The Empire Strikes Back

Ticketmaster filed a \$306.8 million defamation suit in New York County State Supreme Court last week against the attorneys behind at least nine of the lawsuits brought against the ticketing giant around the country. TM alleges the lawyers intentionally interfered with its business and economic relationships and have seriously damaged its reputation. TM claims the attorneys, Carlos Lidsky, Stephen Rubin, Paul M. Wertz and Herbert Posner, used the media and abused the process of the courts in an attempt to suck money out of the computerized ticketing agency. TM alleges the purpose of each suit was to create public anti-Ticketmaster sentiment which was achieved when the lawyers supplied the legal complaints to the media. A number of media outlets are being subpoenaed as part of TM's legal counterattack. TM is attempting to show that the lawyers' real intent was something other than a typical lawsuit (such as an effort to extort money, for example). The laws in New York allow the possibility of defamation claims by defendants if they can prove that was the plaintiffs intent in filing the action. The process server reportedly had a bit of difficulty giving the subpoenas to Lidsky and Rubin. Lidsky denied he was the correct Carlos Lidsky when the server appeared at his office. And when the server went to Rubins' house for the third time, several buckets of water were poured on her head from a second story window, allegedly by Rubin or someone associated with his family. Lidsky said the TM action was just "an attempt to distract us," and "we're not remotely concerned."

Bernstein & Bethel

Bethel '94, scheduled to be held at the site of the 1969 Woodstock festival, got the go-ahead from the New York state Department of Health July 15th. Also, the Bethel Town Board approved a mass gathering permit for the Woodstock tribute event. Those two hurdles essentially clear the way for promoter Sid Bernstein and his financial partner, Shea Entertainment. The two day event, August 13-14, hopes to draw 50,000. Tickets priced at the catchy amount of \$94.69 were to have gone on sale July 23rd, but the start of ticket sales was delayed to July 25th for undisclosed reasons. There will also be special "Garden Tent Passes" available for \$275 for one day and \$475 for two days that include VIP parking and shuttle service, food, beverage and tent access. Among the acts scheduled to appear are Judy Collins, Fleetwood Mac, Canned Heat, John Sebastian, Melanie,

Eric Burdon, Richie Havens, Tom Paxton, Country Joe, Mountain, and Blood, Sweat and Tears. Over 500 buses, a team of 300 on-site medical professionals, a medivac helicopter, 500 private security personnel and 225 state troopers will come together to help make the festival go smoothly. Bethel '94 is trying to keep with the festival's original vibe by asking concert-goers to donate four items of clothing and four items of non-perishable food when they arrive at the event. Additionally, concert-goers will be given either a seed, sapling or acorn and asked to participate in a pledge of renewal, consistent with the theme of the event. Bethel '94 will be the first major concert on the original site, formerly known as Max Yasgur's farm, in 25 years. Bernstein has brought in Delsener-Slater Enterprises as the technical producer of the festival, although they have kept a relatively low profile so far. Assuming it indeed happens, Bethel '94 will take place about 60 miles south of the much larger Woodstock '94 show that same weekend in Saugerties, N.Y.

Live Voodoo At The RPM

The Rolling Stones treated 1,000 fans to an inexpensive (\$3.60) surprise concert July 19th at the RPM nightclub in Toronto. Mick Jagger and mates have been rehearsing for their upcoming tour around Toronto for the past several weeks. The 90-minute warm-up gig was a well-kept secret until mid-morning the day of the show. An unassuming announcement went up on the club's marquee that simply said, "Rolling Stones, Live Tonight, 8:30 p.m." Toronto radio stations quickly picked up on the news and the club soon had lines around the block. The Stones tour officially kicks off August 1st at Washington's RFK Stadium. And the Rolling Stones new release, *Voodoo Lounge*, sold nearly 154,000 units in its first week. Normally, that might be good enough to debut at number one. Unfortunately for Virgin Records and the Glimmer Twins, this week it was less than half the sales needed to unseat Disney's *The Lion King* soundtrack from its top slot on the Soundscan retail chart.

ROLLINS BAND

Henry Rollins' career is a multitudinous conglomeration of art and business. If any performing artist could be designated an industrialist, it would be Henry Rollins. Rollins started his career as, what some would call, the voice and soul of the preeminent punk rock band, Black Flag. When Black Flag ended in 1986, Rollins formed the Rollins Band. Simultaneously, he established a solo career, touring with his spoken word material. But Rollins is substantially more than the front man of a rock band and a poet. He is an author, publisher, actor, producer and entrepreneur.

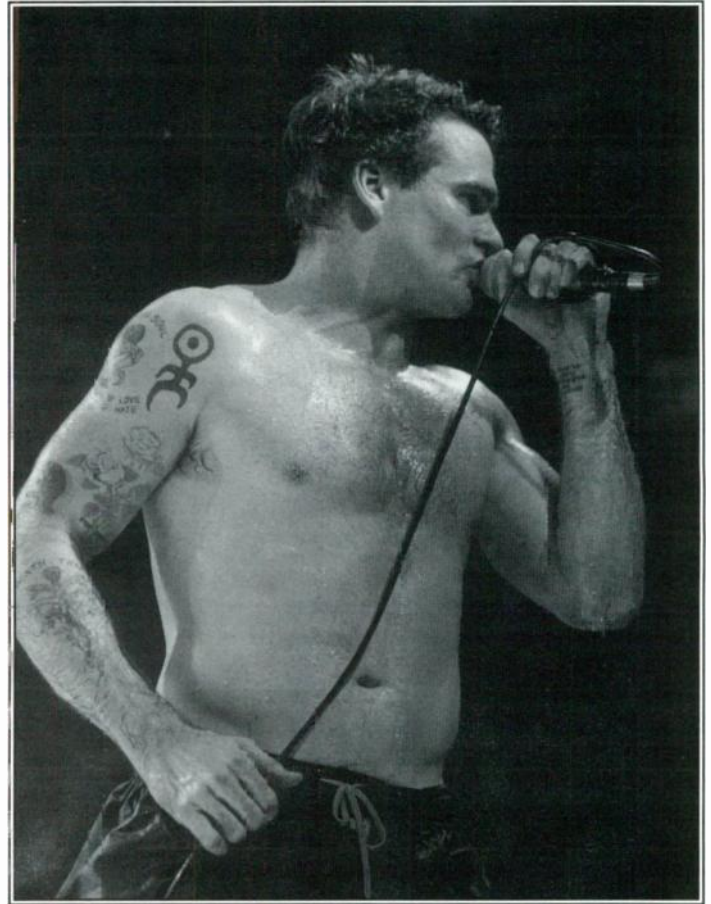
But performing live with the Rollins Band is one of Henry's favorite business and artistic endeavors. "The live experience, there's really nothing like it," Rollins said. "I've been doing it for 13 years [and] I haven't gotten tired of it yet. I get tired but not tired of it. It's just an amazing way to spend two hours a night," he said. "It makes life really matter. Stage time is heightened. You get 70 seconds per minute. It's incredibly intense."

For Rollins, the intensity of performing is not about interacting with the audience, it is very personal. "I don't get into the singing along with the crowd thing. I like the fact that people are there but for what we do, it takes a high amount of concentration. We like to get down to work and play as excellently as we can. And that's what we try and do." Completing the Rollins Band line-up is Sim Cain, Theo Van Rock, Melvin Gibbs and Chris Haskett.

Rollins Band is in the middle of an 18-month world tour. The band has already stopped in Brazil, Japan, Australia, New Zealand, England, Ireland, America, Canada, Scandinavia and the continent of Europe. And U.S. dates with Helmet have just gotten underway. After touring with Helmet, the band will go back to Europe then return to the U.S. to hit the road again in the fall. Between all those dates, Rollins Band will take a short break to play at Woodstock '94.

"We rarely say no to gigs," Rollins said about accepting the offer to play Woodstock. "We like gigs — this is what we do. We're a touring band. We had a few days off on the Helmet tour [and] they said, 'You want to play with Aerosmith and all these bands?' We're like, 'Hell yeah. Joe Perry needs to get his ass blown off stage by us just like anybody else. We don't want to let him miss out on this opportunity. As an American, he's entitled to have his ass kicked by us,'" Rollins said. Listening to Rollins talk, one assumes his tongue is firmly in cheek yet there is an air of seriousness to his comments. When Rollins Band played on the first Lollapalooza tour, many said the band did indeed blow others off the stage. Rollins continued with his enthusiasm about playing at Woodstock. "I don't want anyone who's able, to miss out on getting dusted by the mighty Rollins Band," he said. "I want to give [all] these bands an opportunity to step up and be KOed by the opening band. I wouldn't deprive anybody — I'm trying not to be selfish in my old age." But in all seriousness, Rollins said, "Bands [would] be cutting off precious members of their bodies to be on this thing. It's great money. It's a great day out."

Rollins, who is in his early-30s, is the antithesis of the twentysomething slacker generation stereotype. He said, "I had a lot of people at my high school, which is a prep school, saying, 'You'll never be anything. You're just an idiot.' So I went into



the world going, 'Well I'm not [an idiot] and I'm gonna show you something.' So I just went into things, flat out, with the understanding that if you want to achieve anything, you have to work very hard all the time. This is what I was taught."

That strong work ethic keeps Rollins very busy. Rollins Band recently released a new album, *Weight*, on Imago Records. Rollins made his big-screen debut in March, co-starring with Charlie Sheen in "The Chase." And he just wrapped his second movie, co-starring with Keanu Reeves, Dolph Lundgren and Ice-T and he is helping with the soundtrack for that film. Rollins recently completed the text for a book on his years with Black Flag. The book, based on tour diaries, will be published by Time-Warner. Rollins has set-up a publishing company and he also started a reissue label with Rick Rubin of American Recordings. Rollins also develops other bands and authors. "So I'm kind of running with a few different things," Rollins said. Additionally, Rollins pens his own bios.

With such a full schedule, you would think his life is fascinating but Rollins would disagree. "I think it's pretty boring...because I get up in the morning and I run downstairs as early as I can and I go right to the computer and start getting on the phone. When I'm on the road, life is a bit more interesting but during the day it's business. And the book business is boring. It's not like, 'The exciting world of publishing.' It's like, 'Okay, let's read this fucking book again for the 35th time and try and make sure all the commas are right.'"

Though Rollins has a strong hand in every aspect of his career, he respects his business team, managers Gail Perry (Gail Perry Esq.) and Richard Bishop (Three Artist Management), and booking agent Don Muller at William Morris.

Rhone Rises

Sylvia Rhone was promoted to chairman of Warner Music Group's newly formed Elektra/EastWest division. Rhone, the first African American woman to be appointed head of a major label, has been chairman/CEO of EastWest Records since 1991. In her new position, Rhone, will be responsible for the recording businesses of Elektra, Asylum, EastWest and their associated labels. Presumably, that means EastWest, which had been a part of the Atlantic family of labels, will now combine operations with Elektra Entertainment, which had been a free-standing division within the Warner Music Group. No other details were available at press time.

Steroid Frankensteins

Two of three counts of steroid distribution were dismissed last week in the trial of World Wrestling Federation head Vince McMahon of Titan Sports. In front of a packed courtroom in Uniondale, N.Y., Hulk Hogan admitted to routinely using steroids during a 13-year period between 1976 and 1989. Hogan, using his real name of Terry Bollea, testified for the prosecution, which claimed McMahon "urged and cajoled wrestlers to take steroids." Testifying under immunity (steroid use was legal if obtained through a doctor but became illegal in 1991 for all but therapeutic uses), Hogan said he had discussed steroid use with McMahon but said McMahon never directly told him to take the drugs. Hogan said he would sometimes order the drugs through McMahon's personal secretary, Emily Feinberg, at the WWF's Connecticut headquarters. "I would go by the office and pick up the steroids along with my paycheck and fan mail," Hogan said on the stand. Another wrestler, Kevin Wacholz — a.k.a. the convict-villain "Nailz" — testified that McMahon told him in January, 1992, "I strongly suggest you go on the gas [steroids]." Wrestler Ravishing Rick Rude also testified that McMahon hinted indirectly about using steroids but never came out and told him to take them. About 80 percent of the wrestlers in the WWF used steroids in the 80s, Hogan testified. "I used steroids to get big," to heal injuries and "to keep going," Hogan said. "The

schedule was tough on the road. It kind of gave you an edge." The defense tried to show the court that the wrestlers' steroid use was a personal choice. If convicted on the remaining charge, one count of conspiracy to distribute steroids, McMahon could be sentenced to up to five years in prison. The case was expected to go to the jury late last week.

Chicken Little Plays Seattle

Four ceiling insulation tiles fell from the roof of The Kingdome in Seattle July 19th forcing at least six upcoming Mariners' baseball games to be moved and rescheduled. The first of the 15-pound tiles to fall dropped nearly 180 feet into the stands about 4:30 p.m. last Tuesday while players were doing warm-up stretches but before the gates were opened to fans. About an hour later, three more fell. No one was hurt but a facility spokesperson said an expected \$300,000 to \$500,000 in revenue was lost because of event postponements. The reason the tiles fell was not immediately known. No further problems were spotted and officials called in forensic engineers to try and pinpoint the exact cause of the problem. The results of the engineers' report should be available later this week.

A Remote Electronic Ticket Delivery System

An ambitious new start-up company has announced plans for a remote document delivery network that has the potential to impact the concert business. South San Francisco-based Docunet and its huge corporate partners, Olivetti, Bell Atlantic, Chemical Bank and EDS, hope to see their network of ATM-like delivery machines start to go online this fall. The machines would allow for immediate delivery of documents like airline tickets with the insertion of a charge or debit card. Ron Colnett, director of marketing for Docunet, said the company is currently negotiating with an unspecified party to add concert and other event tickets to the Docunet system. The first place event ticketing will be visible will be in the Washington D.C.-Virginia area where the first machines are being installed. Docunet hopes to be an open network that will serve as an alternate delivery system for all document or ticket distributors. "We would take all ticket distributors if they wanted to be on our network," he said.

Jill Collins reacted to the news by telling the press, the singer was just going through a "midlife crisis." The singer said he was serious about the divorce.... The first time he saw her, she was crying on TV. It was love at first sight. And now it's reported that Frank Sinatra Jr. and reputed Hollywood madame Heidi Fleiss are dating. Ol' Blue Eyes' son even wears a jacket embroidered with "I Love Heidi." As for marriage, Fleiss only said, "I don't know what the future holds." One event her future is sure to hold though, is her upcoming trial on pandering and cocaine charges.... Larry Gatlin has good reason to change his tune from country to the blues. The singer had his

Grammy, his guitar and his clothes stolen in separate thefts, all in Minnesota. The Grammy for his '70s single "Broken Lady" was taken from a display case at Gatlin Brothers Music City nightclub in Bloomington. The clothes were taken from his hotel suite and his guitar, along with two others belonging to band members, was stolen from the Ordway Music Theater in St. Paul.... Neil Campbell has been named GM of B.C. Place Stadium in Vancouver. His duties will include overseeing marketing, operations and revenue enhancement. Previously, Campbell has managed Harbour Station in New Brunswick, the Northlands Coliseum in Alberta and the Kingdome in Seattle.

KISS This Bit Of The Past

Gene Simmons and Paul Stanley of KISS joined with Troy, Mich., police to crash the First Annual Detroit KISS Convention and Hard Rock Flea Market July 17th. They were there to reclaim old KISS costumes that were stolen from a New York warehouse sometime during the past two years. Simmons and Stanley were also in an Oakland County Circuit Court the next day to make their case. The court papers say the defendants, who staged the flea market, used the costumes as props to lure fans to the event which reportedly sold 1,500 tickets at \$10 each. Simmons said the costumes are very important to the band members. "They are part of our history, our personal memorabilia," he said. The attorney representing KISS said no criminal charges would be sought. "These guys just want their stuff back. They don't want to see anyone in jail."

Legal Grievs

The Canadian Broadcasting Corp. has been accused of violating copyright law and ethical standards for airing a portion of a song after being denied permission three times. Gordon Lightfoot's biggest hit, "The Wreck of the Edmund Fitzgerald," was used in a Prime Time report about the ore carrier that sank in Lake Superior in 1975. A CBC spokesman said the network was allowed to use up to 12 seconds (which it did) of the song for its purpose according to the "fair dealing" provision in the copyright law.... A Burbank judge rejected a lawsuit and restraining order July 15th against David Lee Roth by a woman who claims Roth

The copyright infringement suit, filed in federal court in Milwaukee, also names Jim Steinman, who is credited with writing the song, as co-defendant. Lawyers for Jordan Sage said their client wrote the song in 1989 and sent it to publishers working with Meat Loaf.

Rick James Goes To Prison

Rick James failed in his last-ditch attempt to re-enter a drug rehab program. Instead, he was ordered to begin serving his five year and four month prison sentence in connection with violent attacks against two women. The judge said July 18th that James was lucky not to be headed to prison for the rest of his life and called the short sentence "a gift". James was convicted last year of assaulting two women. And the jury was hung on a torture charge in connection with the assaults. But before prosecutors could retry James on the torture charge, allegations surfaced that a district attorney's investigator had furnished drugs to a jailed witness who testified against James. Because of the alleged misconduct, James was allowed to plead no contest to assault charges stemming from one of the attacks. The terms of the arrangement called for James to receive a shorter sentence and prosecutors said they would not oppose his entry into the Civil Addict Program at the California Corrections Rehabilitation Center in Norco. But a few months after he entered the program, he was expelled because the warden there decided he did not qualify due to the violent nature of his crimes.

Michael & Lisa Marie, Part Deux

Speculation about Michael Jackson's personal life continues as the bizarre rumor of his marriage to Lisa Marie Presley persists. Last week, a man called Donald Trump's office saying he was

Elvis and he wanted to talk to Michael. And celebrity reporters in New York confirm that the curious couple have taken up residency at a duplex in Trump Tower. Claudia Cohen reportedly said MJ has been living in the duplex for a few months and Lisa Marie arrived about two weeks ago with her children. The Donald said MJ and Lisa Marie seem to get along very well but he wouldn't comment about the rumors of them living together downstairs from his triplex. But rumors and speculation continue with reports ranging from MJ falling under the influence of the Church of Scientology to allegations that the wedding is a ruse simply to counter child molestation allegations. Others claim the superstar is trying to create interest in his upcoming album. The judge in the Dominican Republic who claims to have married the pair said he was willing to take a lie-detector test to prove his story. But assuming the two are married, the biggest question remains — why?

Bob Dylan Czechs Out Poland

Bob Dylan chatted with Czech President Vaclav Havel prior to performing in Prague for the first time earlier this month. This adds Dylan to the list of performers who have stopped in Prague since the 1989 overthrow of communism there. That list includes the Rolling Stones and Paul Simon, who have performed in the Czech capital. Clouds of cigarette and marijuana smoke filled the 100-degree fahrenheit air at the ice hockey arena as Dylan captivated the ecstatic crowd of 15,000. Continuing on his Eastern European tour, Dylan was forced to stop his outdoor concert in Krakow, Poland because of a heavy rainstorm. After the first three songs, Dylan and his band abandoned their electric instruments in favor of safer acoustic ones. But organizers ultimately decided to stop the concert for safety reasons about 50 minutes after Dylan took the stage at Cracovia Stadium.

Global WAR! Declared

From the opening ceremonies of the 15th annual New Music Seminar July 20th, MTV's Tabitha Soren announced plans for a 24-hour concert to be held next July in at least 17 countries. A talent coordinator for the Philadelphia half of Live Aid, Colin Medlock, has founded World Aid Relief! (WAR!), a New York-

The number of countries involved is expected to grow.

The Grateful Dead spent the afternoon of July 18th at an extended luncheon in the U.S. Senate dining room. Jerry Garcia, Bob Weir, Phil Lesh and Mickey Hart were among the guests of Dead fan Sen. Patrick Leahy, D-Vt., who had sat on the stage at the band's D.C. concert the previous weekend. Many people stopped by to say "hi" to the Dead but nothing turned heads more than when Strom Thurmond, the 92-year-old Republican senator



The 14 pink slips went to staffers in the sales, promotion, financial services and marketing departments.

Musicians On Sick Call

Jazz keyboardist and composer **Joe Sample** is undergoing cardiac rehabilitation in L.A. after suffering a heart attack June 27th. He has been advised by his physician to cancel all performances for the next four months. He will be replaced by George Duke for many already scheduled dates. Sample's latest Warner Bros. album, *Did You Feel That?* is currently scheduled for release in late August..... **Kitty Wells** was taken to a hospital and diagnosed with a bleeding ulcer after she became dizzy during a performance at a country fair in Brookfield, N.Y., July 15th. Wells' granddaughter, Kitty Ervin, said the 74-year-old country singer can be treated with medication and diet but the seriousness of the ulcer has not been determined. Wells returned to her home July 17th.

Between The Dates

Make it three more days of peace and music for **WOODSTOCK '94**. The event will now start on Friday, August 12th with Candlebox, Collective Soul, Sheryl Crow, Jackyl, James, King's X, Live, and the Violent Femmes. So far, more than 130,000 tickets at \$135 apiece have been sold for the concert..... It's been a rough tour for **WHITNEY HOUSTON**. The singer has already suffered a miscarriage, and now she has had to postpone several dates due to a sore throat. She had to postpone an Anaheim concert last week, but was able to perform a short medley of songs at the World Cup soccer finals at the Rose Bowl. Houston has rescheduled 8 shows. See Route Book for the updates..... **ALICE IN CHAINS** was set to be the middle act for the second leg of the Metallica tour, but bowed out 48 hours before the first show in Vancouver. Susan Silver Management issued a statement saying that "due to health problems within the band" the group was not only pulling out of the Metallica tour, but dropping off the Woodstock '94 lineup as well. And the band, "hopes to resolve the situation in privacy."..... It was a reunion of Jersey guys as **BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN** joined his old pals Southside Johnny & The Asbury Jukes during their set at Asbury Park's Stone Pony. The Boss brought a few friends — wife Patti Scialfa, Jon Bon Jovi and Max Weinberg. Together, they played Sam Cooke's "Havin' A Party" and Tom Waits' "Jersey Girl." It was the legendary nightclub's 20th anniversary. When the Stone Pony opened back in 1974, The Jukes were the house band, and Bruce was a regular..... Town officials that have shuddered at the thought of their communities playing host to **THE GRATEFUL DEAD** might want to listen to what the folks in Highgate, Vermont have to say about the band and its fans. It was a first-time appearance for the Dead, which performed at the local airport, and the locals were delighted with the concert and the 100,000 or so people it attracted. The concert-goers were seen as polite and well-behaved. They picked up their trash and asked politely to park or use a bathroom. Both the state police and the Franklin County Sheriff's office said there were only a few arrests for minor offenses. A local medical center treated a few concert-goers, mostly for minor substance abuse problems. Many locals profited from the show by snagging a few bucks by picking up empty bottles and cans to redeem for the deposit. However, two wannabe entrepreneurs didn't do as well with a hamburger near the stage. "These Deadheads don't eat meat," operator Connie Comstock observed..... Australian promoters have been pleasantly surprised by the volume of ticket sales for the debut of what was considered a relatively unknown American country music artist — **GARTH BROOKS**. In Brisbane, more than 17,000 tickets were reportedly sold in less than 30 minutes for promoter Michael Coppel. In all, 40,000 tickets were sold in four hours for shows in Brisbane, Melbourne, Sydney, and Newcastle, prompting promoters to schedule two additional shows. Until a few months ago, few Aussies had heard of Brooks..... " Mick Jagger and The Rolling Stones wanted me to do their tour also, but I think I'd rather do The Beatles." Along with that statement to Reuters, **LITTLE RICHARD** announced that the three remaining Beatles were getting back together for a tour. Not only was this news to the music world, but evidently it was a surprise for Paul McCartney. McCartney spokesperson Geoff Baker had a two word response, "No way." Elizabeth Freund of McCartney's P.R. reps, Dera and Associates said, "First and foremost, they're not back together. Secondly, they're not touring." One thing is certain — Little Richard's Beatles' reunion remarks was the most press he's had in years..... It's been a big year for artists and music services to go "online." MTV has a section on America Online, and is sending "cyberjocks" out to cover Lollapalooza. Aerosmith released a song via Compuserve, and now the **ROLLING STONES** are plugging into the net. It was announced last week that Delphi Internet Services will be the official online service for the upcoming **Voodoo Lounge** tour. Delphi, the 5th largest online service, and of the major services, the only full-access Internet provider, is offering Rolling Stones news, a section for fans to chat, and a contest which will send the winners to opening night at RFK Stadium. Delphi is also providing what may well be the best Stones database available online anywhere, including articles on rare material, set lists, and audio and video files which will be available for downloading. Delphi's Jimmy Guterman said they also plan to offer a similar set-up for Internet surfers..... **NINE INCH NAILS** fans will have to travel either to Atlanta or Toronto if they want to see the band in action this summer. Trent Reznor & Company play at Atlanta's Fox Theatre on July 30th, and on August 6th the band will be the special guest at a Soundgarden concert in Toronto. Nails had planned a summer tour but decided to wait for fall.
