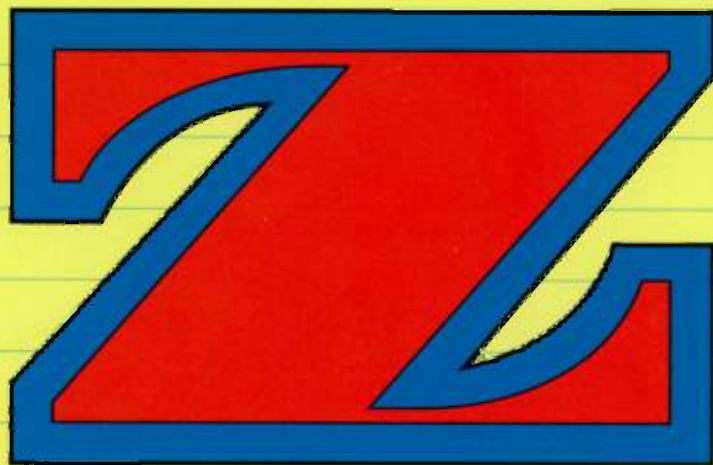

Diamond Set To Shine On His Own

Marty Diamond has departed International Talent Group to form his own agency, Little Big Man Booking. Diamond said he made the move in order to become more closely involved with his clients' career development. "This was the logical progression for me. I needed an environment where I could grow with my artists, that was free from the corporate mentality and sympathetic to artistry," Diamond said. He added that the music business is badly in need of a spirited creative infusion because the typical way of doing business no longer works as the rules of the game continue to change dramatically. "The competition is much stiffer now and the status quo just doesn't cut it," Diamond said. He leaves his position at ITG in New York on amicable terms and opens his new agency with the apparent full support of the artists for whom he had been responsible. Sarah McLachlan said of Diamond, "I love this man! He's a pit bull when he needs to be and a cuddly pet the rest of the time. And he loves music. That's the most refreshing thing in this industry!" Drummed Out Of Pearl Jam

Dave Abbruzzese told ABC Radio August 26th that he was fired from Pearl Jam and did not leave "amicably" as Kelly Curtis, the band's manager, reported. "For reasons that I don't completely understand, the other members of the band decided that it was necessary to fire me," the drummer said during the network radio interview. "I was not aware of their decision, not involved with it, nor do I agree with it. But I accept it and I'm proud to have been a part of what Pearl Jam was." Pearl Jam reportedly won't be naming a permanent replacement anytime soon although the band is still expected to honor its commitment to play Neil Young's annual Bridge School Benefit October 1st.

BIHAZARD

Meaning hazardous to life, the biohazard symbol perfectly represents Biohazard the band and like the symbol, the band appears menacing and deals with dangerously frightening aspects of life. But Biohazard isn't a threat. It exists as a warning. Biohazard's Evan Seinfeld told POLLSTAR, "We use the symbol to represent everything we sing about...drugs, gangs, crack, AIDS, violence, peer pressure, anxiety, stress, O.J. Simpson, the new strain of cancer, the threat of global nuclear war, skinheads, gang bangers, drive by shootings, getting hit by a car, the dissipating ozone layer or whatever it may be. All that stuff is biohazard and our logo stands for all that. Symbols are very powerful. We all got it tattooed on ourselves." Fans also brand themselves with the logo as does the band's manager, Scott Coning of Rush Management. Coning also sports DFL which represents the credo Biohazard lives by — down for life — loyalty and dedication to each other, their band, friends and family. "People who believe in you from the beginning, we call them DFL. Our manager went out and got the tattoo DFL, his first tattoo. And he put it with the Biohazard symbol to prove to us that he was down for life," Seinfeld said.

Biohazard's allegiance isn't subtle. Right up front, the band declares, "Biohazard is and will always be: Billy Graziadei (vocals, guitars, piano), Bobby Hambel (lead and acoustic guitars), Danny Schuler (drums and percussion), and Evan Seinfeld (vocals, bass)." Seinfeld said, "What's made us what we are is the four of us. It's not like one guy who does everything and three guys who follow. We all play an equal part in the band." But Biohazard doesn't view itself as just a band. "It's a way of life. We don't talk about one thing on stage and then live a totally different life. All of our emotion, our spirituality is pouring out of us in music."

Biohazard recently put its emotion in the Warner Bros. release, *State Of The World Address*, which the band says is a wake-up call to let people know what life's all about on the hard side. Born, raised and based in Brooklyn, Biohazard delivers a look into the ominous side with anger, aggression and heart. And that delivery carries over to the band's live performances.

Touring is very important to Biohazard. "It's the concrete reality of finally making contact with your fans. They can buy your album. They can love you. They can hear you on the radio and they can see you on TV. But when you sing the song and you look somebody right in the eye, it's concrete and you can not replace it with anything else. That's why touring will never die." Seinfeld said touring is a bit of a hassle with all the "bullshit politics that go down about packaging of bands" but worth it. While touring, Biohazard will squeeze in a benefit show on its day off and try to see some other bands even it means rushing there between soundcheck and performing. "We love concerts. We're a real band and this is our life."

At a Biohazard concert, fans can expect to participate in something positive. "It's therapeutic. We recognize all the negativity and we let out all of our angst," Seinfeld said. "We walk out of the show and we feel good and they feel good and everyone [feels] empowered and high on an adrenaline rush. Part of a Biohazard show, typically, is so the kids can get on stage and stage dive and slam dance."

Encouraging audience participation has caused the band some trouble. In June, Biohazard got the plug pulled on a performance at the Castle Donington Monsters Of Rock festival in England.

"They put a barricade 40 feet from the stage and they treated people like cattle. The kids were so far back from us we just said, 'Everybody come forward over the barricade. Share our stage.' We humble ourselves to the audience. We treat the audience as our peers. If you treat your audience like fans, then you're placing yourself on a pedestal as a rock star or something and we're not. Our music is all about releasing all your negative energy in a positive way. And we wanted to have a regular Biohazard show. It doesn't matter if there's 40 people or 400 or 40,000, people can still stage dive and slam dance there. But people are so freaked out and paranoid because two people died at the Guns 'N Roses show a few years back. When one of the kids jumped on stage, they panicked. They pulled the plug on us. So I guess we're not true monsters of rock. I guess we're crusaders of the '90s."

The band's attitude sometimes causes conflicts with promoters and Biohazard is often told it cannot encourage kids to stage dive. The band feels that request is a form of censorship and it doesn't usually abide by it. But the band realizes it can't have a free-for-all every night because people do get hurt. But Seinfeld said asking kids not to slam dance is like asking football fans not to cheer. "This is what the kids want to do and these promoters are trying to put restraints on the kids but still want their money. This is supposed to be America, the land of the free and the home of the brave. It's more like the land of the restricted and the land of the censored and the repressed." Seinfeld said the band has often been told it will never be asked back to a club but it always is. "These promoters are getting fat rich because we sell out their fuckin' clubs...so they end up inviting you back anyway."

But Biohazard doesn't face a typical problem — not being paid. Seinfeld said they have a three part plan to prevent that from happening — "a) have a trustworthy tour accountant, b) have a very good agent and c) keep the fear of God into local promoters." How does Biohazard instill that fear? "Let them see you in person. It might not work for Green Day but it works for Biohazard. You know, popping into the offices after the show all shirtless and sweaty saying, 'I hope you liked the show' — a 'we know who you are,' kind of thing.... Nobody's ever not paid Biohazard."

Biohazard won't play a concert unless it is open to all ages. "As far as I'm concerned, that's prejudiced. It might as well say 'no blacks' or 'no whites,' because a kid who's 15 or 16 or 18 has just as much right to hear music as a kid who's 21." But Biohazard doesn't live in an idealistic dream land. They recently opened arena dates for Pantera and Sepultura and respected the fact that those dates were not "their shows" so they played by the rules.

Biohazard is supporting House Of Pain and will play Foundations Forum '94 this week. The band did over 220 shows last year and plans on doing at least 300 this year. Biohazard's agent is Allison Hamamura at William Morris Agency for North America and Ian Sales at ICM/Fair Warning worldwide.

The Garden's New Owners

Cablevision Systems Inc. and ITT Corp. have agreed to buy Madison Square Garden arena and the Paramount, New York's Knicks and Rangers, and the MSG Network from Viacom for \$1.075 billion it was announced August 28th. ITT initially will pitch in \$600 million for 85 percent equity and Cablevision will put up \$100 million, according to the *Wall Street Journal*. The partnership is reportedly financing the remaining \$400 million equally and within one year, Cablevision will become a 50-50 partner by giving ITT a stake in its Rainbow programming arm or \$227.5 million cash. The finalization of the sale comes amid reports that the merger between Viacom and Blockbuster Corp. may be back on. Blockbuster stockholders reportedly will vote on the merger by the end of September.

Irving On Ice

Now that hell has frozen over, Irving Azoff is putting Bugs Bunny on ice. Actually Azoff, the Tasmanian Devil of the music business, is part of a plan to mount a new national touring ice show, "Warner Bros. Family Entertainment on Ice," which will star various cartoon characters from the Bunny. The new family arena show will also include DC Comics characters like Batman when it makes its debut January 17th at the Great Western Forum in Los Angeles. The show plans to tour worldwide in major arenas 40 weeks each year for the next three years.

Woodstock Scrim, Taxes and Television

It seems the official Woodstock '94 condom, belt buckle, kaleidoscope, comic book, flying disc, temporary tattoo, leather jacket, cigarette lighter, sweatpants, bandanna and money clip weren't enough to satisfy some concert memorabilia collectors. Several men posing as PolyGram employees scammed their way into a warehouse and absconded with the three one-of-a-kind scrim that covered the huge speaker towers during the concert. The \$28,000 curtains decorated with the dove-and-guitar logo

were stored in a warehouse outside Lancaster, Pa., when they were stolen. Items of such distinction would be a bit difficult to discreetly display or sell. Woodstock Ventures had planned to sell the stage decorations and donate the money to charity. An inflatable globe also vanished during the concert as did about 10 murals from around the site. Several of the murals were later returned after promoters offered a reward. And New York state tax officials say the numbers given to them by vendors indicate that sales weren't up to pre-concert expectations. Approximately \$7 million worth of food and merchandise was reportedly sold at the event. The county had hoped for up to \$1 million in taxes but it appears the actual figure will be about \$300,000. Some vendors abandoned the scrip system which was set up ostensibly to keep a better accounting of revenues for sales tax purposes. For that reason, the actual sales figures from the site will likely never been known. Also, the pay-per-view numbers for Woodstock '94 were incorrectly reported in last week's issue at 24 million households. The possible viewing audience was 24 million but with a slightly more than 1 percent buy rate the number of homes watching was actually about 250,000. It was still the highest rated musical PPV event ever aired.

Legal Grievs

Composer Lalo Schifrin reportedly has sued "Three Tenors" concert promoter Tibor Rudas, alleging the promoter failed to give Schifrin arrangement credit for two medleys performed at the July 16th Dodger Stadium show. Schifrin is seeking a temporary restraining order to bar distribution of all concert items that do not carry his name. He is also seeking more than \$1 million in compensatory and punitive damages.... Wayne Newton has reached a tentative agreement with creditors to pay back debts estimated at \$20 million. The tentative deal came on the eve of a hearing where creditors were going ask that Newton's case be converted from Chapter 11 reorganization to Chapter 7 liquidation. Creditors have accused Newton of squandering money on his lavish lifestyle rather than paying his debts. The amended reorganization plan will be submitted to a bankruptcy judge in Reno.... A songwriter who was suing Billy Joel for \$10 million for copyright infringement dropped the suit

shortly after Joel gave his deposition in the case. Gary Zimmerman brought the suit claiming that parts of an unpublished song he wrote were used by Joel in the hits "We Didn't Start the Fire" and "River of Dreams." Zimmerman said he sent Joel the song in 1986 and never heard back from him. Joel said he had never heard Zimmerman's song. Lawyers on both sides said Zimmerman received no money..... **Bob Dylan** filed a trademark infringement lawsuit against Apple Computer August 24th. Dylan claims the computer giant is trading off his good name by promoting a software program called "Dylan." The suit also charges that Apple misrepresented facts to the U.S. Patent & Trademark office in an effort to register the program's name..... The battle between PolyGram-owned **Phonogram UK** and Rick Rubin's **American Recordings** looks like it will end up being fought out in U.S. courts. Justice Evans-Lombe of the High Court in London said the issues in both the U.S. and British cases are the same. And Phonogram agreed to a stay of the English proceedings pending judgment in the U.S. action. American launched a \$9 million suit against Phonogram for allegedly failing to honor a distribution agreement between the companies. And Phonogram is seeking to block American from dealing with any other distributor for its product outside the U.S. American claims Phonogram is nothing but a "shell" company and if it prevails there may not be any assets to attach.

Police Blotter

John Denver could spend up to a year in prison if he is convicted of drunk driving for the second time in a year. Denver was charged with DUI after he crashed his Porsche into a tree near his home in Aspen, Colo., August 21st. The Rocky Mountain High singer was charged with the same offense a year ago to the day but plea bargained it down to driving while impaired. Denver's publicist said the accident was a result of a mechanical problem with the car and the singer being tired from a long tour..... **James Brown** had another run-in with the law August 28th when, while driving his car through a four-way stop intersection, he hit a man on a bicycle. The 42 year-old man from Augusta, Ga., was knocked to the pavement but apparently refused medical treatment. A police spokesman said there is a conflict as to who was at fault. Brown was ticketed for failure to yield the right of way and is scheduled for a municipal court hearing October 3rd..... A man died from injuries sustained at an August 26th Ice Cube concert at the **Barrowlands** club in Scotland. Police would not comment on initial reports that the 26-year-old victim had been stabbed although they have launched a murder inquiry..... A bouncer for the now-closed **Blak and Bloo** club in Hollywood was acquitted of murder August 24th in the deaths of two men he shot outside the club in 1992. Leslie Abramson, attorney for Roman Paul Luisi, said her client shot the men in self-defense because he feared the men, who he had thrown out of the club earlier, had returned to kill him. Luisi had said he thought one of the men, Eric Pierce, was armed but a gun was never recovered, according to a report in the *L.A. Times*..... **Luther Campbell** and eight dancers pleaded innocent August 30th to charges stemming from a concert in Birmingham, Ala., August 19th. Campbell was charged with inciting to riot and the dancers were charged with lewd behavior..... **Dr. Dre**, aka Andre Young, pleaded no contest to drunk driving charges August 30th in Los Angeles and was sentenced to eight months

in jail for violating his probation from a 1993 battery conviction. The recent conviction stems from a January 10th chase through Beverly Hills and Westwood in Dre's '87 Ferrari. A breath test showed a blood-alcohol level of 0.16 percent which is twice the legal limit. The judge offered Dre the option of an eight-month jail sentence with the opportunity of time off for good behavior or five months in jail with no early release. The eight-month sentence means Dre could possibly only serve four months.

Change Of Venue

Expansion plans for the **Oakdale Theatre** Wallingford, Conn., received approval for state support funding from the State Bond Commission August 26th. The commission approved \$9.9 million in state bonding to assist in a \$21 million renovation project that will transform the 3,200-seat summer theatre into a 5,000-seat, year-round venue. Plans to break ground are scheduled for this fall. Oakdale's owners had previously been vocal opponents of the state's plans to assist Metropolitan Entertainment and the Nederlander organization in their plans to build a new year-round shed in Hartford — which potentially could have had adverse effects on Oakdale's venue.....



Insider News Briefs

Connecticut Dog track developer A. Robert Zeff is reportedly proposing a \$150 million entertainment complex to be built along Bridgeport's waterfront. "The Harbour" project would reportedly include a live performance theatre, 350-room hotel, 12-screen cinema, ice-skating rink, sports bar and virtual reality attraction. The site also includes room for a 200,000-square-foot casino but Zeff is putting that issue off pending state legislation regarding gambling. Zeff is working with Steven Wynn of the Mirage on the project. One hurdle Zeff faces is the fact that Donald Trump is proposing his own complex on the same land..... To mark what would be F. Scott Fitzgerald's 98th birthday, the **World Theater** in St. Paul, Minn., will be renamed The Fitzgerald Theater. Garrison Keillor, who will host the ceremonies September 24th, said, "St. Paul was wary of Fitzgerald's flamboyance and his alcoholism and perhaps it was embarrassed by his burn-out, but now it's time to celebrate him as the magnificent writer and brave man that he was.".... **Robin Flavin** has been named director of entertainment and sports at the Cervantes Convention Center in St. Louis. She was most recently a senior account exec at Contemporary Group's corporate entertainment division.

"City officials would rename their mother and put a logo on her forehead if they were paid enough money." But Mayor Steve Goldsmith said without the RCA money, the city could lose its professional sports teams. He also said the money could help refurbish Market Square Arena and aid in the financing of a new baseball park for the minor league Indianapolis Indians.

That list along with other court documents was put under seal and the matter is now closed..... **Whitney Houston's** company, Nippy Inc., is foreclosing on **Bobby Brown's** Atlanta mansion. A spokeswoman for Houston, Lois Smith, reportedly said the foreclosure is being done to help Houston's hubby clear up his financial woes. Smith also reportedly said no one lives in the mansion and the couple live together in New Jersey when they're not on the road. Apparently, Smith is upset with a "Hard Copy" report that aired August 23rd that implied Houston and Brown had marital and financial problems that led to the foreclosure.....

Short Items Of Note

Terry Cline resigned his position as executive VP of World Class Talent and is now working with Artist Concepts, Inc..... Liberty Records is planning to release a **Beatles tribute** album featuring a top line-up of country music artists. A portion of the proceeds from the album will go towards building an industry retirement home for artists, musicians and others directly involved with the country music industry. The retirement home was conceived by Liberty prexy Jimmy Bowen and has been adopted as an organizational project by CMA..... Geffen Records has decided not to release the **Nirvana** double live album previously scheduled for November. Instead, DGC will release the group's "MTV Unplugged" performance as a single album. Nirvana's Krist Novoselic said they will eventually release the other live disc but it won't be in the immediate future..... **"Barbra Streisand: The Concert"** on HBO was the highest-rated first run entertainment special in the cable channel's history. The concert had a 22.4 rating and a 31 share in homes capable of receiving HBO..... Panacea Entertainment's **Eric Gardner** has been deluged with calls regarding the recent announcements about a new movie starring **Tonya Harding**. It seems another Eric Gardner has written and is co-producing the film. Panacea's Gardner said, "I could only manage one project involving a convicted felon at a time," referring to the \$30 million feature based on the life of client Timothy Leary he's producing for Interscope.

Stalkers, Stalkers And More Stalkers

A New York corrections officer was arrested July 23rd for allegedly flashing a badge and gun to commandeer a car at Los Angeles International Airport. Justin Jay Juback was reportedly stalking MTV's **Daisy Fuentes** and had flown to California to find her. Juback was booked for investigation of kidnap for purpose of carjacking, but the district attorney's office reviewed the case and filed a felony charge of driving without owner's consent, or joyriding. Juback, 28, pleaded innocent July 26th in West Los Angeles Municipal Court. The LAPD Threat Management team was also "monitoring the case because of the possibility of a stalking" involving Fuentes, said a police source. Juback was held on \$20,000 bail..... Another celebrity stalker was taken in front of the judge recently. James Peter Dahl was sentenced to 30 days in jail and ordered to stay away from his victim, **Amy Grant**, her family and Williamson County, Tenn. Dahl pleaded no contest August 17th to trespassing on Grant's Riverstone Farm. Dahl, who was arrested August 8th when found concealed in a "low-lying area" on Grant's farm, will be

escorted to the county line upon his release, according to Assistant District Attorney Derek Smith..... The man arrested for stalking **Madonna** was sentenced to a year in jail August 23rd. Todd Lawrence pleaded no contest to misdemeanor charges of battery on a police officer and attempted entry into a building. He originally pleaded innocent but switched his plea just after jury selection in Hollywood Municipal Court was completed. Lawrence was accused of illegally scaling an eight foot wall to make his way on to Madonna's Hollywood estate. He apparently was uncooperative with police during the arrest which resulted in battery charges. A single count of resisting arrest was dismissed. A Deputy City Attorney said Lawrence refused to undergo psychiatric counseling and other conditions of probation that would have reduced his sentence. Earlier this month, Madonna received a three year restraining order barring Lawrence from coming within 100 yards of her or her property.

World Unity Festivities

Plans for a week-long World Unity Festival near the Grand Canyon, which was to feature performances by Jefferson Starship and Ritchie Havens, were scrapped but thousands of people have set up camp in the ponderosa pine forest 50 miles south of the Arizona landmark anyway. Lured by visions of global peace and advertisements of a big-name concert, the crowd started at 600 but had reached 3,500 by August 24th. Northern Arizona University officials canceled the Starship/Havens concert at the school's stadium and Kaibab National Forest officials refused to allow the concert or the planned vendors on federal land. The encampment, which officials reluctantly allowed to spring up 10 miles from the nearest paved road, lacks water, toilets or first-aid facilities. The Forest Service said they were concerned about sanitation because of the makeshift trench toilets. The group of tie-dye wearing campers, which included a gathering of the Rainbow Family, had originally set up camp on Native American Hopi land but was evicted for trespassing. Citizens of nearby Flagstaff say the group of unity seekers is causing area merchants problems by bumming cigarettes off tourists, stealing toilet paper and soap, and standing in line at Flagstaff Family Food Center for free daily meals.

Between The Dates

Tickets for **THE ROLLING STONES** are selling like... well... like tickets for the Stones should sell — at light speed. Boxoffice records were shattered at Atlanta's Georgia Dome as tickets for the November 16th performance sold out in less than 90 minutes prompting a second show to go on sale last Thursday. Oakland Stadium sold not one, but two shows in just over an hour, resulting in two more shows being added. A total of 100,000 tickets for the two Edmonton, Commonwealth Stadium shows were sold in 24 hours, with the first show selling out less than an hour after sales started. More Stones dates are expected to be announced in the near future. Check Route Book for the latest schedule. Meanwhile, things are shaping up for the band to play just north of Phoenix in Peoria, Arizona. The City Council unanimously approved a draft contract for two shows, tentatively scheduled for late October at Peoria Stadium, which is part of the brand new Peoria Sports Complex. Plans call for approximately 25,000 tickets to be sold for each show making it, with the exception of the warm-up gig at Toronto's R.P.M. club, the smallest North American venue the boys will play on the current tour. Earlier this year when the tour was being routed, Sun Devil Stadium was expected to be the Phoenix host for The Stones, but conflicts with existing sports schedules made the booking impossible.... An August 28th article in the *Los Angeles Times* reported that **ERIC CLAPTON** may do "three or four" shows at West Hollywood's House Of Blues. L.A. radio stations started quoting from the article, and by mid-week the club had been deluged with callers seeking more info about the shows. A spokesperson for the club would neither confirm or deny whether the venue was negotiating with Slowhand's people. Rumors have been circulating for the last few months that Clapton would play selected nightclubs throughout his fall tour, with the House Of Blues being one of the clubs most mentioned.... **OZZY OSBOURNE** is back in the news. The heavy metal legend has recorded a duet with Miss Piggy, and no, it wasn't "War Pigs." Ozzy and the famous porker sang "Born To Be Wild." The track appears on the upcoming *Kermis Unpigged* album which also includes Muppet duets with Don Henley, Linda Ronstadt, George Benson, Jimmy Buffett and Vince Gill.... It was jail house honky tonkin' time at the federal prison in McKean, Penn., as **WILLIE NELSON** performed for 500 inmates. Later, he signed autographs for fans waiting outside the chain-link fence, telling them he had performed for "a couple of buddies in there.".... The upcoming MTV Video Music Awards show can add another first to the event. Along with snagging The Rolling Stones for the telecast, the music video channel has inked **BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN** for a performance. Springsteen's video, "Streets Of Philadelphia," is nominated for two awards — best male video and best video from a film. The awards show is scheduled for September 8th.... Glenn Frey's stomach problems forced the postponement of three **EAGLES** concerts. Two shows for Charlotte and one for Knoxville were rescheduled for the next leg which begins September 13th in D.C.... The reunion story of the week features the Los Angeles all-girl band **THE GO-GO'S**. The group reunited to record some new tracks to be featured on a greatest hits album.... It was the old "musical differences" story that caused **DREAM THEATER** keyboard artist, Kevin Moore, to leave the group. Both Moore and the band say that the split was an amicable one. Though no permanent replacement has been chosen, Jordan Rudess will be performing with the band when they debut material from their upcoming album, *Awake*, at Foundations Forum.... U.K. News Report

(London) A restricted viewing lawsuit brought against promoter Harvey Goldsmith may spark off similar claims, said industry lawyers. Although no legal ground was broken in this case, the public interest generated by the issue has increased awareness of such consumer litigation. Goldsmith successfully defended the action against him brought by Cure fans unhappy with their view at a concert they attended two years ago. The plaintiffs alleged that a stack of speakers obscured their view of The Cure's concert at the NEC on November 18th 1992. They claimed that 60 percent of their view was blocked. The case went to court after they refused the offer of free tickets to any other show promoted by Harvey Goldsmith Entertainments at the venue. The court claim was for a full refund of the ticket price (£17.75) plus compensation of £200. The judge ruled in Goldsmith's favour on the basis that the plaintiffs did not lodge a complaint on the night of the concert. The plaintiffs say they brought the lawsuit as a matter of principle because they were not happy with their treatment when they did not lodge a complaint. One of the plaintiffs, Helen Bolton, explained the delayed action: "The show appeared to be sold out and we had no reason to believe we could be re-seated." Bolton adds that subsequent complaints to both venue and promoter were dismissed out of hand. A spokesman for Harvey Goldsmith Entertainments said, "At all shows, there is a complaints procedure. On this occasion the procedure was not taken advantage of." The legal action was regarded as a potentially important test case for restricted viewing litigation (the only successful lawsuit of this kind in the U.K., handled by the Plaintiff's lawyers, has been over seats at a football match). However, as the case was heard in arbitration under the British small claims court procedure, it is unlikely that a ruling in favour of the plaintiffs would have set a legal precedent.... Goldsmith has generated more entertainment news with the announcement of his latest sporting venture. He and his partner, Allied Entertainment's, Edward Simons, have joined forces with Planet Hollywood Entrepreneur Robert Earl to put basketball firmly on the map in Britain. The partnership has invested in the London team, the Leopards, which will be based at the SMG-managed London Arena which reopens this week with a Magic Johnson exhibition match. Goldsmith describes the new venture as a "melting pot of sport, fashion and music." Basketball already has several close allegiances with the music industry in the U.K. Also in the Budweiser Basketball League, promoter Marshall Arts' team, London Towers, has moved to a new home at Wembley and the record company team, The Sheffield Sharks (launched by Chrysalis and Mushroom Records in July) is based at the Sheffield Arena.... There is a new agent at MPI. Rupert Tracy, formerly with Mike Hinc at ATB, has joined the MPI team led by Phil Banfield and Steve Parker. He brings with him Stiff Little Fingers, All Mod Cons, The Nivens and Oosh. Other additions to the roster are Alannah Myles and Junior Brown who are represented by Phil Banfield, and Jan Johnston who has been signed by Steve Parker.... Wembley Stadium may host a live music event this year. The stadium has been chosen as the location for a major charity concert which is already being billed in some quarters as the "sequel to Live Aid". As plans for the Music Relief charity (in aid of Rwandan refugees) gather momentum, a live initiative is taking shape and October 29th is the suggested date for the Wembley concert. Music Relief organiser Christian Ulf-Hansen, at the London office of BMI says negotiations are underway and no performers can be named at this stage.... Reading Festival, the last of this summer's open air rock events, was a sell-out success. Headliners over the three days, Cypress Hill, Primal Scream, and the Red Hot Chili Peppers each played to around 40,000 people. Meanwhile, The Mean Fiddler Organisation, promoters of the festival, celebrated the fifth anniversary of its West London club venue, Subterranea, with a special rap and dance bill to complement the neighbourhood Notting Hill Carnival which took place the same weekend.

Australian News Report

(Sydney) Harry Connick, Jr. is set for a promotional tour in October. He will be performing what Sony describes as "private showcases" and promoting the release of his new album, She.... Garth Brooks has set merchandising records in several cities during his recent tour of Australia and New Zealand including Auckland, Brisbane and New Castle. In Brisbane Brooks did \$17 a head which is far and away the biggest merchandising per cap they've ever done there. (Reported by Stuart Coupe)
