


Gord Edwards to WEA as Nat'l Accounts Mgr.

"Peryscope is now being run by Riley O'Connor who is General Manager," said Perry. "But I'm still the President of Perryscope. Michael Cohl, who is the President of CPI, will still be involved in all aspects of

CBS Good Times promo grabs national interest

Toronto: Liz Braun, National Manager of Press and Publicity of CBS Records Canada, reported the company's summer-fall campaign, Good Times Sweepstakes, was one of their most successful.

The focal point of the sales promotion was a CBS and Kawasaki co-op that offered 10 Kawasaki motorbikes, as prizes in a consumer contest, which have been distributed to the winners across Canada.

The campaign was designed to generate heavy consumer traffic at the retail level and CBS provided over \$100,000 in promotional support for the campaign. This included the prize merchandise, a \$30,000 radio ad blitz, and \$50,000 in in-store/display materials. The materials included the motor bikes, window banners, window posters, mobiles, mounted posters, header cards, and ad pad entry forms.

A display contest was also put together and the creator of the retail display judged "the most exciting and complete" during the contest period, was awarded one of two prizes, a Kawasaki KLT-200 or a KZ-235-LTD.

Don Oates, Senior Director of Sales of CBS Canada and Bob Muir, Senior Product Manager of CBS Canada, travelled across the country to introduce the campaign to all major accounts. Several hundred accounts representatives attended the CBS receptions and were asked to fill out a ballot for a secret prize, a Kawasaki bike won by Sheldon Frymerman of Mister Sound in Toronto.

the corporation. I'm hoping that my presence here can help the Canadian concert scene. Toronto is the heartbeat of the industry and hopefully we'll be able to create a higher flow."

Perry explained that CPI has several other divisions in addition to concerts which includes movies, sports, and theatre.

"Now with two people soliciting, we hope to approach other projects," said Perry. "CPI has projects and concerts throughout Canada and the U.S. Perryscope is four years old and proud of its achievements.

"The North American concert scene is down but I don't feel there's any major problem. We're going to have to remain aggressive and hungry. The number of touring groups to pick from is smaller. The promoter's job is to make sure the groups are brought to as many people as possible. If you look at the baby boom than you can understand why it's harder today. If all you look at is transportation costs alone, Toronto is one of the most expensive cities. The promoter also has a mandate to audience diversity."

Perry believes the Canadian market will survive because audiences here are more adrenturous and actually break acts.

Quality & Platinum pact for distribution deal

Toronto: Quality Records will be the distributor of the Platinum label in Canada, with the first release being a version of the old Lesley Gore hit from the 60s, It's My Party, recorded by Dave Stewart and Barbara Gaskin.

The single, just released in Canada, is on Platinum in the U.S. and originally on the Stiff label in the U.K. where it sold three-quarters of a million copies. The song also held the number one position on the English charts for five weeks.

Another artist to be distributed by Quality in Canada through the Platinum deal is Heather, whose first release here is to be a version of the old McGuire Sisters hit, Sincerely.

Bob & Doug McKenzie reach double platinum

Toronto: Anthem Managing Director Tom Berry reports the Bob & Doug McKenzie album, Great White North, is now double platinum in Canada after only three weeks of release.

"The same reaction that happened in Canada is now happening in the U.S.," said Berry. "The album is breaking in Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Louis, Kansas and is spreading. The album is going out of the stores faster than they can stock it, and the single Take Off is the top request."

Berry added that Bob & Doug are going to the U.S. to appear on several syndicated radio shows including Rock Live and Rolling Stone. They will also be visiting New York radio stations and holding a major press conference.

Eddie Colero of Capitol reports that several competitive record company people have phoned to express their thanks for the Bob & Doug album. Says Colero "The album brought the buyers into the stores and prompted them to buy other product." Colero expects the album to reach the 300,000 units sold mark by the end of the year.

David Clayton-Thomas inks deal with Bernstein

New York: Former Blood, Sweat and Tears lead vocalist David Clayton-Thomas has signed with Sid Bernstein Associates for management. He was immediately booked for a five-city tour with the Cincinnati Pops Orchestra.

The tour, which also included Sarah Vaughan and Roberta Flack, was tagged, A Tribute To John Lennon and recently concluded at the U.S. Military Academy in West Point, New York.

His appearance with the Cincinnati Pops marks Clayton-Thomas' return to the music scene and his initial engagement as a solo performer. He is also planning to produce his own LP.

Clayton-Thomas' first Madison Square Garden appearance with Blood, Sweat and Tears was under the promotion of Sid Bernstein; establishing a professional relationship that continued through the years, which resulted in the management agreement.

"John Lennon's contribution to pop music is so monumental and so well chronicled that there isn't anything new I can add," said Clayton-Thomas. "He has had a profound influence on my own personal approach to music."

Bernstein is well-known for having brought the Beatles to Shea Stadium in New York and was also reported to have tried to get the four members back together for a reunion concert before the death of Lennon, which took place just over a year ago.

The orchestra, conducted by Erich Kunzel, performed a four-part program featurning Beatle songs with a backdrop of Lennon photos.

WEA re-releases Nonesuch classical disc line

Toronto: The Nonesuch classical recording line, which includes 163 titles, has been rereleased in conjunction with WEA Music of Canada.

In addition to the 20-year history of the catalogue, the re-launching of the line includes a Silver and Digital series which joins the Standard Series and which carries a suggested list price of \$5.98. The Silver carries a suggested list of \$9.98 while the Digital carries a suggested list of \$12.98.

In view of the demand of classical music on cassette, the Nonesuch line includes 25 titles on cassette which shipped simultaneously with the album release.

Nashville: Ralph Murphy, President of Picalic, and Mick Lloyd, General Manager of Little Giant Records and the Music City Song Festival, jointly announced the incorporation of the International Country Music Awards Gala.

Robin Eichel, Public Relations Director for ICMA advised RPM that the event, scheduled to take place in September of 1982, is to be an annual live television special "which will recognize and award those artists and songs responsible for the tremendous growth of country music throughout the world."

Participating countries, through their own voting procedure, will select their leading country music artists. These votes will then be combined to select international winners across-the-board.

Streetheart working on new LP

Streetheart is currently recording their next album at Toronto's Amber Studios. Coproducing and engineering is George Semkiw who also produced the band's debut album and laid down the re-mixes on the WEA Streetheart compilation album entitled, Action-The Best of Streetheart. The new album will be the follow-up to Drugstore Dancer released on Capitol, and is scheduled to be released in mid-January.

Vic Tanny's goes Physical

Olivia Newton-John's current MCA album release, Physical, has scored well with those involved in physical fitness. George Burns, Vice President MCA Canada, reports a highly successful campaign which he ran in conjunction with Vic Tanny's. For every new Vic Tanny membership, the first 1,000, an Olivia Newton-John album was given to the new member. It took only a few weeks for the first 1,000 albums to go and now the goal is 4,000 memberships/albums. The Physical album is now fast approaching the platinum mark.

Attic signs Nylons

Attic has signed the Toronto vocal quartet the Nylons with their debut self-titled LP to be released in February. Production is by Sean Delaney, who has also produced KISS. The quartet formed in 1979 and released the single Some People on an independent label. They recently made their U.S. debut appearance with performances in Chicago and Los Angeles. They also guested on the Doug and the Slugs single Real Enough. The quartet consists of Paul Cooper, Marc Connors, Claude Morrison and the most recent member Arnold Robinson, formerly with the Platters. The group is managed by Wayne Thompson of Absolute Entertainment.

Bob Welch Live at the Roxy

The first joint original video music production of RCA Selecta-Vision Videodiscs and RCA Records recently took place in Los Angeles when the two joined forces to tape and record Bob Welch and Friends, Live at the Roxy. The program material will be licensed to Warner Amex Satellite Entertainment Company's MTV: Music Television for telecast as an exclusive 90-minute special for late December. The former Fleetwood Mac member performed songs from his debut RCA album, which is a self-titled project. Welch also performed some of his older material and hits. RCA will produce an original video disc of the show.

A&M live EP from Adams

To keep up the momentum on Bryan Adams with his album You Want It You Got It, A&M is releasing a radio-only, live 12-inch EP recorded at the Rondun and a private party at Casa Loma in Toronto. The EP is described as "recorded to capture the live excitement of Adams." This is the first live disc

from the Vancouver rocker who is presently on tour, opening for Loverboy in the U.S. The EP contains the songs Lonely Nights, Fits Ya Good and Don't Look Now. Release is scheduled for mid-January.

Capitol gold and platinum

Capitol experienced gold fever for December with gold singles for Queen of Hearts and Angel of the Morning by Juice Newton, and Morning Train and For Your Eyes Only by Sheena Easton. Frank Mills' album Prelude To Romance is gold and nearing platinum. Juice by Juice Newton double platinum, Bob Seger's Nine Tonight platinum, Kim Carne's Mistaken Identity triple platinum, Red Rider's As Far As Siam platinum, Neil Diamond's The Jazz Singer triple platinum, Little River Band's Time Exposure gold, Cliff Richard's Wired For Sound gold, Kinks' Give The People What They Want gold, Billy Squier's Don't Say No platinum, Kenny Rogers' Share Your Love double platinum, Pat Benatar's Crimes of Passion quintuple platinum, and Debbie Harry's KooKoo gold.

Quality release for Keith Marshall

Quality Records has picked up a single by Keith Marshall titled Only Crying to be distributed on the Quality label. Marshall is a 25-year-old singer-songwriter who also produces and plays everything on the record. The single is his first song in England and he's also had success in Europe, Japan, South Africa and Australia. Marshall was inspired by artist Russ Ballard who wrote material for Marshall's first band. An LP is expected in the new year which is yet untitled.



David Bendeth makes bid for R&B revival

A group of musicians fronted by three black singers take to the stage and spontaneously start the first number.

The music is clearly a combination of funk, jazz and rock. Is it Kool and the Gang? Earth, Wind and Fire? The Isley Brothers?

Suddenly a spotlight picks out a white artist in the background slowly moving towards the front of the stage, and he suddenly lets go a searing lead guitar break. The guitarist then steps back into the shadows again while the rest of the band continues.

The guitarist is David Bendeth with his group the Bendeth Band. Bendeth is one of Canada's most respected axe players.

The Bendeth Band recently released their debut self-titled album on the Ensign label in Canada and the U.S. distributed by RCA. Produced by Bendeth, the LP contains the single Love Collect. The band has recently been on a club tour supporting the album which has included dates in Toronto, Montreal, Ottawa, and Buffalo.

"I consider our sound to be progressive R&B," said Bendeth. "Canada really is an untapped market for that kind of song. We play jazz rock with a funk groove. I like the music because it gives you a cross-section with direction. It's a kind of music that you can do a lot with, and it sounds great on radio.

"I plan to stay in this direction for a while," he said. "I probably will do a jazzrock album in the near future. Going back to your roots means giving up on a direction."

Bendeth, a short while ago, was the temporary guitar replacement for Gordie Lewis of Teenage Head following his absence due to an injury.

"Playing with Teenage Head gave me the chance to show I could play different kinds of music," said Bendeth. "When they first called to offer me the job, I told them that I felt I couldn't do it right. It was a lot of fun but that was all. You need to have a lot more than fun, although enjoying yourself is important."

Bendeth felt that a lot of Canadian radio stations are avoiding R&B.

"... A lot of R&B being played lacks colour ..."

"I'm not on any crusade but I think some programmers are assuming that there's no market for R&B," he said. "Some Canadians are missing a whole scope of music. A lot of people wrote off R&B when disco came along. A lot of the R&B that is being played lacks colour. Take a look at the amount of records that Rick James sells but many stations won't play him."

Bendeth said that Toronto has more working bands than any other place in the world, but that most of the R&B groups are doing sixties material. He also felt that so far, the eighties seem to lack direction in an artistic sense.

Many critics have often compared

Bendeth's style to that of British guitarist extraodinaire Jeff Beck who also plays jazz rock fusion, and who Bendeth jammed with on a few occassions at the British club, the Speakeasy. Bendeth maintains however that guitarist Tommy Bolan was more of an influence and that he doesn't play like Beck.

Also in the Bendeth Band are vocalists Fred and Bob Boyer, vocalist Selwynn Pitt, drummer Fred DeLong, keyboardist John Cleveland Hughes, and bassist Randy Bramwell.

Bendeth was born in England and moved to Canada as a pre-adolescent. At the age of 17 he went back to England supporting himself by working in a London record store.

At an earlier age, he took violin lessons but after hearing Cliff Richard and the Shadows, he automatically started tilting the violin like a guitar. He finally bought his first guitar by saving up Pinky stamps.

Back in Canada, Bendeth got hooked on the British guitar heroes and when he moved back to England he would skip school on Fridays to play weekend gigs out of town.

Bendeth later picked up on the black music being played by the British groups. In 1973 economic conditions in England forced him to move back to Canada. He recorded his first album, Adrenalin, in New York, which included his U.K. hit Feel The Real, which attracted the Ensign label.

It's difficult to categorize the Bendeth style, if in fact a musician should be categorized. Ed Preston, Vice President and General Manager of RCA Records Canada, perhaps says it all: "The music is not necessarily as black and white as most AM broadcasters would like. (It's more white and black) but it's good—very good!"

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

SHARI ULRICH Pop/rock One Step Ahead - A&M SP-9067-W

A west coast talent who has been simmering under for some time and who should break into prominence with this release. The session was produced at Vancouver's Pinewood Studios by Claire Lawrence. Ulrich's roots are rock but her approach is very subtle making her material and delivery acceptable across the board. A single, Save It, an Ulrich original, has been taken from the album and is already making good gains with the contemporary adult programmers. Instrumental background is enhanced by Ulrich on violin, Lawrence on guitar and sax, and very effective piano by Graeme Coleman. The keyboards and synthesizer programming was looked after by David Pickell. Background vocals are supplied by Ulrich, Jane Mortifee, Nancy Nash and drummer Marc LaFrance. Preferred cuts are Bringing Back Your Love, penned by guitarist Brent Shindel, and the co-penning by Ulrich and Lawrence of Birdman, Cancon,

that one as well. The Royal Philharmonic Orchestra came along with this Jeff Jarratt and Ron Reedman production just in time to make RCA's Christmas a much more joyous event. With today's pop/middle-of-the-road market commanding a larger than usual chunk of the business, the release was timely. You can take your pick from Hooked On Tchaikovsky, Hooked On Bach, Hooked On Mozart, Hooked On A Can Can or just Hooked On A Song, Maestro Louis Clark is, perhaps, a little out of his element but when you have professional musicians and an arranger with the ability to funk up the works of the Masters, the

combination is bound to please and could open the door for a series. Serious music needs this type of re-charging to bring it to the attention of the masses.

FRANK SODA Saturday Night Getaway Quality - SV-2093-M

The founder and only surviving member of Frank Soda and The Imps and who now bills himself as "the rock 'n roll Imp", Soda hets a production sheen from former Max Webster member Michael Tilka. Most of the cuts are Soda originals with the exception of the Cavaliere penning of Come On Up and Born To Be Wild, written by Mars Bonfire. Effective flute feature on Moon Man by Peter Crolly, no longer with the trio. Another track that has possibilities because of its creativity and concentration by Soda on delivery is Shoot To Kill that should attract the AOR programmers. With a little editing, down from 5:20, the AM rock programmers could be interested. Drummer on the session is Glen Gratto. Crolly has been replaced by Brian Gagnon,

formerly of The Hunt, Cancon.

lent here as it was on Free Fall. The rebirth of one of the main sparks behind Ten Years After, which disbanded in 1977, could be timely for this powerful guitar talent. Although Lee jumps in with three strong originals, the best tracks were penned by guitarist Steve Gould and these include Hang On and Lady Luck. Another out-standing cut is the Tina Turner penning of Nutbush City Limits. Flat out rock and rollers, Rock-N Roll Guitar Picker and Double Loser should attract the AM rockers. A note of interest is the addition of Mick Taylor, not on this session, a member of the Rolling Stones from 1969 through 1974, to Lee's touring group which will also include Fuzzy Samuels on bass and drummer Tom Compton, the latter being the drummer on this session. No single release at time of writing.

AGAM AND THE ANTS

ADAM AND THE ANTS
Prince Charming - Epic JE-37615-H
This is the third album try by this group that perform on disc as colourfully as they

look. Their music is rock with a definite difference. They have already captured a fairly large sized Canadian audience through their summer dates in Toronto and Vancouver. A major tour of Canada and the U.S. is expected for the spring. Adam is actually Stuart Goddard and, of course, he does all the vocals. The other members of this rogue ensemble are drummer Terry Lee Miall, guitarist Kevin Mooney, another drummer, who goes by the name of Merrick and another guitarist named Marco Pirroni. No single at time of writing but choice cuts are Stand And Deliver, Picasso Visita El Planeta De Los Simios or the really top choice of the title track.

DWAYNE FORD Pop/rock Needless Freaking - Sefel SEF-1003

A songwriting/performing talent from the early seventies, Dwayne Ford is a graduate from the hard knocks school. He made good moves into the business, following his close association with Ronnie Hawkins an association that taught him, if anything, the art of hanging in. Ford made his first move when he formed Atkinson, Danko and Ford, a trio that made somewhat of a splash with their initial album release. They went on to be known as Bearfoot and then disappeared. Needless to say, Ford has used this experience to his advantage and much of it shows here, particularly with Lovin' And Losing You, co-written by Ford and Derek Kendrick and taken as a single. Also preferred is The Stranger In Paradise track, a teaming of Ford and Patsy Gallant as writers, and his own solo penning of There's A Life In Me, Gallant also helps out on background vocals. Produced by Ford, David Foster and Ken

Friesen and distributed by Almada. Contemporary adult and AM rockers can fit any of these cuts into their format. Lyrics included. Cancon.



LUTHER VANDROSS R&B/pop Never Too Much - Epic FE-37451-H

One of the talents behind some very big names, Luther Vandross makes a bid for the solo market with his debut album for Epic, He's known as a background voice on several hit releases including those from David Bowie, Chic and Todd Rundgren. He's also worked as vocal arranger on releases by Donna Summer and Barbra Streisand. Another claim to fame is his voice overs on many of the top jingles in the U.S. including Kentucky Fried Chicken. An abundance of soul which puts Vandross into the R&B slot, a music form that is always acceptable. Preferred cuts from this ballsy vocalist are Sugar And Spice, You Stopped Lovin' and She's A Super Lady.


