Hello! No report of DX MONITOR for some time, but reading John Callarman's contribution in 12/22 issue prompts me to beat out a report on the old IBM... There appears to be just too much "non-DX-drive" in the Monitor. Lads..let's co-operate with our hard working editors in reporting DX often, but exclusively! There have been a few things that have appeared that would have been better off left unprinted, but I think it is simply a matter of maturing a bit; there certainly is a wealth of young DX material being uncovered by the IRCA! Perhaps it would not be out of line to introduce myself in these pages as other havell' am in my early 40's, a vice-president of a Western Washington Federal Savings & Loan Association; 3 children in High and Jr. High School; a past director of the NRC, and one time editor of a section known as "Fary West DXer" which was a part of the NRC bulletin, "DX News". My DX-perience dates back to the late '30's when I DXed from 9000' high Custer County in Colorado using a battery powered equipment. I reentered the DX field in earnest again along about 1951 from the Seattle area, from which general arealall my present verifications have been earned. Due to sunspot cycle conditions, I primarily DX For Foreign, but do have all 50 states, plus D.C. and all Canadian Provinces verified. Dec. 31, 1964 will mark 11th anniversary of my first TA reception, that of NDR-1586 syndronized German group, with Oldenburg at 40 kw, the most powerfull. This is a rather fitting anniversary as this season has seen the greatest TA opening possibly of all time. As incredible as it may sound, the African/European/Asian Near East is workable from the Pacific Northwest on the Medium Wave band this season. I had never expected to reach into Asia via the TA route, but Beirut, Lebanon (836 kc.) has become first such to make it here, making it during the fantastic late December opening that I'm sure many others experienced. Recently built the loop per plans from IRCA but similar to past experiences it doesn't work; no null, no signal, napaacitor no effect, so have shelved. Always go back to the "L's" from which I have 10 to choose. These range from 90 to 250' in length. Receivers include a 20 Quebe Navy DAK3 surplus direction-finder radio unit; an HQ-180; and a German Grun-Dig. Each receiver feeds into a tape-recorder and is automatically pre-scheduled for reception during the wee-hours. Live DX is generally limited to hours of 7AM to 10PM, local time as no hobby worth breaking up sleep schedule and disturbing family. Tapes often monitored as much as 48 to 72 hours after reception, so few reports out in 24 hrs.!

I also suggest that Ron's C&BLRC start producing a document soon. 3) I am opposed to the addition of FM or any other band except the BCB to the IRCA's program. 4) I am opposed to any merger with the NRC. 5) I favor Ron Schatz's suggestions that the BoD members use the DX Forum as their medium of balloting, and that there be an Electronic Theory and/or a construction section added to the DX Monitor when space permits and that a permanent editorship for such a section created. 6) I favor Howie Modell's suggestion that there be a better form of geographic representation in the BoD in the next election. 7) I am against changing the reporting time from EST to some other time zone. 8) I favor that a committee be formulated to write a publication with the scope of the NRC's How To Enjoy Better DX and make this publication available to the membership at cost. 9) Alaska and Hawaii should be considered as states, not as countries. 10) I am opposed to the addition of any survey collecting program in the IRCA other than that which is now being carried on in DX Forum. 11) I favor dropping the f/s list, and 12) lastbut not least, I favor every member of IRCA resolving to recruit at least one new member this year. - 575 -SDR- Muhlack, WEST GERMANY sent a very pretty QSL card to verify my report but it was, unfortunately, made out for 6030 kHz, and so it wasn't counted. I sent it back with a request for one correctly filled out. Shades of Andorra-998 ! (ELK)
- 593 Sofia, BULGARIA is a now regular here past their 2300 s/on. (RFS)
???? An UnID TA has been heard running AN lately. Polka music suggests Frankfurt. (RFS)
- 625 TIRICA San Jose, COSTA RICA, "La Voz de la Vistor" was logged here for the first time (And for my first Costa Rican !) on 12/16 with a loop at 2005. No QRM, and fairly good signals. Frequent slogan IDs. (DR)
Was heard on 12/26 from 0611-0625. (RJS)
- 640 CMQ Havana, CUBA is the SS station I heard here, I'm pretty sure. No call heard, but IDed as: "Libre de America ... la Voz de Cuba ... La Habana, Cuba." In fair from 2200 on. Country # 5 here. (LS)

- 655 -KCBC- Pyongyang, NORTH KOREA was heard with a fair signal on 12/26 and MMs. Not as good as September and October, however. (RJS)
- 656 Murmansk, RUSSIAN SFSR was logged at 0040 on 12/28 throbbing against Firenze. (RFS)
- 665 ???? An UnID TA heard with music past 0100 is probably Ravensburg. (RFS)
670 HRN Tegucigalpa, HONDURAS is almost definitely the LA logged here with good signals with the loop pointed SE. WMAQ was still dominant. (DR)

- 764 Dakar, SENEGAL (cont.) Mail to "Radio Senegal", BP 1765 in Dakar. (EW) Was heard at 0130 on 12/28. They peaked at 10 db over S 9 on a "scotch" meter ! (GSK) Was heard at 0825 (? - ed) on 12/23 with good level. (JLK) Was heard with a good signal on 12/28 from 0213 until after 0300. Not as good as 12/21. (RJS)
- Sottens, SWITZERLAND was noted on 12/28 at around 0115 under and mixed in with Dakar. Unneeded here, but a curiosity ! (ELK)

- TGJ Guatemala City, GUATEMALA, "Radio Nuevo Mundo" was logged with the loop with absolutely no WCBS-WLS-WWL QRM. Good at times on the S 20 without a loop also. (DR)
- 881 -BBC- Washford, WALES completely surprised me ! They were heard over WCBS's tone or OC, whatever. First at 0259 then lost at 0315. Same type programming as 1214 kc., it seemed, but not in parallel. Country # 29. Never more than 50% readable. No definite IDs either, but I'm satisfied it was they ! (RJS)
- 890 HJCE Bogota, COLOMBIA was noted in the clear with their AN program and an excellent signal on 12/21 at 0345. (DS)
- 900 TICS San Jose, COSTA RICA, "La Antenea, su Antenea" was heard at 0430 on 12/7 with a wierd program. (RFS)
- XEW Mexico City, MEXICO was heard well here on 12/18, not signing off until 0110. CJBR signed off at 0100 and CHML was looped out. This made this almost a clear channel. (RB)
- 908 -BBC- Brookmans Park, ENGLAND was noted at 0217 on 12/22. Fair level, with a discussion program. Separated from 910 kc. nicely. (JLK)
- 917 ???? An UnID TA was heard here on 12/28 from 0121-0135. Too weak to even ID the language, but I suspect the much wanted Ljubljana. (ELK)
- 935 -RTM- Agadir, MOROCCO was in with its best signal this season on 12/28 at around 0135. Usual chanting. (ELK)
- 950 JOKR Tokyo, JAPAN was heard quite weakly under KSEL during the WBER test time on 12/14. (KGS)
- 962 -RTT- Tunis, TUNISIA was logged with a French program finally one night. Don't recall the time. 13th. African. (RFS) Was apparently the French station here with News on 12/28 at around 0135. Unneeded however. (ELK)
- 998 Andorra-la-Veille, ANDORRA was noted with a nice signal on 12/28 from 0135 on. Unneeded, but nice to hear again. (ELK)
- 1010 XEKD Ciudad Acuna, MEXICO was noted at 0125 on 12/28 with a call letter ID. (JLK)
- 1020 ZCO Nuku'alofa, TONGA was heard on 12/28 at 0306 briefly atop KGBS with a female announcer with a British accent. What we need is a reverse special from KGBS, i.e., KGBS would sign-off from 0300-0400 one of these MMs so everyone could get a crack at ZCO in the clear, hi ! (JLK)
- 1020 TGUX Guatemala City, GUATEMALA was logged here on 12/16 at 1930 with a loop and with little KIMA QRM. Fair signal. Frequent slogan IDs as "Radio Panamericana". (IG)
- 1030 LS 11 Buenos Aires, ARGENTINA, "Radio Libertad de Buenos Aires" is the one running AN over/under XEQR. Frequent News and Weather between the music. (RFS)
- XEQR Mexico City, MEXICO. I was wrong on this one. They are apparently AN. WBE is usually dominant here, however. (DR)
- 1034 Tallinn, ESTONIAN SSR was logged past 2300 on 12/28 throbbing against an UnID TA. My 77th. Country. (RFS)
- 1035 4 VEF Cap Haitien, HAITI was logged from 2033-2055 on 12/22, I'm pretty sure, and again from 0537-0542 on 12/28 with guitar music, slow non-stop. (RJS)
- * 1045 ???? Need some help here. A very definite tone was heard here on 12/25 at 0249. Had code repeated. Anyone ? Panama ? (RJS) (Doubt Panama - ed)
- *1040 Peking, CHINA sent a QSL for my 9/20 report. No frequency or v/s listed. I don't suppose anyone actually knows the exact location do they ? (KGS) (Not I ! - ed)
- PRG 2 Sap Paulo, BRAZIL, "Radio Tupi" was heard on SM 12/20 with WHO off. S 2, R 95% in Portugese. English and Spanish reports were sent via Air Mail. (EW)
- 1050 XEG Monterrey, MEXICO sent a v/q for my report. It says on the card that the power is 100 kw., while VJ says 150 kw.. Which is correct ? (DR) (I believe 150 kw. is right. The card may be an old one. - ed)
- 1052 ??? A weak TA signs on here at 2200. (RH)

- 1064 TG.. (...?), GUATEMALA is noted evenings ID ing as "Radio 1210". (RFS)
Their ID slogan is definitely "Radio Novela". I think there are
three stations in a network. (JLK)
- 1070 HJCG Bogota, COLOMBIA was noted again on 12/21 from 0434-0437 with a
"Radio Santa Fe" ID and a good signal. (DS)
- 1075 TIFC San Jose, COSTA RICA sent a nice v/c and v/1 for my 11/13 report. (RB)
- 1090 KHAI Honolulu, HAWAII was noted with a fair signal after KING's s/off at
0409 on 12/20. (KGS)
- 1092 ???? An unknown SS station was almost surely measured as this frequency.
Heard on 12/28 at 0307. Possibly a Colombian drifting ? (RJS)
- 1106 -AFN- Munich, WEST GERMANY was logged for a report on 12/28 from 0044-0102,
when KYW's OC came on. Fair signal only. (ELK)
- ???? I have a definite taped ID of the UnID Spaniard on this frequency.
Not a "Radio Juventud" station. Announced as "Radio Nacional de Espana".
Rest of the ID is unreadable. (RH) (No -RNE- outlets are listed here
by either the EBU or the -RNE- program guide, Bob. - ed)
- 1150 XEAD Guadalajara, MEXICO was logged on 12/30 at 0355 with a call letter ID.
Good signal, especially considering the 125 watts ! In the clear. (JLK)
- XEJP Mexico City, MEXICO was logged here SM 12/20 at 0400 in the clear.
Call and slogan ID at 0400. Slogan was "Radio P..." (DR) (Slogan should
be "Radio Variedades (Var-ee-eh-dah-days)", I believe, Dave. - ed)
- 1170 KOHO Honolulu, HAWAII was dominant after KCBQ's sign-off on 12/28 until
0400 when they signed off. Then an UnID SS station took over until
WVVA's sign-on. (RJS)
- ???? An UnID LA was heard on MM past 0400 with continuous news and time. (RFS)
- 1177 ???? Who is the UnID LA in the clear here at 0630 most mornings ? (RH)
- 1178 Horby, SWEDEN sent a verie back in 10 days. Signer not discernable. (RH)
- 1196 -VOA- Munich, WEST GERMANY was heard with the "Breakfast Show" at 0034 on
12/28. Put in a strong signal. (GSK) Was heard on 12/12 at 2330 in
Russian giving WOAI trouble. (JLK)
- 1200 CMDD Bayamo, CUBA, "Reloj Nacional" was noted at 0300 and on, parallel to
1260 kc.. KOGO's second harmonic messes it up before 0300, and after
WOAI is off. (RJS)
- A Chinese jammer is audible by about 0240, and a Spanish ANer by 0220,
but both are weak. This was on 12/14. (KGS)
- 1205 -RTF- Bordeaux, FRANCE is believed to be the French station noted here on
12/21. Not enough for a report. (EW)
- 1206 ???? Who's the Ecuadorian here evenings, SACCA ? (RFS)
- 1210 HJFF Pereira, COLOMBIA, "La Voz Amiga" was way on top here on 12/28 all AM
from 0310 until WCAU signed on. (RJS)
- 1214 -BBC- The Light Program was heard with a truly fantastic signal, not totally
readable, but with an almost definite ID at 0258. It faded in and out
until 0415 when they had the best signal of the night - equal to HJFF.
I kept hoping they'd fade out because their local time is 0915. They
have been heard by the NRC until 0500 though. (RJS)
- 1220 XEB Mexico City, MEXICO is heard with a very good signal every MM after
WGAR signs off. (RB)
- 1224 HCBJ 2 Guayaquil, ECUADOR, "Radio Mundo" is now strong most evenings. They
sign off at 0005. (RFS)
- 1245 ???? An UnID "Metropolitana" was logged in Portugese here on 12/7 at
0330. Doubt Ecuador. (RFS) (Apparently not, Ron, as Dave says they
sign off normally much earlier. See last week's DXWW. - ed)
- 1268 Novi-Sad, YUGOSLAVIA was heard with a positive ID at 1700 on 12/24. (RHO)
- 1270 XENY Nogales, MEXICO is the call here, I'm pretty sure; at least per the
NARBA listing a few issues ago. S/off is at about 0310. (RJS)
- 1286 CSB 3 Lisbon, PORTUGAL, "Radio Renascenca" was heard masking Prague on
12/29 past 0230. (RFS)
- Prague, CZECHOSLOVAKIA verified my report of 11/8 with an "OLR QSL".
Quite definite. Christmas card, pocket sized calendar card and a

- 1286 Prague, CZECHOSLOVAKIA (cont.) short-wave schedule. V/s is Martha Frojamora. Not prompt, but welcome ! (RFS)
- 1313 Stavanger, NORWAY was in the clear and S 7 at 1615 on 12/27. First time logged. Country # 76. (RH)
- 1315 HJAK Barranquilla, COLOMBIA, "La Voz de la Patria" sent a very nice v/1 for my reception of their station on this frequency although their letterhead shows 1310 kc.. They also enclosed a pretty pennant, a color postcard of Barranquilla, a picture card of their "Radio Teatro" and a greeting card with a view of the front of their building on it. V/s is Clemente Vassallo Manfroni and their address is Apartado Aereo 231 or Apartado Nacional 621, Colombia # 30 here. (ELK)
- 1331 -RAI- Rome, ITALY was good at 1900 on 12/16. (RH)
- 1358 Tirana, ALBANIA was S 8 at 1715 on 12/19. They seem to be on later now. What is their power ? (RH) (All of the sources I have say 1 kw., although the Copenhagen plan allows them 100 kw.. The WRTVH Summer Supplement says they now sign off at 1800 on Saturdays. - ed)
- 1385 ???? An UnID TA was noted in weakly past 0130 on 12/29. Cantabria ? (RFS)
- ???? An UnID TA is heard daily, but weakly, with deep fades. Bell like ID, but not clear on tape. Could be part of a "Radio Moscow" IS. (RH)
- 1394 Graz, AUSTRIA is the one definitely heard here at 0110 on 12/29 under a mess of OCs. One of them from the Azores, I hope. (RFS)
- 1412 ???? An UnID TA, too strong and too late for Pristina, was noted here around 0130 on 12/29. Any ideas ? (RFS)
- 1466 3 AM 2 Monte Carlo, MONACO has got to be the shocker of 12/28. It was totally unexpected ! Noticed a signal at 0200 between KENO and KXOA, definitely French, but only had about twelve minutes of him. Bad QRM, but I'm pretty sure of it. Country # 28 heard. Oh, for a tape recorder ! (RJS)
- 1475 Vienna, AUSTRIA was in very nicely on 12/28 from 0150 on, to dispute my DXWW note of 12/15 ! (ELK)
- YNAG Chinandega, NICARAGUA was heard on 12/29 at 2245. Separated easily from local KLVL on 1480 kc.. (JLK)
- 1484 -BBC- Barrow, ENGLAND was logged at 0105 on 12/29. (RFS)
- 1511 ???? An UnID TA, probably Brussels, was noted "hetting" with WLAC on 12/29. (R)
- 1520 "Radio Caroline North", INTERNATIONAL WATERS was logged for the first time on 12/28 from 0319-0341. Fair signal. Reported. (ELK)
- 1546 ???? A weak TA is being heard here at around 1645. (RH)
- 1562 "Radio Veronica", INTERNATIONAL WATERS sent a monster greeting card and a letter in English which I am counting as a verie. It mentions that I will be receiving a QSL card from them as soon as their new shipment arrives. V/s is Jos Hogen, Technicus. Address is Postbus 218 in Hilversum, NETHERLANDS, but he mentions that they are located off the coast of Scheveningen. He also said that they use only 5 kw., so this is my lowest powered TA ! Europe # 41, and the first I've received from a "non-country", hi ! (ELK)
- 1570 XERF Ciudad Acuna, MEXICO explained their absence as "transmitter trouble" when they signed on for the first time after their recent absence. (JLK)
- 1578 CSB 5 Porto, PORTUGAL was in very nicely again on 12/28 from 0120 on. It's hard to believe that they only use 10 kw. ! (ELK)
- 1580 -FEN- Iwakuni, JAPAN sent a QSL from the FEN. V/s is Lt. Col. E. T. Pardee, and the address is APO 67, San Francisco. He verified both this station and Itazuke on 1550 kc. for my 12/6 report. (KGS)
- HJAY Galapa, COLOMBIA, "La Voz de la Cordialidad" was heard with an ID at 0334 on 12/23 under and over an unknown tone tester. (RJS)
- 1585 HIBS San Pedro de Macoria, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, "La Onda de la Sintonia" is here from 1590 kc.. Their schedule is from 0600-0005. They were AN on 12/25, however. (RFS)
- 1594 CSB 4 Lisbon, PORTUGAL is believed to have been the TA noted here weakly on 12/28 from 0212-0220. (ELK)

- 1594 "Manx Radio", ISLE OF MAN is scheduled from 0300-0900 on weekdays, and from 0400-1000 on Sundays. They ID as "Manx Radio on 188". Their address is Victory House, Prospect Hill, Douglas, ISLE OF MAN. (MWN)
- 1608 EPO El Paso, COLOMBIA is another CW marker noted at 0444 (The same time as RAB) on 12/21. A real fine signal. Dave Rogers, this one is only 1 kw. - try for 'em ! (DS)
- 1612 RAB Rabinal, GUATEMALA. I hope this is still within the BCB limits because it was heard on 12/21 at 0444 with excellent CW IDs. Only 1200 watts, so it is my best Central American. (DS) (Operating within the framework of the Constitution drafted at Denver in 1963, the upper limit of the BCB band is taken as 1630 kcs., Dan. I'm frankly a little doubtful as to whether these should be counted as BCB stations, however. - ed)

- (3) Distances will be computed using STATUTE miles.
- (4) Stations must be received from the same general location. This will be taken to mean within a nominal 25 mile radius.
