Gospel Music Bombshell

Michael English quit his Christian singing career because of an extramarital affair just one week after he was named the Gospel Music Association's artist of the year. "I feel it is necessary to announce my withdrawal from the Christian music industry because of mistakes that I have recently made," English said in a statement released by his label, Warner Alliance. English reportedly was involved with another Christian singer, Marabeth Jordan of the group First Call, who is also married. Jordan and English had been on the road together on the Mercy Tour to raise money to build a home for unwed mothers. English returned his four Dove awards May 6th but GMA officials said May 9th that English won the awards fair and square and he can reclaim them whenever he wishes. A spokesperson for the GMA said there are no moral or character clauses tied to the Dove Awards but the association may consider changing the criteria for winners because of the scandal. Warner Alliance announced it would drop marketing, promotion and distribution of English's music because of the incident and First Call has replaced Jordan. English's songs have been pulled from some radio station playlists and retailers are keeping a close watch on the facts as they unfold. "In Christian music, listeners consider an artist to have a responsibility not only as a singer but also as a minister," said Mark DeYoung, station manager at WNAZ radio in Nashville. "When they do something like that, they're not practicing what they're preaching." DeYoung was one of the radio programmers that pulled English's records despite his status as one of the station's most popular artists.

The Rubber Check Syndrome

A promoter in New Mexico has been ordered to pay restitution and serve five years probation as a result of issuing worthless checks in relationship to a festival he promoted in 1993. Michael Andrew Byrd's Music Fest '93 was supposed to showcase local amateurs while using headliners to draw the crowds. The three-day festival, which was held at the Southern New Mexico Fairgrounds, was canceled on the second day because of poor attendance. Byrd wrote five bad checks totaling more than \$10,974 on an account that was closed. Byrd said the account wasn't actually closed when he wrote the checks but he closed it after he realized his checks would bounce. He claims to have done that in order to save himself the bounced check charges. "I've hurt a lot of people and I will pay back my debts," Byrd

said. Byrd pled no-contest to five counts of issuing worthless checks and another hearing will be held to determine how much restitution he will have to pay.

Barbra Opens U.S. Tour

Barbra Streisand kicked off her 18-show, U.S. concert tour May 10th in front of a sold-out crowd of more than 18,000 at the USAir Arena outside Washington, D.C. It is her first tour in more than 27 years. Streisand sang "Happy Days are Here Again" while huge television screens flashed pictures of President Clinton, who was scheduled to attend the May 12th show. The concert started a half-hour late because everyone had to pass through security screening at Streisand's request. Fans that can't make it to one of her concerts this summer will still have an opportunity to drape themselves in Babs swag. Sony Signatures has the merchandising license and has developed a line of fashion apparel, gifts and memorabilia to celebrate the tour. The Barbara

DC TALK

Contemporary music is full of labels. Sometimes those labels are helpful for a quick insight to what the band is all about. But in the case of DC Talk, labels oversimplify the band's multi-genre music and diminish its actual mainstream appeal. DC Talk is commonly referred to as a Christian rap act. Aspects of that label are right-on. DC Talk is a Christian band and they do use rap as a vocal style in their music but they are more than that. Toby McKeehan, Kevin Smith and Michael Tait come from a variety of musical backgrounds. McKeehan's musical roots are firmly planted in hip-hop, Smith is a rocker and Tait's influences are gospel and soul.

"People try to categorize us as rap or hip-hop. That's one of the elements we use in our music but it's by no means the core of what we're doing," McKeehan told POLLSTAR. "We're blatantly a pop group. There is no other way to categorize us. It's frustrating to us because it pigeonholes us. Not only that, but it frustrates true hip-hop groups [or] hard core purist rap fans because we're called a rap act when you've got people like Snoop Doggy Dogg or Ice Cube, the true rap acts. It's not the same thing, it doesn't deserve the same label. We don't even claim to be a rap group. Rap is just one of the vocal styles our generation grew up with so it's part of our arsenal."

Also, being labeled a Christian act adds to the preconceptions of DC Talk. "When you hear the word Christian, [the public] expects a group that would be up there singing hymns or a church looking group. They don't expect people who can communicate to our generation. We're not a facade. We grew up with exactly the kind of music we're making. And we grew up lookin' the way we look. I think the whole categorization of Christian music shuts people's ears down immediately. If we're not labeled a Christian band, [our music] will typically fall on more open ears because they haven't already pre-judged us. I think in the '90s, people are a little tired of church and people are a little tired of religion not meeting their needs. And we're the same way. Religiosity didn't meet our needs but God did, so that's our point. We want to share our faith in God without being categorized a certain way. You don't categorized R.E.M. as a humanitarian rock group just because they stand up for some causes. [And] you don't call Ice Cube and other hard core rappers Muslim rappers, they're just rappers."

DC Talk's current release, *Free At Last*, is at the top of the Christian charts. They have toured in support of DeGarmo & Key and Michael W. Smith and are currently in the middle of their first headlining tour. And their success on the road (they draw between 2,000 and 6,000 per night) has helped open up some secular paths. "We're this underground band that people are amazed at. They want to know what's behind this music that is making people come out [to concerts]." DC Talk has appeared on the "Tonight Show with Jay Leno" and "The Arsenio Hall Show," and they have been featured in many publications including *People*, *USA Today*, the *Los Angeles Times* and the *Wall Street Journal*.

But that still hasn't cleared the path to pop radio. DC Talk, which records for ForeFront Communications Group, has tested the pop radio market with some luck. "We've had some great success in smaller towns. We've sent them a CD and they've run us on the 'is it a smash or trash' kind of thing and we've beat groups like Tony Toni Toni." But McKeehan said DC Talk doesn't have the

right political set-up and business team to actually get adds on secular radio. The live side of their business team is strong with John Huie at Creative Artists Agency as their agent, but without the support of a major record company, their acceptance at non-Christian radio is virtually nil. That may be slowing down their secular acceptance but it isn't standing completely in the way. "We thought the only keys [to success] were radio and placement in the record stores and we have neither of them. We don't even have MTV." But they have a growing and supportive fan base and McKeehan said, sooner or later, people will demand to hear them. "That's what we're banking on."

Major non-Christian record companies are considering banking on that success, also. "There's a lot of mainstream record labels pursuing us right now." Some labels have told DC Talk that they would sign them immediately if they soften their lyrics. But the message of their music is a top priority for DC Talk. "If you change our message, the group has no reason to exist." Other labels have told DC Talk not to change at all. "That's much more attractive to us. We'd be looking to be signed as a pop act, but a pop act that is very message oriented." DC Talk has no intentions of being preachy, however. "We're tired of being preached at. We don't ever want to come across as 'holier than thou' because we're not. We stumble and fall every day. We're just pursuing our faith in God." Regardless, pursuing a secular audience has drawn some criticism from the Christian community. "I think there are some people that want to keep you to themselves. They want you to be the Christian industry's own little group. We would much rather go out and share our faith with the world than simply speak to the converted all our lives. And the fact that they can't understand that doesn't make a lot of sense to me. If they truly have a faith in God, they should want to share it. If you find a great restaurant, you want to tell people about it. That's a little bit of a trite example but [we] want to share [Christianity] because it's worked in our lives, not because we want to shove it down people's throats."

For today, McKeehan, Smith and Tait are content in their careers. "We're very comfortable in our setting. We have a great peace about it." But when the time to sign on to a major secular label comes, they will be ready. "When the right door opens, we'll know to step through it."

Although the tour quickly "sold out," additional tickets to some shows have just been put on sale as a few unsold \$1,000 fundraising tickets are turned back in and the real number of production seat kills needed became known.

Willie Nelson was arrested on misdemeanor marijuana possession charges May 10th. Police found Nelson asleep around 9 a.m. in the back seat of his Mercedes Benz on a side road just off Interstate 35 near Hewitt, Texas. In the course of checking the situation out, police reportedly found a roach in the ashtray and then some rolled joints and a baggie containing less than two ounces of pot in the car. Nelson was reportedly returning to his home in Austin from a poker game when he decided to pull over for a snooze. He was arrested on a Class B misdemeanor and taken to McClennan County Jail where he was released on bond a few hours later. Nelson, who supports pot legalization efforts and admits he's been smoking weed for decades, didn't appear too concerned about the bust. A June court date has been set.

Bobcat's Career Heats Up

Bobcat Goldthwait's berserk graffiti antics on "The Arsenio Hall Show" may have gotten him booked on "The Tonight Show With Jay Leno," but his May 6th antics on Leno's show might also get him booked at the Burbank County Jail. Bobcat doused his chair with lighter fluid and lit it on fire to the surprise of his host. Leno later said he expected Bobcat to have some kind of stunt up his sleeve but didn't suspect that it would be something so

potentially dangerous. Leno, looking obviously perturbed at the stunt, quenched the fire with liquid from his coffee mug then tried to make Bobcat sit on the mess. But the fiery comedian jumped up and proceeded to carry on with the mayhem but was stopped in his tracks when he slipped and fell. Leno later told KNBC News that it was "really no big thing except when you have fire and 550 people in the audience and a set that's made out of paper and balsa wood." Burbank Fire Marshall Darryl Forbes said that no charges have been filed yet but the investigation is continuing. "We do intend to press charges," Forbes said, although he declined to say what they would be. Bobcat, through his management reps at Gold Mountain issued a statement May 12th saying the whole stunt was meant to be funny, not dangerous, and that he was sorry it happened.

Liberty recording artist John Berry had major surgery May 10th to drain fluid from a benign cyst that was located deep within his brain.

Berry was moved to the intensive care unit at Emory University Hospital in Atlanta after the five-and-a-half hour procedure. Doctors said he was doing very well. He was expected to remain in the ICU until the end of last week. The new high-tech stereotactic endoscopic procedure that was used only required a small incision in the skull, something that wouldn't have been possible five years ago. Berry had to cancel an extensive itinerary and it's not yet certain when he might be able to return to the stage..... The new **Kiel Center** arena in St. Louis will open October 8th, three months ahead of schedule. The new arena will have been completed in a record 21 months. The new Gateway Center in Cleveland and United Center in Chicago will also open around the same time, although they started construction 8-10 months before Kiel..... The Sam Boyd Silver Bowl at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, has been officially renamed **Sam Boyd Stadium**. The school felt the old name was too long and detracted from honoring the late gaming exec whose company was the venue's major benefactor.

Legal Grievs

Marion (Suge) Knight, CEO of Death Row Records, was ordered by a federal magistrate to appear in Las Vegas May 13th to answer charges that he obtained two Austrian Glock 40-caliber pistols illegally. The FBI alleges that Knight, who manages Dr. Dre and Snoop Doggy Dogg among others, paid another man and his girlfriend \$2,500 to buy the guns under a fictitious name and then deliver them to him. Knight is free on \$100,000-bail and his attorney claims the guns were for Death Row security guards..... **Dan Hicks** won't face any problems with the law for exposing himself at a concert in Newport, Ore., late last month. Police decided it wasn't worth the effort to arrest Hicks, who could have been charged under the city's ordinance against disorderly conduct. Police Chief Jim Rivers said it wasn't a productive use of time since Hicks would have only faced a maximum fine of \$50..... **Michael Jackson's** lawyers spent two hours in a Santa Barbara courtroom May 10th in an attempt to quash the search warrant that allowed officials to take nude photos of MJ. The December 20th photo session was accompanied by a body search that MJ called one of the most humiliating experiences of his life. MJ's attorneys contend the search was unconstitutional and want

the photos returned. The Santa Barbara DA claims that the warrant was lawful and the photos should remain in the custody of law enforcement officials. The judge did not indicate when he would rule on the motion.... A scrap of paper found in a hotel room may be proof that **Michael Bolton** did not steal his hit "Love is a Wonderful Thing" from the Isley Brothers. Al Wilson, a former employee of a Marriott Hotel in Connecticut, said he retrieved the scrap paper from a wastebasket in a room where Bolton stayed in 1990. He said several phrases from Bolton's "Love is a Wonderful Thing" were written on the paper. Wilson said he thinks this finding will strengthen Bolton's case. "It shows that he was creating the song back then, not taking it from someone else's lyrics." Actually, it may only help prove Bolton didn't overtly pirate the song. It doesn't prove he didn't subconsciously recall bits of the Isley's song from the '60s when he was crafting his tune.

Wynonna Planning For A New Judd

Wynonna surprised everyone when she announced May 10th that she is pregnant. As a result, all tour dates after Labor Day have been cancelled. "Into my fifth month it's not going to be feasible for me to be jumping off risers," she said. The father, Arch Kelley III, is a divorced Nashville boat salesman. Wynonna described him as very supportive and responsible but there are no marriage plans yet and no consideration of an abortion. She plans to wait until she comes off the road before making a decision about marriage. The baby is due on New Year's day and the singer's tentative plans include a hiatus thru Spring '95.

More Shots At Ticketmaster

A class-action racketeering lawsuit was filed May 10th against Ticketmaster, Tower Video, Madison Square Garden and New York sports teams the Yankees, the Jets, the Giants, the Rangers and the Islanders. The suit, filed in Manhattan by two women on behalf of themselves and others, claims that Ticketmaster has an illegal monopoly. And it also alleges Ticketmaster gives kickbacks to facility operators and promoters in order to obtain the exclusive rights to sell tickets to their events. Actually, TM has publicly acknowledged that it shares revenues with venues

and promoters and such payments are part of its contracts — not some under the table payoff. And in California, where TM faces another class-action lawsuit, only three consumers and two attorneys showed up May 6th at a hearing to lodge complaints about a proposed settlement of the action filed against Ticketmaster and BASS over the service charges they charge. That settlement, less the handful of people who asked to be excluded, was expected to have been approved late last week.

Pros On The Move

Bill FitzGerald has been named VP of concerts for Ogden Presents. He will be based in Ogden's NYC offices and will coordinate the concert promotion efforts at all Ogden-managed venues. FitzGerald spent the last four years as a senior producer for Metropolitan Entertainment.... Sue McLean, the veteran in-house promoter for The Guthrie Theater in Minneapolis, has formed Triad Entertainment, a concert and special event promotion company to be based in the Twin Cities. McLean and Triad remain the exclusive talent buyer for the Guthrie but she will also now be promoting acts in a variety of other venues.... John Tevis has joined forces with Capitol International where he will handle the agency's small hall division on the East Coast.

Deals, Deals, Deals

Tony Bennett has apparently broken more new ground by becoming the first major musical artist to cut a high profile sponsorship deal with a large software company. The crooner will help WordPerfect market its new MainStreet consumer software line. The deal was put together by PS Productions and involves tour stops in 40 cities between July and December.... Gaylord Entertainment Co., which owns Opryland, TNN and is the majority owner of CMT and CMT Europe, announced May 11th that it will take over management of the Christian music video channel Z Music. Gaylord also paid an undisclosed price to buy an option for purchase of 95 percent of Z Music.... Lee Iacocca invested \$4.5 million in Full House Resorts Inc., which operates Deadwood Gulch Resorts, a casino and resort complex in South Dakota. The company is seeking approval from the state's gaming commission to provide Iacocca with nearly 10 percent of the shares of Full House common stock. Iacocca has

reportedly said that the gaming industry is the fastest growing business in the world. The resort now has a casino and hotel but plans to add a recreation park and family fun center to the complex. Full House is also funding development of a second casino in Oregon. Full House will be merged with Iacocca's Branson WR Productions, which owns half-interest in the Will Rogers Follies and three commercial properties in Branson.... The second annual Ticketmaster Music Showcase kicks off July 27th. This year's program will cover 35 cities with a caravan of music industry professionals and will focus on artist development. In addition to cash awards, TM will also award one of the five national showcase bands a one-week recording session at Heart's Bad Animals studio in Seattle.

2 Pac Sure Keeps His Lawyers Busy

Tupac (2 Pac) Shakur was charged May 6th for violating his probation stemming from his April 29th gun and pot arrest on Hollywood Blvd. The case was referred to the L.A. County DA for possible felony prosecution. And when Shakur surrendered May 10th to serve a 15-day jail sentence for an unrelated misdemeanor battery charge, he was arrested again — this time on two felony counts relating to gun possession by a convict. Shakur pled innocent to the two felony counts and his bail was set at \$45,000. Since he is serving a sentence for beating up director Allen Hughes, he won't be allowed to post bond until the end of the 15 days. Shakur, who was convicted last year of carrying a concealed weapon, is also awaiting trial in New York for an alleged sexual attack on a woman in his hotel room and in Atlanta for allegedly shooting at two off-duty police officers.

Payola Prosecutor Gets Reprimand

In a rare move earlier this month, the Justice Department dropped the veil of secrecy that traditionally has shrouded discipline of federal prosecutors. Prosecutor William S. Lynch was formally reprimanded May 5th for failing to disclose critical information in the high-profile payola case against Joe Isgro, who was the nation's largest independent record promoter in the 1980s. The case against Isgro was dismissed when U.S. District Judge James Ideman discovered that Lynch had concealed information that cast serious doubts on the merits of the case. However, the

Justice Department decided not to punish Lynch beyond the reprimand because he did not act "intentionally." At the time he dismissed the charges against Isgro, Judge Ideman called the government's misconduct, "as outrageous and egregious as anything that I have seen." Isgro subsequently had charges reinstated against him, but it now looks like the government will have a difficult time mounting a successful new case against the one-time king of indie record promoters.

Aerosmith Gets Those Platinum Blues

The Roseanne And Tom Show

Roseanne Arnold is being sued by her former manager, Arlyne Rothberg, for \$20 million. The defamation lawsuit was filed May 3rd as a response to the release of Arnold's autobiography, "My Lives." Rothberg claims the book portrays her as disloyal and unprofessional. She said that depiction has damaged her reputation and her business. Rothberg managed Arnold from 1988 until she was dumped in 1990 after Rosie married Tom Arnold. Meanwhile, a \$120,000 lawsuit against the Arnolds, which accused Tom Arnold of hitting a nurse at a psychiatric hospital, was rejected by a jury in Los Angeles. The nurse, Angela Brooks, said Arnold's hand struck her in the chest and knocked her into a wall in 1991 at CPC Westwood Hospital. She claimed the blow caused her to miss work and was also responsible for her giving birth to her baby two months prematurely. But she testified that she couldn't tell if the blow was deliberate. The Arnolds denied Brooks was hit at all. The Arnolds were moving their 15-year-old daughter to another hospital when the "commotion" developed because the girl wanted to stay. Brooks said she was struck when she tried to help the girl.

The Capitol Hill Rap

Recording industry reps fought against a rating system for rap lyrics, May 5th, telling a House subcommittee in Washington, D.C., that a voluntary advisory label already exists, alerting parents to lyrics that emphasize sex, violence or drugs. But lawmakers question whether the voluntary labels are sufficient. Rep. Cardiss Collins, D-Ill., said the violent, anti-women theme of many rap recordings "dehumanizes relationships." Hilary

Rosen, the new president of the RIAA, defended an artist's First Amendment rights saying the voluntary warning label program "balances the rights of free expression with the desires for social responsibility." Of a similar hearing that was held in February, Collins said it made more women express their dislike of derogatory references in rap lyrics and made the recording industry more willing to help.


W.C. Handy Blues Awards

Albert Collins was posthumously honored at the 15th annual W.C. Handy Blues Awards show May 5th. Collins was named blues entertainer of the year, male artist of the year in the contemporary blues category, and blues instrumentalist for the guitar. The Blues Foundation's awards show, which was hosted by Isaac Hayes and Cybill Shepherd, was held at the Orpheum Theatre in Memphis. Etta James took home two honors as best female artist in the soul/blues category and best female vocalist. B.B. King's *Blues Summit* was named best contemporary blues album, and Bobby "Blue" Bland's *Years of Tears* received soul/blues album of the year honors. Other winners included Anson Funderburgh & the Rockets with Sam Myers for blues band of the year; Koko Taylor for female artist in the contemporary blues category; and Charlie Musselwhite for blues instrumentalist for the harmonica. In the traditional category, Robert Jr. Lockwood won male artist of the year and Jessie Mae Hemphill was named female artist of the year. And Taj Mahal's *Dancin' the Blues* was named best traditional blues album. John Hammond, Pinetop Perkins, Clarence "Gatemouth" Brown, and Otis Rush were also among those honored.

Obituaries

Michael Piranian, Jr., the four-month-old son of CAA agent Mike Piranian and his wife Maureen died quietly in his sleep May 8th, an apparent victim of SIDS — sudden-infant-death syndrome. Funeral and memorial arrangements were still pending at press time.... Dwight Winslow Johnson, 48, operations director for Stone City Attractions in San Antonio, died earlier this month from lung cancer. Johnson was Stone City prexy Jack Orbin's best friend and had worked for the concert promotion firm for 10 years.

Between The Dates

Most of the LOLLAPALOOZA '94 itinerary was released this week, but four dates were announced and went on sale two weeks ago. Tickets for a Lakewood Amphitheatre show in Atlanta quickly sold out and another show was added the same day. Starplex Amphitheatre in Dallas also started out with one date. It didn't sell out immediately but a second date was added late last week. This year's Lollapalooza mainstage features Smashing Pumpkins, The Beastie Boys, George Clinton, The Breeders, A Tribe Called Quest, and L7. The Boredoms and Green Day will also be on the first and second legs respectively..... After initial sales became known, Metropolitan Entertainment moved its July 9th EAGLES show scheduled for Rich Stadium outside Buffalo to the Darien Lakes Performing Arts Center. Under the circumstances, a stadium show in the market was a stretch. The biggest problem was probably that tickets for a show across the border at Exhibition Stadium in Toronto had gone on sale three weeks earlier and many of the band's most ardent fans may have already bought tickets for the Canadian show before word got out there would also be one in Buffalo..... The first round of tickets for the upcoming ROLLING STONES tour went on sale the weekend of May 7th. RFK Stadium in D.C. sold out as fast as fans could buy them. In Toronto, two shows went on sale for Exhibition Stadium, and although at press time, neither show had sold out, both shows were said to be on their ways to a sell out. The other markets which went on sale included the college towns of East Lansing, Mich., Columbia, Mo., and Columbia, S.C. The East Lansing area, which together with neighboring Lansing, has a total population of less than 250,000 people, and both of the Columbias have populations of less than 100,000. Though there are still tickets available, these shows are expected to sell out by attracting fans within about a 4 hour drive of the sites. NYC and Madison, Wisc., were to have gone on sale this past weekend. While we're mentioning the "dairy state," officials and promoters involved with the Camp Randall Stadium show have scrapped plans for a second Stones show due to complaints from a neighborhood group. Local promoter Herb Frank and University of Wisconsin athletic officials said meetings were held with the Regent Street Neighborhood Association in April about the possibility of adding a second show. However, the group reminded the university that they had promised in 1988 not to hold more than two major concerts per summer in the stadium. Pink Floyd is already set to play there on July 3rd. As a result the school is passing on the income from a second show and will honor its deal with the neighbors. The president of the Greater Madison Convention and Visitors Bureau, said a second Stones concert would have added as much as \$1.4 million into the local economy, plus the UW athletic department would have received about \$120,000 in rent and concessions from a second show..... WOODSTOCK '94 expects to announce its line-up within the next two weeks, but several acts have already indicated they'll be there. Crosby, Stills & Nash, Melissa Etheridge, Spin Doctors, and The Rollins Band are among those planning to play the 25th anniversary show. And if you look at Aerosmith's itinerary, you'll note that August 13th or 14th in Saugerties, N.Y. routes rather nicely. Among the other bands that are rumored to be on the bill are Guns N' Roses, Peter Gabriel, Stone Temple Pilots, and Red Hot Chili Peppers..... Remember when Luciano Pavarotti performed in Manila and the price of tickets, which went for as much as \$925, caused a local political furor? Now, Philippine first lady Amelita Ramos says that FRANK SINATRA and LIZA MINNELLI will perform benefits between June 17-20 in Manila and tickets will cost up to \$740. Gold circle seats seem to be real pricey in that country. Proceeds will benefit the first lady's "Clean and Green" environment project..... The MISFITS IN THE ATTIC are winding up a month-long tour which included just about every prison in Pennsylvania. We'll refrain from any puns about playing in front of a "captive audience." 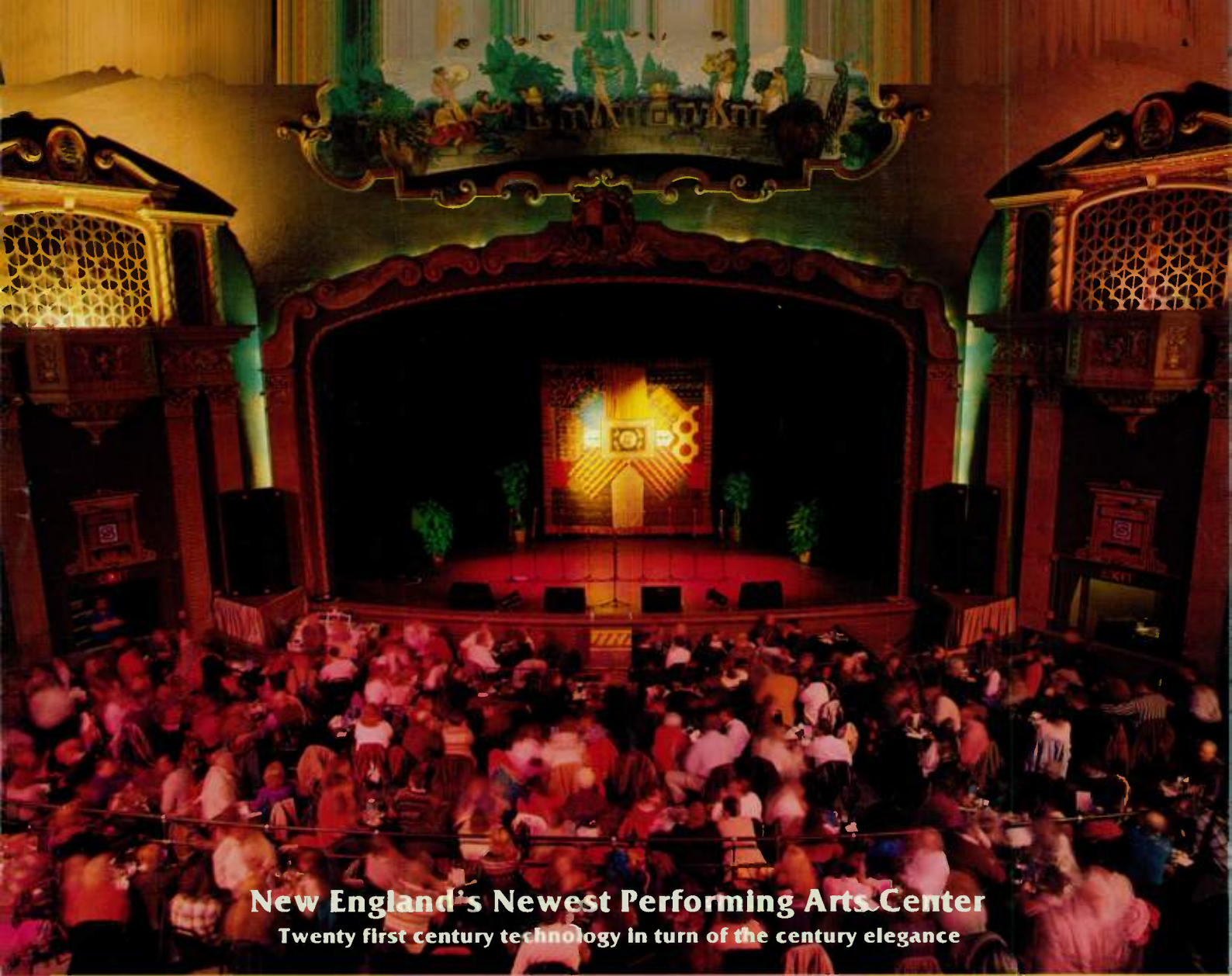
