629 -RTT- Tunis, TUNISIA verified via a painting type card. Is definite-it says "QSL card" right on it-but it doesn't specify the frequency. Country # 96. (CMS) (No 962 kc., Stan ? I think you pick on the hard ones, hi !-e)
630 CA 63 Chanaral, CHILE, "Radio Chanaral" has been here since 2/26/63. Was ex-CA 142 (1420 kc.). Apparently the old CA 63 in Iquique has changed frequency. Power is 1 kw., and their schedule is 0800-2230. (See also 1530 kc.) (LBG)
640 CMQ Havana, CUBA continues to be strong here. They start overriding WHLO at around 1940. (MM)
647 -BBC- Crowborough, ENGLAND was logged with a superlative signal on 1/6 from 1842-1959 s/off in Russian with Russian Orthodox Christmas Eve services. Thought it was Simferopol at first, hi ! (ELK)
650 HJKH Bogota, COLOMBIA was heard to ID at 0139 on 12/21 as "La Voz Amiga". (DP)
OAX 5 R Ica, PERU, "Radio Regionalista" is a new one here. They operate from 0600-0000. Power is unknown. (LBG)
655 YSS San Salvador, EL SALVADOR was logged here on 1/5 for a report. Heard from 1855-2012 in Spanish. IDed at 1905 in part as: "Este es YSS ... Radio Nacional de El Salvador, America Central... 655 kilociclos Onda ...". Even played Beatles records ! (DR)
660 CB 66 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Chilena" operates from 0600-0000 with 50 kw.. (LB)
685 TGRT Guatemala City, GUATEMALA, "Radio Fabulosa" was logged on 12/6 at 0125 from Cookeville. (DP)
690 CB 69 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Santiago" verified my report of 6/26. The v/s is Agustin Fernandez B.. The WRTVH address is correct. The station explained that it was operating on 705 kc. for less than a week last June, so it was just luck that I heard it there ! (LBG)
CC 69 Concepcion, CHILE, "Radio Universidad" is now here with 1 kw.. Was ex-CC 89 (890 kc.). Schedule is 0655-2300. (LBG)
707V Cairo, EGYPT/UAR IDed on 12/22 at 2300 s/on via clock interval signal. This is the Sudanese Service, which explains why it isn't //773 kc.. As this transmission is for Sudan, I wonder if this station is located in southern Egypt, say Aswan or Abindan, which is right on the Sudan border ? Something to think about anyway ! (CMS)
715 HRTV Tegucigalpa, HONDURAS, "Radio Television" was logged at 0030 on 1/4. New country here. (DP)
720 CM.. Colon, CUBA. Constant monitoring of this frequency starting at 1900 revealed nothing, only an ID as "Radio Rebelde". But on 1/5 a set of what sounded like call letters was given so fast that they almost blended. Sounded like CMGO or CMJO, but I'm not sure. (MM)
723 Jeddah, SAUDI ARABIA was undoubtedly the TA with OC noted here on 12/21 at 2220 and again on 12/22. I am trying something new with these Mid-East stations which fade out before or right after they sign on.

- 723 Jeddah, SAUDI ARABIA (cont.) I am trying to note the exact time at which the carrier is turned on. (CMS)
- 730 OAX 5 E Ica, PERU, "Radio Independencia" operates from 0700-0000 daily. (LBG)
- 746 Cottbus, EAST GERMANY, "Radio DDR" was almost certainly the station logged here in German on 1/6 from 0048-0100 when Hilversum signed on and covered them. (ELK)
- 755 ????? A tone tested was heard here on 1/1 at 0107. Very mysterious. They had Morse CW, but I'm not too hot with it. (RJS)
- 760 CB 76 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Cooperativa, La Voz de Chile" operates from 0556-2329 with a power of 300 kw. in the towers, according to their staff. They have an attractive new QSL card. (LBG)
- 764 Dakar, SENEGAL was logged from 0143-0200 with a fairly good signal; about S 6-7. Tape and letter report sent. (DP)
- 780 CA 78 Antofagasta, CHILE, "Radio Libertad" is now here with 1 kw.. Was ex-CA 90 (900 kc.), but here since last May. Schedule is 0500-0000. (LBG)
- 782 CSB 9 Miramar, PORTUGAL was logged at 0220 on 1/4 in the clear when WBBM cut off their carrier. (JLK)
- Burg, EAST GERMANY signs on at 2200. (CMS) (See DXWW of 15 December)
- 795 Black Rock, BARBADOS was logged from 1925-2010. Weak, S 5-6, but they were reported. Quite a bit of 790 kc. and 800 kc. "slop-over". (DP)
- 800 XEMMM Tijuana, MEXICO is on daily until 11 PM (0200 EST, I presume, Larry ? - ed) despite the fact that they are a daytimer. XELO cuts them up after sunset. I picked up a verie from them when in Tijuana. Their address is: XEMMM, Apartado Postal 425. The v/s is Oralia Hernandez, Sec., but I'd suggest writing to the Gerente. They have a real nice studio, which is owned by XEBG ! (LS)
- 818 Andorra-la-Vieille, ANDORRA verified via a postcard type QSL. Country # 97. (CMS) (Three easy ones to go I hope, Stan ! - ed)
- 820 CB 82 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio del Pacifico" is AN - 7 days with 1 kw.. This one should make it into North America despite HJED. (LBG)
- 830 CMCA Havana, CUBA continues to give WCCO a run for its money, but WCCO usually gets on top. On 1/4 at 2259 CMCA IDed as "This is CMCA, Habana, Cuba; everybody's Friendly Voice", or something to that effect. It was only S 4, and there was Christmas light noise. (MM)
- 836 -RTF- Nancy, FRANCE was logged on 12/21 between 0130 and 0200. (DP)
- 840 HJBI Santa Marta, COLOMBIA was noted on 1/1. AN ? (RJS)
- TG.. Guatemala City, GUATEMALA, "Radio Emperador" was heard again on 1/4 from 0051-0110; still on then. (RJS)
- CC 84 Talcahuano, CHILE, "Radio Almirante Latorre" operates with 1 kw. from 0500-2330. The Gerente, Sr. Alejandro Deij S. verified my report from Boulder giving me my best SA ! CC 84 plans to change to 820 kc. in March. (LBG)
- ???? What LA had a s/off on 1/1 at 0113, immediately after WHAS's s/off ? (DR)
- 845 -RAI- Rome, ITALY was finally heard here (Probably) on 1/5 at around 0103. WJW is just too much here even during Newscasts. (ELK)
- 875 ????? An unknown LA was heard here on 12/30 from 2227-2254. Very weak. TISS ? XEMO is bad news. (RJS) (TISS is most often heard here, Randy, but YNW 1 is occasionally noted. - ed)
- 880 1 YC Auckland, NEW ZEALAND. A New Years present ! A very nice letter and NZBC card were received from Mr. S. Williamson, Programme Organiser to confirm (quite specifically) my reception of 12/28. First Zedder here, and Country # 58 verified ! (ELK)
- 881 -BBC- Washford, WALES was heard with the Welsh Home Service at fair level in the clear on 1/4 at 0210. (JLK) Was logged to 0200 on 1/4. Two reports were sent; one to Cardiff, and the other to London. Knowing London's rather indefinite veries, I'm hoping for something more specific from Cardiff ! (DP)
- 890 CB 89 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Bulnes" operates with 1 kw. here from 0630-2300. (LBG)
- 950 XEGM Tijuana, MEXICO operates from 0900-0100. They use Spanish, with some

- 950 XEGM Tijuana, MEXICO (cont.) American Rock and Roll. (LS)
- 960 CB 96 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Jose Miguel Carrera" is here with an RCA 10 kw. transmitter. Ex-CB 116 (1160 kc.). Schedule is 0600-0100. (LBG)
- 995 ???? An unknown LA, seemingly AN, was heard on 1/1 in and out of the QRM from 0251-0335. Very good at times. Best split (LA) I've heard, but no "Radio Suceso" IDs. They're the most obvious possibility. (RJS)
- 1000 1 ZD Tauranga, NEW ZEALAND verified my report of 12/7 in two weeks with a NZBC QSL card and a personal letter from S. D. M. Smith, Station Manager. He mentioned that 1 ZD shares antennas with 1 YC - Rotorua on 800 kc.. (DJ)
- XEOY Mexico City, MEXICO, "Radio Mil" was in from 0230-0330 on 12/30 with a very good signal. WCFL was easily looped out. (RB)
- 1020 TGUX Guatemala City, GUATEMALA, "Radio Panamericana" was heard on 12/30 at 2350. Very rare here. (RJS)
- ???? An UnID LA was noted here on 12/30. Seemed to be slightly off frequency. May be Cuban. Heard two descending chimes at 2320 as reported also by the NRC. (RJS)
- 1030 XEQR Mexico City, MEXICO, "Radio Centro" was heard on 1/4 from 0018-0030 with music and IDs in Spanish. (LL) Was in at 0330 on 12/28 with a good signal. This frequency is usually clear on MM here. (RB)
- 1040 Peking, CHINA was heard on 12/28 from 0510-0730+. From 0530 to 0600 their programming consisted of musical recordings with a woman vocalist. (LS)
- PRG 2 Sao Paulo, BRAZIL, "Radio Tupi" was heard well on 1/3 at 0230 with music and Spanish IDs. (LL) (Methinks you had your first brush with Portuguese, no ? - ed)
- 1045 HOJ 2 Las Tablas, PANAMA, "Ondas del Canajagua" was heard to ID at 2232 on 12/30. Had a tone tester over it later, at 0003. Maybe not exactly on 1045 kc.. Two chimes at 0148 from HOJ 2. (RJS)
- 1060 CB 106 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Minería" operates 0500-0030 with 80 kw.. (LBG)
- 1090 XEWL Nuevo Laredo, MEXICO verified my report of 11/5 with an interesting letter by Fidel Cuellar, GM. They were surprised at my clear tape and used it "to their advantage". Address is Apartado # 8. (DJ)
- CA 109 Antofagasta, CHILE, "Radio La Portada" has this license now. The old "Radio Toco" in Tocopilla must have moved. Operates with 1 kw. from 0600-2330. Is ex-CA 103 (1030 kc.). (LBG)
- 1100 ???? An UnID LA was heard here very strong on 1/5 from 1950-2000. Clear ID at 2000, but my lack of knowledge of Spanish prevented an ID. Completely over KYW with the loop. (DR)
- 1106 -AFN- Munich, WEST GERMANY sent a QSL card to verify my recent report. Europe # 42 and West German # 5. Interesting to note that APO 757 is now ZIP 09757. (ELK)
- 1125 "Radio London", INTERNATIONAL WATERS came on over Christmas on this frequency. They operate from 0100-1600. They are apparently 50 kw.. Operates from a ship in the Thames estuary. (KB) (SCDX)
- 1140 CB 114 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Corporacion" is AN - 7 days, and operates with 50 kw. days, 10 kw. nights. (LBG)
- 1150 ???? An UnID Spanish station was heard on 1/3 at 0235 with pop music. (LL) (Most likely XEJP. - ed)
- 1165 "Radio Americas", SWAN ISLAND was sent a taped report. Logged on 1/3 with an ID heard at 2330. (DP)
- OAX 6 D Tacna, PERU, "Radio Nacional" is definitely on this frequency according to the station staff. Power is 300 watts, and they operate from 0600-0000. Never AN. (LBG)
- 1180 CB 118 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Diego Portales" verified my Boulder report of 5/15 with a letter and a beautiful pennant. Address is as listed in WRTVH. V/s is Sr. Raul Tarud Siwady, Gerente General. S/on is 0600. (LBG)
- HIBE Santo Domingo, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, "Radio Mil" was logged in the clear on 1/3 from 0150-0215. Good signal. Reported. The Dominican Republic

- 1180 HIBE Santo Domingo, DOMINICAN REPUBLIC (cont.) is now on fast time, i. e. EST + 1 hour. (ELK)
- ???? Who was the Spanish station heard around this frequency on 1/3 with music ? (LL) (The above ? Note the date. They were featuring a program called "La Fiesta ... de Brugal". - ed)
- 1196 -VOA- Munich, WEST GERMANY was heard on 12/21 at 0130 with News. It was the most terrific TA signal I've ever heard ! S 7-8 on my meter, and perfect readability. (DP)
- 1200 ACE Fort Brooke, PUERTO RICO was in briefly at 0430 on 12/28 at s/on, but the Cuban powerhouse soon took over with that ticking sound behind the announcer's voice. (RB)
- 1205 -RTF- Bordeaux, FRANCE was heard on 12/21. S 5 signal. (DP)
- 1210 HJFF Pereira, COLOMBIA, "La Voz Amiga" was heard on 1/4 from 0150-0205 with music and IDs. (LL) Was logged on 1/4. IDed at 0130. It was reported. (DP) Was very strong at 0400 on 12/28. Is this HJEL or HJFF, and where is it located ? (RB) (This one, Roger. HJEL-Cali, "Radio Tricolor" is now operating on 620 kc.. - ed)
- CB 121 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Universidad Tecnica" has been operating here. Ex- CB 120 (1200 kc.) for two months. Power is 1 kw., and they operate from 0730-2200. (LBG)
- 1214 -BBC- The Light Program, ENGLAND. No ID was heard, but it had to be them. Heard from 0200-0330 on 12/28 with popular music, weather and News. (RB) Was heard very strong (S 6-7) as usual on 12/21. Next best signal to the VOA on 1196 kc.. (DP)
- 1220 HJ.. (...?), COLOMBIA. At least one Colombian, and probably two, were noted every night around 0100 and on, after XEB's s/off. One is definitely "Radio Cordobesa", and I'm hoping that the other is "La Voz del Litoral". Will keep trying. (RJS)
- 1240 ???? Who was the oriental station here on 12/28 from 0520-0620. Man and woman spoke and at the hour (0600) a woman sang, then the man said a couple of words, followed by 3 tones and a high pitched pip and then March music. Nothing listed. (LS)
- 1250 This "Radio Moscow" relay station was heard from 0450-0635 with Kremlin chimes at the hour and the half hour. Was heard in an oriental language, presumably Japanese. No music, just speech with man and woman. (LS) (Both the WRTVH and World Medium Wave Guides for 1964 indicate Khabarovsk, Larry. - ed)
- CA 125 La Serena, CHILE, "Radio La Serena" is here with 1 kw.. They operate from 0500-2330. Ex- CA 108 (1080 kc.). (LBG)
- CB 125 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Andres Bello" is now operating here with 1 kw.. Ex- CB 64 (640 kc.), they operate from 0615-2330. (LBG)
- 1270 OAX 5 B Ica, PERU, "Radio Ica" has its s/on at 0645. On the AM on 7/28 they will be on until 0300 or so. (LBG)
- 1295 -BBC- Crowborough, ENGLAND was logged on 12/21. Not too readable. (DP)
- 1310 XEC Tijuana, MEXICO operates from 0900-0500 except Sunday when they sign off at 0200 MM. Address is: XEC, PO Box 521, San Ysidro, Calif.. (LS)
- 1320 CA 132 Vallenar, CHILE, "Radio Estrella del Norte" is now here. Ex-CA 147 (1470 kc.), they operate with 250 watts from 0730-2230. (LBG)
- CC 132 Concepcion, CHILE, "Radio Simon Bolivar" is now here. Ex-CC 116 (1160 kc.), they operate from 0600-2300. (LBG)
- 1325 PJA-10 Oranjestad, Aruba, NETHERLANDS ANTILLES surprised me by holding forth nicely here on 1/2 from 1920-2005 in Spanish. Good signal; peaking at S 7, with heavy slow fading. This is the first time I've heard them since 1956, when they were on 655 kc.. Reported. (ELK)
- 1358 Ibadan, NIGERIA was logged on 12/31 at 1715. Political program, but very rough copy. (CMS)
- 1380 CB 138 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Cruz del Sur" operates from 0600-0000 with a power of 25 kw.. (LBG)

- 1400 CA 140 Copiapo, CHILE, "Radio Atacama" is now here. Ex-CA 121 (1210 kc.), they operate from 0700-1400 and from 1700-2200. Their power output is 250 watts. (LBG)
- "Radio Noordzee", INTERNATIONAL WATERS is off the air, as was suspected. (KB) (SCDX)
- 1420 XEXX Tijuana, MEXICO verified with a picture postcard and note in Spanish. No address or v/s given, but it was mailed in Tijuana. (DJ) Operates from 0900-0330, except on Sunday. Their address is P. O. Box 648, San Ysidro, California. Their Tijuana address is Apartado Postal 469. Uses 2 kw., non-directional. (LS)
- 1440 CA 144 La Serena, CHILE, "Radio Universidad Tecnica" is a new station here. S/on is at 1000. Power is unknown. (LBG)
- 1457 -BBC- Clevedon, ENGLAND was heard at 0300 with time pips followed by News. One of the best British signals noted so far. (JLK) (They only use 20 kw. according to the EBU, Jack! - ed)
- 1460 CA 146 Antofagasta, CHILE, "Radio Antofagasta" is now here. Ex-CA 141 (1410 kc.), and operates from 2 to 3 hours daily only. (LBG)
- 1475 Vienna, AUSTRIA may have been the station heard here on 12/28 at 0200. Man talking. (DP)
- 1480 XE.. (...?), MEXICO. A definite Mexican station was heard here on 1/2 at 0105. Gave call, starting with XE, in Spanish, but I was unable to ID it due to heavy KLEO QRM. (DR)
- 1500 CB 150 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Sudamerica" operates with 1 kw. on the following schedule: 0830-2300. (LBG)
- 1520 "Radio Caroline North", INTERNATIONAL WATERS was heard at 0316 until 0345 with good level on 1/4. Reception was marred by a hum on the frequency. Is the Oxford Street address still good? (JLK) (I'm not sure, Jack, but the best bet seems to be the address listed in DXWW on 1 December. - ed)
- 1530 CA 63 Chanaral, CHILE, "Radio Chanaral" (See also 630 kc. - ed) is temporarily operating here with 100 watts. They will return to 630 kc. as soon as a new tube arrives. (LBG)
- CA 153 Copiapo, CHILE, "Radio Juan Godoy" will begin operating here in February or March with 3 kw.. The v/s will be Sr. Namberto Aguilere A., Director. (LBG)
- 1546 -BBC- The Third Program, ENGLAND was noted here at 0310 on 1/4 with fair level. (JLK)
- 1550 XEBG Tijuana, MEXICO operates from 0900-0330 (Note this earlier s/off). Their address is Avenida "C", 225 Altos, Apartado 425, Tijuana. (LS)
- 1554 -RTF- Nice, FRANCE was logged on 12/21 between 0130 and 0200. (DP)
- 1590A ???? On 1/3 at 0300 there was a code station over WAKR and only two letters were repeated over and over. (C and Z). I don't know too much code, and this was keyed very swiftly, but that was what it sounded like. (MM)
- 1594 CSB 4 Lisbon, PORTUGAL was undoubtedly the station noted here in Portuguese at 0240 on 1/4. Weak but separable. (JLK)
- 1600 CB 160 Santiago, CHILE, "Radio Chronos" is now here. Ex-CB 154 (1540 kc.) since April. They operate from 0500-0000. (LBG)
- PIRATES It is undoubtedly a good idea to log these stations now, while they are available. On December 17 a convention was proposed by the 17 nation Council of Europe in Strasbourg to eliminate these stations. (KB)
- NETHERLANDS Anyone desiring a more specific QSL from Trans World Radio on 800 kc. ANTILLES should attempt to log Bonaire while they are relaying Radio Nederland in Hilversum. Reports can then be sent to the Radio Nederland at P. O. Box 222, Hilversum. They verify with a real nice QSL card, with a solid red background, a white crane standing on one foot in

NETHERLANDS (cont.) a pool of water (blue) with a Dutch windmill and buildings
 ANTILLES in yellow, and a large sunflower (I guess it is) in the upper right
 hand corner also in yellow, Radio Nederland in white over the
 windmill, Hilversum-Holland opposite the windmill buildings and in
 the lower left corner, in white, "Relay Via Bonaire". It took
 12 days approximately to receive. (HW)

PORTUGAL Anyone having trouble getting QSLs from ENR in Portugal might try
 writing in Portuguese. I did so, didn't include return postage,
 and got their QSL and a printed schedule in 24 days ! Address your
 report to: Emissora Nacional de Radiodifusao, Rua do Quelhas 2,
 Lisboa, Portugal. (RFS)

SWEDEN (Further from Lars Ryden) "Sveriges Radio" produces the programmes,
 but the actual transmitting is done by the Board (The Swedish Royal
 Board of Telecommunications), who "own" and operate the feeder lines
 and transmitters. Therefore, they are very interested in reports,
 preferably dealing with the technical side of the reception, whereas
 this corporation (Sveriges Radio) is interested in how you liked the
 programmes. (In fact the verifying of reports are merely a matter of
 good relations to the listeners.)

There are now three different radio services (programmes). Programme 1
 on AM and FM, Programme 2 mainly on FM but also relayed by several
 low powered AM stations, and Programme 3, still in the experimental
 stage, and carried by a small number of FM stations in the large
 city regions. "Melody radio", i.e. the US style of programming with
 news and recorded DJ programmes, is carried by Programme 1 stations
 from 2200-0600 (1600-0000 EST, I presume - ed). From 2400, or
 rather 0000-0600 (From 1800-0000 EST, I presume - ed) only the main
 stations (593, 719, 773, 980, 1178, 1223, and Longwave 191 kc/s)
 are operating. In the future, when the Programme 3 net is fully built,
 the "melody radio" will be carried over it all 24 hrs., Programme 1
 will remain the same, but will not have the night broadcast - at
 least we hope so.
