RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Battered Wives/Bomb 7028 (This Canadian power band starts with a weird name and few good songs. Songs like "Get What I Can" and "You Better Be Right" do well but could use some help to add depth to potential. Merit.)

Paul Brett/INTERLIFE/RCA PL 25149 (Interlife is named after a side long folk-rock symphonette which, more than others of its type, manages to hold listener interest. Side two is divided among four guitar pieces, also instrumental, which are good but not as involving as the long piece. Merit.)

Gary Burton/TIMES SQUARE/ECM 1111 (With Steve Swallow and Roy Haynes playing rhythm an interesting match up is implicit. Because of Haynes' be-bop drive this is a hotter LP than is normally associated with Burton, Swallow or ECM, for that matter. Merit.)

Contact Trio/NEW MARKS/Japo 60024 (Contact Trio features impressive guitarist Evert Brettschneider, bassist Aloys Kott and drummer Michael Jullich. Their music is skilled abstract adventures which come together too infrequently around Brettschneider's guitar. He can be melodically superior when moved to be. Merit.)

Barry Dransfield/BOWIN' AND SCRAPIN'/Topic 12TS386 (A solo album, Dransfield bows all of the instruments, whether they need it or not, and sings too. It's all traditional Empire fare. For old folkies, purists at that. Special Programming.)

Guru Guru/LIVE/Brain 0080.018 (Earlier albums showed a multi-talented instrumental rock band. Recently they added vocals of a much inferior quality. The distinction is clear here because the instrumental portions take off while the vocals don't. Merit.)

Art Lande/DESERT MARAUDERS/ECM 1106 (Desert Marauders features a mellow, very contemporary brand of jazz. It is endowed by some very pleasing melodies and some very talented new names. Mark Isham on horns, Bill Douglass on bass and Kurt Wortman on drums. They work well together. Merit.)

Madcats/Skyline SKY 10166 (Graced with a couple strong voices in Grant Fullerton and Bobby Blake, Madcats carry some weight. Their arranging is standard rock and Fullerton's material stays average. His lyric writing needs work. Still, there is potential here. Merit.)

Ian Matthews/STEALIN' HOME/Rockburgh ROC 106 (Few have his talent and few have had as rough a time cracking through. Always good tunes and a pretty voice, here those elements enjoy some fine production help too. Merit Plus.)

Pacific Eardrum/BEYOND PANIC/Charisma CAS 1136 (Sonic purity is the most attractive aspect of this recording. Top rank performances also help to give average material life. Great songs would soar. Merit.)

Scene Stealer/FIRST OFFENSE/Negram 5N 058N-60275 (In the world of new rock ideas Scene Stealer comes up short. However, they are good enough in all areas. A simple blues tune like their "Rolling Man" is best, more material as good would make a big difference. Merit.)

Brinsley Schwarz/FIFTEEN THOUGHTS OF/United Artists UAK 30177 (Reissue.)

IMPORTS CONTINUED

Dave Swarbrick/LIFT THE LID & LISTEN/Sonet SNTF 763 (Swarbrick's name is synonymous with English folk music tradition. Here he joins with some of the like-minded and has a good run at a batch of very enjoyable instrumentals. Merit.)

Vangelis/BEAUBOURG/RCA PL 25155 (Vangelis goes off the deep end. Or at least out in deep space. Beaubourg is an eery exploration into keyboard abstraction. Not too musical. Obscure. Special Programming.)

Various Artists/PERCUSSION PROFILES/Japo 60025 (This six movement piece by George Gruntz features Jackie DeJonette Pierre Favre, Fredy Studer, Dom Um Romao, David Friedman and Gruntz. All of the instruments are persuasive and so is the music. It is less musical and more experimental sounding than one would hope. This is on the avant side of Stomu Yamashta's earlier work. Special Programming.)

The Walker Brothers/NITE FLIGHTS/GTO GTLP 033 (Of special interest to music-art lovers. The Walker Brothers perform songs by three writers listed as S. Engel, G. Leeds and J.J. Maus. All have a gift with melodies and all are poets of consequence. Leonard Cohen's work is recalled. The result is a better than average album, one which makes a contribution. Substance. Merit Plus.)

Wayne County & The Electric Chairs/STORM THE GATES OF HEAVEN/Safari Good 1 (Combining hard rock and punk posturing with a Satanic theme is the stretch this group makes. Average songs are the limiting factor in their quest. Wayne County is a guy's name. Merit.)

Yellow Dog/BEWARE OF THE DOG/Virgin V 2104 (Opening with a rock version of "Officer Krupke" from West Side Story sets the stage. Here is a band with a sense of humor and a well developed sense of melody too. The writing collaboration of Kenny Young and Herbie Armstrong is aces. The performance is there too. Merit Plus.)

CONCEPTS

OBITUARY - KEITH MOON

The death of Keith Moon is only a footnote in the history of rock 'n' roll deaths. He was not a Buddy Holly, Otis Redding, Janis Joplin, Jimi Hendrix or an Elvis. But, with his passing has gone one of the last true rock 'n' roll spirits. Hell bent, his life was a long series of antidotal adventures. From the equipment destruction days to the hotel destruction days it was Loony Moon who was the force behind what came to be recognized as the image of the whole band, The Who.

It was either Dick Clark's T.V. rock award show or Don Kirshner's, it doesn't matter much, on which Keith darted on stage from the audience and stole the award before Roger Daltry could accept it. In that act, spontaneous and defiant of protocol, Keith touched on the very nature of rock 'n' roll and revealed the very essence of himself.

This music was disapproved by our parents for just those very qualities of irreverence. Today the culture has built up antibodies against the needling of rockers mostly because we are now the parents.

It was fun when it was the forbidden fruit. Goodbye Keith Moon.

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Randle Chowning Band/HEART'S ON FIRE/A&M SP-4715 (Decent songs and lots of vocal harmonies are set in a mellow rocking context. Chowning is a masterful hook writer. "Crazy Over You" takes the cake.)
- David Coverdale's Whitesnake/SNAKEBITE/United Artists UA LA 915-H (While the purple stain remains, David's hard rock persona allows for a few top rank songs. In any context, quality elevates the presentation. "Bloody Mary," "Ain't No Love.." and "Only My Soul" stand out of the haze.)
- Mark Farner Band/NO FRILLS/Atlantic SD 19196 (A funny thing happens on the way through Mark's new Lp. While the use of classic tunes "When A Man Loves A Woman" and "Just One Look" elevate the album as they were intended to do, they also point out the awerageness of the original material. Solid rockin' carries it.)
- Craig Fuller-Eric Kaz/Columbia JC 35324 (It's the middle of the second side before the texture changes at all. The rest of the Lp features good songs, harmonies on the hook and the Kunkel-Sklar rhythm bottom. Best bets are "You Take A Heart" and "Fool For You.")
- Gentle Giant/GIANT FOR A DAY/Capitol SW-11813 (Gentle Giant has been moving itself into the rock mainstream. With Giant For A Day they fully arrive. Before, their dexterity counted heavily. Now, however, their tunes are going to have to be more exceptional. Advance to "It's Only Goodbye.")
- Nick Gilder/CITY NIGHTS/Chrysalis CHR 1202 (Rocking with new wave influences gives Nick freshness. But, the influences are tempered by other more standard rock moves, so he can't be boxed into a cult corner. Several good songs are highlights.)
- Hardin & Russell/WAX MUSEUM/Demo 513 (A folksy's delight. Hardin & Russell sing about the obscure folks of mythology and the famous folks of history. They weave little tales in a comfortable but unmarked musical setting. Write: 1893 San Luis, Mountain View, Ca. 94043.)
- Heart/DOG & BUTTERFLY/Portrait FR 35555 (Starting with a live track is so appropriate given that so much of Heart's success is a result of the stage. Meanwhile, the sonic quality of the studio recording and the performances are striking. The writing is good.)
- Richard Kerr/WELCOME TO THE CLUB/A&M SP 4721 (Welcome To The Club reveals a dramatic MOR-rocker named Richard Kerr. He's got a super, foggy rock voice but, not one especially suited to this approach. He always has to sing beyond his range. Christopher Bond's production is expansive.)
- The Allen Harris Band/OCEANS BETWEEN US/Columbia-Tappan Zee JC 35364 (Mediocre writing is bolstered by good presentation. Allen Harris has to give more melodically and lyrically in order to get beyond merely acceptable. A sign of our times.)
- Walter Horton/FINE CUTS/Blind Pig BP 006-78 (Side two is the more traditional although the first side couldn't be called Las Vegas pop. The hot uptempo tunes move so well that they are the most appealing. Write: 208 S. First St., Ann Arbor, Mich. 48103.)
- King Of Hearts/CLOSE, BUT NO GUITAR/Capitol SW 11848 (Like an uncommitted power band, King Of Hearts' hard rock is often modified to lighten it. Harmonies and orchestration work to counter their general posture. Songs are the kind you'll think you heard before.)
- Lynyrd Skynyrd/FIRST AND LAST/MCA 3047 (Their easy Southern stride is the consistent thread woven through song after song. Another consistent element is songwriting. Solid.)
- Molly Hatchet/Epic JE 35347 (Behind that anachronistic album cover stands one nambur rock. They combine the loose movement of the South and the urban nastiness of the Midwest. Their writing is pretty good too.)
- Mother's Finest/MOTHER FACTOR/Epic JE 35546 (The feel is always there but the difference between M.F.'s position and striking gold are lots of terrific songs. Their writing is O.K., often getting pushed into shape by the band's other qualities.)
- Doug Owen/EVENINGS EAST/Hickory HB-44013 (Traces of The Beatles spice a few songs, notably the appropriately named "Here Comes That Feeling Again." Doug's writing is O.K. and so is the presentation though it tends to look backward.)
- Sonny Rollins/DON'T STOP THE CARNIVAL/Milestone M-55005 (Sonny has always had extra grit in his saxophone sound. It puts a rough edge on traditional jazz which brings it into current time. These four live sides prove, down to the last one.)
- Al Stewart/TIME PASSAGES/Arista AB-4190 (Time Passages is a particularly appropriate title. First there is Al's sense of history which is as strongly present here as in previous efforts. Secondly, there is the matter of tempo. Only once does Al really vary his vocal gate. Alan Parsons' production speeds up, slows down, swells and diminishes but, Al doesn't move much either way. Wisely, guitars and saxes break the air with a few gripping solos.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Scotty Stoneman/LIVE IN L.A./Briar SBR 4206 (Through some primitive sound recording you'll get a wonderful sense of the joy and sorrow of mountain music. Scotty's name is on the cover but this is really a hot Kentucky Colonel's performance from 1965. Stoneman was acknowledged as one of the best fiddlers bluegrass music had until his untimely death in 1973. Write: Box 5853, Pasadena, Ca. 91107.)
- Styx/PIECES OF EIGHT/A&M SP 4724 (There is nothing subtle about the drama rock of Styx. They stick it to you. But, unlike the British style of this music Styx works from round, finished melodies so their songs don't come off as pompous.)
- Sweetbottom/ANGELS OF THE DEEP/Elektra 6E-156 (This keyboard centered fusion band exhibits the standard genre characteristics of tight, quality play. Everything but a sweetbottom is included. The writing is good, not more.)
- Traveler/LOST IN THE LATE, LATE SHOW/ABC AA-1101 (Energy is the key to enjoying Traveler. Their songwriting is decent with a weakness in the lyrics which could get them in trouble. They always go for the cliché rhyme. The country tune at the end may be best of all.)
- McCoy Tyner/THE GREETING/Milestone M-9085 (Here we are treated to the typical high level Tyner performance. It is filled with his overflowing piano style and some solid sidemen. It leads off with its one truly inspired melody called "Hand In Hand." That puts the rest in perspective.)
- Gino Vannelli/BROTHER TO BROTHER/A&M SP 4722 (A master of movement, Gino's music is more arrangement and execution than it is musical. That pattern has been consistent through all of his Lp's and it continues here. The man knows how to reach people.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Jon Gailmor/PASSING THROUGH/Green Mountain GMS 1066 (On the positive side is the pretty Gailmor tenor and the traditional music which he sings. On the negative are Jon's own not-quite-there songs and a living room quality accompaniment. An amateur level recording with good intentions. Write: Northfield, Vt. 05663.)
- Nashville West/Sierra SRS 8701 (If you read the small print, the out of whack mix makes a humorous kind of sense. Gene Parsons, the producer-engineer also manufactures a gizmo which fits on a guitar, so guess which instrument is way out in front of this mix. Well his guitar gizmo sounds great, especially played by Clarence White, except that the vocals are lost in the cracks. This is a sales presentation. Write: Box 5853, Pasadena, Ca. 91107.)
- Various Artists/SATURDAY NIGHT POGO/Rhino RNLP 003 (An interesting "Collection Of Los Angeles New Wave Bands." Various levels of worthiness are immediately apparent. They all have the proper punkish stance but The Motels come up with the single best song called "Counting.")

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Jim Chesnut/SHOW ME A SIGN/Hickory HB 44012 (A light form of country-rock places Jim in-between. He isn't committed to either style or even the middle road. His nice presentation of nice songs comes up benign.)
- Roy Clark & Buck Trent/BANJO BANDITS/ABC AY 1084 (Roy Clark is quite a good picker when he leaves that Las Vegas glitter outside the studio. Here he and Buck Trent have made a pop bluegrass album which seems like it was fun for them to do.)
- Roberta Flack/Atlantic SD 19186 (The first track "What A Woman Really Means" is a gutsy eruption which changes from Roberta's hip torch singing of the past. Track two returns to the sheer sensitivity which has made her a celebrity. The Lp is carefully pulled together and rather beautiful music.)
- Stan Kenton/THE JAZZ COMPOSITIONS OF DEE BARTON/Creative World ST 1022 (While Kenton's band is no longer at the cutting edge of progressive music, its cleanly developed lines are a testament to order and symmetry. Layer upon disciplined layer, the arrangements breathe design. Write: 35216, Los Angeles, Ca. 90035.)
- Denise LaSalle/UNDER THE INFLUENCE/ABC AA-1087 (There are not too many women producers so Denise's self-produced Lp draws extra interest. She does a fine job injecting even the more pop tracks with a sense of rhythm & blues tradition. "Feet Don't Fail Me" and "You Oughta Thank Me" are the kinds of tracks which work the groove best.)
- Les McCann/THE MAN/A&M SP 4718 (Tiptoe through the sweeteners. The McCann metamorphosis has pretty much de jazzed the man in favor of a pop singing career. Still, you can get close to that old raunchy feel on tracks like "How Can You" and "I Think You're Something.")

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Tony Bird/OF PARADISE/Columbia JC 34988 (Like Scotch Tony Bird's voice is an acquired taste. Once accepted you'll note how well suited it is to the bright, bouncy melodies it sings. African culture weaves through these songs affecting the tunes and lyrics equally. The two political songs strain. Tony finds his own place.)

The Brecker Brothers/HEAVY METAL BE-BOP/Arista AB 4185 (A significant improvement is made with this Lp just by The Breckers coming to grips with what they want to do. Their last effort was flawed by fragmentation. Here R&B, jazz and rock influences are welded together to make a strong statement in all three mediums.)

Crawler/SNAKE, RATTLE & ROLL/Epic JE 35482 (Just like their last one, Crawler has turned in more rock authority than expected. Power when needed, resilient play and hot hooks snake throughout their Lp.)

Dave Edmunds/TRACKS ON WAX 4/Swan Song SS 8505 (As the mystic main-spring of England's back to basics rock and roll scene Dave has been an important personage without much acclaim in the U.S. Terrific songs fill the Edmunds' album, all tied together by classic rock 'n' roll licks. He borrows from everyone equally. Fun.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Oregon/OUT OF THE WOODS/Elektra 6E-154 (Oregon's art-jazz is unique. On a technical level they are always extraordinary. On a melodic level they are good this time but, tunes as good as Towner's "Icarus" are required to match the other skills. Still, Oregon works on a higher plane.)

Peter C. Johnson/A&M SP 4723 (A refreshing streak of inventiveness is immediately apparent in Peter's music. His arrangements are starkly attractive as is his music. The quality is fairly consistent throughout an album which purposely doesn't fit into any prepackage categories.)

Booker T. Jones/TRY & LOVE AGAIN/A&M SP 4720 (An austere accompaniment is warmed by Booker T.'s personal reading of often classic lyrics. His choice of material is rangy but tied together by quality and the album's style. Though these versions of past hits may not be better than the originals, in the Lp's context they provide pleasing hours.)

MERIT ALBUMS

April Wine/FIRST GLANCE/Capitol SW 11852 (At first and second glance April Wine is a standard rock band. They are acceptably good at everything, not weak or strong anywhere.)

Stephen Bishop/BISH/ABC AA-1082 (Stephen Bishop's hip MOR is sparked by a couple super songs and his pretty voice which seems to buoyantly float in mid-air. While the sound is uniform, Bishop's writing isn't. After "Losing Myself In You" and "Everybody Needs Love" it thins out noticeably. "Bish's Hideaway" is O.K. too.)

Gary Burr/MATTERS OF THE HEART/Lifesong JZ 35362 (When the harmonies kick in its hard not to think of old Poco stuff. Lots of good songs and pretty harmonizing wash through Matters Of The Heart. A hacksaw guitar would have balanced it a little better.)

Ron Carter/A SONG FOR YOU/Milestone M-9086 (Subdued by the need to let the bass come forward, Ron's Lp is more mental than it is somatic. When it swings it usually happens because Kenny Baron is soloing on piano. "N.O. Blues" cannot go unmentioned.)
