OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Johnson Party of Four/FALL OUT/Swann AW14010 (Amateur hour. This demo tape on vinyl doesn't have the foggiest idea about what it wants to be when it grows up. It's watered down R&B, jazz and rock. Churn 'em out. Write: IRDA, 55 Music Sq. West, Nashville, Tenn. 37203.)

Cathy Saunders/SWEET & GENTLE/Bud's Records AW 14031 (Sweet & Gentle is a joke. The music contained inside is non-vintage 1950's rock & roll, both in style and recording quality. Beside being miss-named, the set order is wrong too. Issued 20 years late. Write: IRDA, 55 Music Sq. West, Nashville, Tenn. 37203.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

Abba/THE ALBUM/Atlantic SD 19164 (Abba is so pop that normally they wouldn't get considered. However, on this Lp the first track "Eagle" moves them into the realm of usefulness. The track is majestic and sports a grit which is lacking in all of their other work.)

Dr. Buzzard's Original Savannah Band/MEETS KING PENETT/RCA AFL 1-2402 (This marvelously avant dance band borrows ideas from forefront musicians and applies them in a standard context. Their genius is to know which outside moves can work. Stimulating.)

Art Garfunkel/WATERMARK/Columbia JC 34975 (Watermark is a beautiful album as Art's others have been. It, mercifully, retreats from the enriched saccharine of the recent past. Hip M.O.R. which manages to stay close to the border. "Wonderful World.")

A FEW WORDS FROM ACE YOUNG, NEWS DIRECTOR AT KMET-FM, LOS ANGELES

Here I am in the K-MET newsroom during the post-Christmas..pre-New Year's lull. Our local city news service wire normally carries a budget of perhaps 20 items news-worthy. These days our street reporter is choosing the best among very little. But there is news out there! It is happening somewhere. Even today, on the slowest of slow weeks, I have managed to scare up a good story (Hustler/turned religious Larry Flynt buys the Los Angeles Free Press.) I have good sound, some nice copy that would be interesting to our demographics - and the 18-34's elsewhere too. So...I'll trade that story. I'll call up KGB in San Diego and trade stories with Jeff Prescott. News Director George Garrett at KMPS in Seattle and I trade on a daily basis. Regular exchanges of news between us at KMET and Dave Alpert at WMET in Chicago...WCOZ in Boston with Jim Cameron. Cameron's style at WCOZ suits us perfectly here at KMET. News geared to our demographics! In a delivery I find more acceptable than what any network or audio service can offer. What I suppose we are doing is making up our own audio service - our own exchange via telephone lines. Not as nice as 5 KC satellite loops perhaps, but with microphone thru board output we can usually match or beat the nets who also rely on phones for other than New York or Washington, D.C. sound.

Here we are on a slow day. Where we are grasping for something other than Carter or Middle East re-hashes. Many of us are dedicated to these ends. I do not hesitate to call anywhere in the world for a story. I am fortunate in that Metromedia has supported me; my general manager, David Moorhead, I believe, has recognized that when we hustle (make the phone calls, trade the stories) we do come up with a product that is unique in our market. And when Cameron at WCOZ gives us a special report on the man who lives on top of New England (Mt. Washington) or Mark Howell in Bakersfield phones in a story on those high winds there (when it was impossible to call into that area!)...well...I'm not afraid to let our audiences know it's an exclusive in our market. "KMET...with news stories you will not hear on any other Los Angeles radio station!"

Suddenly...slow days become great days. At this moment, I find myself too busy to continue except to invite other news folks who are reading this to think about what I'm saying. And what others are too - folks like Cameron at WCOZ and others. We offer to you our services, our news hotlines, our newstimes, our skeds and we hope you would reciprocate.

I would like to continue but...our San Francisco trade station is on the line wanting the Larry Flynt story.

- Mickey Baker/BLUES & JAZZ GUITAR/Kicking Mule KM 142 (Mickey can play a robust blues guitar into which he weaves jazz chords. That gives his music a distinctive quality. For bluesers who remember Mickey and Sylvia from the 50's.)
- Dena Carroll/THE FANTASTIC.../Lanark AN 14029 (Second rate sound quality cuts into the enthusiasm for a woman who can sing a song. Some of the arranging is interesting enough to raise the state of this recording beyond being a demo. Through it all good song selections and Dena Carroll emerge. Write: IRDA, 55 Music Sq. West, Nashville, Tenn. 37203.)
- Buddy Causey/DIXIE FRIED/Lanark AW 14037 (A bar singer with a good bar band behind him, Buddy Causey is recorded in his natural habitat. It's live and loose and benefits from an excellent choice of material. Raw recording quality. Write: IRDA, 55 Music Sq. West, Nashville, Tenn. 37203.)
- Crane/Capitol ST-11742 (Chuck Crane makes it on energy mostly. His material and his voice are mediocre. But, his band jumps on the songs with determination. His voice would do better if it were always harmonized. Rock and roll without pretense.)
- Micky Denne & Ken Gold/MCA 2303 (Pop artists at their core Denne and Gold manage not to over step the bounds. Excellent, proven writers, their ability in that area is confirmed. They are good singers too. Here their accompaniment doesn't do what it could to project their music.)
- Lonnie Donegan/PUTTIN' ON THE STYLE/United Artists UA-LA 827-H (As England is exporting its punkers, its ultimate folk-blues oldtimer shows up too. Lonnie Donegan hardly made it to these shores on his own, though he has had an influence on a generation of English players. Gathered are esteemed rock names in support of Donegan's flight. Classic songs, updated, mark the LP.)
- Far East Family Band/TENKUJIN/All Ears FF 11479 (Not particularly electronic, the music of the Far East Family Band resembles the spaced, other spiritual consciousness, music done by European electronicians. Their melodies are good but not transcendent. Pleasant. Write: 1420 N. Beachwood Dr., Hollywood, Ca. 90028.)
- Al Green/THE BELLE ALBUM/Hi HLP 6004 (Al Green's first LP away from Willie Mitchell does not disown his past. Yet, it does take a logical step toward independence. His own writing is O.K. while the rhythm and the arrangements are more involved than those of his former mentor. Good show.)
- Alexander Harvey/PURPLE CRUSH/Buddah BDS 5696 (Harvey takes steps to separate himself from other Alex Harveys. Though the sophisticated production seems to run against the grain of a southern gentleman, Alexander adapts quickly. Pretty good tunes flow through it.)
- The Billie Hays Band/MCA 2324 (Devoid of style the Billie Hays Band rocks behind Billie's potent voice. Their songs ought to be augmented by outside material with some creative arranging applied. Competent.)
- Fred Holstein/CHICAGO & OTHER PORTS/Philo 1030 (A lovely recording captures Fred's rich voice and his fine choice of material. Folk music, in its essential state, is an always comforting form. Enjoyment.)
- Jericho Harp/United Artists UA-LA 812-G (Pretty harmonies are still the central interest of Peter Yarrow these many years later. His productions, this one in particular, approaches M.O.R. from the hip side. The good songs would have profited from a hardened presentation and a name other than Jericho Harp.)
- Lonnie Jordan/DIFFERENT MOODS OF ME/MCA 2329 (Accurately, the title of Lonnie's album telegraphs the variety therein. Holding it all together is a uniformly bright, up performance. The recording is also laced with a dose of Jordan's humor. Positive feelings.)
- Kayak/STARLIGHT DANCER/Janus JSX 7034 (There are two levels of Kayak writing, the adequate and the very good. They are able to make their adequate songs work by applying powerful play. But, that is not the same as spinning out a fine song like "I Want You To Be Mine." You can hear the work which went into this album.)
- Peter Lang/PRIME CUTS/Waterhouse 2 (Lang plays a blazing midwestern folk guitar. This live recording displays his humor as well as his performing skills. Recording quality suffers at one of the two locations. Write: 3974 Waterhouse Rd., Oakland, Ca. 94602.)
- Gordon Lightfoot/ENDLESS WIRE/Warner Bros. BSK 3149 (A mix which obscures the slurred Lightfoot voice gives the album a matter-of-fact feeling. The writing isn't projected to the front. A general impression of pleasant tunes is all you get at first.)
- Jimmy Louis/THE BEST OF THIS DEAL/Lanark AN 14036 (Plain and simple, Jimmy Louis is a country-blues-folk singer who boasts notable talents. His singing, writing and choice of material all hold their own. It's not a slick production. Write: I.R.D.A., 55 Music Sq. West, Nashville, Tenn. 37203.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Maze/GOLDEN TIME OF DAY/Capitol ST-11710 (There is a pleasing mellow streak which filters through all of the music of Maze. It is centered in the solid writing of Frankie Beverly. A warm spring.)
- Katy Moffatt/KISSIN' IN THE CALIFORNIA SUN/Columbia JC 34774 (If you like Katy's singing style you are stuck with figuring out why her album sometimes misses. Several tracks are plagued by ill conceived arrangements which work against her ability. Side two bails it out by getting back to basics. There's more to Katy Moffatt.)
- Bob Morrison/HOME AGAIN/Monument MG 7618 (As a Southern singer and songwriter Morrison draws together influences from folk, rock and country music. When he injects the rock spirit his tunes become forceful. Otherwise, Bob adds his name to a long list of good players.)
- The Nielson-Pearson Band/Epic JE 34984 (Strength at all positions. Reid Nielsen's voice is the kind which establishes itself indelibly. Especially, since he is singing solid material in front of an equally solid presentation. They start a stronger side one with a super Hall & Cates sound alike called "Home.")
- The Original Texas Playboys/LIVE & KICKIN'/Capitol ST-11725 (Their sophisticated Texas swing never stops turning a pleased ear. Probably the first form of fusion music, their eclecticism is a point of admiration. Smooth.)
- The Real Kids/Red Star RS 2 (Many new wave bands, The Real Kids among them, sound like bands from 1962 in England. Double time rhythm and some good songs elevate this band to a real level. Accessible punks.)
- Sharon Redd, Ula Hedwig, Charlotte Crossley/FORMERLY OF THE HARLETTES/Columbia JC 35250 (David Robinson has put together one of his standard crafted albums for these former Harlettes. As crafted as it is there is a missing stylistic anchor. That had to come with the trio. Redd-Hedwig & Crossley are trying to be all things to all people.)
- Rico/MAN FROM WAREIKA/Blue Note BN-LA 819-H (Instrumental reggae, at least as practiced by Rico, has a tendency to fade into the background. It suggests itself in a functional sense, as transition material. A more out-front lead would have resolved that question.)
- Fenton Robinson/I HEAR SOME BLUES DOWNSTAIRS /Alligator AL 4710 (Blues, not quite in the raw. Fenton's music cooks in its own juices. It's authentic without the lousy sound or the esoterica. Feels good throughout. Write: Box 11741, Chicago, Ill. 60611.)
- Rubicon/20th Century T-552 (An invigorated performance enhances good songs by giving them their best shot. A full frequency range recording also adds to the enjoyment of Sly's old band.)
- Sanford & Townsend/DUO-GLIDE/Warner Bros. BS 3081 (You can talk about good songs, good playing and production but, it is energy which distinguishes Sanford & Townsend. They project themselves through the recording process bringing the other stuff along. Their best is stacked onto a merit plus side one.)
- Rosalie Sorrels/MOMENTS OF HAPPINESS/Philo 1033 (A gentle accompaniment stands back giving Rosalie all of the space she requires. Folky and bluesy, Sorrell's music establishes a standard of consistency and principle.)
- Starz/ATTENTION SHOPPERS!/Capitol ST-11730 (A straight ahead rock and roll stance varies little though Starz' songwriting does. A couple songs on each side get down to business while a couple go astray. The feel is right.)
- Status Quo/ROCKIN' ALL OVER THE WORLD/Capitol (Previously reviewed as an import. A dozen songs gives any rock enthusiast their money's worth of music. Status Quo is a band which spices its albums with some rather special songs too. Their straight forward approach is all that is needed.)
- The Voltage Brothers/Lifealong JZ 35042 (A funky R&B band, The Voltage Brothers show you some of their megabyte on the instrumental tracks. They move better than the songs because they tend to be based on better melodies. After the first few songs the album gets stronger musically.)
- Wild Oats/Clouds 8803 (Several generations after C.S.N. & Y. and Eagles, Wild Oats does facsimile harmonies and songs. They are adequate in both regards but, no threat to the kingpins at this stage. Distributed by T.K., 495 S. E. 10th Ct., Hialeah, Fla. 33010.)

Hoyt Axton/FREE SAILIN'/MCA 2319 (Avoiding the studied quality of others, Hoyt's albums flow naturally. A warm glow comes out of the speakers along with his mellow music. Enjoyment all of the way.)

Bohannon/ON MY WAY/Mercury SRM-1-3710 (Bohannon's disco music is completely individualized. His tunes are very enticing and his big beat arrangements uniquely sewn. It is that combination which sets him apart. A tune like "You & I" places him in a league with the best of Jarrett.)

Bo Hansson/MUSIC INSPIRED BY WATER-SHIP DOWN/Sire SRK 6044 (Previously reviewed as an import and reconsidered here. Somehow the cover on this album conveys its inner quality. You get the feeling that this music, composed by Bo Hansson, was inspired, at least in part. It is majestic at times and beautiful always. The new classics.)

Emmylou Harris/QUARTER MOON... / Warner Bros. BSK 3141 (Her star is on the ascent. This carefully mounted album should not work against that vector. A special batch of songs highlights an Lp with only one flaw. You know exactly what it sounds like before the stylus touches the vinyl.)

Hawkwind/QUARK STRANGENESS & CHARM Sire SRK 6047 (Previously reviewed as an import. A strikingly candid message to their fans reveals internal upheavels which have lead to a fundamental rethinking. Quark. results from it and the Lp is a significant move back to the basics; rock music with a dash of space. It is their most cogent album in years.)

Journey/INFINITY/Columbia JC 34912 (A guitar too big to be contained by the recording process and an impressive stock of songs elevates Journey to new heights. Infinity makes a significant leap in quality, moving the group from ordinary to special. Their new lead singer is potent too.)

Dennis Linde/UNDER THE EYE/Monument MG 7608 (Because he doesn't follow standard form Under The Eye is more interesting than many other albums. Linde's arrangements are resourceful rock and roll brews. A few notable tunes, lead by "There Goes My Heart Again," further help to set him apart.)

Taj Mahal/EVOLUTION/Warner Bros. BSK 3094 (His deadly ear for a melody and his distinctive sound help to make Taj an endearing and enduring artist. This is another of his entertaining efforts.)

Ronnie Montrose/OPEN FIRE/Warner Bros. BSK 3134 (Surprise. Ronnie Montrose takes a great step toward serious music. It is a bold departure, a grand instrumental album, one which will get noticed. His old/young audience may feel deserted. Good sounds.)

Muddy Waters/I'M READY/Blue Sky JZ 34928 (The combination of Muddy Waters and Johnny Winter brings vitality to the blues. As the foundation for all of rock and roll it is a music which transcends fads. It just feels good.)

Steve Young/NO PLACE TO FALL/RCA APL 1-2510 (A master of heart wrenching ballads, Steve drags it out of you. A dramatic country-folky, he doesn't fail to choose the right song for his style. He manages to focus all of his energy into each song, investing each with a down believability.)

MERIT ALBUMS

Willie Alexander & The Boom Boom Band/MCA 2323 (The Boom Boom Band starts with Lou Reed and twists. Rhythmically they require an adjustment because they try not to move their music along - it's all punctuation. The album tends to strain.)

Angel/WHITE HOT/Casablanca NBLP 7085 (Through the decibal punding, Angel shows an increasing talent for songwriting. "The Winter Song" is a super song by any standard and though it leads the way, it is not alone. Aren't the threads out of style?)

Aztec Two-Step/ADJOINING SUITES/RCA APL 1-2453 (Good songs and easy harmonies mark a flowing album. It may not knock you over but, it will impress you with its uniformly mellow quality.)
