I noted with dismay John Johnson's Forumula of Nov. 3 concerning KOOK's having received sub-standard reports from IRCA. It hit me hard that since John Tucker's commentary of July 21st (a little over 4 months ago) there has appeared not one in-depth directive on how to send an acceptable report to a radio station. I have a proposal: Let us publish a booklet, similar to the old NRC publication "How To Enjoy Better DX" and distribute it to those who wish to receive it for the cost of postage. Now, to give birth to such a booklet, I believe any member who has any knowledge concerning any phase of DX should send the same to a previously appointed committee. This committee can then assemble all the information into a booklet which can be then mailed to any interested party. Under no stretch of anybody's imagination can the IRCA retain its high standards if no means are provided our newer members to best learn the art of DX. If we do not educate them well, they will send out all kinds of poor reports and destroy any good name we may have gained. Also, I propose that all knowledgeable members, when sending in a forumula, include a few of their pointers on how to improve reception reports. I will endeavor here to quickly sketch a picture of a complete reception report so that you newer members can spot any mistakes that you might have been making. A reception report to a station consists of a letter indicating that the DXer has heard it, and expressing time date and program details (of utmost importance). Program details consist of names of spots (commercials, if you are ignorant) with their times, the names of the DJ doing the show, and any other station personnel, the name of the show, etc. A good rule of thumb is to concentrate on details that could not be known except by listening to the station. In other words, one would not likely have any previous acquaintance with "Hunky-Dorey Milk." So if one should hear such a spot, it would save well for a program detail. Then one should tell about his receiver, antenna, and anything else that might interest the person reading the report. Finally, ask for a verification or confirmation (never ask for a "QSL") and enclose sufficient postage for a verie to be mailed to you (a SASE is best). If you leave any of the above out, FORGET IT! No self-respecting CE will answer an incomplete report and we who send complete reports rejoice in this. More next time. 73 and good DX. (Editor's note--we suggest that you take this matter up with the President or member of the Board, so that work might be started on such a sorely needed project and a committee can be appointed.)

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Send FORUM reports to HQ, not to any individual editor. Stencils are typed each week by DeWayne Bruce, Dallas John, or Bill Wittler, oftentimes by a combination of these members. Having all reports come to one address considerably simplifies our work. If you do not send your report to HQ it may miss the deadline! Send all reports to DXWW directly to Ed Krejny, whose address is listed in the "yellow pages." ... Do you have suggestions about the club? If so, send them to one of your elected representatives so that action may be taken on them! Otherwise some valuable suggestions may be wasted when a member neglects to submit them to the proper club official.

The RA-37-C is the long wave and low end of the broadcast band up to 980 kc. Need to replace 4 of the 30 tubes. It has direct reading calibration, with 6½ inches to 100 kc. and 6½ ft. to each megacycle. It makes one a very good freq. meter. I use it to check freq. on the splits as I can calibrate down to 100 cycles. No CJCB DX, but KABH-1510 Midland, Texas DX logged from 0333-0346, JOHB-1090 Sendai, Japan logged at 0445-0502. 885 Plymouth, MONTSERRAT, "Radio Montserrat" sent a v/l. The usual v/s. Settles another old score. (CMS)
908 -BBC- Brookmans Park, ENGLAND was heard with the Home Service on 11/19 from 1835-1840. First time heard in the evening. Also noted on 11/20 at around 1825. Very good signal. (ELK)
926 -RTB- Brussels, BELGIUM was heard weakly on 11/20 from 0035 on. (ELK)
940 XEQ Mexico City, MEXICO was noted at their 0100 sign-off. (MWN)

962 -RTT- Tunis, TUNISIA was noted with a woman talking in French on 11/18 from 0030-0035. Fairly good signal. (ELK)

970 HLGA Suwon, SOUTH KOREA was quite loud, over and with US qrm on 11/14 and 11/16. (KGS)

1000 ???? A fairly strong oriental station was heard on 11/15 after 0500. Good signal at times. Announcer sounded like the same as was heard on "Radio Peking"-1040 kcs., but they were not in parallel. Also was NOT // 655 kcs., so my guess is another Peking outlet. (RJS) Presumably the same oriental station Randy has heard was noted on 11/16 at 0507. Seemed to be in Chinese. KOMO tone is quite distracting ! (KGS)

1020 "Radio City", INTERNATIONAL WATERS is still testing its new transmitter on frequencies around this one. Was heard on 11/8 on 1022 kcs., but later they were noted on 1028 kcs.. (LAR)

1025 TIAC ? San Jose, COSTA RICA. Classical opera type music was heard here on 11/11 at 2055-2113. Did not ID as far as I know. (RJS)

1040 PRG 2 Sao Paulo, BRAZIL, "Radio Tupi" was heard on 11/8 at 0140 after WHO signed off. Very good signal with few fades. Excellent music. (JLK)

KHVH Honolulu, HAWAII was heard under PRG 2 on 11/8 at around 0204. (JLK)

???? Re my 10/25 reception. Seemed to be a s/on. Instrumental music then talk, and I jumped to conclusions, hi ! (RJS)

1045 -KCBC- Pyongyang (?), NORTH KOREA was quite good on 11/13 from 0945-1000 s/off, with repeated IS as shown in WRTVH. (RHM)

1100 Taiyuan, Shansi Province, CHINA is believed to be the location of this "Radio Peking" outlet. Was heard with a quite strong signal on 11/15 from 0727-0740. Taped report off. (RHM)

1196 -VOA- Munich, WEST GERMANY was heard on 11/6 at 0006, good level, with VOA News in English. Unusual as TICA-1195 kcs. normally dominates here. Some WOAI splatter. (JLK)

1200 BED 50 Taipei, TAIWAN. This new 100 kws. transmitter of "The Voice of Free China" may be the mystery station reported in DXWW on 10/13 and 10/27. (LAR) (Thanks Lars, and maybe a mystery solved Gray ? - ed)

1214 -BBC- Brookmans Park (?), ENGLAND was heard on 11/6 at 0025 with a tone modulated carrier. Had 0030 s/on. Fair level. (JLK)

1270 JOFR Fukuoka, JAPAN is presumably the Japanese station heard on 11/6 at 0500. (KGS) (This location per PAL, Gray. - ed)

1305 ZP 10 Asuncion, PARAGUAY was noted at 2200 s/off. (MWN)

1310 -RTF- Fort de France, MARTINIQUE was noted at 2130 s/off. (MWN)

1358 Tirana, ALBANIA was logged on 11/10 at 0110. ID'd via their IS. (CMS)

1420 2 AP Apia, WESTERN SAMOA was audible on 11/16 from 0315-0345, but WHK was on top. Tone and call sign ID at 0330. (KGS) (Sigh ! - ed)

1480 JORF Yokohama, JAPAN was in quite clear on 11/14 from 0435-0500. (KGS)

1495 "Radio Caroline South", INTERNATIONAL WATERS is apparently not signing on now until 0130. (Stan, I believe you meant this time. - ed) Heard poorly on 11/10 and 11/11 at that time. (CMS)

1520 "Radio Caroline North", INTERNATIONAL WATERS has tested on 1510 kcs., but an old friend, one of the engineers on board, states that they are looking for a clear frequency around 1100 kcs.. (LAR)

TGDX Guatemala City, GUATEMALA was noted on 11/16 at 0630 with marimba music. In the clear with good level. Listed as 1500 kcs.. (JLK)

1570 XEAE Ciudad Acuna, MEXICO is apparently here to stay. They are carrying some XERF type programs (With Del Rio addresses). Is XEAE owned by the same company as XERF ? Is their transmitter always under armed guard ? If so, it may be because they haven't apparently paid RCA for it yet. (JLK)
