Peace In The Valley

The Champlain Valley Exposition in Vermont broke a contract with All Points Booking over a June 10th Metallica concert that fairground officials said violated a local noise ordinance. Now, two shows, Jackson Browne and the H.O.R.D.E. Festival, that were scheduled to play in the next few weeks, are not going to happen — at that venue anyway. Attorney for the fairgrounds, Alan Overton, said, "We had signed the contract with the promoter that the noise ordinance would be complied with. We reserve the right to break the contract if a part has been breached." But All Points Booking attorney, Art Anderson, told POLLSTAR the promoters were never notified during the concert that they were in violation of any noise ordinance. "Obviously, without any notice of that, we couldn't deal with the band and ask them to turn it down," he said. Also, he said All Points and co-promoter Metropolitan Entertainment were never officially notified of any violation after the show. As far as defensive action is concerned, Anderson said various options are being considered. The Jackson Browne concert has been moved to the Stowe Mountain Performing Arts Center but no decision had been made about the H.O.R.D.E. date as of press time.

Executive Shakeup At Warners

A major executive realignment at Warner Music Group last week elevated Doug Morris to the position of president and chief operating officer of Warner Music's U.S. operations. In his new position, Morris will oversee all three of Warner's major labels: Warner Bros., Atlantic and Elektra, and their subsidiaries. The day after Morris' promotion was announced, Bob Krasnow abruptly resigned from his position as Elektra's chairman. Morris' promotion had been rumored for some time but it was a sensitive issue because, in his new position, Morris, was to supervise three more senior executives — Warner Bros. chairman Mo Ostin, Krasnow, and Atlantic founder Ahmet Ertegun. Previously, all three had reported directly to Warner Music Group chairman Robert Morgado. The day of the announcement, Morgado said he didn't think his decision to promote Morris would ruffle feathers among the senior executives. Krasnow apparently didn't see it that way. Ostin, whose contract runs through the end of the year, has reportedly committed to remaining at Warner Bros., even though he too is said to be unhappy with the change in reporting structure. Sylvia Rhone, the head of Atlantic's EastWest Records is rumored to be in line

Henley, Frey & Geffen's Legal Freeze Is Over

Geffen Records officially announced it will release the Eagles album, *Hell Freezes Over*, this fall. The recording will include four new songs along with new renditions of classic Eagles tunes. The first single will be the new Don Henley/Glenn Frey composition, "Get Over It." Geffen also will release a home video of the Eagles' MTV special, which will include documentary footage and possibly additional recordings. With

OFFSPRING

Some say punk rock died after the Sex Pistols' rock 'n' roll swindle in the late '70s. If so, it was quickly reborn in underground scenes in U.S. cities in the early '80s. Out of the do-it-yourself punk spirit in Southern California's Orange County, the Offspring were spawned. The members of the band were high school buddies who related to bands such as TSOL, the Vandals, and the Adolescents, which existed alongside corporate rock and L.A.'s Glam scene. Since Offspring's intention was contrary to the typical aspiring musician in L.A. — it wanted to make music not money — it had no problem sticking to its punk roots and D.I.Y. work ethic. Now, the band has infiltrated the airwaves and achieved success "its way".

Offspring's Dexter Holland, Greg K and two other friends decided to start a band after they were denied admittance to a Social Distortion concert. When they couldn't get into the show, Holland and mates went to a friend's house to drink beer. During the evening, someone suggested they start a band. None of them played any instruments so they randomly assumed roles. Holland chose guitar and vocals. Greg K opted for the bass. The other guys didn't stick with it but within a year or so Noodles (guitar) and Ron Welty (drums) completed the band's line-up. Holland told POLLSTAR, "We went out and we bought guitars and just started messing around. With punk rock it's mostly just bar chords so it took me six months to really be able to play...convincingly."

The band recorded a 7" record in 1987, pressed 1,000 copies and had a difficult time getting rid of them. In 1989, the band signed a pressing-and-distribution deal with Nemesis Records. Nemesis, distributed by Cargo, released Offspring's first full length recording which sold a few thousand copies. By the end of its deal with Nemesis, the group had begun hunting for another label. The band didn't look to major labels however. Instead, it focused on known-indies such as Touch and Go, Slash, SST and Epitaph. But none of the labels showed interest. The band continued to do its own thing and was eventually approached by *Flipside* magazine. *Flipside* was releasing a compilation of California bands and it offered to finance the recording of an Offspring song. The band recorded a song for the compilation at West Beach, the studio owned by Bad Religion's Brett Gurewitz. Gurewitz engineered the song and showed some interest in signing the band to Bad Religion's label, Epitaph. "[But] he wasn't convinced that the rest of our material was strong enough, so he backed off.

"Six months later we still didn't have a label. It had been three years since our [last release] and we decided we were gonna sign with someone, no matter who it was," Holland said. Despite the fact that Epitaph had turned the band down earlier, it sent the label another tape "just for the hell of it". Gurewitz showed interest again and asked the band if it had any new material. When Gurewitz heard the new stuff, he called the band with an offer.

After Offspring's first Epitaph release in 1992, the band toured extensively but wasn't selling many records. Then its music became a favorite soundbed for surf and skate videos. "A lot of kids watched their favorite skater over and over again and after a while they're going, 'hey, what's that song?' Our record climbed up to about 50,000 [units sold] by the time *Smash* (the newest CD) was released. We couldn't believe it."

Smash shipped more than 50,000 units in its first week and is rapidly approaching gold. The video for the first single, "Come Out and Play (Keep 'Em Separated)," is smoking up the airwaves as a buzz bin clip on MTV. Add to that, massive radio play as the number one requested alternative song and the sum is packed houses at every stop on Offspring's summer club tour. The U.S. tour continues throughout the end of August and Offspring heads to Europe after that.

Labeled "punk's last great hope" in '92, Offspring is living up to that moniker. The band has been approached by every major label but decided to stay at Epitaph. "It seemed kind of ridiculous that all of a sudden there'd be all this major label attention because it's real home grown music, [not] what I would consider corporately feasible. But all of the sudden — boom — it comes down to numbers. Epitaph is doing a great job so we didn't see why we should sign to a major. That wasn't what we were about."

Offspring is ironically managed by the same team that manages Social Distortion, Jim Guerinot and Larry Weintraub of Rebel Waltz Management. The band booked its own shows for years but occasionally gave someone else the opportunity to secure gigs. "It would invariably be bad, really sleazy and I just didn't trust those kinds of people at all." Then Stormy Shepherd of Leave Home Booking called. "Stormy actually called me out of the blue. I'd never met her and I was really wary about her, too." Shepherd booked three shows for the band and Holland liked the way she handled the job and agreed to let her be the band's agent.

Holland may eventually resume his formal educational quest for a PhD at USC but for now the cloning of viruses has to wait. Holland took a leave of absence from his molecular biology research to dedicate 100 percent of his time to the band. The Offspring is not going to let opportunity pass it by.

And the band is adamantly trying not to succumb to the corporate hype that killed punk rock in the first place. "I think [Offspring] shows that there's a real spirit of rock 'n' roll left. [The way Offspring does business] is almost like the way it was done in the '50s, where people used to record something in their garage and they could take it to a station and it would become a hit. It's the way things are supposed to be, or like you'd think they would be until you find out that it doesn't usually happen that way. But the fact that it still can happen is a real good sign for music."

All In The Family

Another Week, Another Ticketmaster Lawsuit

A \$185 million lawsuit was filed against Ticketmaster July 7th contending TM violated antitrust laws and charged exorbitant fees. The wannabe class action suit was filed in Los Angeles federal court on behalf of five ticket buyers. TM has succeeded in fighting similar lawsuits in California and New York and expects to do the same with suits pending in Georgia, New Jersey, Texas, Florida, Washington and Massachusetts. The number of suits against TM has caused some in the industry to start seeing the situation as something of a joke. Denver promoter Barry Fey quipped, "TM should institute a random drawing policy for people who want to sue them. You line up to draw a number at 8 a.m. and then the highest priority number can file suit starting at 9 a.m." Fey also said he's heard that when TM's Fred Rosen goes through customs and is asked what his occupation is, the reply is simply, defendant. Actually, we hear it may soon be plaintiff. Rosen and the TM empire may be ready

to strike back with their own legal counteroffensive against the attorneys and others behind this rash of legal hassles.

Guerinot Heads For The Back Nine

Jim Guerinot resigned from his position as senior VP/GM of A&M Records effective July 15th. Guerinot, who is an artist manager as well as a record exec, said he plans to get his golf game in the 80s, go surfing and set up his own business — in that order. Guerinot and Larry Weintraub's Rebel Waltz Management has Social Distortion, NOFX, and this week's cover artists, Offspring, as clients. Prior to joining A&M in 1988, Guerinot was with MCA Concerts and before that Avalon Attractions. He is setting up an office in Laguna Beach, Calif., where he will continue his association with A&M on an exclusive consulting basis. Weintraub, who is also an A&M exec, is expected to remain with the label.

Tornado Benefit Sucks Wind

A benefit concert for Alabama tornado victims had hopes of raising \$100,000 but instead left promoters with an estimated \$42,000 loss. Les Meekins, who helped to get the fund-raiser rolling, said, "I think I overestimated the people's concern for the disaster victims." Only 504 tickets were sold and the \$8,122 gross didn't come close to covering the \$25,000 advance guarantee they paid Merle Haggard to headline the event.

Short Items Of Note

David Geffen's personal services contract with MCA reportedly will expire in nine months and there is considerable speculation about what the incredibly rich mogul will do when he becomes a free agent. Geffen sold his namesake record company to MCA in 1990 at the height of the market for independent record companies. He has been sitting on several hundred million dollars and industry observers have been wondering for some time what he will spend it on and when. It appears unlikely he will stay with MCA unless Lew Wasserman offers him his chair..... A labor dispute at the Chateau Ste. Michelle winery in Woodinville, Wash., prompted Willie Nelson to cancel his July 16th concert there. A spokeswoman for Nelson said he didn't want to cross United Farm Workers' picket lines..... When she goes out on tour later this year, it will be as just Roseanne. After calling it quits with husband Tom, Roseanne Arnold has decided to drop her last name all together..... Cellar Door has

The Sumner County Probate Court denied a motion by two of the heirs to protect Twitty's personal and intellectual property. A request to set aside property for the widow's share was also denied. Twitty City has already been sold to Trinity Broadcasting Network for an undisclosed amount..... **George Michael** isn't giving up on getting out of his contract with Sony

The appeal makes a point of saying that CMT does not oppose the addition of the other country music channel and that CMT does not compete with Canadian services for advertising dollars..... **Nelson Riddle** won't be forgotten as the arranger of Nat King Cole's "Unforgettable." Riddle will finally get credit for the duet version of the song which brought together Cole's voice with daughter Natalie, according to Elektra Records. This comes after Riddle's widow, Naomi, filed a \$1 million lawsuit because Johnny Mandel was given all the credit for arranging the Grammy Award winning version of the song. Elektra said all future manufacturing runs and promotions for the song will now credit Riddle for his work as arranger..... Two former **Benedictine monks** say they are entitled to \$5 million for their work on the hot-selling CD of Gregorian chants. Ismael Fernandez de la Cuesta and Francisco Lara say they scored the

music on *The Best of Gregorian Chants* before they left the monastery more than ten years ago. At separate times, they both served as directors of the choir at the Santo Domingo de Silos Abbey monastery during the time frame the recordings were made. The unexpected success of the CD prompted the ex-monks to publish the scores and register the arrangements with the General Society of Spanish Authors. EMI-Odeon officials said the chants are in the public domain and are not protected by copyright. They said the chants are simply what the monks have sung for hundreds of years. The prexy of EMI Spain, the company that released the recordings, reportedly said that this proves when the smell of money is in the air, flies gather. The two-disc CD, released as *Chant* in the U.S., made it to the top of the Spanish music charts, the American classical charts and broke into the top 10 on the pop charts..... **Richie Havens** reportedly filed a \$50 million lawsuit against Time-Warner claiming it violated copyright and civil rights laws by using his Woodstock performance in the movie "Woodstock" without his permission. A lawyer for Time-Warner reportedly said the company has a contract signed by Havens..... **Bianca Jagger** filed an \$11 million lawsuit June 30th against the author and publisher of a book written about her former husband, Mick Jagger. She claims that Christopher Andersen's book, "Jagger Unauthorized," contains false and defamatory statements about her although she doesn't specify what they are.

Promoters And Dummies

Garden Bidding Party

Viacom Inc. chief executive Frank Biondi and chairman Sumner Redstone said the first round of bidding for its Madison Square Garden division was recently completed and a deal could be reached by the end of the year. Five prospective buyers apparently have thrown hats in the bidding ring for purchase of the Garden complex, Knicks, Rangers and the MSG cable network. The prospective buyers, according to the *New York Times*, include Liberty Media; Nike; a partnership of Cablevision and ITT Hartford Insurance; a partnership of The New York Times Company and Delaware North (which owns the Boston Garden); and Laurence Tisch, chairman of CBS Inc., who is reportedly acting as an individual investor. Viacom, which acquired the various businesses as part of its acquisition of Paramount Communications earlier this year, said the MSG division isn't one of its strategic businesses and its sale will help

reduce its huge debt. Biondi said Viacom will be able to get a price that reflects the values inherent in the assets but sources reportedly said the bids are expected to fall short of Viacom's \$1 billion price tag.

Antitrust Probe Into CD Technology

Sony Corp. and Phillips Electronics NV are the focus of a federal antitrust investigation into the manufacturing and marketing of compact discs. Sony and Phillips agreed in the 1970s to cross-license each others' patents on CD technology. The Justice Department reportedly sent out subpoenas to a dozen companies asking for details of their business relationships with Sony and Phillips. A Justice Department antitrust attorney confirmed the agency opened an investigation into the licensing practices of compact discs but declined to comment on whether Sony and Phillips, specifically, are under investigation.

Memories Don't Always Lead To Nirvana

Nirvana bass player Krist Novoselic said he would personally knock down a controversial statue of the late Kurt Cobain if it was displayed in the Washington town where both he and Cobain grew up. Sculptor Randi Hubbard, who has been working on the 600-pound, 5-foot-6 concrete statue, has decided not to display her work. Instead, she'll sell it and donate the money to a juvenile facility that treats mental illness and to a fund to build an amphitheatre in memory of Cobain. The Aberdeen City Council was originally behind the idea of showcasing the statue in a public park until the public got wind of it. Though some recognize the artistic value of the work, others see it as an object paying tribute to a man whose life of drugs and despair ended in suicide. Novoselic said Cobain would have hated the statue and it would only become, "a shrine for idolaters to prostrate themselves in front of and a beacon for reactionaries to shake their fists at while cursing." Meanwhile in Seattle, a judge issued an anti-harassment order against a 25-year-old man who is obsessed with Courtney Love. Love said Robert Sceeles went to her home around midnight June 21st and insisted on seeing her. "I do not care if I die tonight. I want to see Courtney," Sceeles told the security guard according to Love's petition to the court. He was driving a Porsche with "Nirvana" spray painted on it. He

Also, Love said in her court petition that Sceeles' parents told her by phone from Alaska that "their son had called them and said he would be the next lead singer of Nirvana and was going to marry me [Love]." The court order prohibits Sceeles from contacting Love or keeping her under surveillance. And on a related subject, Kristen Pfaff, the bass player with Love's band Hole, died of an accidental drug overdose, the King County medical examiner's office said July 12th. Pfaff, 27, died of "acute opiate intoxication," but the medical examiner said the tests did not determine if heroin was the type of opiate Pfaff had used.

The Rolling Stones Gathered The Green

In POLLSTAR's Mid-Year Business Analysis, it was stated that Barbra Streisand's \$16.5 million gross from her seven show run at Madison Square Garden would be a world record for gross concert ticket sales in one venue. Although its definitely a record for North America, it apparently was not a world record. CPI says the 10 shows the Rolling Stones did in February 1990 at the Tokyo Dome in Japan took in 4 billion yen from 457,220 fans, which at the time equated to a gross of about \$32.9 million. The Stones are currently in Canada practicing for the start of their "Voodoo Lounge" tour which kicks off August 1st in D.C. Aside from Toronto being homebase for tour promoter CPI, there is a good reason why the rehearsals aren't happening in the U.S. If the band spent more than 183 days in the country, the U.S. Internal Revenue Service could consider them residents rather than visitors for tax purposes. That would mean a tax bill from Uncle Sam for the income on their entire worldwide tour and the Glimmer Twins are too smart for that.

Wayne's World Gets A Bit Bigger

Blockbuster chairman Wayne Huizenga's Huizenga Holdings, Inc., has acquired a half interest in Leisure Management Int'l, the Houston-based facility management company. LMI operates the Miami Arena, Monroe Civic Center, Pyramid Arena, the new Nashville Arena, and The Summit among others. "HHI and its affiliates made significant investments in sports franchises and facility management is a natural extension of those investments," said HHI's prexy Richard Rochon. HHI and affiliates have interests in the Florida Marlins, the Florida Panthers, the Miami Dolphins and several public assembly facilities including Joe Robbie Stadium. Huizenga is planning to develop a 45,000 seat baseball stadium for the Marlins and a new arena for the Panthers. Those projects are part of Huizenga's proposed \$1.4 billion Blockbuster Park.

Michael And Lisa Marie

A judge said he can prove he performed the mysterious ceremony that supposedly married Michael Jackson and Lisa Marie Presley May 26th in the Dominican Republic. Immigration officials confirmed Jackson arrived in the Carribean nation on a private jet May 24th. However, Jackson's spokesperson, Lee Solters, adamantly denies that the marriage took place. But the *New York Post* reported that MJ and Lisa Marie are hidden away in a cozy love nest at the Trump Towers in Manhattan. Lisa Marie's spokeswoman said she has not heard from Elvis' daughter and does not know whether the rumors are true or not. Civil Court Judge Hugo Alvarez Perez said he is prepared to travel to the U.S. with records that prove he united the King of Pop and the

King's daughter in matrimony. There's no word on how Brooke Shields is taking the alleged news. Meanwhile, in California, the grand juries in Los Angeles and Santa Barbara that investigated allegations MJ molested a 13-year-old-boy, disbanded without bringing an indictment against the superstar. However, the case will remain open, authorities said.

I Fought The Law


Christopher Babbington, 22, of Chicago was sentenced to 14 years in prison for killing the road manager for **Boyz II Men**. Babbington was convicted June 2nd of second-degree murder in the May 1992 death of Roderick Rountree..... **Tracy Lawrence**

had two counts of aggravated assault against him dropped and instead was indicted on charges of reckless endangerment and illegal possession of a weapon July 12th. Lawrence is accused of following a carload of teenagers to a Tennessee home and firing a gun twice into the air. He is scheduled for arraignment July 21st..... **Don King** was charged July 14th with wire fraud for allegedly filing a fraudulent insurance claim after a 1991 boxing match was cancelled. The nine-count indictment alleges that King made a false claim for out-of-pocket expenses to Lloyd's Of London after a match between Julio Cesar Chavez and Harold Brazier was cancelled. King allegedly claimed those expense were non-refundable when they actually were and as proof, he submitted a contract to Lloyds which was different from the one actually signed by the boxers. If convicted on all charges, King faces a maximum sentence of 45 years in prison and up to \$2.25 million in fines. His arraignment is scheduled for July 21st..... **Percy Sledge** thanked Jesus and the U.S. District Judge who gave him the most lenient sentence under the law for charges of tax evasion. Sledge pleaded guilty in April for failing to report more than \$260,000 in income. He was sentenced July 1st to five years probation and ordered to pay more than \$95,000 in back taxes. He also will serve six months in a halfway house in Baton Rouge and participate in a substance abuse program. Sledge is still allowed to perform though. Judge John Parker said, "I want you to perform and earn a living. I want you to be able to support your family and pay your taxes."

Obituaries

Former Hawaii concert promoter and KPOI-FM DJ **Greg Mundy**, 39, died June 29th while boating with his family on Lake Tahoe. A friend of the family said Mundy dove into the water and never came up. The body has not been found. Mundy moved to California several years ago after his Island-based promotion company went bankrupt..... Former Damian Dame member, **Debra "Deah Dame" Hurd**, 36, was killed in a car accident June 27th in Georgia. Hurd lost control of her car during a thunderstorm and collided with a van..... Gospel singer **Marion Williams**, 66, died July 2nd in Philadelphia of vascular disease. She was the first singer to win a "genius" award from the MacArthur Foundation and in 1993, she was a winner of the Kennedy Center Honors where she sang for President Clinton.

Between The Dates

With the release of *Voodoo Lounge* last week, the upcoming **ROLLING STONES** tour has shifted the publicity machine to light speed. It seems that you can't open up a newspaper without seeing Keith Richards' friendly face staring out at you, nor turn on the radio without hearing "Love Is Strong," the first single off the album. Mark Fisher, who designed both the Steel Wheels stage and the stage for the current Pink Floyd tour, has come up with a set that has been described as bigger than the stage for either of those two tours. A tour spokesperson said the stage is a, "melding of modern 21 century concepts of a wired world with ancient superstitions."..... **WOODSTOCK '94** recently added The Band, Blind Melon, Primus, Salt N' Pepa, Traffic, and Youssou N'Dour to the bill. It's also now a four day event, with the major acts appearing on the last two days. The festival will officially open its gates at high noon on August 11th. The early start allows concert goers a chance to avoid the traffic jam and time to experience things like the "Surreal Field, a six-acre "interactive village." Featured will be Compact Disc Interactive (CD-i), Jimi Hendrix "On the Road Again," and Peter Gabriel's Mindblender. A multi-media theatre featuring Todd Rundgren performing in the "Todd Pod" — a one man show similar to his TR-i tour is also part of the event. And Apple Computer will produce the "Woodstock '94 Nation News," which will be broadcast to the audience on the main stage screens twice daily..... Yet another Woodstock festival? In addition to Woodstock '94 and Bethel '94 (if it happens) comes **FREEDOMFEST 1994**, a free concert spread over 12 days in August. The event, scheduled to start August 11th will take place on 80 acres of land in Sullivan County, about three miles from the Bethel site. Richard Pell, a kindergarten teacher and amateur musician is planning the concert. Pell said more than 150 musicians, many of them local, would appear at the show. Richie Havens, who appeared at the first Woodstock, and is scheduled to play at Bethel '94, will also appear at Freedomfest..... Calling the time off an "intermission," concert pianist **VAN CLIBURN** began his first tour in 16 years. But a dizzy spell forced Cliburn to cut short his July 11th performance at the Hollywood Bowl. He apologized to the audience and ended the program with four short pieces. The program ended on a light note as Johnny Mathis and producer David Foster placed a Stetson hat on Cliburn's head and led the audience in a chorus of "Happy Birthday." Cliburn turned 60 last Tuesday. Although the Hollywood Bowl performance was billed as the official start of the tour, the pianist performed at San Diego's Summer Pops Bowl on July 9th..... The first tour dates in two years for **AMY GRANT** are in this week's Route Book. She plans on playing Europe, Asia and Australia this fall. Expect a North America tour in early 95..... Even though most of the large summer tours opt for outdoor venues, **THE SPECTRUM** in Philadelphia has played host to three major tours that otherwise have mostly played the shed circuit. Janet Jackson, Depeche Mode, and the Eagles have all included the venue on their summer tour schedules. Maybe it's the air conditioning..... The current tour by **THE B-52's** includes the return of bandmember Cindy Wilson. A spokesperson said that Wilson, who hasn't toured with the band since 1990, is not planning on joining the band on future tours and is a "retired B girl."..... **BLIND MELON** has dropped the last two and a half weeks of its European tour. Singer Shannon Hoon is said to be feeling a bit drained after completing a month in rehab. The band is still scheduled to open for the Stones on some dates, and perform at Woodstock..... Political unrest in his home country of Mali has forced **ALI FARKA TOURE** to postpone his tour and return home to safeguard his family. The current instability in the Timbuktu region of the African nation is rooted in a land conflict between the country's ruling tribes and Tuareg nomads. Toure hopes to return to the U.S. later this year..... After 36 years as a famous showcase for jazz artists and stand-up comedians, the **VILLAGE GATE** in Greenwich Village has apparently lost its last chance at a comeback. A state appellate court recently upheld a foreclosure action enabling Chemical Bank to take over the building. Owner Art D'Lugoff, who filed for bankruptcy in 1991 and boarded up the club in January said he had already given up hope on reopening. The club opened in 1958 and was once the place to hear the best in jazz and blues in NYC. Dustin Hoffman once waited on tables, and Sam Shepard washed dishes there. Remarkable on how the music scene has changed D'Lugoff said, "But all things change, and all the giants are dead. All you got now is this grunge, hip-hop, disco. The Blue Note is presenting Kool & The Gang. If that's jazz, I'm the pope."..... And all Italia was still partying July 13th as the ground crews began ripping up the natural turf installed in Giants Stadium for the **WORLD CUP**. Seems there's a couple of **PINK FLOYD** shows to get ready for in four days.
