

Boomtang Boys breaking ground "single" handedly

It has been a long adventurous road for Toronto's Boomtang Boys including a 1995 Juno Award for their work on Camille's Deeper Shade Of Love and

a nomination for another Juno for their production of Charlene Smith's Feel The Good Times. However their latest single Squeeze Toy which features Kim Esty on vocals in English and Diane Di Vito in French has brought the multi-faceted trio to the dance forefront snaring the attention of programmers and more significantly retailers across Canada. The commercially released single grabbed the #1 spot at retail holding big named internationally recognized artists like Cher, 'N Sync, Savage Garden and The Spice Girls down. Shania Twain and Alanis Morissette were the only other Canadian artists to ever hold the #1 spot on the retail singles chart.

The Boomtang Boys' Tony and Paul Grace and vocalist Kim Esty came by the RPM offices to lend a little insight about the group and their plans for promoting their upcoming Virgin Music Canada album oddly titled Greatest Hits.

Paul a deejay at some of Toronto's major dance spots for a good ten years and Tony a longtime drummer, who spent his teenage years in U2-



inspired new wave bands, combined their musical backgrounds in the late '80s forming Fun Wow Records. From their home studio they managed to release two singles before hooking up with Rob DeBoer in 1991 to launch The Boomtang Boys.



Throughout the first five years of TBB they released about 18 singles as well as producing and remixing material for other notable Canadian artists.

It wasn't an easy task releasing vinyl singles in Canada from the onset with vinyl manufacturers packing up with the introduction of the compact disc, but Paul had made a few friends in the business as an import buyer for Star Sound and got their tracks manufactured and released in the U.K.

The evolution of The Boomtang Boys, as recording artists, through the early '90s hinged predominantly on word of mouth as well as an inviting UK industry which is one of the reasons they leaned towards dance as their preferred genre as Tony recalled "For one thing it is something we like to do. We always liked dance music. Secondly as opposed to any other musical genre I can think

of, dance for us was the most cost efficent. We could put out a record fairly cheap. We had at

that time established a relationship in Europe with a vinyl manufacturer because of Paul's job as an import buyer. We weren't able to press vinyl in



Canada at that time so we had it done in the UK.'


Tonys adds "With dance you can release a single in the UK and people will review it. That was a great advertising avenue for us." Paul cites "the clubs were also great advertising for us too." Tony explained further that the U.K. press had "a more loyal and higher readership than here in Canada and at that time television wasn't as prominent so we were able to generate a lot of excitement on the streets just through our reviews."

Although the singles market was all but dead in Canada the U.K. singles market was flourishing and a single release was a viable marketing tool that garnered bands a lot of consumer attention.

Paul reflects on a conversation with John Reid regarding singles "where John came from (London) everything was totally singles oriented and that is what drives the market. But he couldn't understand why it wasn't the same way in Canada. So we talked about revitalizing the singles market in Canada. You just have to make the effort to promote them. When you look at a whole album, it is just a series of singles. I love the idea of conceptual albums and that sort of stuff and I am a big jazz fan but there is something exciting about singles. I would like to see the singles market come back."



Obituary

Bruce Fairbairn's sudden death shocks industry.

The global recording industry has lost one of its most illustrious rock music producers with the sudden passing of Bruce Fairbairn at age 49. Mr. Fairbairn died suddenly at his home in Vancouver on May 17 of undetermined causes.

Mr. Fairbairn's career spanned almost 25 years during which time he figured significantly in the careers of Aerosmith, AC/DC, Van Halen, Bon Jovi, the Cranberries, INXS, KISS, Loverboy and Prism. At the time of his death he was working on the new studio album for Yes.

Born in Vancouver in December of 1949, Mr. Fairbairn learned to play the trumpet at age five. By the time he entered his teens he was fronting various west coast R&B bands. He met Jim Vallance, drummer for Sunshyne, in the '60s. (Vallance is best known for his work in later years with Bryan Adams.) They produced a demo tape together, the end result being Prism. Mr. Fairbairn decided early that the road wasn't for him, and began concentrating on the production console. Loverboy took Mr. Fairbairn's career to the next level with more than eight million albums sold in North America. International acclaim came his way with Bon Jovi's chart topping, 13 million selling Slippery When Wet.

It was Mr. Fairbairn's quiet demeanour and his straight forward manner in working with artists that distinguished him among his peers. It was because of his reputation that superstars lined up to utilize his production skills.

Sheila Copps says "hands off" Internet

Heritage Minister Sheila Copps, speaking to the Canadian broadcasters in Vancouver, revealed that the government doesn't intend to attempt to regulate the Internet with Canadian content regulations, similar to those for radio and television.

Copps was quick to point out that although the government had backed away from the contentious Internet issue, she and her government is still intent in maintaining Canadian content rules in broadcasting and magazine publishing.

Although Copps admitted that it wouldn't be practical for the government to get involved in the Internet at this time, because of its rapidly changing technology, she did leave the door open for another look-see, perhaps in five years. "Bruce was a friend, a colleague and a client," manager Bruce Allen fondly recalls. "We grew up in this business together and shared a love for music that ran the gamut from punk rock to classical. I admired him not only as a fabulous musician and producer but also as a man who placed a tremendous value on his family and friends. We've lost a great man."

Tower hosts in-store for Phantom's Paul Stanley

Billed as "the world's largest independent music and entertainment retailer," Tower Records was scheduled to host a rare appearance by Paul Stanley, founding member of KISS at its Toronto location, 2 Oueen Street West, on May 22.

Stanley makes his debut as the Phantom of the Opera, at the Pantages Theatre on June 2, which has been running for 10 years years. At the in-store, KISS and Phantom fans were expected to enter into dialogue with Stanley during a 40 minute question and answer session, mediated by Q107 which was also to provide a live to air feed. An autograph session was to follow.

Stanley and his fellow band members began performing and recording as KISS in 1974. They have released 24 albums with Stanley, regarded as one of the most influential rock musicians of the last 25 years, going solo for one album



JAMIE HAMILTON - Country Self-titled Ocean-01-21-99

Born in Campbellville. Ontario and now living in Windsor, Hamilton has a unique handle on country music. There's no pretention here, he has developed his own style and above all a structuring of his song material that leaves no

doubt that he is in control. Most of the material was written by Hamilton, a natural-born poet, which is so obvious on It's Our Time, the first single and a hot summer offering. The same goes for Workin' Man, which should be a followup. Hamilton has the balladeering tact down to a tee. His club act must be a killer. Keyboardist Craig Allen, no slouch when it comes to styling himself, wrote two of the songs, Texas Heart and Normandy, both beautifully interpreted by Hamilton. Although a countrified title, Texas Heart has crossover possibilities. Also key is You Said Yes, which could become an anthem for wedding songs. Hamilton wrote it for his brother's upcoming wedding where he will perform the song as well. It's a bit of a tearjerker, a treasured keepsake for their mom. The album was recorded at Ocean Studios in Windsor, where it was produced by Larry Thompson (who wrote Long Train Ride), with Allen and Jack Genaro credited as executive producers. Great pickers on the session, particularly fiddle prodigy, 20-year old Dan McGrath, who was joined by guitarist Rene Comeau (who wrote Here's To You), steelman Dale Rivard, drummers Gary Craig and Vic Mizzi, Peter Bleakney and Ryan Fountain on bass, producer Thompson on keys, and guitars, and Thompson, C.J. Joan Charette, Linda Peleshok, Steve Davis, Bob Scott and Ian Smith on background vocals, all of whom contributed to this highly professional session. IAN TYSON Lost Herd Stony Plain-1255-P

- Country/Folk

As Canadian cowboys go, there's only one who just happens to be a singing cowboy, and that's lan Tyson, once Canada's only folk hero. He now lives the life of a cowboy/rancher in the foothills of the Canadian Rockies. A born poet, Tyson has come a long way from Four Strong



Winds, but the folk roots are still there, which gives him that edge when it comes to writing and performing what he probably intended to be pure country. You can pick it up with any of these ten tracks, particularly with the title track and Summer's Gone the latter featuring exceptionally sensitive sax work by Phil Dwyer, and a track that should be targeted to A/C radio. Brahmas And Mustangs, which he wrote with Dick Jones has a mean kick and La Primera has a nice flamenco feel to it, courtesy Jesse Cook. To say this is Tyson's best album yet, might be a bit of an overstatement, but he'll certainly maintain his status as the best singing cowboy this country has. He split his recording sessions between Calgary, Toronto and Nashville, and there's a noticeable difference. He produced the Calgary (Night Deposit Sound Studio) and Nashville (Seventeen Grand Recording) sessions, the latter with Steve Buckingham and Danny Greenspoon laid out the Toronto session at McClear Pathe, a studio that's a cut above many in North America. No matter where he recorded, he packed the sessions with the best pickers in the business with an abundant use of horns. fiddles, cellos, keyboards and, of course acoustic guitars. Oh yes! Tyson treats us here to a song he didn't write, the old film chestnut Harold Arlen's Somewhere Over The Rainbow. It won't be an anthem, but a nice closer. -WG

It's all very laid back and, production values aside, almost like cocktail music. Given the present ages of those who were growing up when the music first appeared, it's quite appropriate. Footnote: Like most guitarists, Frank Vignola can play banjo though obviously not here. In 1979 when he was 14, he won the Grand National Banjo Championship in Canada. JULIE REEVES - Country It's About Time

Virgin has eased into country with the release of Reeves' debut album. The first single, the title track written by Mark Sanders and Ed Hill,



didn't get the break it should have, but it certainly got her the ears of country programmers on both sides of the border, setting her up beautifully for the follow-up Although there are a number of radio friendly tracks, He Keeps Me In One Piece written by Dan Loggins would be a barnburner for Reeves, whose vocal properties go without question. It's that gutsy vocal approach and her exceptional talent in interpreting the works of others that puts her in the "artist to watch"

category. Also patch into Marv Green's penning of What I Need, If Heartaches Had Wings, written by Jody Alan Sweet or If I'd Never Loved You from the team of Bob Regan and Aimee Mayo. A left fielder could be the country rocker Trouble Is A Woman. The album was produced by Scott Hendricks and Trey Bruce. -WG




DUKE ELLINGTON - Jazz Artistry **Best Of Centennial Edition** RCA Victor-9026-63459-N

It's 60 minutes and 20 seconds of sheer enjoyment listening to Duke Ellington's representative best of the best from 1927's Black and Tan Fantasy to 1967's Raincheck. There's no need to list them all; they're all familiar and truly classic. Still, we must admit personal disappointment that Cotton Tail and the wondrously evocative Translucency aren't included. It seems regrettable too that the liner notes aren't always satisfactory. On Come Sunday, for example, there's a wonderful solo by a mezzo-soprano but nowhere could we find

her name. The vocalist isn't listed either for My Old Flame. It might have been lvie Anderson but one can't be certain. We're probably being picayune. Simply enjoy. -BW

AVISHAI COHEN - Jazz Classical Devotion Stretch-9021

Avishai Cohen is an all 'round accomplished instrumentalist but his chief strength is the bass, both acoustic and electric. He can and should be legitimately proud of his versatility with them. It would seem to this ear however, that pride has veered perilously close to hubris as he leads a group of musicians through a programme of his own compositions featuring said basses. It doesn't succeed. Oh, there are a few opening measures on some of the compositions that tease one with the romantic sound at which the bass can excel when not simply a rhythm accompaniment but they soon descend into discordant and silly syncopation. Still, the album represents at the very least, a good effort. Maybe next time? -BW

What's Happenning

Z95.3FM is #1 for the first time in history. The Vancouver radio station reports that the BBM radio ratings released May 20 show that the station (part of Standard Radio) is now the #1 radio station in Vancouver with a weekly cume reach of more than 691,000 listeners and total hours tuned of 4,788,100, a 13.3 share. CKNW is next with a 13.3 share as well, but as the BBM rounds shares to the nearest 1/10th, Z95.3 has 13.3144 shares as opposed to CKNW's 13,3068 shares. The other stations and their share are CFOX (8.2), CFMI (8.0), CHQM (7.4), CKKS (7.3), CJJR (4.5), CKBD (4.1), CISL (2.6), CKWX (2.6), CFUN (2.0), and CKLG (0.8).

MIX 99.9 #1 WITH 18-34's, up 13.3 per cent in quarter hour averages from the fall of '98, according to the latest BBM ratings. In circulation 12+, the station is Toronto's #2 radio station with 1,127,822 listeners tuning in on a weekly basis. J.J.Johnston, vice-president of programing for the station boasts that "after a tough year and a half battle, the MIX's Rob Christie in the morning show defeated Howard Stern in circulation, quarter hour averages and share." Johnston also points out that the station is #1 overall 18-34, 25-34, Female 18-34, Female 25-34, and most male demo's including 18-34, 25-34, 18-44, 18-49, 18-54, 25-44, 25-49 and 25.54.

CFRB 1010 is #1 in news talk according to the BBM radio ratings. The station posted significant gains in several key ratings, but what's most important is the fact that the Ted Woloshyn Morning Show continues as the #1 radio morning show in Canada with an average quarter-hour audience of 126,500 listeners. It was also pointed out that Woloshyn also hosts "the highest exclusive morning show audience in Toronto - 397,600 listeners (12+)"

A big win for Oldies 1090 and KOOL-FM who took home three gold, three silver and three bronze awards as the priority winners of The 1999 Icon Awards. The awards are presented annually by The Kitchener-Waterloo Sales and Advertising Club "celebrating excellence in advertising," spanning all media. In the Radio Promotion category, Decora Homes and KOOL-FM took home the metal with "a groundbreaking announcement" which heralded the launch of The Kool-FM Millennium Fantasy Home. Both stations shared a bronze award with the Owen/Holleway



Group in the Retail Radio-Campaign. "We have a team of dedicated, passionate, talented individuals, fuelled by caffeine," crowed Steve Thompson, manager of creative services, "who work hard to create fun, effective, strategically targeted messages for our clients and listeners. 


