# RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

As jazz fans know by now, the Milestone Jazz Stars (Sonny Rollins, McCoy Tyner, Ron Carter) are currently on tour. We have the pleasure of presenting them in New Haven's Woolsey Hall Oct. 24. We expect a full house and the tastiest creative music ever to come to New Haven. That should be a big weekend for us: from the 1st. - 21st we'll be broadcasting live from New Haven's Black Expo, with over ten thousand expected to attend. Two local records of interest: East River Consort's "Laurasia" - with acoustic guitars, violin, bass and reeds, this group defies all categories, and will surprise all listeners. It was added to our jazz format (Grisman fans take note) and features former WYBC treasurer Laura Keller on vocals. Some of the best new music on record can be heard on Gerry Hemingway's "Kwanza", with Anthony Davis, George Lewis and Roy Anderson, among others. # CONCEPTS

## GOODIES FOR CHRISTMAS?

As the leaves start to fall an overview of the year's recorded output starts to fall into place too. This year is not pleasant to contemplate. It is a year of mediocrity, a year of playing it safe. There is a sense in which the continuing perfection of the format of recording has reached new levels, but in doing so much of the spontaneity of music has been sacrificed. There has to be a trade-off.

It does not seem logical to assume that the artists aren't as good especially with so many of them around. So what are the factors at play.

A major factor is the perceived tightening at all radio formats. Record companies sensing the tightening in radio tighten their own A&R policies and guide their previously signed artists into a more saleable and/or playable mode.

Tangent to that is the attempt to make the gamble - which every record is - a safer bet. That is done by hiring a known, successful producer who will deliver a proven product. Hence, the amazing rise of the independent producers. Always a part of the industry, they are now its subsurface insurance policy.

For insurance of their own the industry's turn to studio players with whom they are familiar. So, the same players end up on album after album. It's like a band with revolving front men. The big news in the studio world for this year is that Steve Gadd has done some sessions on the west coast.

All of this leads to a year of albums which sound the same as something else you've heard before. Good records but no adventure. Maybe, they have saved the goodies for Christmas.

## MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Smak/BLACK LADY/Fantasy F-9559 (When you come away from an album and your strongest memory is of the drummer something is wrong. Smak presents the old problem of quality musicians who really have little to say musically. It holds together as well as it does because of the playmanship.)
- Stephen Stills/THOROUGHFARE GAP/Columbia JC 35380 (Lots of electronic and instrumental stuff fills this Stills album with extraenia. Echo devices on the voice and the drums bend the sonics out of shape sometimes accounting for the boomy bottom. Steve's vocal similarity to Mike Nesmith is, at times, striking. A couple top-rank songs emerge from each side. The question is: Can your booty dance alone?)
- The Symphony Jazz Ensemble/EASTSIDE CORRIDOR/Red Mark RM 378 (Symphony players people this hybrid jazz band. Bigger than a combo and smaller than a big band The Ensemble leans in both directions. Side two is the place to go for the adventurous music. Side one plays it safe. Melodies are O.K.)
- Tasty Licks/Rounder 0106 (Described as Northern bluegrass, Tasty Licks music fits the bill. The instrumentation and other sounds of bluegrass are present but, musicians from the Northeast part of the country tend to add complexity to their music. Hence, the composite sound of the North and 'grass. Top notch play will dazzle, the songs are O.K.)
- Ted Taylor/KEEPIN' MY HEAD ABOVE WATER/MCA 3059 (If you are a sucker for traditional rhythm and blues you will be treated by Ted Taylor's falsetto. But, the attraction isn't merely Ted's voice, it is as much the songs he chooses to sing. This kind of music is source material for rock 'n' roll.)
- Richard & Linda Thompson/FIRST LIGHT/Chrysalis CHR 1177 (The Thompson's only go half way in the modernization of their traditional folk music. On side one, they use electronic instruments but, don't really alter the texture of tunes. Which leads to the question, why use the electronics if not to change the texture? The answer is on a much hotter side two. Meanwhile, style excluded, these songs are of a high quality.)
- Pat Travers/HEAT IN THE STREET/Polydor PD 1-6170 (The blues-based power rock of Pat Travers remains intact. Every element works toward the totality. A solid performance.)
- Uriah Heep/FALLEN ANGEL/Chrysalis CHR 1204 (The character of the band changes with John Lawton doing the vocals instead of David Byron. Heep is still a group of screamers but, the tunes come through as being more musical. Upgraded.)
- Richard Wright/WET DREAM/Columbia JC 35559 (It is not until the middle of the second side that the tempo and/or texture changes. Wright's songs all pass, but it is the guitar and saxophone soloing which pierces the air. Richard Wright is the man in Pink Floyd who provides the steady patience required to play their music.)
- Zytron/NEW MOON IN ZYTRON/Pacific Arts PACB-7-120 (James Zitro is a drummer and David Liebman is a well known saxophonist. Together they are the focus of a wide-ranging jazz group called Zytron. They stand out on two very successful tracks, Zitro's "Green Sun God" and Coltrane's "Equinox." Other tracks range between spaced and fair.)

## SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Various Artists/THE GREEN ALBUM/Pilgrim PLL 7702 (The Green Album's subtitle is "The Tulsa Sampler." Artists, The Old Dog Bog, Randy Crouch, Jim Byfield & Rance Wasson, are included. Taken as a whole, they indicate that they are on the right track, but the train hasn't come in yet. Potential. Write: Box 3031, Tulsa, Oklahoma 74101.)

## FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Eric Carmen/CHANGE OF HEART/Arista AB-4184 (Eric goes to the west coast to lighten up. The sound smooths out and Eric becomes a pop artist. That is his true change of heart. His songs are better than average. "Someday" is tough enough.)
- Faze-O/GOOD THANG/SHE SH 741 (Don't be fooled just because Faze-O is a funky R&B band. Side one offers some super funky-jams, great rhythm and top drawer soloing. Side two is in a less successful song format.)
- Glad/Myrrh MSB-6603 (Jesus-rock. Decent songs delivered by a high quality performance cannot be denied. The subject matter may get in the way.)
- The Heath Bros./PASSING THRU.../Columbia JC 35573 (The Heath Bros., Jimmy and Percy, amble through a quietly pleasing jazz album. Cool is the most apt word. Only one tune, "Artherdic Blues," could be called up-tempo. Everything else turns down.)
- Marcus Joseph/THINGS I MEANT TO SAY/Big Tree BT 76012 (Using what seems to have been a rough love life Marcus forges round pop songs which lean on a plaintiff quality. He writes from the same perspective as Dan Hill, but he's not as cerebral. Through the prettiness try "Trapeze.")

## FRINGE ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Les McCann/THE MAN/A&M SP-4718 (Paul Rizer's orchestrations push at the reliable rhythm playing of Les McCann. The Man is sweetened to M.O.R. but "You Think You're Something Mr. Man" remains heated.)
- Peter, Paul & Mary/REUNION/Warner Bros. BSK 3231 (The Peter Paul, and Mary reunion does exactly what it ought to do. It is a classy, very contemporary M.O.R. album. They didn't try to talk to the younger generation - that would have been disastrous.)
- Diana Ross/ROSS/Motown M7-907R1 (Diana's recording career suffers from a lack of focus in the production of her albums. This practice of using five different producers on one Lp is destructive. The first track, a terrific song and production called "Lovin', Livin' & Givin'" is never matched in texture again. The rest is pop.)
- Wind Chill Factor/CITY STREETS/Red Mark RM 372 (Mellow-phonics. Wind Chill Factor generates little of the heavy weather their name implies. They are more like a warm spring day. Write: QCA Records, Cincinnati, Ohio 45225)

(Spoken, poetry - comedy and extraneous musics.)

- Eddie Palmieri/LUCUMI MACUMBA VOODOO/Epic JE 35523 (Bobby Colomby produced this attempt to step out of the Latin ghetto by one of its luminaries. Palmieri is a remarkable pianist. The structure and rhythm remains true to Spanish Harlem. But, an electric guitar, a sax, and an English singing, female choir are brought in to Anglo-ize it. Eddie's real ability shines through in "Highest Good.")
- Sweet Honey in the Rock/B'LIEVE I'LL RUN ON.../Redwood RR 3500 (At first casual listening you'll think it is a cappella gospel singing which you are hearing. Instead these black women, lead by Bernice Johnson Reagon, are singing of the struggle for equality by both blacks and women. They are pretty good and very political. Write: Box 996, Ukiah, California 95482.)
- Henny Youngman/TAKE MY ALBUM...PLEASE/Waterhouse 4 (Though side one is noticeably more intense than two, Henny, is funny throughout. Nice, short increments make programming it easy.)

With The Future Now, Peter begins to justify the enthusiasm his small group of followers have shown. Merit.)
- Andy Mackay/RESOLVING CONTRADICTIONS/Bronze BRON 510 (Pleasant, but benign instrumentals are the bill of a fare. Andy's album could use some contradictions like changing textures and changing tempos. As you listen to the whole Lp it fades into the background. Special Programming.)
- Sally Oldfield/WATER BEARER/Bronze BRON 511 (Impressive. Sally's folk-soprano vocals are lovely. They are placed in a set of original melodies which are perfectly suited to her voice. A pretty delight. Sonically superior. Merit Plus.)
- Tollhouse/Nova 6.23430 AO (Resting on the shoulders of Dirk Steffens, Tollhouse has an advantage. Dirk can write and Dirk can play guitar. In return they give him a resilient accompaniment. They are missing no more than an injection of individuality. Merit.)

## MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Southside Johnny & The Asbury Jukes/HEARTS OF STONE/Epic JE 35488 (Working from the shadows of a phenomenon is limiting. In fact the contributions by Bruce prove him a fountain of great songs. Still, Johnny's vocals deserve lavish praise and the Van Zandt songs are awfully strong.)

## MERIT ALBUMS

The Bar-Kays/MONEY TALKS/Stax STX-4106 (Funkiness and rock 'n' roll have become mutually exclusive in recent years. That is our collective misfortune. The Bar-Kays show us how funky rock can be done with this very satisfying album. Solid.)

Big Star/THE THIRD ALBUM/PVC 1903 (Previously reviewed as an import and updated here. This third Big Star album communicates the same thing as the first two albums. That mystic mainspring Alex Chilton is a powerful talent who doesn't quite have control of all of his ideas. His music is two steps ahead of him. Your respect for him will mount if you match the sounds in the album to the 1974/75 recording date. The U.S. release exchanges four new tracks for two. Their addition further makes the original point.)

Black Sabbath/NEVER SAY DIE/Warner Bros. BSK 3186 (Given the power they generate it is not surprising that the recording is so boomy. Through the sonic haze some decent tunes can be heard. A song like "Air Dance" isn't as teen centered as the rest.)

Norman Blake/DIRECTIONS/Takoma D-1064 (Directions is a remarkably consistent, easygoing folk music album. Most of the material is traditional. It is surprising that Norman, whose instrumental mastery is widely known, rarely rips it up. Somber.)

The Blend/MCA 3058 (The Blend is a solid rock band at all levels of writing and presentation. The sense of old rhythm 'n' blues projected in Steven Dore's writing and singing adds depth to their sound.)

Brand X/MASQUES/Passport PB 9829 (In Masques Brand X continues to show us their instrumental command. Changing textures are a breeze for them. However, they do not show development in the compositional area. Their melodies are more interesting because of the arrangements than because of their inherent beauty.)

John Coltrane/JUPITER VARIATION/ABC Impulse IA-9360 (Listening to the truly great artists, the visionaries, helps to put everyone else in perspective. Side two is mostly experimentation which was probably not meant for release. It shows what Trane saw as possible. Side one is the finished product. It demonstrates how it worked when whipped into shape.)

Rodney Franklin/IN THE CENTER/Columbia JC 35558 (The contrast in this jazzy Lp is between the slow things and the up tempo things. The slow things require the better melodies but, the better melodies go to the fast tunes. Franklin plays a very strong rhythm piano. That helps enhance the "up" things too.)

Arlyn Gale/BACK TO THE MIDWEST NIGHT/ABC AA 1096 (After the first tune which is a blatant Springsteen imitation both in its structure and delivery, Arlyn takes off the mask. As it turns out, he is a rocker in his own right. A gruff voice and pretty fair songs run through it.)

Rory Gallagher/PHOTO-FINISH/Chrysalis CHR 1170 (Gallagher will never learn to sing but, he has learned how to control the instrumental side of his music. With no excess, the band plays tough as nails. Blues busters.)

Fred Geiger/Ridge Runner RRR 0014 (Fred's album delivers some good, not blazing, picking for mountain music fans. The interesting aspect of the Lp is in the choice of material. Old jazz tunes from Fats Waller and "Kid" Ory to George Shearing fill the Lp.)

Bob Gibson & Hamilton Camp/HOMEMADE MUSIC/Mountain Railroad MR 52781 (With a tinge of the early 60's, pop-folk sound Gibson and Camp show the class of veterans. Comfortable performances and solid material eases its way along. Write: 2103 Pleasant Drive, Cambridge, Wisc. 53523.)

Golden Earring/GRAB IT FOR A SECOND/MCA 3057 (Regrouped. Golden Earring has existed for too long on one hit song and lots of energy. Here we find a renewed effort at songwriting. The energy remains but, now a few worthy songs are also included.)

Hero/BOYS WILL BE BOYS/20th Century T-573 (Fresh sentiments like "Rock and roll is here to stay" implies that Hero may be out of touch. Their rock and roll is a standard but, solid brand. Hero speaks to teens.)

John Hickman/DON'T MEAN MAYBE/Rounder 0101 (Between John's flowing banjo lines and the dynamism of Byron Berline, who sits in, this is quite a good Lp. It really moves effortlessly with positive melodies.)

Alberta Hunter/SOUNDTRACK - REMEMBER MY NAME/Columbia JS 35553 (What a soundtrack. No movie music. Just Alberta Hunter singing beautifully, not for her age, for any age. This lady sings the blues.)

Ahmad Jamal/ONE/20th Century T-555 (Jamal music has always had a way of drawing the listener into its spell. His rhythms are infectious. Here they do it in a very contemporary way.)

## MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

Al Jarreau/ALL FLY HOME/Warner Bros. BSK-3229 (The feel is delicious, both Al's personal warmth and his accompaniment come across strongly. Still, his extraordinary vocal skills tend to overwhelm, instead of amplify, the songs he sings. That is a continuing problem. "She's Leaving Home" is beautiful.)

Jebadiah/ROCK N' SOUL/Epic JE 35592 (This Rolling Stones retrospective is interesting especially since Mick has been singing black for so many years. Jebadiah produces straight forward versions of these classic tunes.)

Jethro Tull/LIVE - BURSTING OUT/Chrysalis CH2-1201 (Tull songs are captured admirably well both because of strong performances and because of a high quality technical recording. The thing which comes through on this live Lp is Ian Anderson's wit. That isn't easily gotten from his studio work.)

Jiva/STILL LIFE/Polydor PD 1-6165 (Mastery of their instruments and a highly developed performance are the Jiva contributions. Good songs get their best possible ride.)

Billy Joel/52ND STREET/Columbia PC 35609 (52nd Street is an album which doesn't have the writing intensity of the recent past. But, it thrusts Billy's great voice out front giving it a chance to breathe. Down songs done up.)

The Reggie Knighton Band/ARC-Columbia JC 35286 (Basic teenage rock 'n' roll is the backbone of pop music. The Reggie Knighton Band places itself at the central nervous system without using excesses to do it. Solid.)

Nicolette Larson/NICOLETTE/Warner Bros. BSK 3243 (A pretty voice and enlightened song choices are the organic ingredients upon which this brew is based. The accompaniment has a tendency to get too big but, it is usually brought down to earth by an insistent rhythm section.)

Matthew Moore/WINGED HORSES/Caribou JZ 35611 (The story of Winged Horses is a list of good songs and crowded arrangements. If the arrangements had had an injection of originality they could have given Matthew Moore a distinctive character. As it is he is quite good but, not something special.)

Michael Moss - Four Rivers/CROSS CURRENT/4th Stream ERG 022 (On soprano saxophone Michael injects a middle-Eastern tone. With his fitting melodies some very engaging, very contemporary jazz tracks emerge, "Coal Sack" and "Weaving" to be specific. The whole-side "Ain Soph" is 18 minutes of extra-logical adventure. Write: 192 Ave. of the Americas, No. 2R, New York, N.Y. 10013.)

Nova/SUN CITY/Arista AB 4203 (Dynamic performance is the attractive aspect of the Nova album. Their material is good enough to be elevated by the play. Sun City tries to be a tour de force.)

Omega/SKYROVER/Fantasy F-9560 (Driven, Omega is like a second cousin to Yes. A streak of trained, symphonic style flows through all of the band's music. They also play with the same attitude as Yes. Their songs are O.K. The suits are unfortunate.)

Jim Post/I LOVE MY LIFE/Mountain Railroad MR 52784 (Folk-singer Jim Post rocks it lightly. His positive troubadour presentation gives his songs a true reading. Easy. Write: 2103 Pleasant Dr., Cambridge, Wisc. 53523.)

Jim Rafferty/London PS 722 (A light pop-rock feel is the dominant theme in Jim Rafferty's album. The songs are easily digested. Gerry produced it - smooth.)

Ramones/ROAD TO RUIN/Sire SRK 6063 (Road To Ruin is a major step for The Ramones as they leave their bubblegum punk behind them. They move into the rock mainstream with quality songs and a modified punkish disposition.)

Rio Grande Band/PLAVIN' FOR THE DOOR/Rounder 0105 (Texas swing is an appealing sort of music every time it comes around. Instrumentally this band from Nashville hits it on the head though they don't seem quite as loose as the Texans might be.)

Sonny Rollins/THERE WILL NEVER BE ANOTHER YOU/ABC Impulse IA-9349 (New York's Museum of Modern Art is the natural environ for Sonny Rollins. On this live Lp his horn tears at the melodies while the accompaniment eases along behind him.)

David Sancious & Tone/TRUE STORIES/Arista AB 4201 (Sancious has gathered around him several powerful players. The result is that the decent songwriting is not up to the level of play. Instrumental pieces like "Prelude #3" and "On The Inside" stand out as whole and round.)

Santana/INNER SECRETS/Columbia FC 35600 (Shedding all but an implication of their Latinness Santana does straight rock. When Carlos' guitar solos, the songs take off. Otherwise, this approach tends to bleed individually. "Life Is A Lady" is the real thing.)

Son Seals/LIVE AND BURNING/Alligator AL 4712 (Hot Chicago blues has a grit all its own. In a barroom it finds its natural habitat. Son Seals is Live And Burning on this album.)

Jack Skinner/A THROWING SPECIES/Takoma D-1065 (With a voice compatible with a country-rock sound and a mountain accompaniment, Jack makes good grades. He'd be dangerous with a drummer and electric guitar added.)

Neil Young/COMES A TIME/Reprise MSK 2266 ("In the field of opportunity, it's plowin' time again," is the kind of writing which separates the pretenders from those who have something on their minds. Every song is terrific and Neil's voice still has the power to put shivers down the spine. On Comes A Time Neil does not stretch but he does perfect his style.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

David Bowie/STAGE/RCA CPL 2-2913 (Bowie's recent music has polarized his audience. Those fringe fans who had only jumped on the hit bandwagon were thrown off by his continuing musical development. This live Lp makes some of the newer things more accessible. It also does the same thing done by his other live Lp. It focuses on just how good a writer David is. Strong live album.)

David Clayton-Thomas/CLAYTON/ABC AA-1104 (A surprise. Producer Jack Richardson got David to undersing. That stylistic alteration - given David's overheard voice - makes for a difference. Together with the best batch of songs he has had to sing results in a very well turned out album.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Rodney Crowell/AIN'T LIVING LONG LIKE THIS/Warner Bros. BSK 3228 (What a nice way to meet a new artist. Rodney Crowell is an encouraging sign. He brings the whole rock tradition to bare on his style. That is why as a new name his songs sound so true on the very first hearing.)

Dane Donohue/Columbia JC 34278 (Mellow rockin' Dane Donohue presents round songs through a soft sonic filter. His pleasing tenor voice resembles five other hit singers. Warm.)

Bobby Hutcherson/HIGHWAY ONE/Columbia JC 35550 (For the first time in memory Bobby sounds challenged. The music here has a sense of adventure. Built on a low rhythm fire, Bobby's vibes ring true as their reverberation hangs suspended in the air.)

Jules & The Polar Bears/GOT NO BREEDING/Columbia JC 35601 (Their name and the name of the Lp condition you to like them before they start. A punk inspired attitude in Jules' vocals is couched in a blue chip rock setting for an effective result. Sparked by originality.)

Giorgio Moroder/SOUNDTRACK-MIDNIGHT EXPRESS/Casablanca NBLP 7114 (It is quite obvious from his disco work that Moroder is a very talented man. Here his electronic music is not so much meant for dancing and it is arresting on its own. Several beautiful, striking tracks put Giorgio in a league with many of the better German electronicists, Kraftwerk and Tangerine Dream in particular.)

Van Morrison/WAVELENGTH/Warner Bros. BSK 3212 (The Van Morrisons of the recording world up the ante. Their records operate on a higher level of consistency. His indelible voice, quality tunes and resilient presentations are a fact track after track.)

Racing Cars/BRING ON THE NIGHT/Chrysalis CHR 1178 (A wealth of songs and a warm manner of presentation defines an attractive Racing Cars. Every position in the band makes a positive contribution. A checkered flag.)

Arlen Roth/GUITARIST/Rounder 3022 (There are at least 3 people on this album who have the talent to emerge individually beside Arlen. As a unit these people could be a great studio band, they play so well in so many idioms. Instrumental goodies with 2 song delights.)
