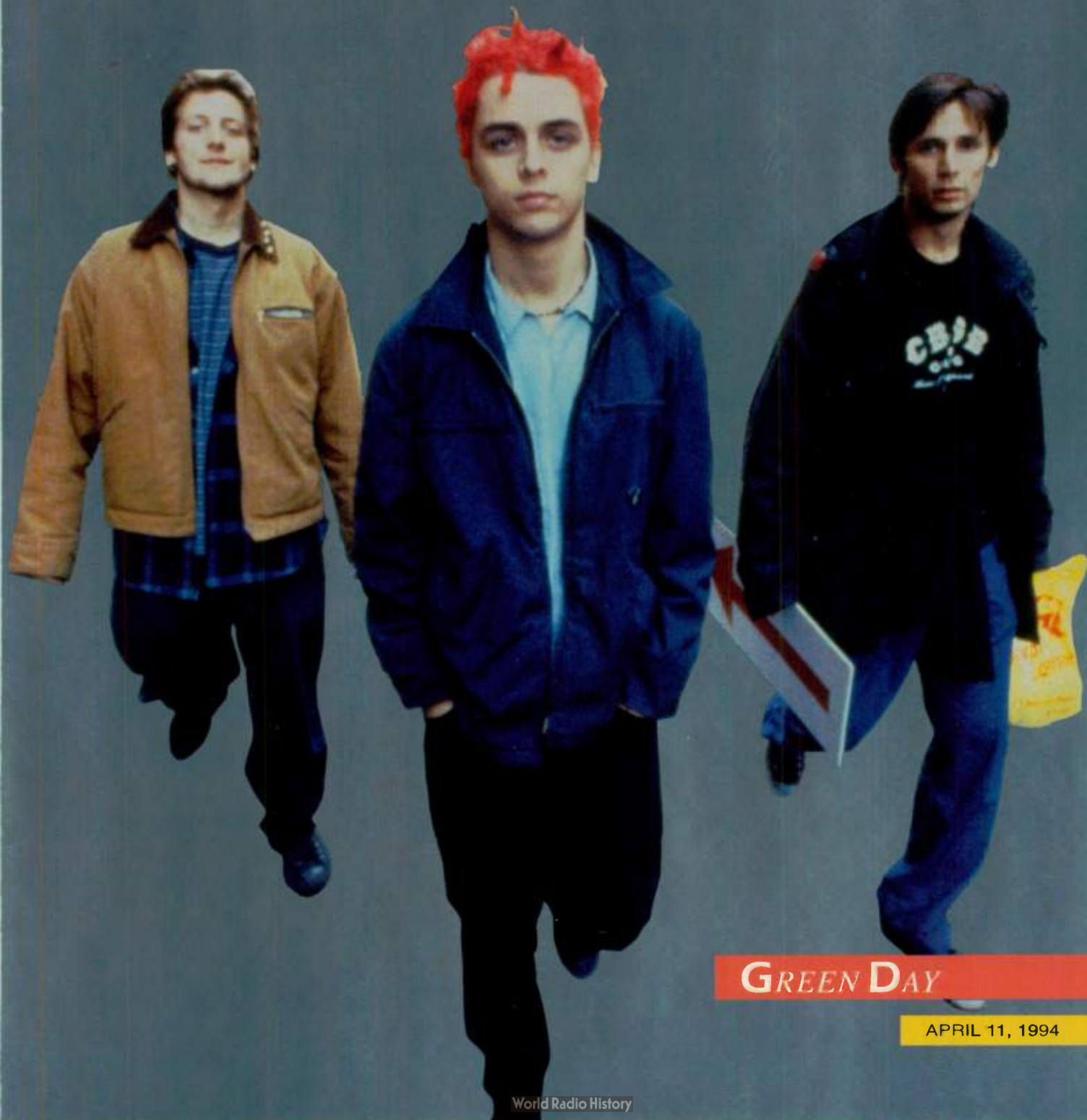

Nirvana... Going, Going, Gone?

There are strong indications that Nirvana has, for this week anyway, broken up. The group has canceled the European tour dates it had rescheduled after Kurt Cobain's near fatal drug overdose in Rome, and has been formally dropped from consideration as the headliner for the Lollapalooza tour. Lollapalooza organizer Ted Gardner issued the following statement: "Although we had been negotiating with Nirvana to headline 'Lollapalooza '94,' due to the ill health of Kurt Cobain we cannot confirm them on the bill. We wish Kurt a full and speedy recover and look forward to the possibility of working with Nirvana in the future." Doctors have reportedly suggested that Cobain stay at home and rest, and that is the official reason given for the cancellation of the European dates. According to other sources, however, alleged tensions between Cobain and fellow bandmates Dave Grohl and Krist Novoselic concerning Cobain's health have fueled reports that the band has broken up. Nirvana has been described as a band almost constantly on the verge of self-destructing, and people familiar with the group claim that the current situation should be taken no more seriously than the last "... 43,000 times" they have broken up.

Lollapalooza '94 Confirms Line-Up

Once the angst of uncertainty concerning Nirvana's possible involvement in doing the tour was over, Lollapalooza organizers formally announced the tour line-up on April 6th. Smashing Pumpkins, a hot but hardly proven headliner, will top the bill for this fourth edition, which may have to rely heavily on the buzz from previous years to sell tickets. Following criticism of last year's tour, the non-musical elements are being made less costly and the merchandising less tacky. The initial announcement even touted the fact that there will be "free drinking water" at this year's shows. The other main stage acts are the Beastie Boys, George Clinton & The P-Funk Allstars, The Breeders, A Tribe Called Quest, Nick Cave & The Bad Seeds, L7, and the Boredoms. A list of 30 cities was announced but no specific dates or venues were given, other than the fact that the tour will kick off July 1st in Vancouver.

Musical Chairs For Syracuse Sinatra Fans

At Frank Sinatra's request, the seating configuration for his April 16th performance at the Onondaga County War Memorial in

Syracuse, N.Y., was changed from in-the-round to an end-stage configuration after about 6,000 tickets had already been sold. All the previously-sold tickets must now be exchanged or refunded, which doesn't make happy campers out of fans who waited in line for hours to buy them when they went on sale March 14th. "Musically, Mr. Sinatra prefers having the band behind him," said Sinatra spokesperson Susan Reynolds. The change forced ticket holders to return to the point of purchase to exchange their tickets on a first-come, first-served basis.

They're only around 21 years old, but the three members of Green Day are already seasoned road warriors. Just a day after bassist Mike Dirnt graduated from high school, the raw, melodic punk group was off on its first tour, looking for adventure. "We'd just play wherever we could," vocalist/guitarist Billie Joe says. "The funnest times you'll ever have is the worst possible predicament you could be in. We went out and it was like, 'Okay, we're gonna lose money, our van's going to break down, we're not gonna have food, shows are going to cancel. But that's gonna be our fun.' It's making the best out of the worst possible situation."

Though Green Day has since traded in its touring van for a more-spacious bookmobile and inked a major label deal with Reprise, the band still holds the same attitude on the road. "I swear to God, you couldn't put three more irresponsible people together," Joe says. "We'll have a lot of fun, and hopefully in a couple of years we'll have a helluva story to tell."

Green Day's story-to-date began in Rodeo, a community on the eastern edge of the San Francisco Bay. It was there that Joe and Dirnt starting playing together at the age of 11. Joe still plays the same blue Stratocaster guitar that he strummed back then. "I kind of lucked out with my guitar," Joe says. "It's got a good, strong pickup on it." After playing countless parties and club gigs, the band started to pester Lawrence Livermore, who runs the tiny Berkeley-based indie label Lookout!, about a record deal. Livermore eventually agreed to give the band a listen, as long as they drove up to Mendocino County for an audition. The band arrived to find the owner of the shack they were to perform in had disappeared. So they broke into the building and set up, only to find there was no electricity. And not much of a roof, which became clear when the rain started to fall. The show went on anyway. Livermore located a generator, the band auditioned in the downpour, and Livermore signed them on the spot.

The band recorded two successful albums for Lookout! (drummer Tre Cool joined the band for the second album) and embarked on five ragtag American tours and two European tours before the major labels came knocking. "We'd been talking to other labels at the time, and then [Warner Bros. A&R rep] Rob Cavallo came and hung out with us for awhile and we played in our basement for him," Joe says. "And then the next day [senior A&R VP] Michael Ostin came out, which was really weird.... But I thought it was really cool that, like, the head of A&R and Rob coming down into our basement to come watch us practice. Talk about a personal level. This was like, drink a beer and watch us jam, which I thought was pretty admirable."

Joe said that signing to a major label cost Green Day some of their more hardcore punk fans. "Sometimes when a band gets really famous, or something that was underground that you were really into [enters the mainstream], it's kind of like losing a friend in a lot of ways," Joe says. "From that aspect, it's a little bit sad." Though he says Green Day has stayed true to its musical roots and still has complete creative control, he understands why some old fans have left. "I think it's that people just don't want to see a band that was playing kitchens at one time tied to a huge corporation," he said. "I can kind of see what they mean, but I just want to play music

from all aspects of it. This is just another way of doing it." Right now, Joe says he feels caught between two scenes. "It's weird because we don't totally fit into the underground punk scene, but we don't totally fit into the mainstream. So it's like, where the fuck do we fit in?"

Warner Bros.' deep pockets did allow Green Day more time in the studio when it came to recording their new album, *Dookie*. "*Kerplunk!* [the band's second album] was completely different," Joe says. "*Kerplunk!* was recorded in four or five days, and this was recorded in five weeks. Rob Cavallo co-produced, and he knew all the buttons to push and stuff. It worked out the way we wanted it to."

The band is experiencing a bit of culture shock with its new ties to a media conglomerate. "It's kind of weird to be negotiating about music in the first place," Joe says. "But other than that, we've been able to do what we want, and everyone's been happy. We put out the record that we wanted to put out."

Joe says it's also strange to turn on the television set and find Green Day on the screen. One of the band's first TV performances, on "Late Night With Conan O'Brien," caused very different reactions from different band members when they saw it on tape. "Mike got completely pissed off. He thought it sucked, and he started throwing lamps and beer bottles and stuff. And Tre is pretty oblivious to everything, he never gives a fuck. And I was like, 'It wasn't bad,' and I was pretty happy about it. So it was like, all these things going on in the room and all of these people kind of like being really quiet for awhile because Mike was breaking things. I think it was just the initial shock to actually see yourself on TV. It's like listening to your voice recorded for the first time or something."

Green Day recently wrapped up a nearly sold-out North American club tour and has now moved on to Europe. In the meantime, MTV has placed the video for *Dookie's* first single, "Longview," into the coveted Buzz Bin. How's Joe reacting to this seemingly-impending stardom? "I don't know, I live in a bookmobile," he says, laughing. "I don't know what the hell goes on outside of that."

Green Day is booked by Andy Somers at ICM and managed by Elliot Cahn at Cahn-Man.

eliminate this basic supply and demand problem, Streisand opted to take a novel approach. For those fans who just have to have tickets to her shows and who don't mind paying the price of a used car to get them, Streisand has made arrangements to "scalp" them tickets herself. Actually, Babs has identified twenty charities and given them access to nearly 10,000 choice seats, which they are selling at \$1,000 per ticket. The charities get to then keep \$650 on what otherwise would have been a \$350 ticket. These charities include five organizations that deal with the AIDS crisis as well as groups addressing children's rights, women's rights and health issues, environmental matters, poverty concerns, the homeless, constitutional liberties, inner city education and earthquake relief. All told, Streisand will raise \$6.3 million for charity during her five city U.S. tour. If you add in the charitable money from her London dates and what was donated from her Las Vegas run, she will have generated \$12.8 million for charity from her concert appearances. Speaking of scalpers.... er, we mean ticket brokers, scalping is illegal in Michigan and is punishable by 90 days in jail and a \$500 fine. Brokers get around the law there by selling someone a pen for hundreds of dollars and then throwing in a ticket. Another scheme is to get buyers to join a "ticket club" and sign a paper that states they're paying box office price for the tickets and paying extra for "special services." It's been reported that the price of pens in the vicinity of the Palace of Auburn Hills has now risen to \$1500.

Short Items Of Note

The Glen Helen Blockbuster Pavilion in southern California has been allowed to more than double its capacity for the 1994 season. The shed opened for its debut season last year with only a 16,800 capacity, but with several recent road and highway improvements, the new limit has been upped to 35,000. Other road improvements are planned, and eventually the County of San Bernardino is expected to allow the venue to increase its capacity to a stadium-sized 65,000..... The Fillmore in San Francisco went on sale with its opening line-up of shows last weekend. Among the acts booked by BGP during the first month at the legendary venue are Primus, Huey Lewis, Blues Traveler,

NRBQ, Counting Crows, Gin Blossoms, X, Queen Latifah, Chris Isaak, and Brian Setzer. The surprise act for the grand opening on April 27th, however, hasn't been announced. We could be Dead wrong about our guess on who that might be.... Pink Floyd launched their tour amidst a steady rain March 30th at Joe Robbie Stadium in Miami. It now looks like the tour will be at least the second biggest North American tour of all time, easily passing the \$74.1 million posted by the New Kids On The Block in 1990, but probably falling short of the record \$98 million done by the Rolling Stones in 1989..... Two new books claim Rolling Stones guitarist Brian Jones' death in 1969 was murder, and not an accidental drowning. The books — "Paint It Black: The Murder of Brian Jones" by Geoffrey Giuliano and "Who Killed Christopher Robin?" by Terry Rawlings — claim London builder Frank Thorogood, who died last November, held Jones' head underwater until he drowned while the two were swimming. Supposedly, Thorogood made the confession on his death-bed. At the time of Jones' death, a coroner ruled that Jones drowned in the pool at his estate while under the influence of alcohol and drugs. Police are considering reopening the case.... Steven Greil has been named president and CEO of the Tennessee Performing Arts Center, effective May 1st. He has served as executive director of the Nashville Symphony Association for the last five years. He began his career with Sound Seventy as a production manager and later founded his own management company, GreilWorks.

Melee Erupts Outside Dead Show

A crowd throwing rocks and bottles was pelted with pepper gas grenades when they tried to storm a Grateful Dead concert at the Orlando Arena on April 4th. No arrests or serious injuries were reported. The disturbance began while the concert was already underway. "What happened was that somewhere between three and four hundred kids — of whom I would estimate half were Deadheads and half were just local kids attracted by a party — fueled by way too much beer, decided they were going to get in to the show by hook or crook," Dead publicist Dennis McNally said. "Among other things they threw some bottles...it's clearly behavior we don't condone." Tear gas was initially used by police to try to move the crowd back. No problems were

A Dead show in Orlando was cancelled the previous day after an unnamed band member had to fly home to visit his critically ill father. McNally said the canceled date will not be made up because of conflicts between the facility's schedule and the band's schedule. Tickets for that show are being refunded.

Producers Sue The Jacksons Over "Honors"

Smith-Hemion Productions, producer of the financially disastrous "Jackson Family Honors" charity TV show, has filed a lawsuit against the Jackson family accusing them of fraud. The producers claim they're owed more than \$2 million. Specifically, the suit says the Jacksons failed to pay Smith-Hemion \$2 million, that the family spent \$69,000 for limos, wardrobe and other amenities for the show, and that Michael Jackson failed to pay \$110,000 for show tickets. A spokesman for the family said the show originally had more than \$4 million in sponsorships, but when MJ's sex scandal broke, sponsors bolted. The Jackson camp claims the show brought in \$4 million, but the cast, crew and producer are owed \$2 million and other debts are still being counted. The *L.A. Times* reported that the show will end up at least \$1.7 million in the red. "It is our intention that all creditors will eventually be fully paid," executive producer Jermaine Jackson said. Producer Gary Smith said: "I'm angry and I'm embarrassed. The most frustrating part is how arrogant they act about it. In fact, Jermaine Jackson has never even called me since the show." The show raised \$100,000 for charity after organizers predicted they would donate \$6 million. The suit was filed on March 31st in L.A. Superior Court. Ticketmaster-Las Vegas and the MGM Grand were also named as defendants in the case because they apparently are holding ticket money in anticipation of refund requests from customers who paid full price for tickets which were later deeply discounted. Meanwhile, a Trenton, N.J., porcelain sculptor says the Jackson family owes him more than \$10,000 for two diamond-studded trophies given to Elizabeth Taylor and Berry Gordy during the "Honors" telecast. Richard Vassil of Boehm Studio said that if the

Jackson's don't pay up, he may take legal action. Jermaine accused Boehm of taking advantage of the family's problems by bringing the matter to the attention of the media. He said the Jacksons paid half of what is owed, and will pay the rest after proceeds from the show are processed.

Gangsta Country?

Tracy Lawrence was arrested on April 4th on charges he fired a gun in the air to scare some teenagers during an altercation. Police in Lebanon, Tenn., said one of three teens traveling in a car on Interstate 40 allegedly "shot the bird" at Lawrence and his brother Stewart as they passed their car. Police said the brothers followed the car to one of the teen's home, where Tracy Lawrence allegedly fired a .357 magnum in the air after a fight broke out. Lawrence was charged with aggravated assault and possessing a prohibited weapon. He also faces one count of impersonating a government officer for allegedly carrying a fake ID which identified him as a captain in the Stantonville, Tenn., police department. There is no Stantonville PD. Police said Lawrence never identified himself as a police officer. He was freed on \$5,500 bail. His brother was charged with possessing

"Based on past experiences, the incident was a very stressful situation and I fully admit I overreacted and didn't handle myself in a proper manner," Lawrence said. Lawrence was shot four times when he walked into the middle of an armed robbery attempt in 1991.

Sony Restructures Newly-Acquired Relativity

Sony Music announced a restructuring of Relativity Records and Relativity Entertainment Distribution so that the two freshly-acquired organizations will operate independently. R.E.D. will retain its autonomy as an independent distributor under president Sal Licata. Relativity Records becomes a TriStar Music Group label, alongside TriStar Music. TriStar Music Group president Bob Buziak will oversee both of the R.E.D.-distributed labels. Both Licata and Buziak will report to Sony Music senior VP Ron Urban on a day-to-day basis, while Sony Music executive VP Michele Anthony will continue to provide strategic direction for both operations. Relativity Records executive VP/GM Harry Palmer will oversee operations of the label, reporting to Buziak. Howard Gabriel, who previously was TriStar Music's VP of sales and marketing, takes over day-to-day operations of TriStar Music as VP/GM for the label, also reporting to Buziak.

Judge Won't Throw Out Snoop's Murder Charge

Snoop Doggy Dogg and two other men must face trial for murder in the shooting death of a man last year, a judge ruled on April 4th. The rapper, whose real name is Calvin Broadus, and two other men have claimed the shooting was in self-defense. The judge's ruling said that "there was sufficient evidence presented to the Grand Jury to warrant their conclusion that there was probable cause that the defendants committed the crimes alleged in the indictment." Before making the ruling, the judge said that the defense had raised serious issues in their attempt to have the charges dismissed. The defense had argued that friends of victim Philip Woldemariam testified that he was carrying a gun when

he was shot, and that they helped to hide the weapon. One friend testified that Woldemariam reached for the gun before he was shot by Snoop's bodyguard. The D.A.'s office, however, contends that the defendants hunted down Woldemariam in a classic drive-by shooting. A pre-trial hearing was scheduled for April 15th. Snoop remains free on \$1 million bail.

Madonna's A Bleeping Nightmare For Letterman

CBS censors had to work overtime when Madonna spiced up her March 31st appearance on "The Late Show With David Letterman" with a total of 13 four-letter words, as well as a couple of other statements deemed not fit for network TV. The offending comments were bleeped from the broadcast. During her appearance at the show's taping, Madonna — who consistently has been a target in Letterman's monologues — smoked a cigar, handed Letterman a pair of panties and refused to leave the stage. In one exchange, Madonna asked Letterman why he was so obsessed with her sex life. Letterman replied, "I have none of my own." In one of the few non-sex related exchanges, Madonna pointed at Letterman's hair and asked, "Is that a rug?" Letterman pointed at Maddy's slicked back hair and said, "All right, what is that? A swimming cap?" The overnight ratings showed the Material Girl's appearance drew plenty of viewers, good taste or no. The show scored an 8.6 rating in the major markets, compared to typical ratings in the low- to mid-6 range. And critics castigated Maddy for her behavior the next day...but they did it in big type on page one of the entertainment sections of virtually every newspaper in the country. Hmmm.

Between The Dates

The upcoming summer tour for **MEAT LOAF** is making ticket vending history. For the first time ever, Ticketmaster simultaneously put 61 North American concert dates on sale. Each date went on sale April 9th at 9:00 a.m. local time. One other unusual (and controversial) aspect to this arena-level tour is the \$1 million national ad campaign being launched to support it. MCA Records is putting up half the money but, in another first, all the local promoters are being forced to put up the rest. And many of them aren't real happy about financing a national ad campaign which may or may not help them sell tickets to their shows. This will be one tour to keep a real close eye on. It's either a stroke of marketing genius or the Wilson Phillips of '94..... How would you like to have the beer concession for this tour? The new **LYNYRD SKYNYRD** itinerary includes special guest Ted Nugent and Ian Moore opening the show..... **LENNY KRAVITZ** has cancelled his upcoming US tour. Kravitz, who has toured for the last 18 months, reportedly has decided to head back into the studio to work on new material..... Arnold Stiefel, the manager for **MORRISSEY** has announced postponement of three sold-out concerts in Los Angeles and New York because the band was "not rehearsed to Morrissey's satisfaction." The April 8th show at Los Angeles' Olympic Auditorium has been postponed to September 30th, while April 11th & 12th Carnegie Hall dates have been rescheduled for September 19th and 20th. Five months should give them time to get it together..... Check the Route Book for the first few dates to be announced for the upcoming **WHITNEY HOUSTON** tour. Expect more shortly..... **NKOTB** (aka New Kids On The Block) will be one kid short when they come to your town. Jonathan Knight is on the sick list from a back injury that resulted when he was thrown while horseback riding..... If the concert biz was on the big board, certain choice artists' stocks would be going through the ceiling. Tickets for **THE EAGLES** two shows at the Shoreline Amphitheatre in the Bay Area sold out within minutes prompting the addition of three more shows. The same was true for the southern California shows at Irvine Meadows Amphitheatre where Avalon's Brian Murphy figures the group could have sold out two weeks worth of dates. And of course this frozen over hell nostalgia trip doesn't come cheap. For the group's Glen Helen Blockbuster Pavilion show for example, ticket prices ranged from \$35 for lawn seats up to \$115 for "gold circle" seats..... The Sacramento dates listed in the new **GRATEFUL DEAD** itinerary are benefits for the Rex Foundation, which is the band's personal charity. The foundation, named after road crew member Daniel Rex Jackson, who died in a car accident 20 years ago, acts as sort of a "clearing house" to provide funds for various Grateful Dead charitable interests. It was through the Rex Foundation that the band directed money towards help for the homeless, musical instruments for the San Francisco School District, and Open Hand which delivers food to AIDS victims. The foundation also helped finance the album "Elliot Carter - Violin Concerto" which won last year's Best Contemporary Composition (Classical) Grammy Award..... Opportunity rarely knocks twice, but it made an exception for **MINT CONDITION**. The act's highly coveted position as the opener for the **JANET JACKSON** tour was in jeopardy when JJ started cancelling March dates because of illness. However, those dates have been rescheduled for April and Mint Condition remains the opener..... You might remember Imago Recording artists The Sextants which broke up last year. Former members have formed a new band called the **THUNDER CHIEFS** and you'll find their first dates in this week's Route Book.

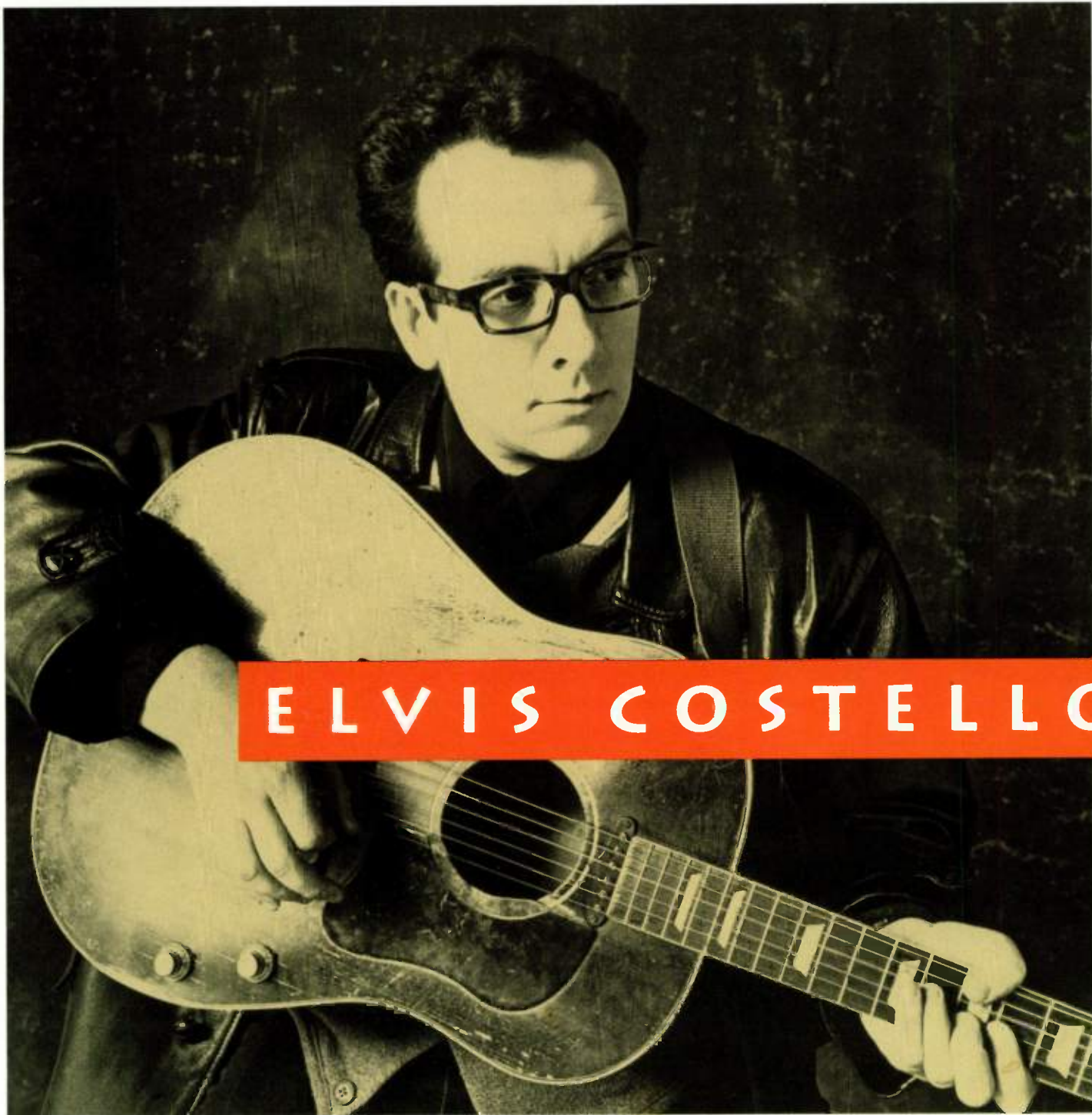
