

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

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May 7th. It was one of the first Canadian record labels to be distributed by a major, and that was Capitol back in 1970. The label was originally formed by Frank Davies and Ronnie Hawkins "with a lot of 'grease' from Australian/Canadian journalist Ritchie Yorke," Frank fondly remembers. By the way, Frank has some big and good news coming down the pipe shortly. (EC: Does it have to do with cows . . . ?)

Hey Warren, this one's for you! It didn't take much... we finally got Tom Williams to surface. Remember Tom... he founded Attic Records many moons ago with Al Mair. We got a rise out of him over the recent comments from Warren Cosford and, after quaffing "62½ beers" he penned the following: Dear Walt-Although I admit that I'm looking forward to Altzheimer's Disease as an excuse for my memory, I feel I must take issue with Warren Cosford's statement that FACTOR was his idea.

He may indeed have been part of the CHUM team at that time, but as the person who first met with Jim McLaughlin and Chuck McCoy at Moffat's Winnipeg offices and subsequently at the CHUM boardroom, my memory tells me that J. Bob, Duff, Earl Rosen and myself (plus probably some others) hammered out the concept.

At the time, both the CHUM Group and the Moffat Group were putting all of their money into things like big band concerts, while Bob Wood in particular was concerned about the lack of programmable Canadian records. It was these two factors (clever what?) which led CIRPA to suggest that they should find some way of solving three problems: 1) the lack of new records, 2) the money wasted by stations as part of their proof of performance, and 3) the lack of funds for Canadian records.

There is no question in my mind that the CHUM group came up with the idea of a production, and Warren may have been part of that decision making group, but it is my recollection that most of my meetings were with Duff Roman and (sometimes) J. Robert Wood. It also must be recognised that without the immediate, and indeed, enthusiastic support of Chuck McCoy and Jim McLaughlin I think that FACTOR would have been viewed by the industry as CHUM grandstanding in front of the CRTC.

I well remember that first meeting between CHUM, Moffat and CIRPA in the CHUM boardroom. It was like three old gunfighters getting together in the OK Corral, each of them manoevering to get the sun behind their back, only to discover at the end of the day that they had more in common with each other than they did with the hangers on. To be fair, Jim Sward may also have been present at this meeting, but my recollection is that Rogers was not brought in until the broad outlines of FACTOR had been set up. We did use the Rogers boardroom for all our meetings for at least the first two years while I was involved.

Not being part of the business anymore, I don't know whether FACTOR is working or not, but if it isn't CHANGE IT! If the recording industry is becoming like the publishing industry and can't exist without government handouts, then perhaps it doesn't deserve to exist. If people who get

FACTOR loans who are successful don't pay their fair share back, abolish it.

But Warren, don't confuse this issue with the one of Neighbouring Rights. It has always struck me that the smallest part of a broadcaster's budget is devoted to music. The major stations at least, get most of their programming for free and yet 90 percent of their programming is based on music. I own a restaurant now and 90 percent of my programming (food and booze) is the major portion of my budget . . . the other 10 percent is entertainment . . . me insulting the customers. (signed) Tom Williams, Pals, Aurora, Ontario. (EC: He sure talks a lot!) He had more to say . . . and that's when he told me he that while watching this year's Juno Awards show he counted 621/2 beer commercials and being a big supporter of Cancon he supported the sponsors by cracking open a bottle everytime a beer commercial came on. (EC: 621/2 beers?)

What a party Carmen throws . . . ! I've never seen so many celebrities jammed into one room before. It was the annual York Region Celebrity Banquet which raises money to help the Variety Club and the Heart & Stroke Foundation of Ontario. Carmen Di Paola, who left the music industry a few years ago to become one of the most successful realtors in Canada, organized the big bash. Last year the banquet raised \$110,000 net. I had the opportunity to sit with hockey great Frank Mahovlich and Ben Johnson. It was interesting standing there, talking to both Stan Kulin and Paul Burger, a unique opportunity to have the attention of both of them at the same time in the same place . . . and what a gabfest that was. Isn't it interesting how these charity parties bring people together.(EC: All in the name of charity!)

It's only rock 'n' roll . . . ! Record companies have become so rock 'n' roll oriented that when something else comes along . . . they just don't know how to handle it. Which leads to a recent remark that if it wasn't for the radio stations and the record companies . . . the Lambada would be number one!!! That same mind thinking is also holding back the eventual breakthrough of country music into the mainstream. But give it time. In spite of the RS and RC resistance, in about six months, we'll hear a new sound . . . and it won't ONLY be rock n' roll!! (EC: The doors are wide open!!)



Industry veteran MacNeil introduces CD Lock Box

Hector MacNeil, with many years of experience in both the record manufacturing and record retail fields, has teamed with his brother Robert, who is President of the Waterloo, Ontario-based Hergott Plastics, to launch a Security CD Lock Box. The attractively designed locking system, measuring 30.3 cm x 14.7 cm x 1.5 cm, allows for the display of two CDs in the space of one LP.

Made of durable polypropylene plastic, the secure, easy to use locking device has already attracted the attention of major retail chains. MacNeil has secured a large-sized order from the Sam The Record Man chain and expects to close several other "large" orders over the next couple of weeks. The Lock Box carries a low introductory price (less than seventy cents), which expires June 9, 1990.

Established in 1947 by William H. Hergott in St. Clements, Ontario, the company introduced Plastic Injection Moulding in 1956 and by 1960 Hergott

Alexander Mair, President Attic Records, Canada's largest independent label, has announced that the first quarter of 1990 was the biggest in the company's history.

"First quarter domestic sales were up a fantastic 1549 percent over 1989," boasts Mair, "and most other areas of income, both domestic and international are surpassing 1989."

The increase was obviously fueled by platinum plus releases from Lee Aaron and Maestro Fresh Wes. Excellent sales were also registered for Sybil, John James and others, particularly in the dance area.

"Attic is hot," says Mair, and he points out that "Major releases in the second quarter by Digital Underground and others as well as the introduction of the Malaco catalogue indicate Attic will complete its fiscal year (June 30, 1990) with the highest sales in its 16 year history."

Mair concludes with, "New releases after June 30 by Haywire and a major international artist who cannot yet be identified . . . and a couple of pending acquisitions, should keep Attic red hot into 1991."


Songwriters Association dips into public purse

Ontario Culture and Communications Minister Christine Hart presented a cheque in the amount of \$40,000 to the Songwriters Association of Canada "for the promotion of Ontario-based musicians," at the upcoming New Music Seminar to be held in New York (July 14-18).

A special CD featuring 39 Canadian artists, 28 of whom are Ontario-based, will be produced by the Songwriters Association and Intrepid Records. Titled Indie Can '90, the CD will be distributed at the NMS.

The Ministry of Culture and Communications (MCC), together with Communications Canada, External Affairs Canada and the Canadian Consulate General in New York, are supporting the production of a Canadian promotional package.

The provincial grant is a joint project of MCC's Cultural Industries and Agencies branch and the "Arts Abroad" program of the ministry's Arts Branch. As well as funding for Indie Can '90, a reception in New York where four Canadian bands will be showcased and the production of a brochure describing the event will be government assisted



And the Nominees are....

Q: What are the Big Country Awards? A: An annual banquet, held on Sunday evening, at which time the award winners are revealed and awards presented. This evening event is not to be confused with the Variety Club Luncheon saluting the Big Country Awards, which will take place on the Friday prior to the actual Big Country Awards presentation.

O: How are the nominees picked?

A: Nominations are based on chart action in RPM over the previous year. The ballots are mailed to all RPM subscribers. This gives us a very good mix of voters and makes it impossible for blocks and pockets to control the voting. The winners will be known only when the envelopes are opened onstage at the actual awards banquet.

Q: Will the awards feature musical performances?

A: No. The dinner will be followed by the awards ceremony at which time the presenters will open the envelopes and announce the winners. The whole event is designed to be an industry get together and it is a unique opportunity for the heavyweights in the industry to get to know one another and possibly do a deal. One night set aside for the industry, It's very unique.

Q: How many categories are there?

A: Exactly one dozen (12). The Big Country Awards are very coveted awards and are not given out in large numbers. They carry a great deal of prestige for the industry. Q: Will there be meetings and conferences tied into this event?

A: No. We believe there is much going on now, and there's no further need for additional conferences.

Q: Isn't \$100 per person a little too expensive for a banquet?

A: Actually it isn't. That price is all inclusive. Once you pay the \$100, you have paid it all. There are no other charges: for parking, drinks, checking or dinner wine. coat Everything is included. The evening will be a very posh affair in a very elegant setting, designed to bring prestige to the Canadian country music industry. It's an event for the industry. Once a year we get together for a very special industry evening. Your payment will be confirmed to you by telephone and FAX and your table arrangements will be handed to you at the door. Cocktails are at 7 pm and dinner is at 8 pm. Dress elegantly but not black tie.

Q: Is it possible to reserve a table?

A: Yes. Tables of 8, 9 or 10 can be reserved ahead, if you get a group together and arrange that they all pay prior to 4 pm May 25. Mail all the payments in the same envelope. We must have all the names in advance.

Q: Will it be possible to pay at the door?
A: Definitely not! For an event of this kind, advance planning makes it impossible to arrange any additional meals. You must be confirmed at least four days prior to the banquet.

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The Partland Brothers - a fresh start with new LP

If G.P. and Chris Partland are feeling any of the dreaded second album anxiety, they're not letting on.

That may be because their new Capitol album, Between Worlds, is as much a fresh start as a follow-up to their 1986 debut Electric Honey, Although it generated a modest hit in Soul City, which went Top 30 on the RPM chart and did equally well on major U.S. trade charts, Electric Honey was not the grand success the Partlands had hoped for, and troubles with their management kept the pair sidelined until 1989.

Perhaps the hiatus explains the energy and enthusiasm with which the Partlands approached the recording and promoting of Between Worlds. The brothers explain how they were intent on firmly seizing the reins and producing an honest, down-to-earth album that eschewed the synthesizers and slickness of Electric Honey.

"We went out of our way this time to make sure there were no click tracks, no synthesizers . . . if it can't be played by a human being, then forget it," says G.P., while Chris recalls the problems posed by an over-reliance on technology, "When you get on stage and try to do that stuff, all the synthesizers and everything, it's really tough to play it live. If we had a breakdown on a computer, we were lost. But this way, even if the drummer and the bass player are sick, we can still sing the songs with acoustics.

The desire to get back to basics and take

chances extended to the recording process itself. "This album is basically just myself and G.P. playing all the rhythm stuff, and it's basically all live off the floor without anybody knowing any of the songs beforehand," explains Chris. "The band was in there learning songs right there on the spot. and then we just laid them on tape. That was really neat for us to do, because we've always wanted to do that. We wanted to get that [spontaneous feel]. We found that last time we sat down and worked things out for hours on end and we kept destroying the songs. So we let the songs just sort of happen. Of course," he laughs, "you can hang yourself that way, too."

The success of the album's first single. Honest Man, which is now climbing the RPM singles chart, is evidence that they did not hang themselves, and that their hard-won experience is paying off. "The first time in the studio you don't have a lot of knowledge about what would make the song work better . . . how to progress with it," says G.P. "The first time it was ten days and we did the ten bed tracks for the ten songs. On this one we did two songs at a time, finished them, went in and recorded four more, finished them . . . so everybody got a feel for the songs."

For Between Worlds, the Partlands were firmly at the helm. The brothers agree they felt much more in control of this second project. But they admit their debt to the other musicians on the album and to producer Jon Goldsmith, all of whom "contributed a lot to the tracks," according to Chris. "We were looking for producers like crazy," he remembers, "and we ended up talking to Jon (Goldsmith), and he hit it right on the nose, exactly what we wanted to do with this record. He saw that we wanted to do a live

Royal Alexandra to stage Buddy (Holly) musical

The London smash hit musical Buddy is scheduled for a limited engagement at Toronto's Royal Alexandra Theatre beginning June 16. The Toronto production will then move to Calgary and San Francisco before opening at New York's Shubert Theatre (home of A Chorus Line for fifteen years) on Oct. 23.

American actor Paul Hipp will reprise his role as Buddy Holly, whose rise to fame is chronicled by the play. Hipp was nominated for a Laurence Olivier Award for his role in the London production of the show, which received a nomination in the Best Musical category. Other principals for the Toronto production include Canadians David Mucci, Bobby Prochaska and Melanie Doane.

Attic Records will be releasing an Original London Cast Recording album to coincide with the musical's Toronto premiere.

thing, and he suggested doing it live off the floor without us even saving anything. So we took a chance and it worked out. He did a fabulous job." They have similar praise for drummer Jon Anderson, bassist Steve Webster and guitarist Rob Piltch, all talented veterans. "We also had some great appearances by Bill Dillon, who is Robbie Robertson's guitarist," says Chris. "What he brings to the tracks is something really spiritual . . . you don't have to say anything to him."

The resulting album has been described as both gritty and upbeat and positivesounding. "That's just the way we are, I guess," muses Chris. "We tried to make it as real as possible. I don't want to go up on stage every night and sing a depressing song. I don't believe that music is some big 'Oh I've created a monster' type of thing. It's just a vehicle. We just let the music sort of pass through us."

The Partland Brothers bring the same energy to talking about the album that they did to recording it, and they say they are eager to take it on the road. "Unfortunately, we didn't do a lot of this with the last album," recalls Chris. "We didn't generate a lot of success at the start in this country. And then we went to America and sort of broke big there . . . and we didn't pay a lot of attention [to Canada], and we kind of feel really bad and almost guilty about it. because we love this country so much. We wanted to a lot of playing across this country, so that's what we're going to do right now.'

Adds G.P., "Now is the best time to go out and see Canada anyway . . . it's beautiful this time of year."

BASIC ENGLISH Sweet Panic Risque Disque - CD-71031-P

Basic English has a limited vocabulary: no frills guitar-bass-drums rock. But Sweet Panic still packs a punch. The album is full of strong songs, notably Images Of Love, Love Don't Wait, Sentimental Highway, Last Mile and Don't Have To Dance - catchy, energetic rock 'n' roll with a countryish flavour. Any one of them would make a fine single. The band comes on like an edgier Blue Rodeo and the album suggests they're probably a great live act. Only complaints: a slightly murky mix which doesn't allow the vocals to be heard to full effect, and some truly hideous album art. But you can't judge a record by its cover. Cancon (CD reviewed)

MARIANNE FAITHFULL Pop Blazing Away Island · ISLC-1272-W

In the liner notes, Marianne Faithfull describes this live album - recorded in November 1989 at St. Ann's Cathedral in Brooklyn, N.Y. - as "my life story on tape". It is this intimacy which invests Blazing Away with its harrowing emotional power. Crisp production and restrained but brilliant backing by a stellar band which includes Dr. John. The Band's Garth Hudson and Faithfull's longtime collaborator Barry Reynolds, let Faithfull's voice - rough, scarrred, but hauntingly beautiful - do the talking. The thirteen songs span her entire career, from her 1964 hit As Tears Go By (given whole new meaning 25 years later), through cathartic tracks like Sister Morphine, Why'd Ya Do It? and The Ballad Of Lucy Jordan, up to recent ballads such as Tom Waits' Strange Weather. Two new songs, When I Find My Life and Blazing Away (the only track which was not recorded live), are every bit as striking as the classics, if a bit more hopeful. (cassette reviewed)



KEVIN WELCH Country Kevin Welch - Reprise - 9 26171-4-P

Add to the list of the new breed of country, Kevin Welch, who has already found a comfortable niche on Nashville's Music Row. He has written hits for Gary Morris, Moe Bandy, Don Williams, Ricky Skaggs and more and now it's his turn. Welch has a quirky way of projecting his pure and straight-ahead vocals, perhaps best displayed on his first single, Till I See You Again, already charted. There's enough western and folk in this production to make the more avant-garde cringe, but that's what could be Welch's door-opener. What you hear is what you get, pure Welch, no trade-offs, no mimicking others. Also key are Long Way Home, True Love Never Dies and Hello, I'm Gone. Lyric sheet included. Watch for Welch to break big. (cassette reviewed)



DOUG STONE - Country Doug Stone - Epic - BEK-450303-H

There's a new country voice on the scene and Georgia native Doug Stone has made more of an impact with his debut than most first-timers. I'd Be Better Off (In A Pine Box), the first single from this album, is already bulleting up the RPM Country 100 (No. 33 this week). There's something familiar about this traditionalist's vocal delivery, yet it's a style of his own that obviously caught the attention of country programmers. Also key are David Lee Murphy's penning of High Weeds And Rust, and, what could be a complete left-fielder, My Hat's Off To Him, written by Randy Boudreaux. (CD reviewed)

SCOTT McQUAIG · Country Scott McQuaig · Capitol · C2-93914-F

Coming from Meridian, Mississippi, the hometown of Jimmie Rogers, Scott McQuaig takes country that extra mile with a gentle mix of honky tonk and ballads with a real message. Nothing pretentious about McQuaig's approach or delivery, he's bang

on with a vocal confidence that should win him a chart berth soon. He could do it with his first single, Old Memory, a ballad that's just made for summer nights. Honky Tonk Amnesia and The Little Senorita With Green Eyes are also key. (CD reviewed) - WG



GARY MORRIS - Country/Pop Stones - Capitol - C2-90307-F

Gary Morris has certainly spanned the music field over the past few years. He's as comfortable with A/C or easy listening as he is with country, although it's country where he is best known, and where he could be more popular. It's been a little while since he's had a hit, but with Jimmy Bowen behind him as producer and head honcho of Capitol's country division, anything can happen. His first single from this album, So Little Love In The World, could be an uphill battle for chart action. He sounds real good on Chrome Plated Heart, and Never Had A Love Song, but don't overlook the title track. (CD reviewed)

SUFFERIN CATFISH - Comedy Food For Thought Warped Records - WPD9001

If you're looking for that showstopper, this hilariously funny and exceptionally well produced comedy album will do that old "light up the switchboard" thing. Sufferin' Catfish are Hans "Rusty" Winker and Somerset Novak, and the timing isn't bad either for The Meech Lake Accordion and The Budget Song. Also key are Hockey Night In Canada and Receding Hairline. This is big stuff with Campus Radio and CBC. Try Receding Hairline on your morning audience and Meech Lake Accordion anytime. THE 4 OF US Songs For The Tempted Columbia - BCT-46025-H

Songs For The Tempted is an intriguing, if not wholly successful debut from this Northern Irish quartet. The band's R&B and soul-influenced sound is polished; obviously they spent a lot of time working on these songs, which the band wrote, performed and co-produced. When the tracks work - as Mary, Jolene, Lightning Paul and Washington Down do - they're fun. sophisticated rockers which suggest that The 4 Of Us may develop a distinctive sound around their big, soulful production and surprisingly sensitive guitar work. The less successful tracks, though, don't have the song to support the production; as a result they're all revved up with no place to go. The band's first two Irish singles, Just Can't Get Enough and Drag My Bad Name Down, fall into this category, which didn't stop them becoming Top 10 hits in Ireland. Given time, The 4 Of Us may develop into something special (cassette reviewed)

Calgary truck driver Bill Blayney, who was born in Sarnia, Ontario, is the latest to join Scoot Irwin's talent roster. Blayney was lead guitarist for the North Forty Band, the house band of the North Forty Honky Tonk when it won the Battle of the Country Bands in 1988 and he was a semi-finalist in the 1989 Bud Country Rising contest. Blayney makes his solo debut with Fifty Thousand Pounds Of Steel, one of his own originals, produced by Dave Hamilton and engineered by Rob Bartlett. While he was with the North Forty Band he worked with several artists including Monika With A K, Denny Eddy, Marvin Garriot, Valinda Lee and the late Al Cherney. He most recently played lead guitar on a recording with Rick Wells in Calgary.

Lynne & The Rebels look for CD action One of the few country acts to move into the world of the compact disc, Lynne & The Rebels are off with rebel-u-tion, an actionpacked CD released on the Roto Noto label. The band is currently charting with Boy Next Door, included on the CD, but which was first introduced to country programmers as a track on the Roto Noto CD, Audio Radiance For The Radio Audience, a compilation of Roto Noto artists put together by Randall Cousins. Cousins did most of the producing on the new CD, but was also assisted on a few tracks by songwriter Paul Hotchkiss and producers Bob Deidge and John Setej. The cover artwork, a photo of a truck on fire, is the work of Mark Lapointe, Gary Kruchka and

The show will be hosted by Shelly Mangrum. Michelle Wright, now signed to Arista's Nashville division and breaking in the U.S. with New Kind Of Love, her initial single for the label, will be showcased on the Arista Show on June 8 with Asleep At The Wheel, Exile, Alan Jackson and Lee Roy Parnell. Gerry House will host the show.

CFGM-Bud talent search - May 16

The Birchmount Tavern in Scarborough (Toronto) will stage the Toronto area finals in the CFGM-Bud Country National Talent Search on May 16. It has literally taken nine weeks to wade through the hundreds of hopefuls, now trimmed to a "six-pack of the best new crop of country music talent around," says CFGM's new Promotion Director Peter Taylor. The grand prize winner will get studio time to cut two complete songs (producer, musicians etc. included), national distribution of the completed record by a major label plus \$5,000 cash."But it doesn't stop there," says Taylor. "The winner will fly to Edmonton in September for Country Music Week to compete in the National Finals and a shot at another \$10,000 in prize money."


