- 965 HCOT 1 Santo Domingo de los Colorados, ECUADOR, "Radio Zaracay" was on past 0330 on MM 12/14 with Ecuadorian music. Nice catch if you can at 200 w. (DJ)
- YNLU Managua, NICARAGUA was noted with a strong and steady signal on the evening on 12/20 but the DJ was obviously having his troubles. IDed as "Radio Managua" and had a program of popular US and Latin music. (DJ)
- 975 HCAW 2 Guayaquil, ECUADOR, "Ondas del Pacifico" has a s/off between 0100 and 0200, but is AN Sunday morning. Runs 5 kw.. (DFG)
- 995 HCGH 1 Quito, ECUADOR, "Radio Tarqui" has a sign-off between 2300 and 2400, but they are often on past 0100 on Saturday nights (Sunday AMs). They use 1 kw.. (DFG)
- HCEW 2 Guayaquil, ECUADOR, "Radio Suceso" sent a v/1, pennant, and a full page newspaper ad with a reproduction of my report (their first). The verie information is the same as listed before. I also received a letter from the US Embassy in Guayaquil thanking me for promoting international goodwill! (KG) This station has an excellent studio and transmitter. They are owned by Editorial Suceso, the publisher of a national newsmagazine. (DFG)
- 1000 PRB 9 Sao Paulo, BRAZIL was heard on MM 12/14 at 0315 with an excellent signal.
- 1007 -NRU- Hilversom, NETHERLANDS finally made it in well enough for a logging on 12/21 from 0145-0203. Had a program of popular music. Also was noted with a very good signal on 12/22 at 0102. (ELK)
- 1016 -SWF- Mainz, WEST GERMANY was noted briefly with a fair signal but heavy KDKA QRM on 12/20 from 1835-1836 fade-out. Also was noted on 12/21 from

- 1016 -SWF- Mainz, WEST GERMANY (cont.) 0216-0240 with a talk then classical music. Reported. (ELK)
- 1020 YVQB Cumana, VENEZUELA, "Radio Sucre" was logged on 12/14 from 0416-0458. Usually had a fairly good signal. Some KGBS QRM, and after 0430 there was another SS, but I could separate them OK. All in Spanish and was playing native music. (HH)
- 1025 EAJ 8 San Sebastian, SPAIN was logged on 12/12 from 1800-1901 s/off. Bad hum on the channel may have been another station breaking through at times. Also had some WBZ QRM. Got off a fair report. (HH)
- Dobl/Kronstorf, AUSTRIA was noted here on 12/21 from 0127-0145. Nice signal but unfortunately "big brother". KDKA couldn't keep quiet! Also noted with a very good signal on 12/22 at around 0005. (ELK)
- 1035 4 VEF Cap Haitien, HAITI was noted with a powerful signal on 12/20 at 2000 with VOA News in special English and French. ID at 2015. (DJ) Was noted here on 12/13 at 0114, at which time 4 VE was repeated very much. I didn't think they were on that late. (Special program or test? - ed) Also was logged with WBZ "slop-over" later in the morning from 0530-0603 for a report. (DR) Was logged in Spanish on 12/3 from 0543-0615. Very good signal. Religious programming with a number of familiar hymns. Logged for a call change. Have this one as 4 VEC (350 watts) on 1195 kc., 4 VE (2.5 kw.) on 1035 kc.; see 4 VEF is listed as 10 kw.; coming up in power! (HH)
- 1040 Peking, CHINA made it in again this SM from 0515-0530, but faded before I could get a good log. (DR)
- 1052 -BBC- Start Point, ENGLAND was noted at s/off at 1845-1846 on 12/21 with GSQ. Fair signal, just separable from 1050 kc.. Also noted on 12/23 from 1804-1815. No report, however. (ELK)
- 1062 ???? An UnID station was noted here which I believe is 5 kw. "Radio Nacional El Oro" in Machala, Ecuador. Strong but bad distortion. (DFG)
- 1075 TIFC San Jose, COSTA RICA, "Faro del Caribe" was heard well on 12/15 at 2230 with hymns in Spanish. (DFG)
- 1080 YVQJ Barcelona, VENEZUELA, "Radio Barcelona" was logged at 0528. Gave a call letter ID. (RJS)
- 1088 Tirana, ALBANIA was logged on 12/21 at 0109-0120 with a News commentary (apparently) in Italian. Country # 66 logged. Tough copy. (ELK)
- 1118 HCEG 1 Quito, ECUADOR, "Radio Exitos" operates until 2400 nightly on this frequency with a power of 400 watts. (DFG)
- 1124 ???? An UnID TA was noted here Christmas morning at around 0105. Too much QRM for an ID (even the language). Brussels maybe? (ELK)
- 1133 ???? An UnID TA, possibly Zagreb, was logged here on 12/21 at around 0030. Too much WNEW unfortunately! Also heard on 12/25 from 0051 on. (ELK)
- 1138 HJTR Girardot, COLOMBIA, "Radio Girardot" is AN on this frequency with 2 kw.. Plays mostly cumbias and merengues if that's any help, hi! (DFG)
- 1142 -RTA- Oran/Constantine, ALGERIA was heard on 12/12 from 1720-1740 with Arabic programming. Am sure this was the station I had although WRH-64 shows this as French Network. Earlier this year I had what I believe to have been the 1304 kc. station with French programming which I thought to be Oran. WRH-64 shows this as Arabic. Apparently Arabic now on 1142 kc, and French on 1304 kc.. Anyway, 1142 kc. had a fairly good to good signal but heavy WRVA QRM at times. (HH) (Hank, these locations per EBU and the WRTVH Summer Supplement. Oran with 40 kw., and Constantine with 20 kw.. WRTVH indicates the changes you have surmised. - ed)
- 1145 HCRK 1 Quito, ECUADOR, "Radio El Mundo" signs-off between 2300 and 2400. They operate with 1000 watts. (DFG)
- 1170 ???? An UnID SS was noted here on 12/21 at 0410. Is HJGN, "Radio Barrancabermeja" off the air? (RJS) (They're now on 1240 kc., Randy - ed)
- ???? An UnID LA station was noted here on Christmas morning from 0314 on. Plenty of KVOO QRM. Think this was YNUW, but I'm unsure. (ELK)
- 1175 HCAP 5 Cuenca, ECUADOR, "Radio Tribuna del Sur" is apparently the station being heard here with slight YSCB QRM. Hard to ID with a local on 1180 kc.! (DFG)

- 1187 Szolnok, HUNGARY was finally logged on 12/21 from 0011-0023 with an exercise period, and from 0101-0105 with News, Country # 65 logged. Heavy WHAM QRM, and occasional WOWO QRM which finally "killed" it. (ELK)
- 1195 HCCS 1 Sangolqui, ECUADOR, "Radio Turismo" operates with 1 kw., and runs late Saturday night - Sunday morning. (DFG)
- TICA Puntarenas, COSTA RICA, "Radio Columbia-Canal II" was noted behind HCCS 1 on 12/15 at 2230 with tropical music. (DFG) Was logged from 2018 to 0000 s/off on 12/20. IDed as "El Sintonia de Radio Columbia". Reported. (DJ) (Dal, sintonia literally means "tuning", but I think figuratively it's more like "signal" - ed)
- 1196 -VOA- Munich, WEST GERMANY was logged and reported on 12/20 from 1758-1835 with concert music and an ID as "This is the VOA from Munich". Also noted stronger on 12/21 from 0000 on. Reported to Washington. (DJ)
- 1200 YVOZ Caracas, VENEZUELA, "Radiotiempo" was heard at s/on at 0531 on 12/21. Gave call letter ID and then into the News. (RJS) Was noted strongly about 0200. Apparently s/on then. (DJ) (This the right time, Dal ? - ed)
- (Re my mystery station of 10/13 DXWV) A letter was received from Mr. James Wei, Managing Director of the Broadcasting Corp. of China, the "Voice of Free China". He says my report "... does not correspond with our radio beaming." He adds that they have not operated on 1200 kc.. Does Macau have an outlet on here ? Back to the mystery stage ! (KGS)
- 1205 -RTF- Bordeaux, FRANCE was logged and reported via tape on 12/21 from 0021-0115 with an excellent signal at times. (DJ)
- 1210 HJFF Pereira, COLOMBIA, "La Voz Amiga" was noted for a beautiful log on 12/21 from 0404-0424. Not heard too often. (RJS)
- HCGU 1 Quito, ECUADOR, "Radio Ecos" is a new station on this frequency. They operate with 250 watts from a 20' longwire about 15' high. (DFG)
- 1214 -BBC- The Light Program was noted in poorly at 0300 on 12/14. About 15% readable. (DFG) Was noted in English on 12/20 around 1850. Unneeded here, however. (DJ)
- 1220 HJFV Barranquilla, COLOMBIA, "La Voz de Litoral" was noted mixed in with XEB on 12/20 from 0230-0245. Running late for a fiesta I think. (ELK)
- 1224½ HCJM 6 Guayaquil, ECUADOR, "Radio El Mundo" was heard on 12/15 at 2230 "hetting" TIBSD. (DFG)
- 1225 TIBSD Cartago, COSTA RICA, "Radio Victoria" was heard "hetting" HCJM 6 badly on 12/15 with a program of music. (DFG)
- ???? An UnID LA station was noted here Christmas morning from 0340 on. Rather weak. TIBSD maybe. (ELK)
- 1245 HCFA 1 Quito, ECUADOR, "Radio Metropolitana" operates with 750 watts. They sign off between 2300 and 2400. (DFG)
- 1270 XE.. An unknown Mexican station was heard to sign off at 0308-0310. No calls given. Fairly loud. Not local XEAZ, so this leaves two Sonora stations as possibles. (RJS)
- 1285 HCAB 1 Quito, ECUADOR, "La Voz de la Democracia" operates with 500 watts. They sign off between 2300 and 2400. (DFG)
- 1300 CB 130 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Presidente Balmaceda" operates from 0500-0000. They use 10 kw.. News at 0100, 0205 (?? - ed), 0815, 1630, 1940 and every hour during the transmission time. (WRTVH)
- 1320 OAX 4 I Lima, PERU, "Radio La Cronica" sent a v/1, courtesy of Larry Godwin, V/s is Juan Silva Villacorta, Gerente. Address is Avenida Tacna 665 or Apartado Postal 1166. Transmitter is a 10 kw. RCA. (KG)
- 1325 Port-of-Spain, TRINIDAD, "Radio Guardian" was heard on this frequency with a s/off at 2307. (KYDXA)
- 1329 HJAD Cartagena, COLOMBIA, "Radio Vigia" is AN on this frequency. Often mentions Cadena ABC to which it is affiliated. (DFG)
- 1340 ZBM 2 Hamilton, BERMUDA was logged from 0240-0320 with a strong signal at times. Usually dominated the channel, for a real surprise ! Only readable signal on the frequency as the rest of the stations were a jumble. No sign of WOOK, only about 30 miles away ! (HH)

- 1375 ???? An UnID LA station was heard here on 12/14 at 0245 with much talk. Too weak to recognize the accent. TIMAR ? Definitely Spanish. Something on 1376 kc. also ! (DFG)
- 1395 HCVE 4 Esmeraldas, ECUADOR, "La Voz de Esmeraldas" operates with 500 watts. They sign off at 2400. (DFG)
- 1439 Luxembourg, LUXEMBOURG, "Radio Luxembourg" was "hetting" the 1440 kc. LA ANer badly. Seldom reached audibility, however. (DFG)
- 1440 HOC Panama City, PANAMA, "CPR-Radio Aeropuerto" was noted AN on 12/14 being badly QRMed by an UnID US TTer. (DFG)
- 1456 ???? An UnID station was heard on 12/14 at 0250 and on. Two men talking in a thick British accent. Who ? News at 0300. (DFG) (Clevedon below, Dave ? Note the odd coincidence in times, hi ! - ed)
- 1457 -BBC- Clevedon, ENGLAND was noted on 12/20 at around 0250 with a fairly good signal. (ELK)
- 1460 ???? An unknown SS was heard here on 12/21 at around 0350 playing music. Any ideas ? Colombia ? (RJS) (I believe HJJW may be AN, Randy. - ed)
- 1484 ???? What a mess ! About three different stations hashing each other in fine style on MM 12/14 at 0300. And all seemed to be in different languages ! None of the three was ever dominant. Any ideas ? Probably Europe - what's there ? (DFG) (Must be about 100 different stations listed here, Dave. Many 1-10 kwers. Benghazi, Libya is strongest at 10 kw.. This is an International Common Frequency. - ed)
- 1495 "Radio Caroline South", INTERNATIONAL WATERS was noted again on 12/21 at around 0245, but again too weak to get a report. (ELK)
- 1500 PJC 7 Willemstad, Curacao, NETHERLANDS ANTILLES, "Radio Hoyer" was heard DXing for the NNRC at 0315 (Earlier than scheduled) with a fair signal. Station on 1385 kc. and 1010 kc. were NOT on. (DFG)
- 1502 Warsaw, POLAND was logged for the first time this season on 12/24 from 2255-2300. Fairly good signal. (ELK)
- 1520 "Radio Caroline North", INTERNATIONAL WATERS. I got up at 0330 for the KYMN DX but they never made it. Took a log on this one on 12/7 from 0330-0418. Fair to good signal and got a good log. Still coming through very weakly at 0435; the latest I've ever noted a TA ! (HH)
- 1550 XEBG Tijuana, MEXICO was noted here at 0021 on 12/13 with KOKA. (DR)
- 1570 XERF Ciudad Acuna, MEXICO was noted off again on 12/13. (DR)
- XEAE Ciudad Acuna, MEXICO apparently replaced XERF for awhile. They were logged from 0450-0608 on 12/2. (HH)
- 1590 XEHC Ensenada, MEXICO, "Radio Bahia" was heard with an ID at 0125 on 12/22. (R)
