Short Items Of Note

Former New Jersey Gov. Brendan Byrne used to have an arena in East Rutherford named after him. Then came the January 4th announcement by the N.J. Sports & Exposition Authority (which operates the Meadowlands Complex) that it had sold the naming rights to the Brendan Byrne Arena which will now be known as the **Continental Airlines Arena**. For \$6.7 million, the airline gets signage, a skybox and 20 tickets to all events at the venue through the year 2,000..... **BMG** has acquired the remaining 50 percent of **Windham Hill** making the label a wholly owned unit of the German conglomerate. Windham Hill president and co-founder Anne Robinson will continue to head the premier New Age label. **BMG** initially acquired 50 percent of Windham Hill in May 1992..... A stagehand working at **Radio City Music Hall** was critically injured December 21st while preparing for the evening performance of the venue's "Christmas Spectacular." Dennis Larkin, 52, fell into the orchestra pit. He was reportedly still in critical condition at press time..... A federal judge in San Diego has dismissed the \$5.4 million lawsuit filed by a political consultant against the city because there were women in the men's restroom at a Elton John - Billy Joel concert at **Jack Murphy Stadium**. Bob Glaser filed the suit following the .....

Life After The Dead

Grateful Dead members Bob Weir, Mickey Hart and Vince Welnick said they are putting together a multi-act touring festival that will hit the road later this year. The six-week summer tour is expected to be headed by Weir's and Hart's solo band projects which may be augmented by guest musicians such as Bruce Hornsby. The package might also feature new groups in the Dead vein such as God Street Wine, Rusted Root or Colonel Bruce Hampton. The tour could cover as many as 30 cities and has the potential of becoming an annual event. Dead manager Cameron Sears told the *S.F. Chronicle* it's true the band will no longer tour under the name Grateful Dead, but surviving band members still have plenty of music to play. Other Dead related projects included a new album and an extensive box set of music. Sears said, "These projects were in the offing but because we were touring so much, we didn't have time to smell the roses." Bassist Phil Lesh plans to enter the recording studio to try to salvage a new Dead album from the sessions conducted before Garcia's death. He's also been meeting with financial advisors about a Grateful Dead museum, a long-cherished project of his.

# HotStar Of The Week ★

## Kenny Wayne Shepherd Kenny Wayne Shepherd

A seven-year-old boy had stars in his eyes as he was first exposed to the blues, sitting side stage atop Stevie Ray Vaughan's amp case — where the blues legend had personally placed him. Even as a youngster, hanging out backstage at concerts his father promoted, Kenny Wayne Shepherd was touched by the music in such a way that the feeling stays with him today. And with the self-taught guitarist's signing to Giant Records by label head Irving Azoff, it seems the 18-year-old Shepherd is now the one touching people with his own music.

From his office in Shreveport, La., Shepherd told POLLSTAR after that initial introduction to blues, "I badgered the hell out of my dad to get me a guitar and I got my first guitar for Christmas of that same year." Since that time, Shepherd has never really been interested in playing anything but the blues. "That's pretty much the music that captured my soul," he said. "Even though all of my songs are not straight blues, I'm a real blues person at heart."

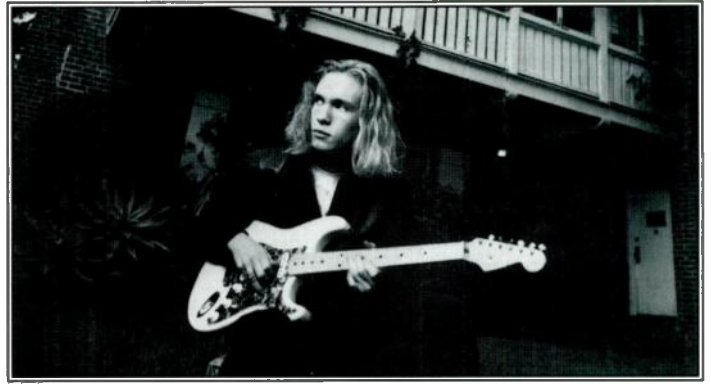
Shepherd never had any formal guitar lessons. "I've pretty much just sat around the house and listened to the radio and CDs and stuff and picked it up by ear," he said. That being the case, one could say Shepherd learned from the legends — Howlin' Wolf, Muddy Waters, Robert Johnson, Albert King and B.B. King.

Even at 13, Shepherd's gifts were quite apparent to his friends and family but he had never tested his skills in front of a crowd. That was until his father took him to The Absent House Bar in New Orleans to see local guitarist Bryan Lee play during a National Association of Broadcasters convention. After much persuading, Lee let "the kid" sit in. Shepherd said, "The place was packed and I played one set with him and then he invited me to play for the rest of the night. And then after that, we got a standing ovation. It was my first time in front of a group of people and I got a standing ovation. I was thrilled."

Shepherd has gotten various reactions from people who aren't used to seeing such a young man so well-versed in the blues. Sometimes they're just in awe. But sometimes, Shepherd said, he has problems being taken seriously. "Some people say, 'This dude is a little young to be doing this.' But people respect it a lot more now and once they see it, they really believe it... I feel like you don't have to be a certain age to play any kind of music, man, as long as you can play it and you know what you're doing and you know what it's about. I don't think it has anything to do with age at all because everybody gets the blues."

The word about this young bluesman started getting out when producer Bill Fordresser discovered Shepherd at a NAB convention jam session and decided to make some demo tapes. Record companies started circling. "And then Irving Azoff from Giant calls and says that he wants to sign me — he's gonna come at us with both barrels," the guitarist said. Shepherd talked to several record companies but Giant showed the most dedication. "You couldn't be in a better position than to be signed by the president of the record company. You know you're not gonna fall through the cracks." Shepherd said things have gone well the last two years at Giant. "I must say that Irving has kept his word because everything that he told me that he would do, he has done. And he's done a lot for us."

Throughout his career, Shepherd has had the chance to play with blues pros like Jimmie Vaughan, Robert Cray, Bo Diddley and



B.B. King, as well as appearing on recordings by the late Albert King and Willie Dixon. "We've gotten to play with almost everybody that has anything to do with this kind of music," Shepherd said. He said the experience that sticks out in most in his mind is his 16th birthday, just prior to getting his record deal, when he opened for B.B. King. Shepherd said King walked up to him and said, "Are you this new inspiring guitarist that I've been hearing so much about?" I was like, 'I guess.' And he says, 'Well, I'd just like to tell you that it's a pleasure for me to share the stage with you.' And I was like, 'WHAT?' I was looking over my shoulder like, 'Who is he talking to?'"

Don Henley's curiosity about Shepherd and Azoff's connection to the Eagles recently landed the blues guitarist a gig opening for the superstar band at Austin's University of Texas football stadium. Shepherd said the giant venue was the biggest place by far he's ever played with band members Corey Sterling, vocals; Will Ainsworth, bass; Jimmy Wallace, keyboards; Chris Moore, drums; and Joe Nadeau, rhythm guitar. He said though standing on stage looking out over a sea of people was pretty intense, he never experiences stage fright. "I've never really gotten nervous about being on stage as long as I have my guitar," he said. "If you asked me to get up in front of 20 people and give a speech, that's a different story."

As for his future, Shepherd said he doesn't expect to gain star status like his idol, Stevie Ray Vaughan, but he wouldn't mind it. "I don't want to be greedy and I don't like greedy people, but I don't expect to be somebody like [Vaughan]. But it's like, if that's what is meant to be, then I don't mind taking on that responsibility." He said the only thing he wants to do is play music and have people listen to it and appreciate it. "I mean, that's the whole thing," he said. "And so far, it's been going really well because the people like it and that's the biggest compliment to any musician is to have people appreciate their music."

Though blues doesn't have its own place on popular radio formats, radio isn't passing on this opportunity. Shepherd's single, "Deja Voodoo," off his *Ledbetter Heights* debut is being played on AOR, AAA and active rock stations. A few alternative stations are catching on as well. The song is showing up in the top 10 on the R&R rock chart and it debuted at No. 2 on the Billboard blues chart, one under Stevie Ray Vaughan and above Eric Clapton and Jimi Hendrix.

Shepherd recently came off the road from a headline tour of the Northeast selling out many of his 19 shows. He left for a tour supporting B.B. King January 2nd.

The singer was accused of kicking the guard who tried to quiet a rambunctious party Brown was hosting at a West Hollywood hotel last August..... A fire broke out Christmas Eve at **Freddy Fender's** home in Corpus Christi. No one was injured and most of the damage was confined to the bedroom closet where the fire was believed to have started.

## Capricorn Cuts A Quarter

Capricorn Records recently let go 11 employees, 25 percent of the staff, in an attempt to make the company more profitable. Among the senior level executives who left Capricorn are GM Mark Pucci and director of operations Marcia Flowers-Simms. Capricorn spokesperson Jeremy Much told POLLSTAR despite the economic necessity to cut staff, the state of the company is good. Capricorn had a successful '95 and early indications for '96 are optimistic, especially with current projects from 311, the Freddy Jones Band and the *Hempilation* compilation, Much said. No acts have been cut from Capricorn's roster and remaining staffers are expected to take over duties for those who were let go. Other Capricorn employees effected by the cut are senior VP of international Don Schmitzerle, some retail marketing executives and support staff. Pucci has moved back to Atlanta to relaunch his own public relations firm, Mark Pucci Media (404-816-7393). Pucci's first client is HighTone Records.

## Material Stalking

After being threatened with a \$5 million arrest warrant, Madonna reluctantly appeared in a Los Angeles court January 3rd to face the man accused of stalking her. The Material Girl testified that she felt sick to her stomach being in court with defendant Robert Hoskins. "I feel incredibly disturbed that the man who threatened my life is sitting across from me and he has somehow made his fantasies come true. I'm sitting in front of him and that's what he wants," she said. Hoskins allegedly threatened Madonna and her employees and twice invaded her Hollywood Hills property, where a bodyguard shot him in May. At one point, Maddy said Hoskins threatened to "slice my throat from ear to ear" if he could not marry her. The superstar testified that she is tormented by persistent nightmares about Hoskins. She said after the alleged stalker trespassed on her property for a second time last May, she decided to sell her Hollywood home. In his opening statement, deputy public defender John Myers portrayed his client as "a homeless guy who poses no threat to Madonna or anyone else." Madonna's lawyer, Nicholas DeWitt, implored Superior Court Judge Jacqueline Connor to either have Hoskins removed from the courtroom and let him watch Madonna's testimony via closed-circuit TV, or allow the singer to testify elsewhere on

video tape. But the judge said that to remove Hoskins from the courtroom would invalidate any verdict because it would send a message to the jury that he was too dangerous to be in the star's presence. And Hoskins' lawyer argued that the defendant had a constitutional right to confront his accuser. The trial was supposed to begin last month but was delayed when Madonna ignored a subpoena to testify saying her recent trip to England left her too sick and tired to come to court and that she had to go to Argentina to begin filming the movie "Evita." DeWitt said Maddy was willing to have the charges dismissed to avoid testifying but the district attorney declined to drop the case. Hoskins faces up to 10 years in prison if convicted of stalking, making terrorist threats and assault.

The list of other nominees for the February 28th awards at the Shrine Auditorium in Los Angeles includes superstar acts like **Madonna**, **Janet Jackson** and **MJ**, **Plant/Page**, **U2** and the **Eagles**, as well as critically acclaimed acts like **Liz Phair** and **P.J. Harvey**. In rap categories, **Bone Thugs-N-Harmony**, **Tha Dogg Pound**, **Skee-Lo**, **Naughty By Nature** and **2Pac** each took two nominations. In the country field, acts receiving multiple nominations along with **Train** are **John Michael Montgomery**, **Dwight Yoakam**, **Trisha Yearwood**, **Vince Gill**, **Alison Krauss**, **Alan Jackson**, and **The Mavericks**.

## Ex-Manager Takes McGraw To Arbitration

**Tim McGraw's** former manager is due a percentage of his earnings, according to a Louisiana arbitration panel. **Carol Booth** sued McGraw in 1993 claiming the country singer illegally dropped her after she helped him start his career. The panel, commissioned by a Louisiana federal court, decided Booth's 1989 contract with McGraw is "valid and enforceable." The panel said Booth is due around \$500,000 at present, but the total could end up in the millions. Still at issue is whether or not Booth is also entitled to 15 percent of the singer's gross income from albums

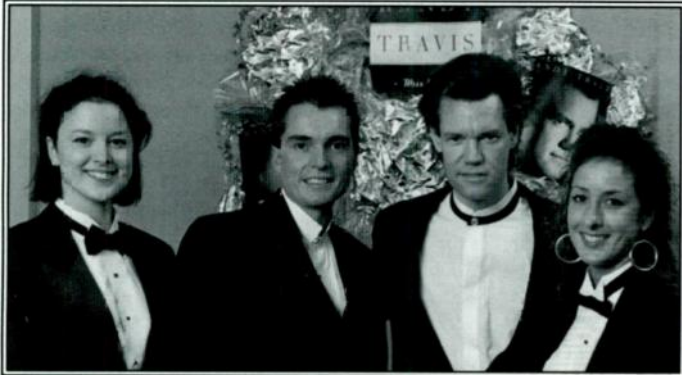

## The Prince & The Bunny

Citing irreconcilable differences and the recent executive shuffle at Warner Bros. Records, the former Prince has once again announced he wants to part ways with his label. A press release from publicist Noelle-Elaine Media Consultants states the instability at Warner Bros. "has made it impossible for the company to effectively market and promote its flagship artists" like the unpronounceable symbol formerly known as Prince. Prince signed a highly-hyped multimillion dollar, multialbum deal with the Bunny in 1992 but hasn't delivered a chart-topper under that contract. The artist has been talking about leaving the label since 1994 and has insinuated that the label has enslaved him by expecting him to deliver an album a year.

## Bootleg Hit Men

The U.K.-based International Federation of the Phonographic Industry (IFPI) is temporarily withdrawing staff from its Canton office in China because of death threats resulting from the organization's attempts to stop piracy in that country. "We have clearly reached a critical point in the anti-piracy campaign if the pirates have to resort to these kind of measures," said Nic Garnett, director general of IFPI. China is said to be the largest pirate market in the world with bootleg sales of around \$250 million. Piracy in southern China is particularly widespread and IFPI, through its office in Canton, is the only international industry organization operating there. The situation in Canton became untenable, according to IFPI, when it heard from reliable sources that hit-men had been contracted on behalf of certain CD factories to halt IFPI's anti-piracy operation. IFPI immediately relocated its staff to its other offices in Beijing and Shanghai.


## The Deal Of The Art

The estate of Jerry Garcia has been hit with a \$12 million lawsuit filed by an Oregon art dealer who claims representatives of Garcia's estate have told her she cannot affix Garcia's silk-

screened signature to lithographs despite having a contract with the late guitarist. According to the suit filed December 18th in Marin County Superior Court, art dealer Nora Sage reached an agreement with Garcia in 1990 to sell and reproduce 180 pieces of his artwork. Sage's deal also extended to designs for ties. The agreement required Garcia to affix his signature to reproductions of his art but when he died, many lithographs were still awaiting his mark, according to the suit. After Garcia's death, his personal representatives forbade and continue to forbid Sage from putting the signature on the lithographs, the suit said. The suit also said Garcia had given verbal approval in 1993 for Sage to manufacture suspenders, vests, belts, scarves, cummerbunds and bow ties using the guitarists art. If the agreement is terminated before the pieces are sold, Sage claims she is entitled to ownership of half the inventory, including Garcia's original artwork and reproductions. The art dealers' claim is the largest made against the late musician's estate so far. In total, the claims against the estate are nearly \$20 million.

## Obituaries

**Dean Martin**, 78, died Christmas Day at his home in Beverly Hills of acute respiratory failure. Born Dino Paul Crocetti, he worked in the steel mills, fought as a welterweight, delivered bootleg liquor and dealt cards in a gambling room before he began singing in clubs during the '40s. The smooth-voiced crooner hooked up with Jerry Lewis and the duo was successful as both a nightclub act and in film. Martin was one of the few non-rockers to top the charts in 1964 when his song "Everybody Loves Somebody" hit No. 1. As a member of the famed "Rat Pack" with Frank Sinatra and Sammy Davis Jr., Martin toured in the late 1980s until he was forced to drop off the package in '88 because of a kidney condition.... **Steel guitarist Ned Davis**, 55, died December 27th of respiratory failure at his home in Fayette County, Tenn. Davis was an innovative player who worked with artists ranging from Jerry Lee Lewis to Louise Mandrell as well as fronting his own band.... **Drummer Sammy Lee Creason**, 51, died from a brain aneurysm December 21st at a Nashville hospital. Creason was part of the Bill Black Combo in the '60s before turning to session work for acts like Bob Dylan, Barbra Streisand and Ted Nugent.

## Between The Dates

Just before the holidays a story appeared on the wire services reporting that **THE DRIFTERS** were stranded in the tiny South American country of Guyana, broke and unable to pay nearly \$4,000 in taxes that the group owed the government. Only problem was, it wasn't the real Drifters. Larry Marshak, manager and trademark owner of the '50s singing group told POLLSTAR that a Guyana promoter, a woman who was that country's only Olympic Gold Medal winner, had booked a series of December dates back in early 1995. However, as the performances drew near, the promoter did not come up with the full deposit, and by the day before the first scheduled date had only managed to send 40% of the deposit. Marshak told her that without the full deposit, the group wasn't going to come. According to Marshak, after a few weeks went by the promoter eventually contacted former Drifter's member Charlie Thomas, who, along with a few other singers agreed to do the shows. Thomas and his friends performed two shows, but didn't get paid. However, the government demanded an entertainment tax based on several shows that the singers were contracted to perform. Since the other shows were cancelled, Thomas and the other performers didn't have the dough, which not only meant they couldn't pay the tax, but they also couldn't leave the country. To add to their troubles, Guyana also charges an airport departure tax. One of the singers even went to the airport to see if he could leave, and the government took him off the plane. Eventually, Thomas and singers Caesar Valentino and George Staley, along with Guyanese optometrist Don Gomes, ended up walking the streets of Georgetown, Guyana, soliciting money from strangers. Thomas, who started crying during an appearance on Guyana's local public television, called the tour a nightmare. Eventually a person connected with the first show came up with the funds to allow Thomas & company to leave the country. Marshak, who holds the trademark for The Drifters in the U.S. while another person holds it in the U.K. said it was hard to say who holds the trademark for the rest of the world. "You wouldn't go to every single country in the world and apply for the trademark," said Marshak. Marshak said The Drifters don't work in South America because there isn't a South American market for them. Marshak added, "If you want to go, I'll be happy to send you."

The second leg of **BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN's** solo acoustic tour kicked off Sunday night in Montreal. The Boss will play Toronto and then sweep through the U.S. before he takes his act to Europe where he'll perform in February, March and April. Expect the solo tour to continue through the summer. See Route Book for the latest dates.

Those last night computer gremlins added an extra digit to one of the figures on the **1995 TOP 50 TOURS** chart in last week's Year-End Special Edition of POLLSTAR. Amy Grant's chart position remains unchanged at No. 20 but her correct total gross was \$12.7 million.



The deep-voiced William Lee Golden has rejoined the **OAK RIDGE BOYS**. Golden left the vocal group in 1987 and was replaced by Steve Sanders. Sanders resigned from the group last November after publicity over a fight that took place between his wife and ex-wife in a Hendersonville, Tenn. grocery store. Golden rejoined the act for a few songs during their New Year's Eve show at the Star Plaza Theatre in Indiana and officially resumes touring with the boys on January 19th in East Lansing, Michigan. The Oak Ridge Boys originally started in 1945 as a gospel group called The Oak Ridge Quartet, and has seen over 30 members in its 56 year history. Golden first joined in 1965.

## U.K. News Report

■ **GLASTONBURY** founder and organiser Michael Eavis has announced that the festival will be taking a break this year. To the surprise of many, Eavis has said that he wants to keep the local community happy and that everyone involved in the festival needs a "fallow year." He stated: "We will be back in '97 and will continue until the millennium." The festival last took a break in 1991 and came back stronger than ever. Most agents seem to think that skipping a year will not dent the festival's popularity in any way, although the gap may benefit other summer festivals like the Phoenix.

■ The best concert tip so far for 96 has to be a **SEX PISTOLS** reunion... yes, the rumours of concerts in the US have moved across the pond and there is talk of a show at Finsbury Park in the summer.

■ **MICHAEL JACKSON** retained the much-specified number one chart position through Christmas and the New Year, beating off the much-touted Mike Flowers Pops and The Beatles.

■ If 1995 was the year of Britpop, will 1996 see the beginning of the big **BRIT BACKLASH**? Or will it be the year that our new crop of homegrown talent finds a strong export market? There is hope for the two most hyped Brit bands - both **OASIS** and **BLUR** are reportedly considering playing British stadiums this year. Last year in the UK, Oasis made it into the Guinness Book of Records, when the band played the biggest live indoor shows on record with two sell-out Earl's Court gigs with a capacity of 20,000 per night. The band also blew up four telephone exchanges in the rush for tickets and played to 180,586 people during the year and sold out four new arena dates in March in less than a few hours. *What's The Story Morning Glory* is selling around 150,000 copies a week and was six times platinum by the end of '95. After starting last year on the cover of POLLSTAR, during their US trip, Oasis toured 14 countries and 1996 will see more international activity says agent Ben Winchester at Primary Talent. Blur meanwhile sold out everything they printed a ticket for in 1995 and played to over 370,000 people in the UK, including their own headlining gigs and festival appearances, which totalled 37 shows and have notched up album sales of around 1 million units in the UK. Plans for 1996 are uncertain, says Ian Huffam at Fair Warning Wasted Talent, until the next album. But it could be a more international year for them too.

■ Beyond the hype, the rise of **BRITPOP** has undoubtedly contributed to a resurgence in the spending power of audiences and the recession finally appears to have become a distant memory, giving the industry the chance to bask in the reflected glory and financial benefits generated by a thriving pool of homegrown talent. This January has a very healthy calendar of gigs from club dates to arena shows. **SIMPLY RED** continue their European tour which kicked off with three sell-out Wembley Arena dates before Christmas and plays a further 29 dates in January in the UK and Ireland. This leg of the tour includes six N.E.C.'s plus a further four Wembley Arena and four London Docklands Arena shows. All of these sold out in advance last autumn. **BJORK** is also playing arenas and the NME's "Barts Bus Tour" returns with a selection of talked about and up and coming acts, including, Northern Uproar, the Cardigans, and Fluffy among others.

■ Tips for 1996 are that **PULP** should continue to ride on the crest of their current wave and we should see more of **SUPERGRASS** and **BLACK GRAPE** who broke through in 1995. New breakthroughs at home and abroad may well be Placebo, Baby Bird, and in the dance market Dreadzone and Moloko. On the home front, **ROBSON & JEROME** look set to consolidate last year's chart success with a live tour. The two TV actor-heroes scooped the top selling single slot this year with their versions of "Unchained Melody" and "The White Cliffs of Dover" - but they haven't decided which agent to go with.

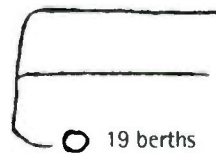

artists include Troy Cassar-Daley, Lee Kernaghan, Gina Jeffreys and Texas band Dallas County Line.

Michael Coppel has announced February dates for SOUL II SOUL. Jazzie B and his 11-piece band featuring five singers will perform just four shows in Australia.

Korda's Worldwide Concerts announced that prior to arriving in Australia in mid-December reggae legend LUCKY DUBE completed the South Pacific leg of their tour playing to audiences of well more than 10,000 in several stops. The biggest show happened at Honiara in the Solomon Islands where the attendance was augmented by a huge number of gatecrashers.

Former MC5 guitarist WAYNE KRAMER is touring Australia in January as the special guest of RADIO BIRDMAN. Aside from the dates with the Australian punk legends, Kramer will be doing shows on his own.

AMMONIA's first single, "Drugs," will be released on the Epic label in the first week of February. The band will be touring in March and April to coincide with the release of the album. Looks like the chances are good for another international success for Murmur, home of silverchair.

Promoter Peter Korda pulled off the corporate gig of 1995, organising a special appearance by TOM JONES at the Retail Awards for Excellence hosted by Shopping Centre Group Westfield in early December at Sydney's Regent Hotel. Presented as a total surprise to 400 of the top Westfield retailers, Jones reportedly delivered a superb set and then headed off to continue his '30 Years Of Cool' tour for Frontier Touring across Australia and Southeast Asia.

An interesting ad appeared in the Sydney Morning Herald whilst I was in the States last month. Placed by Chartered Accountants William Buck in Sydney it says: "An opportunity exists for the purchase of a complete BOOKING AGENCY for live entertainment, which has the lion's share of the market in its state. Astute operators already in the market would find the business a positive contribution to their existing operations." No word on exactly which agency is for sale.

The BIG BACKYARD Concert, which was scheduled to take place on January 7th at the Domain, has been cancelled. It will now be staged in March around the same time as the Melbourne and Adelaide concerts. The organisers felt that industry support in some quarters was being stretched thin, due in part to the numerous other festivals/concerts taking place over the Christmas and New Year season. Details of the Sydney, Melbourne and Adelaide shows will be announced soon.
