Metropolitan Entertainment, which is developing the project with the Nederlander Organization. "Our summer opening is definitely in jeopardy," Koplik said. "It will open in 1994, it's just a question of when at this point." The final hurdle was the approval of \$8.6 million in state bonds to be repaid by the developers. The state approved two additional bond packages totaling nearly \$30 million, which will be repaid with new admission and sales tax revenue, earlier this year. The new 30,000-capacity Connecticut Centre For The Performing Arts does have critics. The owners of the 3,178-seat Oakdale Theatre in Wallingford have sued the development authority, arguing that it took illegal votes because the package was approved before an environmental impact study was completed. The new venue will be convertible into a 7,500-seat indoor facility for more intimate shows. Oakdale is against the project, claiming that it would knock them out of business.

Don't Shoot My Wife, Please

Tammy Wynette's husband and manager, George Richey, was accused of assaulting a cameraman at The Alabama Theater in Myrtle Beach, S.C. February 26th. Chris Collins of WCSC-TV in Charleston told police that Richey grabbed and shoved him because Richey was angry about the video coverage of his wife. Collins said he had been given the okay by the road crew and Richey to shoot Wynette's first two songs. But Collins said once he started videotaping the crowd, Richey became angry and pushed him into the theatre lobby, and they began scuffling. Theatre president Bob Wood said, "Both were at fault, really. There were no punches thrown, but he [Richey] may have shoved the guy against the wall." Collins signed a warrant for Richey's arrest March 1st and a court date of March 23rd has been set.

Ticketmaster Broadens Its Global Reach

Ticketmaster has agreed to acquire a 50 percent interest in the Pacer/CATS software and ticketing company owned by the U.K.-based Wembley PLC. TM will act as managing partner in the new joint venture. Pacer/CATS has systems installed in over 4,000 venues worldwide. The agreement will broaden the reach

champagne. Cobain, who was in the midst of Nirvana's European tour, had canceled several shows following the group's March 2nd show in Munich to fly to Rome where he planned to rest with his wife Courtney Love and their daughter. A spokesperson for Nirvana said the tranquilizers had been prescribed because Cobain was suffering from severe influenza and fatigue. Cobain survived the incident, and was released from the hospital March 8th, only four days after he had been admitted. Cobain is reportedly not going to suffer any permanent damage due to the overdose and the coma. Doctors have ordered Cobain to rest, as the balance of Nirvana's European dates remain in a state of flux. Rescheduling can be expected, but at press time it was unclear how much of the tour will be rerouted. The band had been scheduled to tour Europe through April 6th.

Yeah, But Can He Shoot A Basketball?

The Killer Comes Home

Jerry Lee Lewis wants to play a live show in Memphis and possibly tour around the country to help pay his debts to the Internal Revenue Service, according to his lawyer. Lewis, who had been in an IRS-inspired exile in Ireland until last week, owes more than \$3 million in back taxes, interest and penalties, according to court records. His troubles with the IRS date back to the 70s, and in 1984 he was acquitted of criminal tax evasion charges. However, the IRS says he still owes the money. He filed for bankruptcy protection in 1988 but a court refused to absolve him of his tax debts. Rob Kahane, of Kahane-Shimmel Mgmt., said Lewis has just signed a contract with his company and they are planning on bringing him back in "a big way."

No Juno Nomination For Bryan Adams

Bryan Adams wasn't nominated for a Juno award and the Canadian Academy of Recording Arts & Sciences wants to make it clear that it wasn't their fault he was left off the ballot. CARAS president David Charles, in an interview on CFOX-FM, revealed that Adams wasn't nominated because A&M Records simply forgot to file the required nomination papers before the deadline. But Joe Summers, president of A&M in Canada, said he is "dismayed, distressed and embarrassed that the criteria for nominating the single of the year would penalize a bona fide contender and a legitimate number one record." Summers admits that he overlooked the news that CARAS was changing its nominating process from 100 percent sales based to 100 percent

radio chart activity with a November 30th deadline. But Summers said that he immediately informed CARAS of the oversight when the list of nominees came out. "As an ardent supporter of CARAS, and a two-time past director, I can appreciate the pressures and politics that pertain to the nomination process, but I have always felt that common sense and justice would prevail over man made rules," Summers said. He also said he believes the system is flawed and CARAS has abdicated its responsibility to insure that all contenders are given fair consideration. CARAS' prexy Charles said they tried to keep a low profile about A&M's oversight, but they were tired of taking all the blame for something that wasn't their fault.

Highly Illogical, Sir

The executive director of the International Association of Auditorium Managers, John Swinburn, and the immediate past president, Bob Mayer, testified February 24th about the inequities of copyright laws that hold facilities accountable for music copyright infringement. Swinburn, speaking on behalf of IAAM, said the doctrine of vicarious liability should be overturned and he proposed amendments to the Copyright Act of 1976. The proposed amendments would exempt public assembly facilities from being responsible for music licensing fees if the fees are not paid by the organizer of the event. Swinburn said the members of IAAM believe that the person or organization responsible for causing the music to be played should bear full responsibility for paying the appropriate music licensing fees associated with the event. Swinburn made it clear that the IAAM strongly believes

Crash Test Dummies

It is no accident that Canada's Crash Test Dummies are making a major mark on the American music scene with their sophomore Arista release, *God Shuffled His Feet*. The Winnipeg-based band is already a big success in Canada where their 1991 debut release, *The Ghosts That Haunt Me*, went triple platinum. But it sold only 200,000 copies in America — a respectable first outing, but far from the numbers needed to actually be considered a major act in the States. Lead singer and songwriter Brad Roberts told POLLSTAR that even though the first album's sales were decent, they were not stellar by American standards — not by any stretch of the imagination.

The difference in the way the two countries accepted the first release pegged Crash Test Dummies as mainstream in Canada, and alternative in America. "I think the reason we're considered a mainstream act in Canada is simply because we crossed over to top 40 and received extensive airplay on conservative formats at radio. I suppose it sounds a little bit cynical but...I think the alternative-mainstream distinction is founded largely upon number of units sold, and I don't think that's necessarily an intelligent way of talking about music." Nonetheless, Roberts believes that because of the money-making ability of "alternative" acts, MTV, radio and record companies have become more flexible in their attitudes. And he sees that changing climate as the reason his music is now vastly more marketable in America.

Roberts, a college graduate with a double major in English literature and philosophy, said he prefers to call his music left-of-mainstream, because the word "alternative" has lost its meaning. "There are bands that achieve mainstream success that break new ground musically, and others that simply plug into tried and true methods of writing and appeal to an audience of perhaps less discriminating palate. The brand mainstream will probably be attached to us if we sell a whole shitload of records."

And it looks as if Crash Test Dummies will do just that. They are in the midst of an American club tour, which is selling out at virtually every stop. "We've had sold out shows in the States in the past, but we've never done an entire tour where we sell out everywhere we go, so that's kind of a first," Roberts said. The video for the first single, "Mmm, Mmm, Mmm, Mmm," has been added to MTV's Buzz Bin, and the record is rapidly climbing the sales charts with both the single and album on the verge of moving into the Top 20. Put those ingredients in the mix and the "mainstream" tag can't be far behind. But Roberts isn't letting these early numbers go to his head. "I think it's always foolish and cocky to assume too much at this point, because it is a very convoluted business that can come to rather abrupt twists and turns quite rapidly."

Roberts knows those twists and turns well. Crash Test Dummies began as a recreational cover band, performing on the weekends while Roberts was in college. His life was perfectly mapped out with plans to finish college and proceed to graduate school in his ultimate quest for a position as a university professor. But those plans took a drastic turn when he finished his undergraduate degree and recorded a demo of his original songs just to see how they would sound. The band had never played outside of Winnipeg, so Roberts sent his demo tape to the producer of a Canadian music

festival, attempting to land a slot on the bill. The band didn't get the gig, but the person who heard the tape liked it and passed it on to some A&R people in Canada. Without forewarning, a bidding war broke out. "I had no clue that there would be this kind of a response to the demo, nor had I intentionally solicited major labels' attention with the demo. It was kind of a case of serendipity. So I got a lawyer, and ended up striking a deal with BMG, and getting sucked into the whole music business vortex, and never finishing up my graduate studies."

That twist of fate resulted in the quirky pairing of a rather senseless name with a quite sensible band. "When we first began... the material that we were playing was an eclectic grab bag of rather silly cover tunes. We played everything from cheesy old Irish traditionals to funny versions of old Alice Cooper hits with acoustic guitars, to TV theme songs. And at that early juncture we decided to call ourselves Crash Test Dummies as a joke; it actually fit what we were doing, in that it was really all quite nonsensical. By the time we had a record deal, there had been so much print generated about us that we couldn't really escape the name even had we wanted to. I don't know whether or not I would have called us [that] had I intended to write material and do this as a profession. But it seemed to not make any sense to abandon the name because we'd become so obviously attached to it. [Now] five years later I'm writing original material which has very little to do with those early eclectic rather recreational days, and the name is still with us."

Crash Test Dummies have a full year of touring ahead, but Roberts said that could change at any second. "Tours are organic things that tend to grow or die according to how well the record is doing. We came down [to tour in] America because frankly America was really happening in a way Canada wasn't." (Yet, the record has gone platinum in Canada.) Arista has had vastly more success with the new record in the U.S., so the band has been working hard to take advantage of the momentum. Once the band finishes covering the U.S., it will return to Canada for a thorough tour. However, they are touring Europe in April, and in May and June they are booked to open for Elvis Costello & The Attractions in major markets across North America.

Steve Martin of The Agency Group in New York handles the U.S. agency responsibilities for the band, and in Canada it is the S.L. Feldman & Associates. Their management affairs are handled by Jeff Rogers at Swell Management.

that authors and composers should be fairly compensated for their efforts, but said that venues should not be held liable for the illegal actions of facility users. He also said the IAAM is aware of the arguments made by music-licensing organizations, that the transient nature of facility users makes it difficult to determine if appropriate fees have been paid. "While we appreciate that the tracking of facility users may be difficult, we believe that difficulty does not justify placing facilities in the position of absorbing liability," Swinburn testified. He also said that facilities are just renting space and they are not responsible for everything that goes on inside that space. As an example, Swinburn asked if it was logical to hold a landlord responsible if a tenant illegally duplicates music from a CD to a cassette while residing in the landlord's apartment. Swinburn sees that situation as illogical as the one facility managers face in regards to copyright fees. The government committee will be hearing other testimony, but no date has been set for action.

Sinatra Collapses Onstage

Frank Sinatra was rushed by ambulance to a Virginia hospital after collapsing during an encore at his March 6th performance, but walked out less than three hours later. Sinatra was singing "My Way" at the Richmond Mosque when he stopped and asked his son and bandleader, Frank Jr., for a chair. Sinatra, 78, then collapsed face down on the stage, witnesses said. Sinatra had complained "it's hot in here" several times during the sold-out show. The crowd of nearly 3,700 gave him a standing ovation when he blew the crowd a kiss as he was taken off the stage in a wheelchair. He walked out of the hospital the same night. "He decided he wanted to leave and he left," a hospital spokesperson said. Sinatra returned home to California the next day, and was reportedly feeling fine. He plans to stay at home until the end of the month, but shouldn't miss any other dates.

Rachael Pine has joined Artists & Audience as assistant to Barry Weisblatt. Pine, who was formerly an assistant at William Morris in New York, will also be booking club and colleges..... Pace Entertainment Corp. has formally opened an office in Los Angeles. Hal Lazareff heads the new office, part of the Sony/Pace/Blockbuster partnership, which is located in the Sony Music building in Santa Monica. Lazareff, who worked as a talent buyer with Nederlander and as an agent with ICM and CAA, will

be assisted by Tim Cannon..... **Sims Hinds** has returned to SMG as senior VP of sales and development. Hinds had been VP of sales at SMG prior to leaving the company in October 1993 to join D.L. Phillips Co..... **Eric Landsman**, formerly of Metropolitan Entertainment, has joined Swing Street Legend Entertainment where he will book national talent into New Jersey clubs and theatres including the Stone Pony..... **John Oldfield** was named assistant GM for the new Polaris Amphitheater outside Columbus, Ohio. Oldfield was previously director of finance for Sony/Pace at the Star Lake Amphitheatre..... **John Croley** has been named deputy director at the Tacoma Dome. He was formerly with the Seagate Center in Toledo.

Police Blotter

Grace Slick was arrested after a bizarre incident in which she allegedly pointed a shotgun at police officers outside her Tiburon, Calif., home before dawn on March 5th. Police went to Slick's home after receiving a call from a man who said a woman was firing a shotgun in the house. When police arrived, Ira Lee came to the door yelling, "Kill me," police said. Police subdued Lee, but then Slick allegedly came to the door carrying a shotgun. Slick pointed the gun at the officers and ordered them off her property, according to police reports. Officers ordered Slick to drop the gun, but she refused, police said. An officer took the gun away after diverting her attention. Police later found the shotgun was empty, but reportedly found spent shells in the yard. Slick was arrested on suspicion of felony assault and felony brandishing of a weapon at a police officer. She was released from jail after posting \$7,000 bail. Lee was held for psychiatric evaluation. Slick recently moved to Tiburon after her Mill Valley home was destroyed by fire. She and her husband are suing Marin County because firefighters took some of her belongings, including a shotgun and backstage passes, from the rubble..... A backup singer for Ice Cube who is also a member of **Da Lench Mob** was arrested in connection with a fatal shooting at a bowling alley in Los Angeles. Terry Gray, 24, was caught March 8th and is being held without bail. Deputies found a variety of handguns at his home and forensic investigators were trying to determine if one of them was used in the shooting, according to sheriff's deputy Larry Mead. One person was killed and another

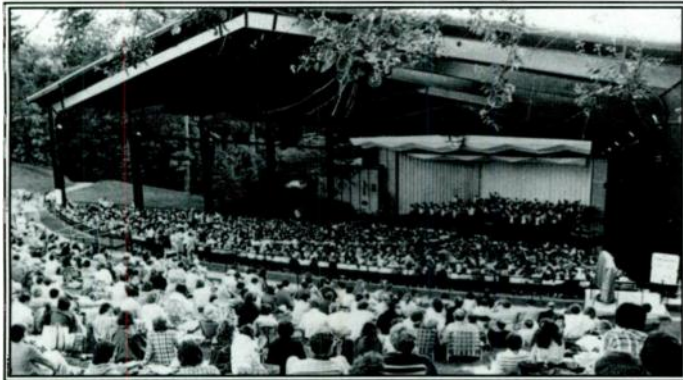

wounded in the February 18th shooting. Gray, who goes by the stage name T-Bone, is the second member of Da Lench Mob to be arrested on suspicion of murder since last summer..... As part of a Drug Awareness Resistance Education program, 173 people were arrested outside a **Grateful Dead** concert at the Desert Sky Pavilion in Phoenix, March 4-6. Most of the arrests were for possession of marijuana, according to a police spokesperson. Flyers were handed out at the entrance to the concert, warning fans that 50 undercover officers were patrolling the parking lot..... Motley Crue drummer **Tommy Lee** pleaded no contest March 3rd to charges he tried to carry a loaded gun aboard an airplane, and was sentenced to one year's probation. Lee was also fined \$540 for the incident, which occurred last November at L.A. Int'l Airport when security guards spotted the gun in Lee's carry-on luggage.

Branson Offers A Blue Velvet Apology

Branson, Missouri's city administrator sent a written apology to Bobby Vinton for including the Blue Velvet Theatre on a list of "illegal" buildings released to reporters in February. The official said Vinton's building was included on the list because of "minor items" like changes in landscaping and a parking lot, and not because of structural problems. The city's head building inspector and his staff had randomly checked 17 buildings constructed since 1992 and told a newspaper that "not one of them was legal." Meanwhile, forgotten boxes of building inspection paperwork were found in a Branson City Hall closet recently. Governor Mel Carnahan said he doubted the misplaced boxes would answer all the questions raised about how the town's booming development has been handled. Town officials say it will take several weeks to go through the inspection slips to determine if they could resolve any of the safety questions.

Legal Grievs

A lawsuit filed March 7th by Axl Rose's ex-wife charges he punched, slapped, shoved, kicked, tied, gagged, spit on her and dragged her by the hair over the course of their four-year relationship, which ended with the annulment of their less than year-old marriage in 1991. **Erin Everly's** suit claims that after one beating, she passed out and woke up in a hospital to learn she had been injected with heroin and cocaine and gone into cardiac arrest. She also charges that the Guns N' Roses lead

singer forced her to have sex with him several times and claimed he was "in touch with the spirit of extraterrestrial beings." The suit also notes that Axl owns Uzis and once had a friend break into Everly's house and "steal pictures of her dog who died, because Rose claimed he needed the pictures to 'transfer' the dead dogs' souls to living souls." Everly said she waited more than three years after the break-up to file the suit because she feared for her safety. Saying they haven't seen the suit yet, Axl's camp had no comment..... The French electronics conglomerate that holds the U.S. patents on the basic design of **compact discs** has sued five recording companies for alleged violations of the patents. **Thomson S.A.** filed the suit February 25th and named as defendants Time Warner, Bertelsmann., Thorn EMI, Quixote Corp., and Nippon Columbia and their subsidiaries. The suit claims the companies had licensed the technology in other countries but "refused to respect" the U.S. patents. A Thomson engineer was granted four U.S. patents beginning in 1989 for the arrangement of information on an optical disc, such as a CD. Thomson is pursuing an order to stop the infringement, and is also seeking a tripling of damages, although no monetary amount was specified..... All five original members of the '60s rock group **Moby Grape** filed a lawsuit against CBS Records and its successor Sony Music, and their former manager, *Entertainment Weekly* reported. In the suit, which was filed in January, the band members claim that the rights to their songs and the name "Moby Grape" were signed away in a 1973 settlement agreement without the band's knowledge. Attorney for the band, Glendon Miskel, said two members of the band, Skip Spence and Robert Mosley, were "acutely disabled" and weren't competent to sign any agreement. Spence and Mosley were both diagnosed as schizophrenic and Mosley is homeless in San Diego, while Spence lives in a residential care facility in Northern California. Under the 20-year-old deal, members of Moby Grape will not receive any royalties from the 1993 Sony release, *The Very Best of Moby Grape*. Miskel said the band is not seeking specific damages, they are just asking that the original agreement be set aside..... A 24-year-old man who contends he is the son of **Jimi Hendrix** filed a lawsuit March 8th in L.A. seeking a share of the late performer's estate. James Henrik Daniel Sundquist said he is the offspring of a 1969 union between Hendrix and Eva Sundquist that occurred while Jimi was on tour in Stockholm.

And in 1975, despite objections from Hendrix' father, a Swedish court upheld his claim. In the suit, Sundquist alleges that his grandfather, Jimi's dad Al Hendrix, and the elder Hendrix' lawyers concealed his right to a share of the estate. Sundquist is asking the court to rule that he is entitled to the estate, an accounting of profits from Hendrix' music since his death, and unspecified compensatory and punitive damages on allegations of fraud and concealment. The elder Hendrix is also in the middle of a lawsuit in which he claims an attorney persuaded him to sign away the rights to his son's work in 1974 for \$50,000 a year. Hendrix' longtime attorney Leo Branton is named in both suits, and Hendrix' estate executors and the companies believed to hold the rights to his music were named in Sundquist's suit. And across the water in England, the effort to start a new inquest into the death of Jimi Hendrix was turned down by the British government March 8th. An application for a new inquest was made last year, but after a police investigation, the attorney general declared that the case doesn't warrant a new look.

Supreme Court Sides With 2 Live Crew

Parody was given explicit protection by the Supreme Court when justices unanimously ruled that 2 Live Crew's take on a Roy Orbison classic could fall under the "fair use" provision of the Copyright Law of 1976. The fair use exception allows portions of copyrighted works to be used for "criticism, comment, news reporting, teaching, scholarship or research." The decision was hailed as a victory by free speech advocates and viewed with shock by some copyright owners. 2 Live Crew was sued by Acuff-Rose Music, which holds the copyright to the song "Oh, Pretty Woman," after the band included a parody of the song on a 1989 album. 2 Live Crew's version opens — like the original — with the line "pretty woman, walking down the street." The song then departs from the original, with the lyrics switching to "big hairy woman," among other things. After a lower court ruled in favor of 2 Live Crew, a federal appeals court reversed the decision, finding that the band had a "blatant commercial purpose" in recording the parody. But the Supreme Court's March 7th decision returned the case to the lower courts, which will decide whether the copyright was breached using newly-forged guidelines which tilt things in favor of parodists. The opinion by Justice David Souter says that judges should avoid rigid rules that would stifle creativity when hearing copyright cases. The court's decision says a parody should convey a new expression, meaning or message through the copyrighted material


to have protection. The decision recognizes that a portion of the original material must be used to make the object of the parody recognizable, but says that whether too much of the original was used must be weighed on a case-by-case basis. The final factor is how the parody might affect the market for the song. The court's decision commented that "we might not assign a high rank" to the element of parody in 2 Live Crew's version of the song, but that the court accepted the group's assertion that parody was the intention. EMI Music Publishing chairman Martin Bandier told the *L.A. Times* he was "astonished" by the decision. "This ruling strips musical authors, composers and songwriters of valuable property rights, elevating free speech to an absurd level," he said. Warner/Chappel chairman Les Bider also expressed his dismay with the decision. The court's ruling means copyright owners can no longer attempt to stop a legitimate parody, although they still might collect royalties if too much of their tune is used. The court had received friend-of-the-court briefs from *Mad* magazine, *Harvard Lampoon* and Mark Russell on 2 Live Crew's behalf. On Acuff-Rose's side were the Songwriters Guild, the estates of many composers, including Leonard Bernstein and George & Ira Gershwin, and Michael Jackson.

Campus Concert Venues

The Dean Smith Center at the Univ. of North Carolina at Chapel Hill faces a \$2 million deficit and is considering increasing everything from student fees to the price of sporting events tickets to help it get out of the red. The facility has lost money every year since it opened in 1986, except for the 1987-88 year, in which a string of concerts turned a profit for the facility. There are several reasons the venue is in financial trouble, including the opening of Walnut Creek Amphitheatre in Raleigh and the expansion of the Greensboro Coliseum. And in 1993, the Smith Center lost about \$250,000 in revenue when school administrators rejected two Grateful Dead concerts and local politicians refused to grant a pyro permit for a Janet Jackson show. However, at other universities concerts are taking precedence over sporting events. For the third time in four years, NCAA women's basketball tournament teams will have to forsake home games because their schools booked entertainment events. This year, No. 22-ranked Florida won't get to play at home because of a March 16th Rod Stewart concert.
