RCA, Coca Cola combine on special E.P. promotion

RCA Records and Coca Cola Limited have jointly announced the release and co-promotion of a special premium package. Titled Portraits In Gold, the package is a seven-inch, 33 1/3 rpm extended play record consisting of eight selections, four on each side

The set features material from the likes of Jefferson Starship, Hall & Oates, Evelyn 'Champagne' King and RCA Canada's own Minglewood Band. Minglewood and group will be represented by their songs Whiz Kids and Hook Line & Sinker. The group, who hail from Nova Scotia, will also be

appearing at the Coca Cola Bandshell at Toronto's CNE August 22 and 29.

The package was conceived jointly by E.T. Traynor, RCA's Manager of Special Projects, and Coca Cola's Project Manager of Field Marketing Services, G. Douglas Lawrason. Lawrason noted that there will also be a French language package available in the same format, including material from RCA's Cantin Begin, as well as other notable French Canadian artists Suzanne Stevens, Boule Noire and Beau Dommage. Both packages will be distributed nationally through bottlers.

Sefel signs Guidonna Lee as its first pop artist

Paul White, Vice President and General Manager of the newly formed Sefel Records, has announced the signing of singer-songwriter Guidonna Lee as the label's first pop artist. The performer, who hails from Toronto, is currently recording her debut album at Fastern Sound, also in Toronto, with veteran engineer Ken Friesen acting as producer.

Lee has also signed a worldwide publishing agreement with the company's Sefel Publishing (P.R.O. Canada), and will be recording, among other songs, two compositions she wrote for The Kidnapping Of The President, a Sefel Pictures Internation-

al film production.

New album and U.S. stage debut for Bowie

RCA Records are preparing for the September release of Scary Monsters, a new album by noted British artist David Bowie. The album, which follows Bowie's previous effort Lodger by one year, will be preceded by the release of a single, Ashes To Ashes/Move On.

Scary Monsters was produced by Bowie with session veteran Tony Visconti in March of this year. Of particular note are the credits of artists and co-writers on the set. One song was co-penned by Tom Verlaine, formerly of Television. Players on the set range from fellow British stars Robert Fripp and Pete Townshend of the Who to Roy Bittan, piano player in Bruce Springsteen's band. Bowie's own band is also featured.

In conjunction with the release of the album, Bowie will also be making his U.S. stage debut with a starring role in The Elephant Man. Bowie plays the title character, a freak saved from a lifetime in side shows by a noted surgeon. The play, by Bernard Pomerance, is a Tony Award-winning hit.



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CRIA terminates \$100,000 industry chart

Toronto: The \$100,000 a year cost of producing the weekly CRIA chart has been cited as the reason the chart will no longer be published.

The weekly Top 50 singles and albums were often used by the foreign trade press as well as the CBC-TV Star Chart teever, which has also been cancelled.

A spokesman for the CRIA said that the loss of the monies received from the use of the chart on television was another factor in the cancellation of the weekly chart.

The chart was computerized and based on reports from dealers.

The CBC-TV Star Chart series, which was cancelled after only a short run, referred to the CRIA chart and presented a countdown of the top ten each week. Prior to the beginning of the year the chart was completely financed by the Canadian Recording Industry Association.

This project marks the third cooperative promotion between Coca Cola and RCA. In 1969, they copromoted a Guess Who record titled The Wild Pair, and three years later, another joint project, I'd Like To Teach The World To Sing, became a gold album for RCA in Canada.

Toronto's Brian Stutz forms CES

Toronto: Veteran limousine driver Brian Stutz has left Toronto Limousine after four and a half years to form Coordinated Entertainment Services, a new and unique company. The company, based in Toronto, offers a wide variety of services to artists and companies in all the entertainment industries, ranging from transportation and accomodations through sound and lighting, security, and even emergency medical services.

Stutz's Coordinated Entertainment Services is a wide-reaching organization. He has assembled an impressive group of expert consultants in a variety of related fields to handle specific assignments on a freelance basis. These people are among the best in their areas. Like Stutz, they have paid their dues and know their ways around the industry. They're aware of the last-second contingencies that are likely to pop up in dealing with artists and companies in the entertainment fields. Among these experts are everything from a security consultant and band service operations (sound, lighting, road crew, etc.) to publicity, P.R. and even promotion.

An ace in the hole for entertainment industries

Stutz calls his new service an "ace in the hole." CES looks after a large proportion of the details involved in bringing an artist into town, in promoting a concert, film or show, and in staging an event or press party. Stutz himself is more than equipped to look after an emergency or to find something for an artist to do while in town. CES evolves from his history as one of the most popular limo drivers in Toronto. His popularity was due to his policy of "looking after the artists.

Stutz has all the experience in the world at taking care of these needs. In the past half-decade, he has done it all, from finding Starsky for Hutch to finding a beer for Boz Scaggs at 2 am (at his own apartment), a sushibar for Greg Lake of ELP, a special antique lamp for a member of Yes, and a tennis fourth for ELO (himself). No reasonable artist's need is too large -- or too small -- for CES.

CBS lowers list prices on key catalogue titles

On August 18, CBS Records Canada will be inaugurating a major catalogue marketing effort involving the lowering of list prices on 164 key catalogue albums.

Under the banner of The Nice Price, CBS will be reducing the suggested list on the titles from their current \$9.29 to \$6.98. The company will also be supporting the new series with an aggressive marketing campaign to stimulate consumer sales on the titles. The campaign will involve colour-coordinated point of purchase materials advertising the Nice Price marketing plan. Among these materials will be mobiles, buttons, header cards, stickers, decals and ad mats. CBS Senior Vice President Stan Kulin noted, "I'm confident that the Nice Price series will result in dramatically improved sales on key CBS catalogue titles."

Among the titles involved for marketing under the reduced list price are 14 Barbra Streisand albums and six by Santana; Chicago V, VI, VIII and

CBS Chairman Arnold Gosewich commented on the Nice Price series, stating, "The U.S. company issued its mid-price line in early fall of 1979,

and it has met with phenomenal success. Many titles have increased in sales four, five, and even sixfold. Application of the Nice Price concept with its wonderful array of merchandising support can only help to make this series very rewarding to our customers."

The Nice Price series is being issued by the parent company to all CBS affiliates. The Canadian company is the first after the U.S. to initiate the

concept.

RCA signs Doug & The Slugs to worldwide deal

RCA Records has announced the signing of Vancouver-based rock band Dougs & The Slugs to a worldwide recording deal. Negotiations were completed between the record company and Sam Feldman, manager of the group.

A six-piece band headed by Doug Bennett, Doug & The Slugs are one of the major success stories of the fastrising Vancouver homegrown music scene. The group had their first single, Too Bad, distributed by Quintessence Records, the Vancouver store which has moved a remarkable amount of local product. Quintessence had sold thousands of copies of the single locally, and had also distributed

product throughout the country. The single became a major hit in western Canada, and has now begun to receive heavy airplay in the rest of the country. Too Bad has also been charted nationally for almost four months, and recently peaked at number 20 on the RPM singles chart.

Now with RCA, Doug & The Slugs become the second Vancouver band to be picked up by the company. The first was the Powder Blues, a platinum act in Canada. Doug & The Slugs are preparing their debut album, titled Cognac & Bologna, for a mid-August release. The band will be supporting the album with a cross-Canada tour in mid-September.

A gathering of experts

Coordinated Entertainment Services can offer a major assist to a record or film company. The company is a mass of expertise, "It's an association of independent people who have said, 'When you need me, call me,' "notes Stutz. "They're all people out there doing their own things, and they're ready to come in and assist me on a project. They're people who've been proven to be the best at what they do. This company is based on that principle -- our people are the best. And our clients are the best, and we want to look after them."

Everything from limos to concert and event security

Stutz is no longer attached to Toronto Limousine, but will continue to use the service heavily as a client. While there, he and several other drivers built up the company within the entertainment field to being the top limo service in the city, which also left Stutz with a very high profile.

Security is another area Stutz and firm can handle. He does not act as a guard or bouncer himself ("I'd probably break a great kneecap!"), but his security consultant is a long-time friend, Nick Misetic. Misetic is a friendly giant who nonetheless presents an imposing invitation to would-be gatecrashers to stay home, Work-

ing through CES, Misetic recently handled security for Rex Smith when the artist was promoting his new movie. Stutz recalls, "They enjoyed his company and the job he did so much that they took him on the road with them to six cities. Rex even talked about Nick on the Merv Griffin Show!" CES can not only supply bodyguards and security men, but can also handle concert security, provide doormen and guards for private parties and serve as a liaison with hotel security.

'We can do a job for the Canadian entertainment scene"

Coordinated Entertainment Services hopes to provide an edge for stars and companies in all these areas. "We're basically the ace in the hole," repeats Stutz. "I sit back on a paging machine, and my team has people on call on a 24-hour basis. If they need something, I want them to phone. We're here, and we're ready to look after them. I've always been very concerned about the way an artist leaves this city, the impression he leaves with."

Stutz emphasizes that his company's primary function is to assist

the record, film and theatre industries in arranging and handling their people's trips to Toronto. "We're here to relieve their responsibilities, make their jobs a little bit easier, and assist them. We're not here to take over their jobs - - we're here to support them." And with that in mind, Stutz has set out on his own. "It's time," he notes. "I've paid my dues through four and a half years of late-night gigs, and I feel we can do a job for the Canadian entertainment scene. Our experience has given all of us a total understanding of the demands, the needs and personalities within the entertainment world, and we're here to cater to those needs.'

FLYING BURRITO BROTHERS

Suggested List \$8.98

Live From Tokyo - Ovation/Regency REG-79001-N Country rock
The Burrito Brothers have been one of the seminal forces in country rock since their formation with ex-Byrd Chris Hillman and the late Gram Parsons a decade ago. Now the only remaining founder is steel player Sneeky Pete Kleinow. While nobody could replace Parsons as a writer and vocalist, the Burritos retain their country rock roots and continue to provide country-based music with rich harmonies and good energy. Only one cut, Big Bayou, is original. Two, Rick Roberts' Colorado and Hot Burrito No. 2 by Parsons and Chris Eth-

ridge, are from former Burritos. The rest are mostly energetic versions of country standards like Rocky Top, Six Days On The Road and Rollin' In My Sweet Baby's Arms.

THE KINGS

Suggested List \$9.29

The Kings Are Here - Elektra X6E-274-P Rock

Coming almost out of nowhere after a short time in the Toronto club scene, this original Toronto rock group has gotten together with a highly notable producer and come up with an album that is receiving instant international attention. Bob Ezrin (most recently of The Wall fame) produced the set at Soundstage in Toronto, and it's a good driving rock effort, very much up to date, with enough keyboards to offer it a mild progressive sense. All material is written by members David Diamond and Aryan Zero (the rest of the quartet is Sonny Keyes and Max Styles), and while there isn't a wealth of AM-style pop material, FM rockers should jump all over this set. Lyrics enclosed.

CHRIS de BURGH

Suggested List \$8.98

Eastern Wind - A&M SP-4815-W Pop

Canada is one of de Burgh's strongest markets - of his four previous albums, one is gold and another platinum - and on this set, everything but the Cancon is Cancon. For the first time, he used an American producer, David Anderle, and a non-British studio, Toronto's Manta Sound, His band also hails from Toronto. Session assistance is provided by Supertramp's John Anthony Helliwell on sax, Toronto keyboardist Eric Robertson and the vocals of Lisa Dal Bello, Colina Phillips and Sharon Lee Williams. As always, de Burgh's songwriting is immaculate, intense, and exceptional, and his songs, more uptempo and pop-oriented than previously, are perfect for this strong Irish tenor. Lyrics enclosed.

The computation of the records from 51 to 100 is based on early airplay, chart action and regional sales and breakouts. The chart is based on samplings from markets across Canada and indicates trends that may not be prevalent in all areas of Canada. Shaded numbers indicate a strong upward trend and gains in airplay or sales. This chart is offered as a guide to new product and an indication of trends in Canadian markets.

Jan Matejcek takes over reins at P.R.O. Canada

Dr. Jan Matejcek, veteran expert in performing rights in Canada and internationally, has been named Chief Operating Officer of the Performing Rights Organization of Canada Limited (P.R.O. Canada). The position also includes the responsibilities of Vice President and Managing Director.

Dr. Matejcek becomes only the third person to head up the operations of the organization since its inception in the 1940's as BMI Canada, then a Canadian division of Broadcast Music Inc. in the U.S. Matejcek succeeds S. Campbell Ritchie, who retired on July 1 after a lengthy stint as Managing Director. Ritchie had replaced Wm. Harold Moon, who after World War II took the fledgeling organization and turned it from a Canadian licensing house for B.M.l.'s international copyrights into a viable performing rights organization with Canadian affiliates of its own.

In 1976, BMI Canada achieved independence from B.M.I. in the U.S. The following year, the organization changed its name to the current P.R.O. Canada to reflect its independence. Concurrent with the name change and the establishment of a separate identity for the organization, Dr. Matejcek came to P.R.O. Canada in June of 1977.

A native of Hamburg, Germany, raised from youth in Czechoslovakia, Dr. Matejcek is well backgrounded in both the music and publishing ends of the business and in law. He studied piano and composition in Prague with notable teachers, and has a Doctor of Laws degree from Charles University there, as well as a degree in musicology.

Matejcek left Czechoslovakia in 1968 and moved to Germany. After a year working with a publishing company in Mainz, he moved to Canada. At first, he acted as representative for GEMA, the West Germany performing rights society, and as a consultant to the Canadian Music Centre. In 1970, he became Executive Director of the Ontario Federation of Symphony Orchestra and the Ontario Choral Federation, and was involved in founding the Association of Canadian Orchestras. Matejcek joined CAPAC in 1971, acting as Executive Assistant and secretary of CAPAC's Committee for the Promotion of Canadian Music. He held those responsibilities until his move to P.R.O. Canada in 1977.

In addition to his education and experience backgrounds, Matejcek is a linguist, speaking six languages, and an established author and correspondent. He wrote a book on contemporary Czech composers in 1957, and has had volumes of new Czechoslovak piano music published in Cologne and New York. He has written numerous articles on contemporary concert music for European publications, and remains a correspondent for European music magazines and broadcasters.

P.R.O. under Matejcek

Matejcek discussed his role as Managing Director at P.R.O. Canada. "Every person who becomes involved in an organization brings in something which is his personal thing. This usually also brings with it change, not in the structure of the organization but in the priorities the organization may have. Because P.R.O. Canada has always been known for being very helpful to its affiliates and for its active involvement in the life of the musical community, I would like to bring with me a continuation of this trend to be actively involved in whatever is important in the field of musical activities in Canada."

Essentially, P.R.O. Canada, under Matejcek, will be involved in trying to bring in legislation to protect the copyrights of composers and publishers in broadcasts carried by cable, pay TV and satellite 'superstations'. Videodisc will be another area where the rights of the composer will have to be established in law. "We are looking for permission to collect, say, on cable or re-broadcast of satellite.

International involvement a Jan Matejcek strength

Due to Dr. Matejcek's extensive international experience, one effect that will almost certainly result from his new appointment is a continuing increase in P.R.O. Canada's international involvement. When the organization was part of B.M.I., the licensing of international compositions fell under B.M.I.'s agreements with societies in other countries. Since P.R.O. has been independent, the organization has had to make its own international agreements as the existing ones expire. That has been one of Matejcek's primary duties since joining P.R.O. Canada. Matejcek notes, "The fact that we were part of B.M.I. prevented us from becoming members of various international organizations. This, of course, has been eliminated by our independence, and as of April 15 of this year, we have become a full member of the International Confederation of Societies of Authors and Composers (CISAC), headquartered in Paris.

"We have also been approached by

some of our affiliates and asked to explore the possibility of protecting their interests in the field of mechanical royalties, income derived from the sales of records and tapes, abroad. The situation in Canada in this field is not very clear, but I think that more or less, the artists can take care of their own interests here. But the situation is different outside of Canada, because there is no central system from which our affiliates can collect mechanical royalties for the reporduction of their works abroad."

A computer system for P.R.O. Canada

Matejcek is inheriting a fast-growing organization whose list of affiliates has swollen in the past three years from just over 8,000 to about 11,700. In line with that growth, Matejcek notes, "We have introduced our own computer system which will become effective in the third quarter of this year. Our affiliates will be sharing, for the first time, in the results of our own logging and distribution, and practically all the activities carried by the computer, which includes accounting, income from general licensing and so on.

"It is a major operation, but we have the great advantage of saving ourselves and our affiliates a lot of expense by sharing a joint data base with B.M.I. in New York. Data base, in our sense, means information on works, composers, lyric writers and publishers. All titles and people involved in either B.M.I. or our organization are set up in that data base, with access being available to all societies, but neither society can change the information that is input by the other

As Chief Operating Officer and Managing Director at P.R.O. Canada, Matejcek will be involved in the effort to change the Copyright Act. P.R.O. has already submitted an extensive brief, and is doing its full share in the fight to revise an archaic law to the benefit of its affiliates. Matejcek also fully intends to retain P.R.O. Canada's open-door policy towards composers, songwriters and publishers, a policy of particular benefit to the young songwriter.

'We are a young organization - - I think that I am not exaggerating when I say that the average age of our employees is under 30. Being a young organization, I think we should have a fresh look at various other areas. But it would be premature for me now to say that this and that will be our priorities. We are just exploring the situations as they come.

Platinum, special contest awaited Genesis in Canada

Atlantic recording group Genesis recently returned to Canada for a series of five highly successful concert dates. The British progressive rock group, riding high on international charts with their current album Duke, played major concert shows at the Montreal Forum (June 19-20), Ottawa's Civic Centre (21) and Toronto's Maple Leaf Gardens (23-24).

In Montreal, following the group's second concert, WEA Music of Canada presented Genesis with a platinum album for Duke. The group are generally credited with having broken out of the Quebec market, and following numerous albums and concert tours, they remain one of the hottest bands in that market.

Meanwhile, in Toronto, WEA Music was preparing an unusual contest in conjunction with local AOR radio station Q-107 and local Mister Sound retail stores. The contest, called 'Duke or Duchess For A Night', featured as prizes a limo ride to the Duke of Richmond restaurant for dinner, tickets to the Genesis concert and a chance to meet the band. Contestants entered either by filling out a ballot at Mister Sound listing three songs from the Duke album or by showing up at the downtown Mister Sound store dressed as a duke or duchess. Q-107 PD Gary Slaight and morning man Scruff Conners judged the best costume in a live broadcast from the store, which was decorated in medieval fashion (complete with a life-size Albert stand-up) for the occasion.

Attic's Triumph earn fourth Canadian gold

Toronto: Attic Records, based in Toronto, have achieved Canadian gold status with their latest album, Progressions Of Power. The album is the group's fourth, and all four are now gold in Canada. Two of their previous sets, Rock & Roll Machine and Just A Game, are also platinum with sales of more than 100,000 units.

Mushroom to release new Doucette album

Mushroom Records of Canada is releasing a new album from Jerry Doucette. Titled It Only Hurts The First Time, the album is the third from the Vancouver-based singer-writer-guitarist whose group, Doucette, received a Juno Award last year as Most Promising Group.

Simultaneous to the album's release will be a new single from the album, Bringing Back Your Love. Doucette will be supporting the product releases with press junkets through Canada and the U.S.

Anthem's B.B. Gabor producing second album

Toronto: Anthem recording artist B.B. Gabor, whose debut album has achieved steady sales and airplay since its release earlier this year, has returned to the studio to begin producing his second album. Gabor, who co-produced the debut with studio veteran Terry Brown, is handling production chores on the new LP himself. He has been working in Toronto's Master's Workshop and Water Street Sound in Vancouver.

Clarifying industry rumours, Gabor is not being managed by SRO Productions. He is handling his own business affairs at this time, and is involved in renegotiating his contract with ATV Music. Gabor is actually signed to ATV, a major publishing company, on a production agreement. It is through an ATV-Anthem deal that Gabor's product is released on Anthem.

Anthem Records have recently released Metropolitan Life as a second single from the Gabor debut, and the artist reports it is receiving airplay across Canada, particularly in the West. The album, which is self-titled, continues to sell steadily and is now over halfway to gold in Canada. The debut single, Nyet Nyet Soviet, continues to receive steady airplay after almost four months on the national charts.

Gabor is also receiving international activity. His album has now been released in Britain, and Metropolitan Life is being played both on Capitol Radio in London and on the gigantic Radio Luxembourg.

Meanwhile, on the home front,

Gabor and his group, Instaband, continue to tour regularly throughout Canada. The group just returned from a highly successful western tour, and are now working in Southern Ontario before returning to the West in late

September. Gabor, who is based in Toronto, is considering a move to Vancouver in the fall. His group now includes keyboard player David Stone, a former member of Max Webster.

Jeff Smith forced to sell Jeff Smith Interchange

Toronto: Jeff Smith Interchange Limited, placed into receivership on May 21 of this year, is no more. The bank has apparently forced Smith to sell all assets of the company, and in order to allow him to continue to operate, he has also been forced to sell the recording studio, Sounds Interchange Limited, the record company Change Records Incorporated, and the music publishing operation, Interchange Publishing Limited. All three companies were intertwined in a large and unique Canadian group of companies based in Toronto.

Ownership changes should take place around August 29, with veteran producer and studio owner Syd Kessler taking over control of the music industry empire Smith has been building over the past eight years.

Of the recent events, Smith noted, "It is unfortunate that the Canadian government has not, in its wisdom, seen its way clear to provide assistance for this type of industry. It is equally unfortunate that the Canadian banking circle also seems to hold little faith or belief in this industry." Smith also thanked his staff, clients and other associates.

Business will continue at all companies. The studio is booked well into the fall, and with several recent album releases, Change Records is also planning a full set of new albums and singles.

Sefel names Lorraine Hume Administrative Co-ordinator

Toronto: Lorraine Hume has been named Administrative Co-ordinator at the new Toronto-based Sefel Records. Reporting to Vice President/General Manager Paul White, Hume will be responsible for administering to the company's day-to-day activities, as well as serving in a liaison capacity with artists, producers and suppliers. She will also be organizing the company's publishing branch, which consists of Sefel Publishing (P.R.O Canada) and Palika Music (CAPAC).

Prior to joining Sefel, Hume spent almost four years with Attic Records in a variety of capacities, culminating in a position as Professional Manager of Attic's music publishing division.

RCA signs Winnipeg's Terry Crawford Band

Toronto: J. Edward Preston, Vice President and General Manager of RCA Records Canada, has announced the signing of a long-term recording contract with the Winnipeg-based Terry Crawford Band. The group is a solid rock unit fronted by the energetic female vocalist Terry Johnson, who has been described as the 'wonder woman of rock'. The signing took place in RCA's corporate office, with Preston and other key RCA personnel, attorneys for both sides, the group and manager Allan Katz present.

A debut album from the group is being slated for a September release. The set is being produced by Dixon Van Winkle and Richard Blaiken for Wam Records, a production house headed by Leon Aronsone.

Manager Katz discussed possible tour dates for the group in Canada and the northern U.S. The Terry Crawford Band is signed to Platinum Artists for Canada and the Magna Artists Agency for the States.

Under the terms of the agreement, which was concluded by Alexenburg

His expertise and all-round working knowledge of our business worldwide." Struth added, "There is no doubt in my mind that Handshake Records will develop very quickly into a major new force both here and abroad, and we are pleased to be associated with Ron and his new label here in Canada."

Handshake product will be distributed in the United States by CBS Records.

Reel Records signs its first act, Second Thoughts

London, Ontario: Reel Records, a new label formed in London by John and Helen Victor, has announced its first signing, a local new rock band called Second Thoughts. The company is preparing its initial product release, a single from the group, within the next few weeks, with a debut Second Thoughts album to follow by two months.

Reel Records evolved out of the company's Southwest Sound Studios, a facility in London which recently upgraded from 16 tracks to 24. The studio has been used by the likes of Steve Blimkie, Blue Peter, the Demics

and others. The Victors evolved the label from the studio as an outlet for some of the local talent in London and the surrounding areas.

The first example of that talent, Second Thoughts, is a four-piece group whose music is influenced by new wave. The band's membership is lead vocalist/guitarist Mark Goodwin, guitar/keyboard/sax player Bob Minderman, bassist Ralph Dame and drummer Brian Hodgson. All members contribute vocals.

Daines reached new heights in his recording career last year with his release of the single, I Don't Want To Be A Star which was culled from his album, Spirit Of The Cowboy. Both single and album chalked up impressive retail sales and airplay. A new

Canadian Country Artist of the Year to be ballot write-in

The top award to be given at Big Country this year will be a write-in on the voting ballot. Canadian Country Artist of the Year will not indicate nominations on this year's ballot and the voters can write in the name of the Canadian artist of their choice. These will be tabulated by the Big Country Awards accountancy firm and announced from the stage at the Big Country Awards banquet on September 21st at the Winnipeg Inn.

Two other catagories will also be write-ins. Top Canadian Country Television Show and Top Country Disc Jockey. Voters will write in their choice since there is no other barometer of popularity or activities from which the nominations can be drawn.

The new nomination system has received praise from many quarters but still needs some refinement and fine tuning. Big Country welcomes comments and suggestions by mail and changes will be implemented if practical and beneficial to the industry as a whole.

single, Please Take Me By The Hand, also from his Spirit album, is expected to be released during Big Country in September.

On the rodeo circuit, Daines is

currently in a race for the number one spot in bronc riding for Canada as well as being nationally rated for the world championship.

Big Country Awards revamps thinking

Walt Grealis the originator of Big Country has announced a major revision in the format of Big Country in Winnipeg September 20th & 21st.

"We will be putting in more work sessions with speakers and panels," says Grealis. "Social events will be brought down to a minimum. We want to talk about important issues and forget the in-fighting and bickering. The industry must move ahead. Everything possible has been done to give everyone a chance and now is the time for a no nonsense approach. If the complaining and the arguing

goes on, there is really no reason for the two day Big Country meeting."

Big Country began in 1973 with a two day meeting at the Holiday Inn Don Valley in Toronto. That year the event was poorly attended and lost a great deal of money. In 1974 the two day meet ended with the first Big Country Awards presentation in the Cafe De L'Auberge of the Inn On The Park.

This year's event in Winnipeg will be number eight in RPM's series of Big Country.

Joe Frechette's return to music business at CHOO

Ajax, Ontario: Since April 14 of this year, Joe Frechette has been the Program Director at country station CHOO in Ajax, Durham Region, just east of Toronto. For Frechette, the appointment marks a return to the music business he has been a part of since 1958. It also marks a new phase - - at 45 years of age, it is his first position in broadcasting.

Frechette's music career began, for all intents and purposes, in 1958, when he formed, led and fronted a recording group called the Beau-Marks. The group received a record deal with Quality Records, and in 1960, Quality released a single, Clap Your Hands.

The single took off. It went to number one in Canada, Australia and New Zealand, and reached the top 20 in the United States. The single is still active in Quality's catalogue -- 20 years later - - and through the years has continued to receive airplay as a golden oldie.

After the group dissolved, Frechette went into the music industry proper. He served as a regional promo rep for Columbia Records in Montreal from 1965 to 1968. The following year, BMI Canada (now P.R.O. Canada) named him Radio-TV Station Relations Manager. Then in 1972, he went to Capitol Records as General Manager of the company's publishing wing, Beechwood Music/Capitol Music.

Frechette left the music business in 1976 to spend two years in a family company in Montreal. Then, at age 44, he decided to follow a childhood

dream and enrolled in the Radio Broadcasting course at Humber College in Toronto. Frechette received an award as Outstanding Certificate Student, and graduated with honours in May of this year, three weeks after successfully applying for his present position at CHOO Radio.

Of his present position, Frechette noted, "I've always liked country music, and with the 1980's looking

more and more like the decade for country, I'm delighted to have the opportunity of being involved with a country music radio station. That, coupled with my desire to be in radio since my youth, has made the effort well worthwhile.

"I'm delighted to be back in the mainstream of the recording and broadcasting industries. I enjoyed the recording industry and I was fortunate to have been able to observe and work for some gracious and brilliant people - - Jack Robertson, Harold Moon,

Whitey Haines and Arnold Gosewich, to name a few. But now, I'm enjoying the experience of radio."

Programmer Frechette also discussed the music policy at CHOO. "It's our intention to develop and maintain a broad base of country music. So records that may not be played at other stations could get a decent shot with us. We also intend to maintain a broad artist interview policy. A phone call to the station is all it takes to set up an appointment to do interviews."

Stag Creek artist Wayne Rostadt coming down off a hectic tour schedule will hold his annual Gatineau Clog August 9 and 10 at Wakefield, a short drive from Ottawa.

CHOW's Fan Fair '80 set for August 17

Welland: CHOW Radio's annual daylong outdoor concert event, Fan Fair '80, is being readied to take place this year on the station's grounds in Welland, Ontario on August 17. The station feels confident that this year's event will be as big and as successful as ever.

Fan Fair '80 will see MCA recording artist George Hamilton IV headlining the event. Hamilton will be joined onstage by such notable Canadian country names as Tim Daniels, Terry Carisse, the Mercey Brothers, Marie Bottrell, Artie MacLaren and Heather Haig, among others.

There will also be local talent from the Niagara Peninsula performing at Fan Fair. They will be judged for their efforts, with the winner receiving a trip to Winnipeg for Country Music Week and the Big Country Weekend. The CHOW winner will compete in the national talent contest as part of Country Music Week. Last year's national winner in Toronto was Lynn Dee of St. Catharines, CHOW's entry from Fan Fair '79. With producer Dallas Harms working on her behalf, Dee will have a debut album on the

market shortly.

Junos date set for Feb. 5th.

Toronto: Brian Robertson, President of the Canadian Academy of Recording Arts & Sciences (CARAS) has announced Thursday, February 5 as the date for next year's Juno Awards. There will also be a change from a banquet to a theatre setting with the awards being held at the O'Keefe Centre

No decision has been made as to the Academy's choice as host or hostess for this year's event.

\$35,000 fine for pricing policy

Toronto: A&M Records has been fined \$35,000 for a pricing policy that was apparently maintained over an eight year period and obviously angered a number of the company's clients. The company had pleaded guilty in January of this year to ten charges which were levied under the federal Combines Investiation Act. Apparently there were no specific prices mentioned with regard to the label's product however, there was an indication that advertising assistance would not be available should the company's product be sold below a certain price.

A sympathetic County Court Judge, Hugh Honsberger, noted "A criminal offense has been committed, acknowledged and discontinued." He continued with "A penalty must be more than a license fee and must bear some relationship to the size of the company, its scale of operations and the nature of its product." He con-cluded with "There is no need for deterrent for this accused. It has discontinued its policy. I accept that this company was not aware that it was breaking the law. It was discontinued when they were advised that it was illegal."

Under the Combines Act, a complaint can be made against a company by six people. Their identities are never revealed. These complainants supply what information they can to the Combines Commission who in turn send an investigating team into the field to ascertain if there is sufficient evidence to proceed with

charges.
