## Buck Williams Swings His Own Club With PGA

Veteran agent Buck Williams resigned from Monterey Artists earlier this month and on June 8th he opened the doors to his own company, the Progressive Global Agency. He brings with him the six acts he originally brought with him from F.B.I. to Monterey: R.E.M., Boingo, The Specials, The Connells, Hoodoo Gurus, Widespread Panic and Queen Sarah Saturday. Also joining the fledgling agency's staff are Brian Hill, who had been an assistant to Mike Piranian at CAA in Beverly Hills, and Scott Clayton, who worked in the D.C. area office of Cellar Door Entertainment. Clayton has brought two other groups into the agency; From Good Homes and Everything. All of these acts will be working in the fall except for R.E.M. which has announced no tour plans but is widely expected to tour in 1995. Williams' history with the members of R.E.M. actually dates back to the late '70s. When he was working at the Paragon Agency in Macon, Ga., Williams was always nice to the guys in the agency's mailroom and one of those bottom-of-the-totem-pole employees, Bill Berry, never forgot that. When asked about his decision to base his new agency in Nashville, Williams said, "There's a lot happening here. I've got no problem with booking rock n' roll out of this town. ## More Shots At Ticketmaster

Three women from Seattle filed a lawsuit against Ticketmaster June 8th over the company's alleged antitrust law violations and monopolistic business practices. The plaintiffs also named the North American Concert Promoters Association in the action, alleging TM has entered into long-term exclusive contracts with NACPA members to fix service fees. While many NACPA members probably do have individual contracts with TM, the trade association itself has never made any kind of a deal with TM. The plaintiffs are seeking an injunction against TM and are asking that the case be declared a class action for all TM customers in the states of Washington and Oregon. The legal action was reportedly provoked by Pearl Jam's complaint to the Justice Department and the suit cites the complaint to support its claim. The Justice Department's antitrust division last week confirmed it is investigating "possible anti-competitive practices in the ticket distribution industry." But a department

spokesperson declined to say whether TM was a target of its probe. A spokesperson for TM said the lawsuit is the latest of six filed recently around the country that are "meritless" and "frivolous."..... One of the hottest rumors floating around the industry is about a possible foray by Sony into the computerized ticket distribution business. The buzz is that Sony is thinking about setting up a distribution network using ATM machines and would seek to challenge TM's exclusive contracts in court. It took some effort to find anyone who could comment on the rumor but eventually a corporate spokesperson said Sony was definitely not getting into the event ticketing business.

# JUNIOR BROWN

Even with all the forces working against him as a young boy, Junior Brown was still determined to learn how to play guitar. He found rock and country music especially attractive since his parents were opposed to those genres. And while all the other kids in junior high had electric guitars (Brown's parents thought the electric guitar was evil), he had to borrow equipment in order to learn to play his music. But hard times or not, the self taught guitarist wrote his first song at age 14 and dropped out of school in 1969, at about age 17, to start working in the honky-tonks, and he's been playing country music ever since.

This 42-year-old Texan is influenced by the deep down roots of country and throws in some bluegrass, Memphis-style blues, and rockabilly. And don't be surprised to hear a Hendrix riff or two. His is the kind of down home music that seems to be lost in much of today's country music — the kind written to put a smile on your face. He acknowledges one of his biggest influences in his song, "My Baby Don't Dance To Nothin' But Ernest Tubb." But Brown doesn't think of his music as totally traditional. "I do use a traditional base format but I expand that with my wild guitar playing. I try to think of it as being futuristic as well as traditional." And his instrument may look a bit futuristic on stage since it is one of a kind. Brown invented his own personal combination of steel and electric guitars. The "Guit-Steel" allows him to switch back and forth between the two sounds very quickly. The idea actually came to him in a dream.

Though a portion of his interest in country music comes from rebellion against his parents, their influence in raising a moral, upstanding man comes out in his music. Unlike much of traditional country music, he's not into songs about immorality and wrongdoing. "I just don't like to hear stuff about going out and cheating on the wife and getting drunk and kicking the dog." He feels lyrical content should not be taken lightly. "I think it's really important that people realize what they're doing and what they're saying with their music. I don't think a lot of people realize what comes out of their mouth. They don't think before they talk or before they sing or anything else. And what you say pretty much establishes what you are, the way you live and what people think of you."

Brown's less than faddish style leads to the question of what audience he's seeking. He said he's being marketed to all audiences. "I'll play the Grand Ole Opry one night and then I'll open up for Widespread Panic or [some alternative rock band] the next." He said different audiences basically have the same reaction to his performance. "Everybody seems to walk away from the show liking it."

Brown put out his first solo album on his own indie label and he released it as a cassette and sold it locally in Austin. One day British rocker Nick Lowe hitched a ride with someone who had the tape. Brown said, "I'd never met him at that time. He heard it on the way to the airport in somebody's pick-up truck and flipped out about it. And the next thing I knew I was getting a call from Demon Records over there in London and they wanted to put it out as a CD." So that was the second release of his first album, *12*

Brown said he made the right decision when he chose Curb. "They're very dedicated and they understand that I'm a unique artist and I can't just be put in this slot with other artists. It takes some sort of tailoring as a long term project [in order] to get to the audiences that will appreciate what I'm doing."

Curb has planned a long term, low key marketing strategy for Brown. That approach stems from Brown's good ole boy purity and honesty. Curb wants people to discover him from those qualities rather than creating hype around him. "We don't want to just ram it down people's throats," Brown said. "We like to take sort of a softer approach and build our fan base as we go."

In building that base of fans, Brown's agent, Bobby Cudd at Monterey Artists, keeps him out on the road quite a bit. Brown said touring is great. "We get new fans every time we play." Things really got started for Brown when he met Cudd at the South by Southwest convention a few years ago. It was Cudd who brought him to the attention of Curb.

Also as part of his business team, Brown has PR firm Myers Media and manager Miles Copeland working for him. He said Copeland, who also manages Sting, has helped a lot to improve his career. "He can open up all of the European markets which are very, very important and not so much what a country artist would be able to do. I mean, I'm going to have some opportunities that other people don't just having him as a manager." Copeland approached Brown when he saw him on a New Year's Eve TV special in London.

Also working on the business side of things is Brown's wife Tanya Rae. Not only does she help handle the business but Rae is also the rhythm guitarist and vocal partner in Brown's band. Brown said having his wife in the band makes things a lot easier but it also puts a certain amount of strain on the relationship at times. "There is some tension because we're together 24 hours a day. There's bound to be some minor tensions but we work them out."

Junior Brown will tour the East Coast through the end of June. He will then do some dates in Tennessee, Indiana and Ohio through the middle of July before taking off to Europe for dates in France and England. At the beginning of August, he'll return to crisscross the U.S. and already has dates booked in California and New York.

Ranks, Joe Cocker, The Cranberries, Crosby Stills and Nash, Cypress Hill, Bob Dylan, Melissa Etheridge, Peter Gabriel, Green Day, Metallica, The Neville Brothers, Nine Inch Nails, Porno For Pyros, Red Hot Chili Peppers, Rollins Band, Santana and Spin Doctors are the acts already secured for the August 13th and 14th concert. Organizers expect to announce more musical artists as well as comedians in the days ahead. Each act will reportedly perform a full set from one of the two main stages which will be going simultaneously from about noon to 2 a.m. each day. The festival has initiated an unusual ticketing plan to facilitate smooth access into and out of the venue site. The first block of tickets went on sale June 15th as part of either an air or bus travel package. Concertgoers who travel to the show directly on a bus or on a bus via a New York City flight will be the only people to have direct access to the Woodstock '94 site. For those not interested in mass transportation, tickets tentatively go on sale through Ticketmaster phone lines June 26th. The cost per ticket is \$135 and they will only be sold in blocks of four with one parking pass per block. Auto parking will be at satellite lots with busses shuttling back and forth to the site. Costs of the travel packages will vary and all ticket buyers will have access to on-site camping facilities. And if a concertgoer needs medical attention while at the show, organizers are doing everything they can to assure the proper attention is available on-site. Organizers have put out a call for 900 volunteers needed to work at least two eight-hour shifts at medical facilities around the site. Two emergency mini-hospitals, each with 52 beds, will operate round-the-clock at the site and 15 other small emergency facilities will be sprinkled throughout the 840-acres. Each of those 15 facilities will have a doctor, nurses and paramedics on hand. Fifteen ambulances and a medical evacuation helicopter will also be stationed on the grounds. All medical volunteers must be registered medical professionals in New York state. For their efforts, medical volunteers will receive a free ticket to the concert, a bed to sleep in, meals and an armful of Woodstock paraphernalia. For those people who don't want to join 250,000 others for a weekend of peace and music in a cow pasture, the concert will also likely be available on pay-per-view.

## Up Periscope At Polaris

The grand opening of the Polaris Amphitheater in Columbus, Ohio, was postponed due to construction delays and heavy rain. The June 15th opening night show, featuring the Moody Blues and the Columbus Symphony Orchestra, was cancelled nine hours before its scheduled start. A June 16th Bette Midler concert also was postponed because the singer has bronchitis. Midler's show was not immediately rescheduled and the Moody Blues show was moved to June 20th. The new amphitheatre was rescheduled to open June 18th with a Billy Ray Cyrus concert.

## Was It A Guaranteed Sell-Out?

Two fledgling concert promoters in Madison, Wis., who lost money booking a James Brown concert in Milwaukee, failed to persuade a judge to eliminate their liability for cancellation costs. Wanna-be promoters Gregory Stutzel and Steven Harle said ticket sales were extremely low for the September 1991 gig at the Marcus Amphitheater and they were forced to cancel the show. The men had asked a judge to rescind an order making them pay \$31,750 to Universal Attractions, Brown's agency. The promoters had claimed they were "taken advantage of by a large

organization" and had sued the agency for allegedly misrepresenting Brown's boxoffice potential. The promoters went to court seeking the return of their \$15,000 deposit. Universal then filed a countersuit claiming the promoter's decision to cancel the concert had cost their client \$31,750 and the judge agreed with the agency.

## The Electric Godfather & One Of His Disciples

## Cyberspace Truce Reached At mtv.com

MTV and former VJ Adam Curry have reached a tentative agreement over the computer Internet address mtv.com. Curry started the service about a year ago when he was still an employee of MTV. MTV launched the trademark infringement lawsuit shortly after Curry quit the network. The interim settlement has Curry setting up his services under a new Internet address by June 30th. By that date, Curry's computers will be at the Internet address metaverse.com. Curry told POLLSTAR, "On mtv.com we will have forwarding links for two months. During the first month [users] will get to a page [screen] that explains why we moved, and where we moved to. The user clicks, and

he's there. Month two... the same thing happens, only you will have to type in *metaverse.com*, and then click." Curry added that after the two months, *mtv.com* will not have a forwarding link, just the notice that the service has moved to a new address. Among the original charges was that Beavis & Butt-head transcripts had been on the *mtv.com* computers along with the MTV logo. Last month, Curry said the Beavis & Butt-head dialogue came from an MTV press release and he just passed the information along to the users of his service. Curry also claims that the MTV logo was a scanned image of one of the early MTV logos and was uploaded from a user. Once it was noticed, he removed it. Curry says, that as part of the interim agreement, all references to MTV have been removed from the service. It remains to be seen what will happen to the address *mtv.com*. Even though Curry has agreed to move his operations to the new *metaverse.com* address, he is still defiant when it comes to giving up *mtv.com*. Internet tradition says that once you've registered an address with the InterNIC, it's your's — forever. Over the last month, several questions have been raised by the citizens of the cyberspace community. Can an Internet address constitute a trademark violation? Would the InterNIC, which oversees the database of Internet addresses, be charged with researching every address request to insure that it doesn't conflict with any already existing corporation name or product trademark? Curry says he still has to be careful with his new name. "When our new *metaverse* address appeared in *New York Magazine*, their [MTV] attorneys immediately sent a letter saying that in any way, shape or form, if you enhance the letters M, T, and V in *metaverse.com*, we'll sue you again."

**WOMAD Falls Victim To Arab-Israeli Tension**

Peter Gabriel was forced to reschedule a planned concert on the border between Israel and Egypt after Egyptian officials called off the show because of security concerns. The concert was to be presented by Gabriel's World of Music, Arts and Dance (WOMAD) organization as a sign of support for the Arab-Israeli peace process. The show was originally scheduled for June 18th at the Egyptian Red Sea resort of Taba, one of the border sites where Israeli and PLO negotiators hammered out the peace agreement. The concert was planned to bring together Arab and

Israeli fans to see Gabriel, Lou Reed, and acts from Britain, Africa and the Middle East. The rescheduled show is to be held in the Israeli port of Eilat at a 1,200-car-capacity parking lot. Transportation will be provided from the Egyptian border for those coming from Egypt to attend the concert. Tickets have been sold in Saudi Arabia, Egypt, Jordan and Israel. Gabriel and musicians from Israel and Egypt were scheduled to hold a small party June 17th at Tabu to make up for the canceled concert.

1,300-seat Ozark Theatre was about 400 people. Also, his show on the Mutual-Westwood One radio network was scheduled to debut June 13th from Branson. According to Brenner's agent, Ben Carizzo, it originated from New York instead.... The **Minnesota Timberwolves** won't be moving to New Orleans for the 1994-95 season, after all. The \$152.5 million offer from Top Rank Of Louisiana was rejected by the NBA's relocation committee. Commissioner David Stern said Top Rank failed to furnish enough data with its offer. Stern also said he expects Top Rank to now sue the franchise. But a Top Rank spokesperson said the group hasn't decided if it will go to court to try and enforce the validity of its multi-million contract with Timberwolves owners Marv Wolfenson and Harvey Ratner. Figuring it would strike the first blow, the NBA filed a lawsuit in federal district court in Minneapolis to reaffirm the league's right to control the location of its franchises.... The historic **Ryman Auditorium** in Nashville celebrated its \$8.2 million renovation and officially reopened its doors June 6th. During the evening, Vince Gill surprised a national radio audience with a duet with his 12-year-old daughter, Jennifer. The family duo sang a song Gill wrote for Jenny called, "Jenny Dreamed of Trains." The radio show was broadcast live from the 102-year-old Gothic-style brick building that was the home of the Grand Ole Opry from 1943 to 1974. The charm of the facility remains intact but it now has some basic comforts like air conditioning and real dressing rooms.... The **Nammies** is the name of the new local music awards which will debut January 18th at the Ryman Auditorium in Nashville. The Nashville Music Awards are based on similar awards programs in other cities such as the Bammies in San Francisco. Awards will honor albums, artists, writers and musicians in all genres of music. Additional awards will be given to outstanding radio station, music writer or critic, music video and music venue.... **Benson Music Group**, the largest independent Christian record company and music publisher, has signed an exclusive distribution deal with **Liberty Records**. Executives from the companies see the union as a step toward the growth of gospel music in mainstream pop culture.... Prince has opened his fourth **Glam Slam** nightclub. The new Miami Beach, Fla., club joins the ones in L.A., Minneapolis and Tokyo.

## Left Eye Shows Rison Some TLC

Lisa "Left Eye" Lopes, of the group TLC, was accused of setting fire to the two-story mansion that belongs to her boyfriend, Atlanta Falcons wide receiver Andre Rison. Rison's home, north of Atlanta, was destroyed in the June 9th blaze. Police issued an arrest warrant for Lopes the day of the fire and the singer turned herself in the following day. In addition to felony arson charges, Lopes faces charges of criminal damage to property for allegedly smashing three of Rison's vehicles, a Mercedes-Benz sedan, a Mercedes-Benz roadster and a Toyota 4-runner. Lopes reportedly was at Rison's home when he returned at 6:30 a.m. from a night out on the town. Police said the singer was enraged and she set fire to cardboard in a whirlpool tub. The couple exchanged hostile words and Rison said Lopes started hitting him on the head. Rison said he had to slap Lopes to get her to stop. In an interview with WAGA-TV, the football player said he then went for a walk, "before it went any further." All of Rison's possessions were destroyed in the fire but he said he still loves Lopes and he plans on going to bat for her. Lopes' bond was set

at \$500,000 for the arson charge and \$10,000 for the criminal damage to property charge. The bond was later reduced to \$82,000, which Lopes posted. Police said they were also going to charge Lopes with a misdemeanor drug charge because a small amount of marijuana was found in Rison's charred home. This isn't the first time Rison and Lopes' relationship put them in the line of the law. Last September, they both were arrested after an altercation in a grocery store parking lot. Rison allegedly hit Lopes and fired a handgun. And Lopes was arrested for fighting with police. Lopes was arrested later that month for fighting with police again, this time at the Georgia Dome. She had to be removed from the facility and she was charged with disorderly conduct while intoxicated, criminal trespass and simple battery against an officer. All those charges were dismissed except the criminal trespass charge, to which she pleaded no contest and was forced to pay a \$200 fine. She also was given a 12-month suspended sentence and was ordered to undergo counseling.

## Legal Grievs

A lawsuit that former manager **Steve Fagnoli** brought against **Prince** has been settled out of court. Fagnoli claimed the track "Jughead" from Prince's *Diamonds & Pearls* album was about him. The \$5 million dispute was reportedly settled for an undisclosed amount just days before an L.A. court hearing.... **Jefferson Airplane** filed a lawsuit in San Francisco last week claiming a computer software company stole the band's 1973 *Thirty Seconds Over Winterland* album cover for a "flying toaster" design that is used as a screen-saver computer program. Berkeley Systems, Inc. denied the claims saying the "After Dark" screen-saver program with the "flying toaster" design was independently created. Berkeley Systems' "flying toaster" design has been used since 1989 but the suit claims the Airplane first became aware of the program last year. The lawsuit filed June 14th says Berkeley Systems copied the toasters consciously or unconsciously creating the false impression that Jefferson Airplane was associated with the program.... Rick Rubin's

**American Recordings** filed a breach of contract suit April 21st against **Phonogram Ltd.**, which distributes the label outside the U.S. and Canada. American claims that Phonogram failed to fulfill its end of a joint venture agreement and is claiming damages in excess of \$10 million.... **Simon Le Bon** was awarded substantial libel damages from two London newspapers over false allegations that the singer cheated on his wife. *The Daily Mail* and *Today* falsely reported Le Bon had an affair with a woman in Rome while his wife was home looking after their two daughters. For the distress and embarrassment caused to Le Bon, his wife, Yasmin, and the woman who was named in the stories, the two papers apologized in London's High Court. The amount of damages the two papers have to pay was not disclosed.... Da Lench Mob rapper **Terry Gray**, otherwise known as T-Bone, pleaded innocent June 10th to murder and attempted murder in a bowling alley shooting. Gray is accused of killing one man, attempting to kill another, and wounding a woman. Gray also pleaded innocent to one count of assault with a deadly weapon in the February shooting. Deputy DA Gregory Jennings said there is a gang connection that is being investigated. Gray is currently free on \$1.5 million bail posted by fellow rapper Ice Cube.

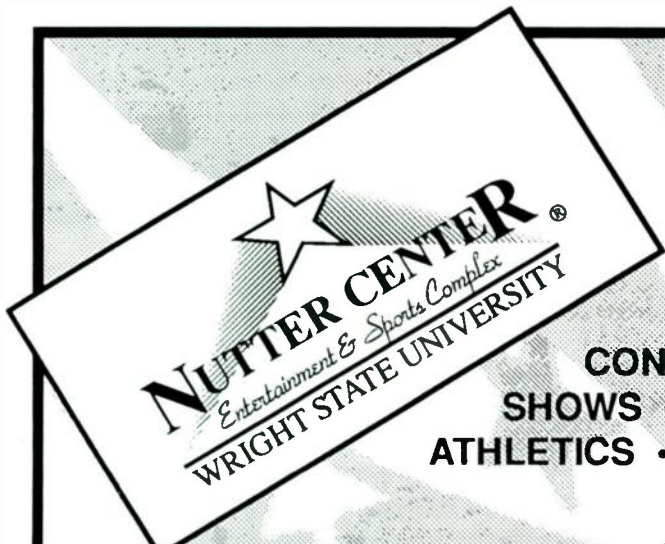

## Between The Dates

Claiming a need for more prep time, the opening date on the **LOLLAPALOOZA '94** tour has been pushed back a day. The festival/tour will now debut on July 7th at the Sam Boyd Stadium in Las Vegas instead of July 6th. The Weber County Fairgrounds date in Ogden, Utah, originally scheduled for the 7th has now been cancelled, but may be rescheduled for a later date.... West coast dates, all two of them, for **W.O.M.A.D. USA '94** are cancelled due to "scheduling problems." The dates, which were the only two on the tour not headlining Peter Gabriel, were to feature Midnight Oil, Primus, Arrested Development and Live.... **JOHN MELLENCAMP** is expected to announce his tour shortly with a national ad campaign financed in part by a six-figure sum from Mercury Records that will lead up to a uniform on-sale date for all shows.... You've heard about those high-priced "gold circle seats" for the Eagles concerts, and Barbra Streisand's high end \$350 ticket price was a sure-fire conversation piece, but what about \$25,000 for a ticket? The event was a special **PAUL SIMON** performance in Dallas at the Morton Meyerson Symphony Center benefiting The American Foundation for AIDS Research where tickets ranged from \$25 to \$25,000. What does a \$25,000 ticket provide? Preferential seating and a small reception. The June 10th show, which also included Ladysmith Black Mambazo, raised over \$900,000 which went to AmFAR and other Dallas-area AIDS organizations. The only other 1994 performance on Simon's agenda, another charity benefit, is planned for Montauk, N.Y., later this year. No word yet on prices for that show.... **BARBRA STREISAND** is reportedly still considering adding an additional date to her upcoming five-night stand at Madison Square Garden. Even if Babs agrees, she is determined to end her tour July 24th in Anaheim. Two films, "The Normal Heart," and "The Mirror Has Two Faces," plus a TV commitment have Streisand booked solid through the end of this year.... Expect the **EAGLES** to head up to the Pacific Northwest after the October 8th Rose Bowl concert. In November the boys play Australia, New Zealand, Japan, and the Far East.... Critically acclaimed San Francisco Bay area band The Call are back. This time the act is being billed as **MICHAEL BEEN & THE CALL**. Look for the dates in this week's Route Book.... **DAVE EDMUNDS** has a new album, *Plugged In*, and plans for a September tour are in the works. Edmunds played all the instruments on the new release.... **STEVE PERRY** has a new album, *For The Love Of Strange Medicine*, his first solo effort since 1984's *Street Talk*. Look for a tour in the fall.... Speaking of fall, that looks like it may well be a great time period for acts to tour. While it seems like *everyone* is touring this summer, there appear to be very few major acts planning to work during the last quarter of this year. Artist managers might want to think about whether their acts would have just a bit more impact in the marketplace if they toured during a time period when there weren't 100 other headliners competing for the public's financial adoration. Just a thought.... For the last few months the rumor mill has been cranking overtime listing acts that might play **WOODSTOCK '94**. Now that the initial list has been released, it's time to cross off a few of the acts that will definitely not, we repeat, not play at the 25th anniversary of the festival. R.E.M. will not play Woodstock, as rumored last spring, and original Woodstock participants The Grateful Dead will also not be appearing. For the Dead, Woodstock is not a very happy memory. Although it's a lot of dead brain cells ago, bandmembers apparently still recall playing their set during a rain storm, receiving electrical shocks from their equipment and hearing people in the wings yelling, "The stage is falling, the stage is falling!" Ah, memories. Where would we be without them?
