- 730 XEX Mexico City, MEXICO had a newscast at 0047 on 12/6, then at 0102 they signed off. ID was "La X(eckis) de Mexico". (DR)
- 746 ???? A very weak TA was noted on 12/16 at around 0005. Too weak to even tell the language. Too early for Hilversum. (ELK)
- 764 .... Dakar, SENEGAL was heard at s/on at 0100 on 12/14, louder than anything ever heard from across the oceans. Completely readable. A re-log. (FM)
- 782 CSB 9 Miramar, PORTUGAL was relogged at 0240 on 12/14. They were still quite strong though it was nearly 0800 in Portugal. They have been heard frequently this season. Easy at 0100 s/on. (FM)
- 800 PJB Bonaire, NETHERLANDS ANTILLES was heard under CKLW on 12/6 at 0600 in English. Bet I'm the last one to hear this one, hi ! (DPJ) Verified by Fay Robinson. My report to Holland was relayed to Bonaire ! (DJ)
- 818 .... Andorra-la-Vielle, ANDORRA, "Radio de Valleees" sent a very large (21½ x 16½) program schedule in reply to my tentative report of September, but no verie. I guess I'll just have to re-report ! Their schedule seems to be from 0000-2000 daily. Address listed is: 7 avenue Meritxell, Andorra-la-Vieille. (ELK)
- 827 ???? An unidentified TA was heard here on 12/16 from 0035-0045. Man and woman talking. Too much WCCO QRM and too weak for an ID. Sofia ? (ELK)
- 836 -RTF- Nancy, FRANCE was heard on and off between 0115 and nearly 0300 on 12/14. This is the first time I've heard them despite their high power. I got a lot of reportable info, so a report is out. (FM)
- 854 OAX 4 A Lima, PERU verified with a letter from Alfonso Pereyra B., Sub-Director. Again thanks to Larry Godwin for my 31st. country ! (DJ)

- 863 -RTF- Paris, FRANCE was in with an excellent signal on 12/16 from 0103-0110. Still too much WJW splatter for a report, however ! (ELK)
- 872 -AFN- Frankfort, WEST GERMANY. I almost got a log on this elusive one on 12/16 from 0024-0030, but then WWL started playing music, and that was the end of that ! (ELK)
- 881 -BBC- Washford, WALES was heard from 0200-0215 on MM 12/14 with News. They had time pips on the hour. New country for me, but not enough for a report. (FM)
- 935 .... Tangier, MOROCCO, "Radio Africa Maghreb". In line with the just approved IRCA country list I've shifted my 1958 verie from this station from Tangier to Morocco. My verified total still remains at 56 countries, but the heard total drops to 65. (ELK)
- 944 -RTF- Toulouse, FRANCE was most likely the station heard struggling with CBM's sidebands at 0110 on 12/14. No logging as I couldn't even ID the language due to the CBM splash. (FM)
- 990 ???? An unidentified Spanish station was heard on 12/10 at around 2317, too weak to ID. Signal was S I with heavy CBW QRM. (MM)
- 998 .... Andorra-la-Vieille, ANDORRA (?) A het was noted here at 0210 on 12/14 but the carrier never faded in enough for an ID. It would have been nice had they faded in as Andorra would be a new country here ! (FM)
- 1000 1 ZD Tauranga, NEW ZEALAND was logged in fine shape on 12/7 from 0453-0525. Although not much loggable, the tapes are excellent, hi ! (DJ)
- WBNB Charlotte Amalie, VIRGIN ISLANDS was heard strong with s/on at 0530 over 1 ZD with the SSB. To tell the truth, I was hoping for Vermont, hi ! Reported as they didn't verify the DX of two years back. (DJ)
- 1007 -NRU- Hilversum, NETHERLANDS was in with a fair signal, but with severe QRM from 1010 kcs., on 12/16 from 0115 on. (ELK)
- 1040 .... Peking, CHINA was finally heard with loggable signals on 12/6 at 0502. (DJ)
- 1097 ???? An unidentified Spanish TA was noted here on 12/14 from 0222-0230 with music, man and woman announcers, and frequent commercials (I think they were commercials, hi !). (ELK)

IDed at about 2055 with an IS (six tones of chimes) then "Esta es Radio America", then a short lively tune (about 20 seconds), then six more chimes. At best it was QRM'd by WWVA. Anyone know who it is ? (MM) (Undoubtedly "Radio Americas" on Swan Island (1165 kcs.) -ed)
- 1190 XEWK Guadalajara, MEXICO was noted with s/off at 0016, giving a full XEW network ID on 12/14. (ELK)
- 1196 -VOA- Munich, WEST GERMANY was heard on 12/14 at 0205 while briefly tuning away from BBC-881 to look the band over some more. Got an ID at 0215 ending VOA News. (FM)
- 1205 -RTF- Bordeaux, FRANCE was heard on 12/14 as late as 0300. It has been heard about 5 times already this year. They are on by the time WCAU is off, and are a best bet for Europe. (FM)
- 1214 ???? A carrier was noted here but I was unable to ID it; likely the BBC. It was heard on 12/14 as late as 0230. This was my "goal station" for this date as the frequency coincides with the date. Could have proved to be very interesting if I had gotten an ID. (FM)

- 1322 HJHY Sincelejo, COLOMBIA, "Transmisora Sucre". A very friendly letter was received from Rafael Hernandez M., Gerente to complement the "unofficial"

- 1322 HJHY (cont.) verie I received earlier. Handsome stationary ! (ELK)  
 1336 HJFE Pereira, COLOMBIA, "La Voz de Pereira" has been reported in Sweden on this frequency. (EN)  
 1370 XEHF Nogales, MEXICO was logged strong on 12/7 to 0200 s/off. (DJ)  
 1376 -RTF- Lille, FRANCE was heard on MM 12/14 with fair signals. It was a surprise as it was my first TA between two regional channels. (FM)  
 1420 XEXX Tijuana, MEXICO was logged strong from 0100-0300 on 12/5 and 12/6 with a program called "Radio Teatro Musical". Reported. (DJ)  
 1435A HJGH Bucaramanga, COLOMBIA, "Radio del Comercio" has been reported in Sweden on this frequency. (EN)  
 1475 HJFC Pereira, COLOMBIA, "Radio Centinela" has been reported in Sweden on this frequency. (EN)  
 1495 .... "Radio Caroline South", INTERNATIONAL WATERS was heard weakly, but distinctly with English announcements, on 12/14 from 0212-0220. Too poor for a report. Try again next MM ! (ELK)  
 1520 ???? An unidentified station was noted QRMing the KYMN-DX which I didn't actually log (never caught their call letters). It just occurred to me that it could have been some juicy morsel like "Radio Caroline" ! I'll get it yet ! (FM)  
 1550 XENU Nuevo Laredo, MEXICO sent a verie and a pennant for my 11/22 report. (DPJ)  
 1554 -RTF- Nice, FRANCE was noted briefly on 12/14 at 0130 coming out from behind CBE's splash. (FM)  
 1560 WRSJ Bayamon, PUERTO RICO, "Radio San Juan" was logged with a nice signal on 12/14 from 0435 on. Clear channel. (ELK)  
 1562 .... "Radio Veronica", INTERNATIONAL WATERS was probably the TA logged here from 0147-0208 with a program of popular music (Much of it American) and a male announcer. (This was on 12/14). The music was heard very well, but the announcements were poorly heard. Tentative out. (ELK)  
 1570 XERF Ciudad Acuna, MEXICO was noted back on 12/4 at 2334. Completely dominates 1570 kcs. here at night. (DR)  
 1580 HJAY Galapa, COLOMBIA was in with an excellent signal in the clear on 12/14 from 0440 on. Frequent IDs. Good shot for a Colombian verie ! (ELK)  
 1586 -NDR- Oldenburg, WEST GERMANY was relogged on SM 12/13 with good signals in spite of WAKR. It was already verified last season so no worry here. (FM)
